FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

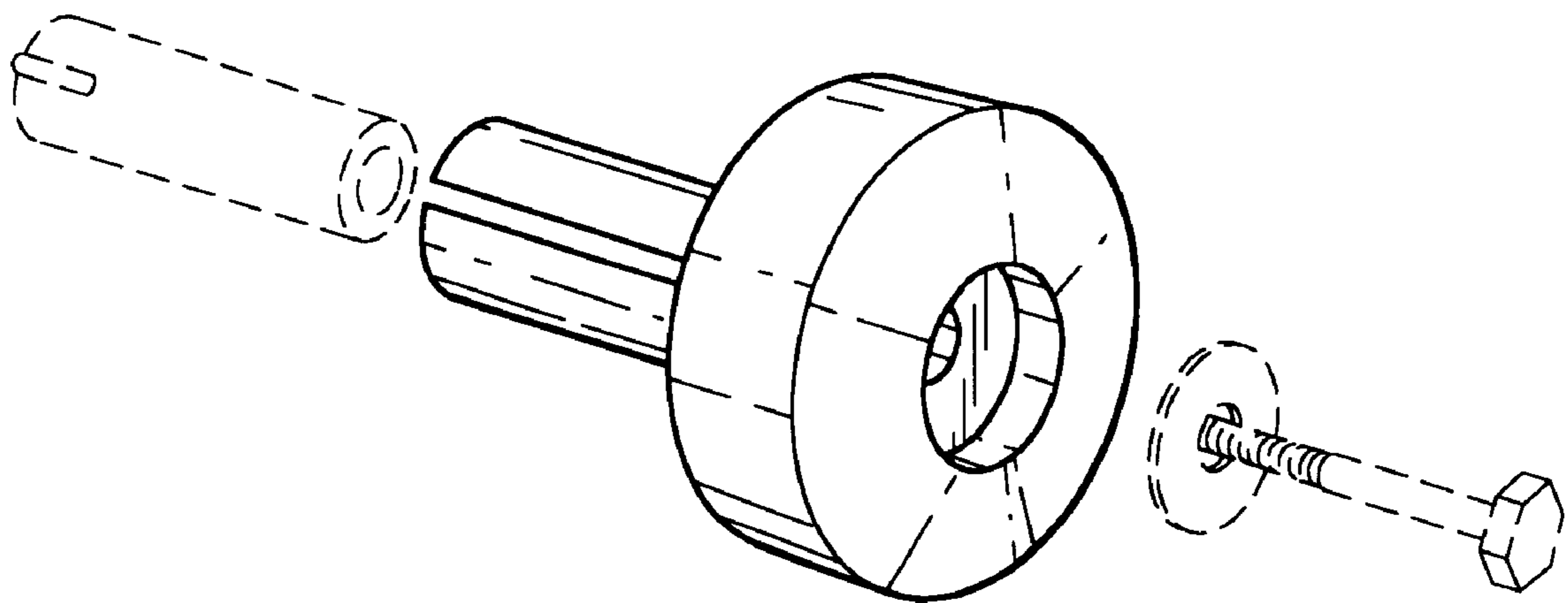
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side is a mirror image;

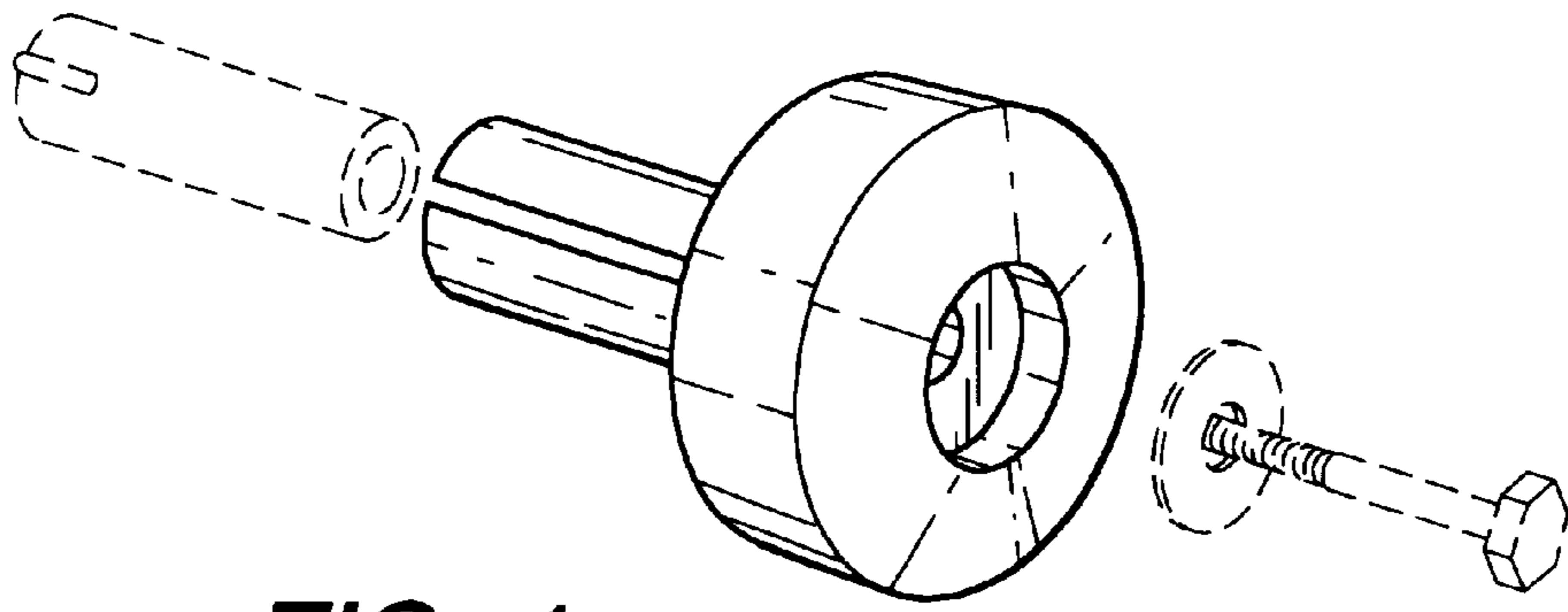

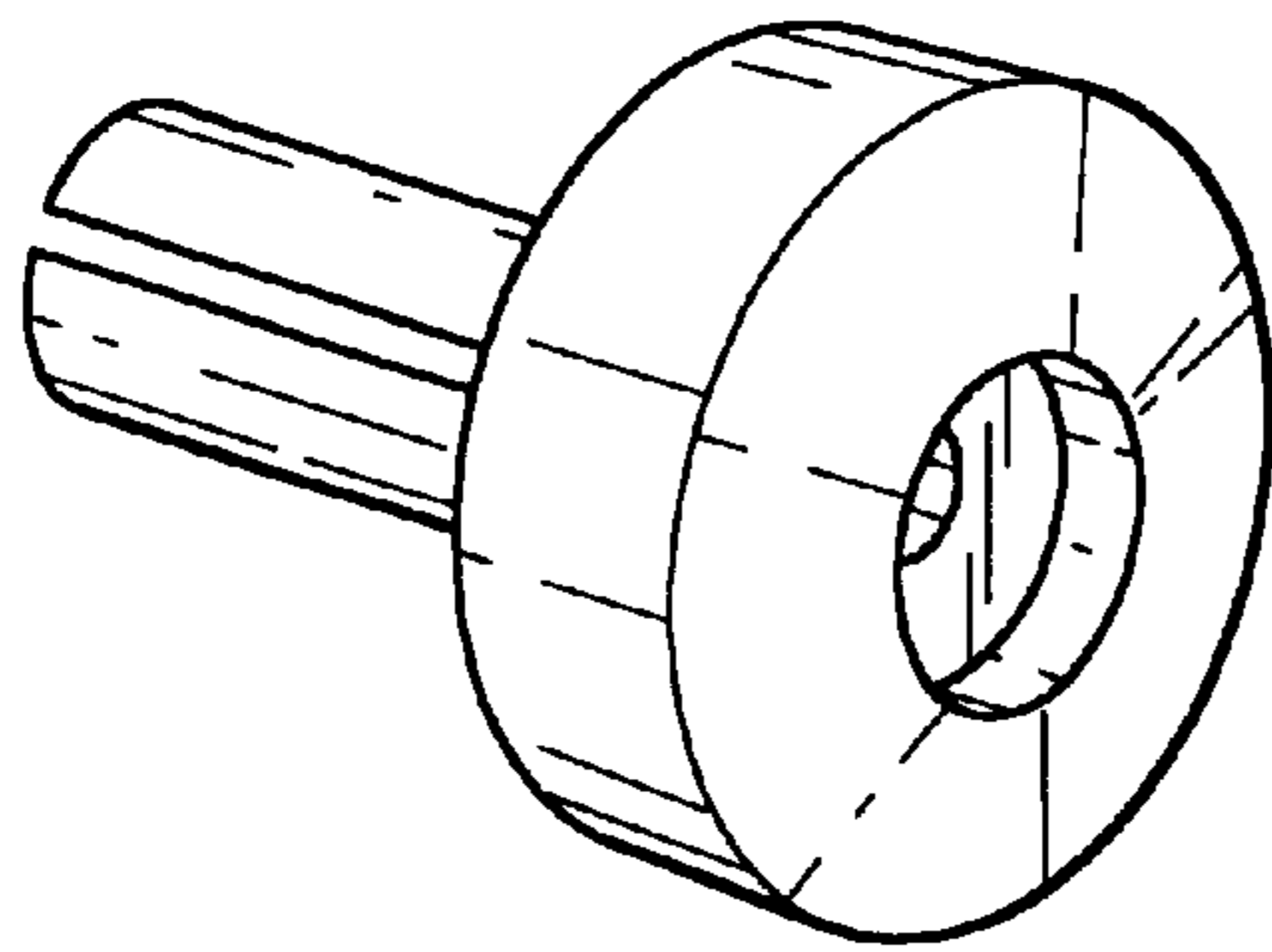

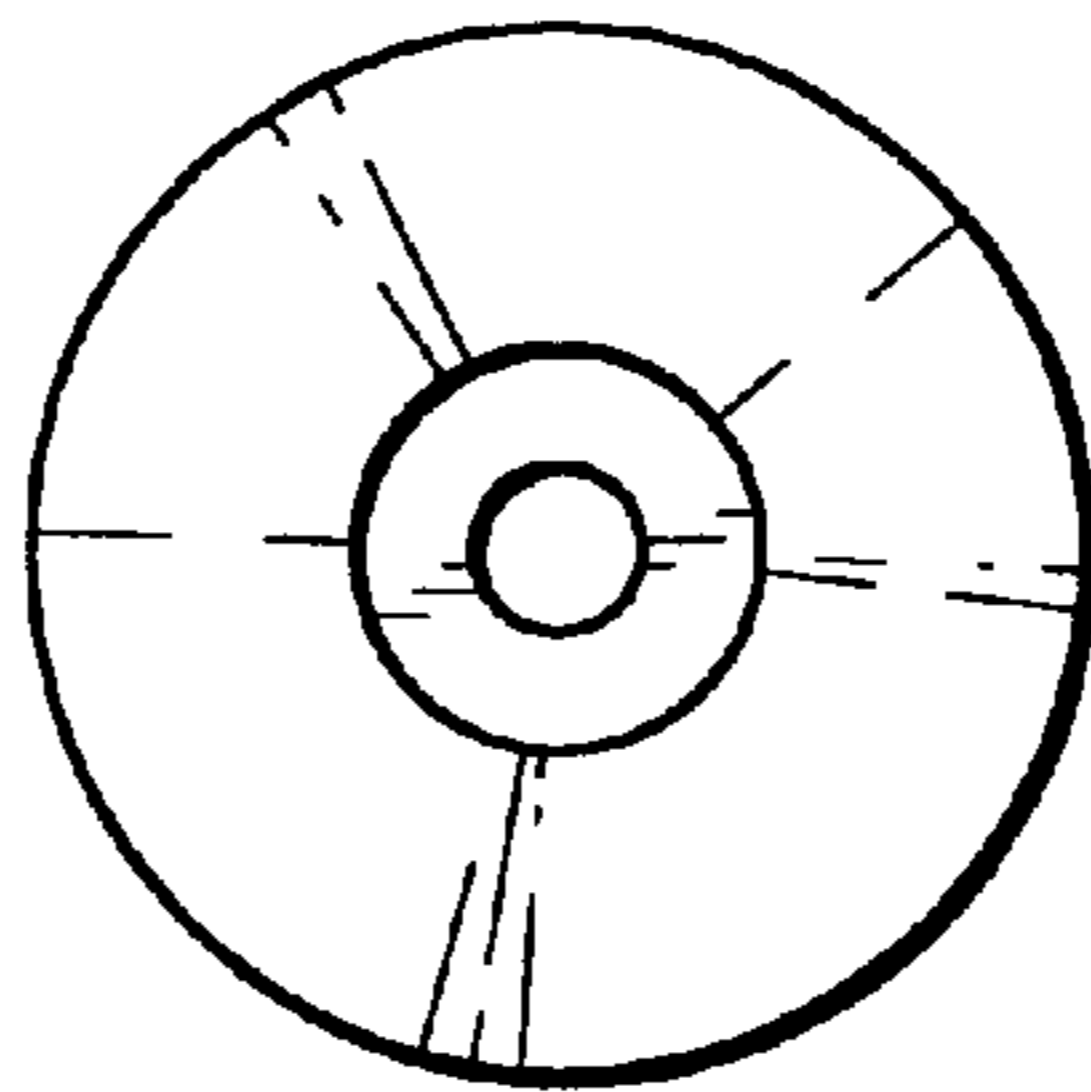

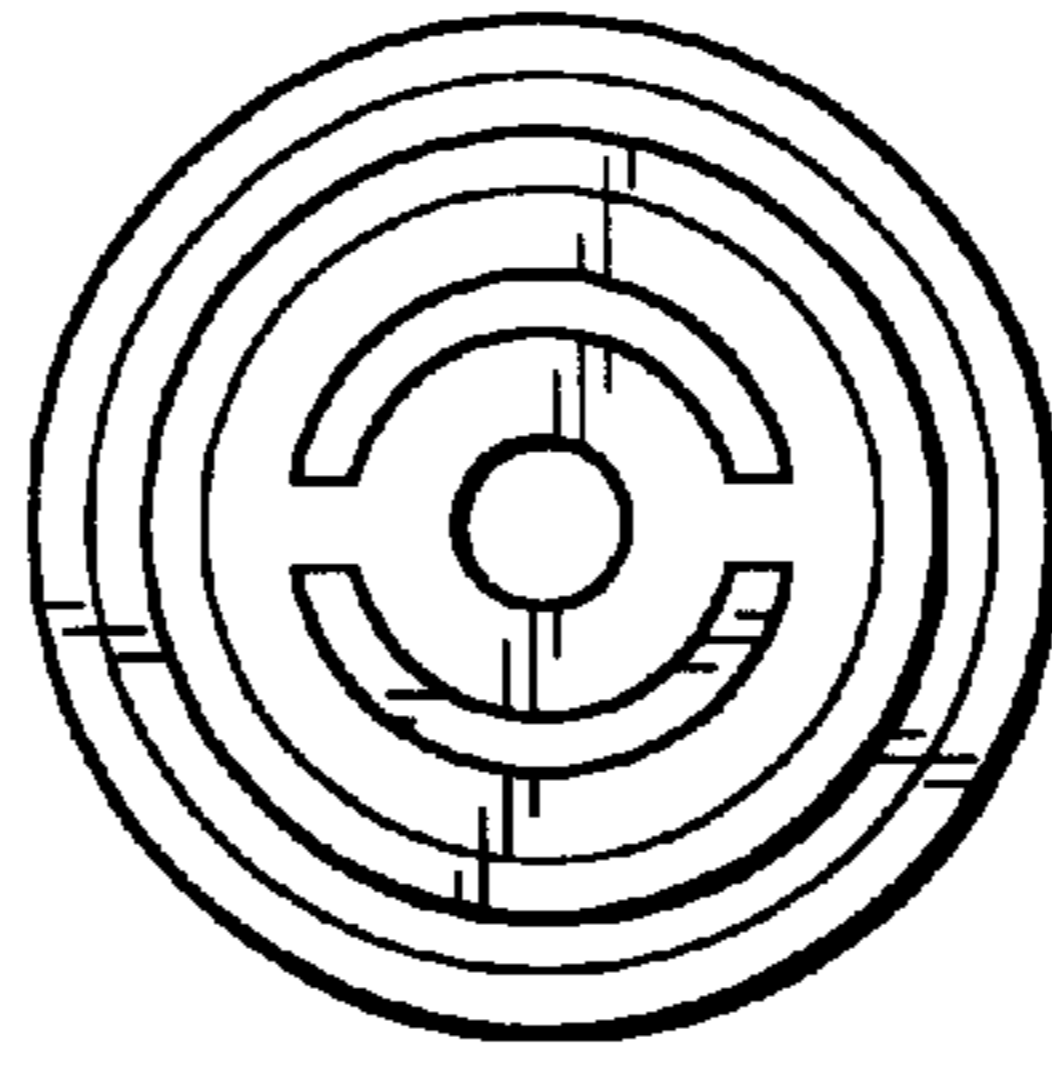

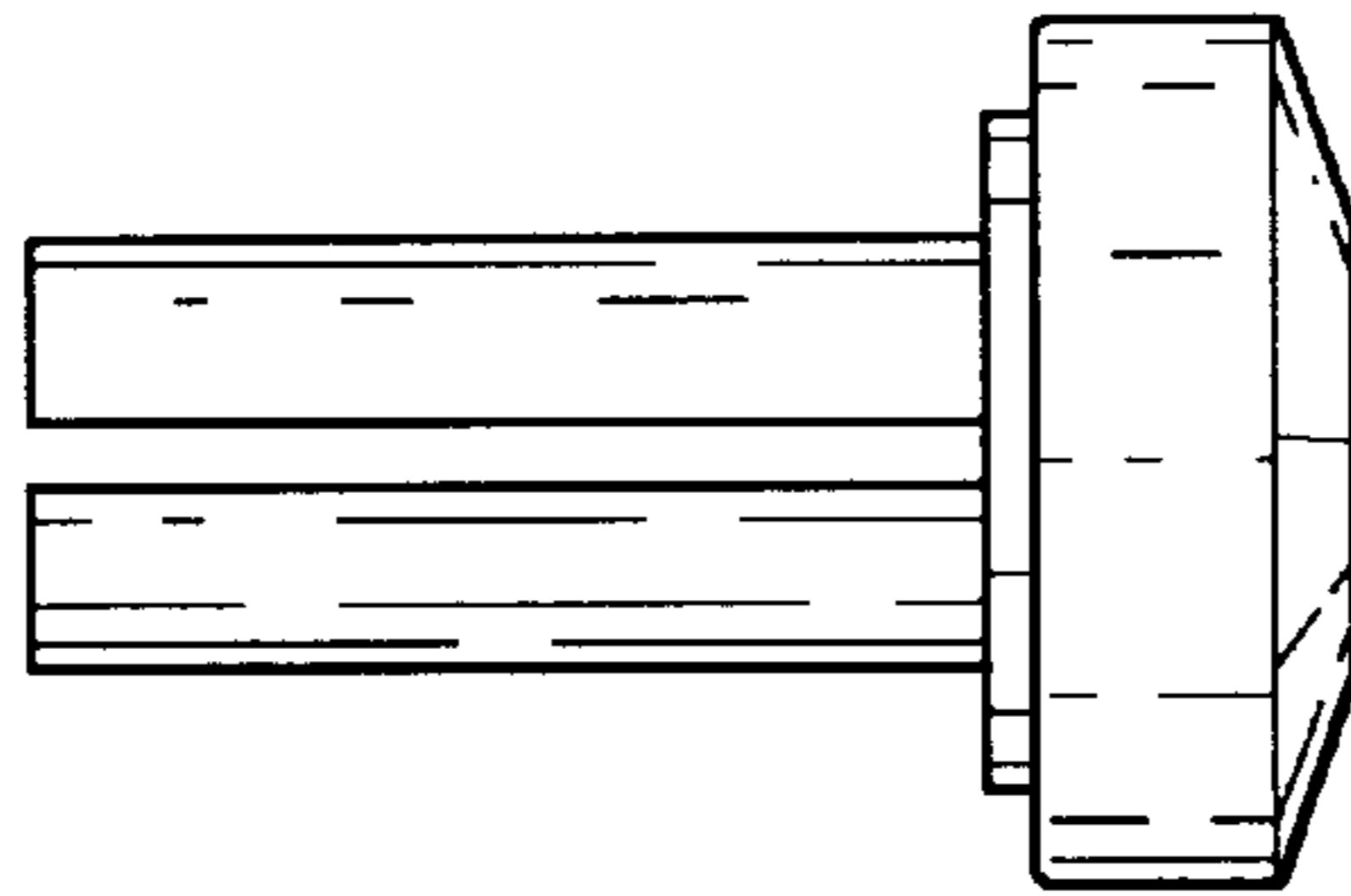

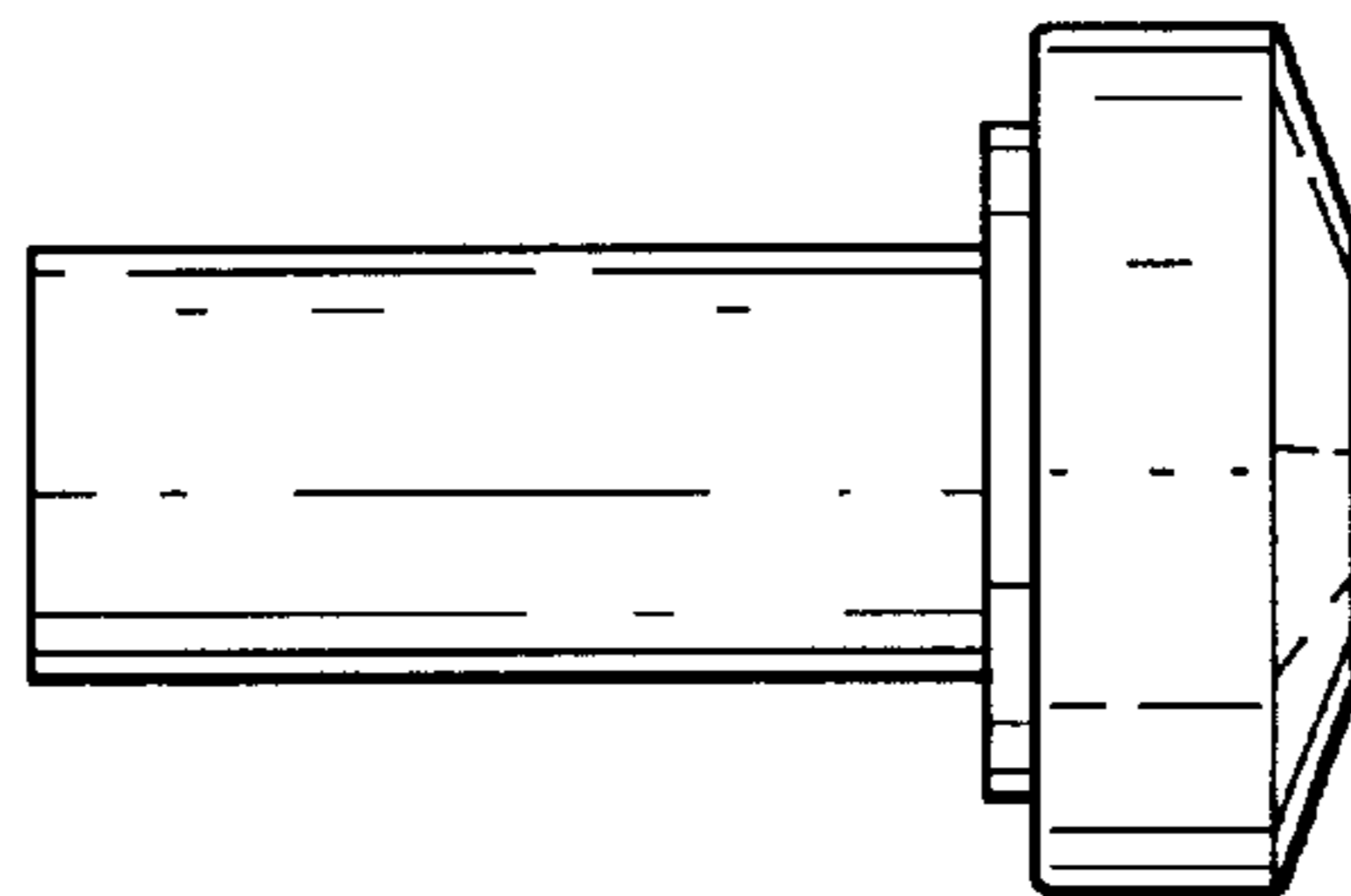

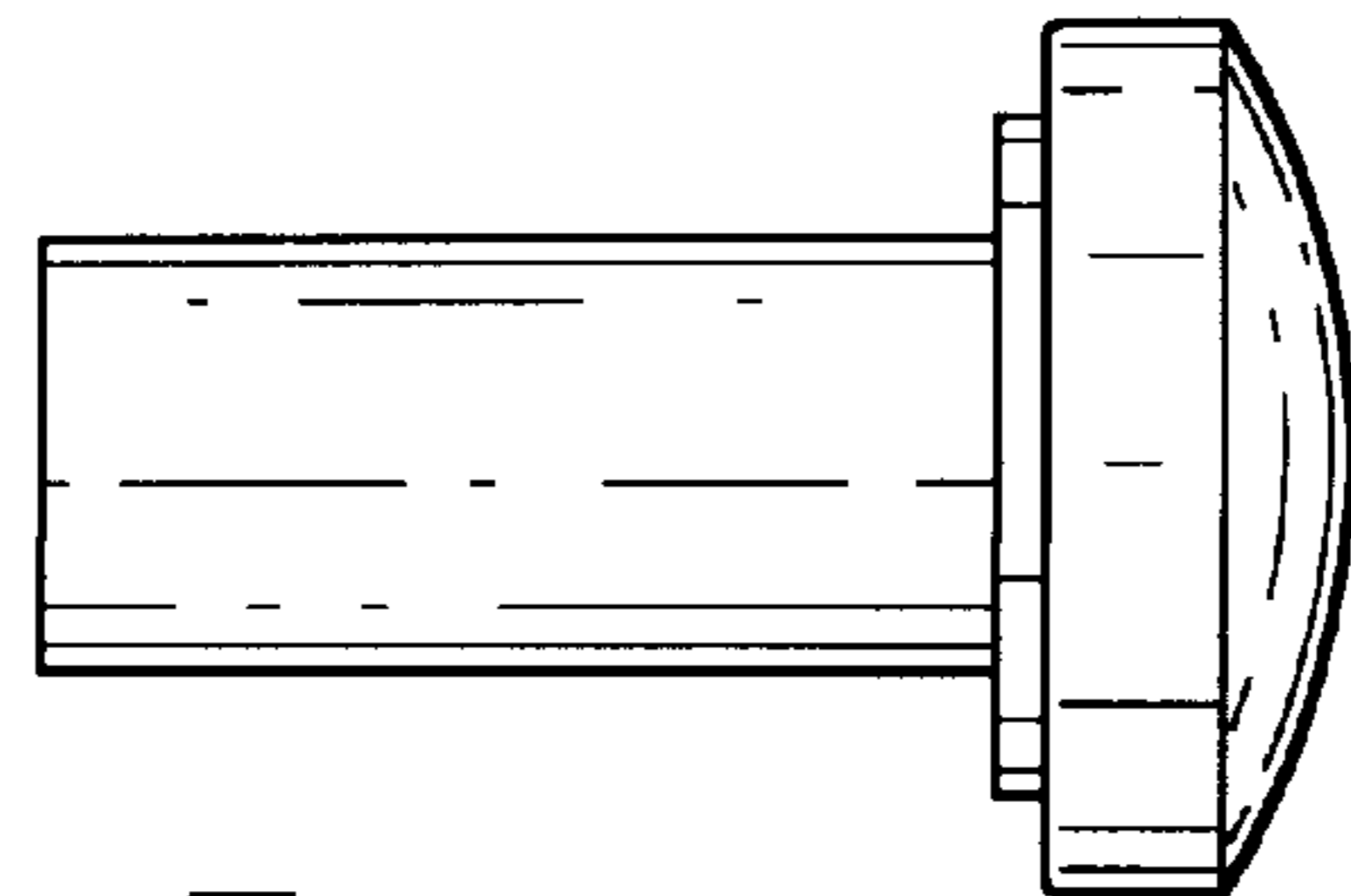
