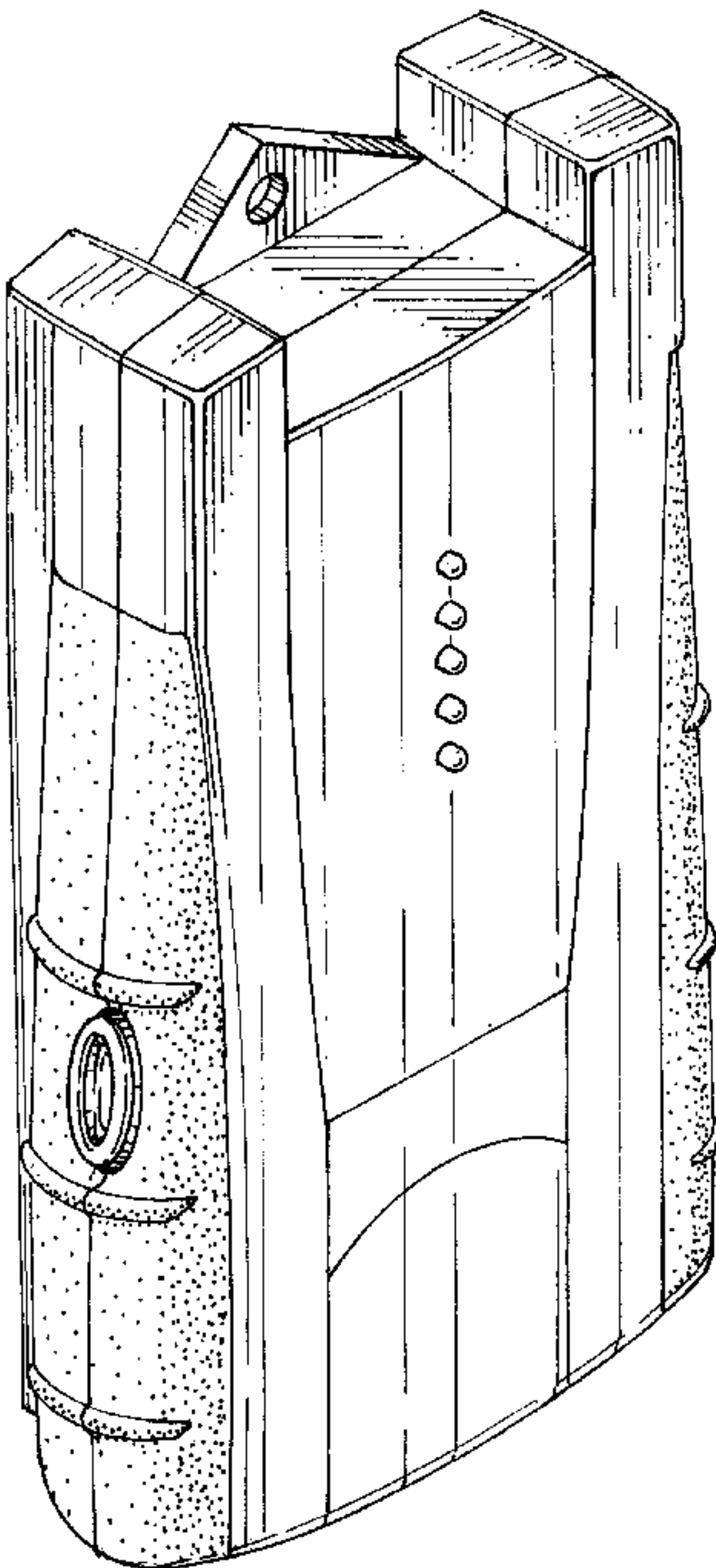
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a stud finder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stud finder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the right side as seen in FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the left hand side as seen in FIG. 2;
FIG. 7 is a top elevational view thereof;
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of another embodiment of stud finder showing my design;
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;
FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of the right hand side as seen in FIG. 9;
FIG. 11 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 13 is a side elevational view of the left hand side as seen in FIG. 8;
FIG. 14 is a top elevational view thereof;
FIG. 15 is a perspective view of yet another embodiment of the design of my stud finder;
FIG. 16 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 17 is a side elevational view thereof of the right hand side as seen in FIG. 15;
FIG. 18 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 19 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 20 is a side elevational view of the left hand side as seen in FIG. 15; and,
FIG. 21 is a top plan view thereof.

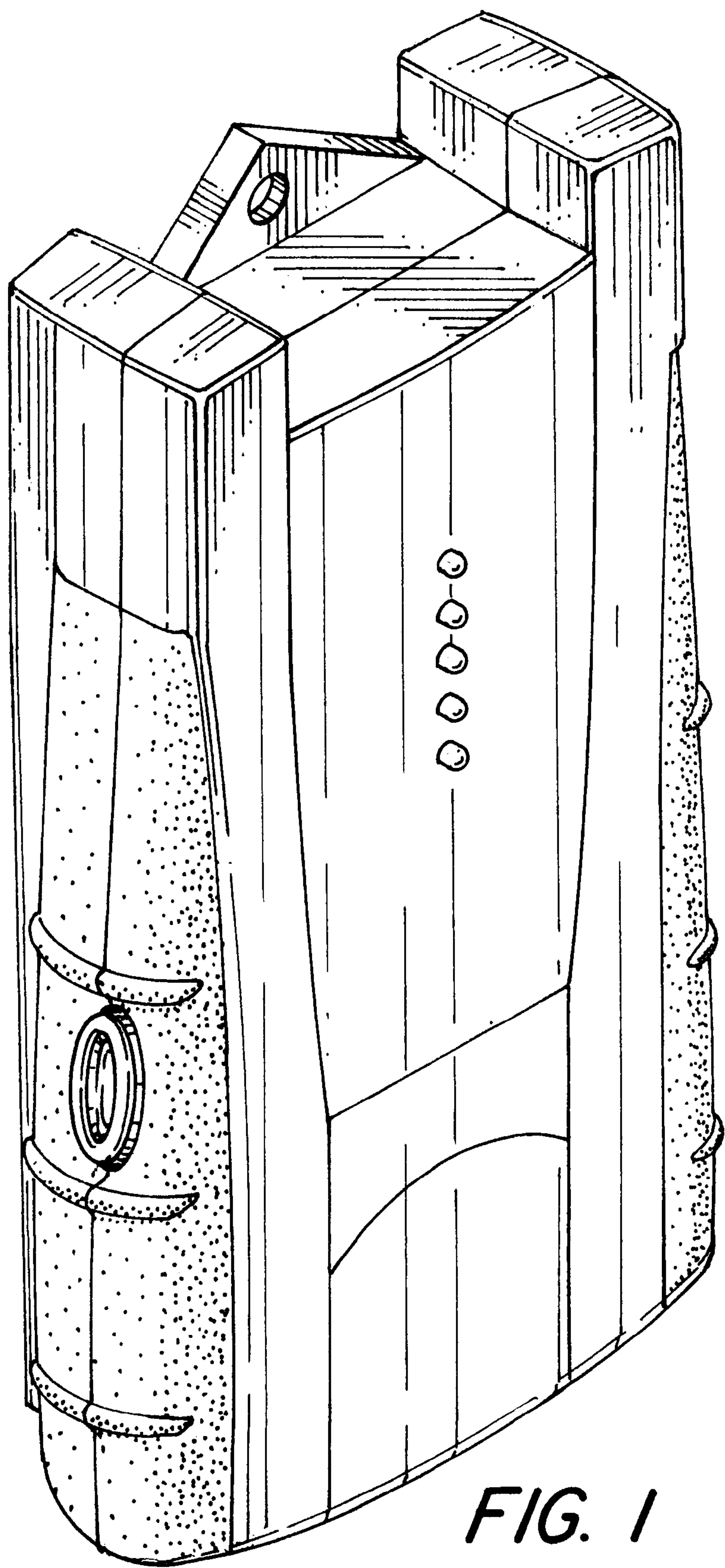

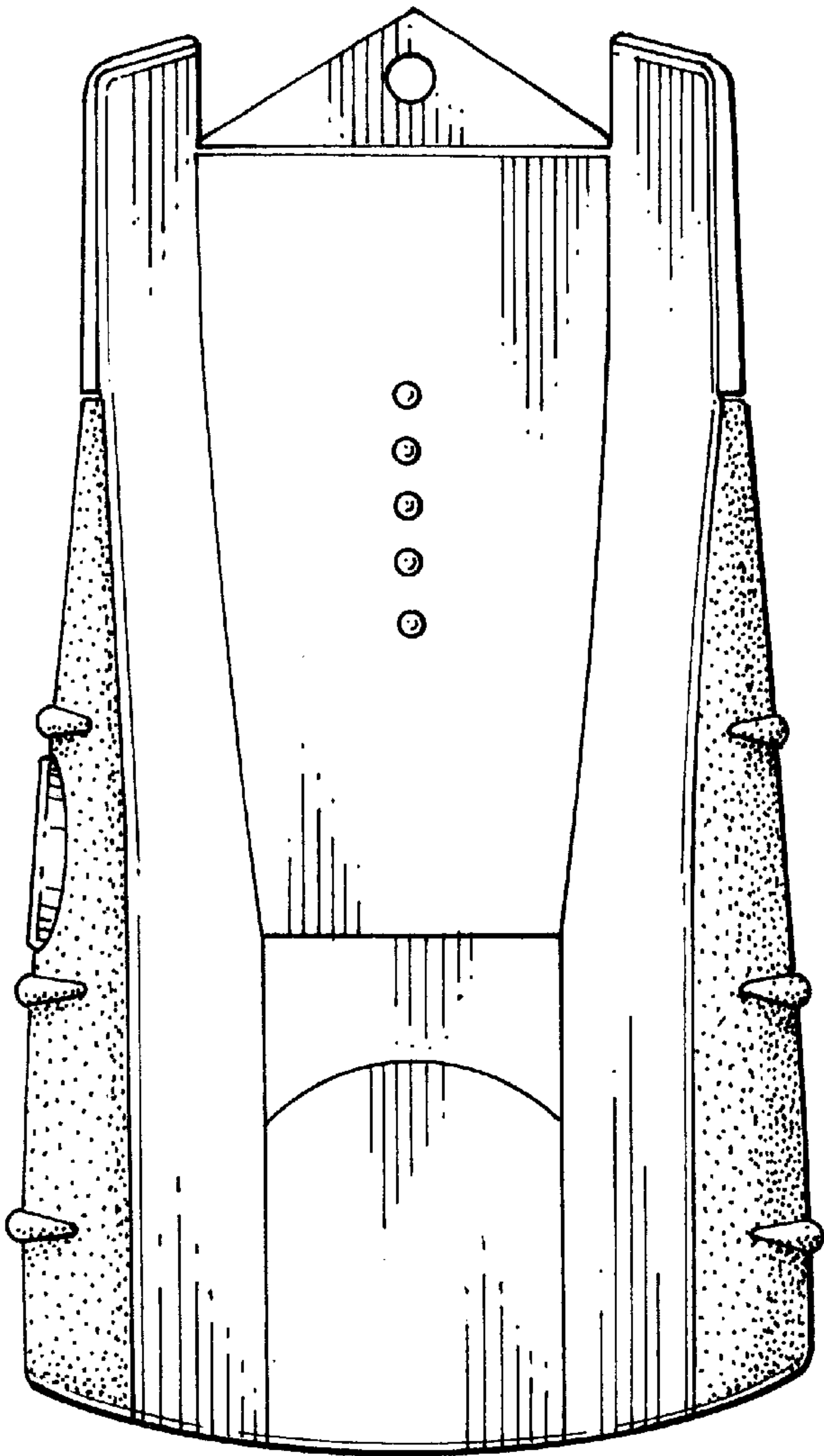

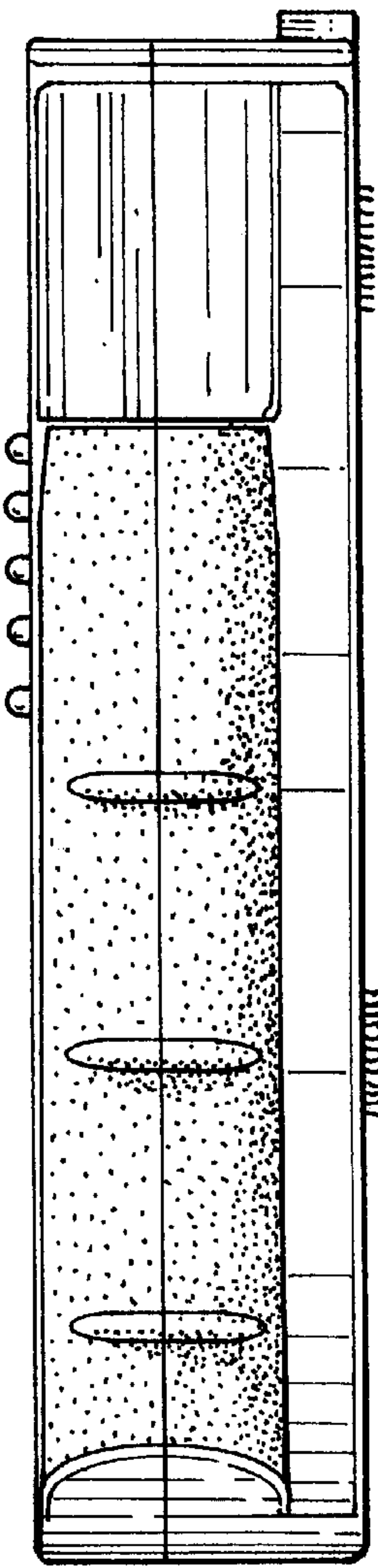

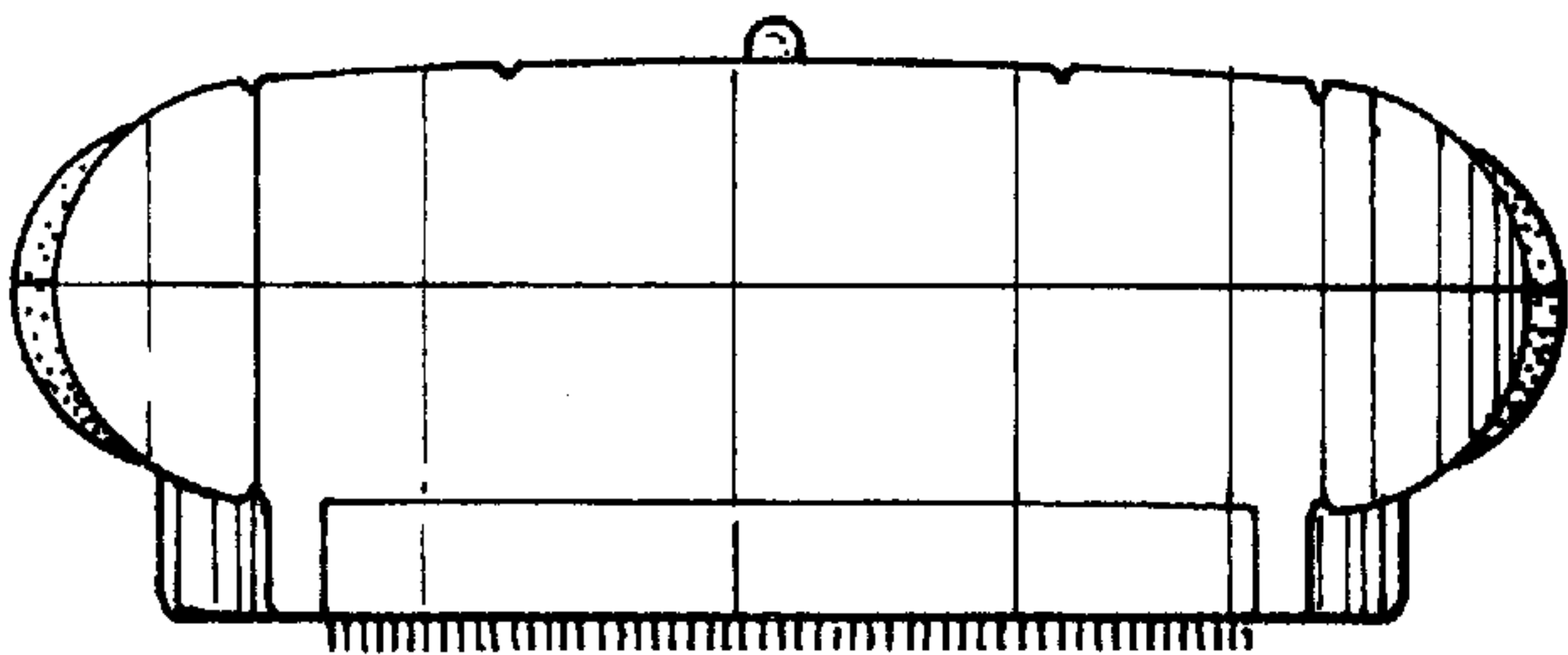

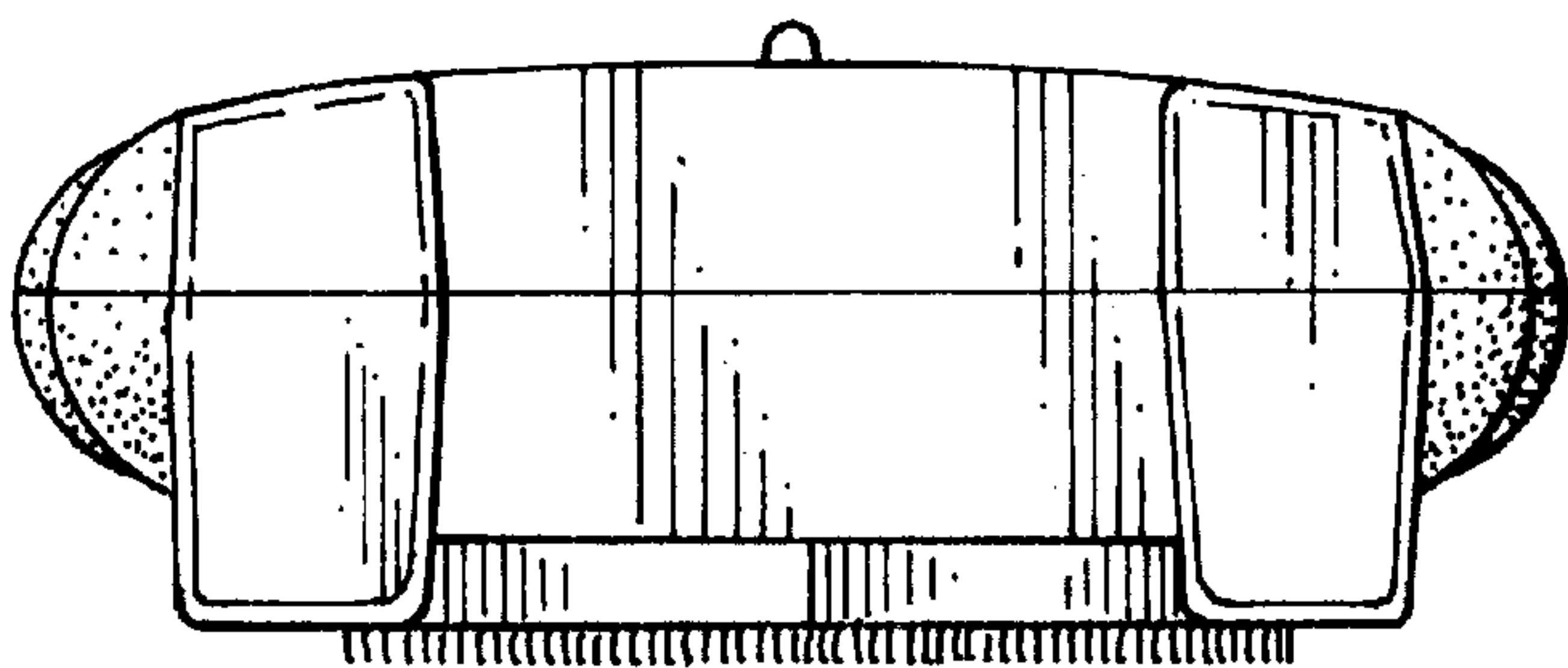

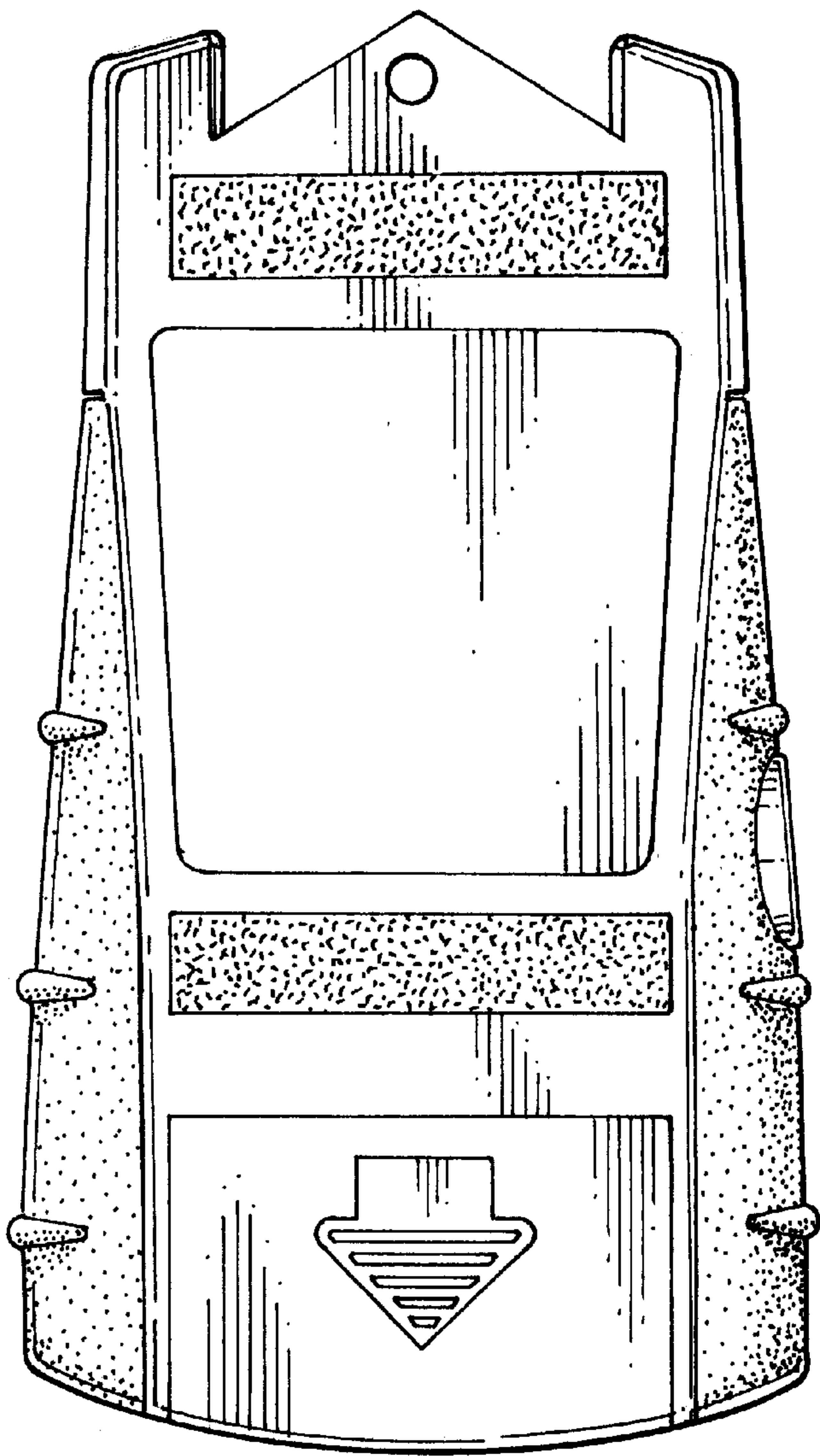

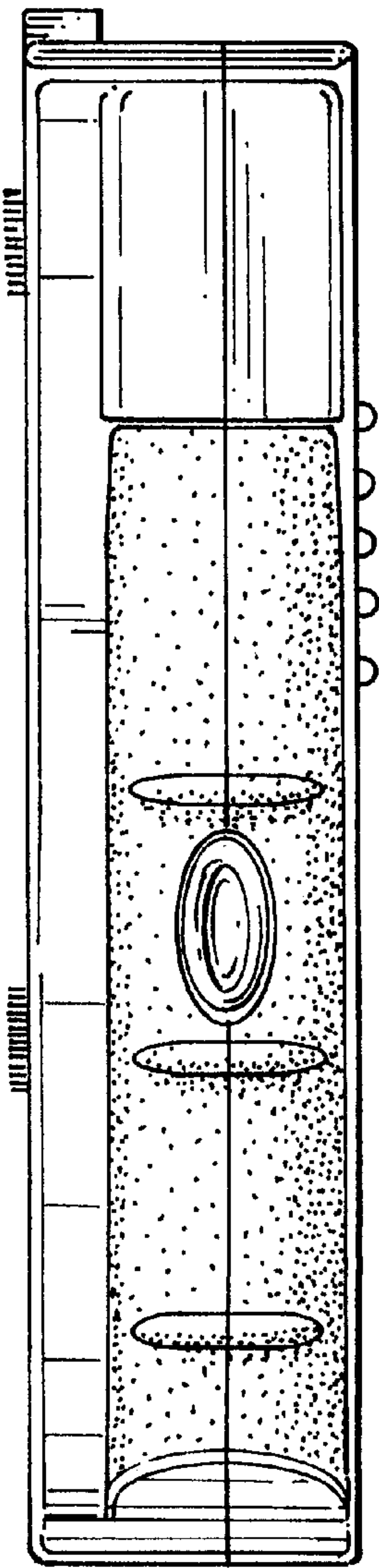

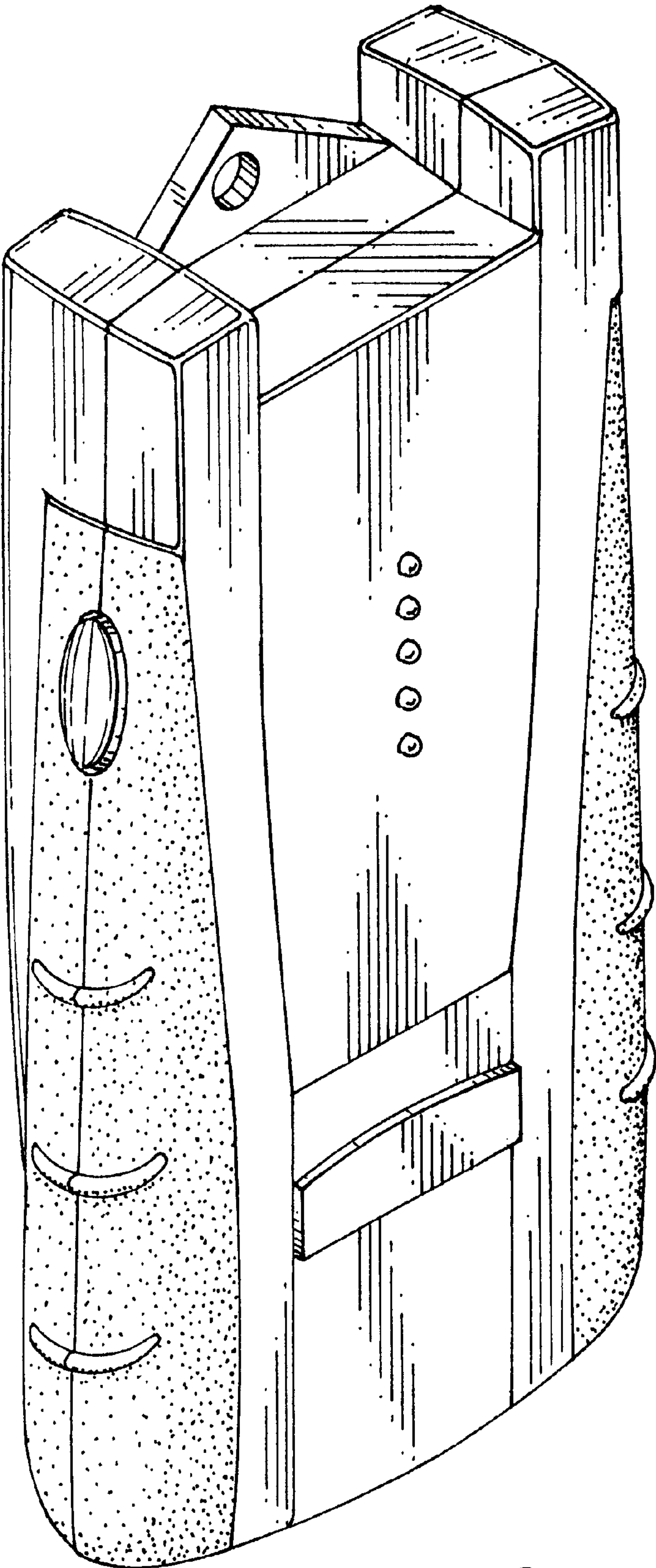

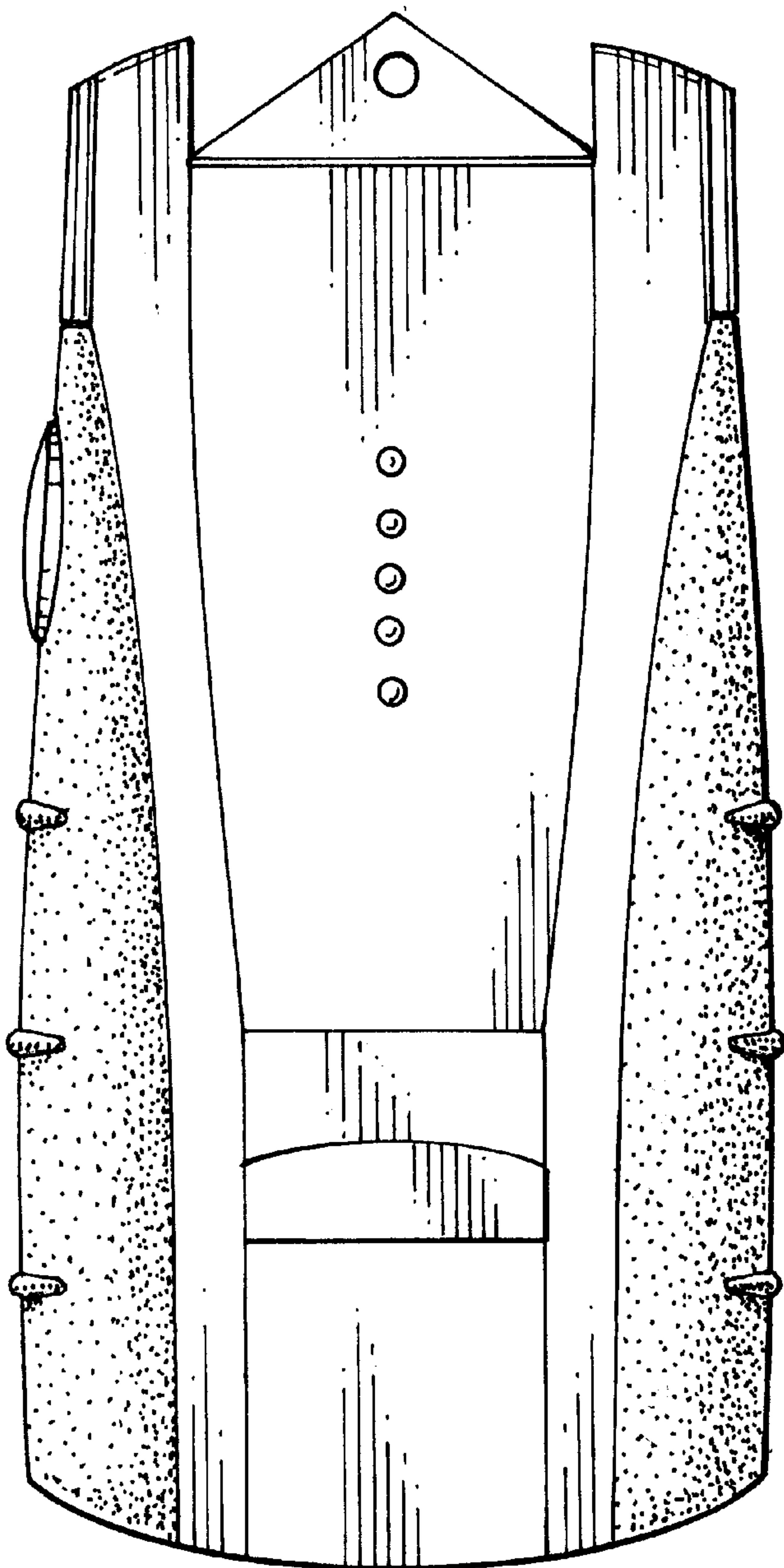

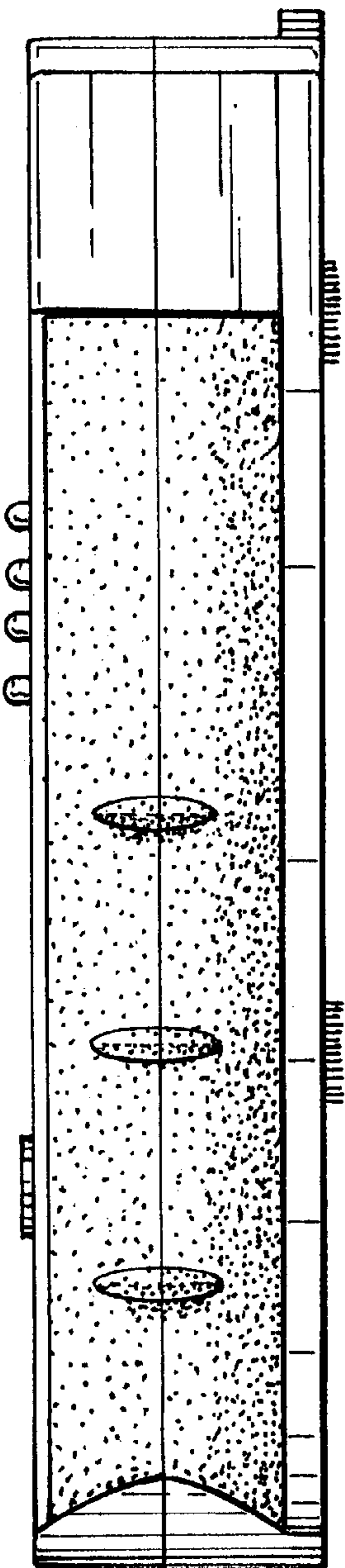

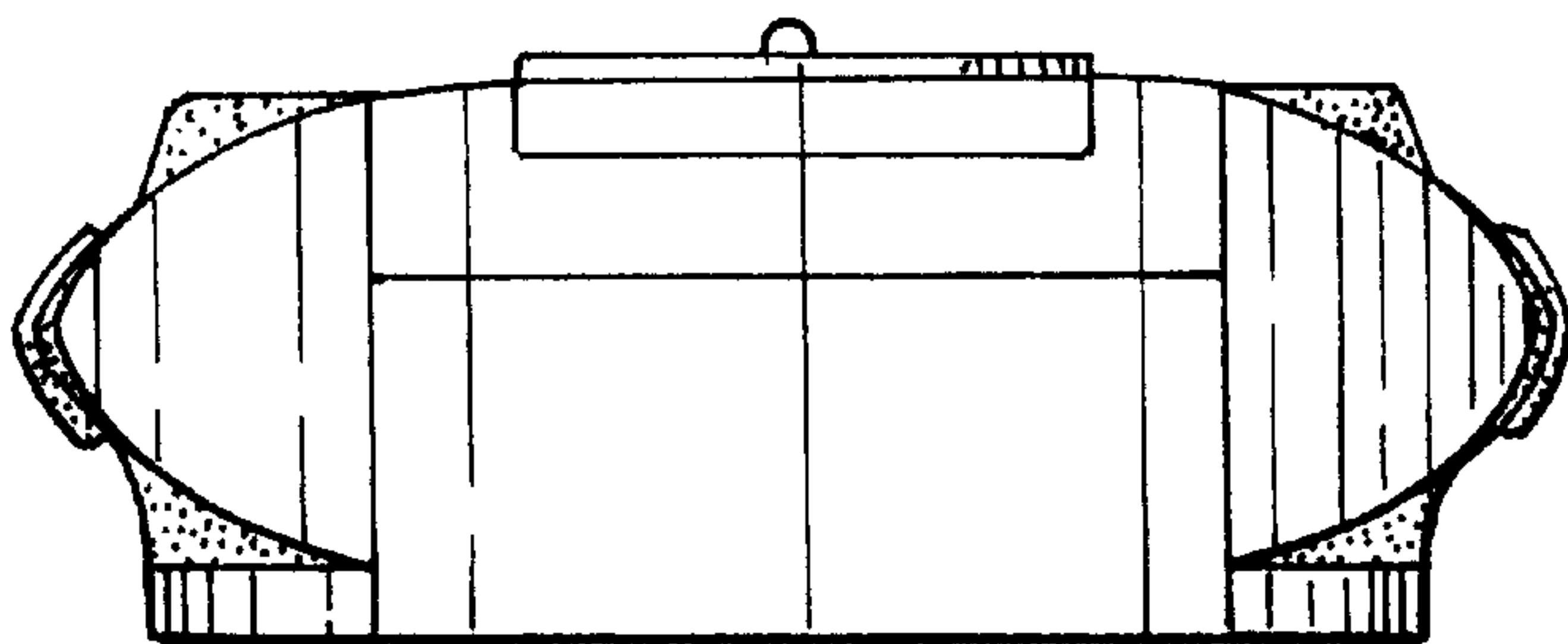

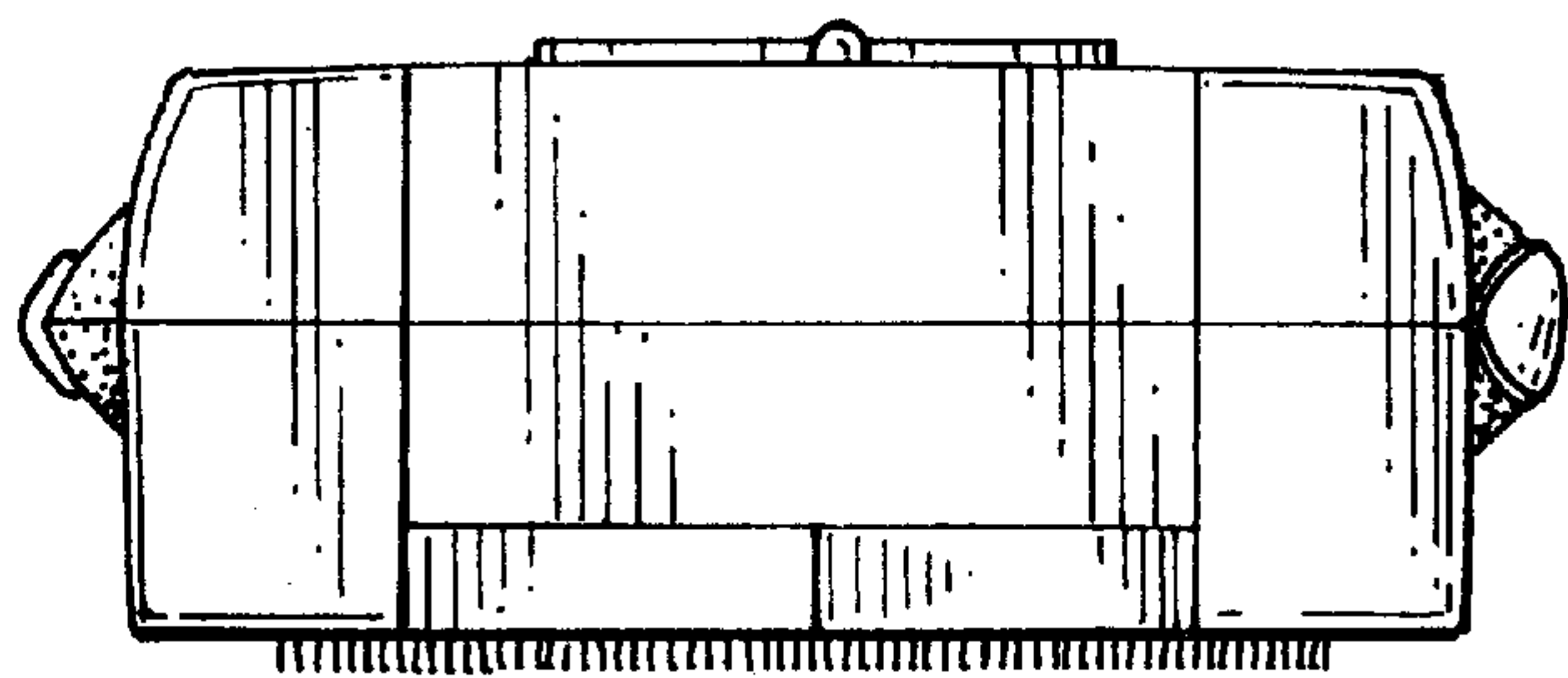

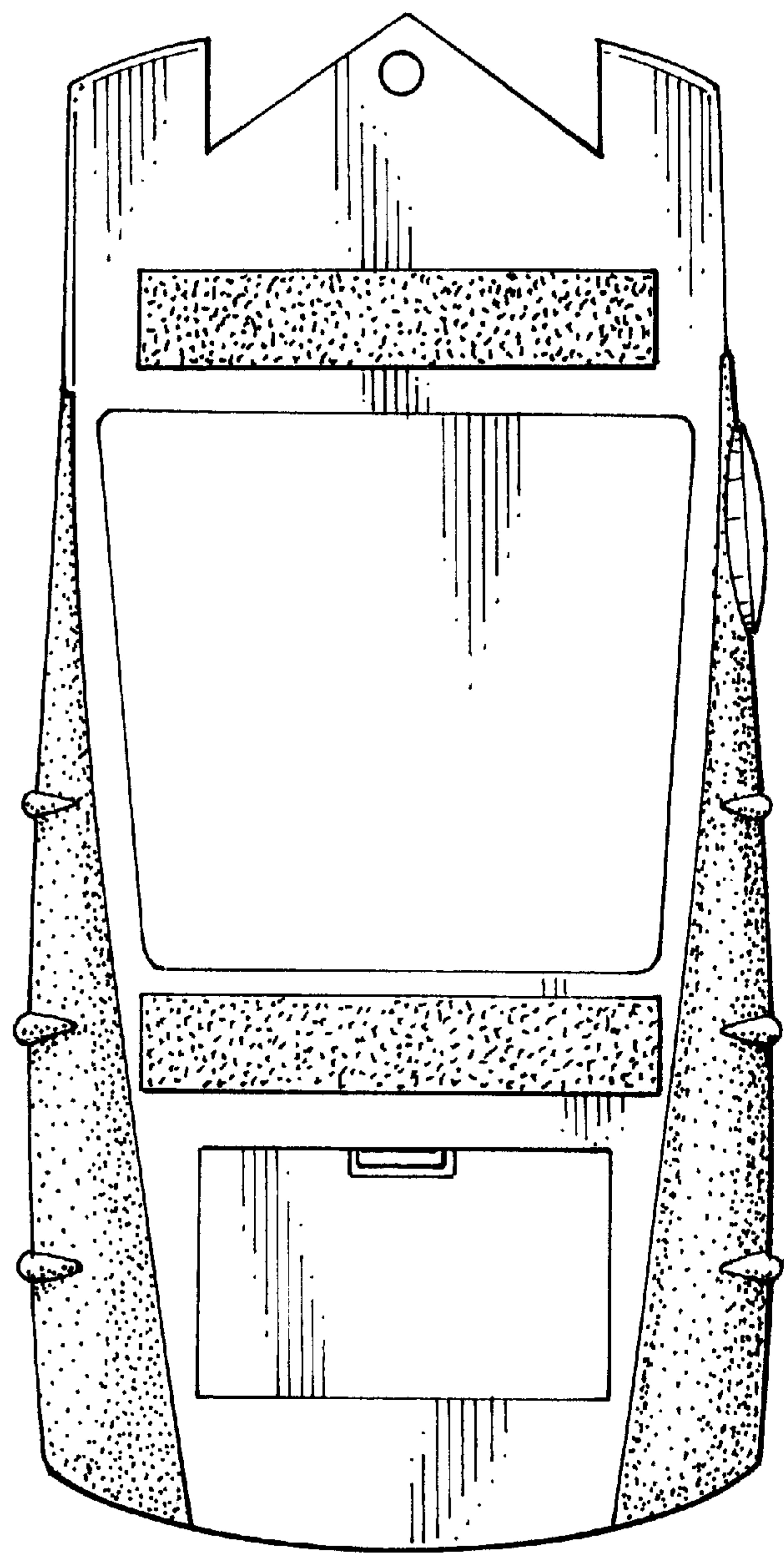

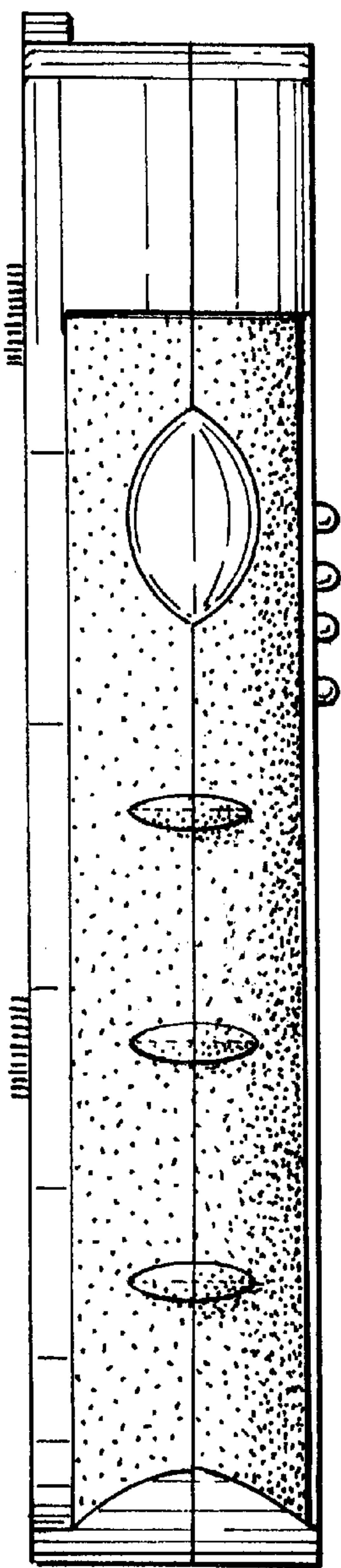

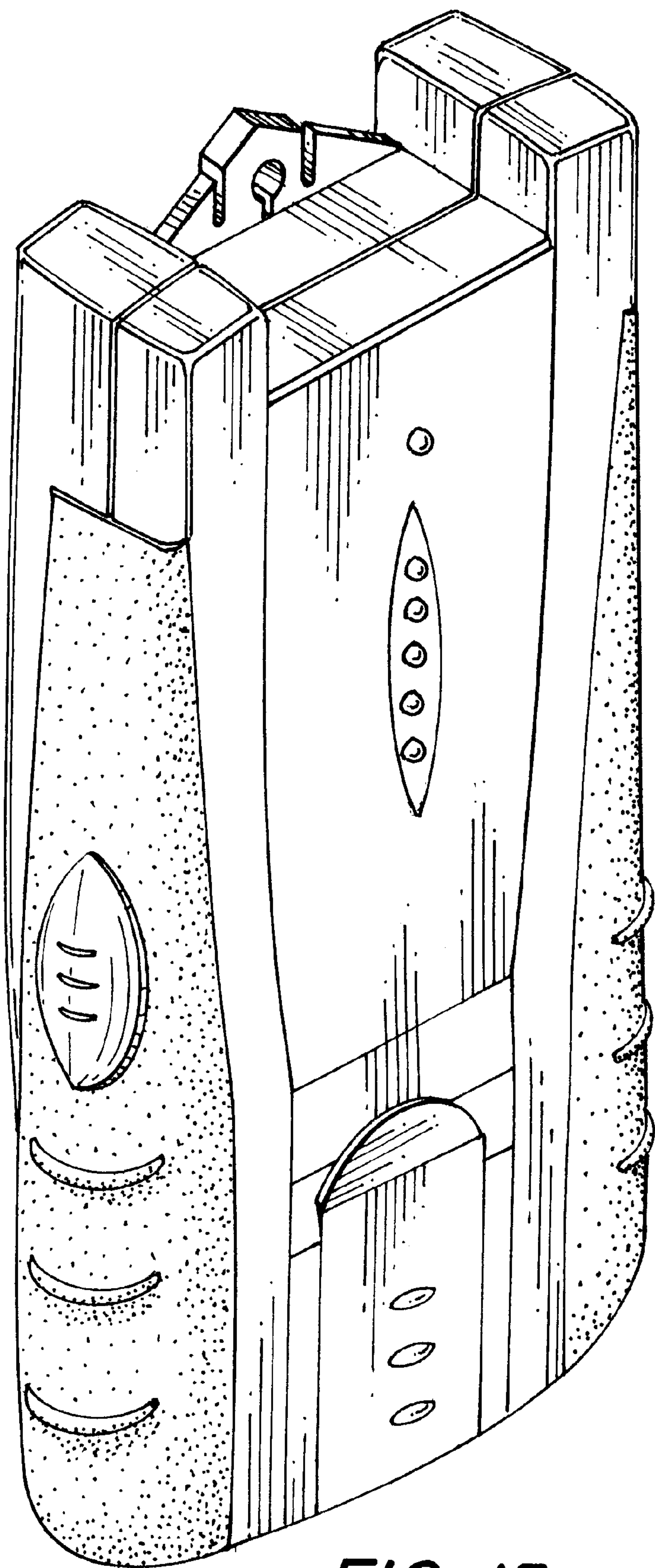

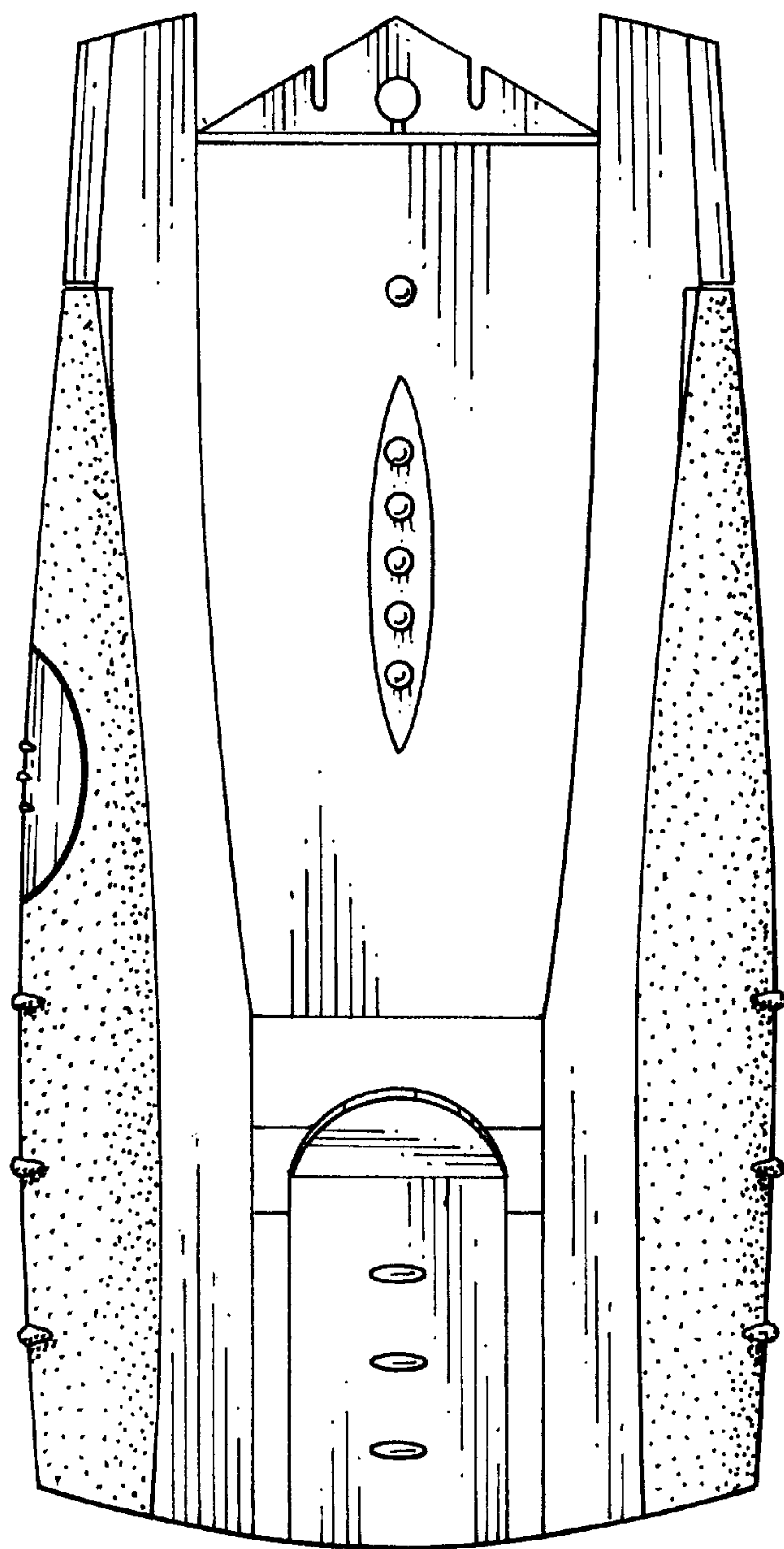

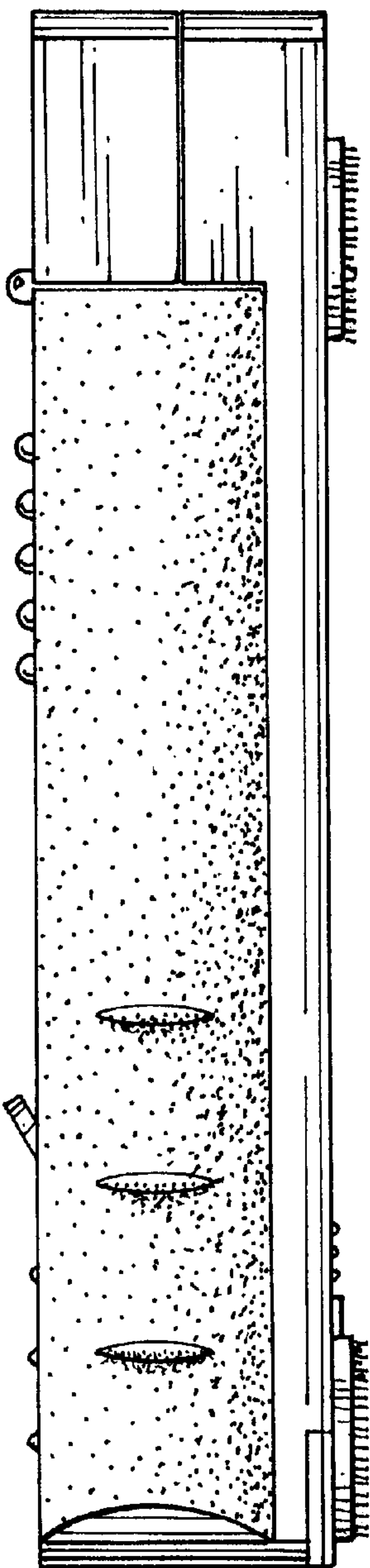

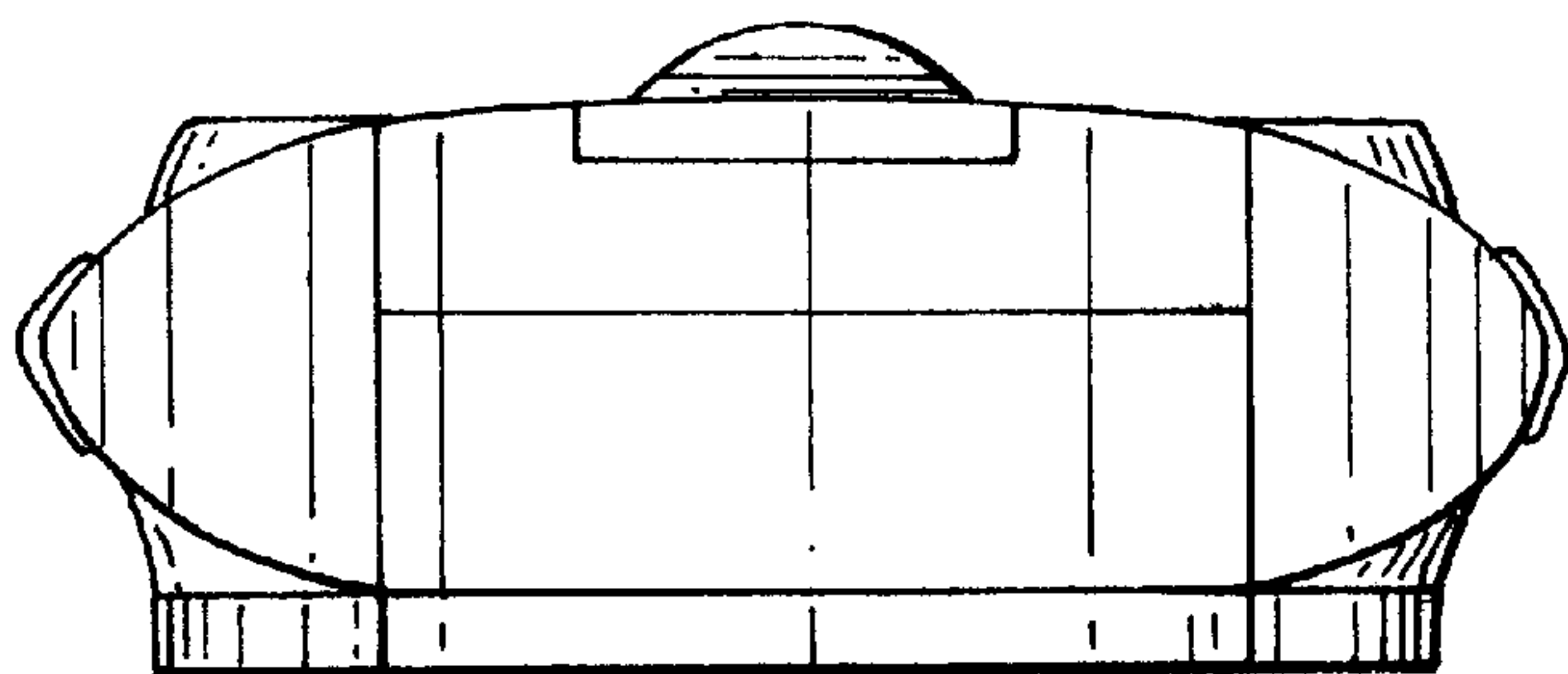

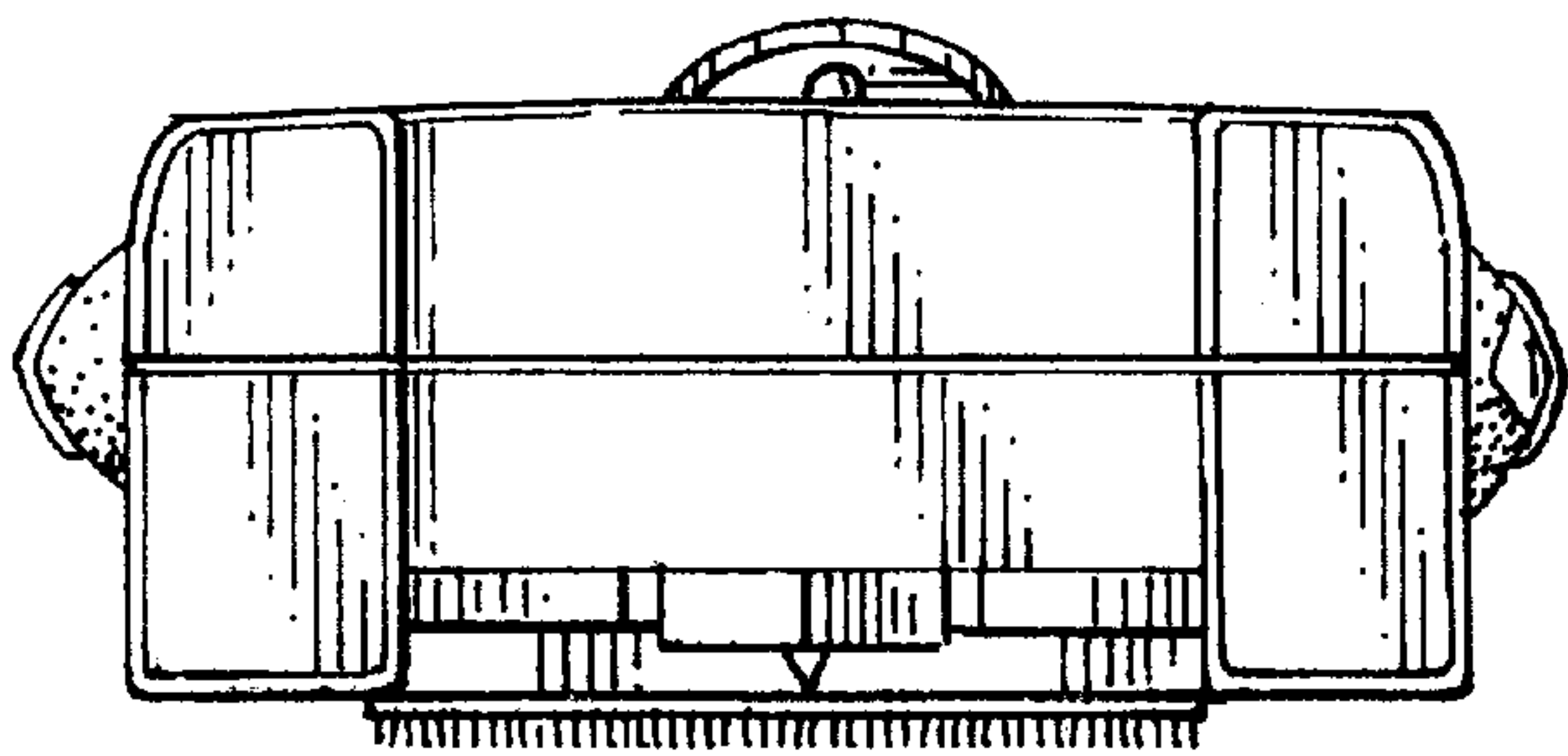

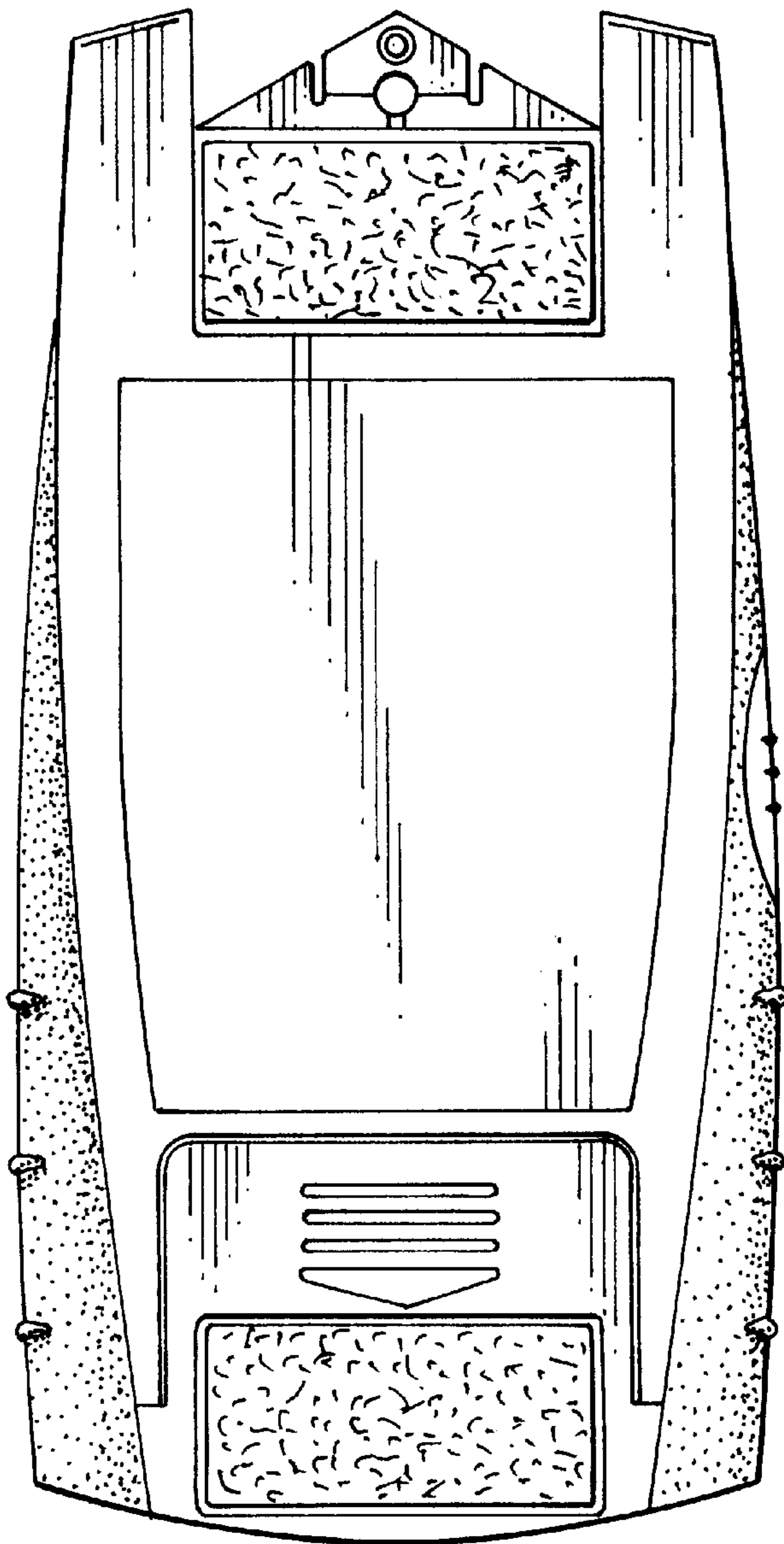

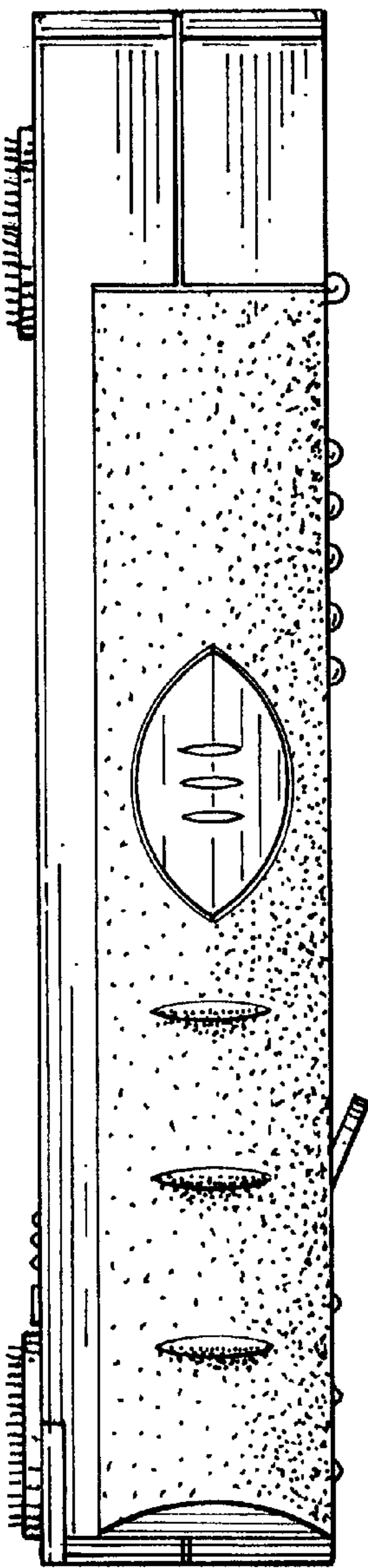
