We claim the ornamental design for a truck front grille, as shown and protected.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an environmental front elevational view of a first embodiment of truck front grille according to the invention.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the truck front grille of FIG. 1 shown in larger scale and in isolation from the

environment truck shown in phantom in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 top view of the truck front grille of FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the truck front grille of

FIG. 2. The opposite side elevational view is a mirror image of the view shown in FIG. 4.

FIG. 5 is an environmental front elevational view of a second embodiment of truck front grille according to the invention.

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of the truck front grille of FIG. 5 shown in larger scale and in isolation from the environment truck shown in phantom in FIG. 5.


FIG. 7 top view of the truck front grille of FIG. 5; and,

FIG. 8 is a side elevational view of the truck front grille of FIG. 5. The opposite side elevational view is a mirror image


of the view shown in FIG. 8.



















