FIG. 4 is a rear view of the console for controlling a radiation probe of FIG. 1;

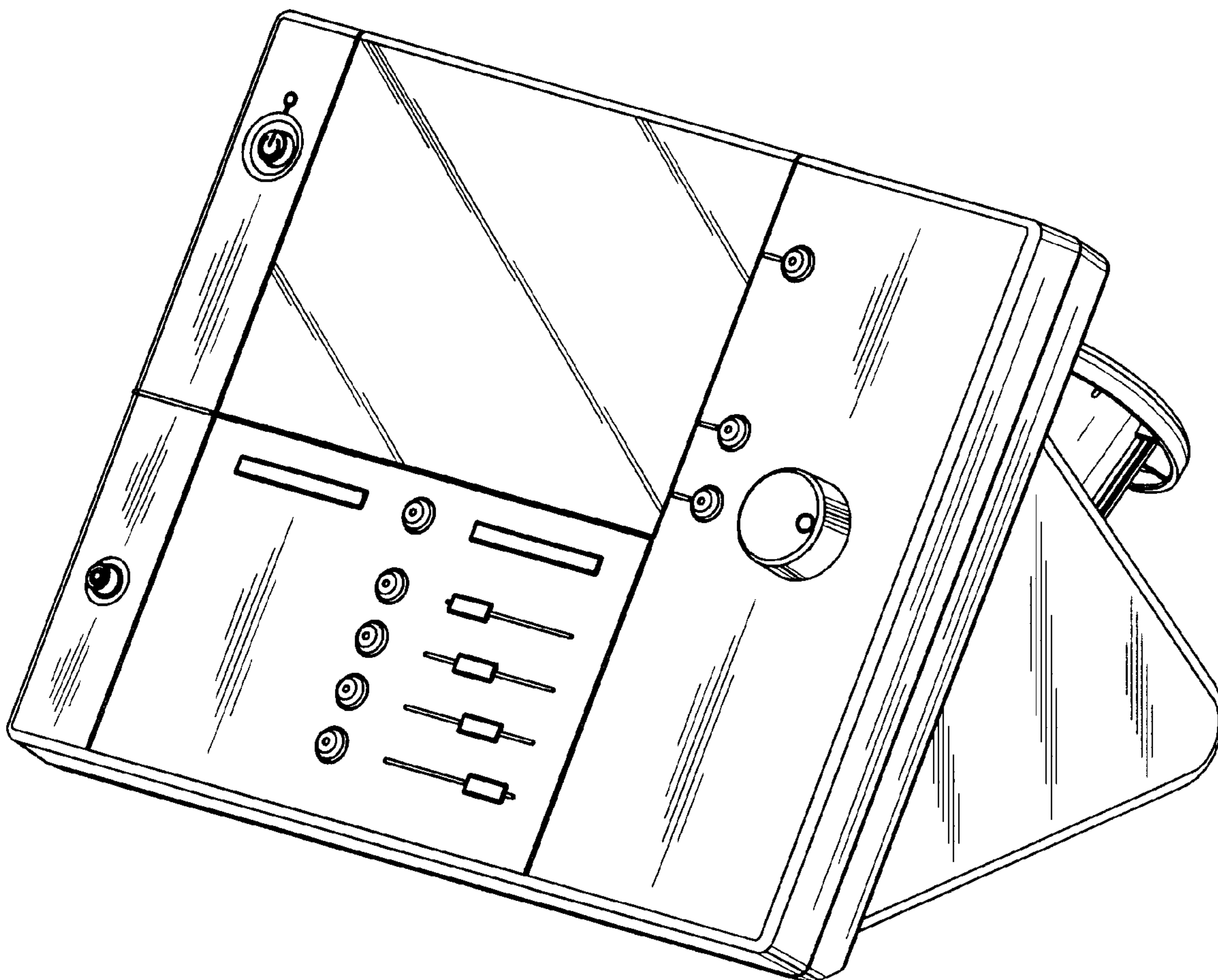
FIG. 5 is a top view of the console for controlling a radiation probe of FIG. 1;

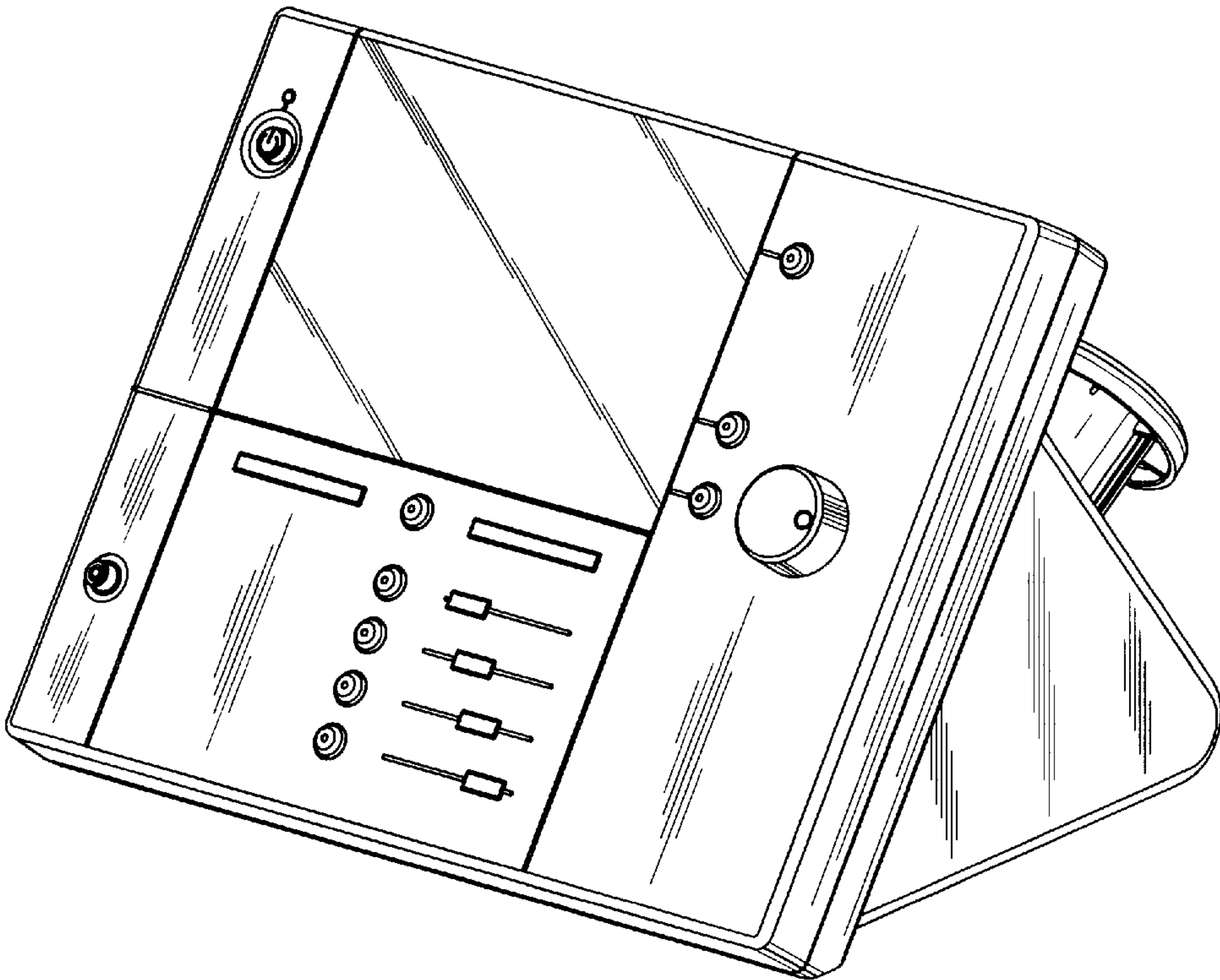

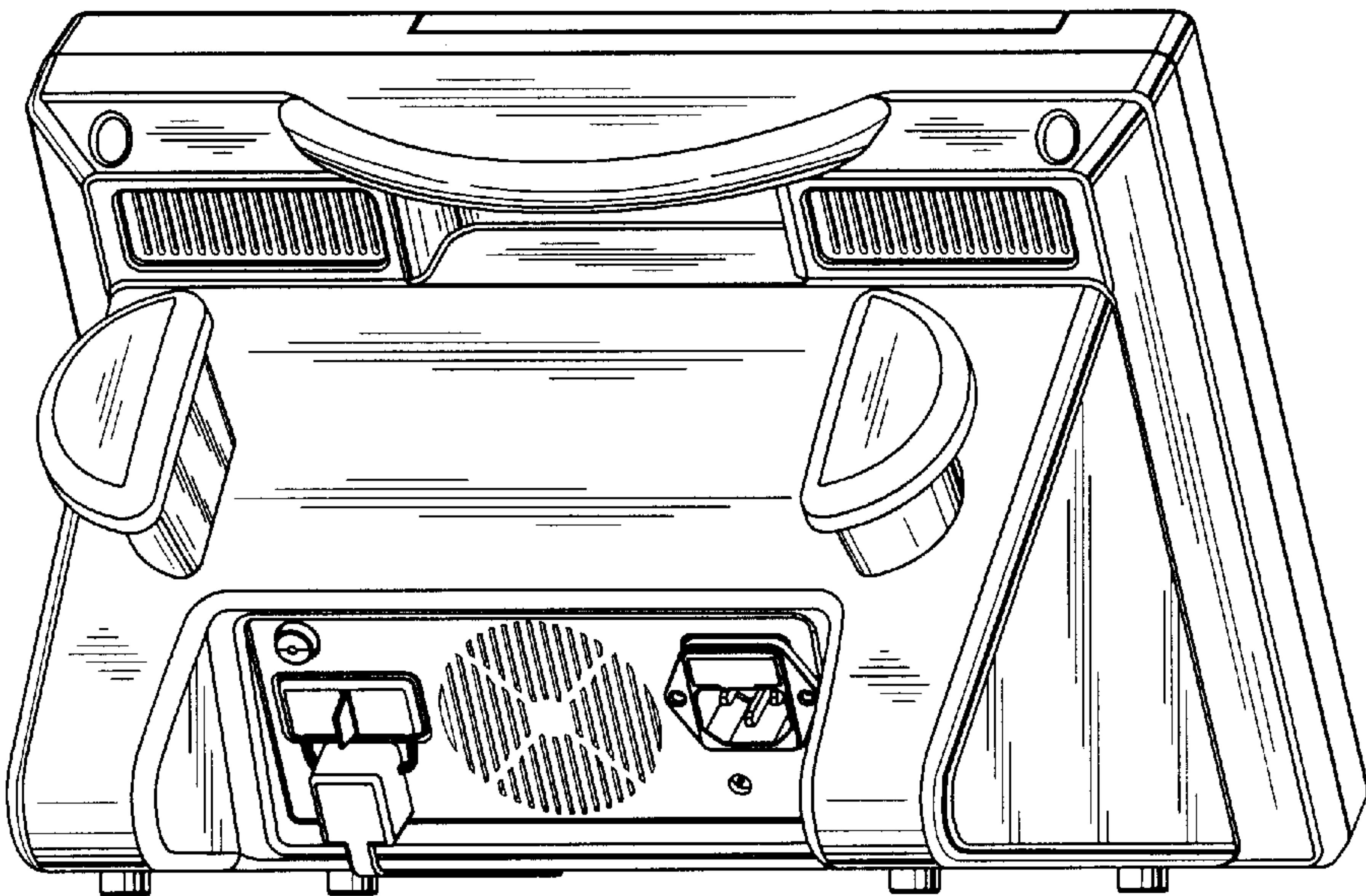

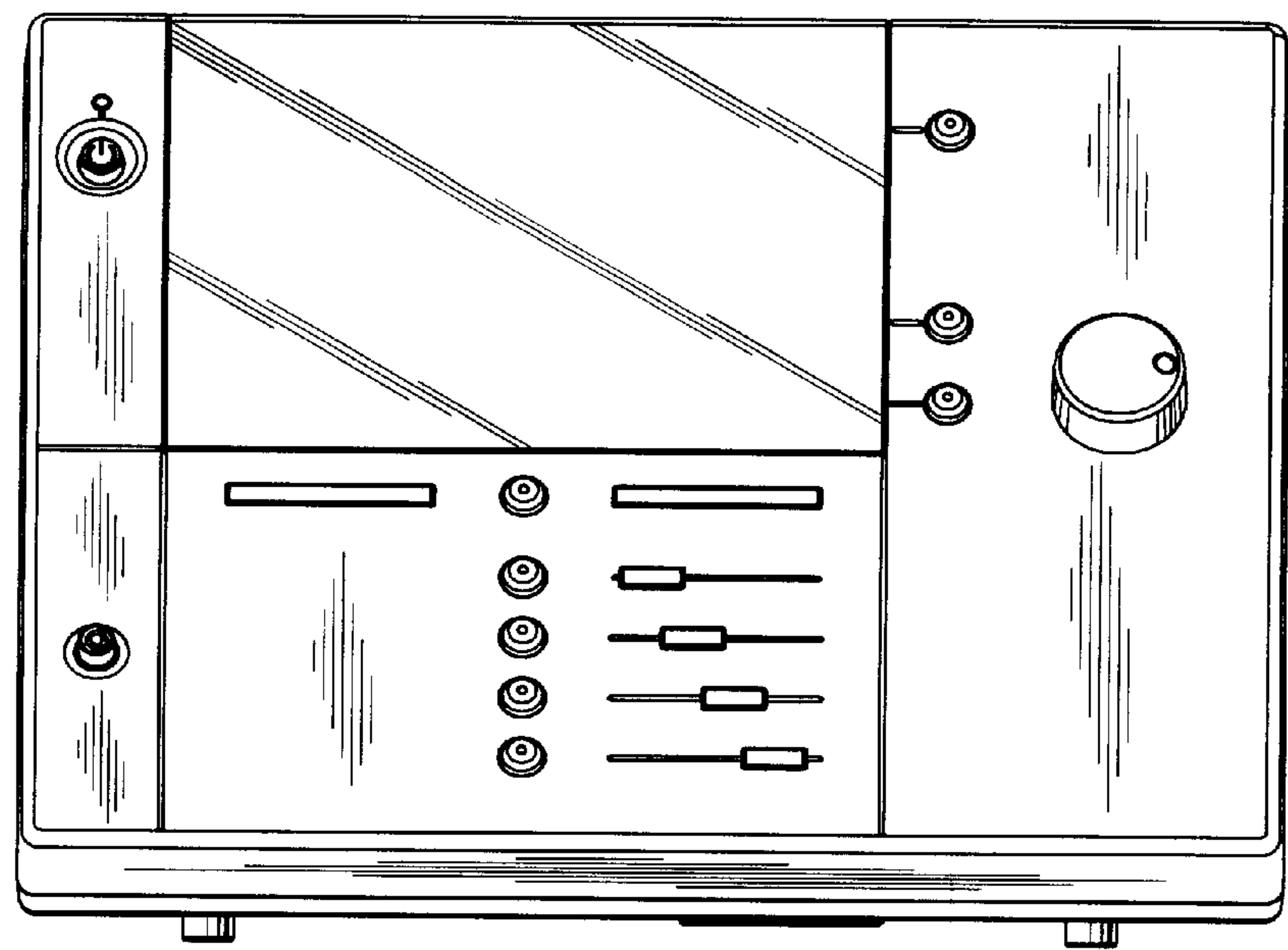

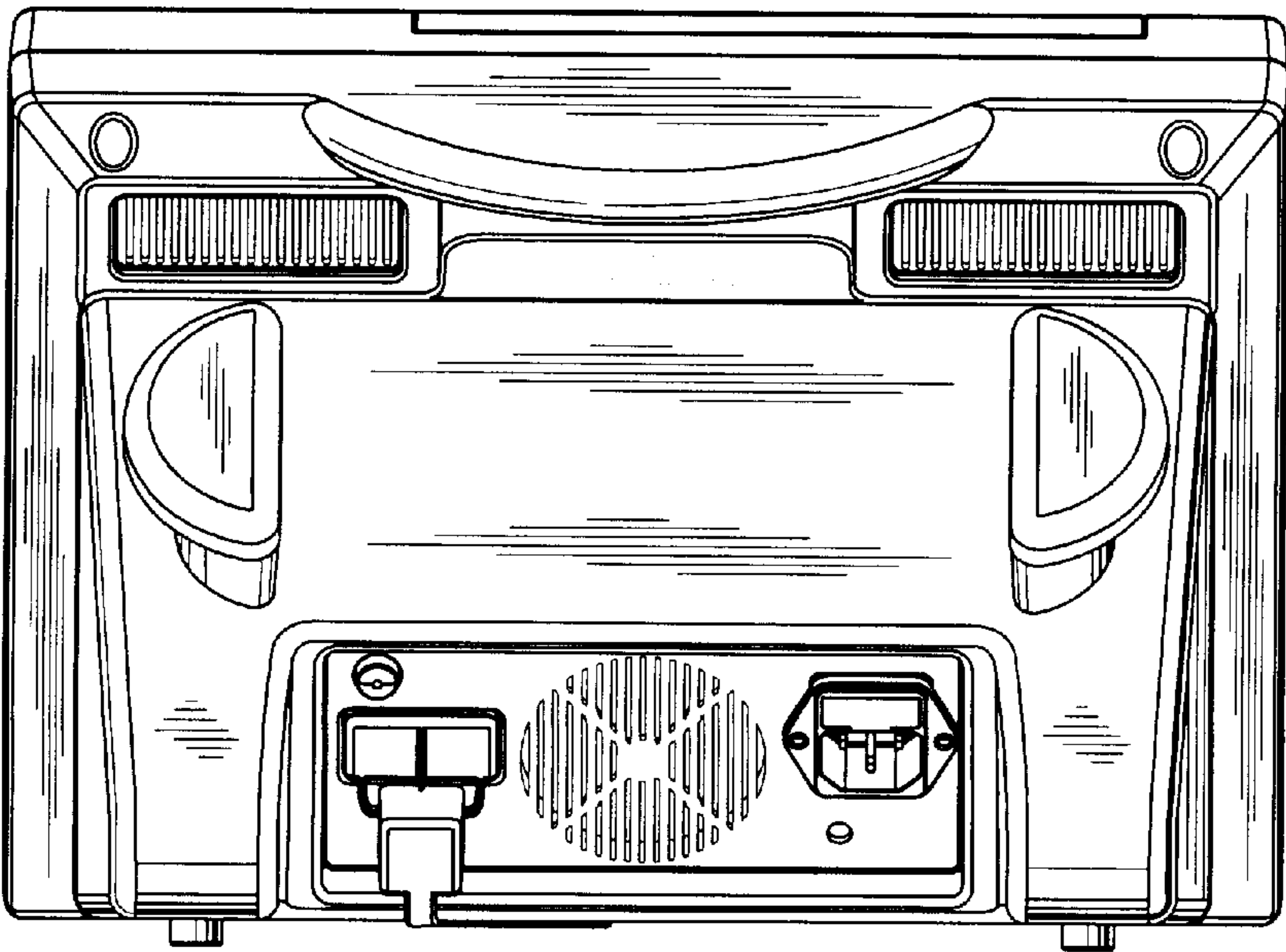

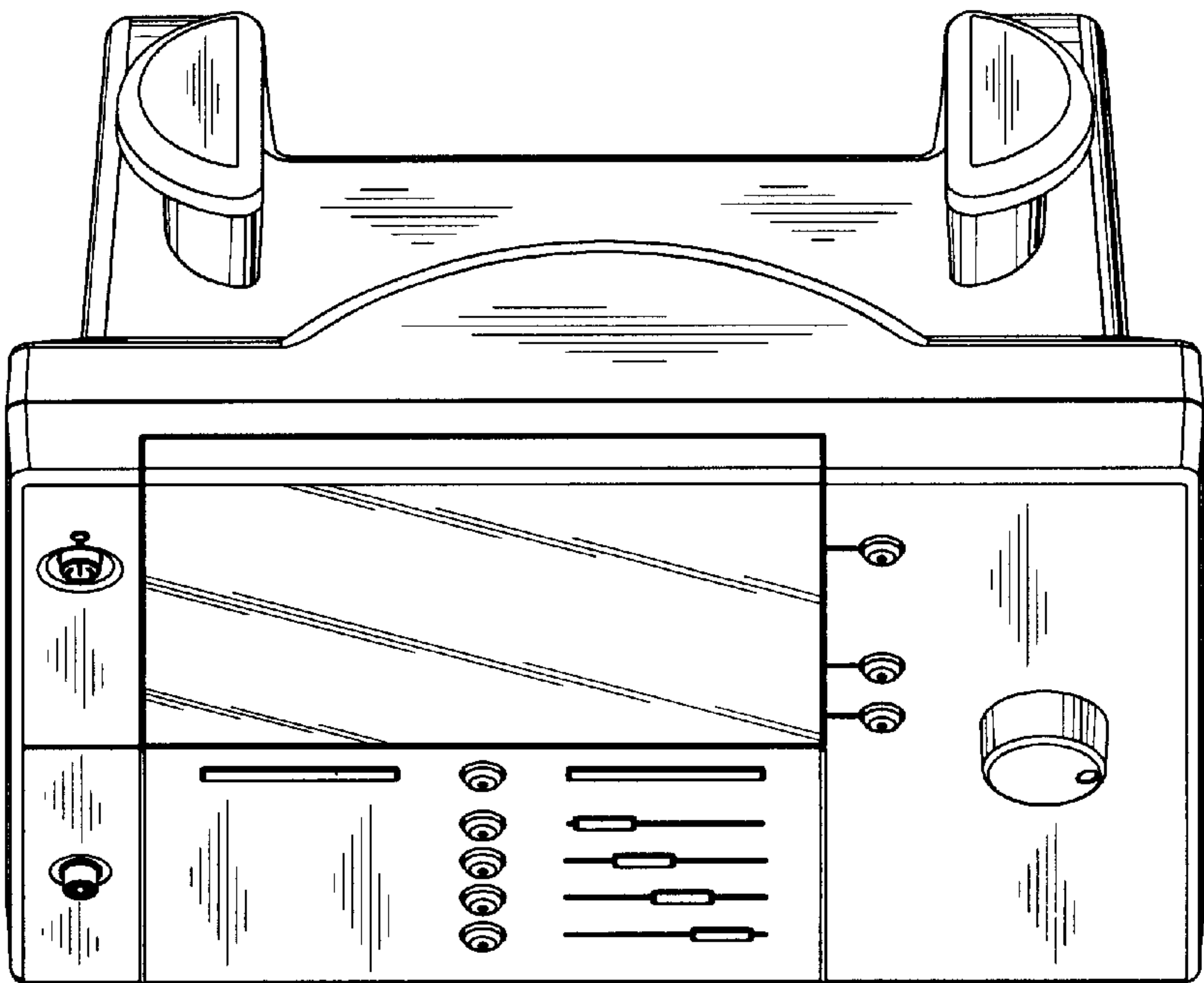

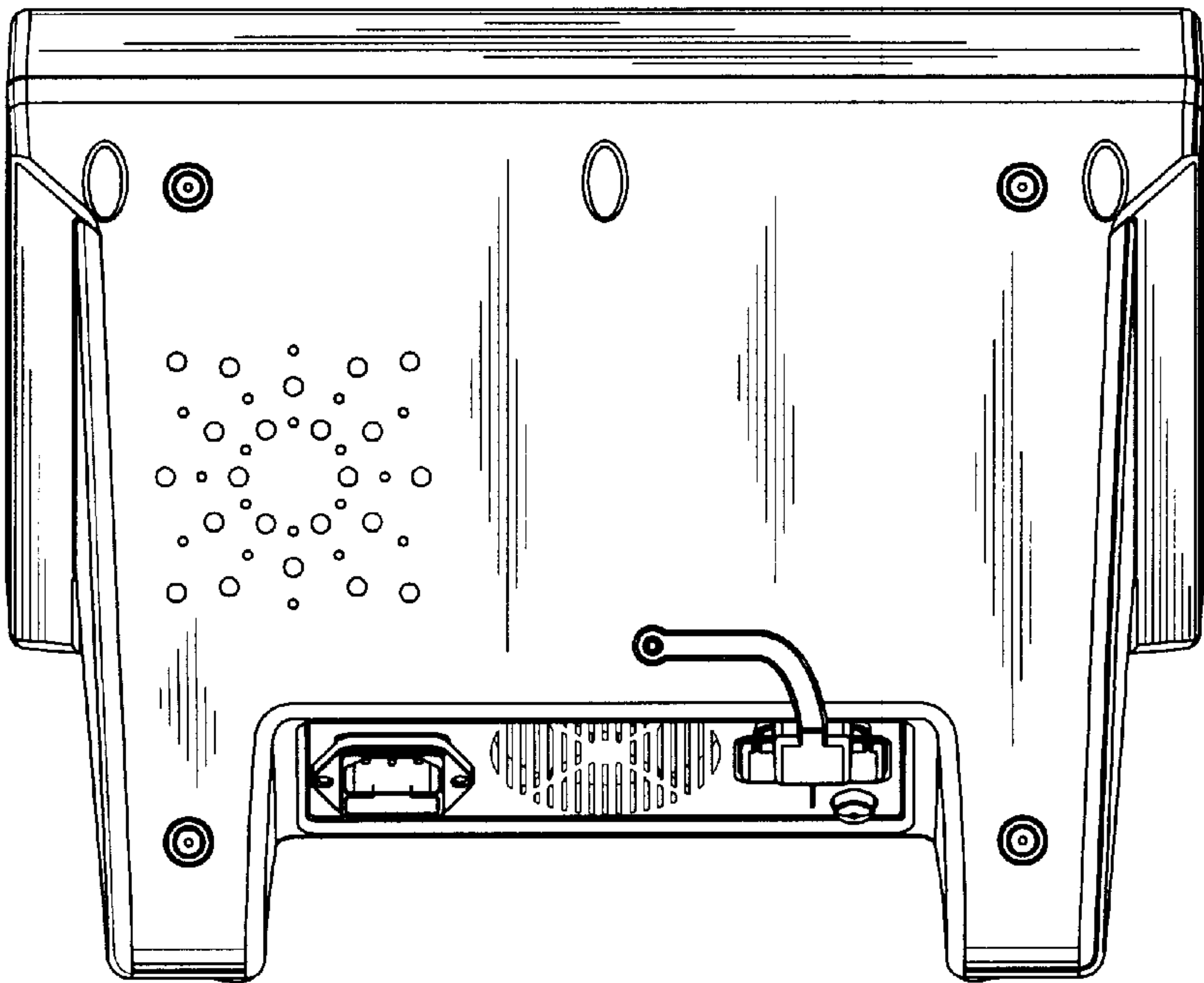

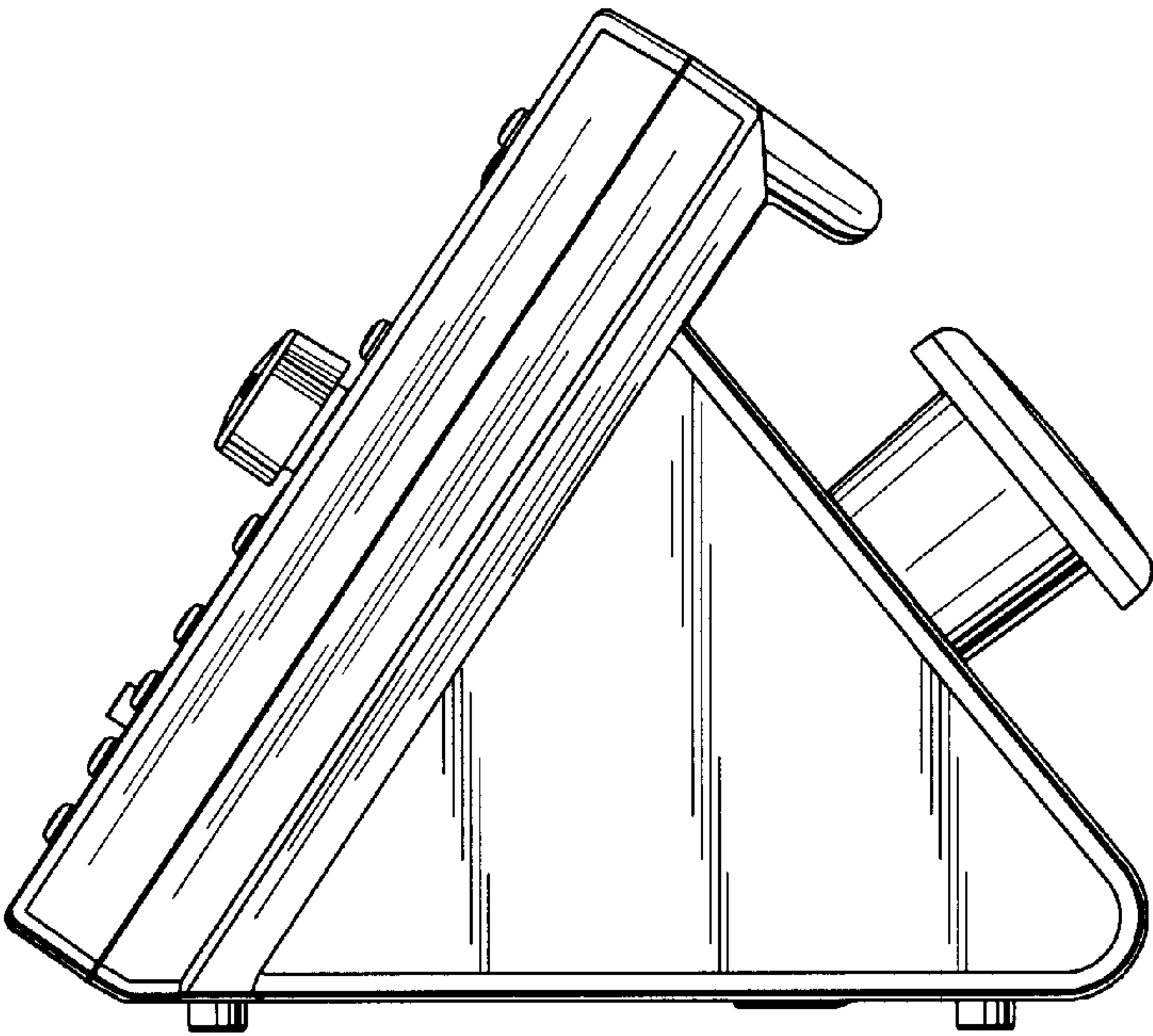

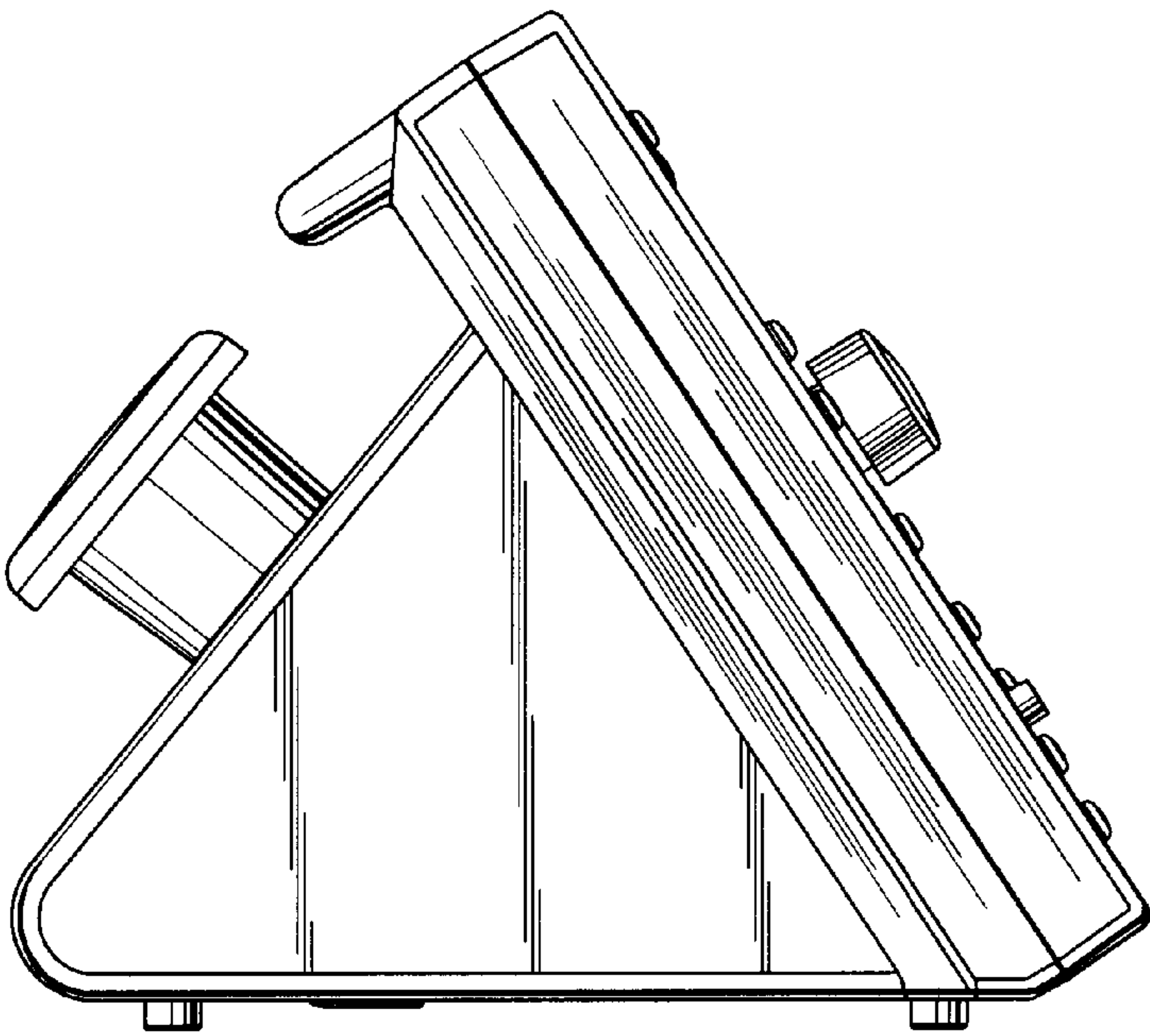
