[57] **CLAIM**

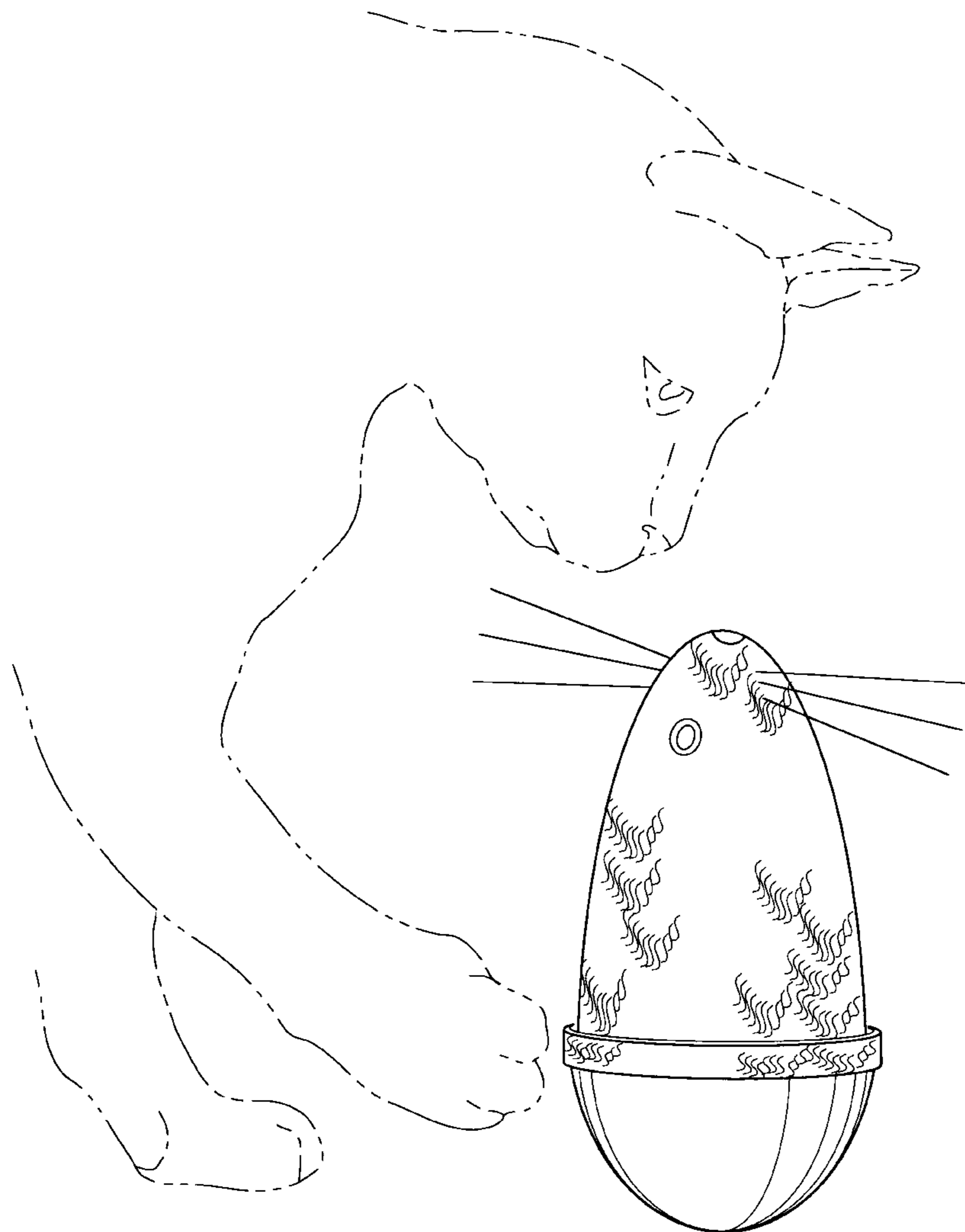
The ornamental design for a cat toy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side perspective view of a cat toy showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is the front elevation view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is the rear elevational view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation view thereof, is a mirror image of the right side elevation view shown;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

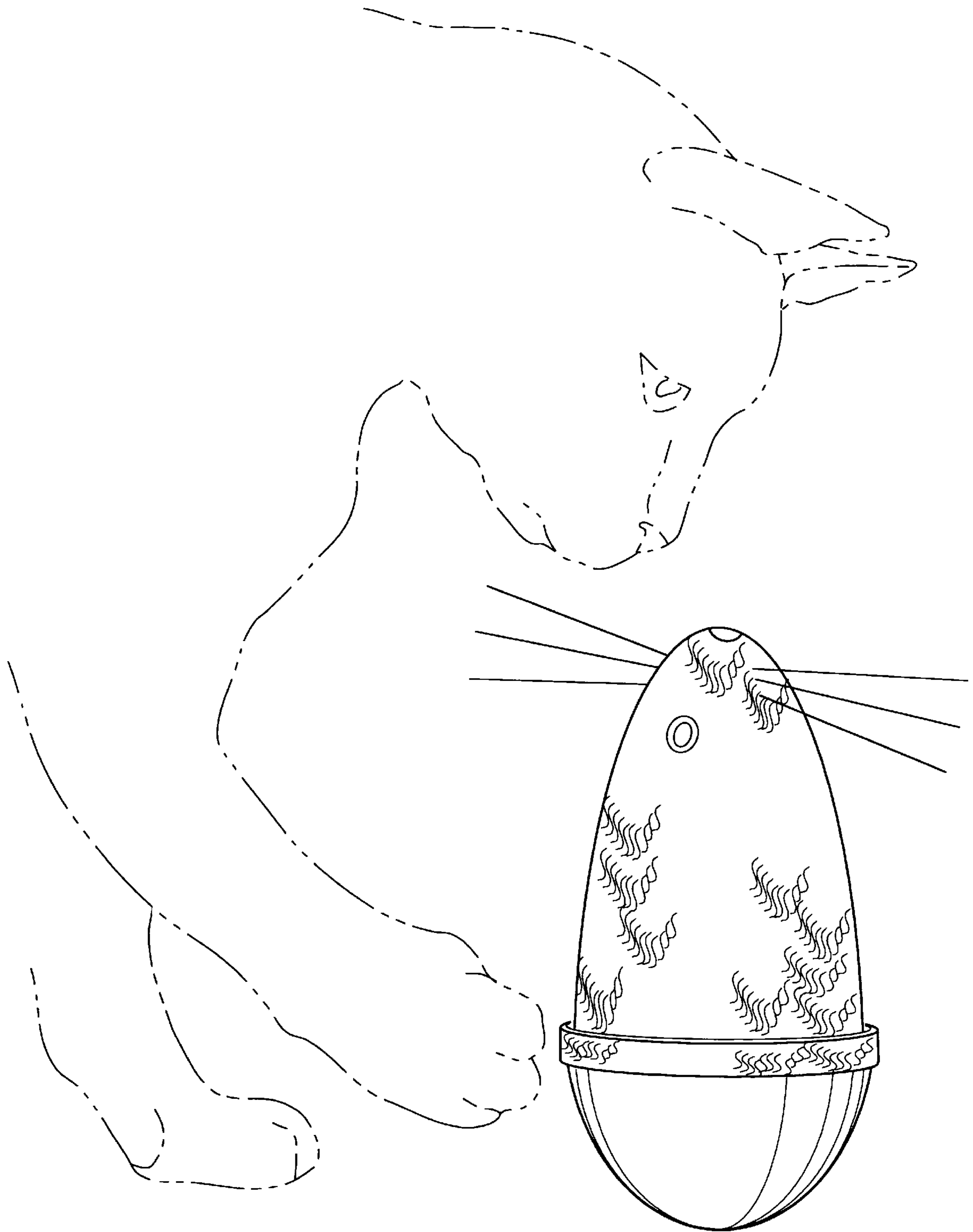

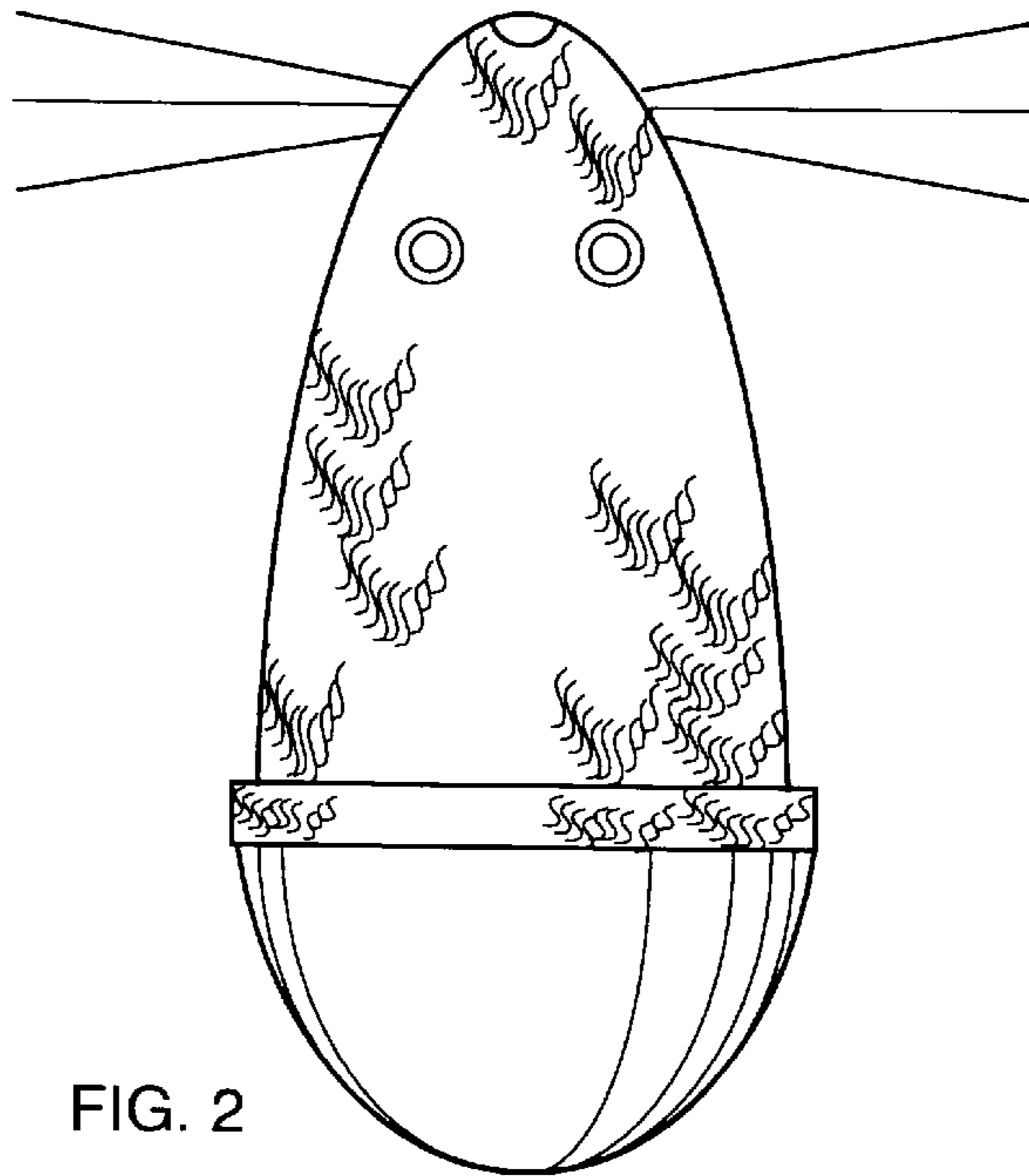

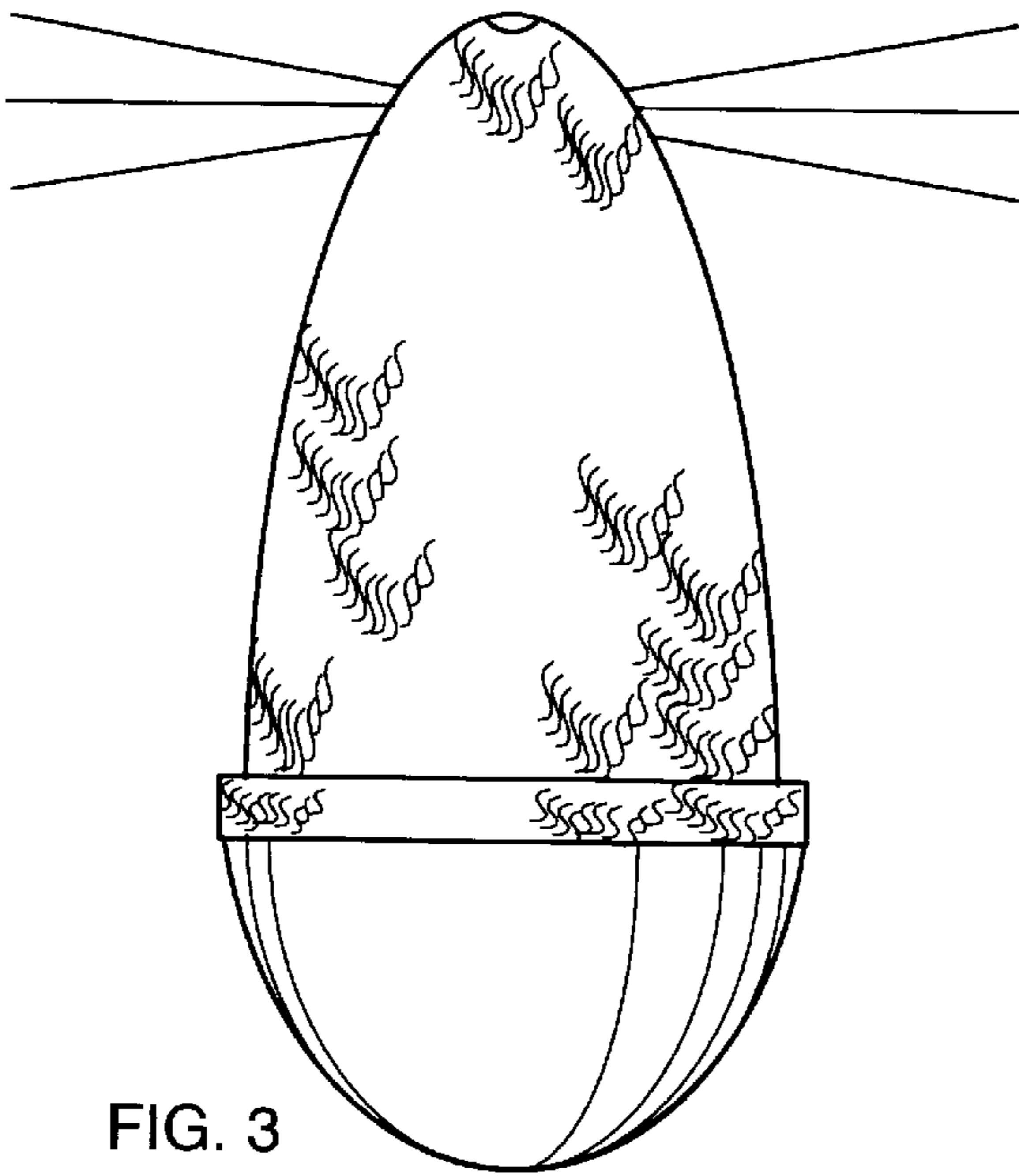

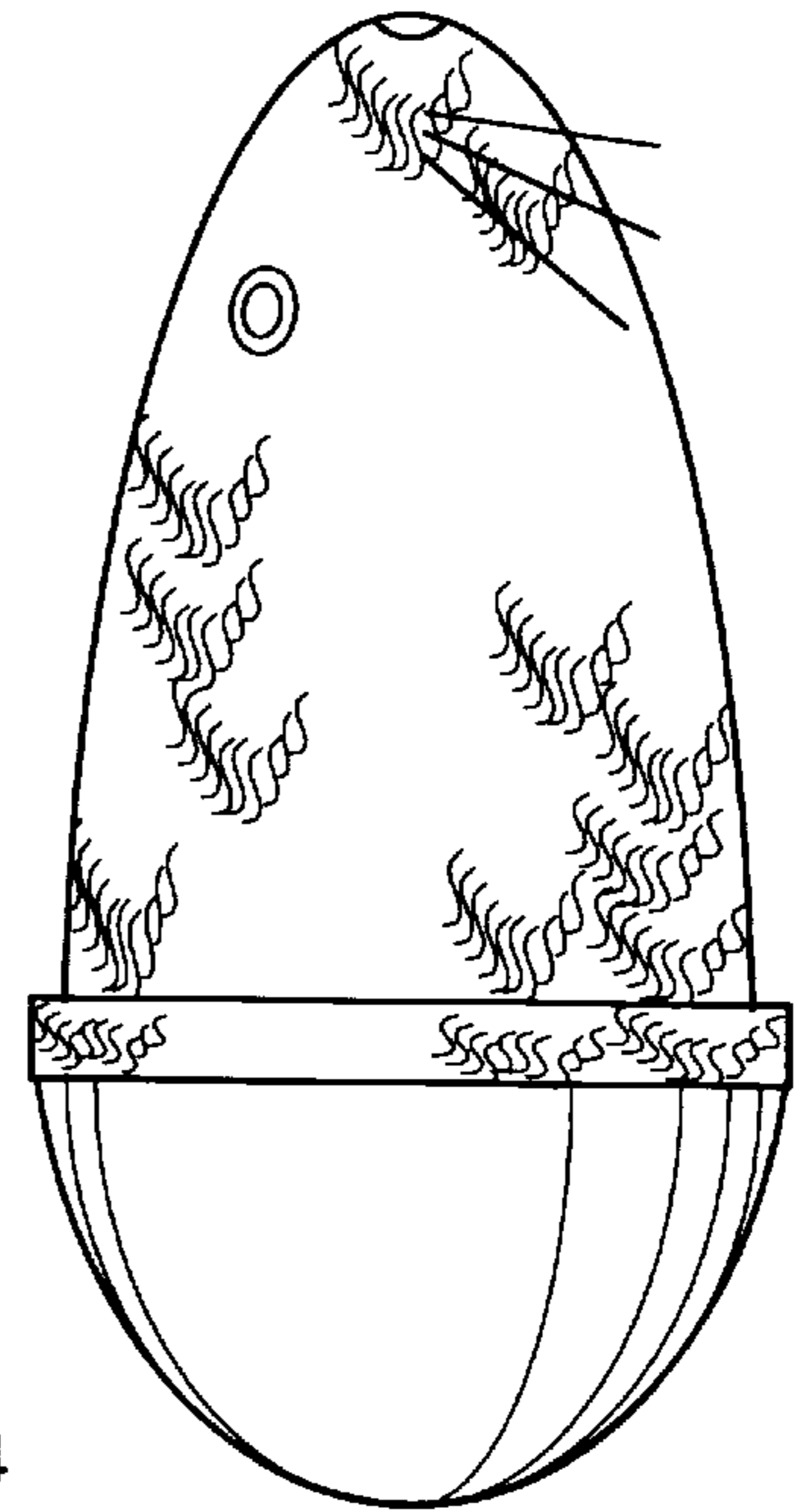

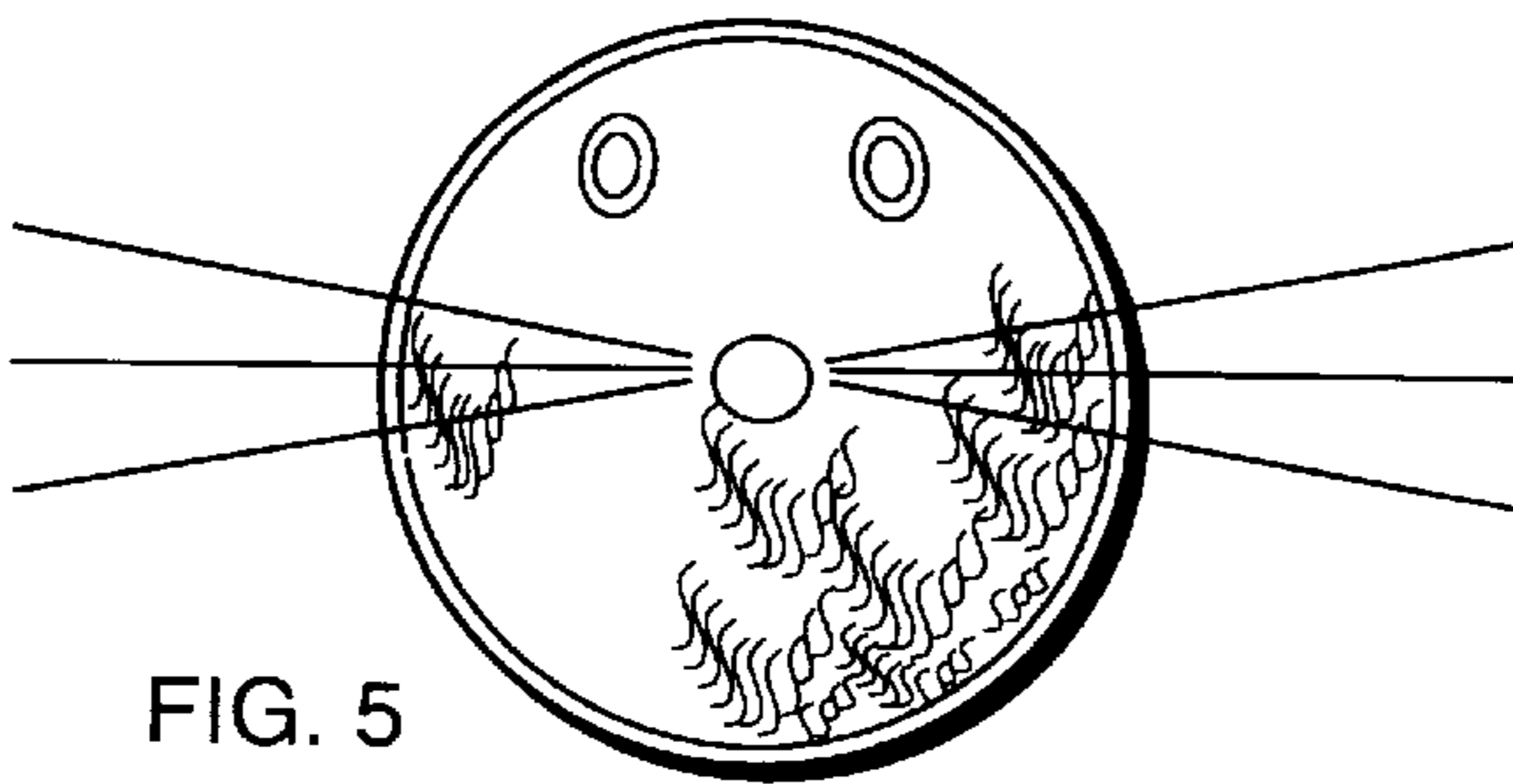

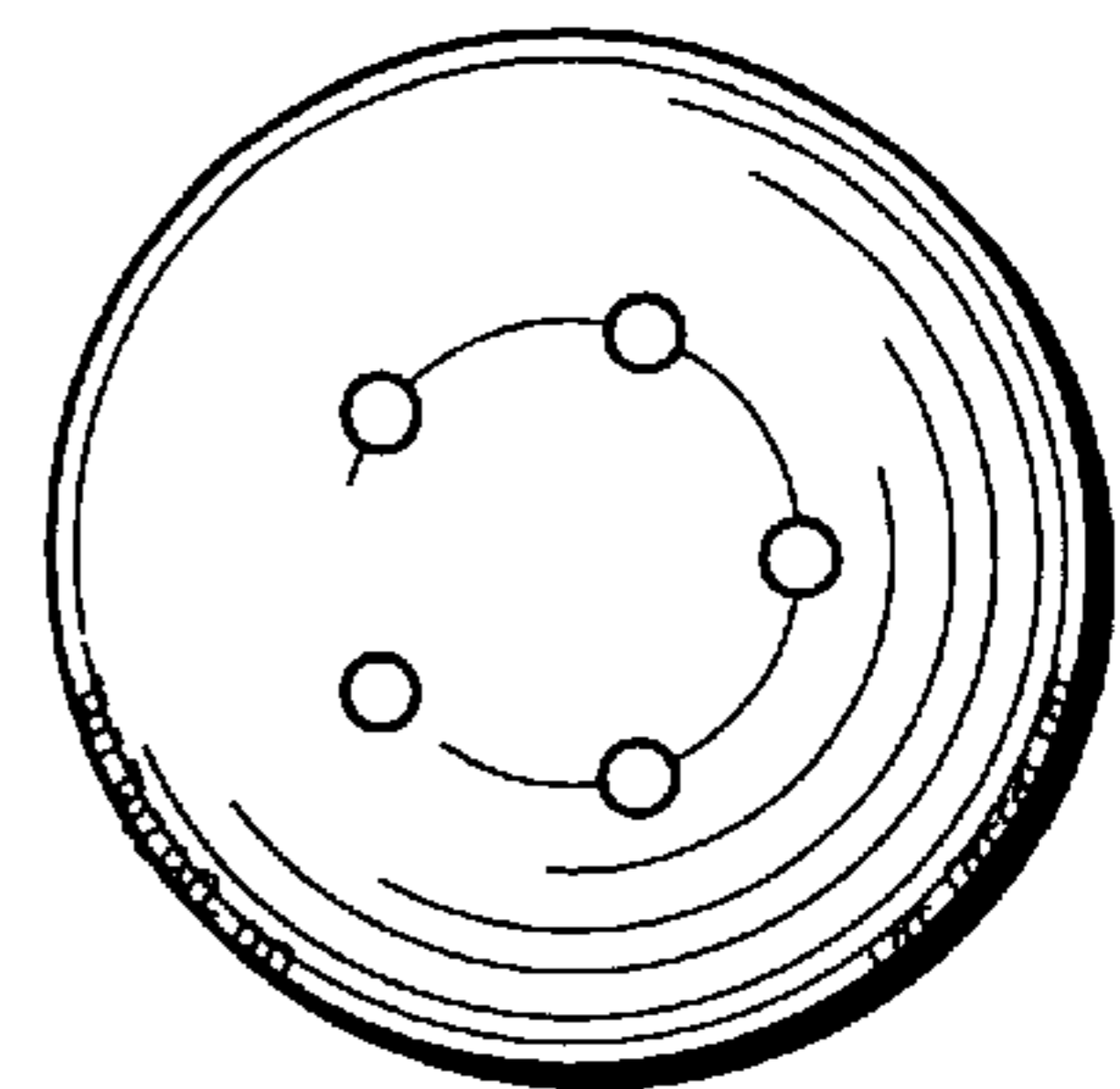
