The ornamental design for a clothespin, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clothespin embodying our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the design;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the upper member of the clothespin of FIG. 1;

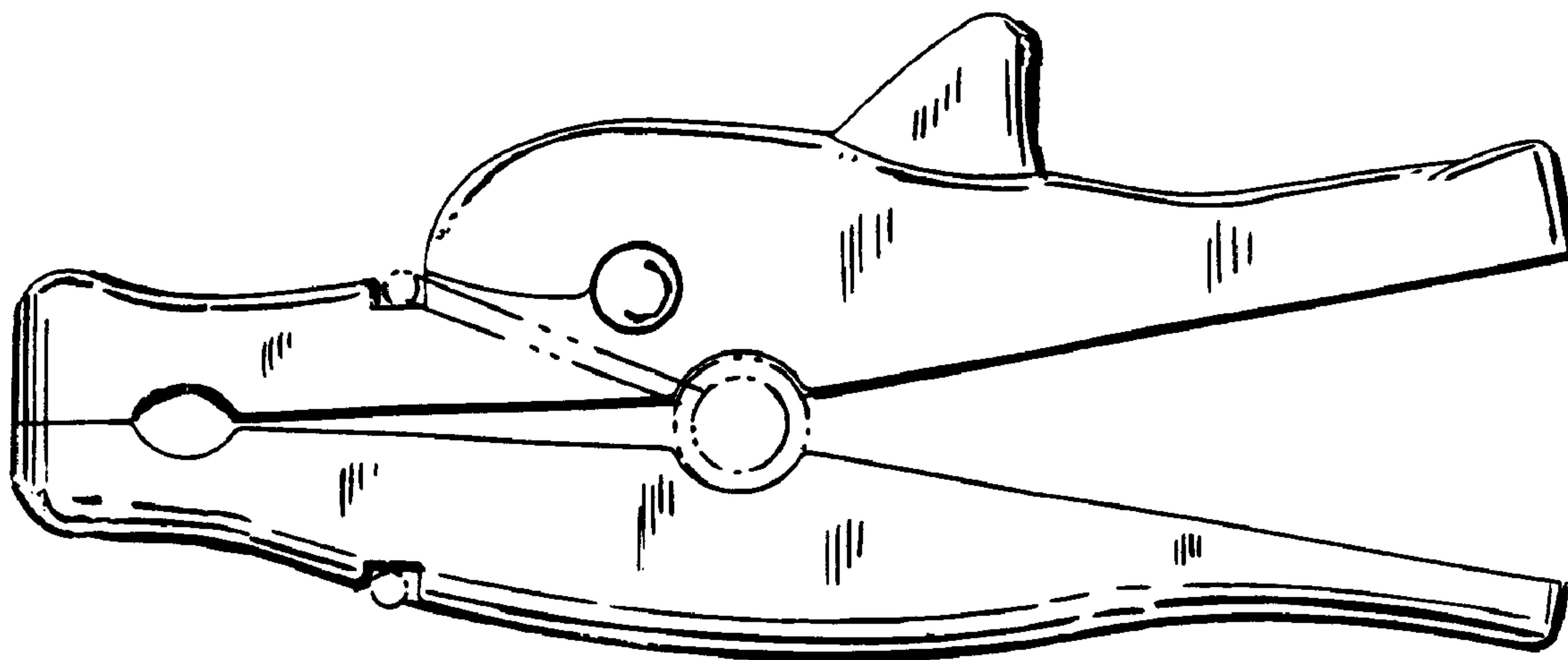
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the lower member of the clothespin of FIG. 1;

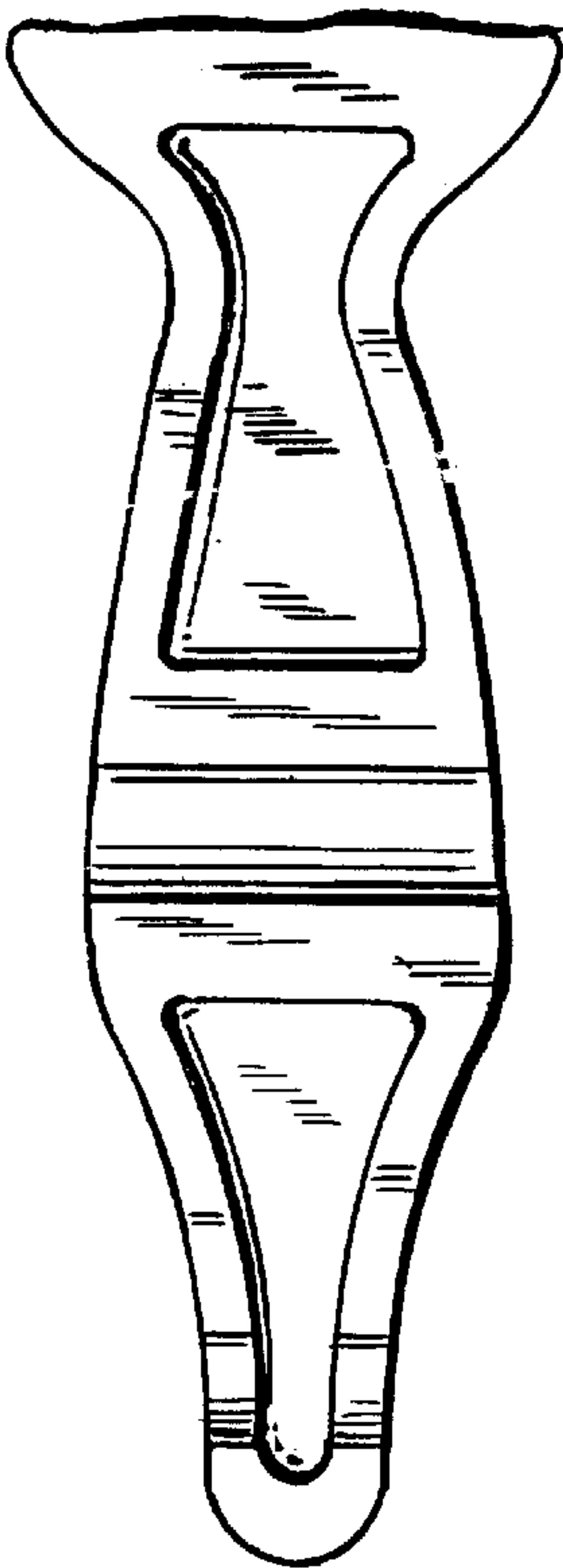

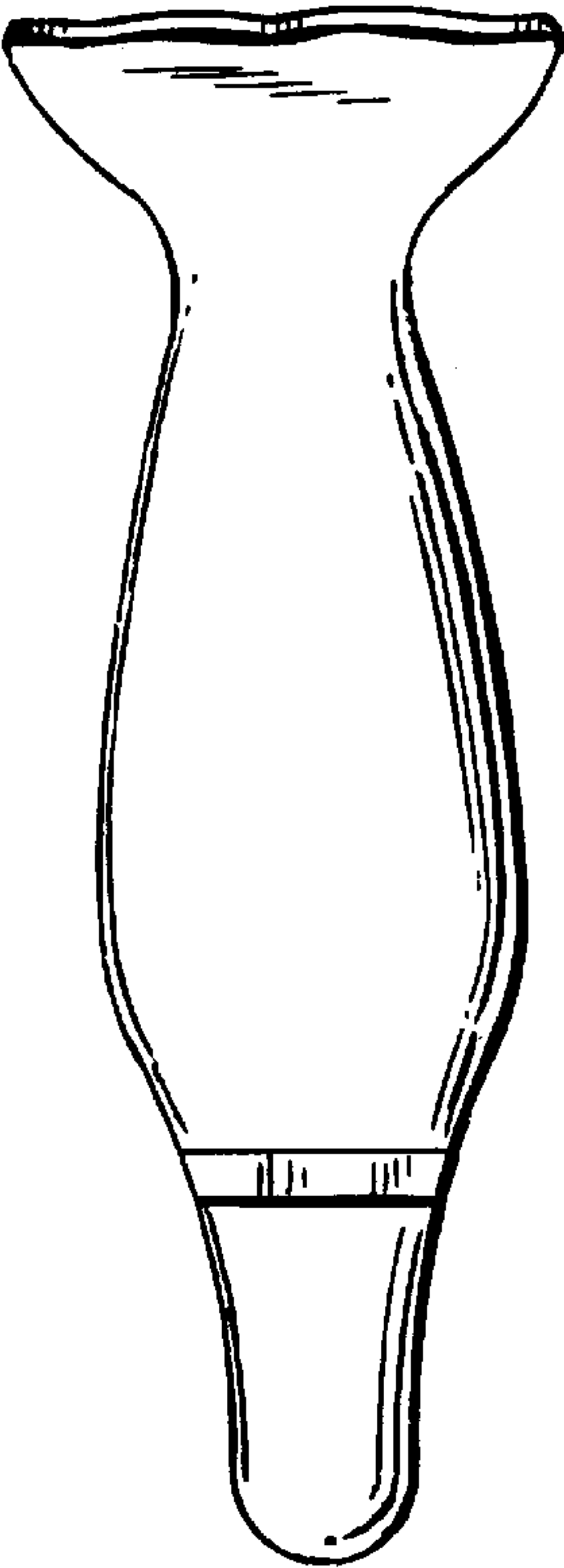

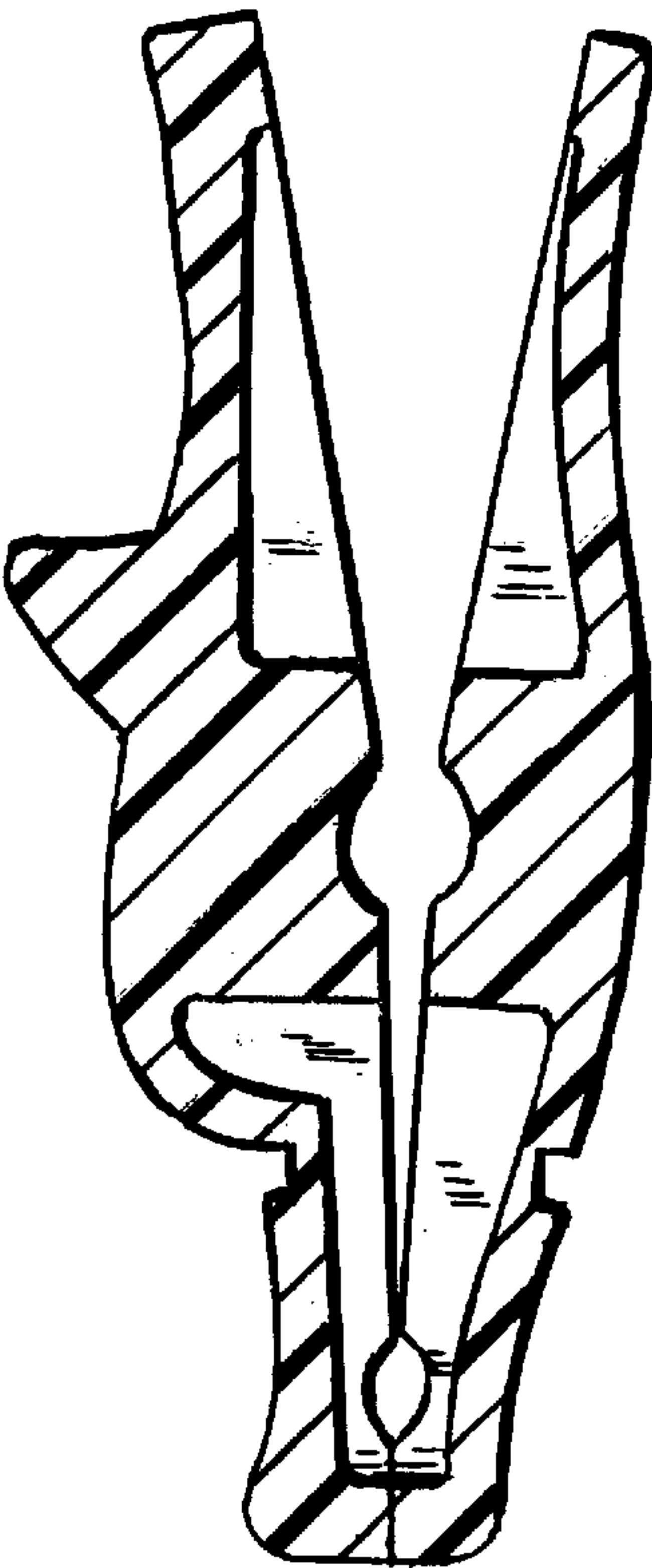

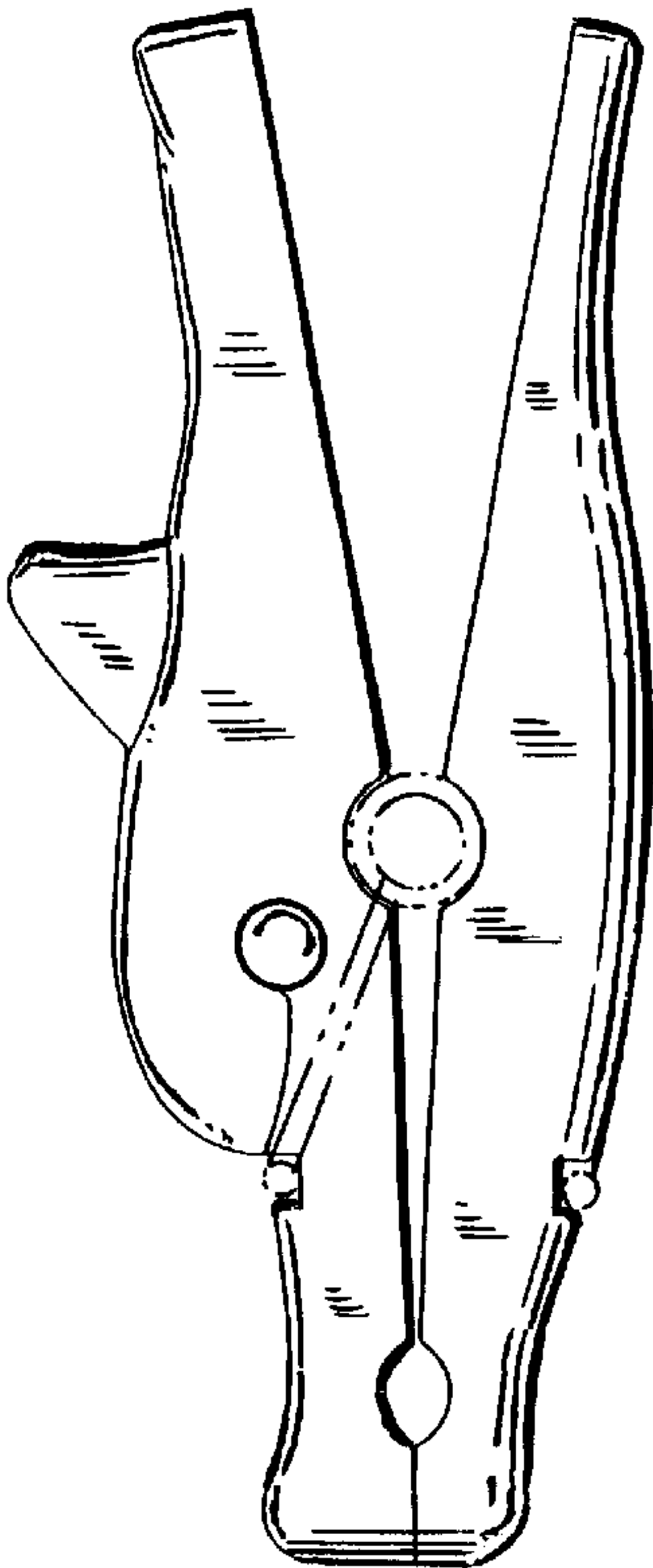

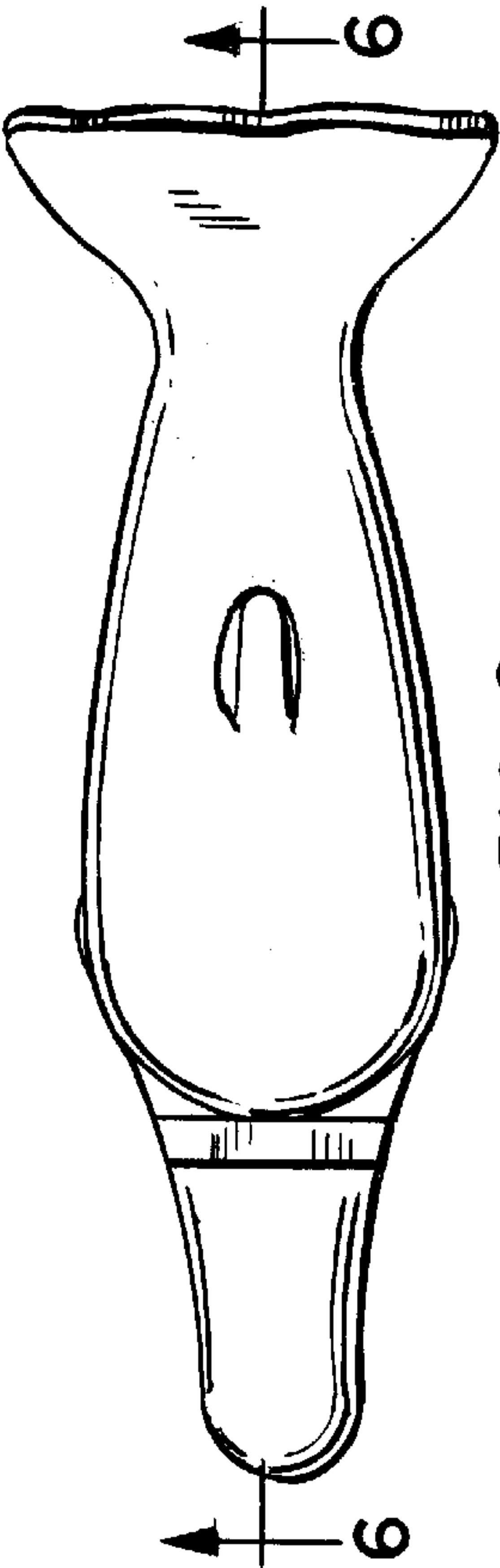

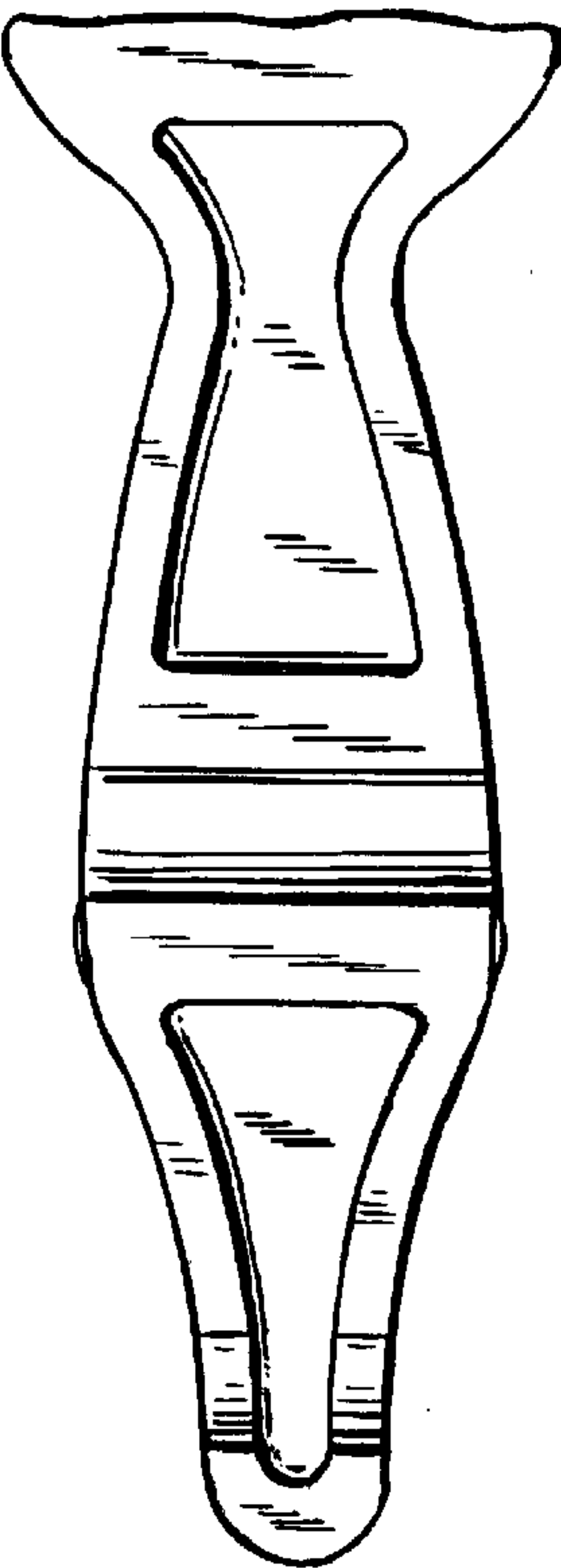
