DESCRIPTION

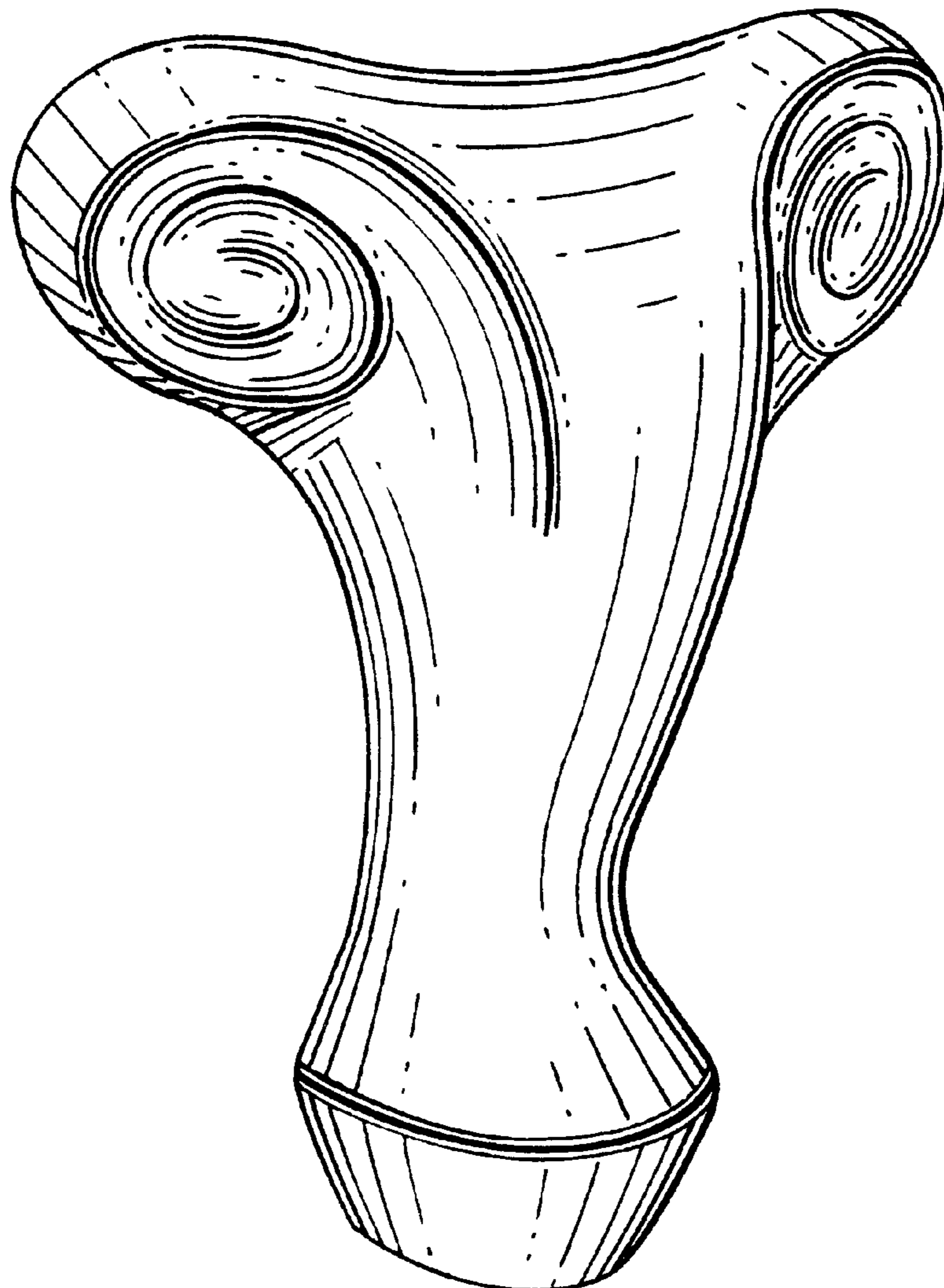
FIG. 1 is a top, front, and left side perspective view of a tub leg showing my new design;

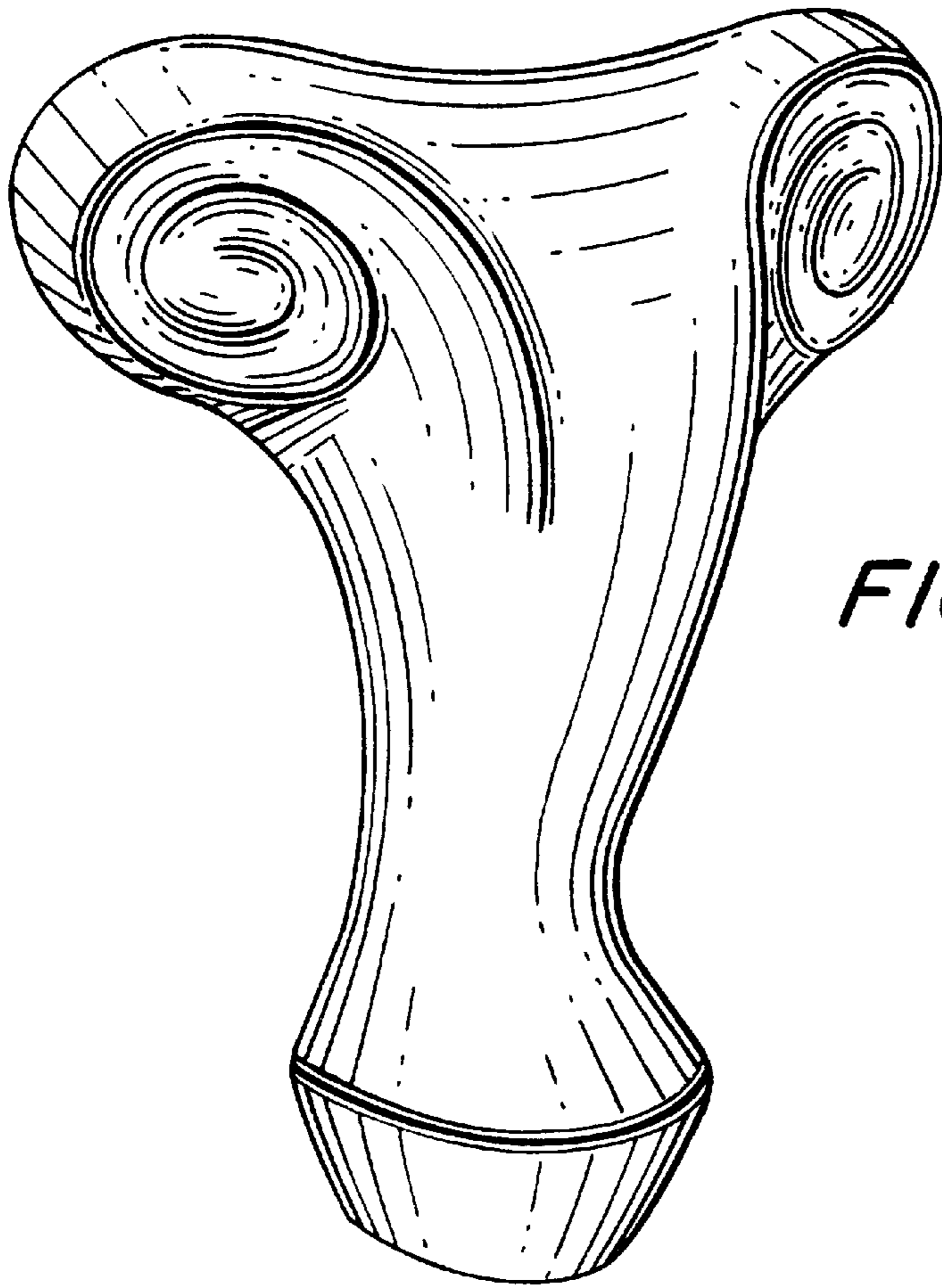
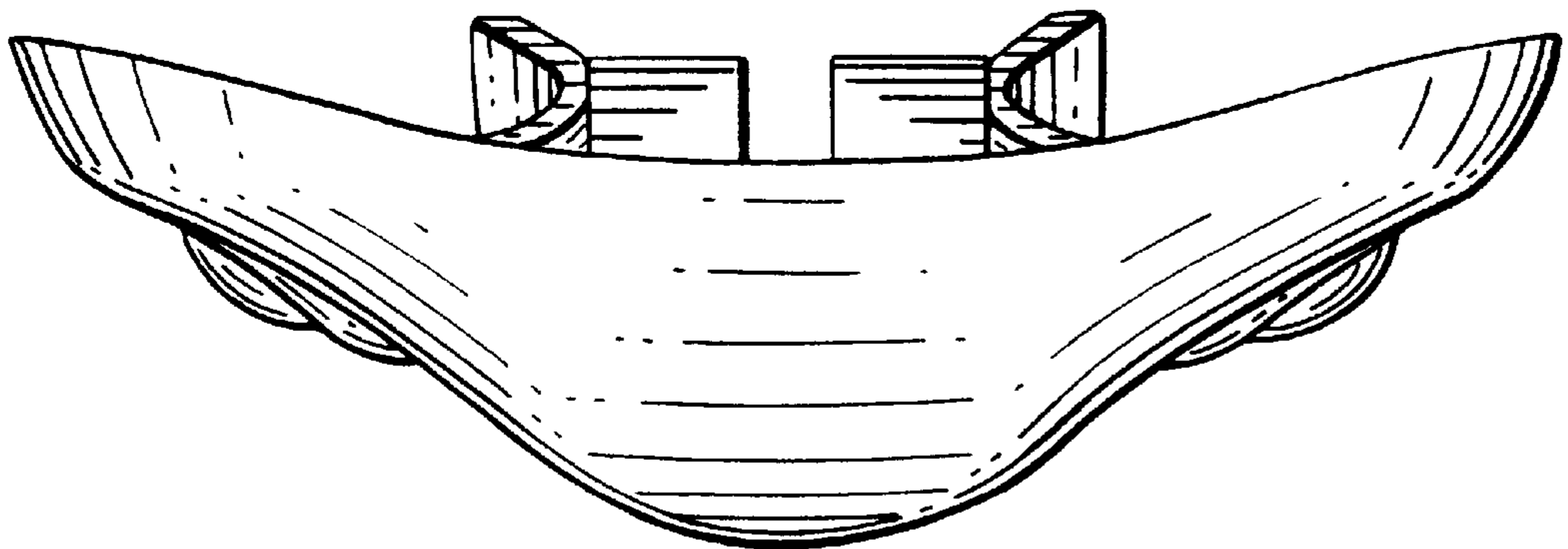

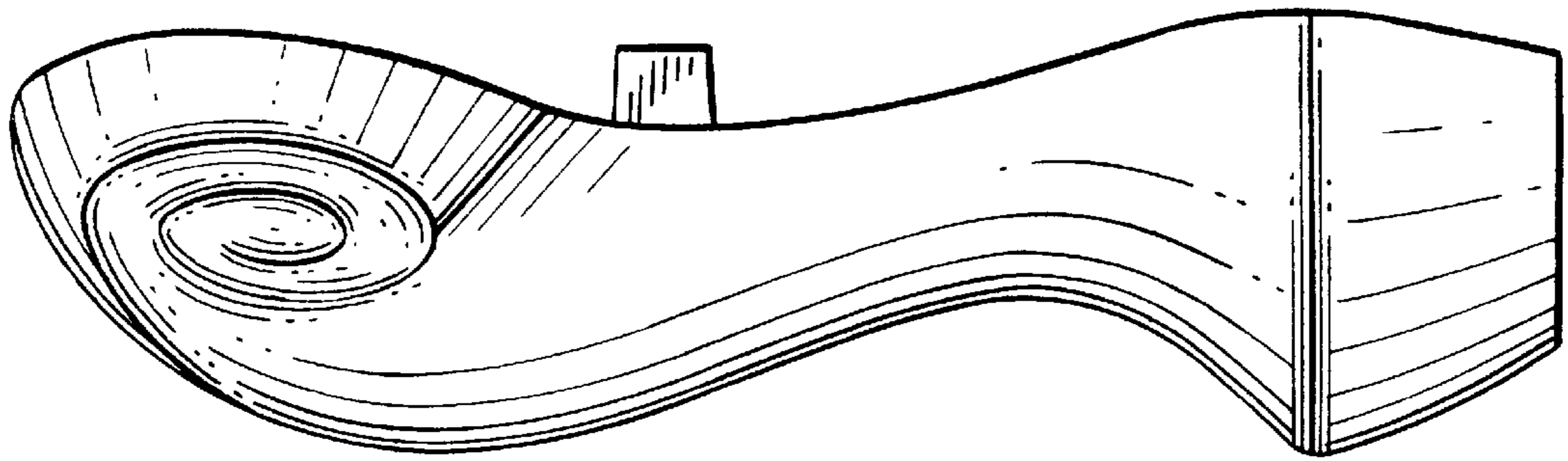

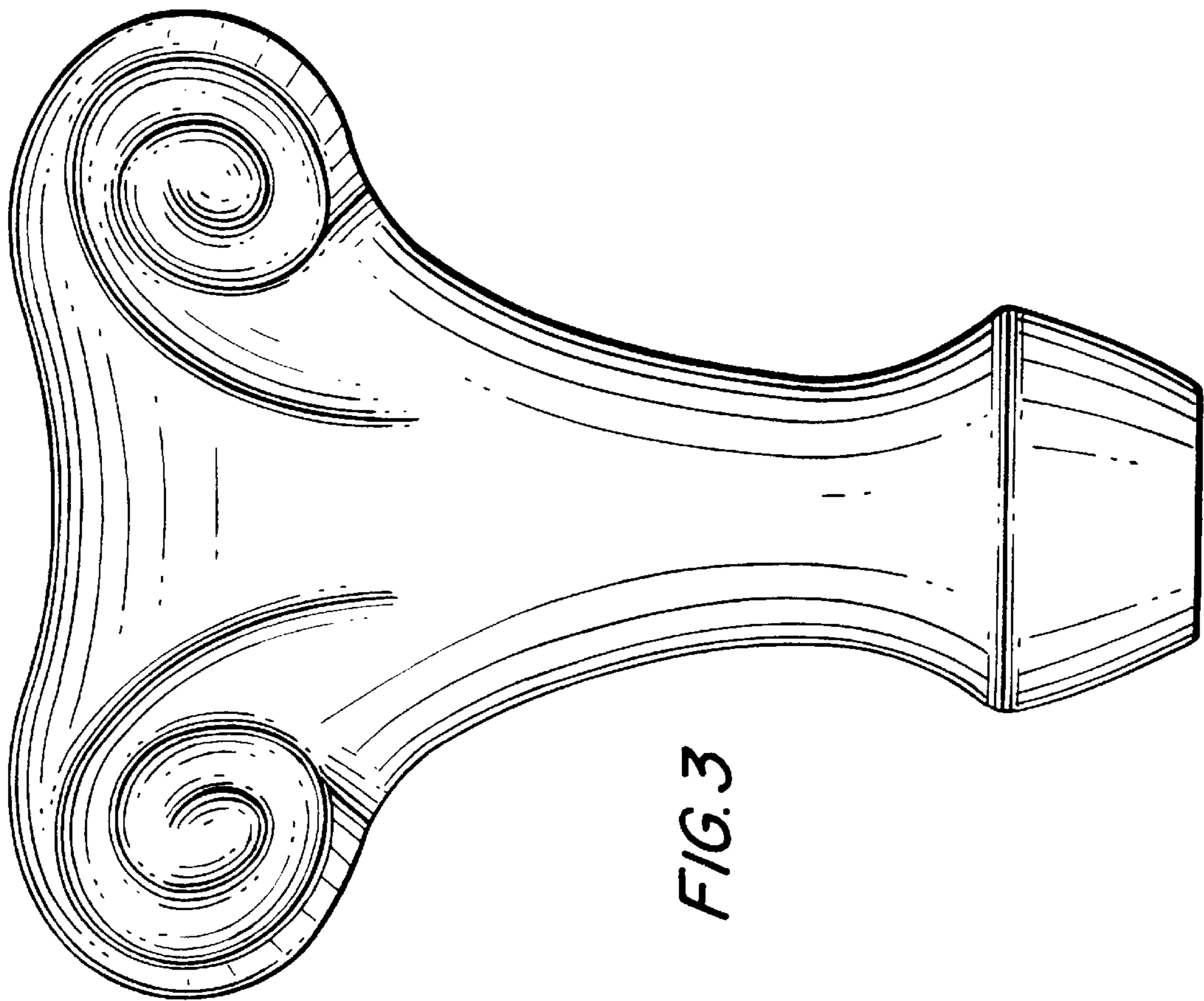

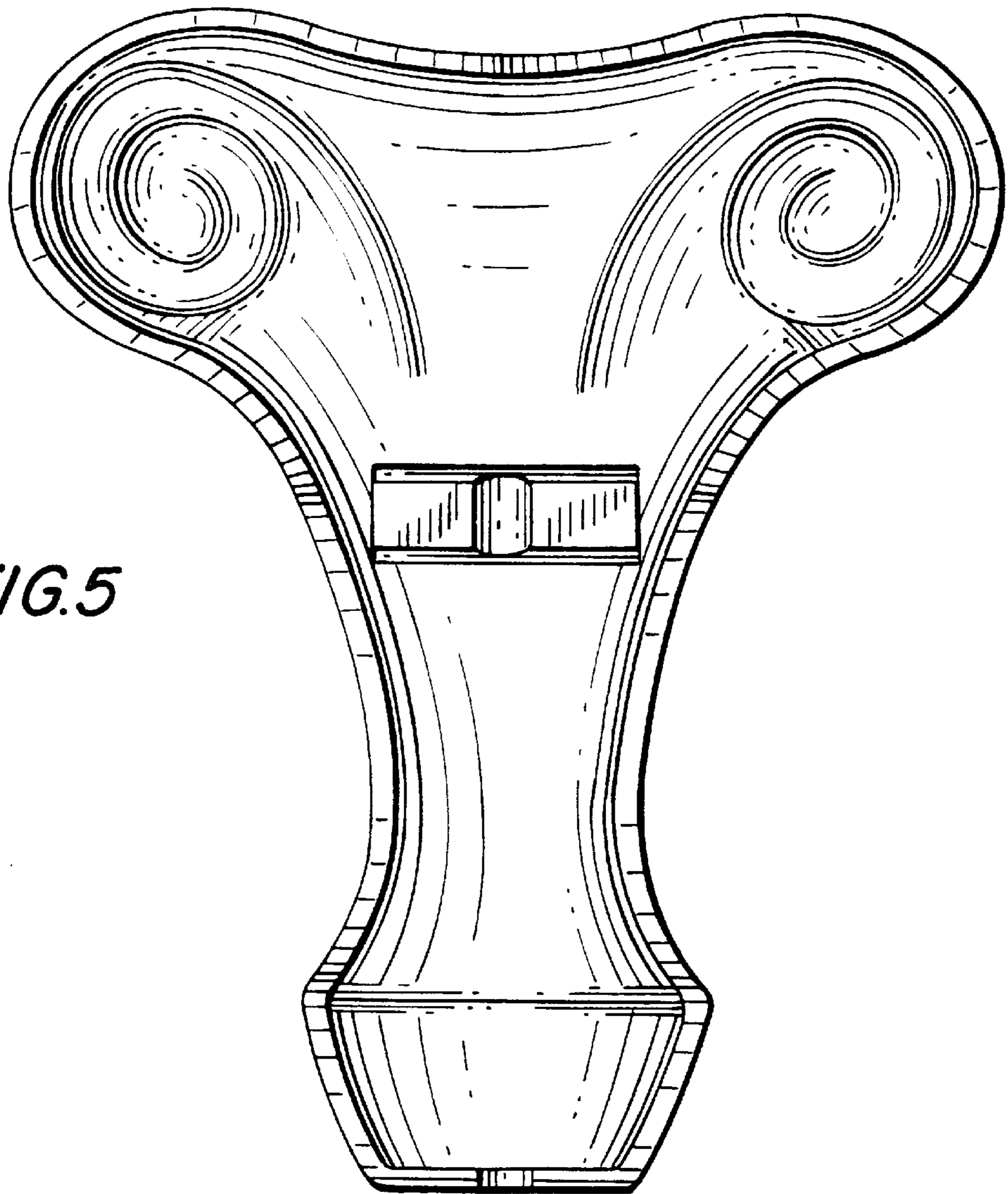

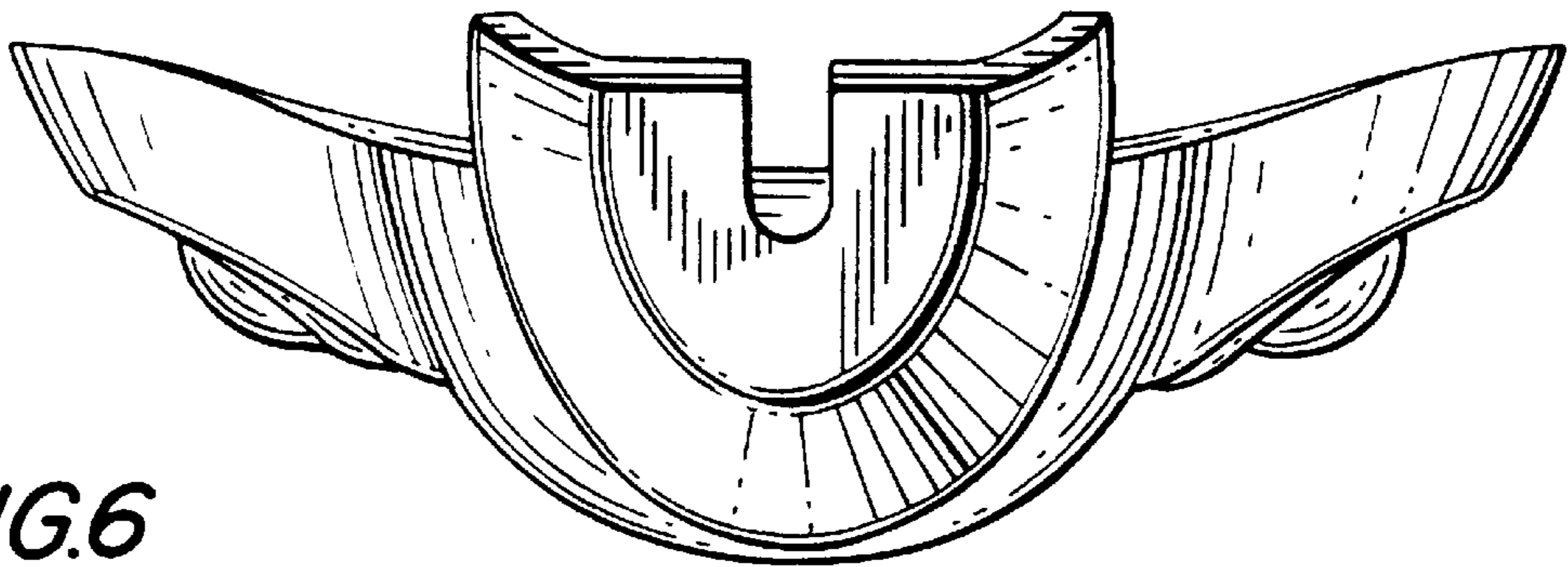
