DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of one embodiment of a chair taken from above and from the left side showing the design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 1, but showing a second embodiment of the design;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a front elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a top view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 12 is a left side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 13 is a perspective view similar to FIG. 1, but showing a third embodiment of the design;

FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 13;

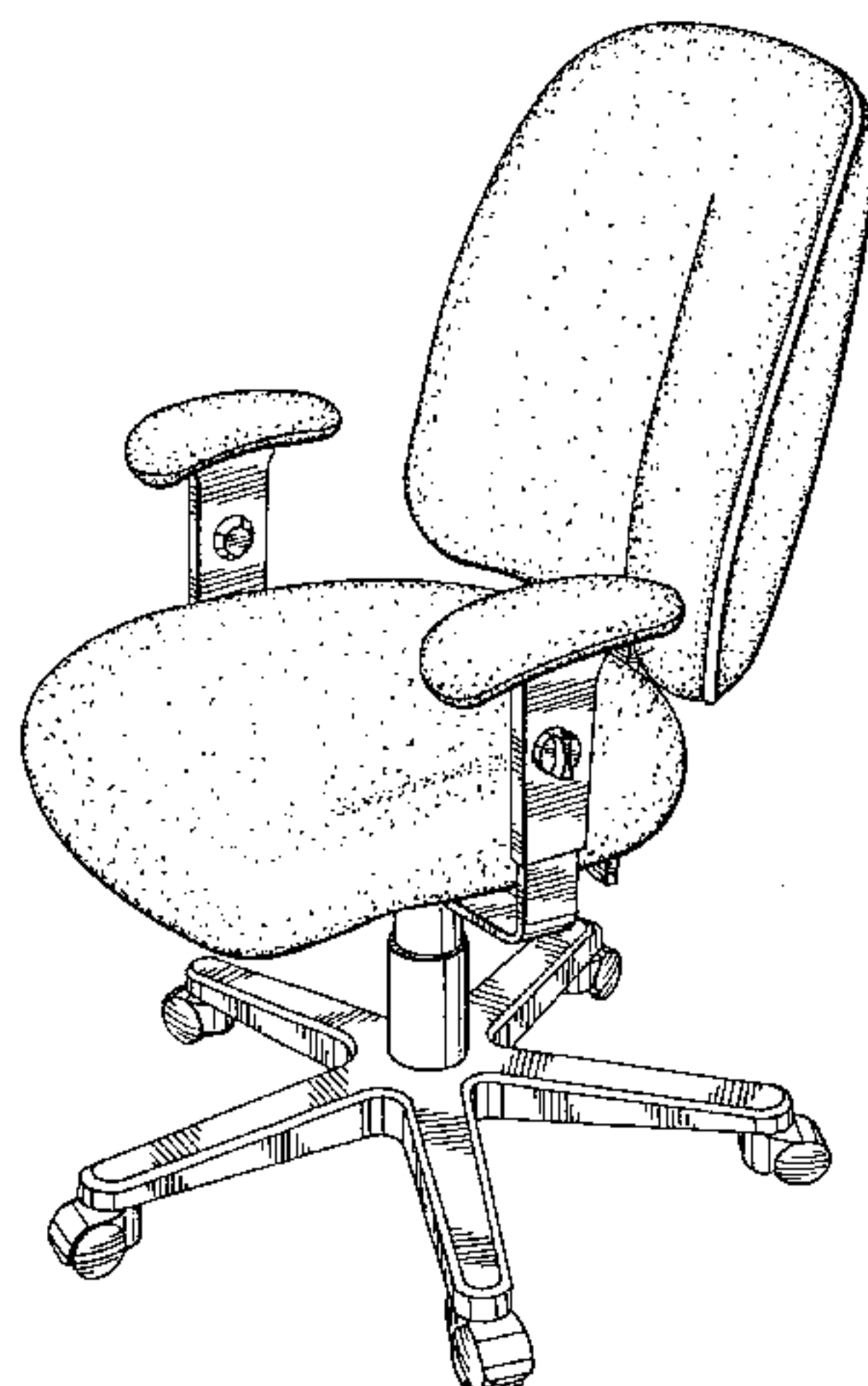
FIG. 15 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 13;

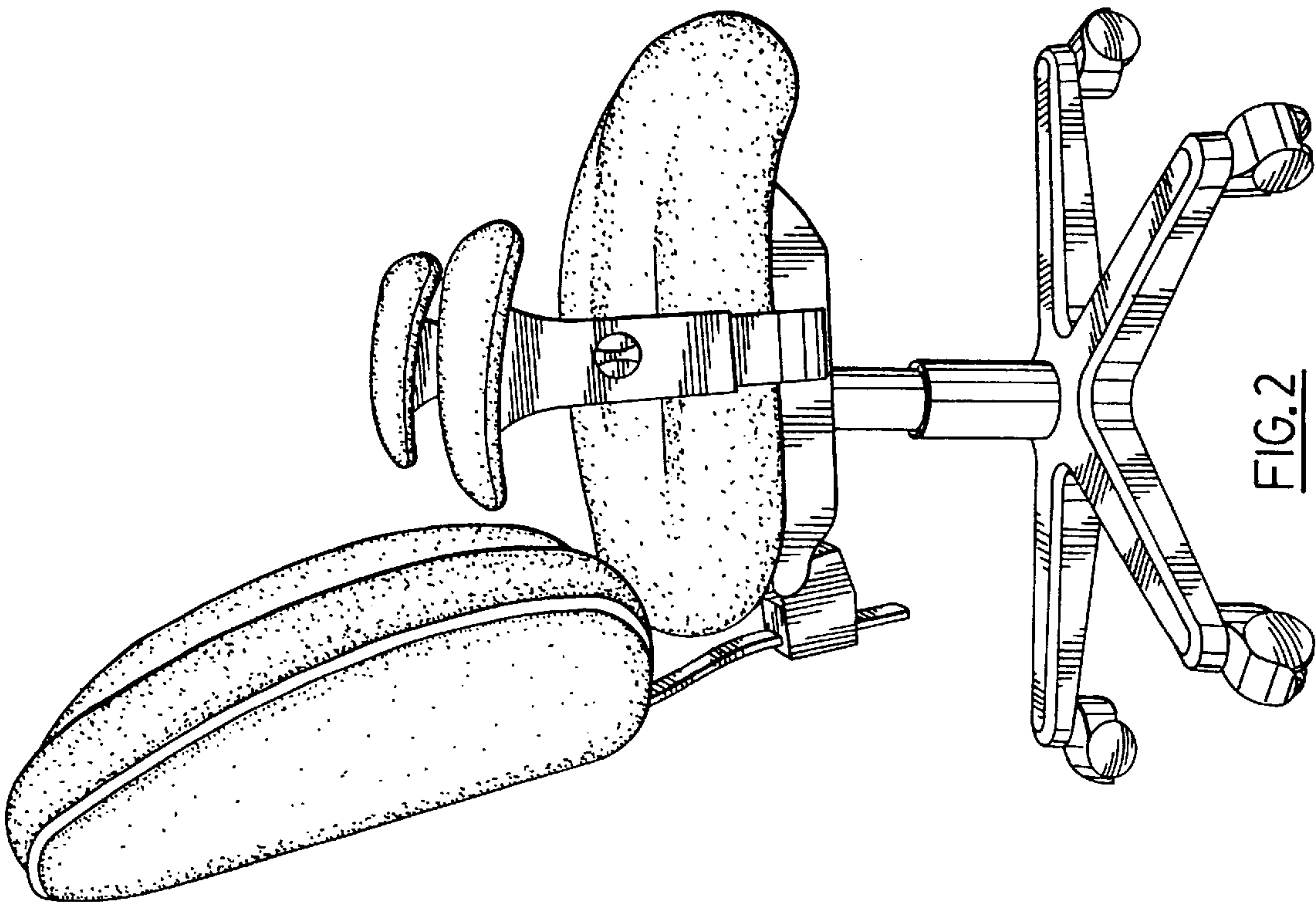

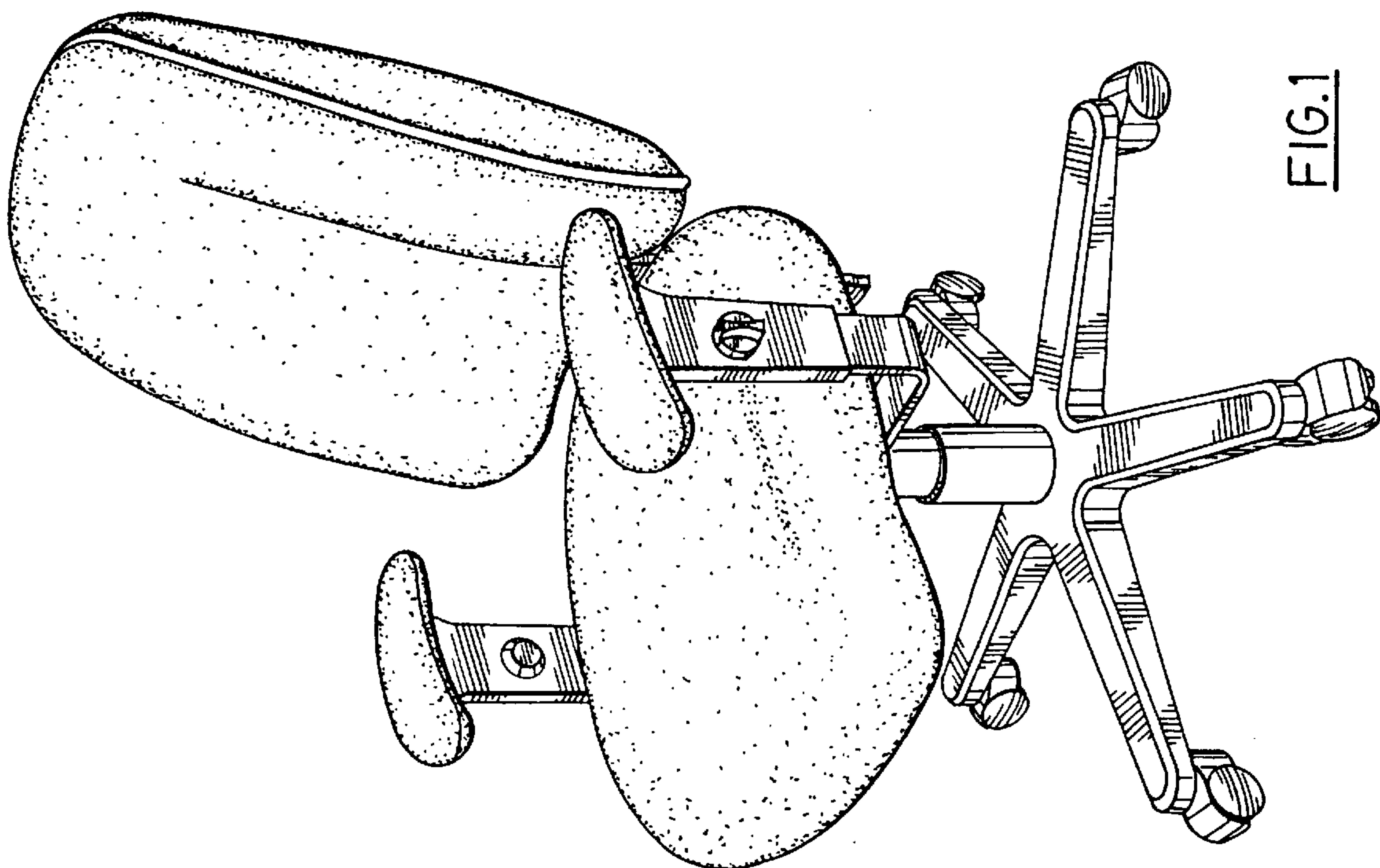
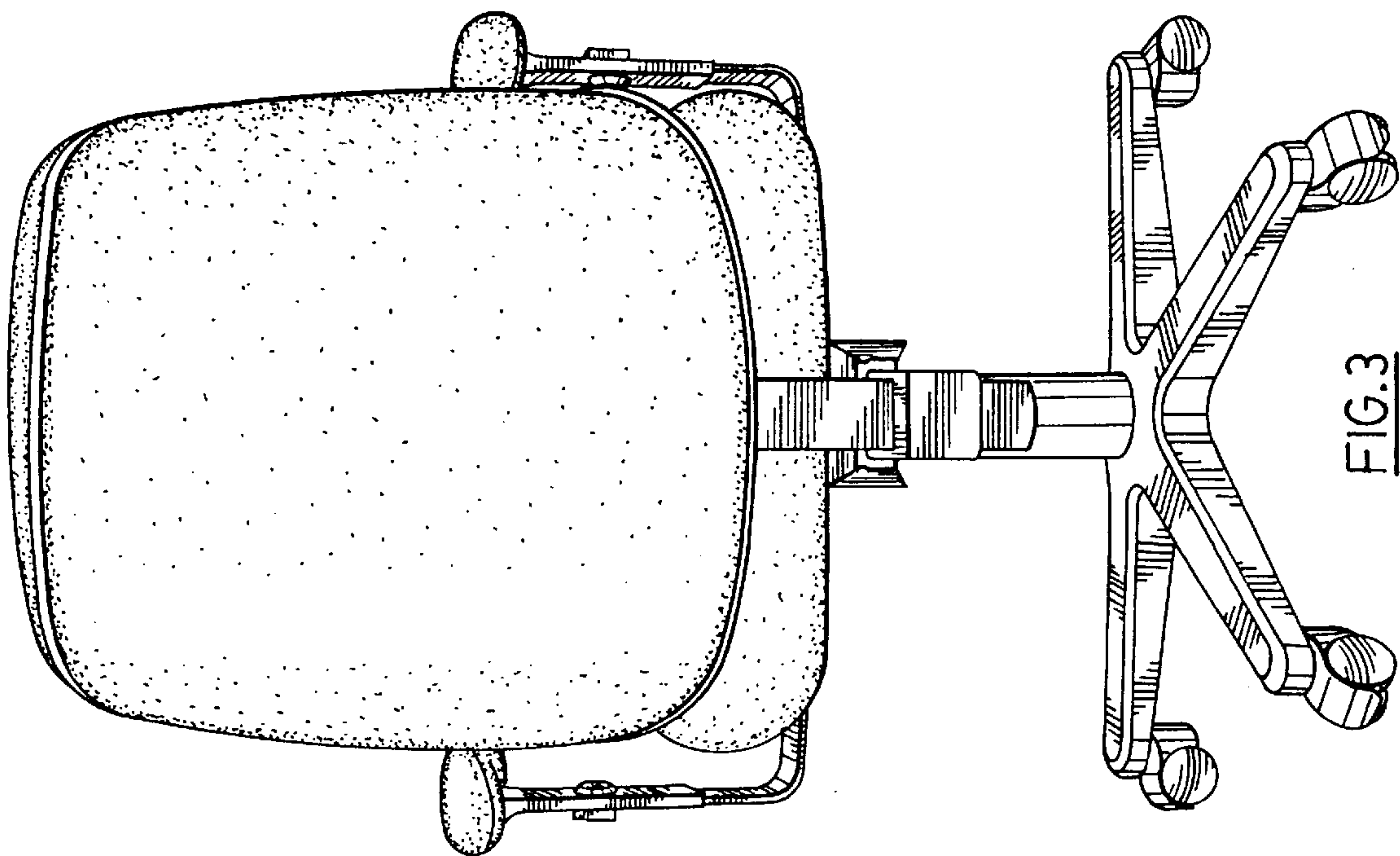
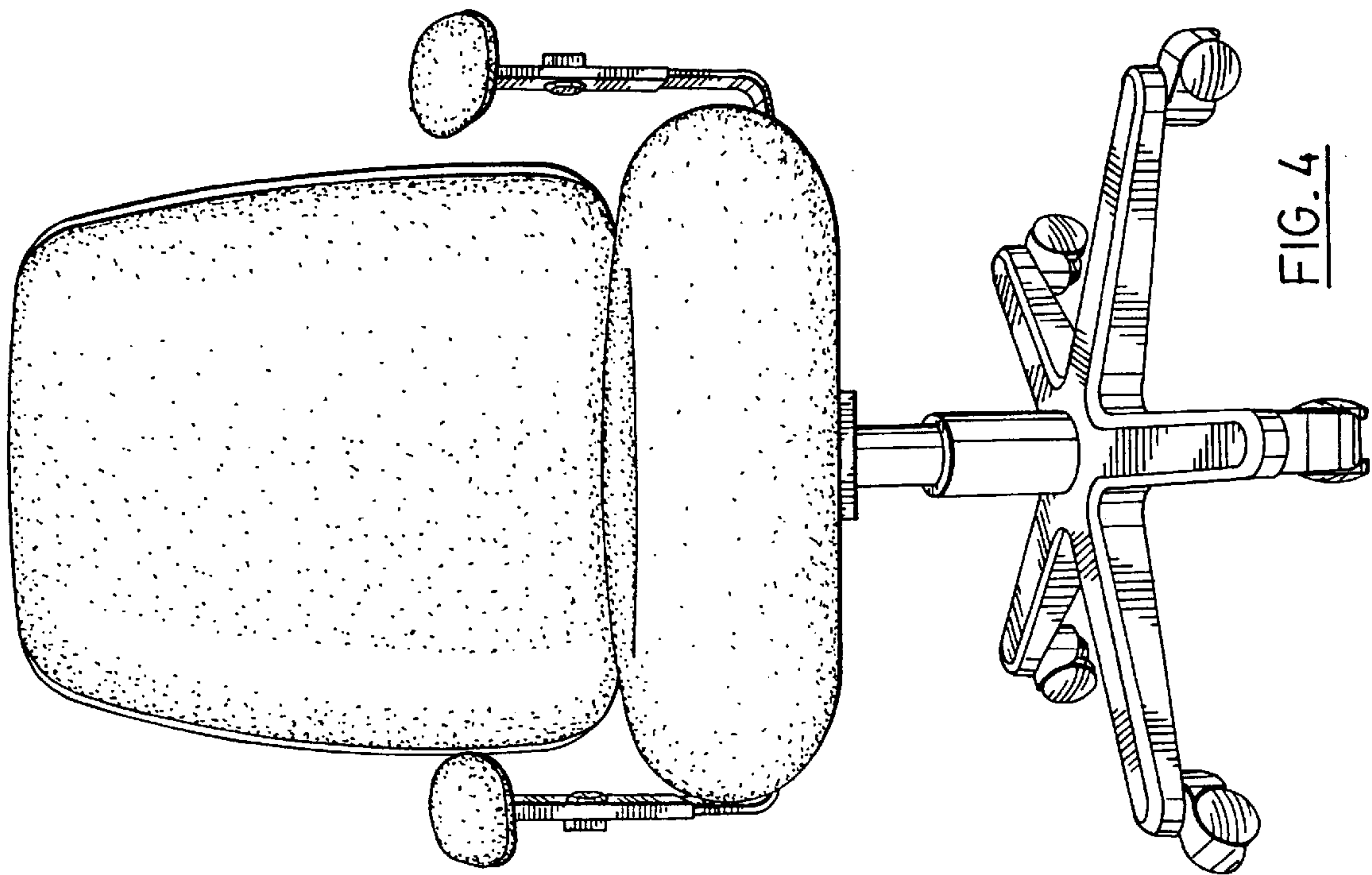
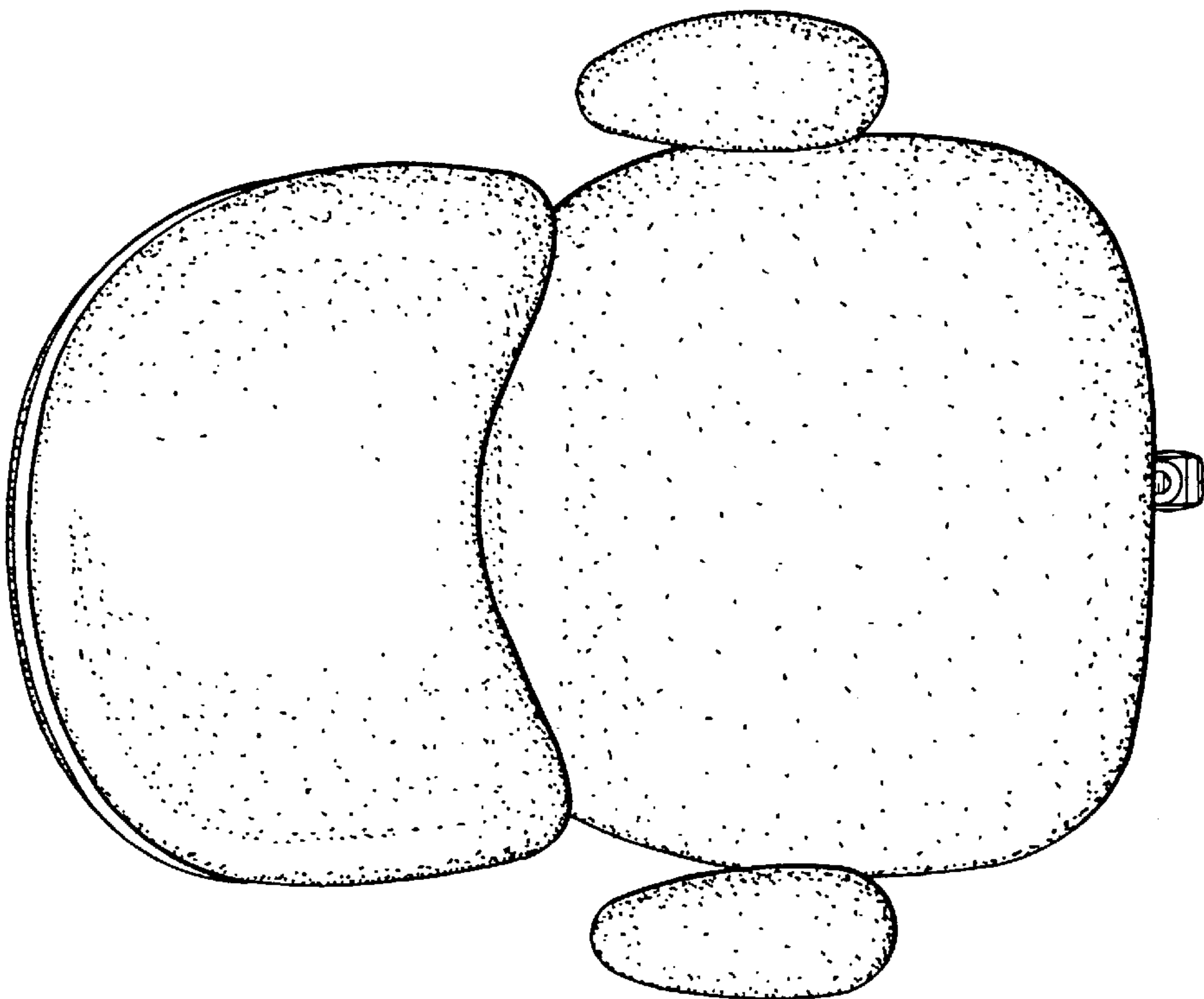
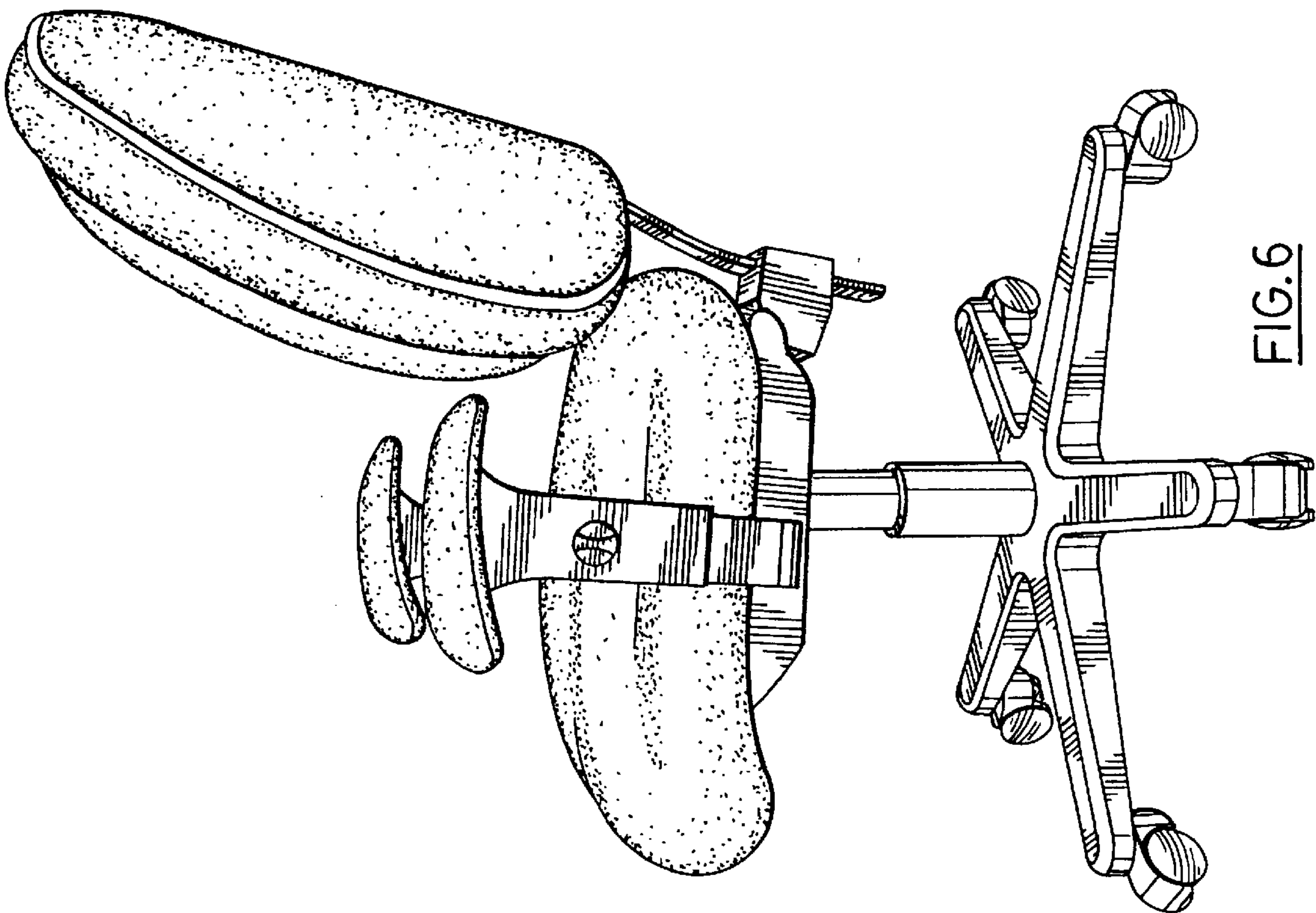

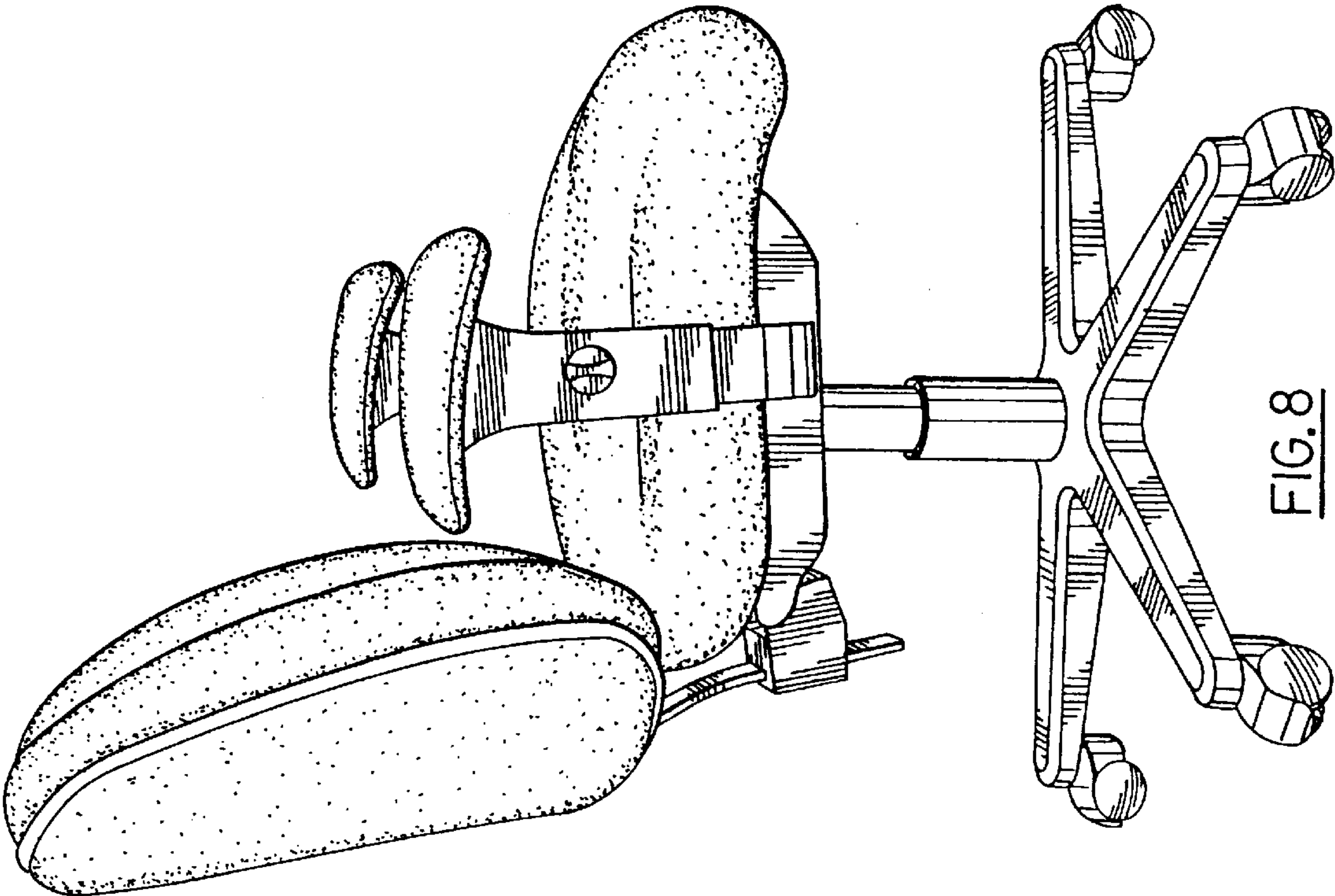

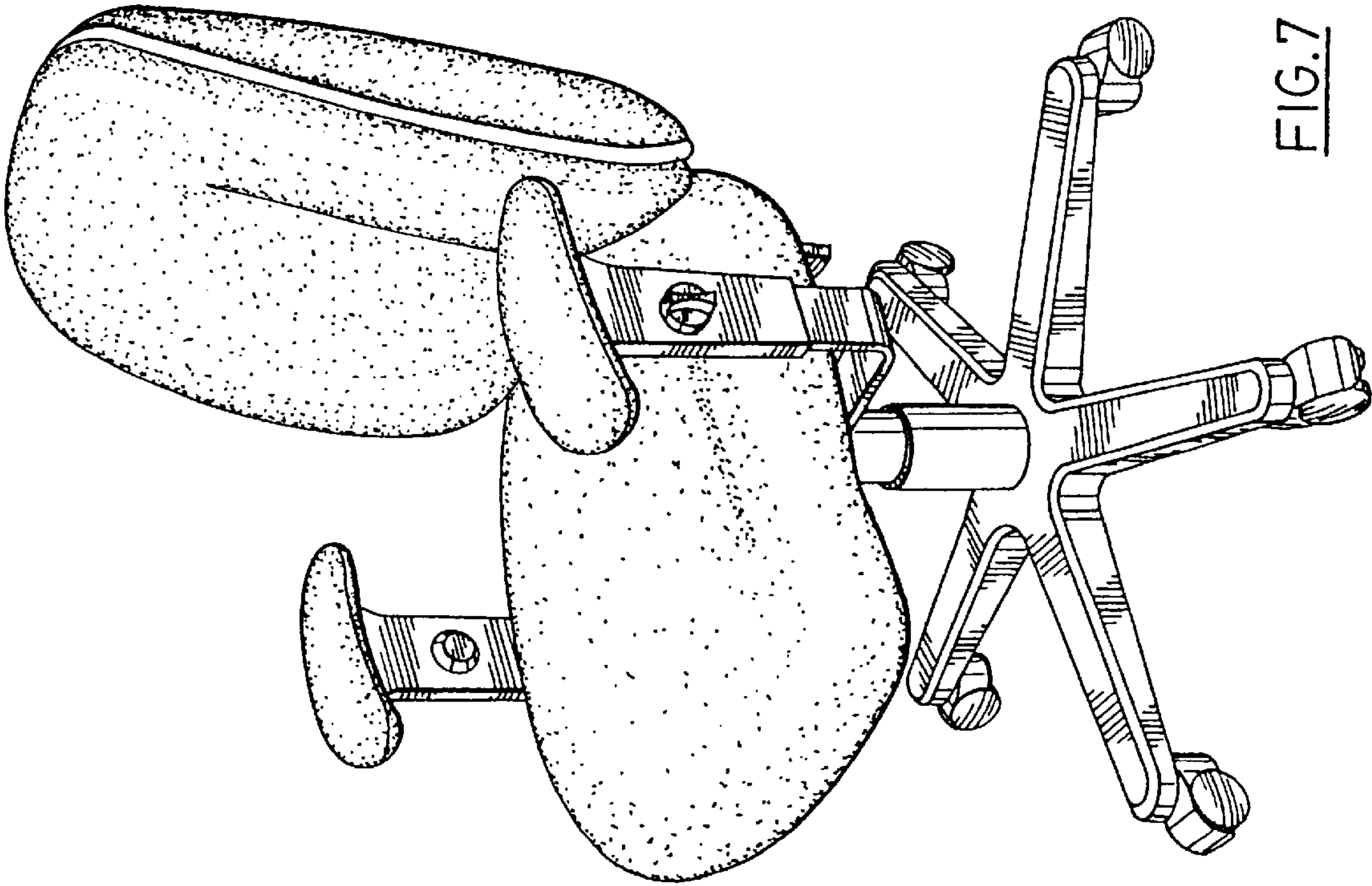
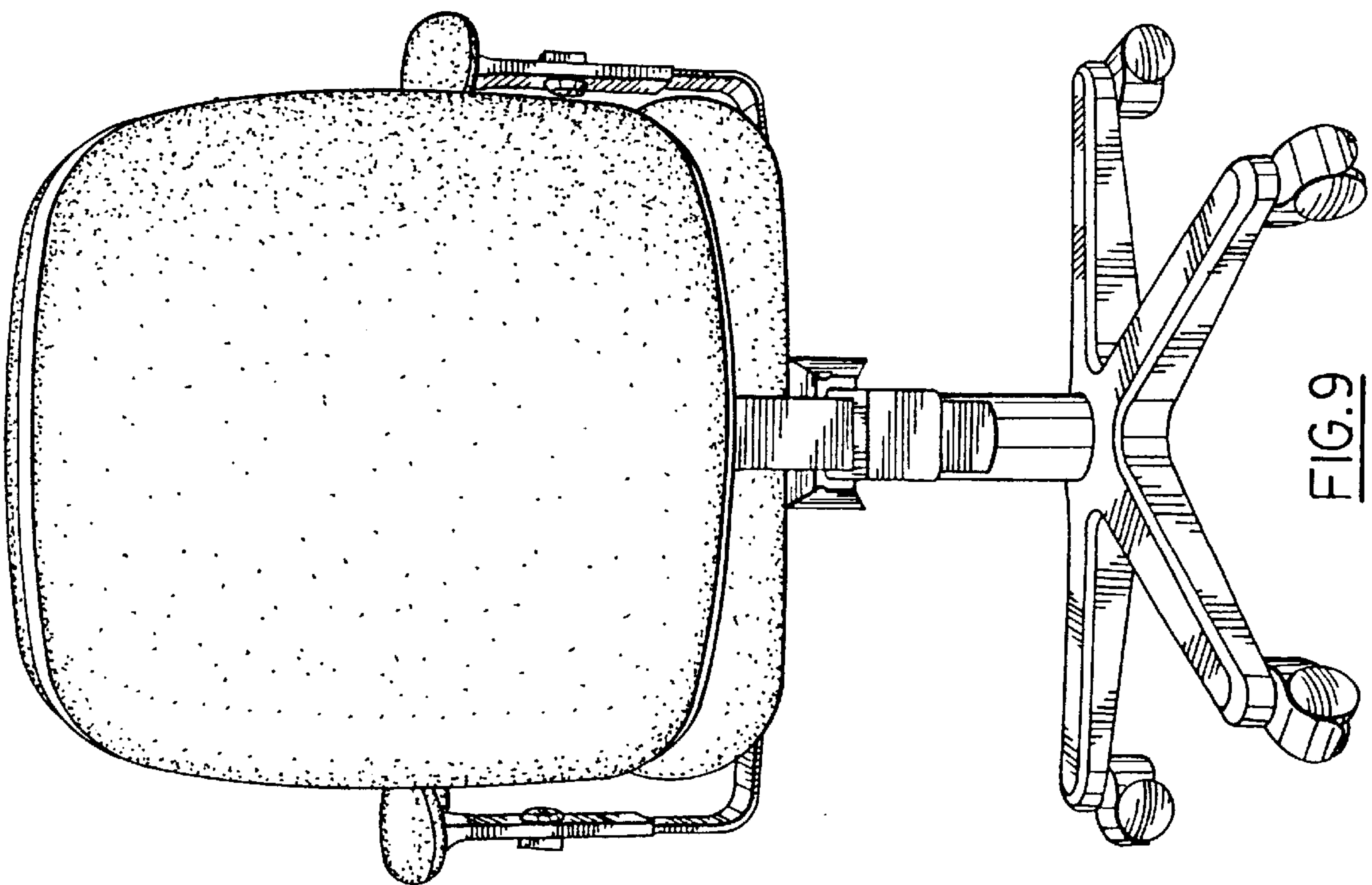
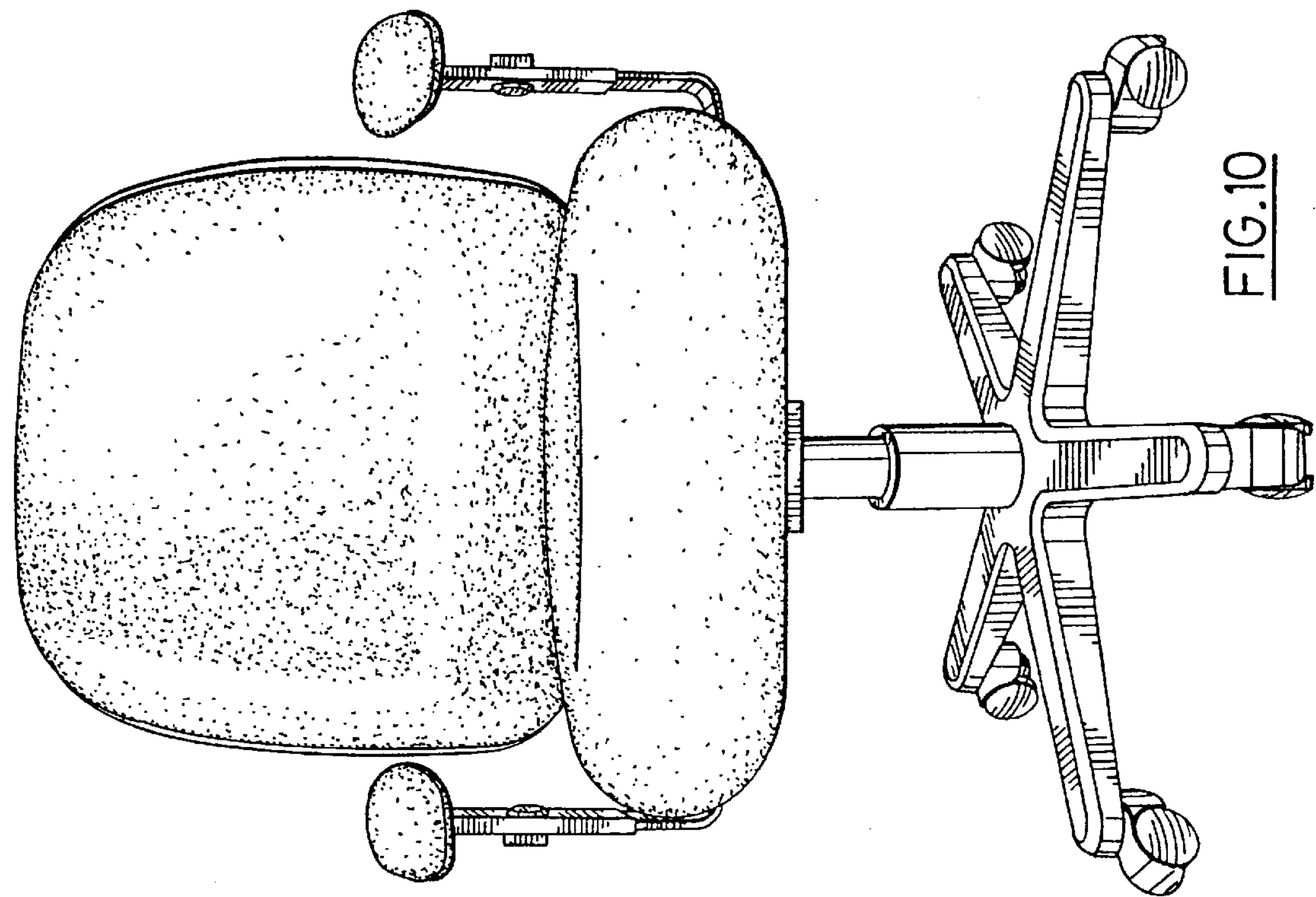

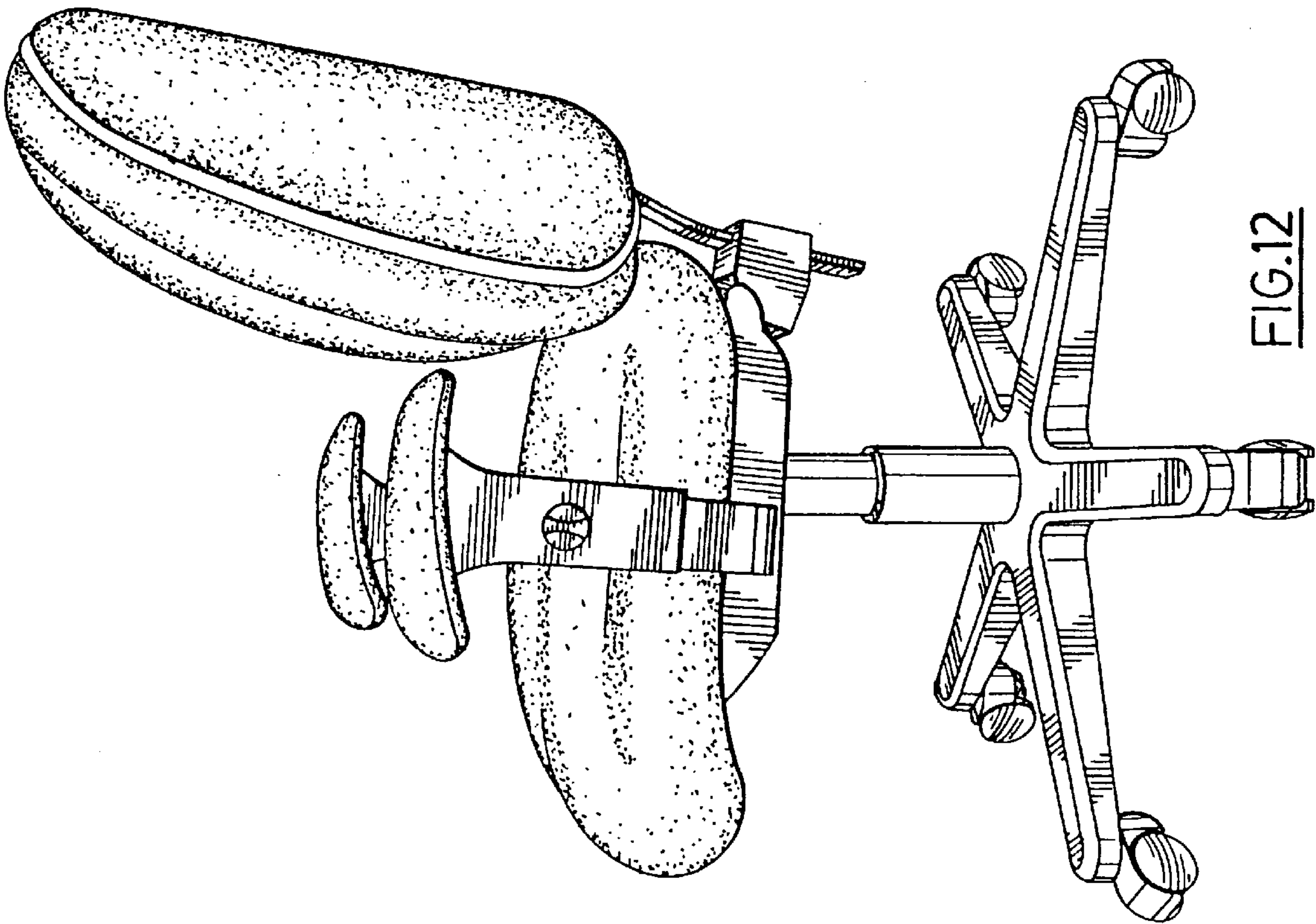

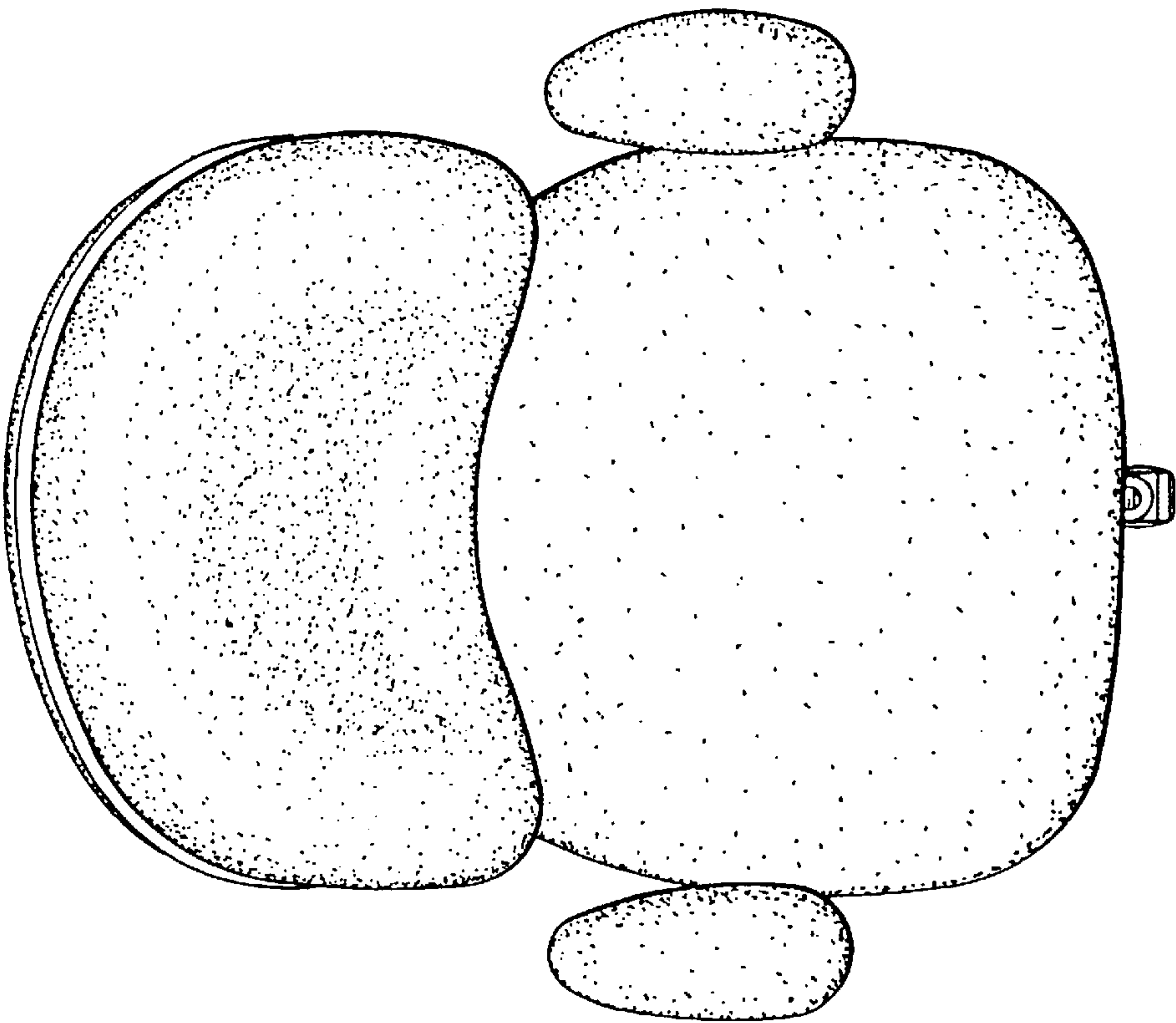

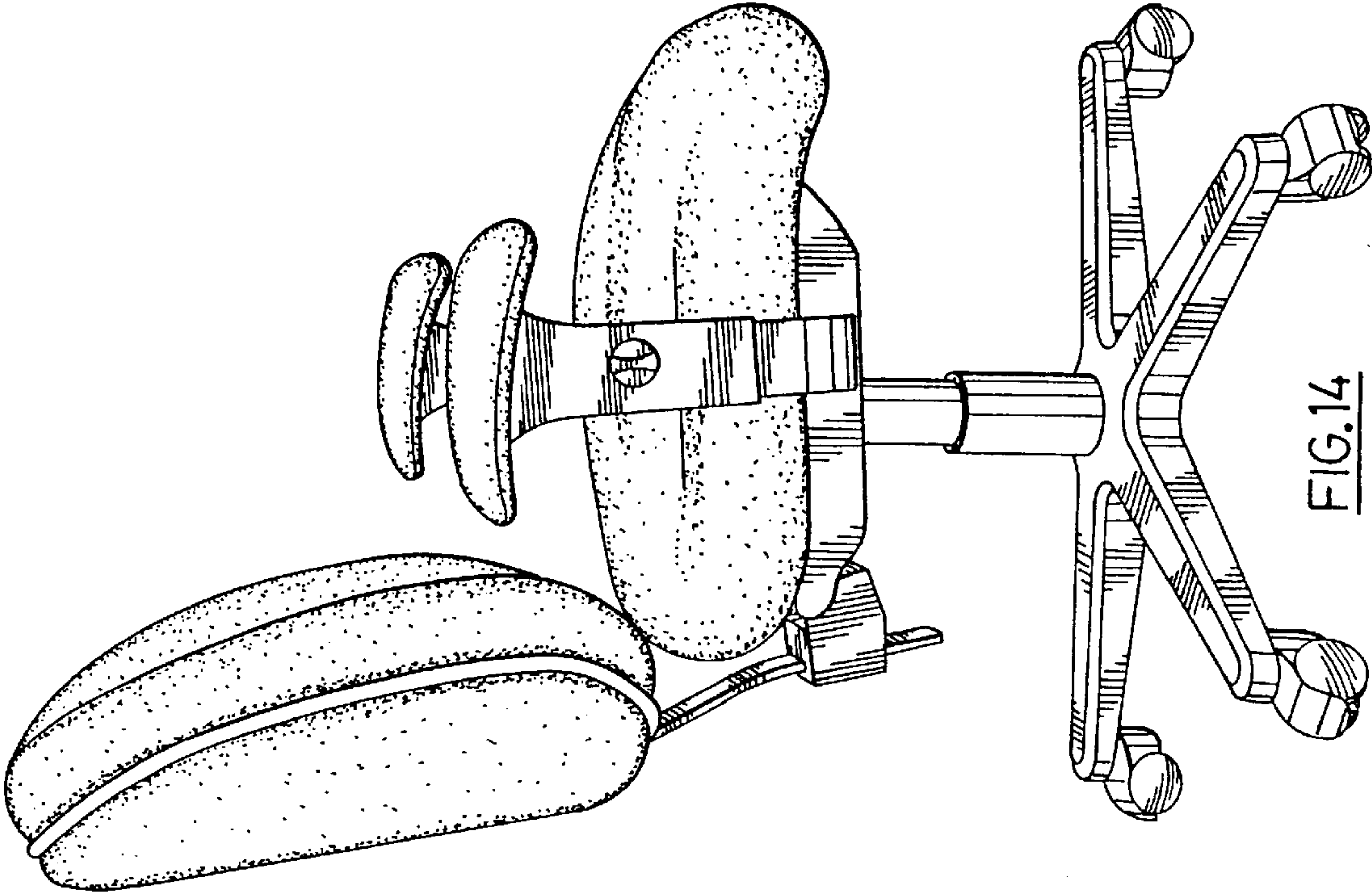

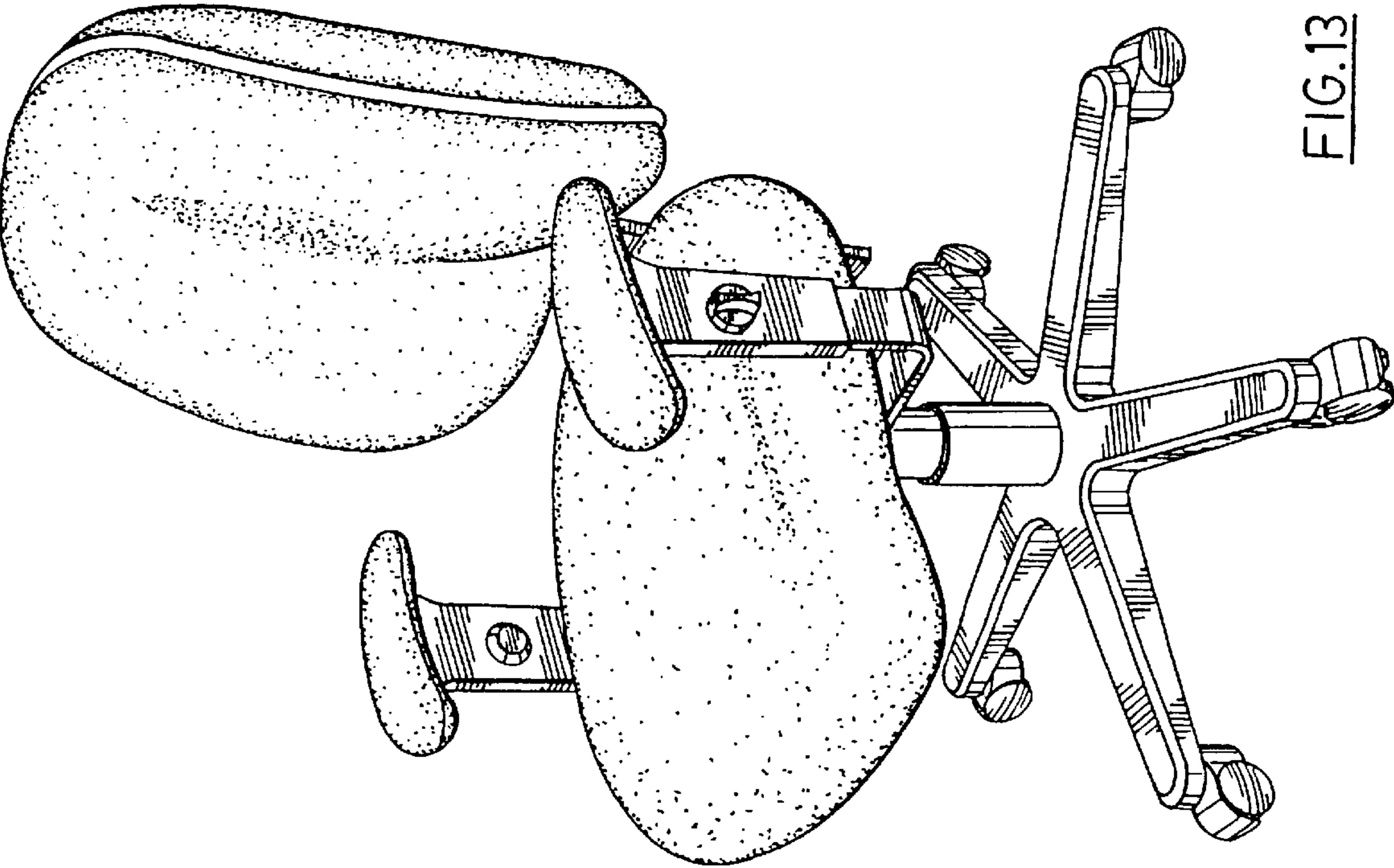

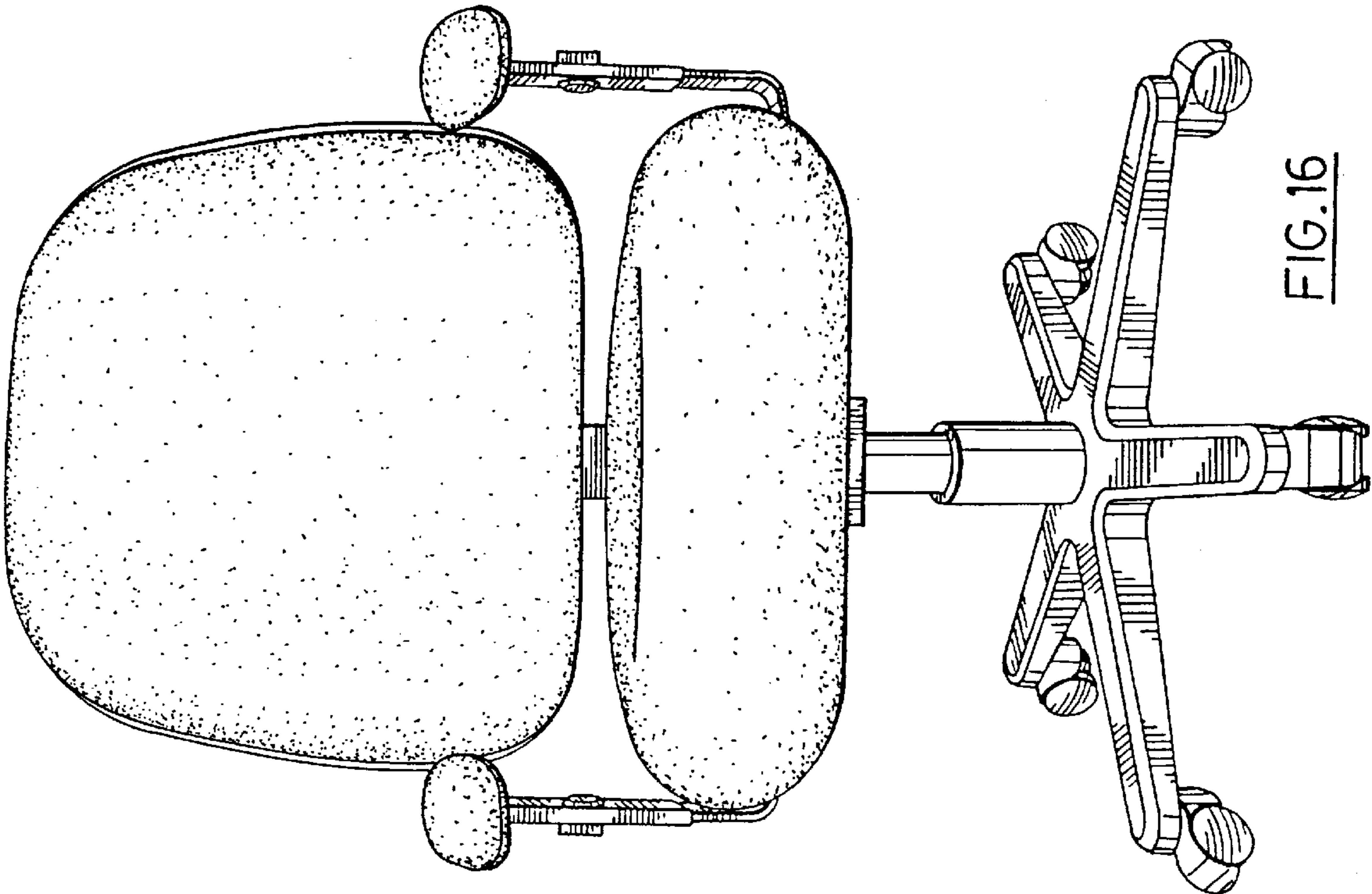

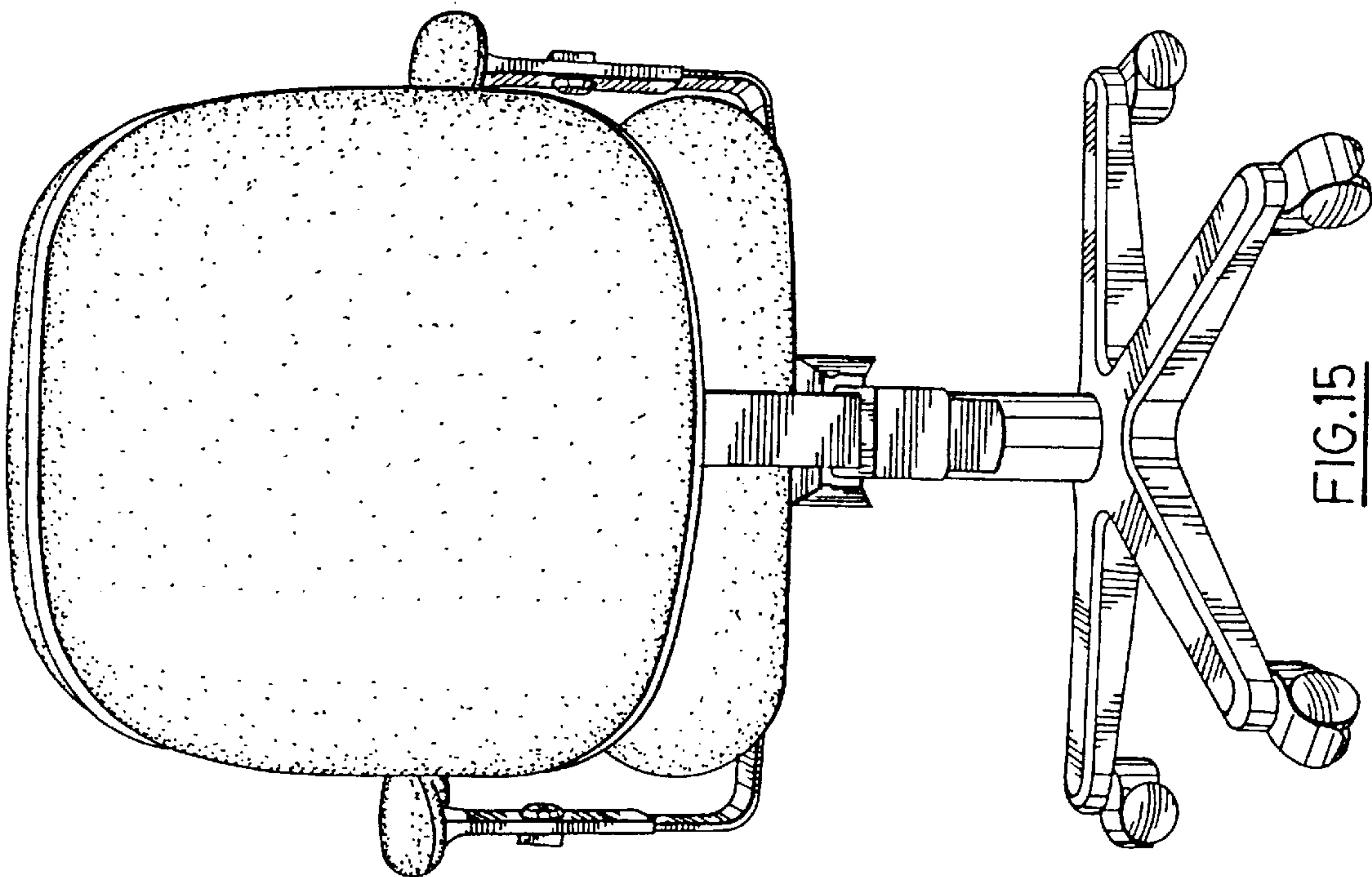
