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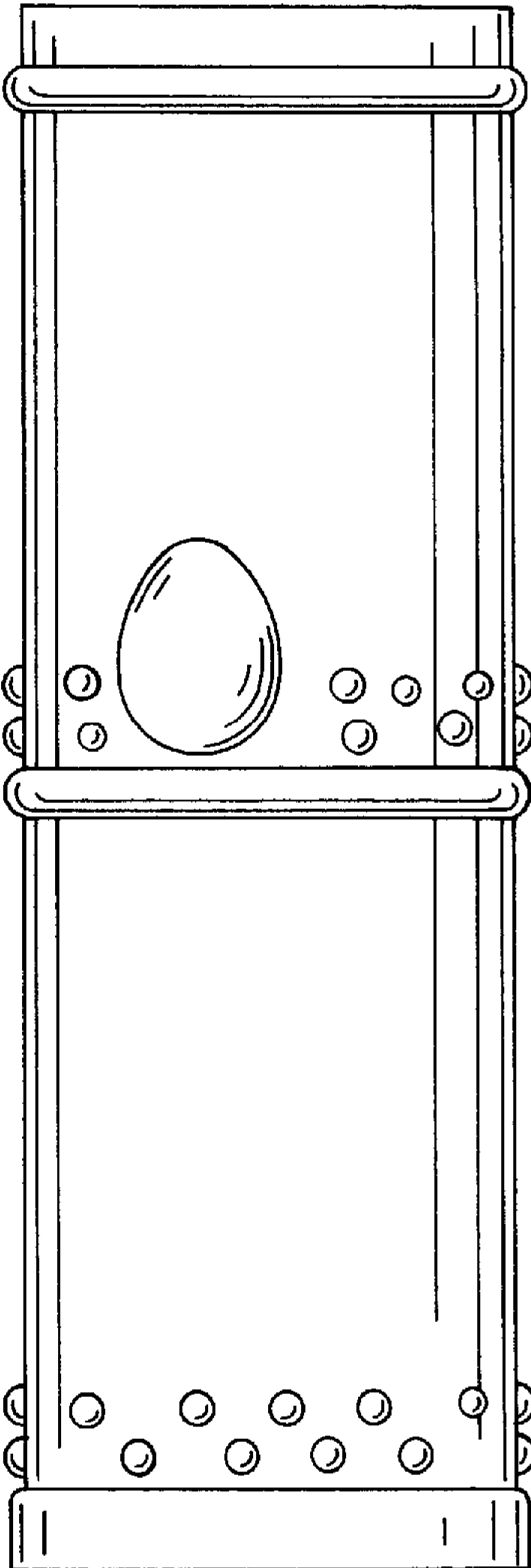
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a beverage can having the appear-
ance of a sugar cane;
FIG. 2 is a top view of the beverage can of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a side view showing the side of the beverage can
opposite the side shown in FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the beverage can of FIG. 1.
The portions of the sides of the beverage can that are not

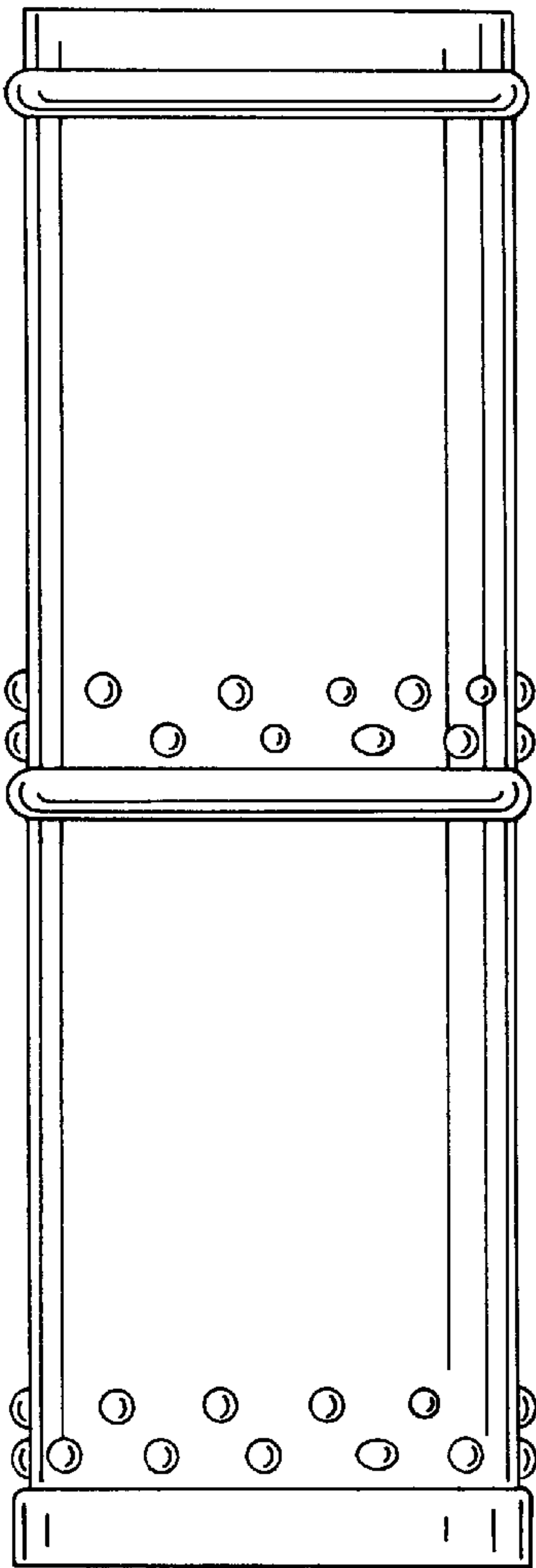

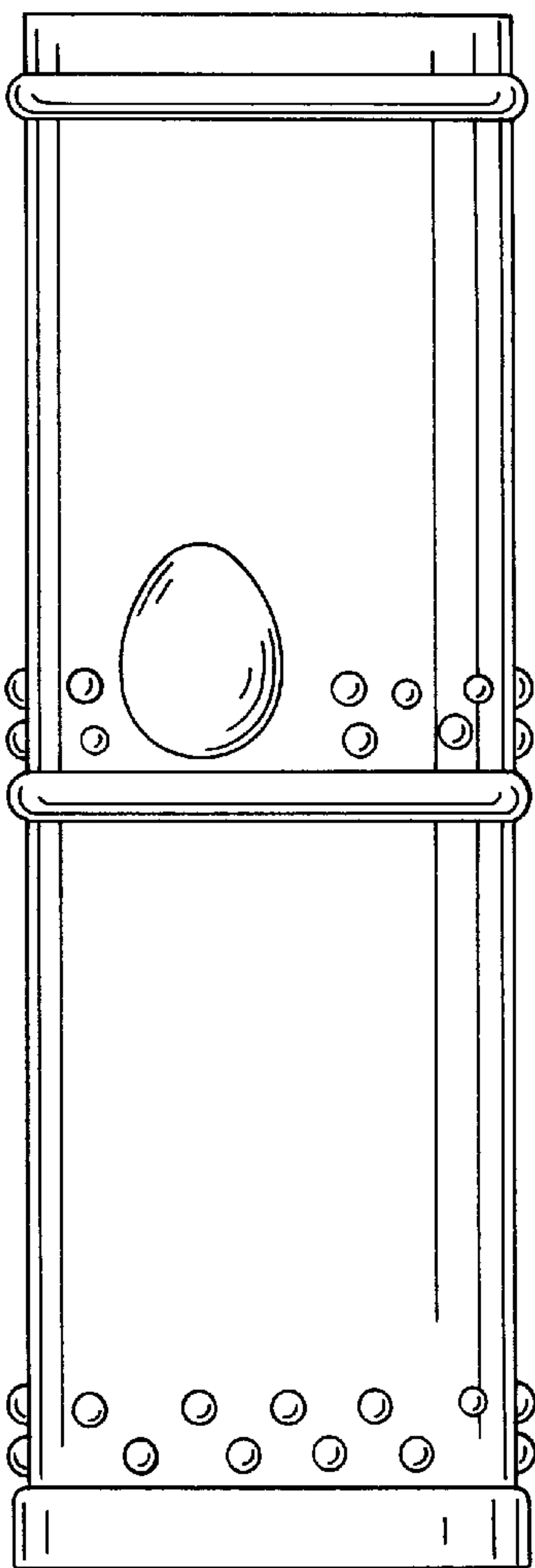

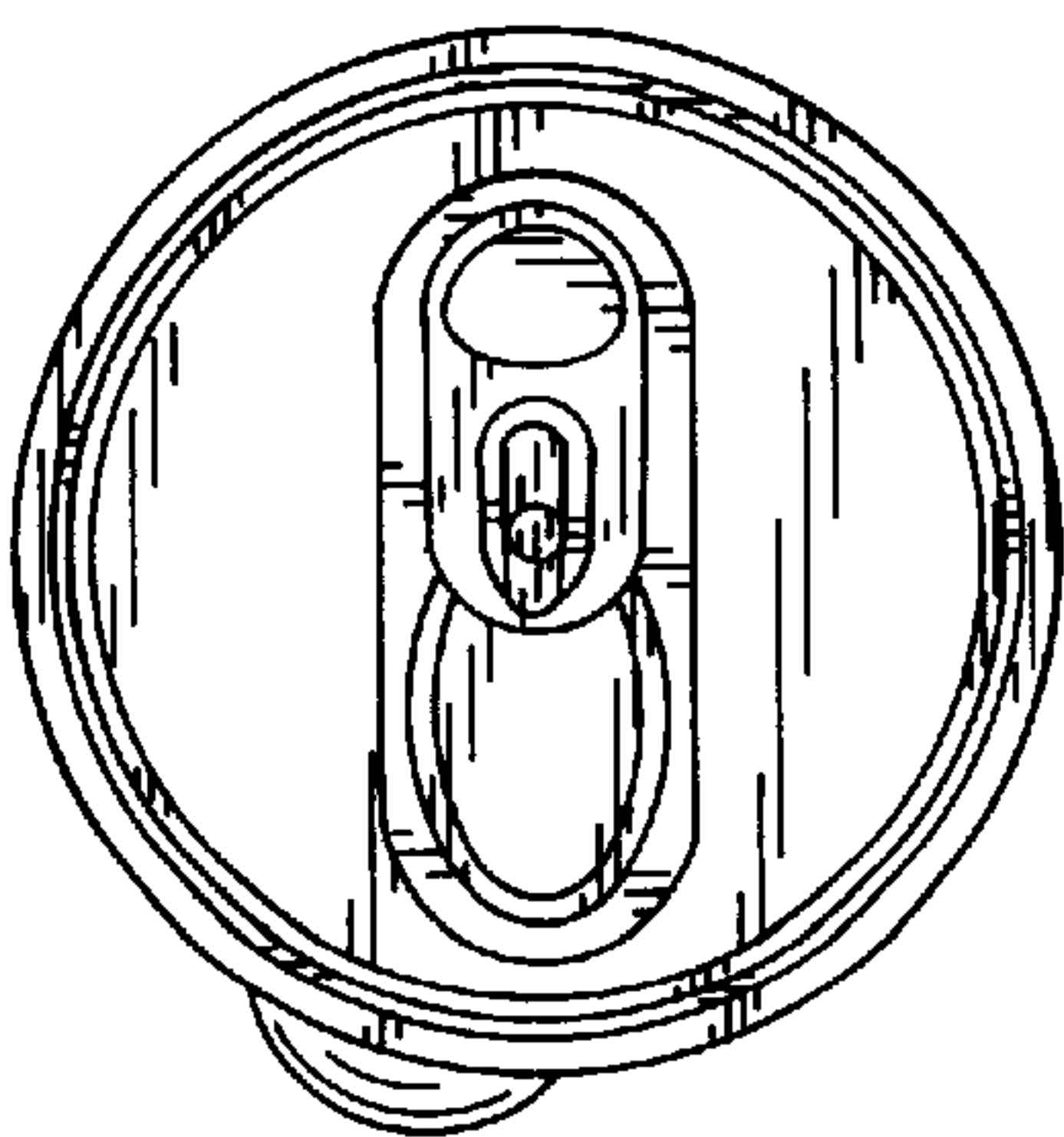

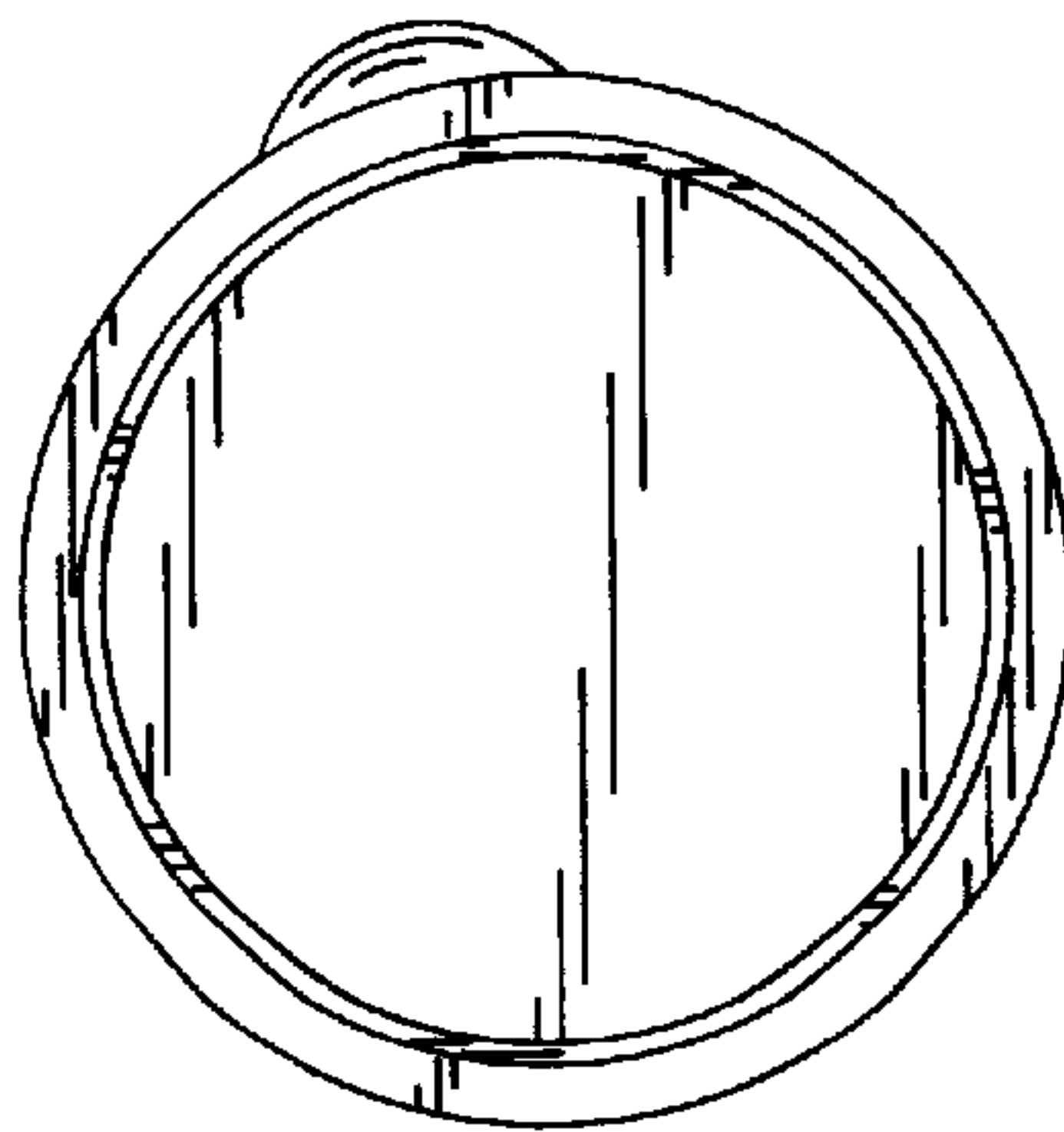
