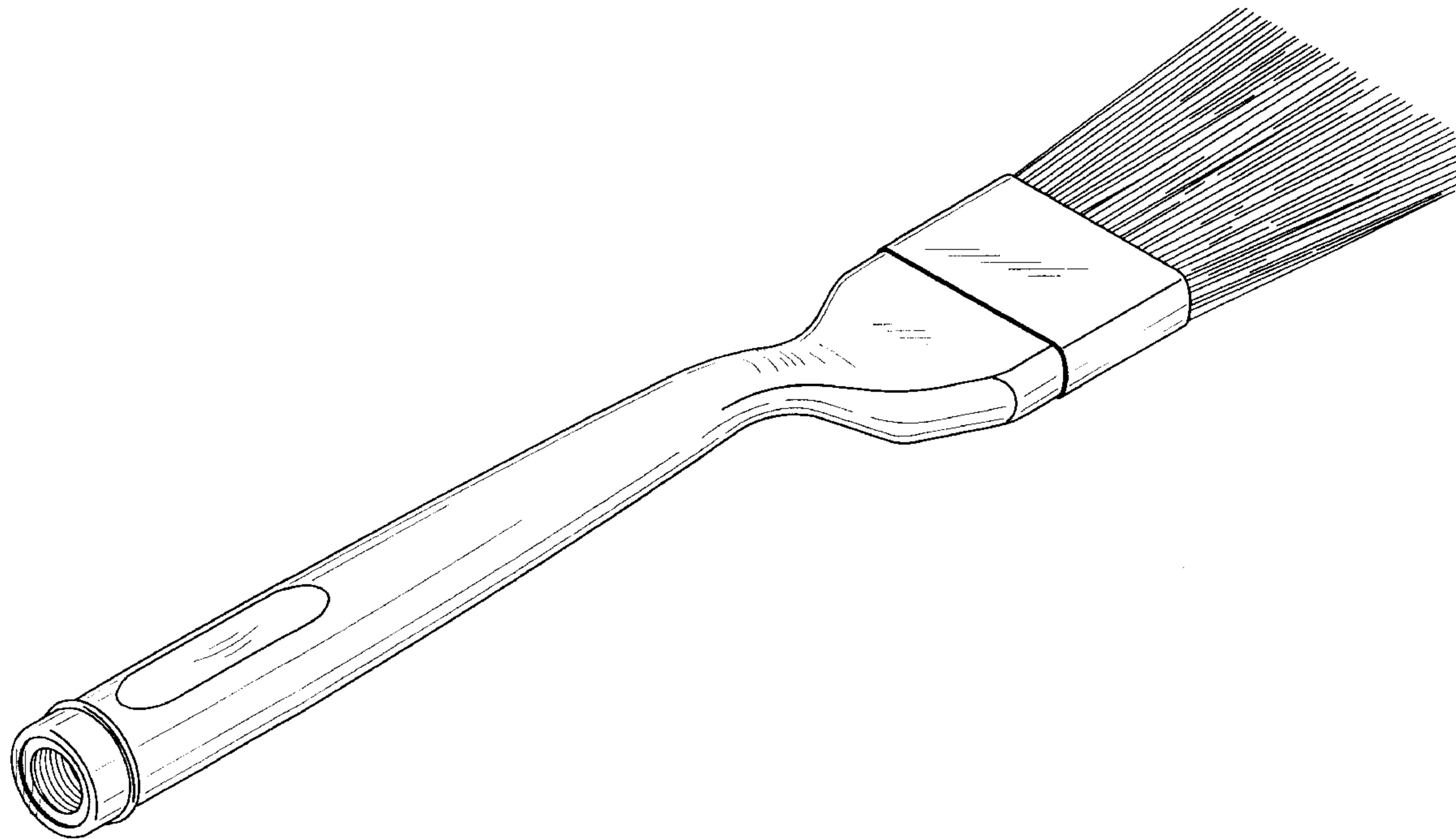
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a paint brush adapted for mounting on a pole, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a paint brush adapted for mounting on a pole showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side view, the right side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a front view; FIG. 4 is a rear view; FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom view.

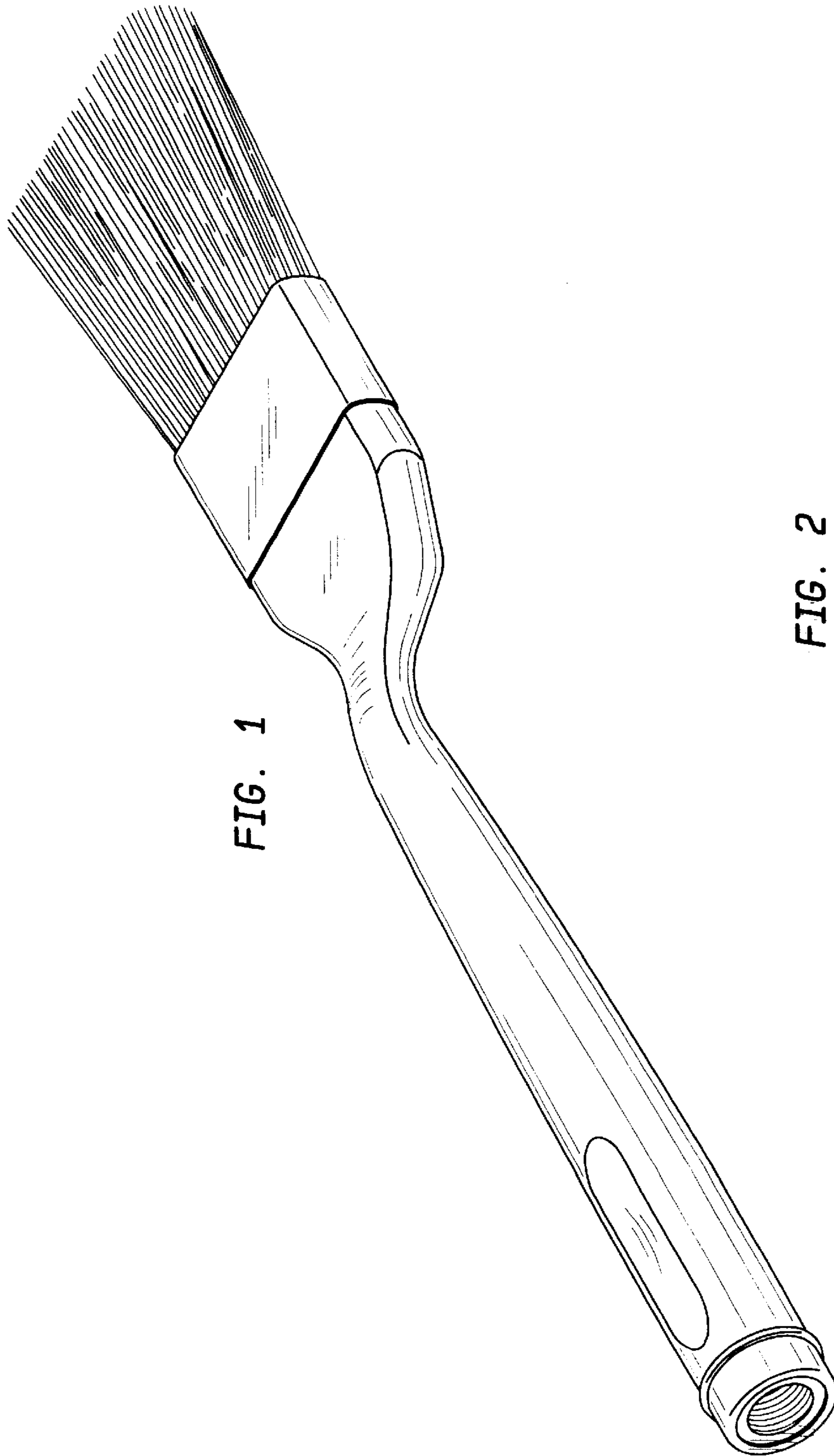

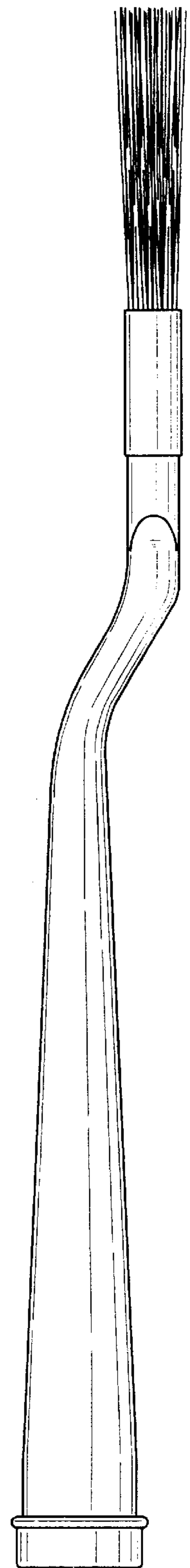

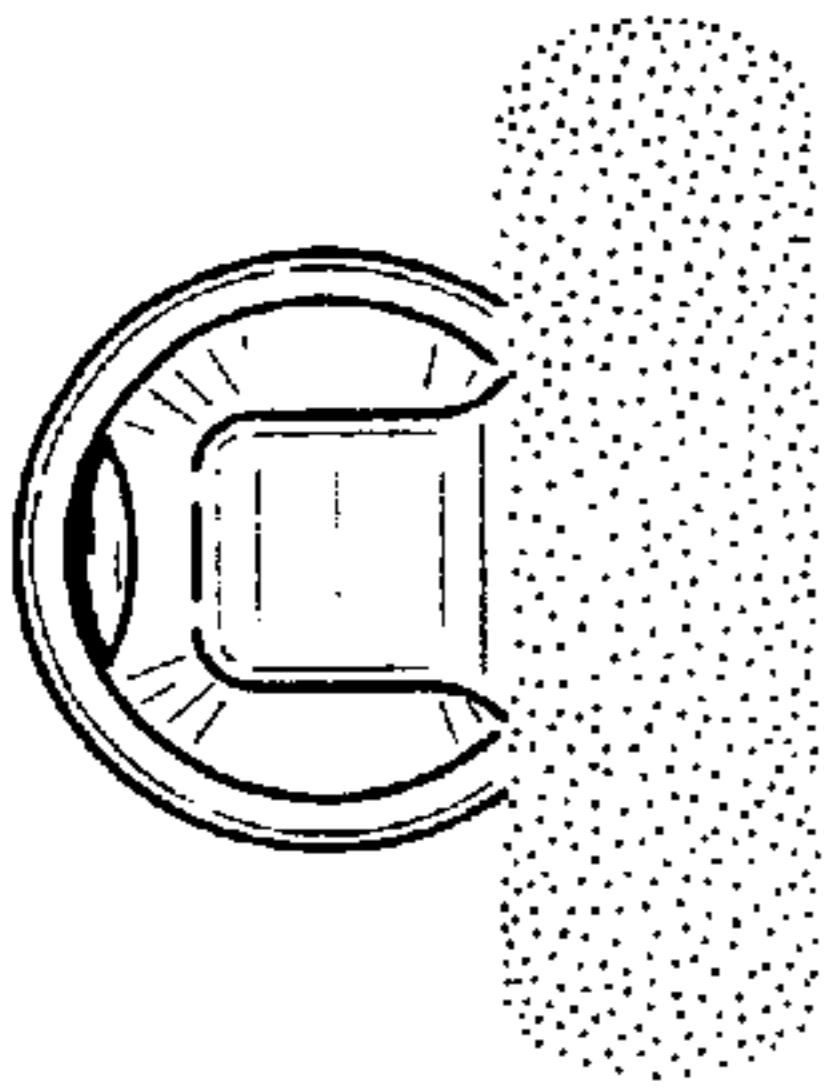

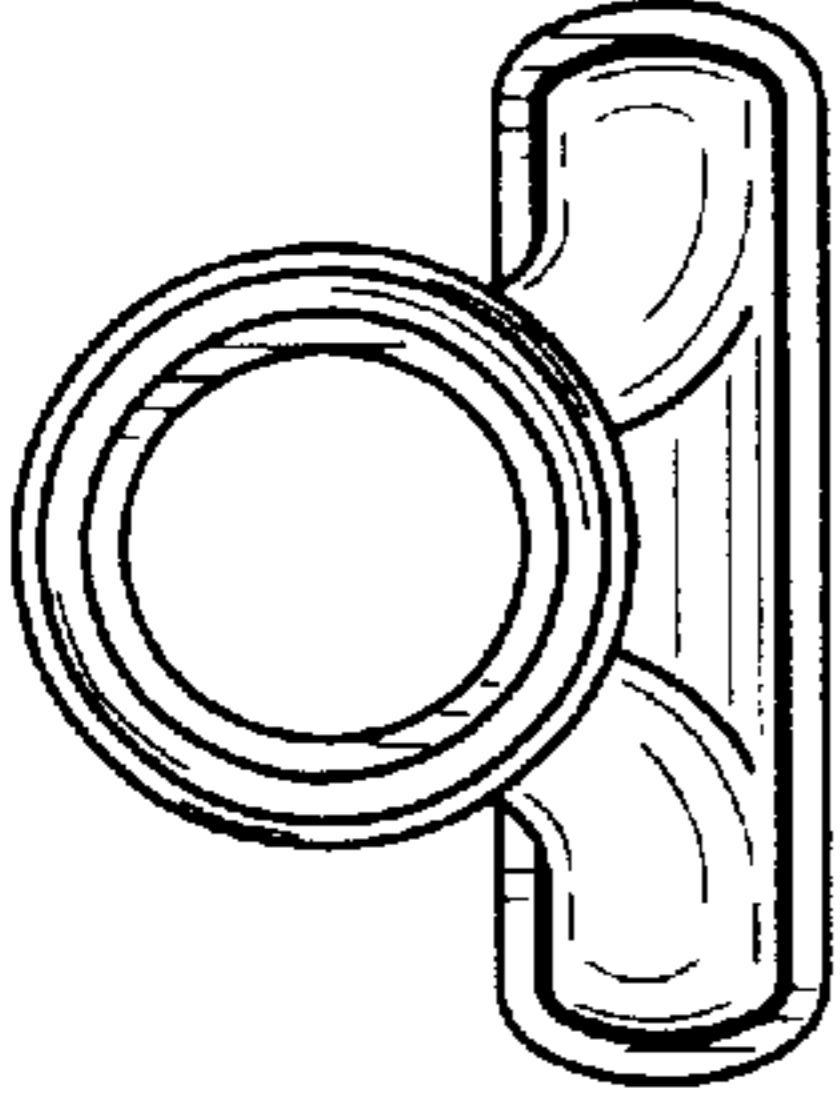

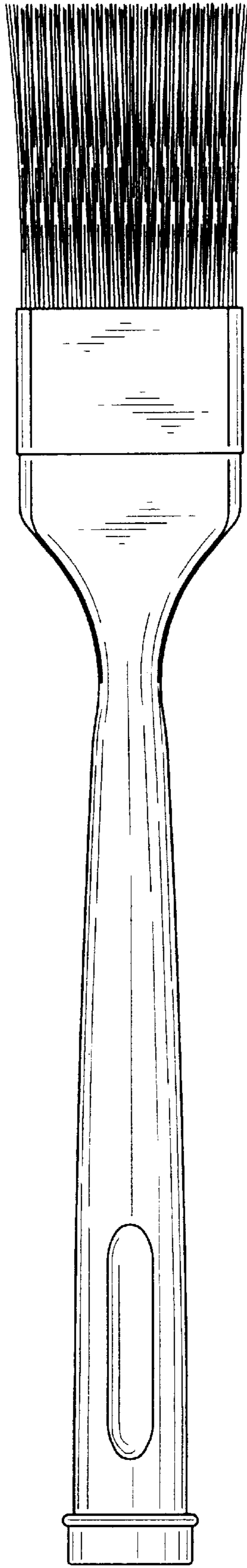
