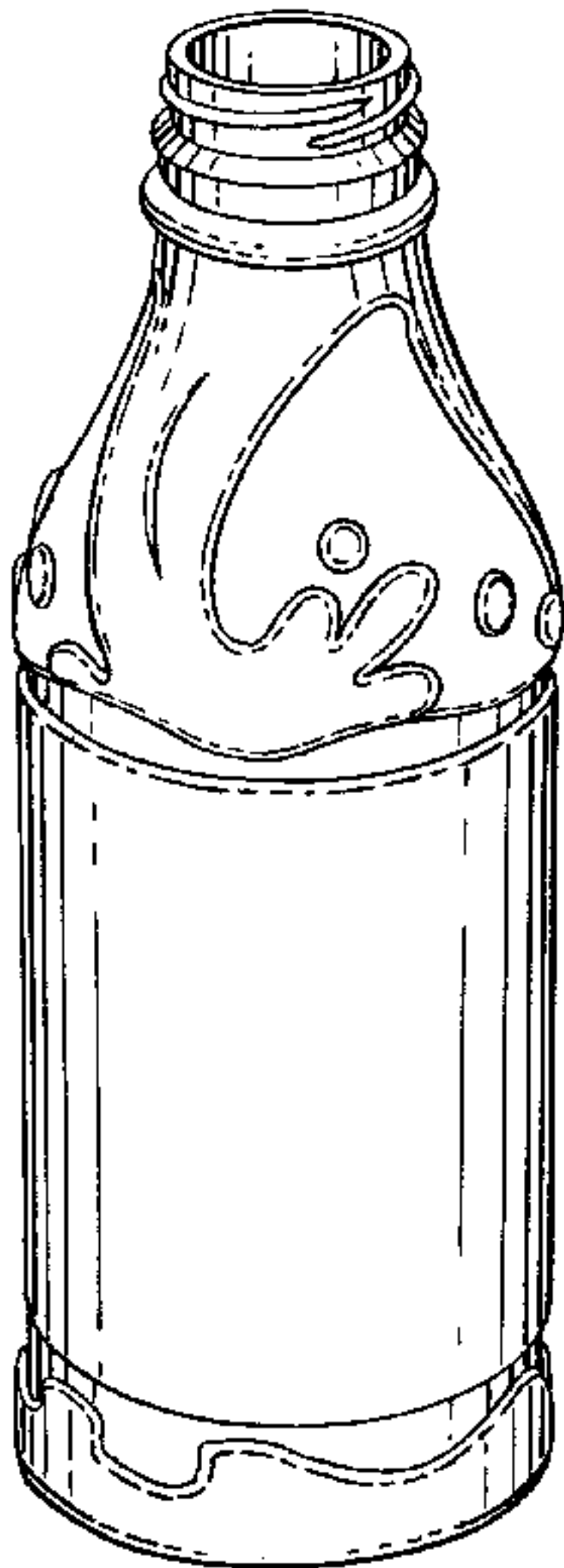
The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 3 is an elevation thereof as seen from the right of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 5 is an elevation thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 2;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a first variant thereof;
FIG. 8 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 9 is an elevation thereof as seen from the right of FIG. 8;
FIG. 10 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 11 is an elevation thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 8;
FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 13 is a perspective view of a second variant thereof;
FIG. 14 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 15 is an elevation thereof as seen from the right of FIG. 14;
FIG. 16 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 17 is an elevation thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 14;
FIG. 18 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 19 is a perspective view of a third variant thereof;
FIG. 20 is a front elevation thereof;
FIG. 21 is an elevation thereof as seen from the right of FIG.20;
FIG. 22 is a rear elevation thereof;
FIG. 23 is an elevation thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 20; and,
FIG. 24 is a top plan view thereof.
The bottom of the bottle in each embodiment is flat and unornamented.

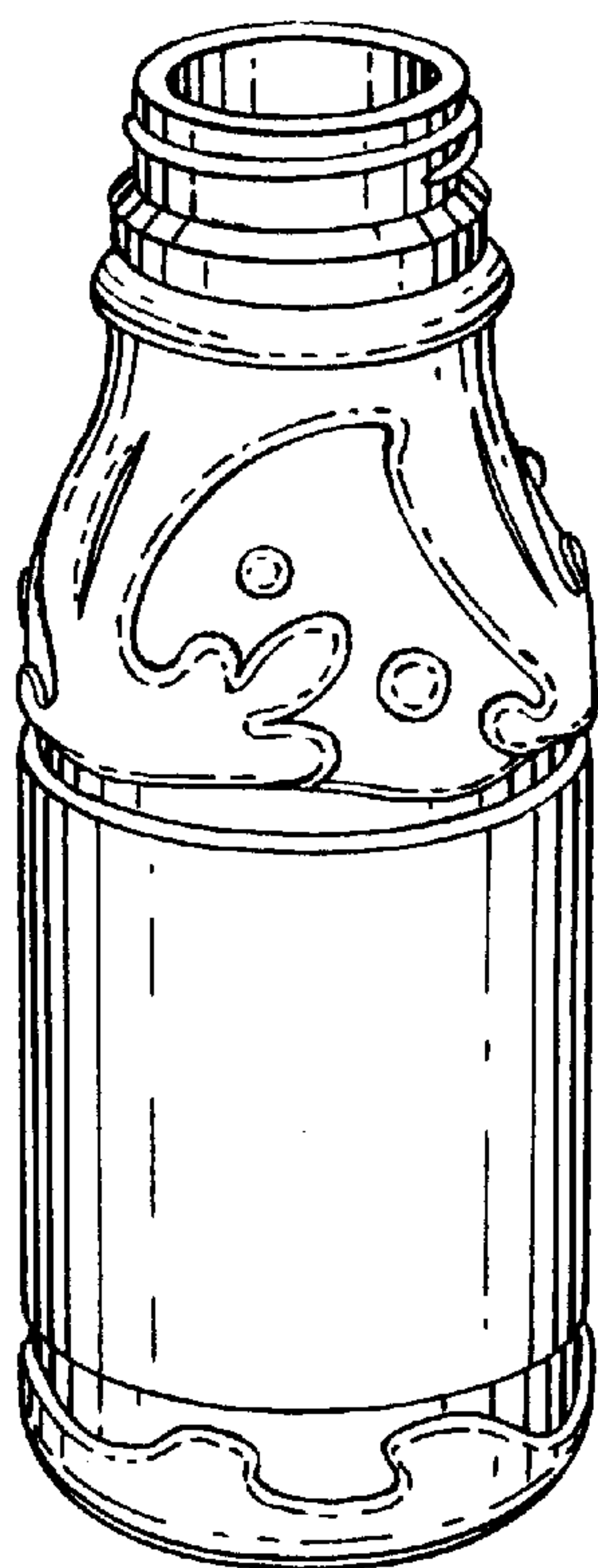

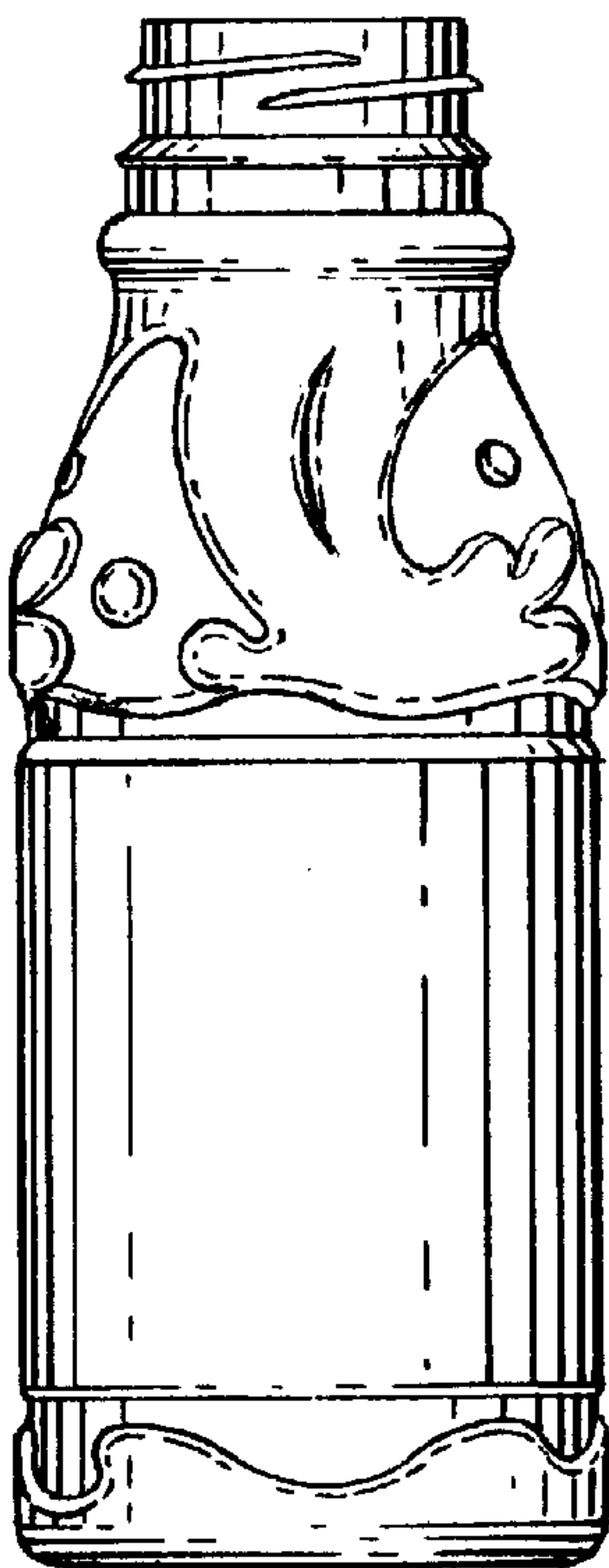

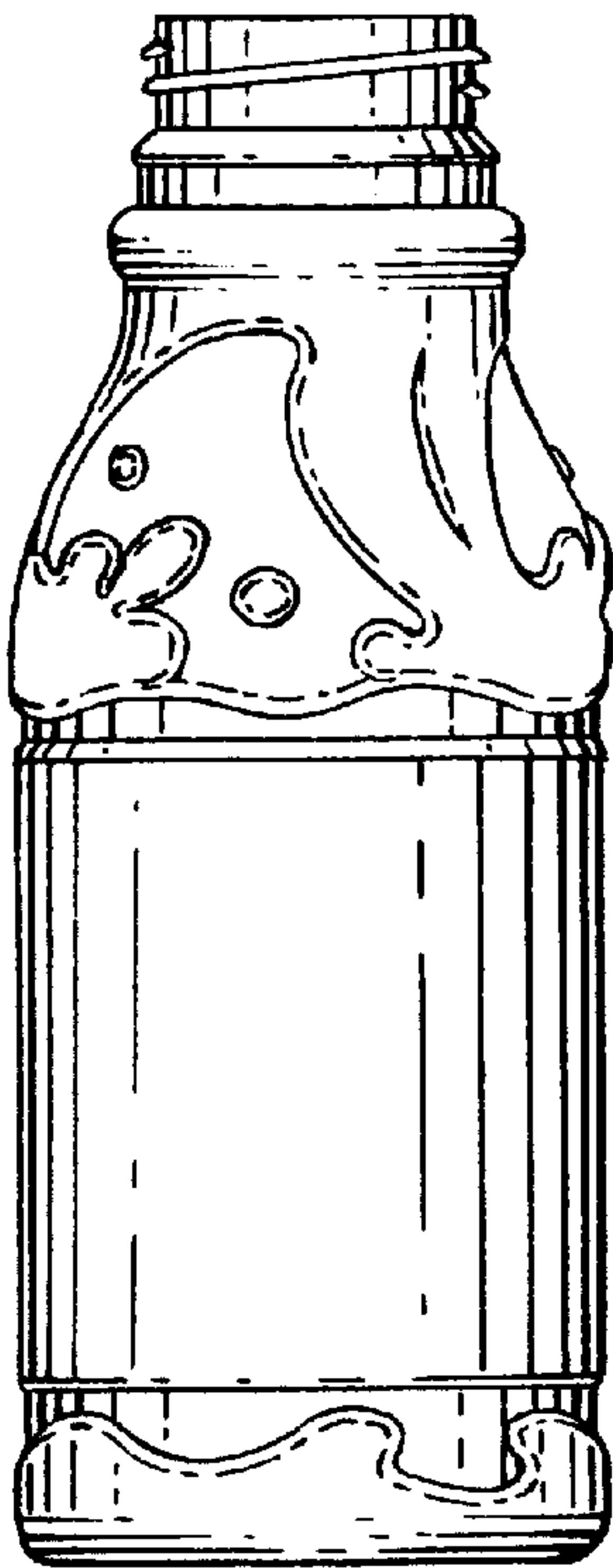

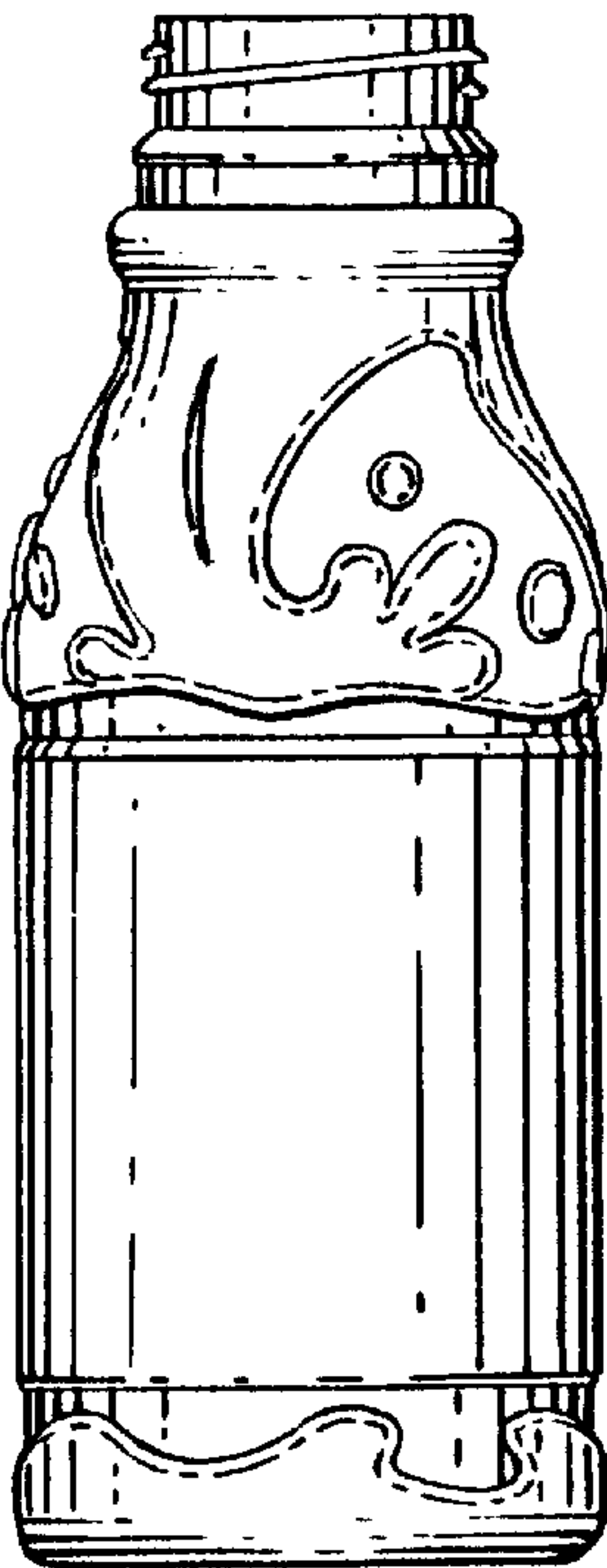

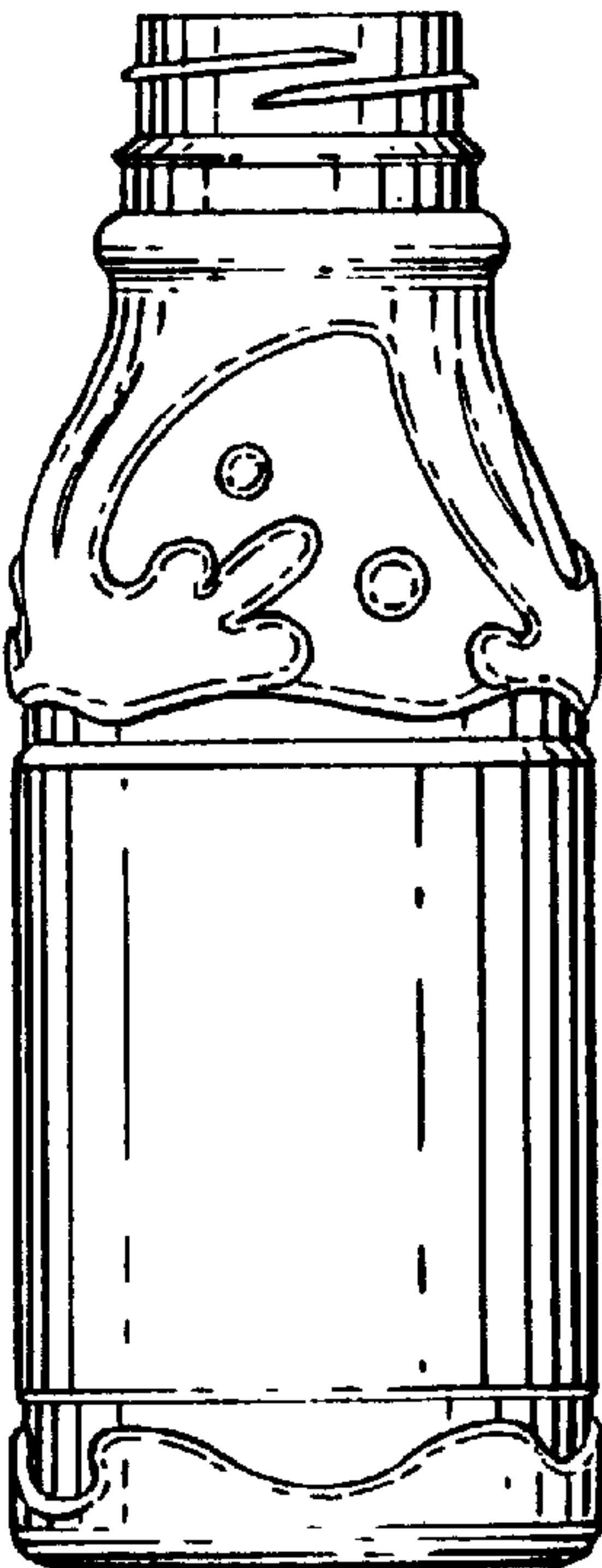

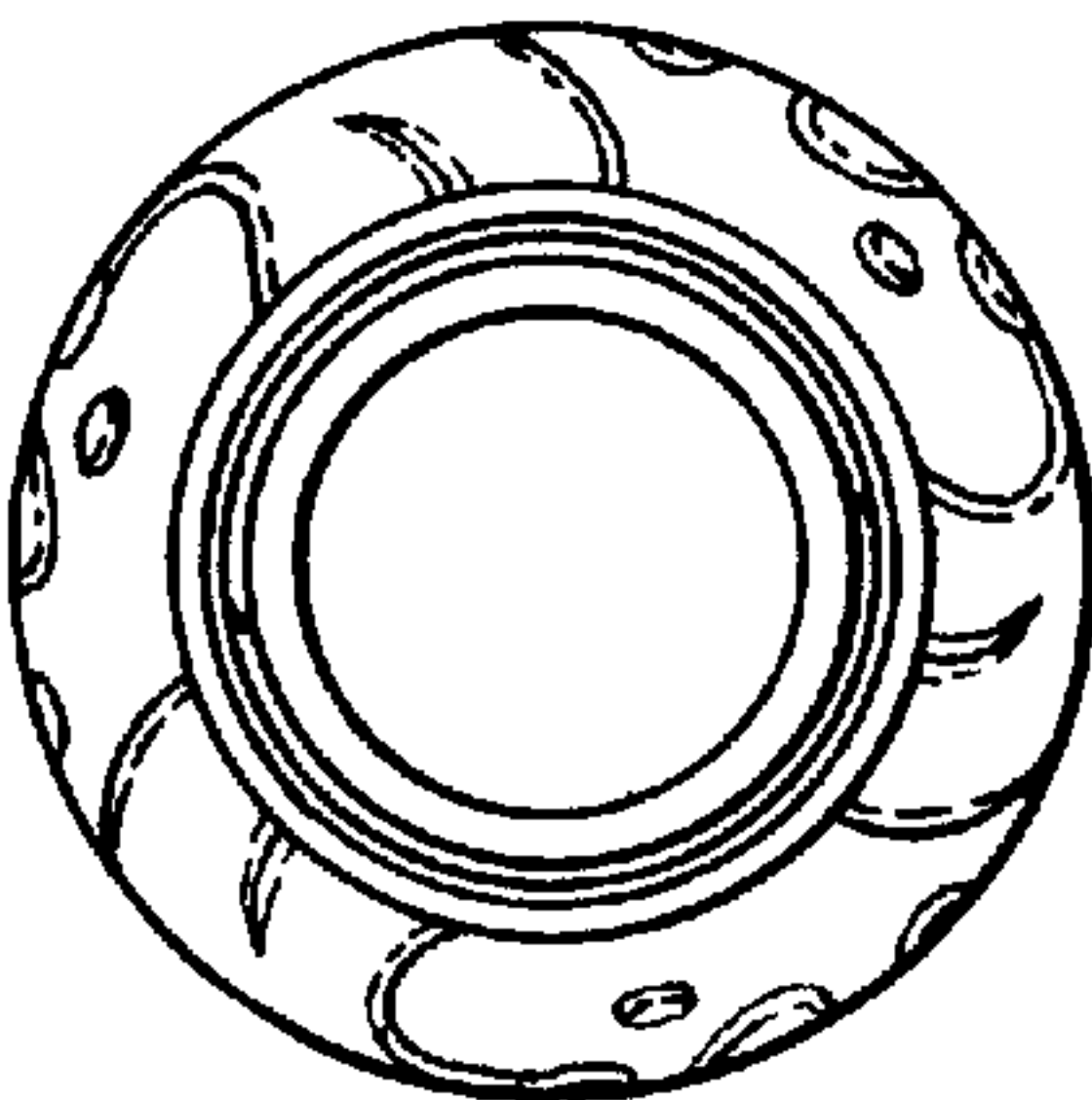

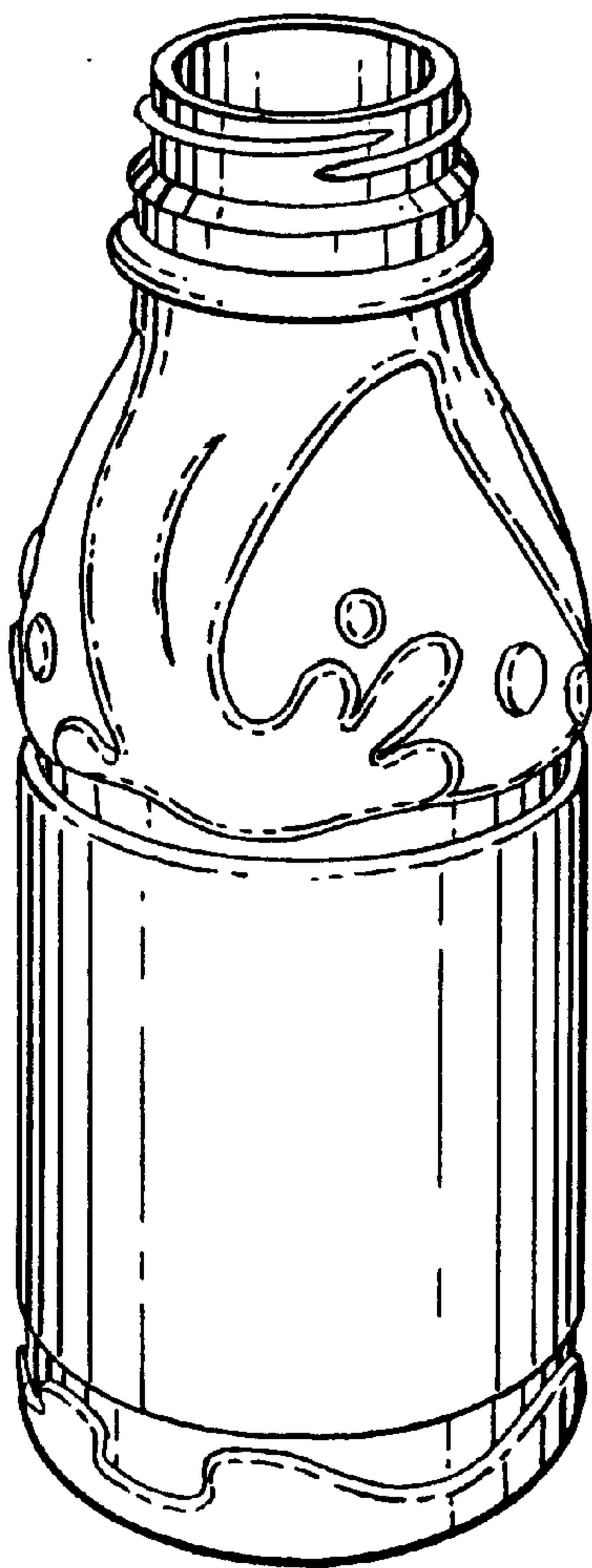

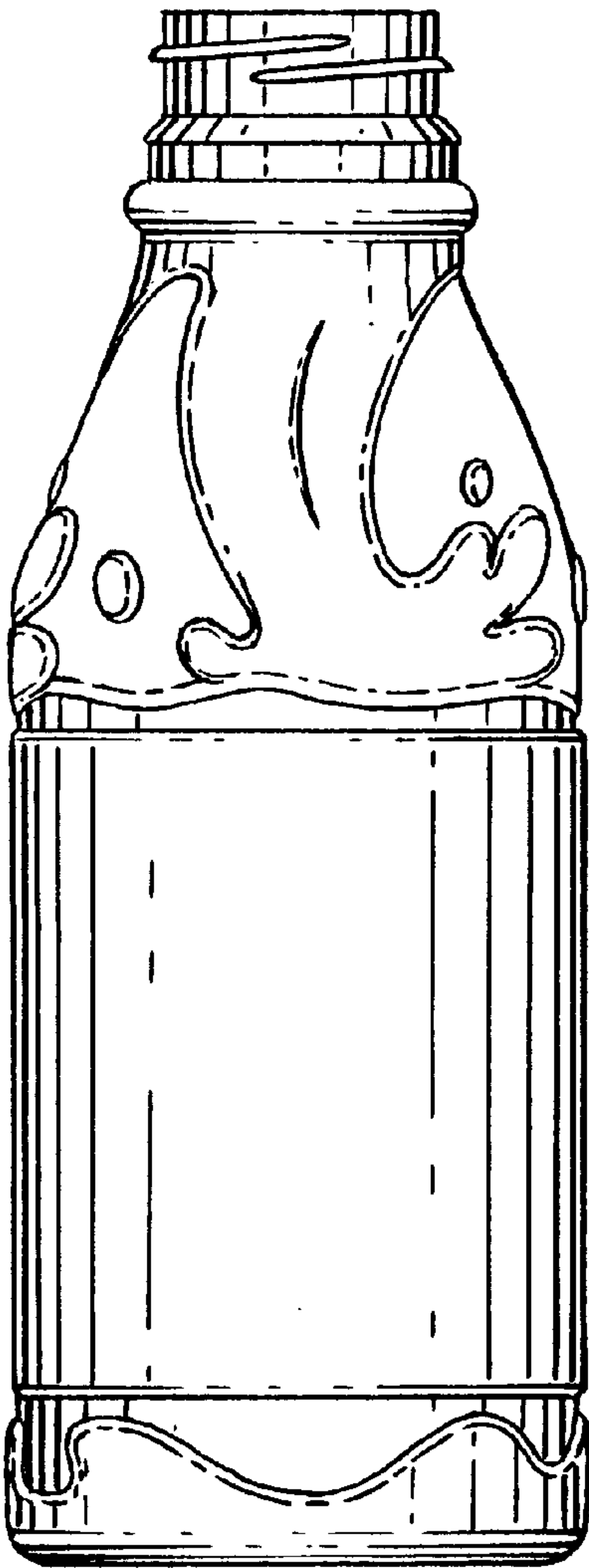

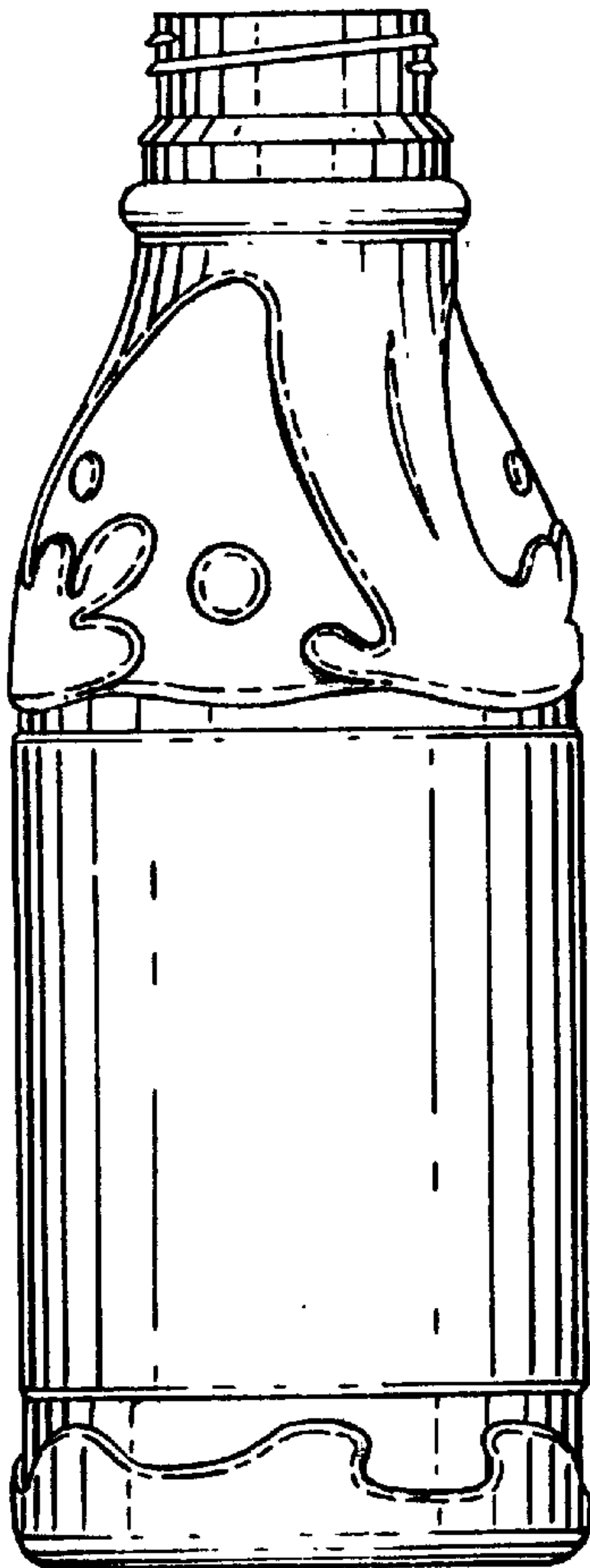

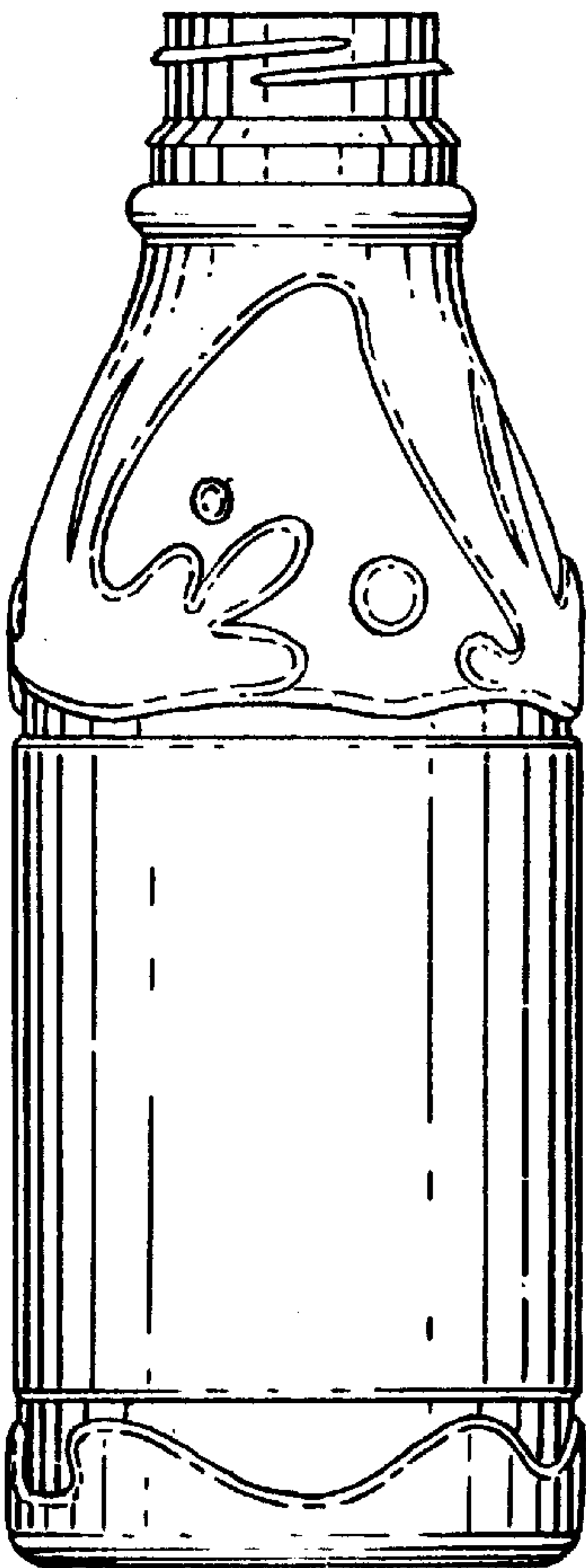

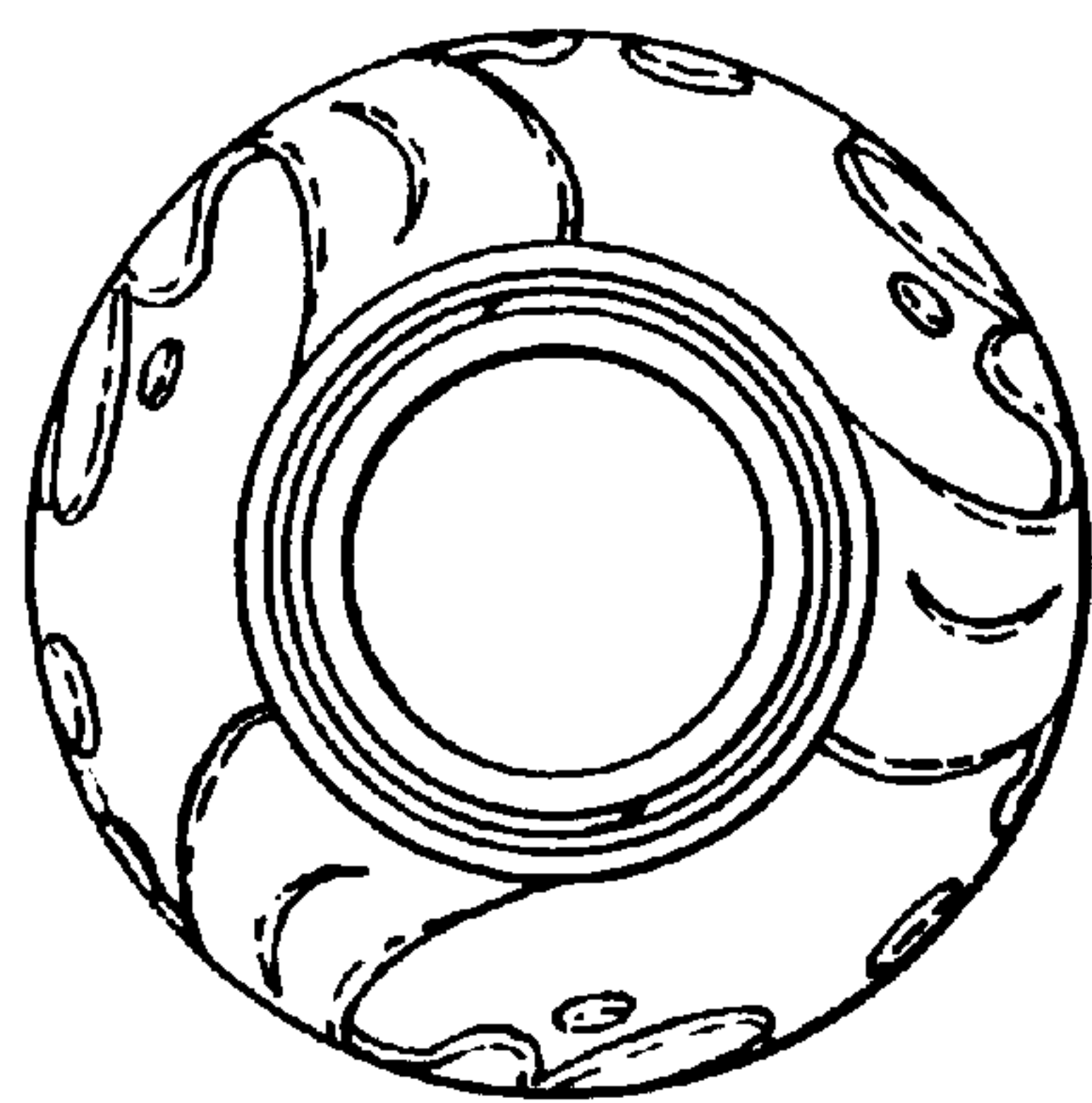

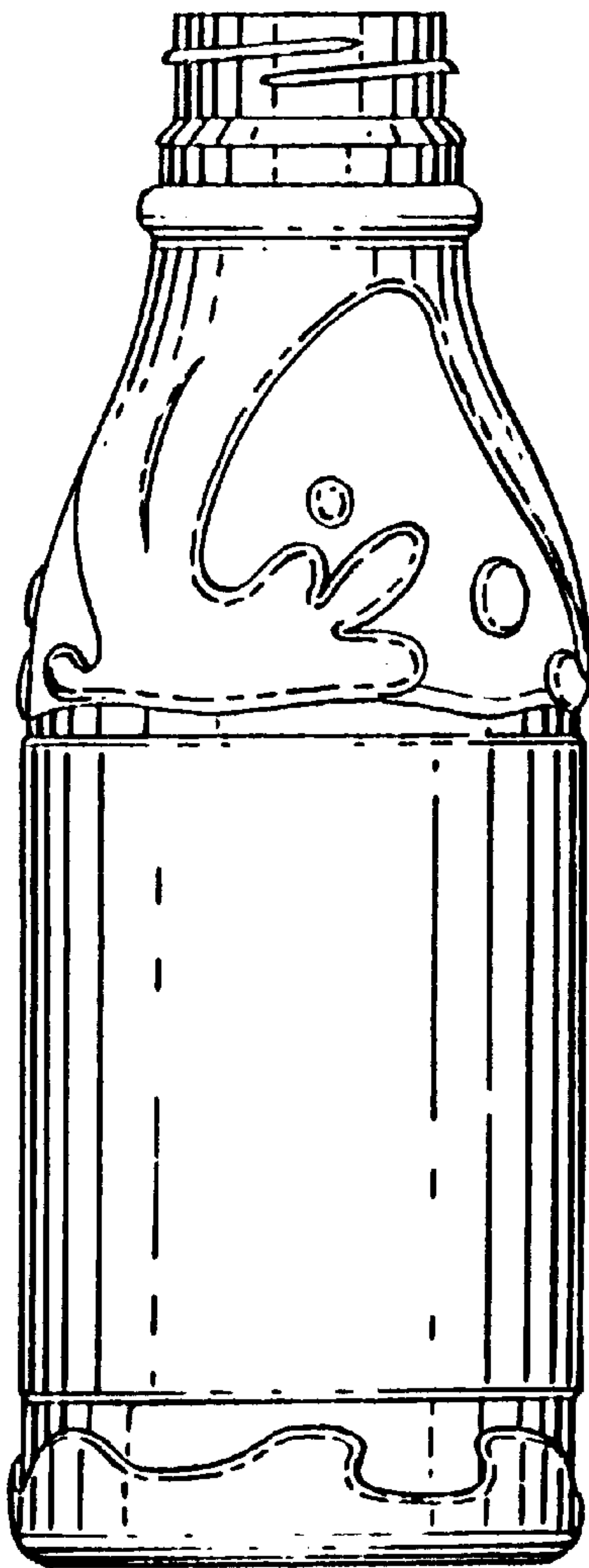

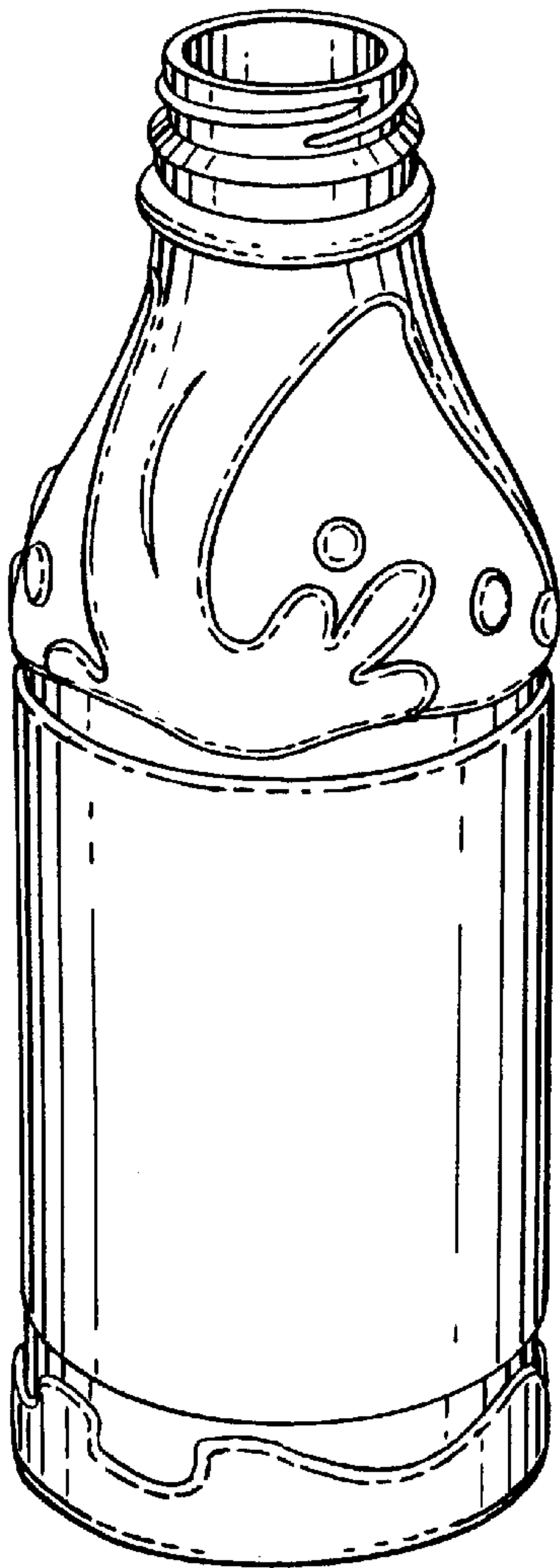

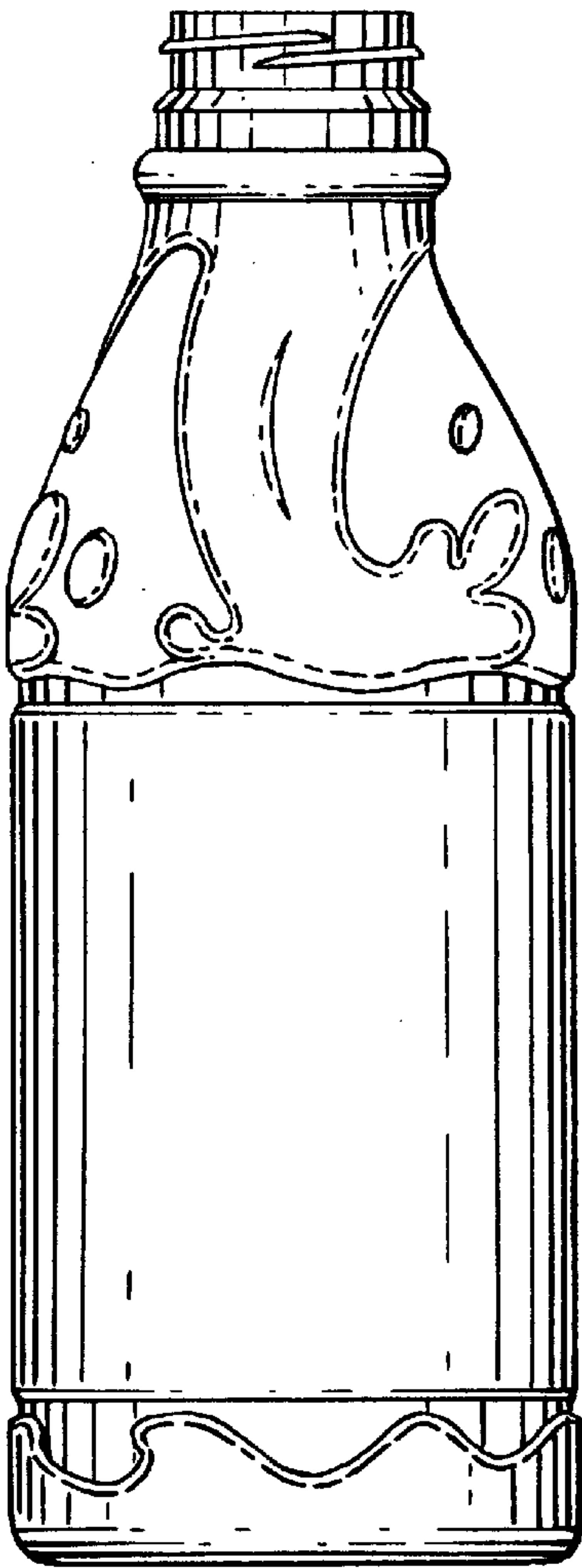

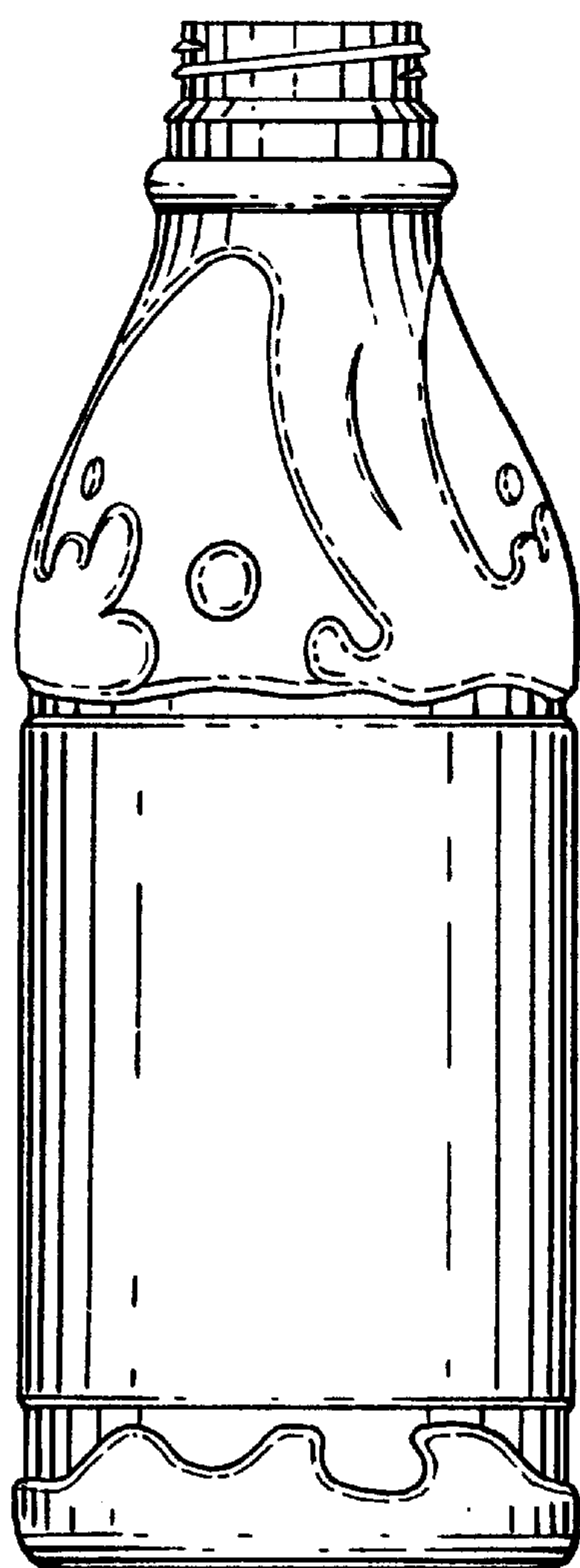

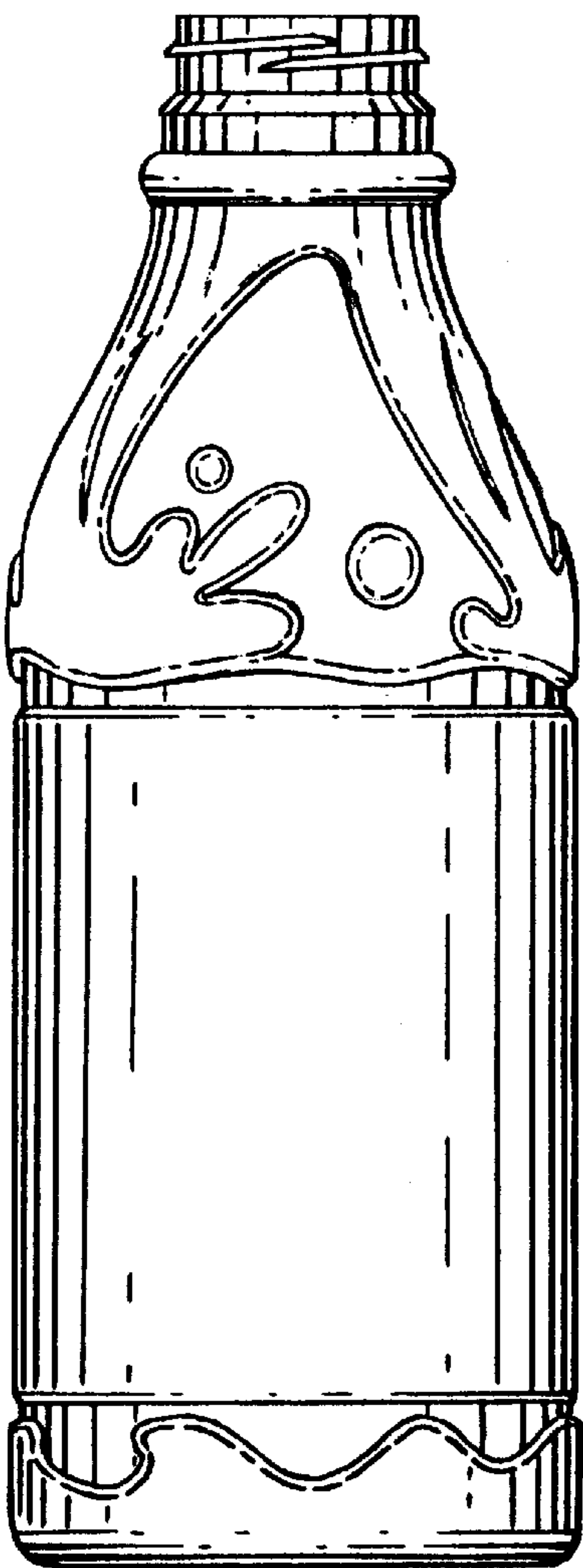

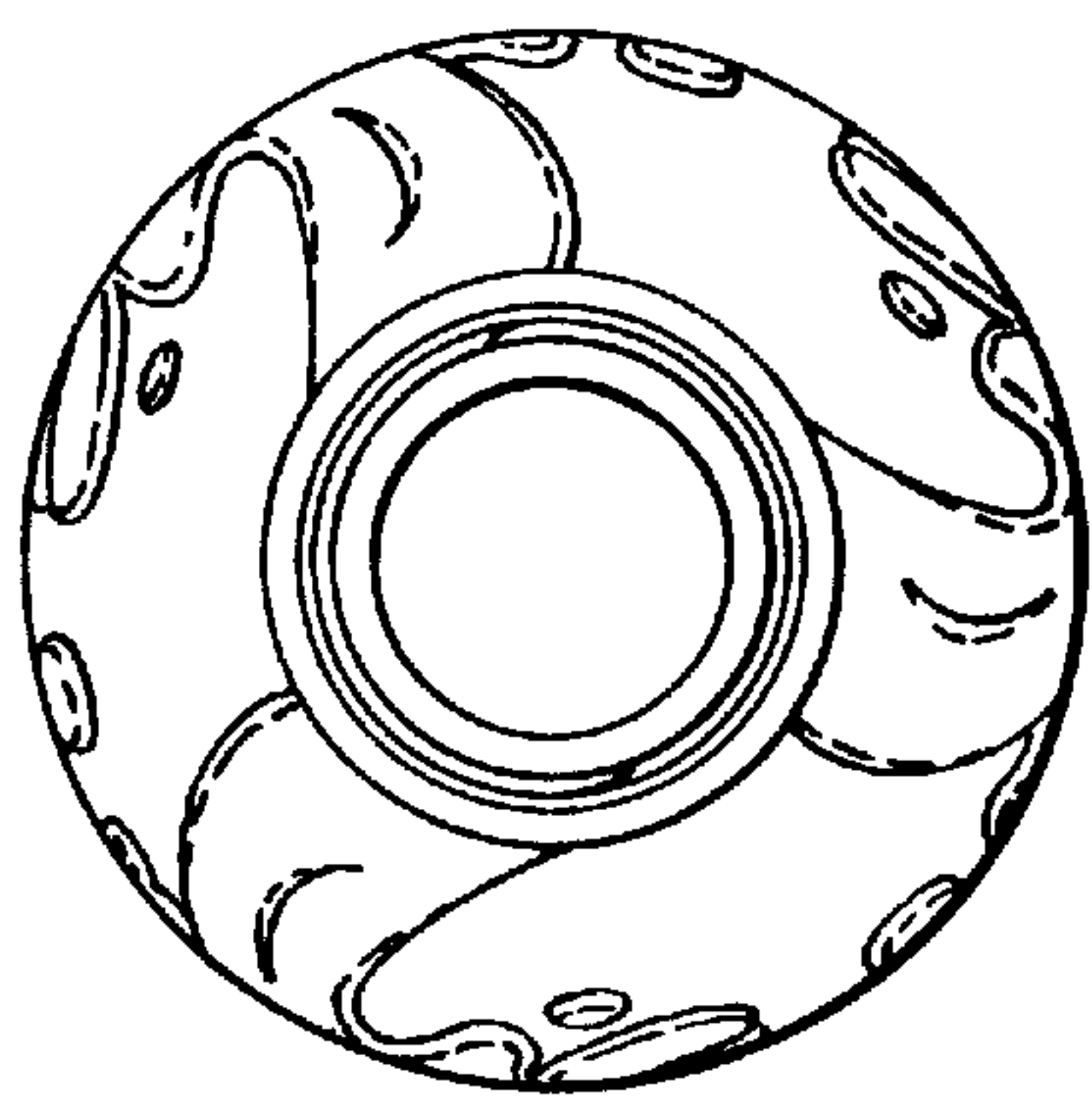

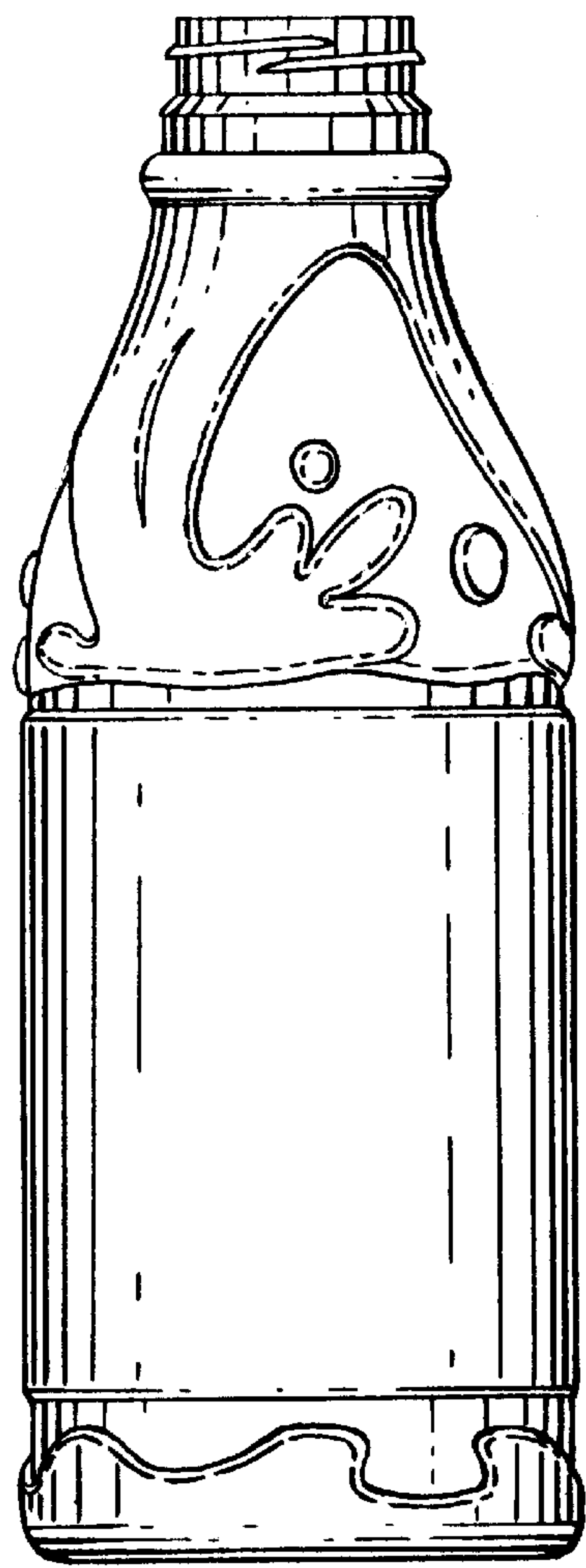

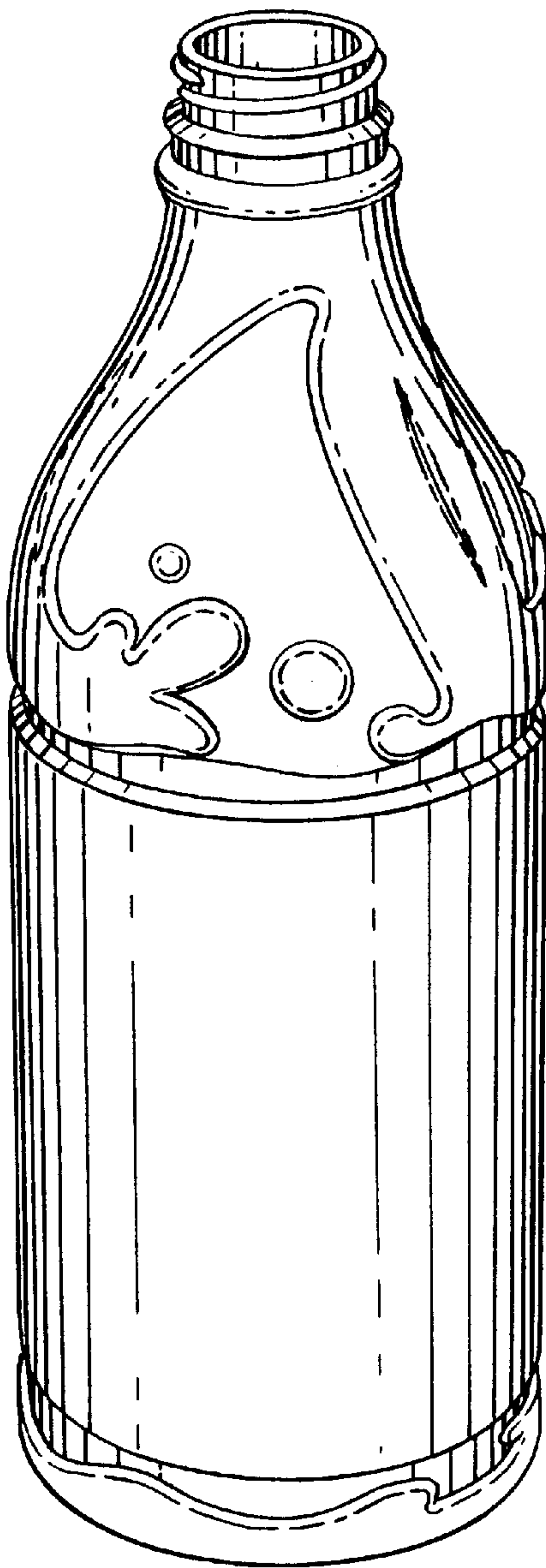

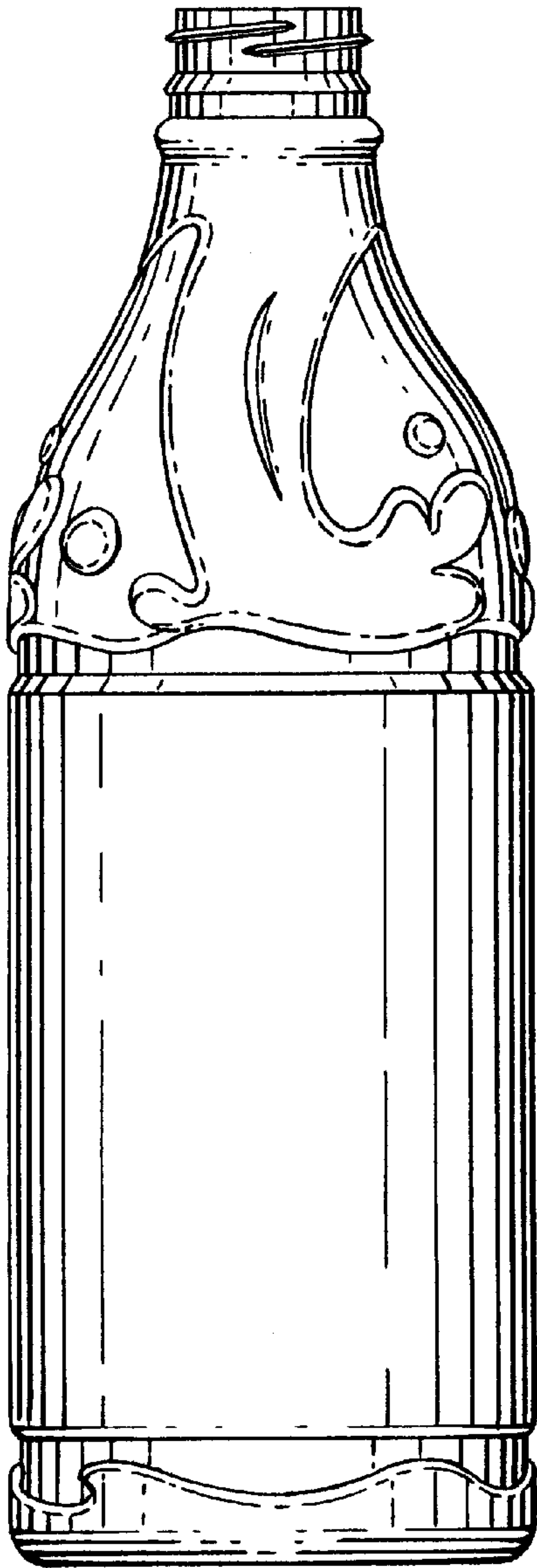

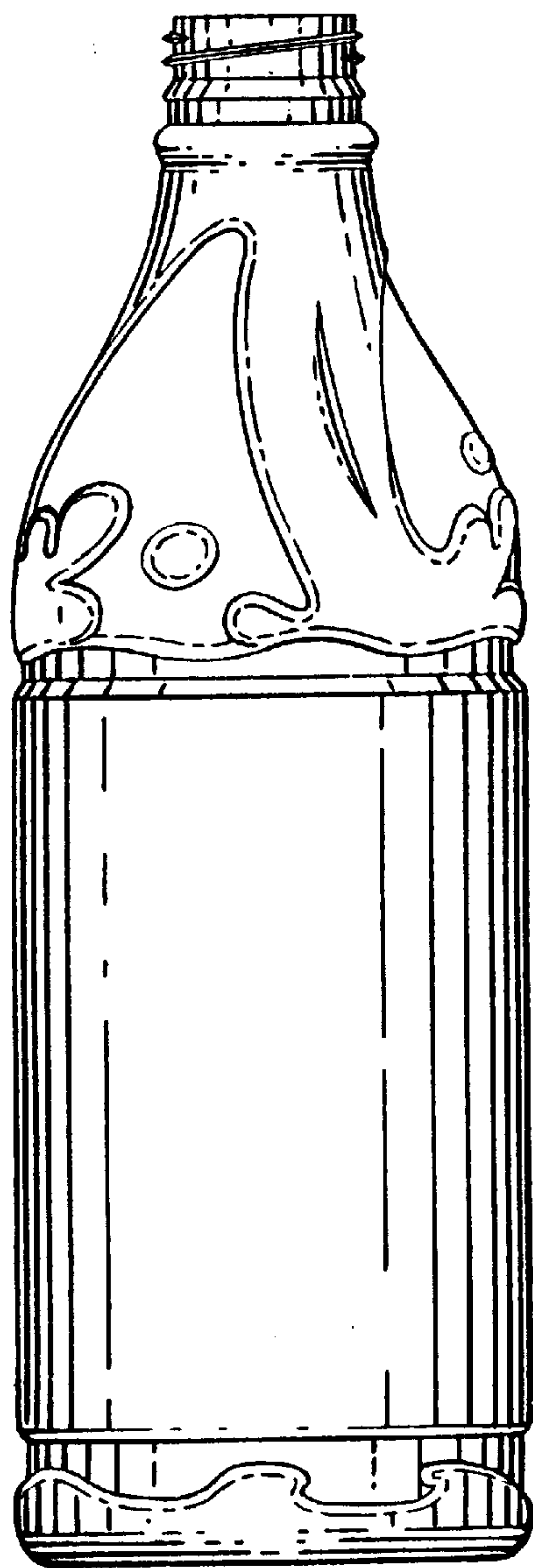

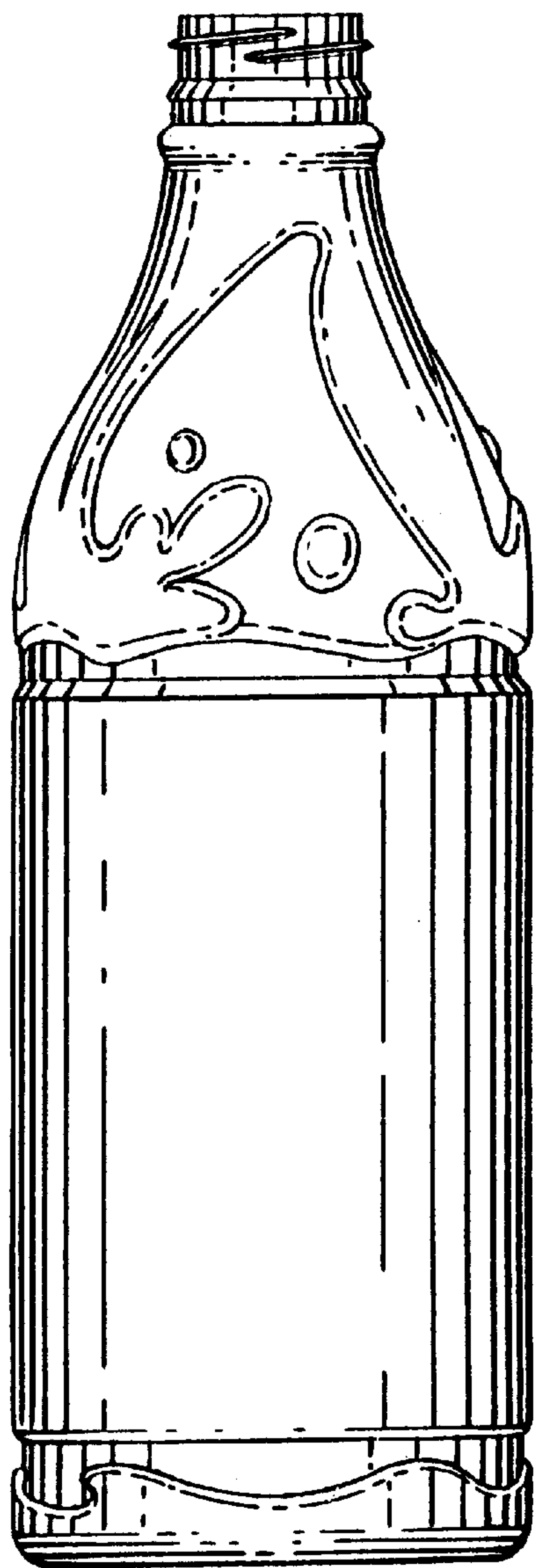

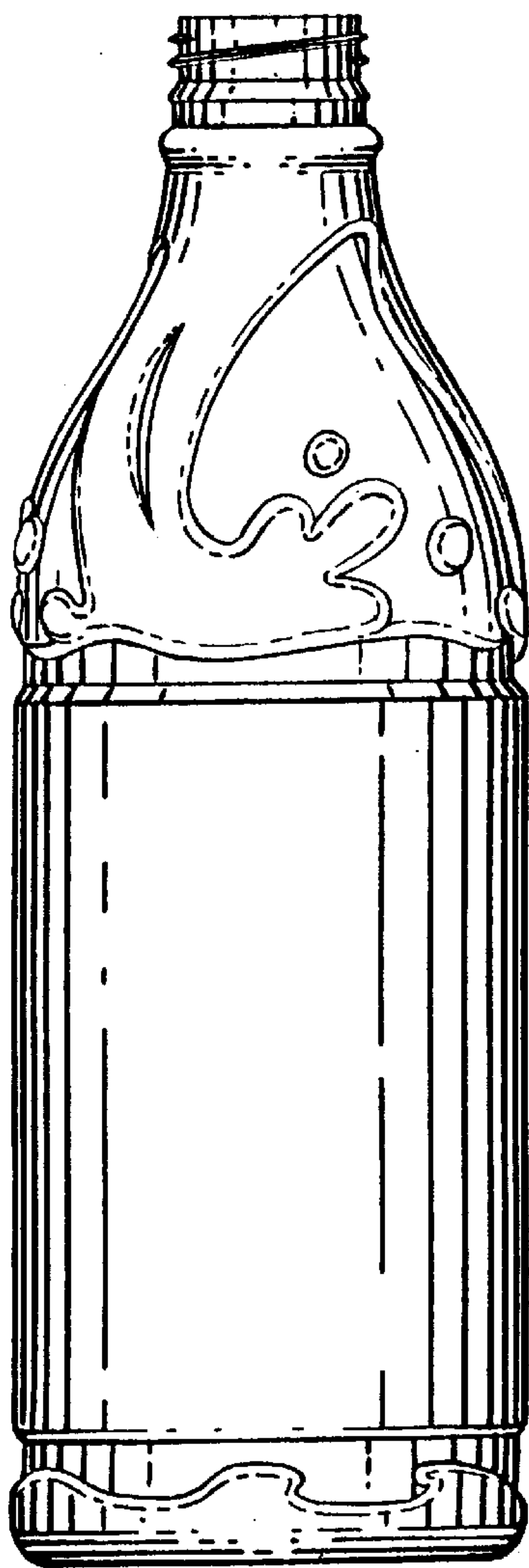
