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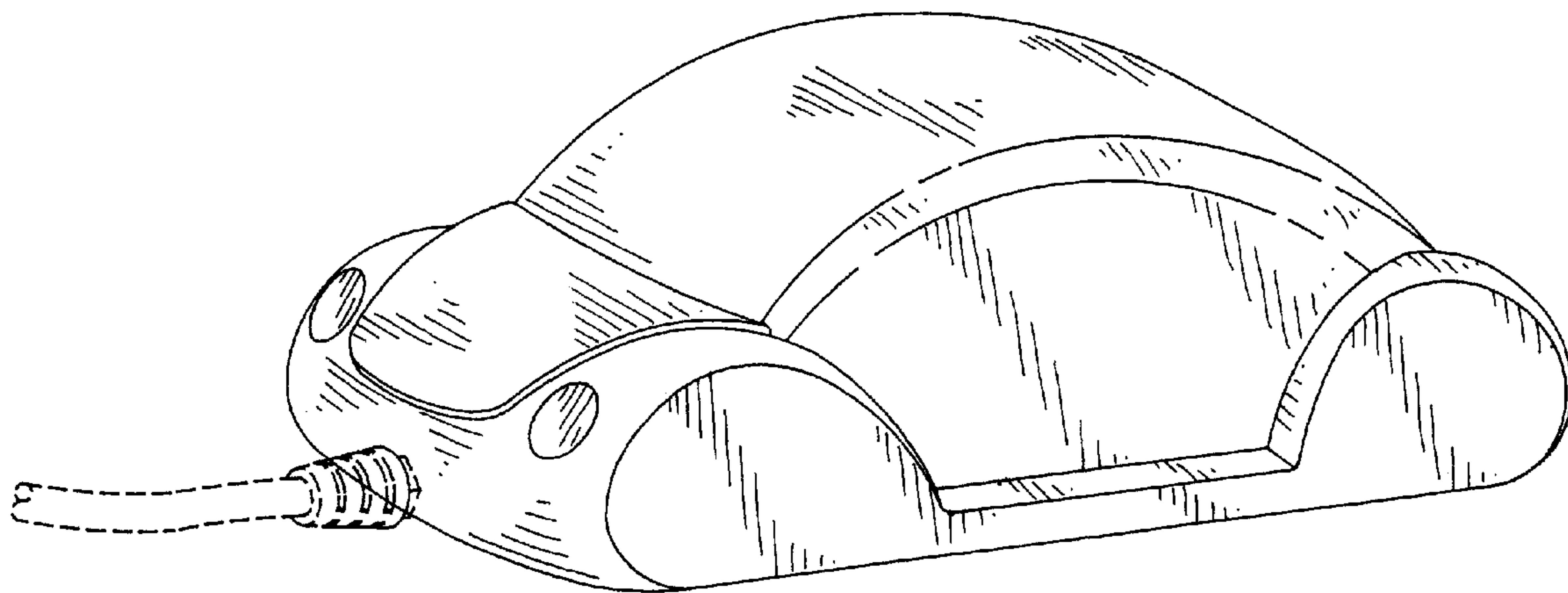
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a mouse for a computer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left perspective view of a mouse for a computer, the broken line drawing of an electrical cord is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a front, left perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top, front left perspective view thereof, on a reduced scale. FIG. 4 is a side view thereof, the opposite side is a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a front, view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a rear view thereof.

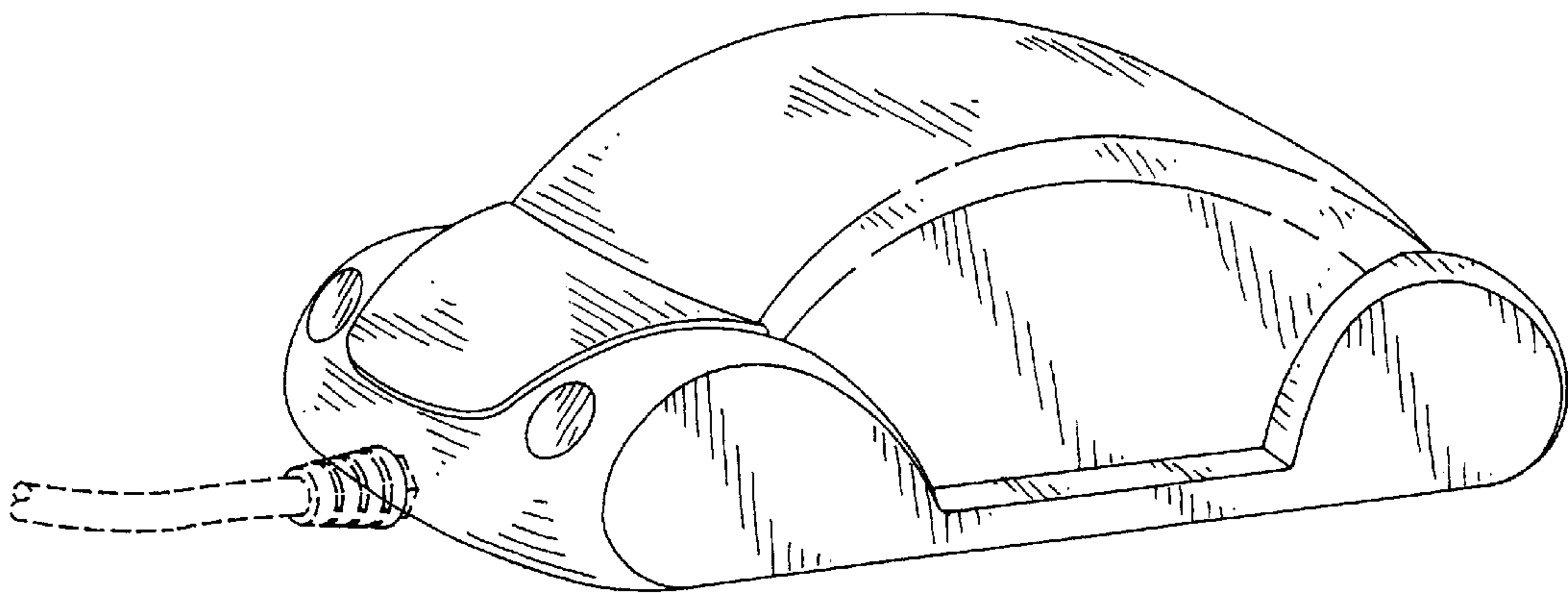

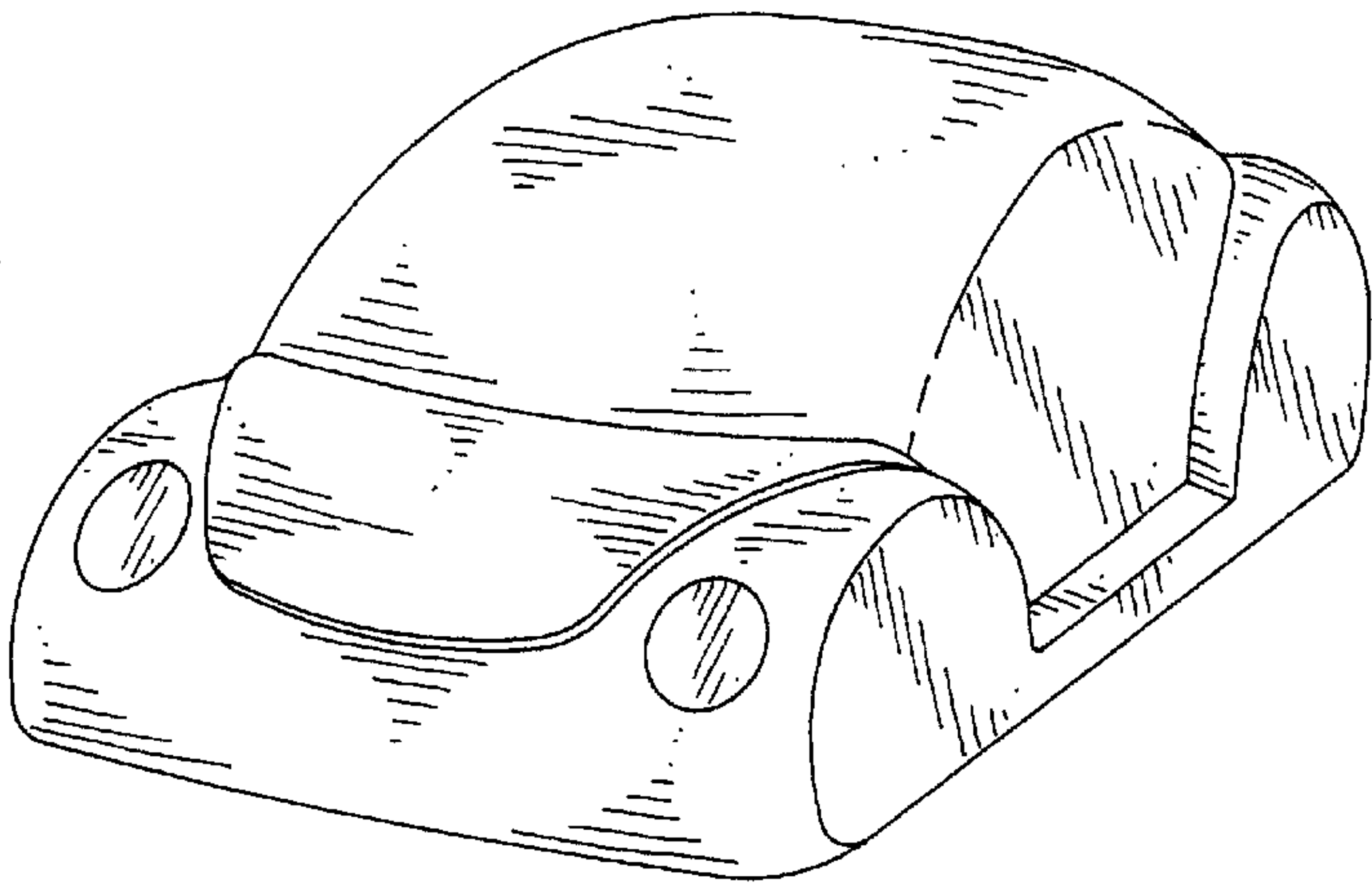

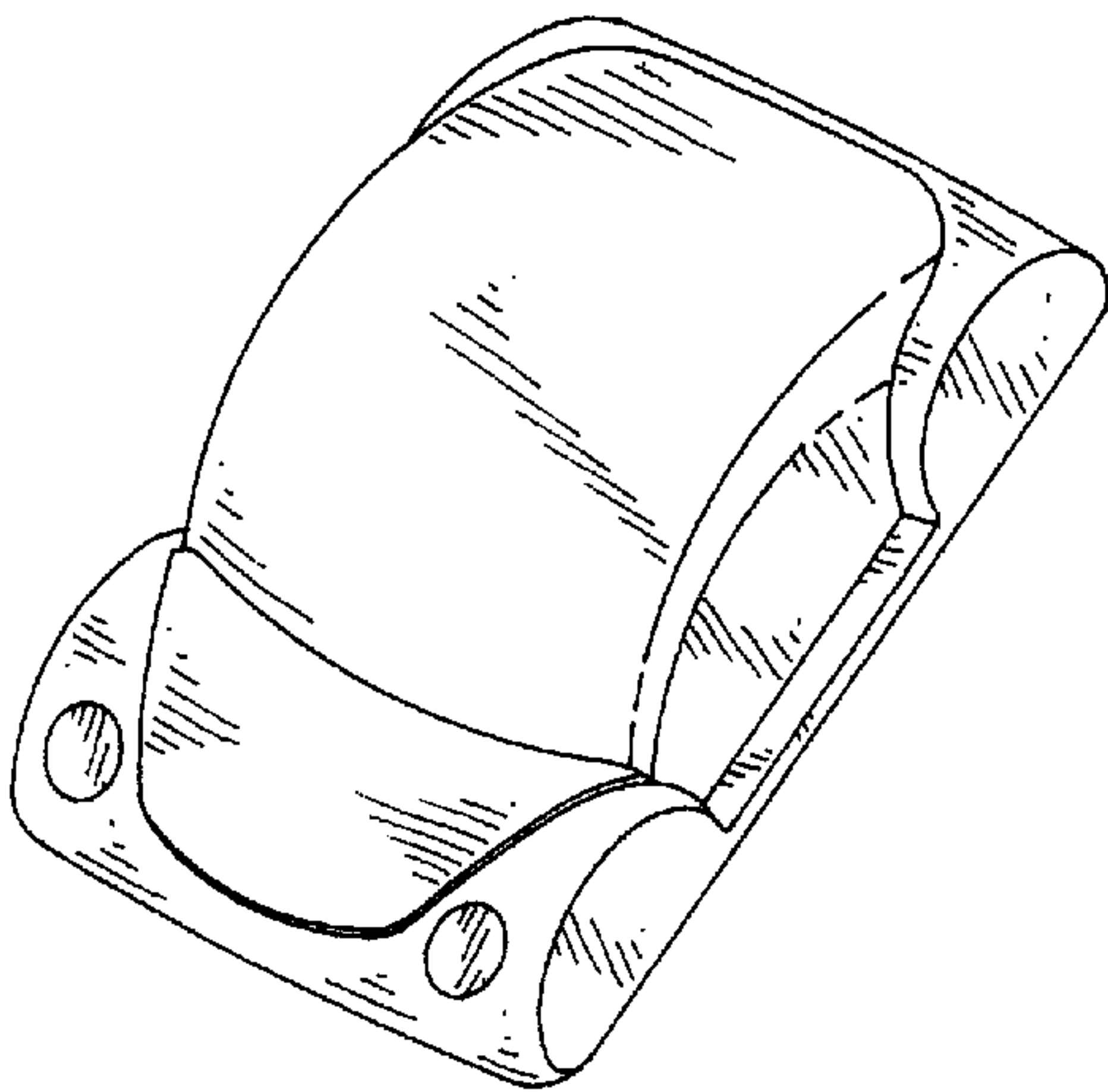
