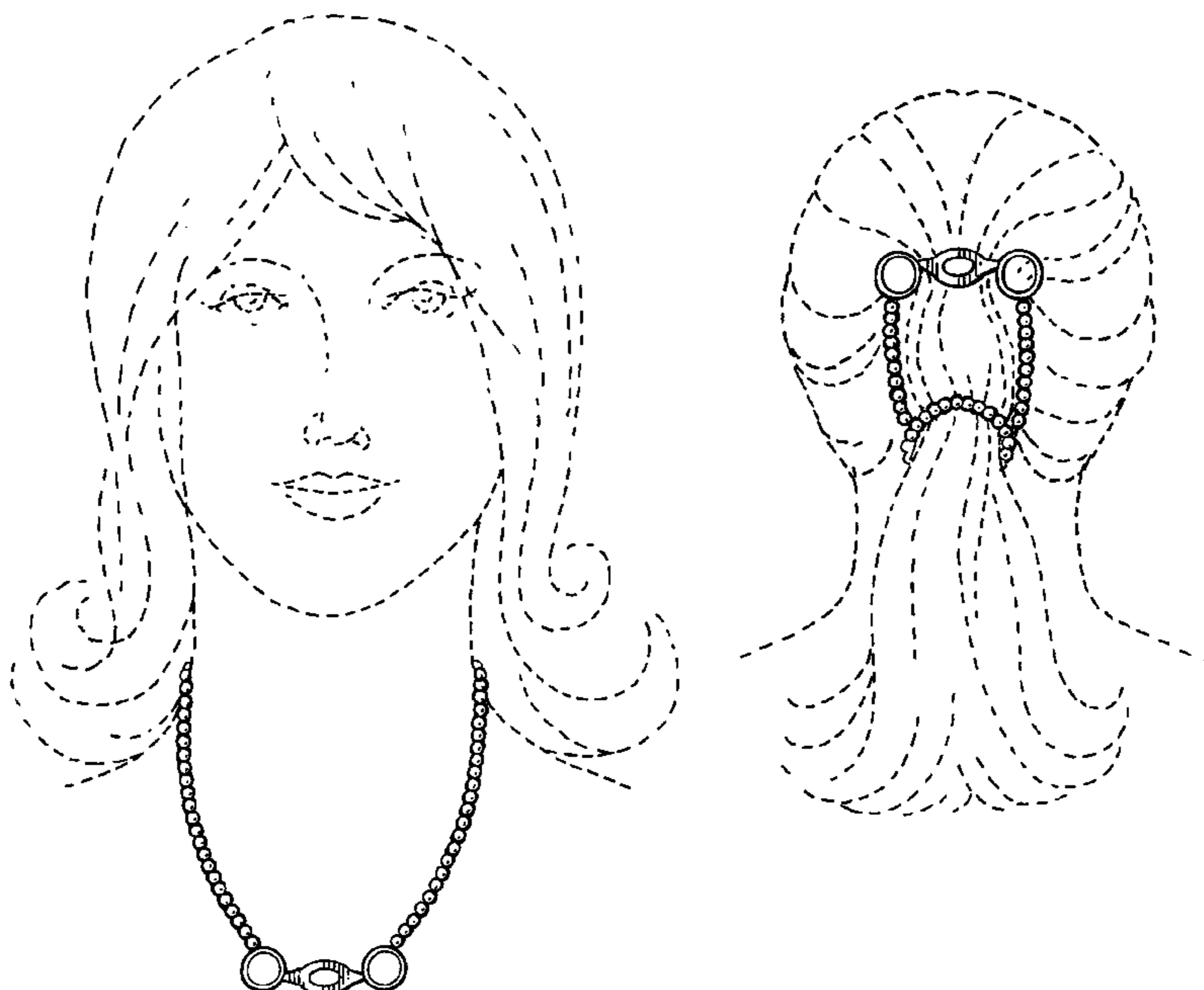
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hair or neck worn ornament, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear view showing my new design worn on a person's neck;
FIG. 2 is a rear view showing the design in an alternate configuration and worn in a person's hair;
FIG. 3 is a rear view showing the design in a further alternate configuration in a person's hair;
FIG. 4 is a front view showing the design in a non use configuration;
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a bottom view thereof; and,
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof.
The broken line showing of the human form is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

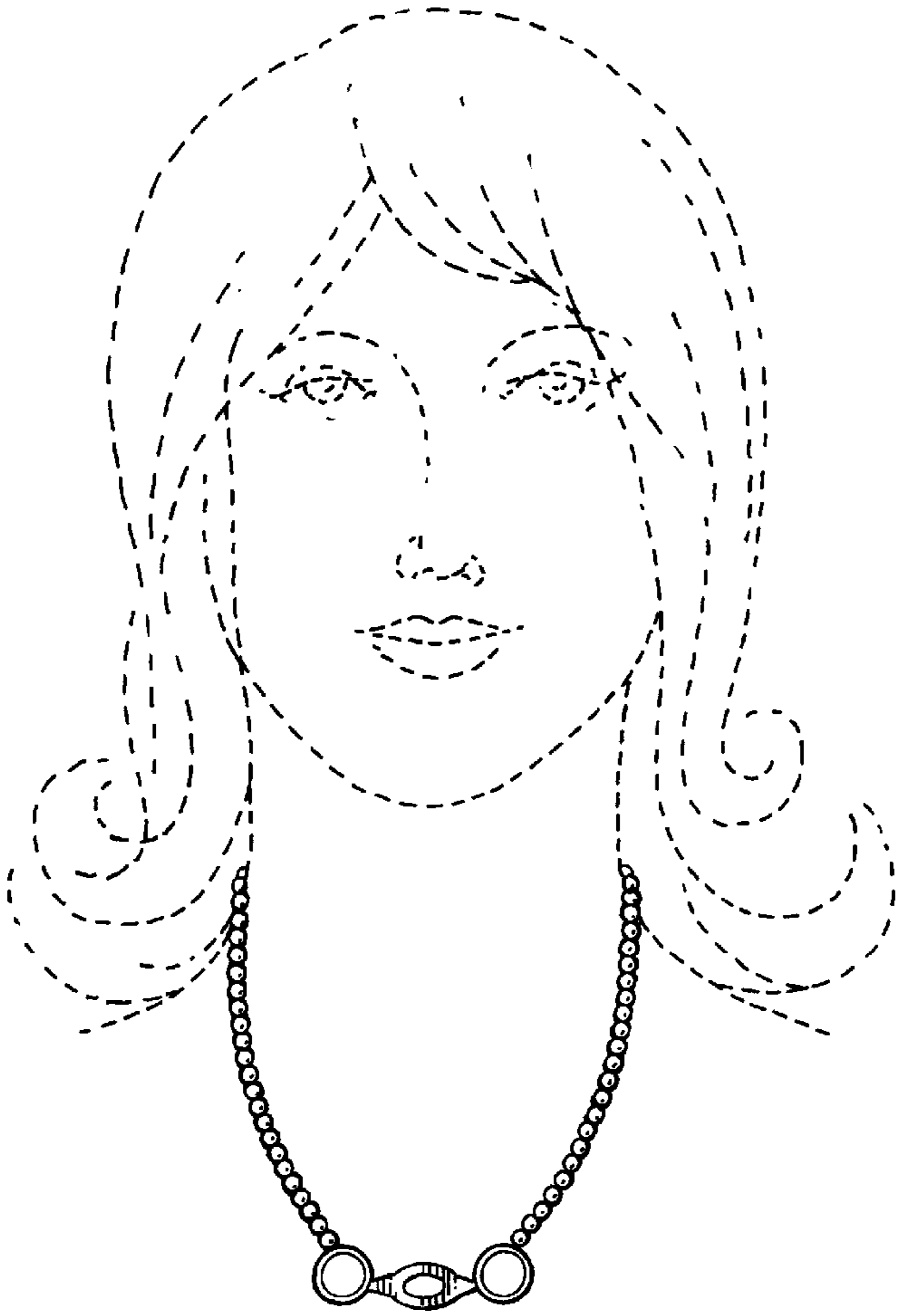

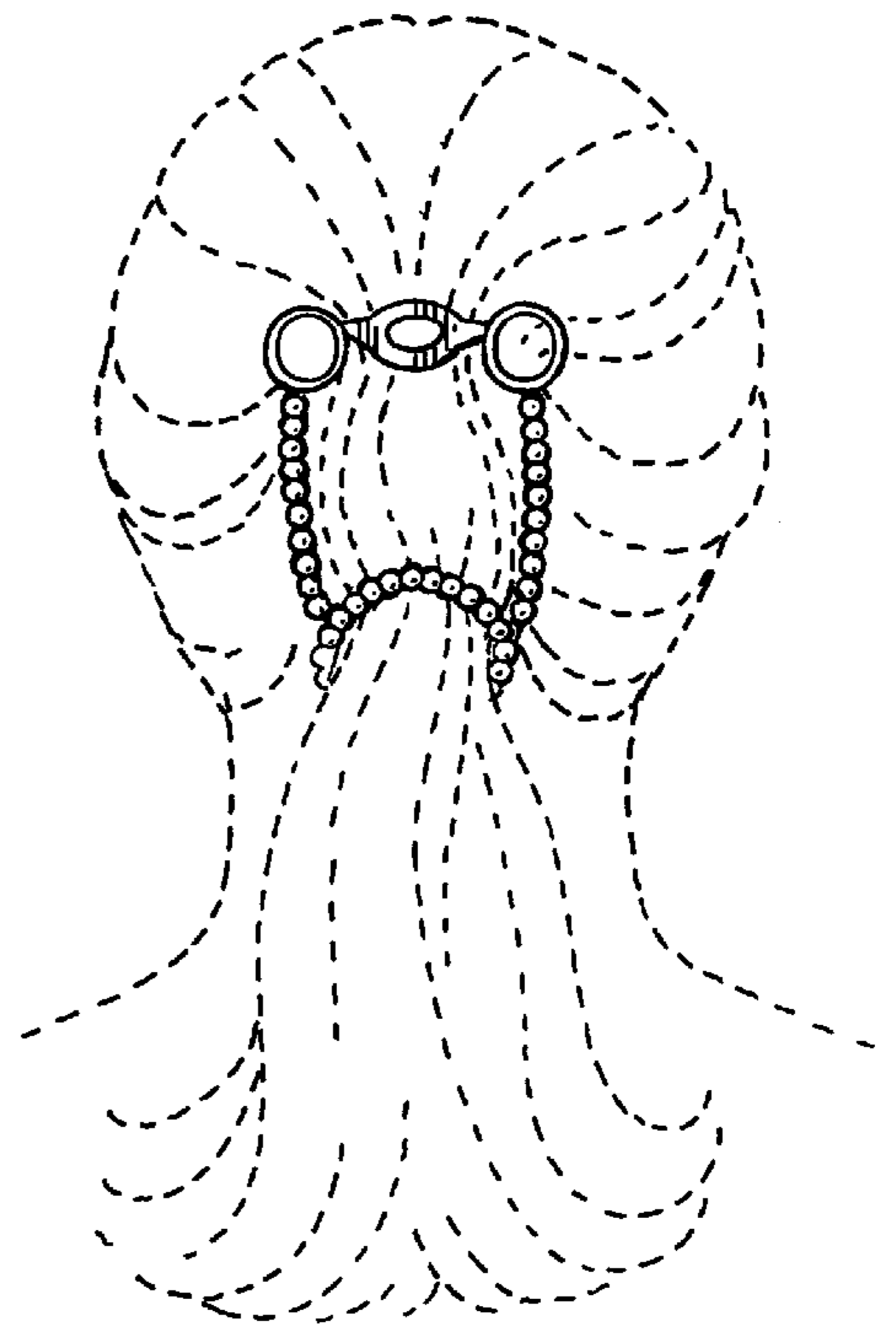

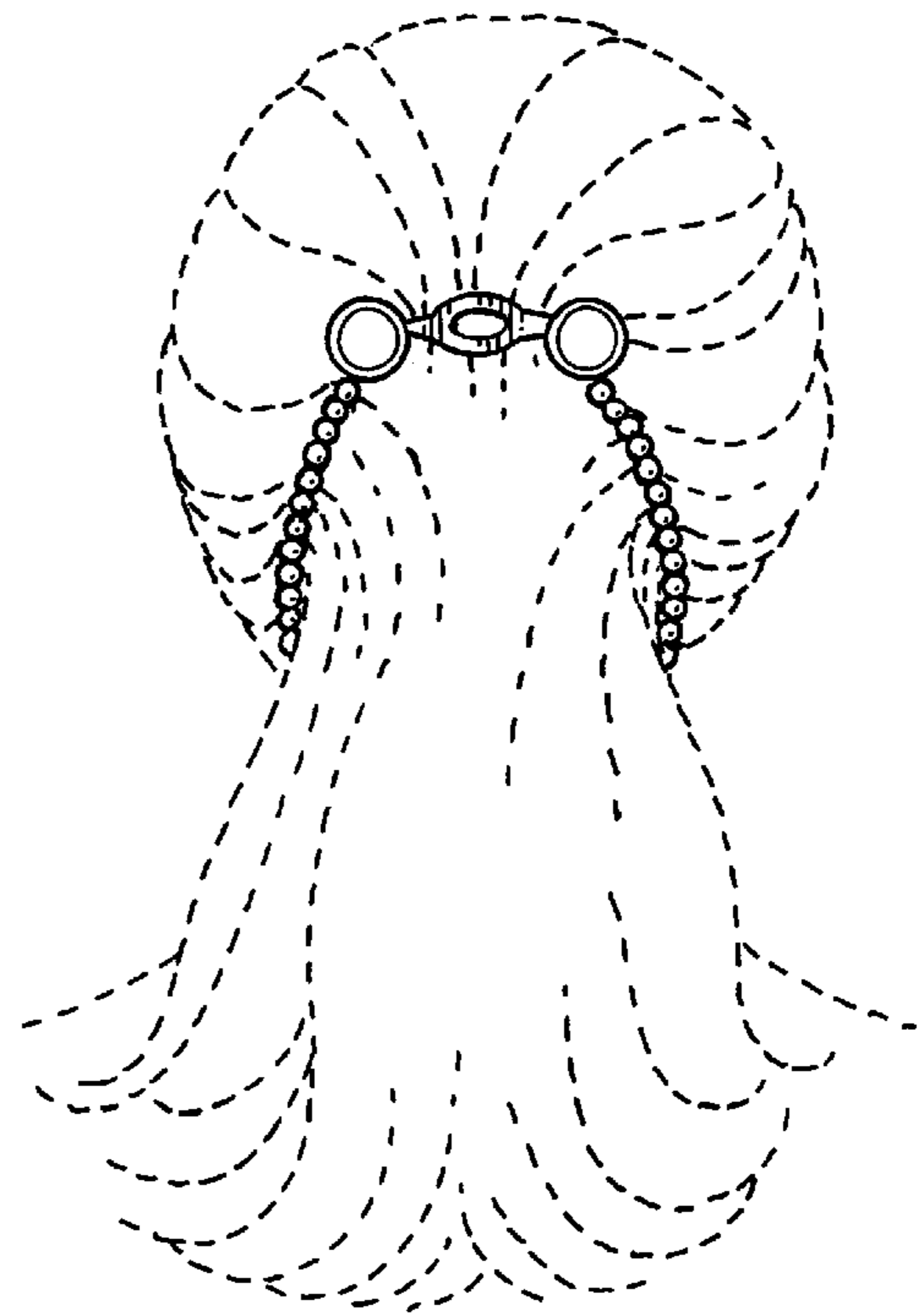
