[57] **CLAIM**

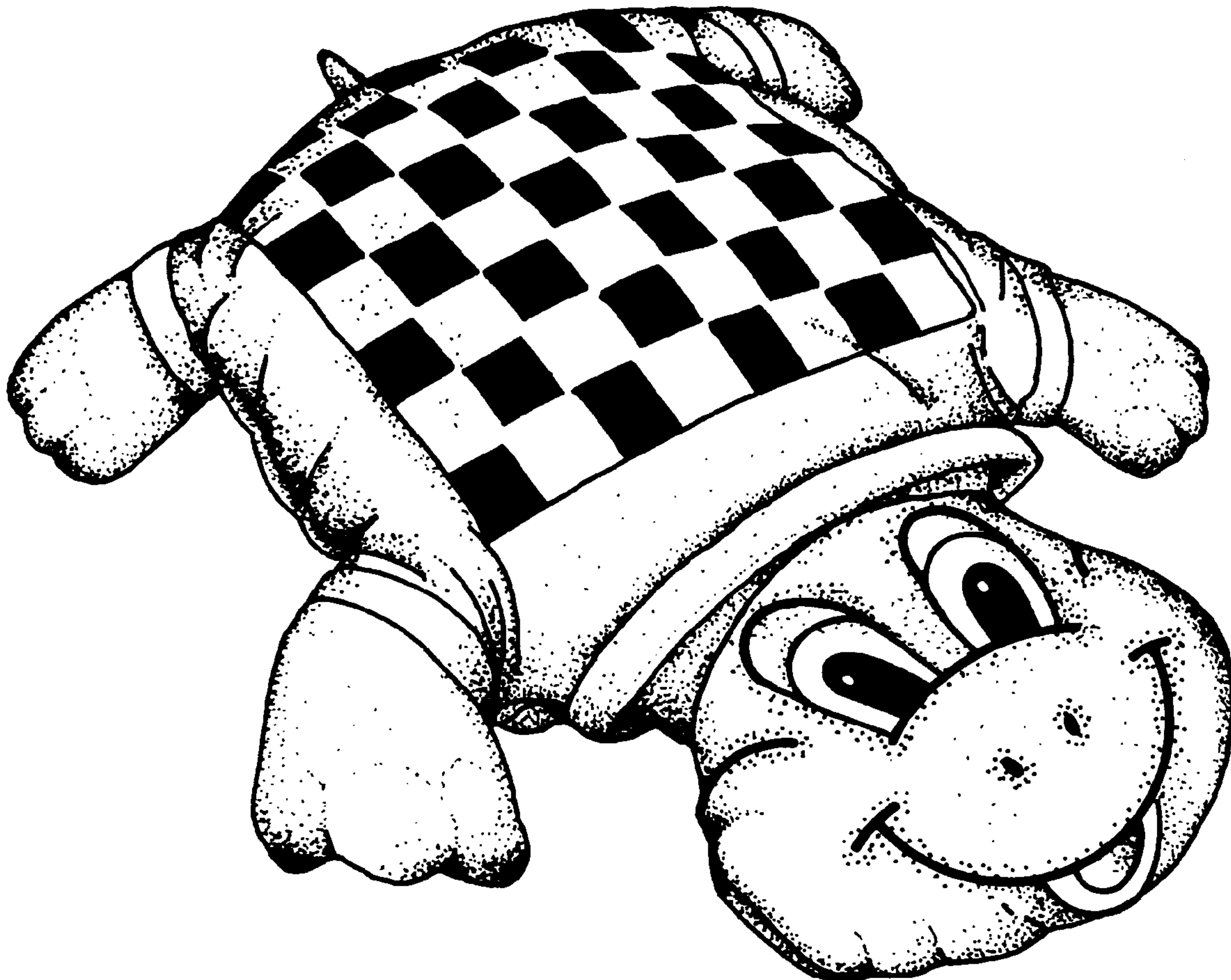
The ornamental design for ornamental child's pillow in the fanciful form of a turtle bearing a checkerboard design on its back, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the ornamental child's pillow in the fanciful form of a turtle bearing a checkerboard design on its back taken from above the right front corner, FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view the left side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a front end elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The stippled shading represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend uniformly throughout the areas represented.

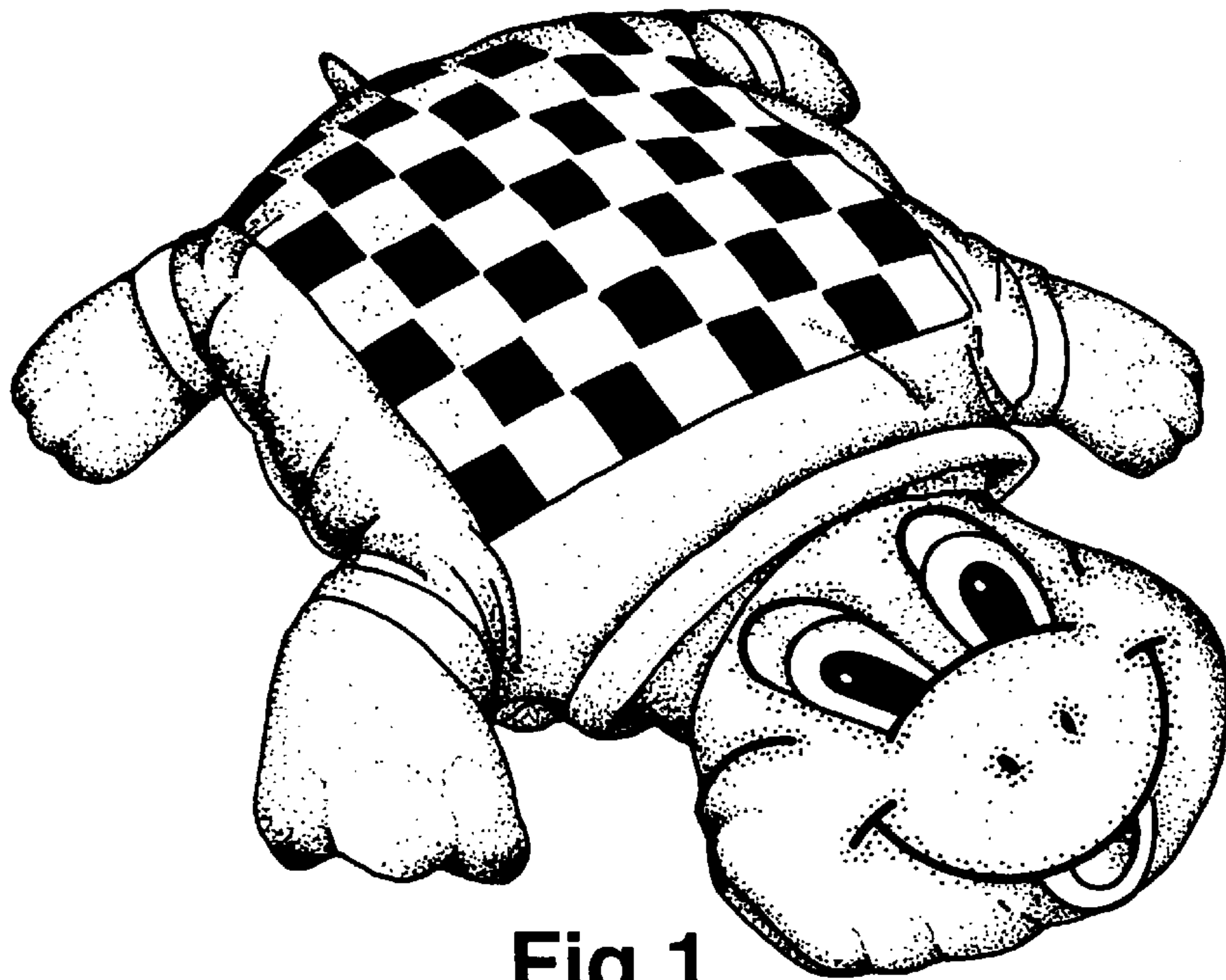

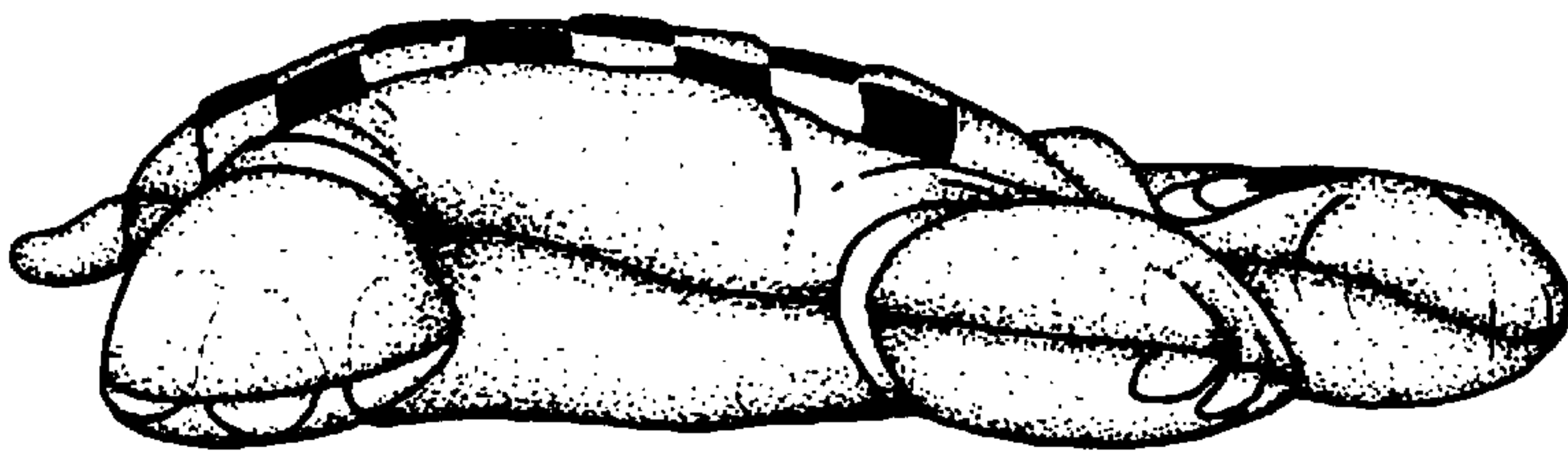
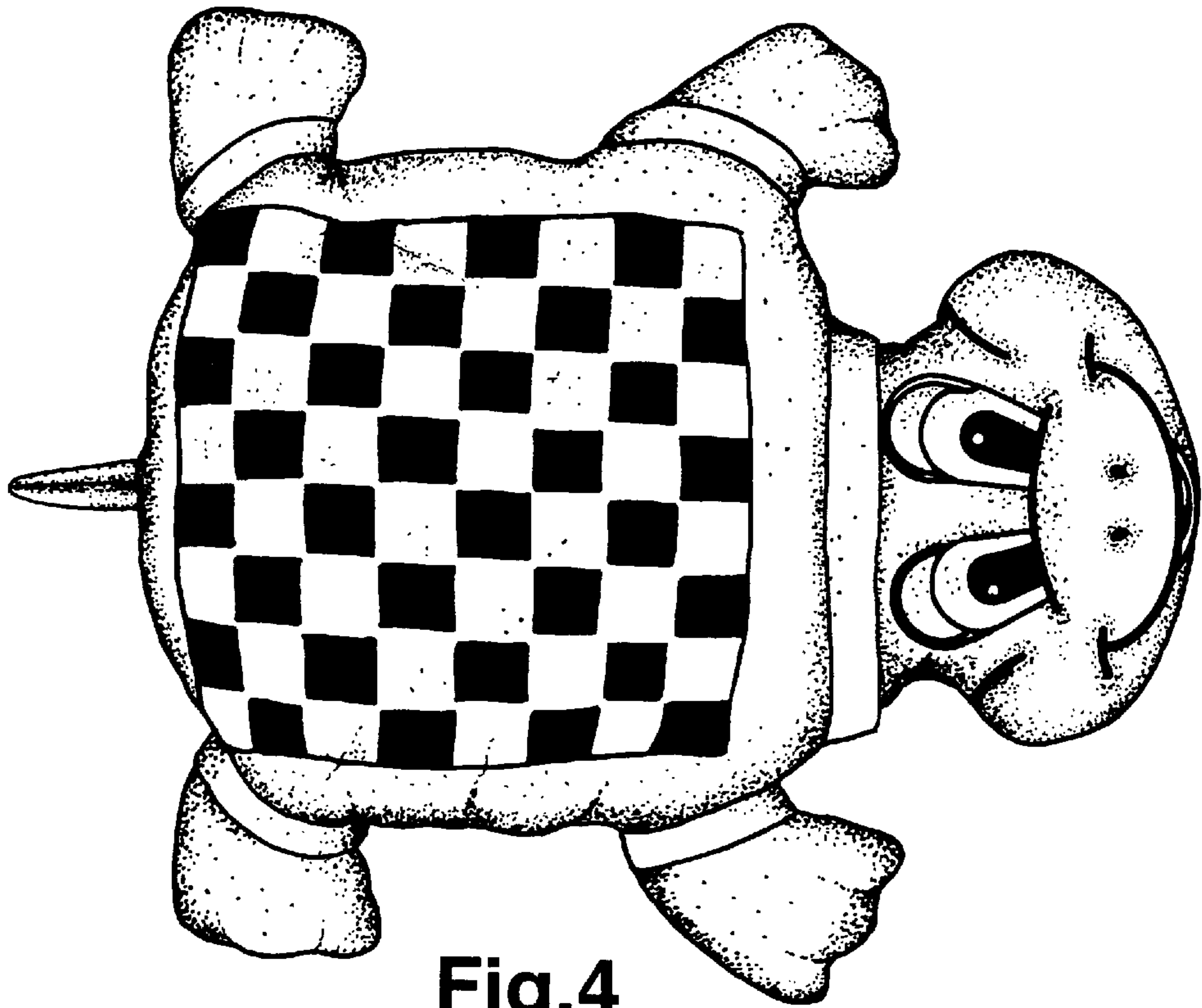


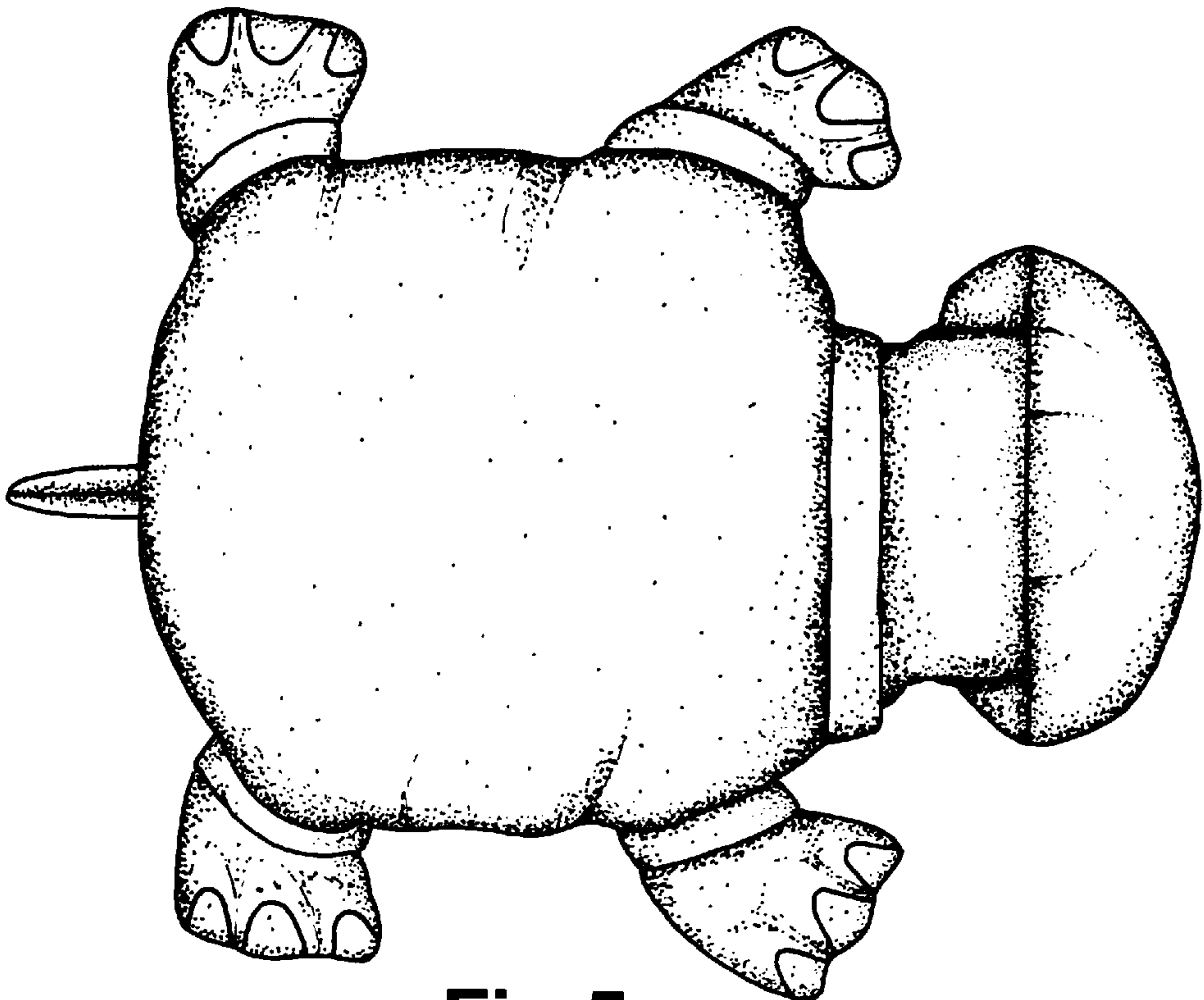
