FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof.

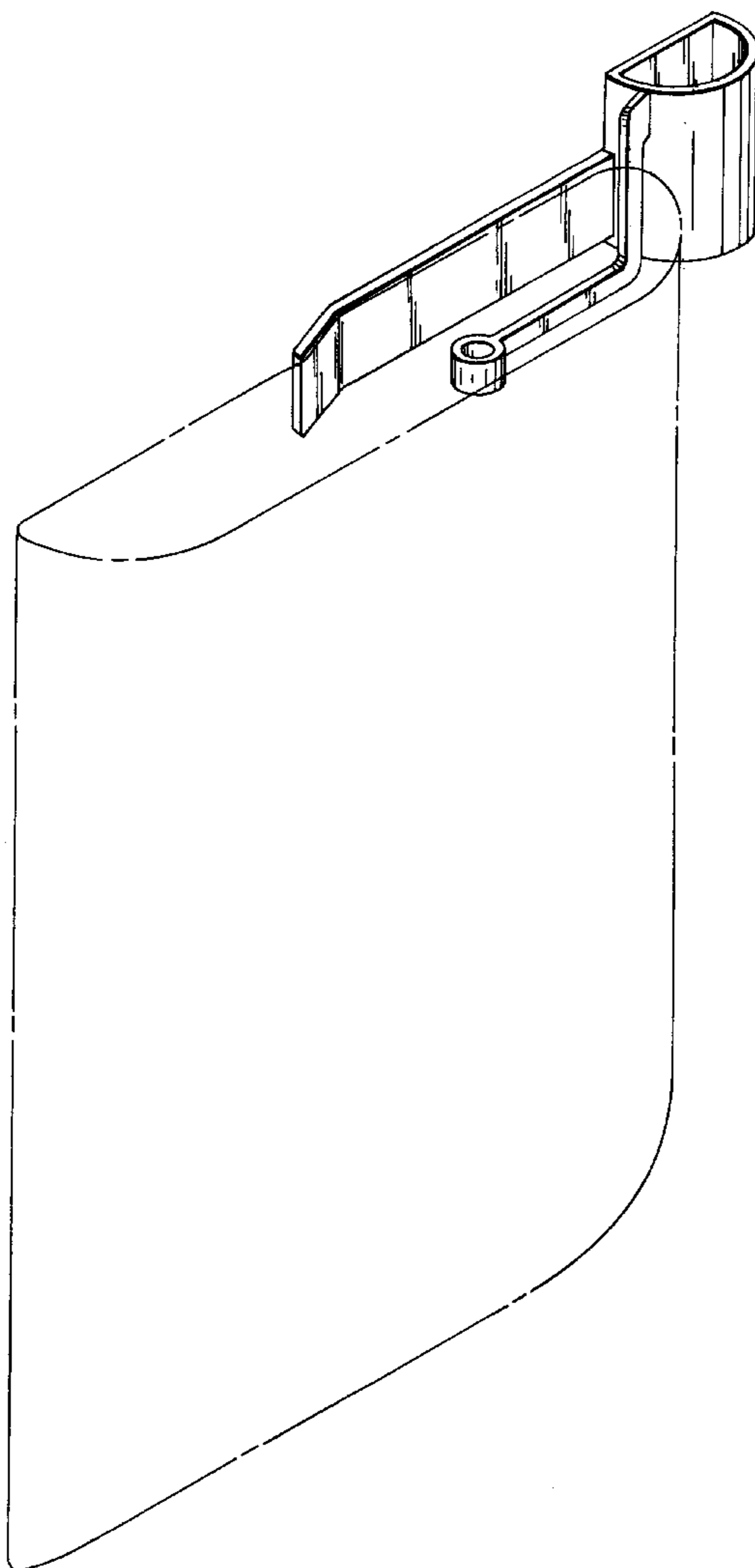

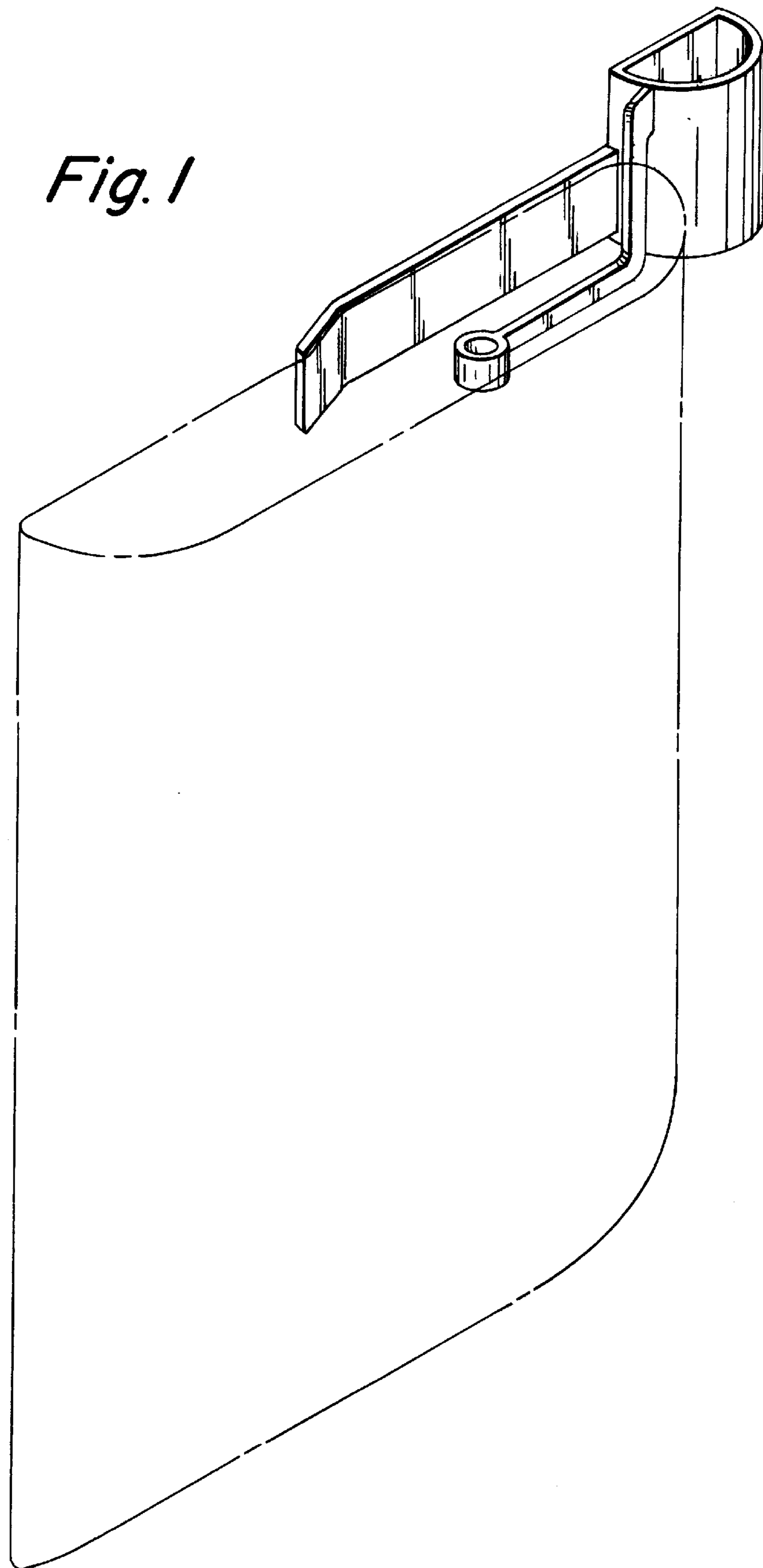

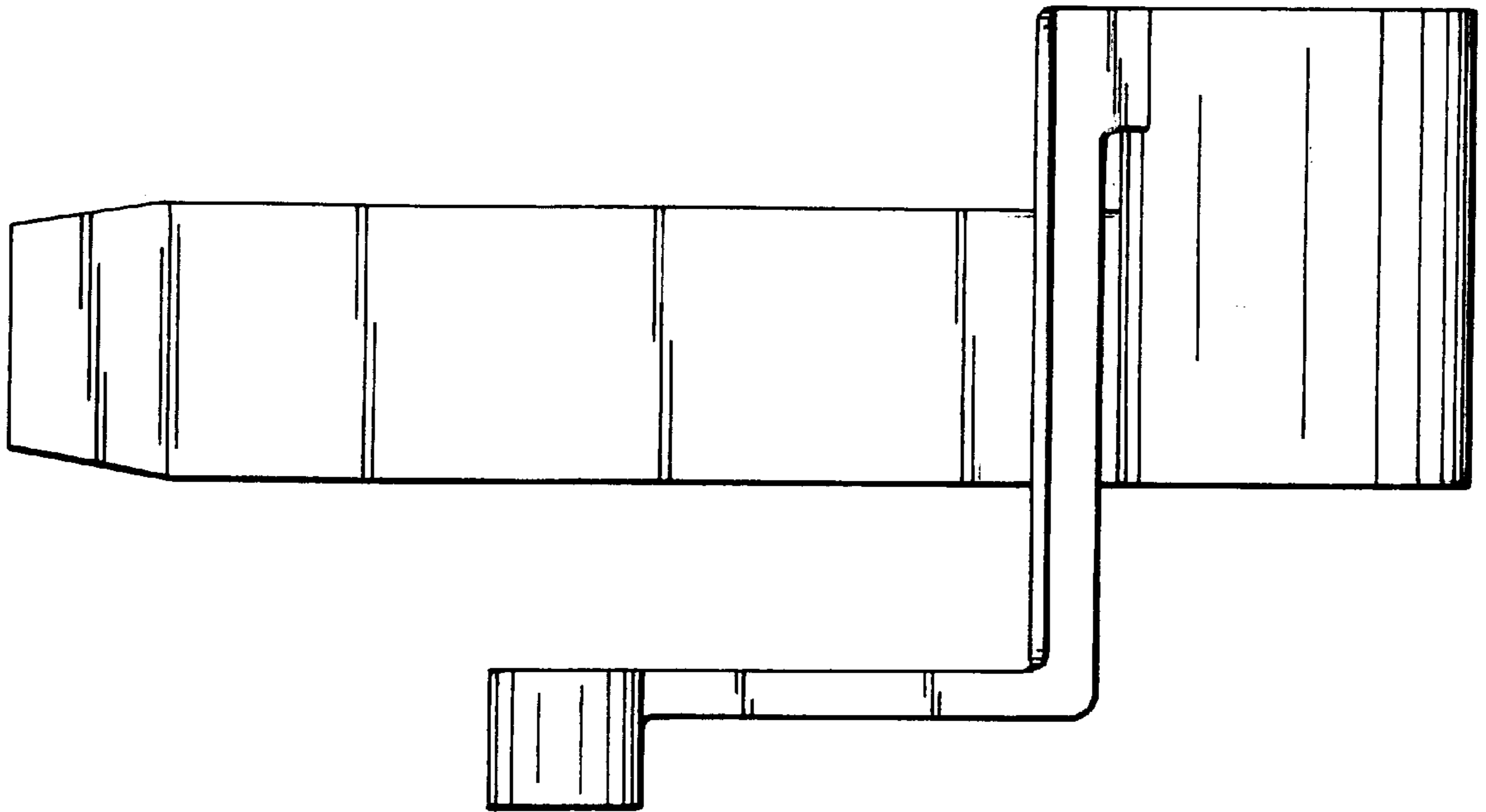

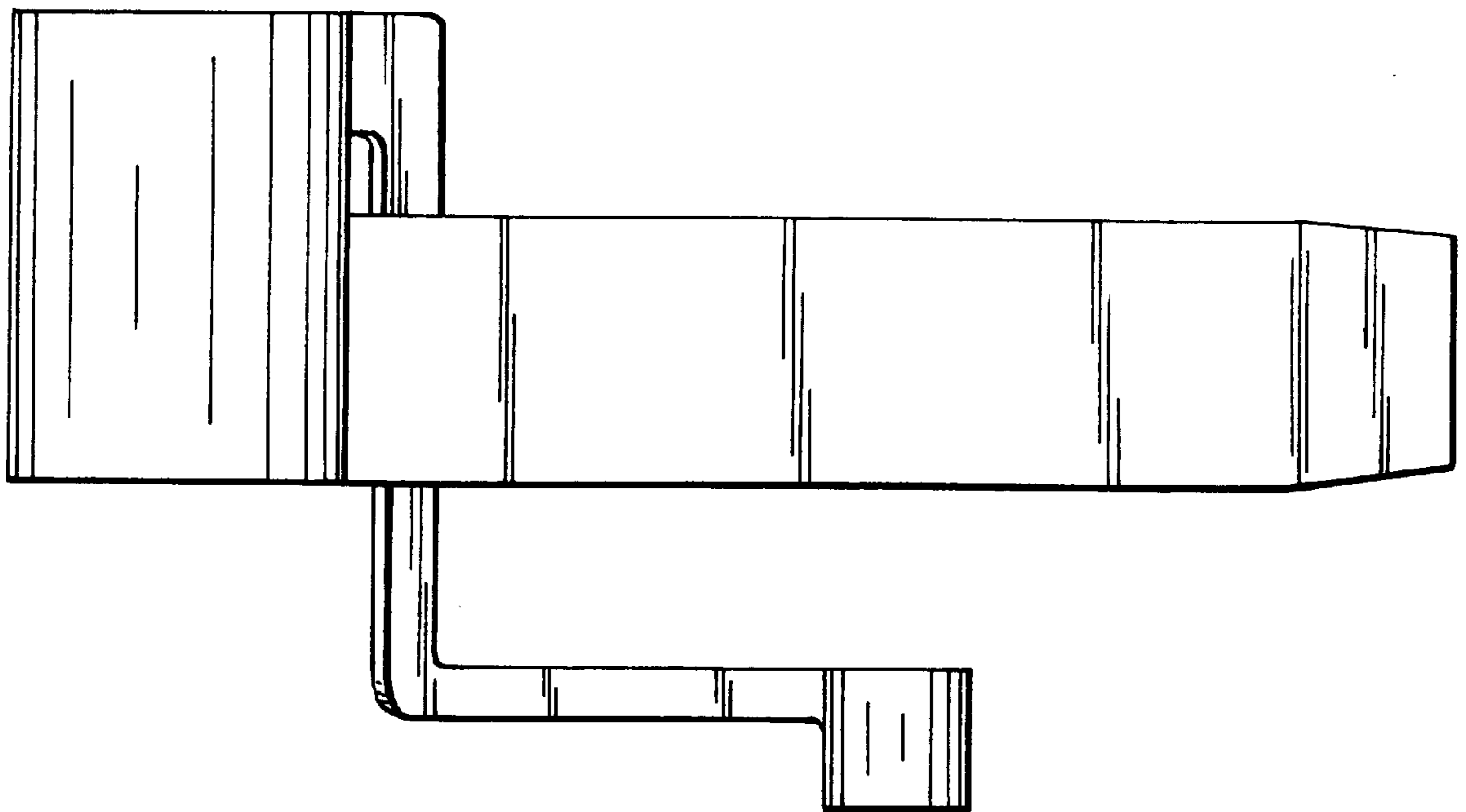

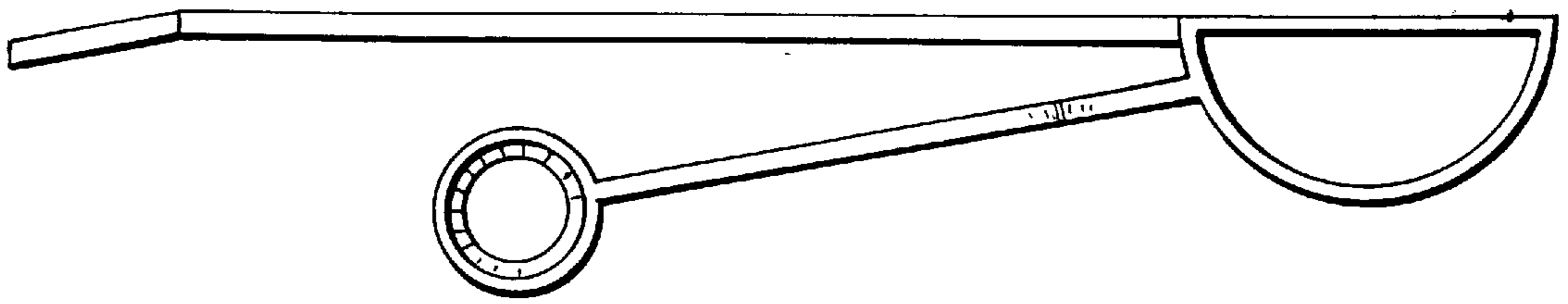

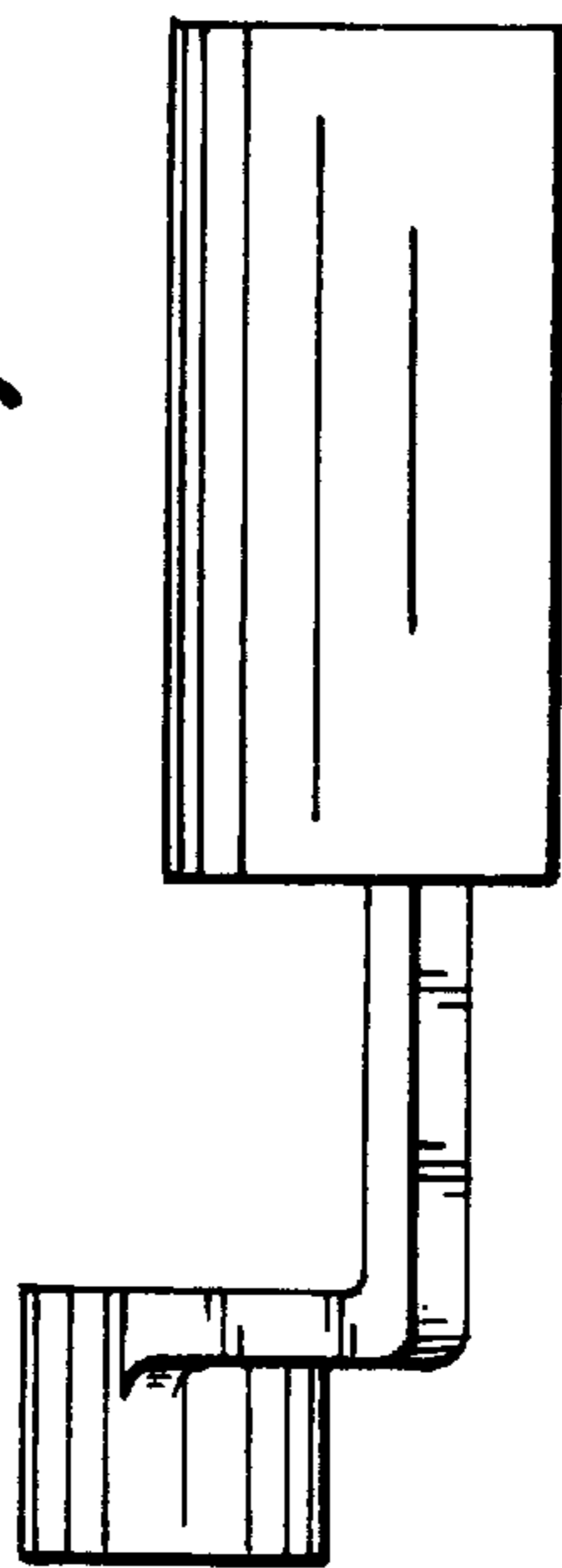
