[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tape player combined with radio receiver, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tape player combined with radio receiver showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational thereof; and FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 8 is perspective view thereof, wherein the lid portion is in the open position. The broken lines showing the inside of the tape player combined with radio receiver is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

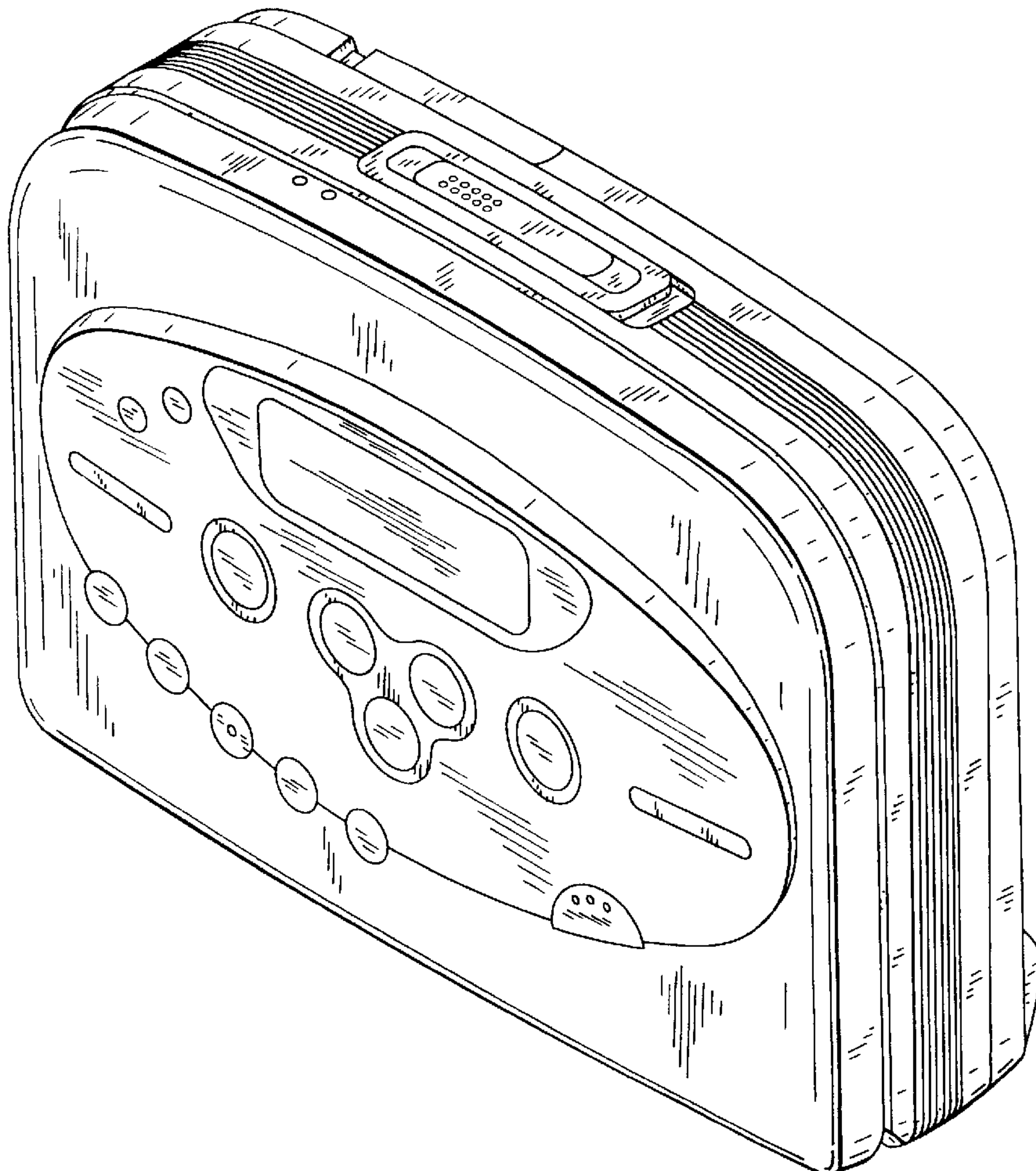

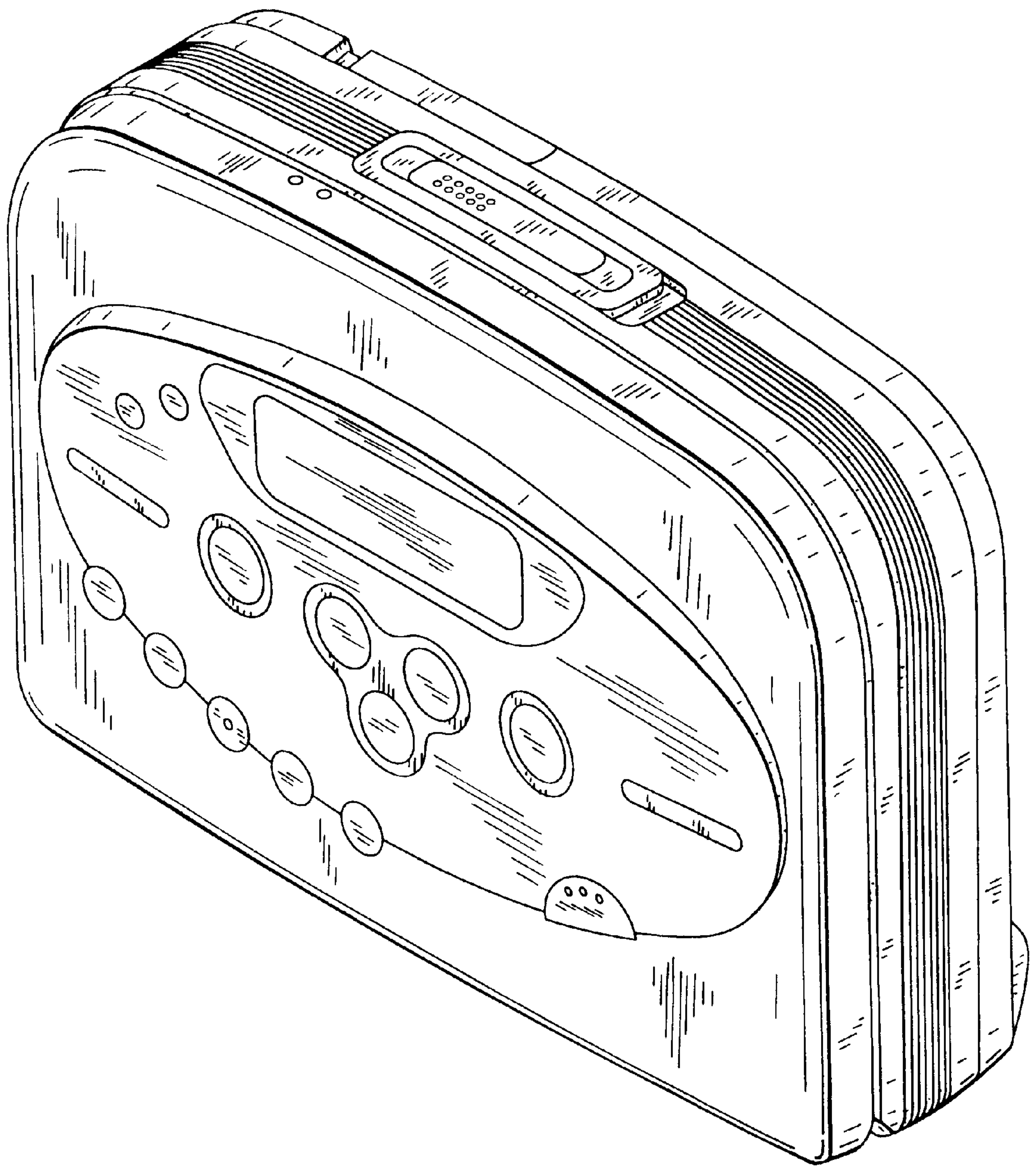

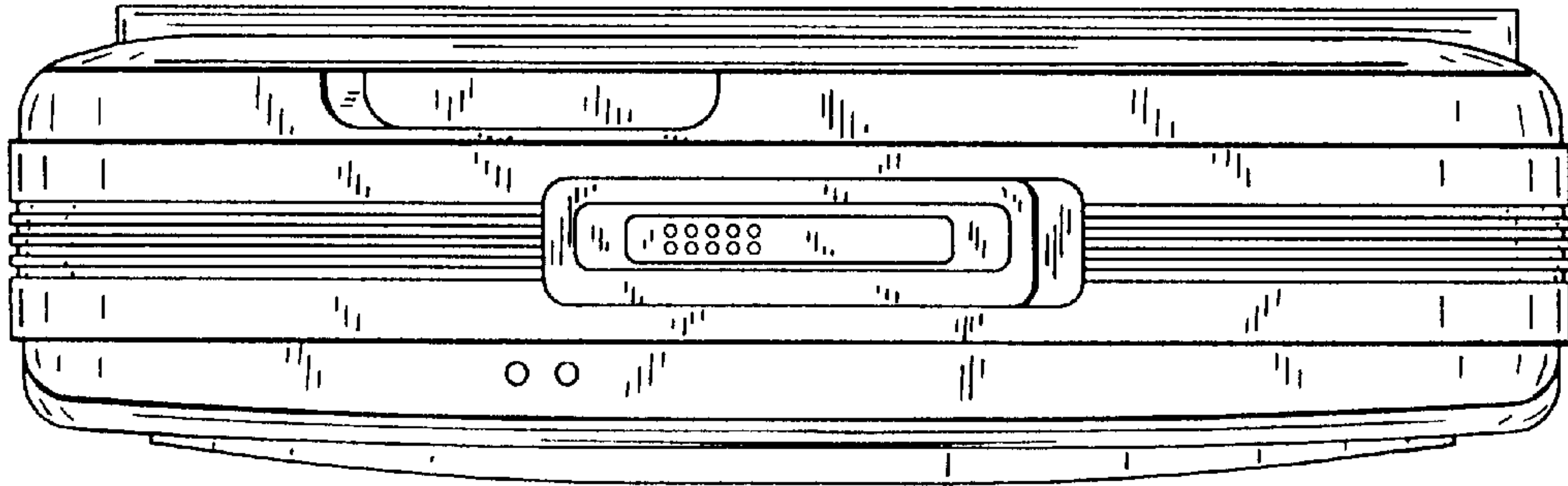

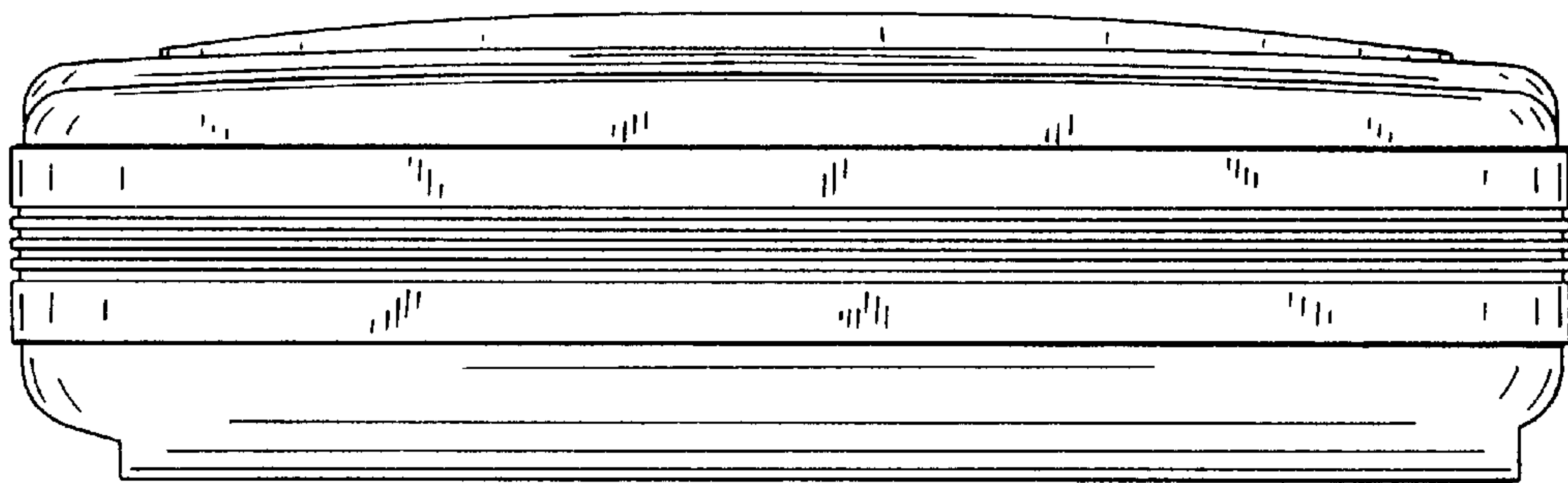

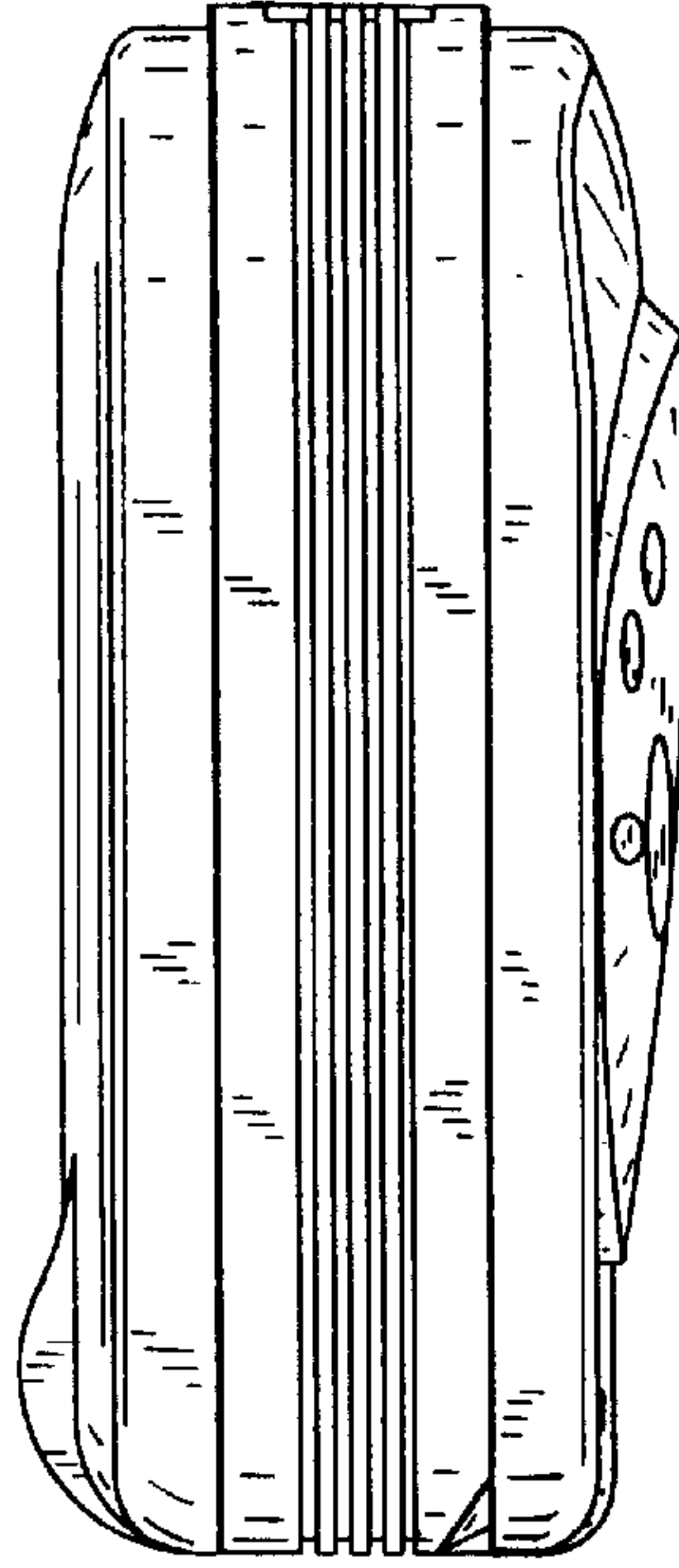

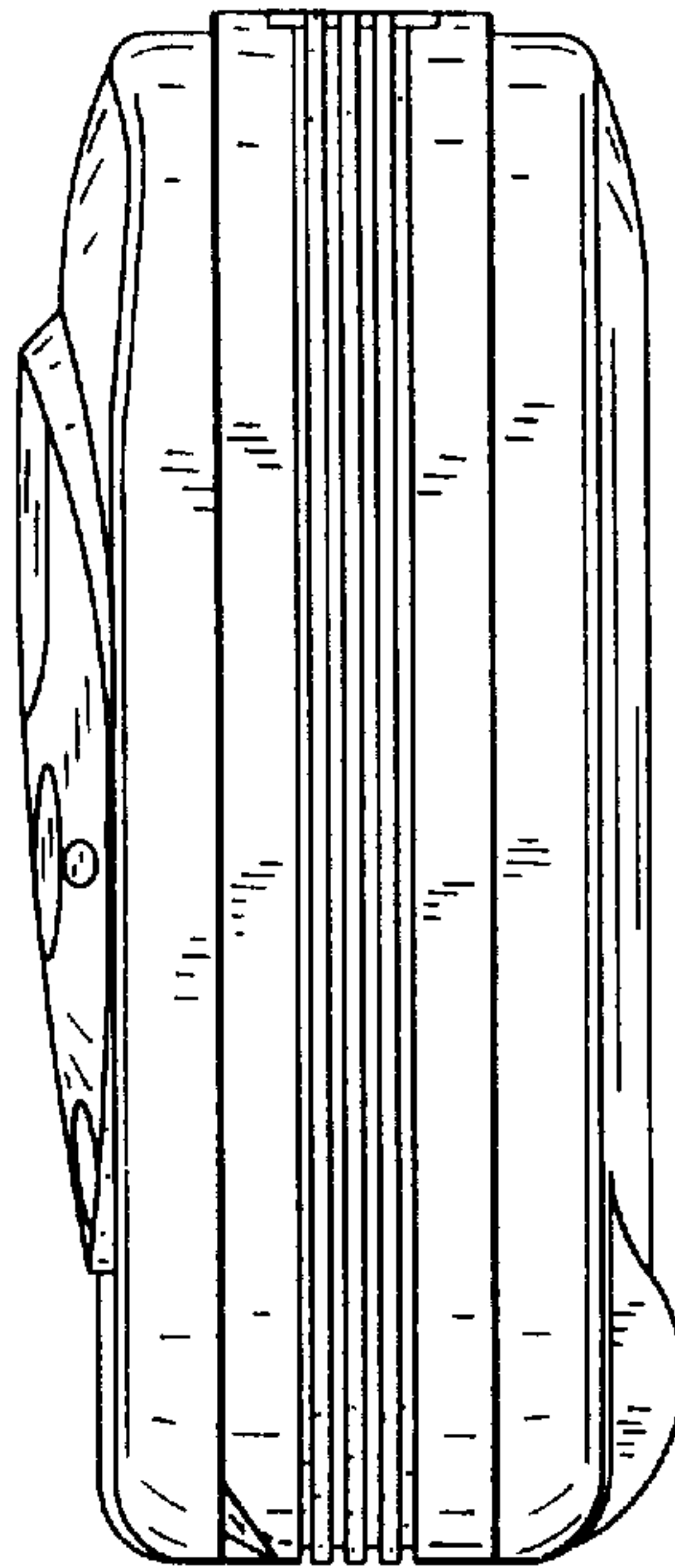

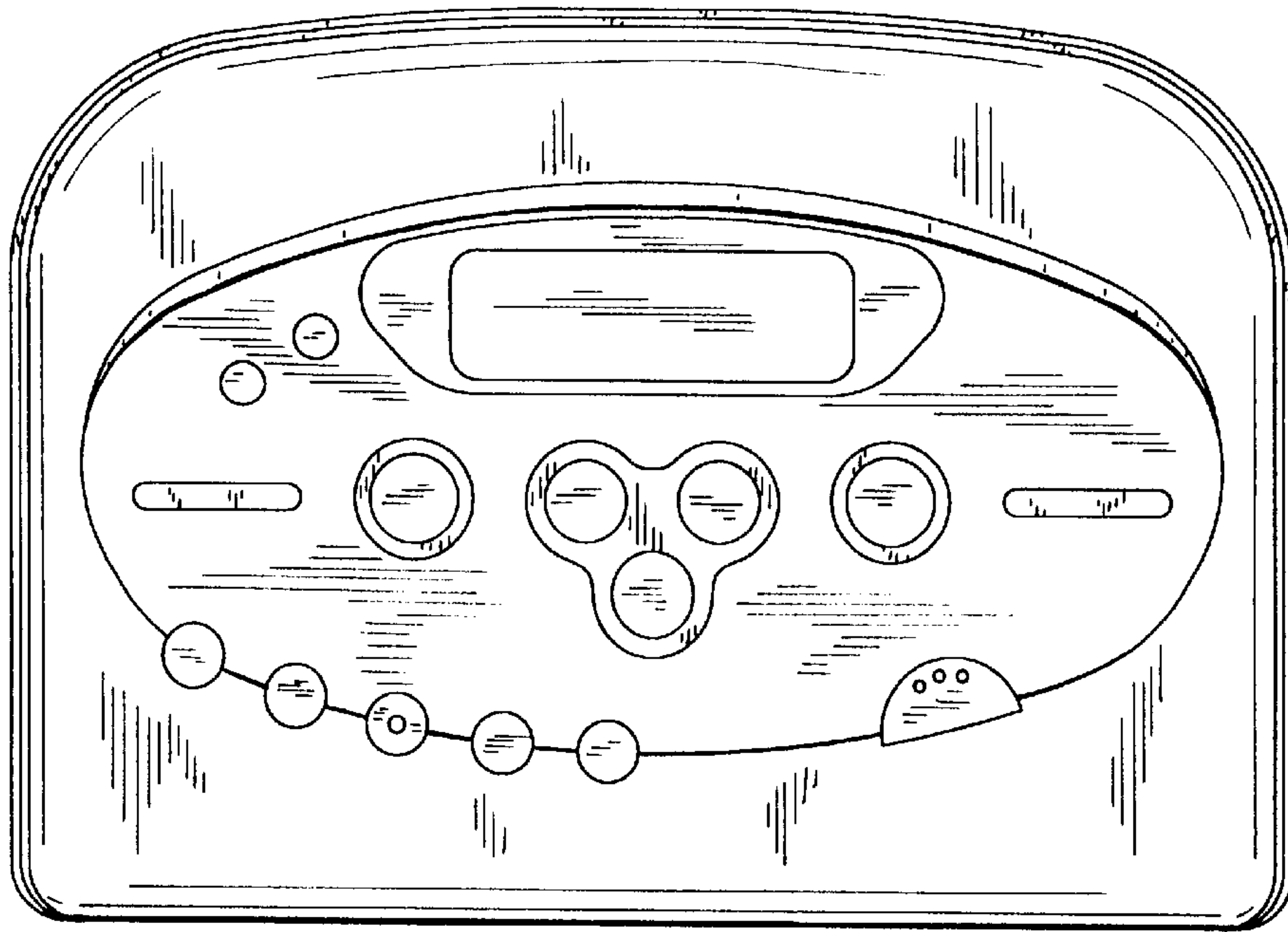

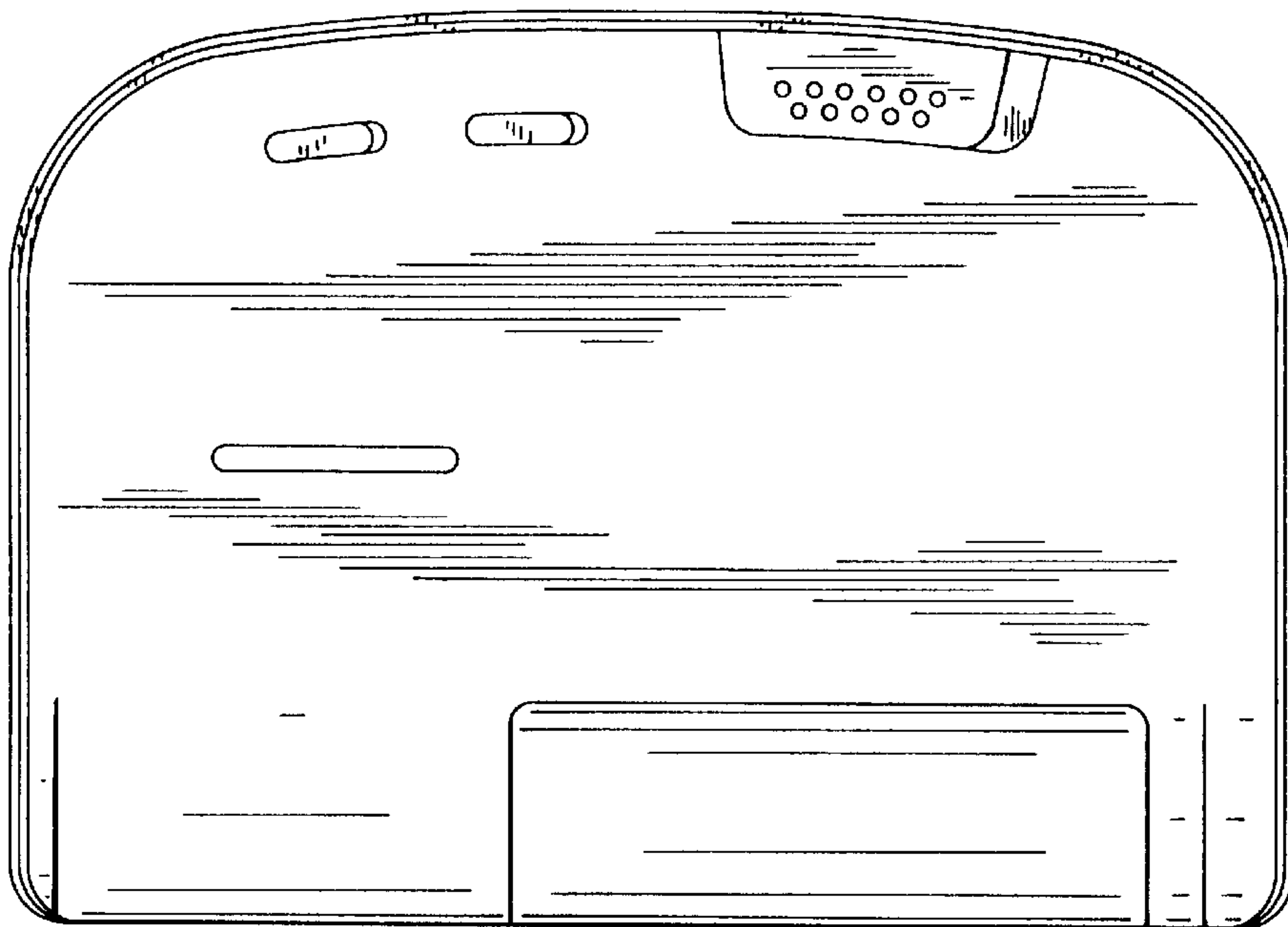
