FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the microbiological bead separation magnet holder.

FIG. 2 is a plan view of the magnetic tube holder.

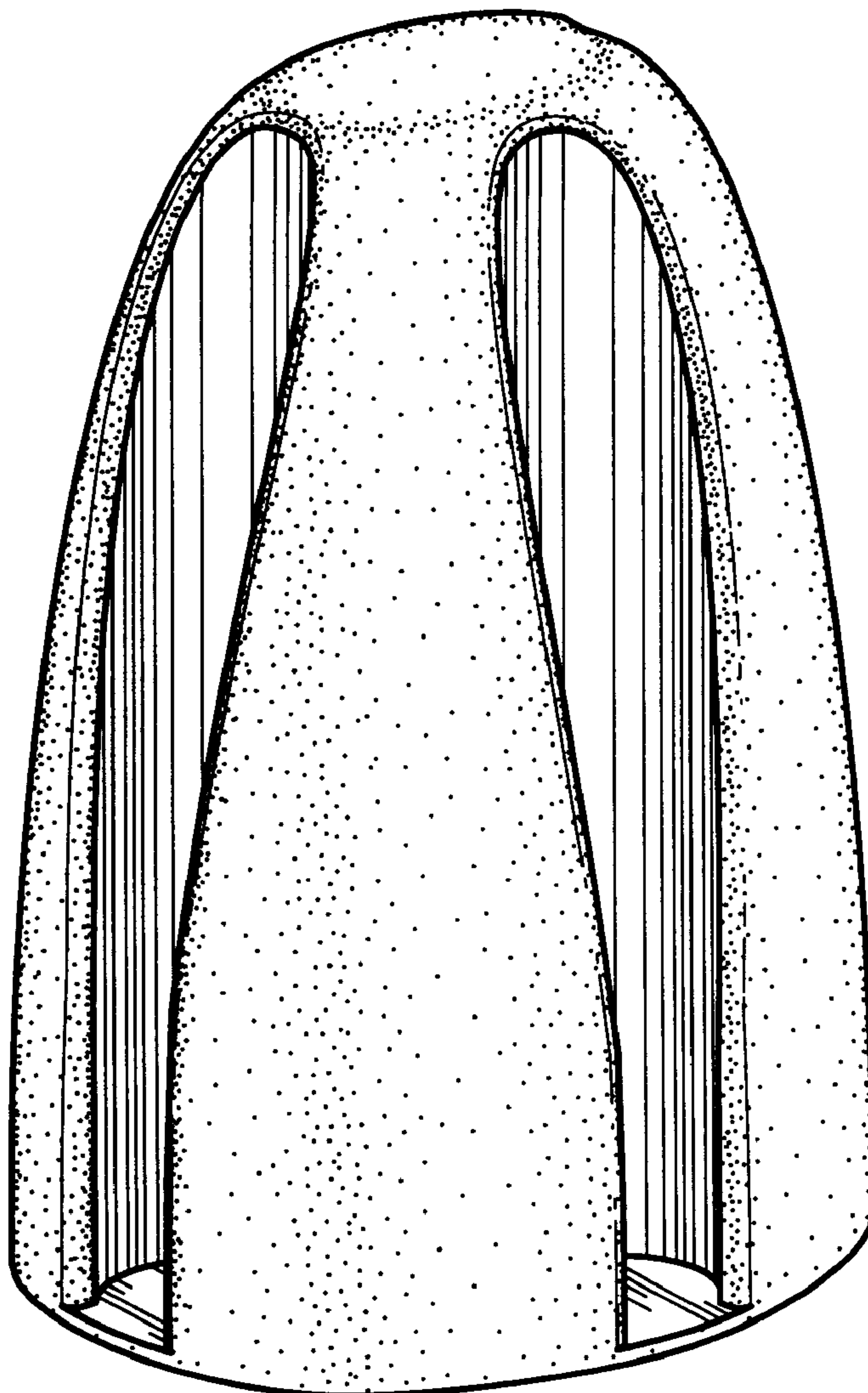
FIG. 3 is a side view of the magnet holder.

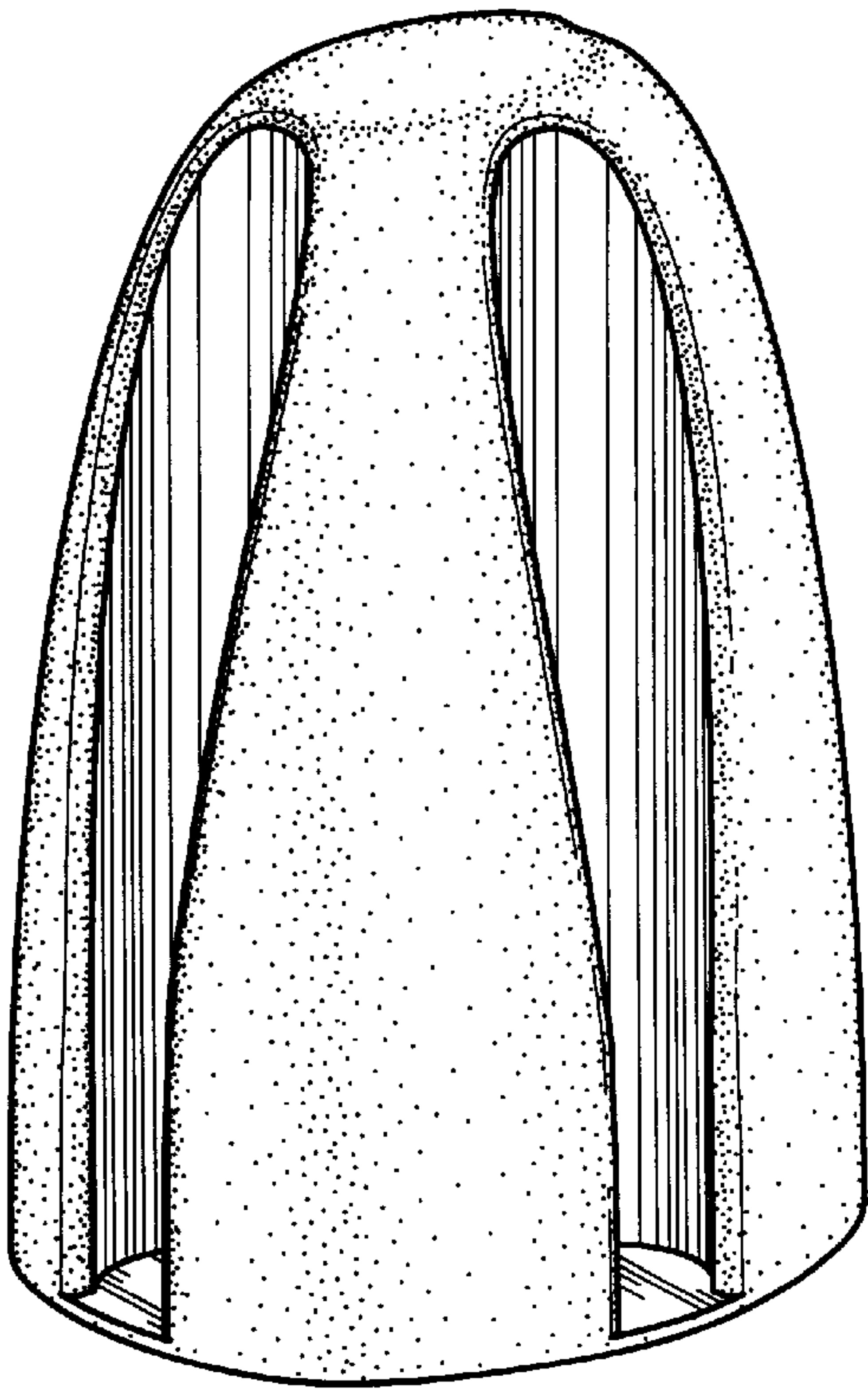

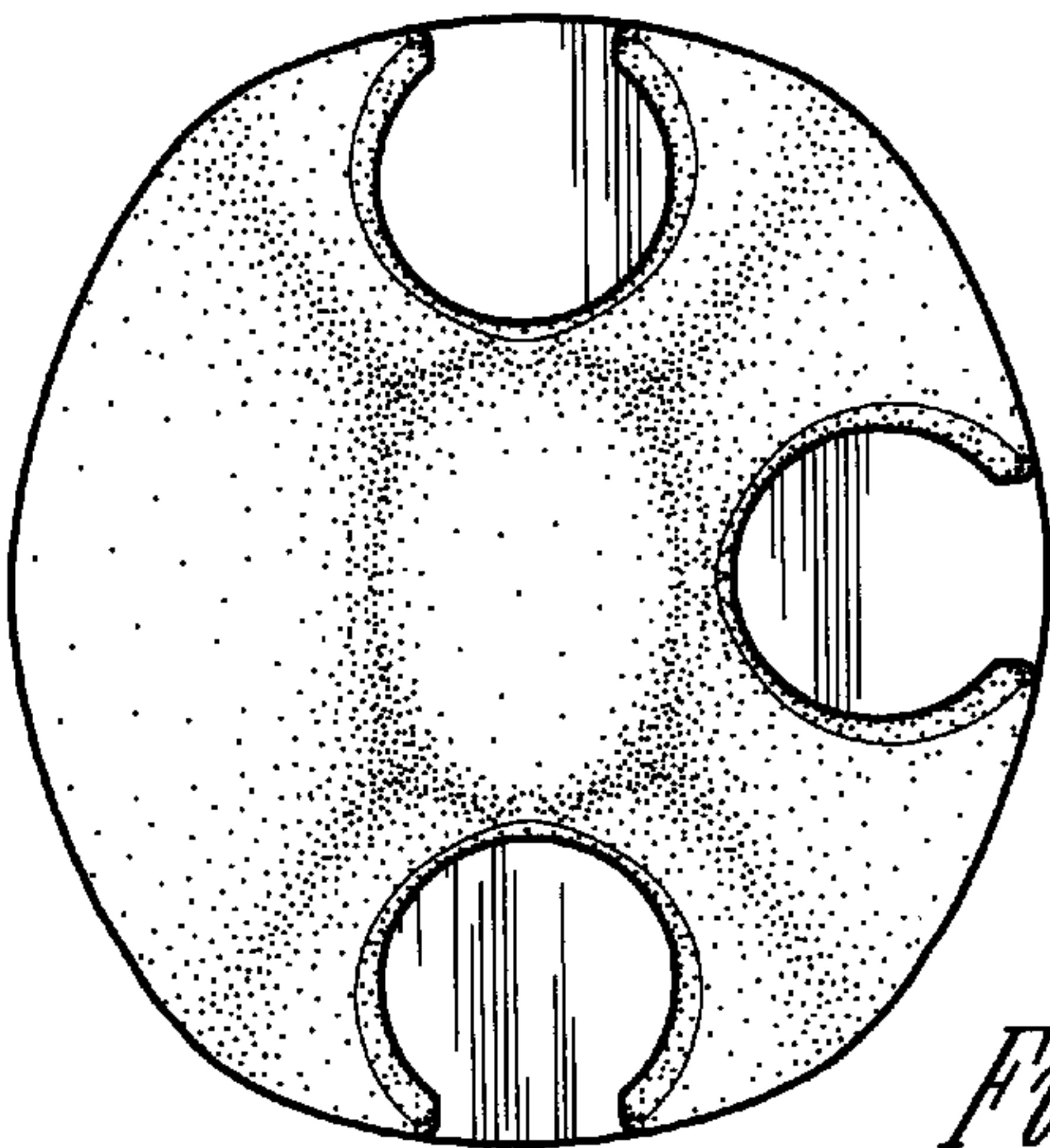

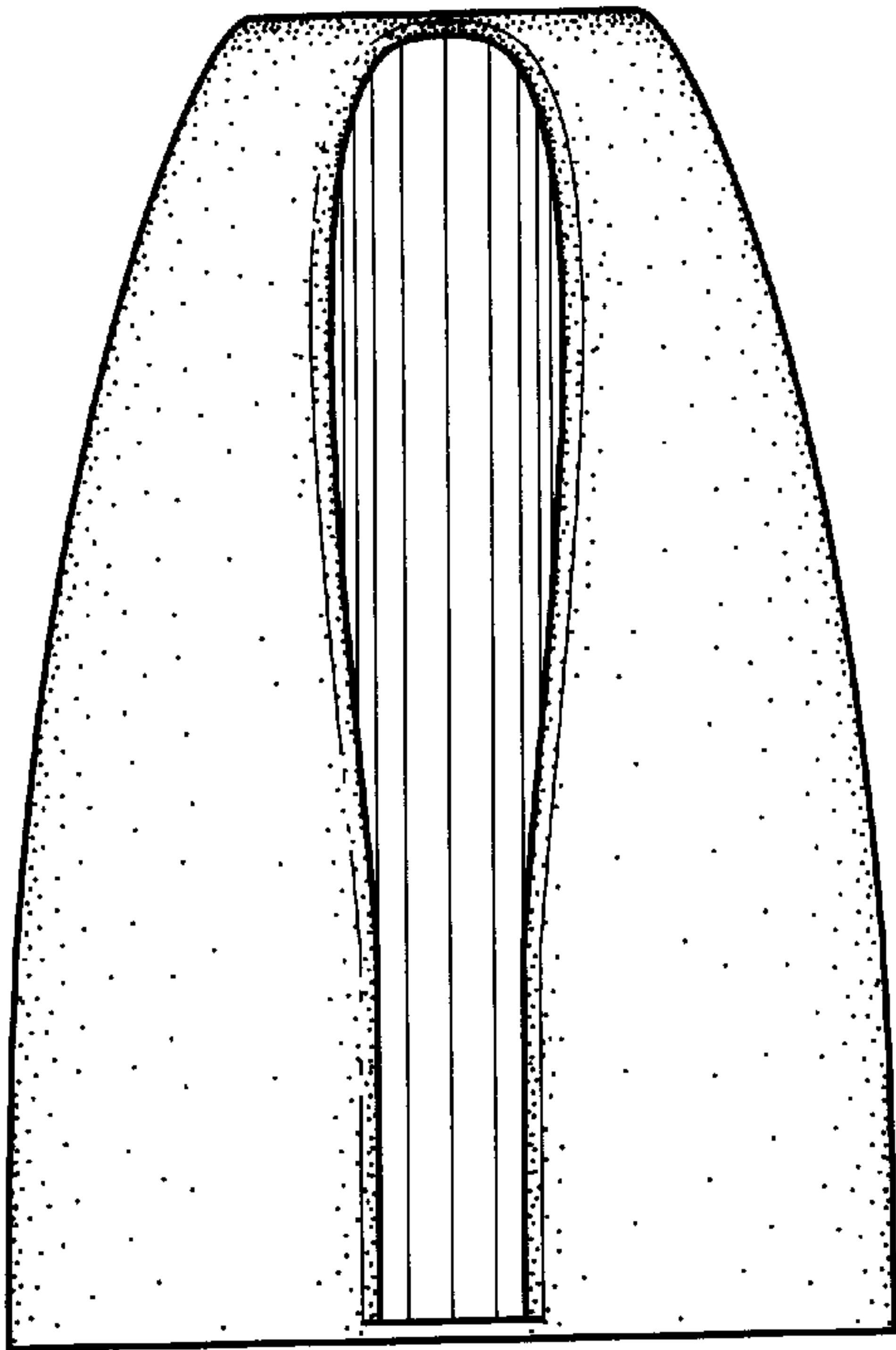

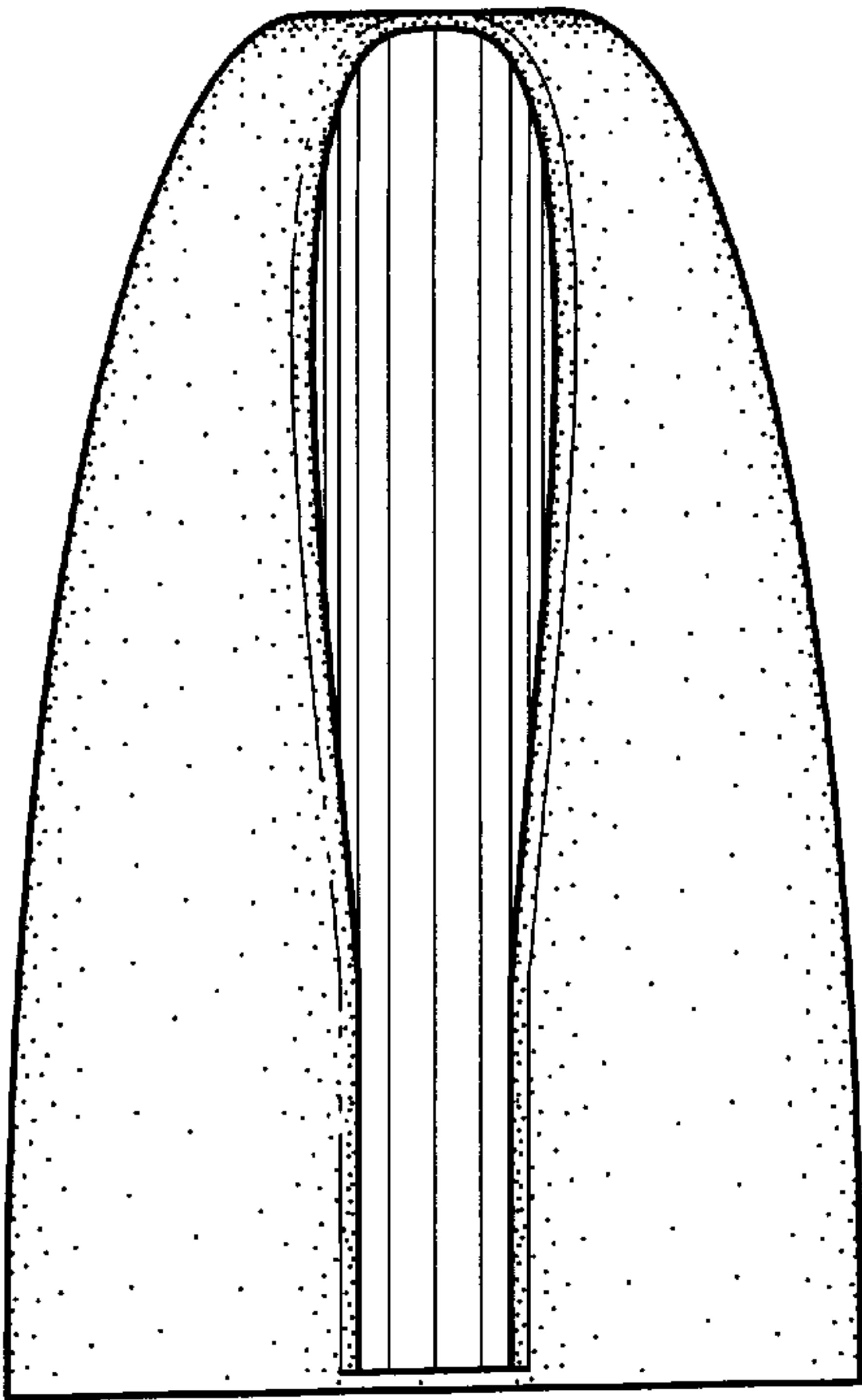

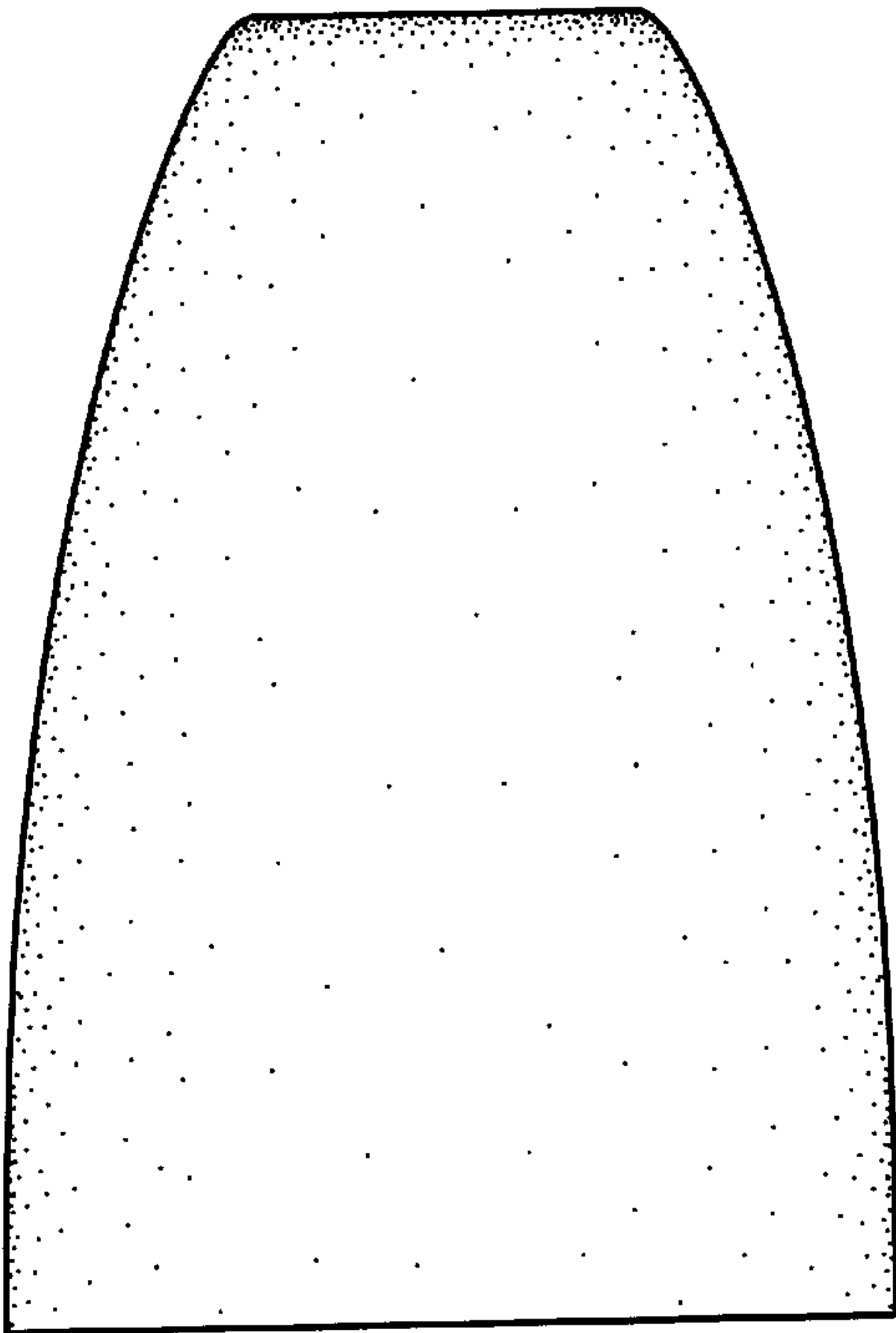

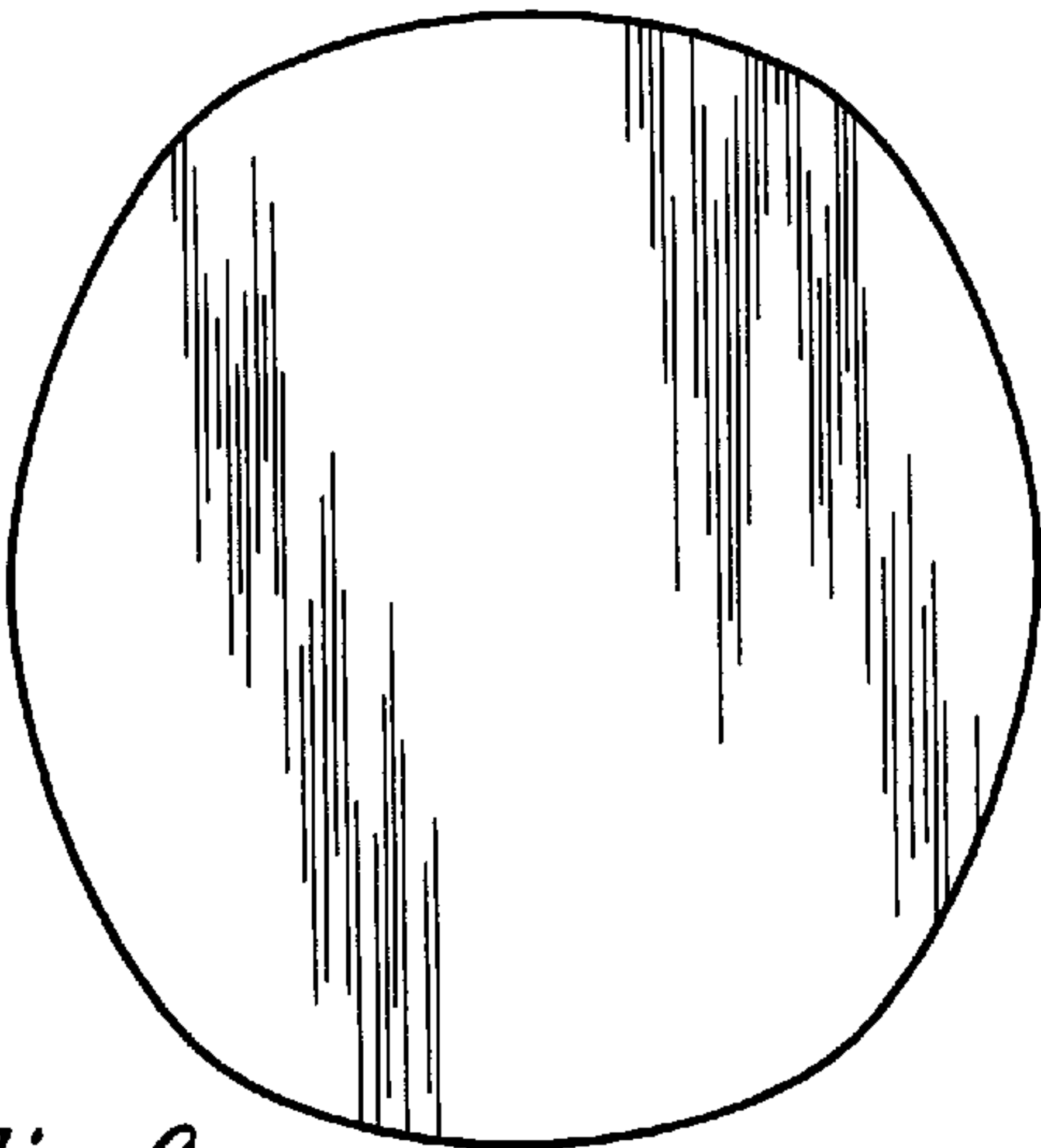
