## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a blade holder showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the opposite side;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

The stippled portions reflect a difference in texture and/or color from the remainder of the design.












