The ornamental design for a chair frame, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair frame embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

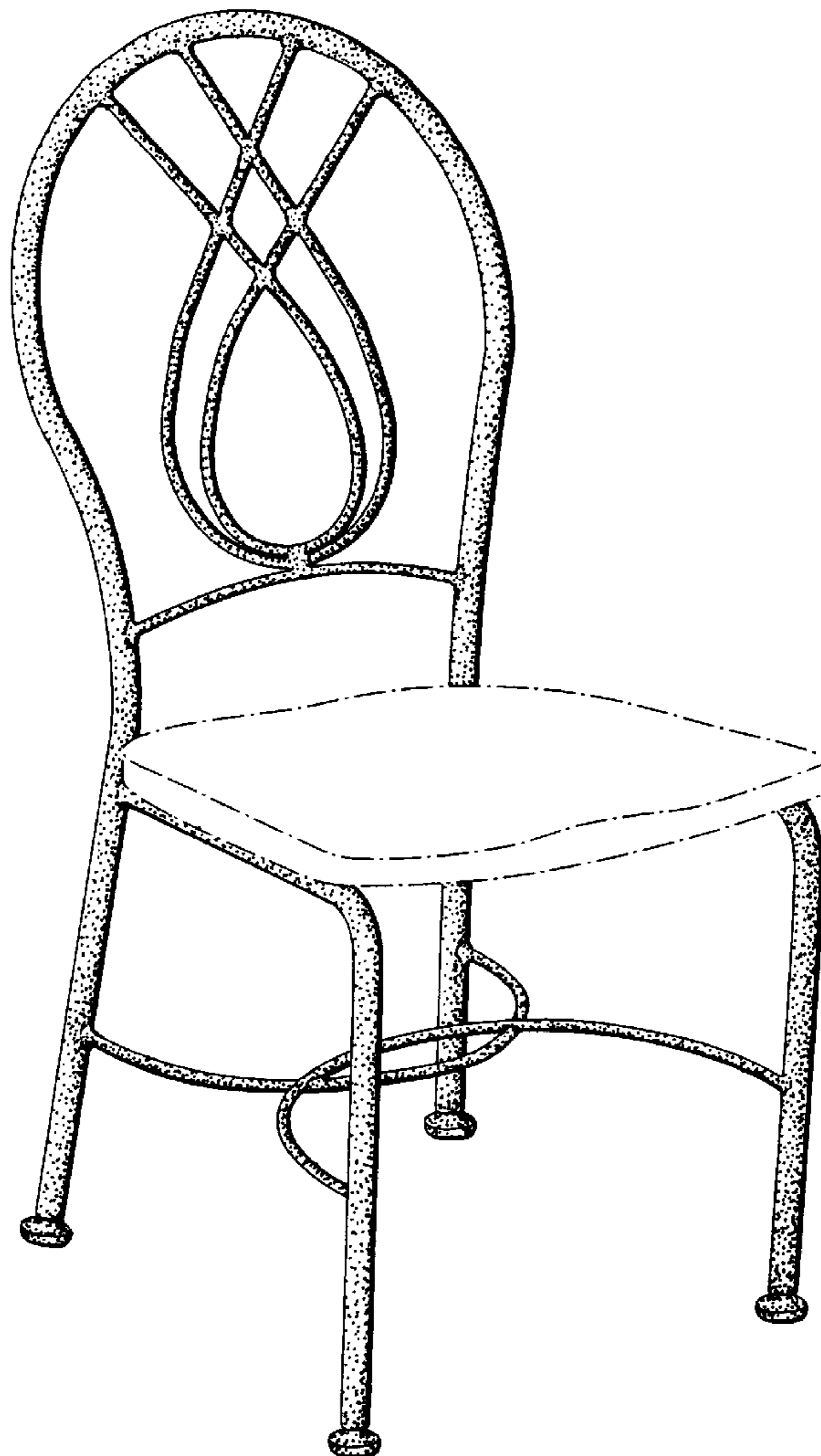
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof, the left side elevation being the mirror image thereof;

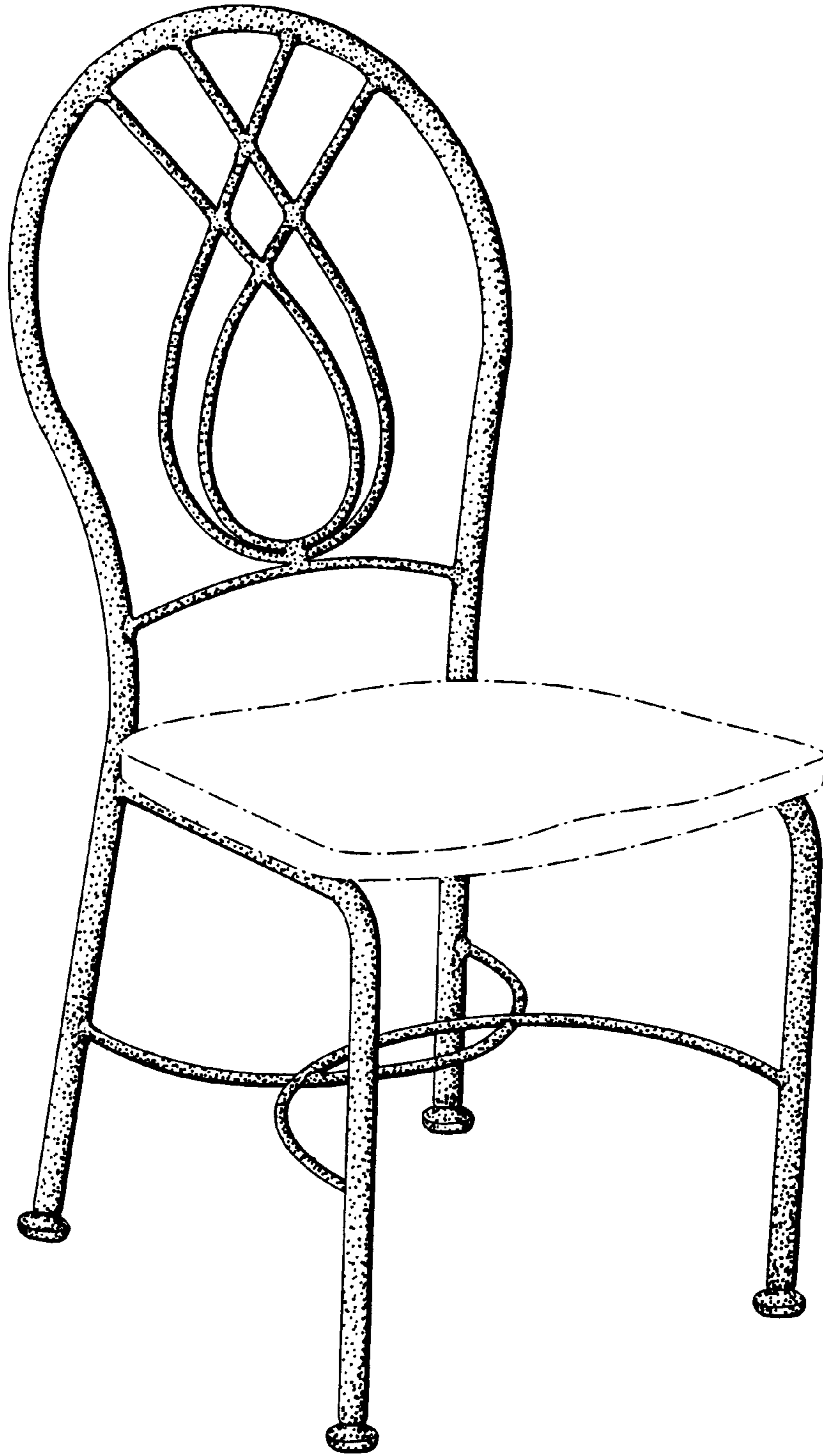

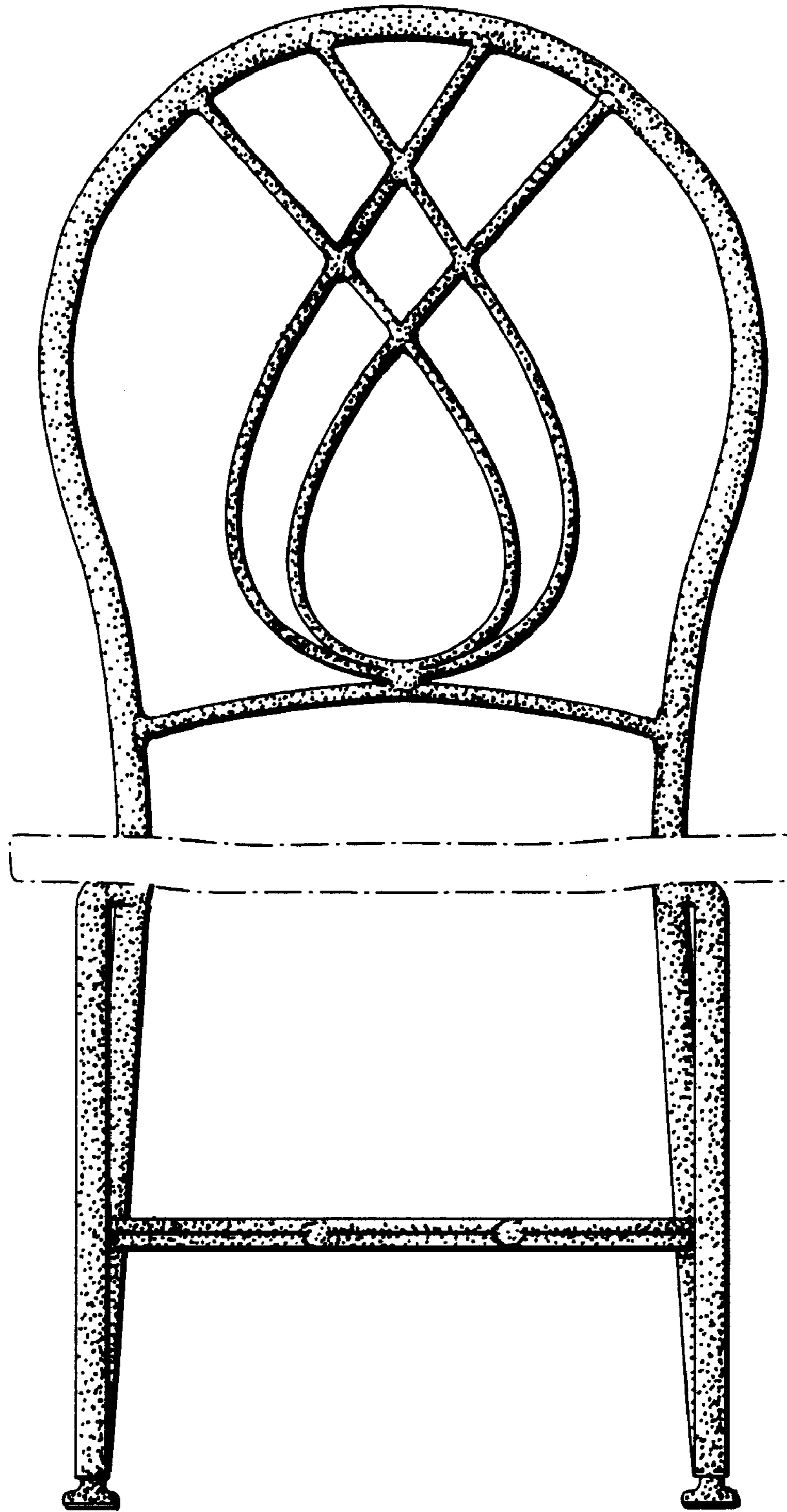

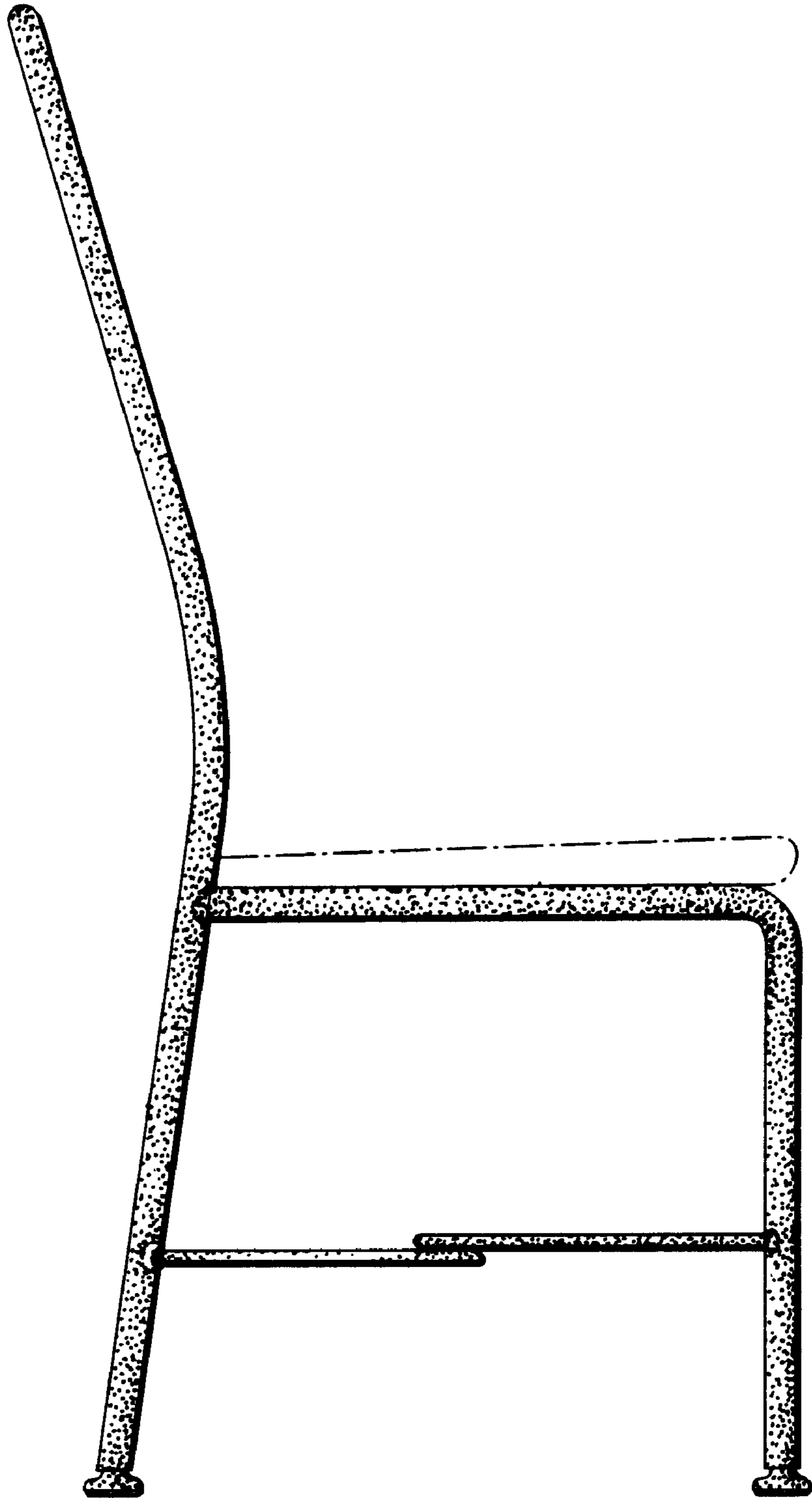

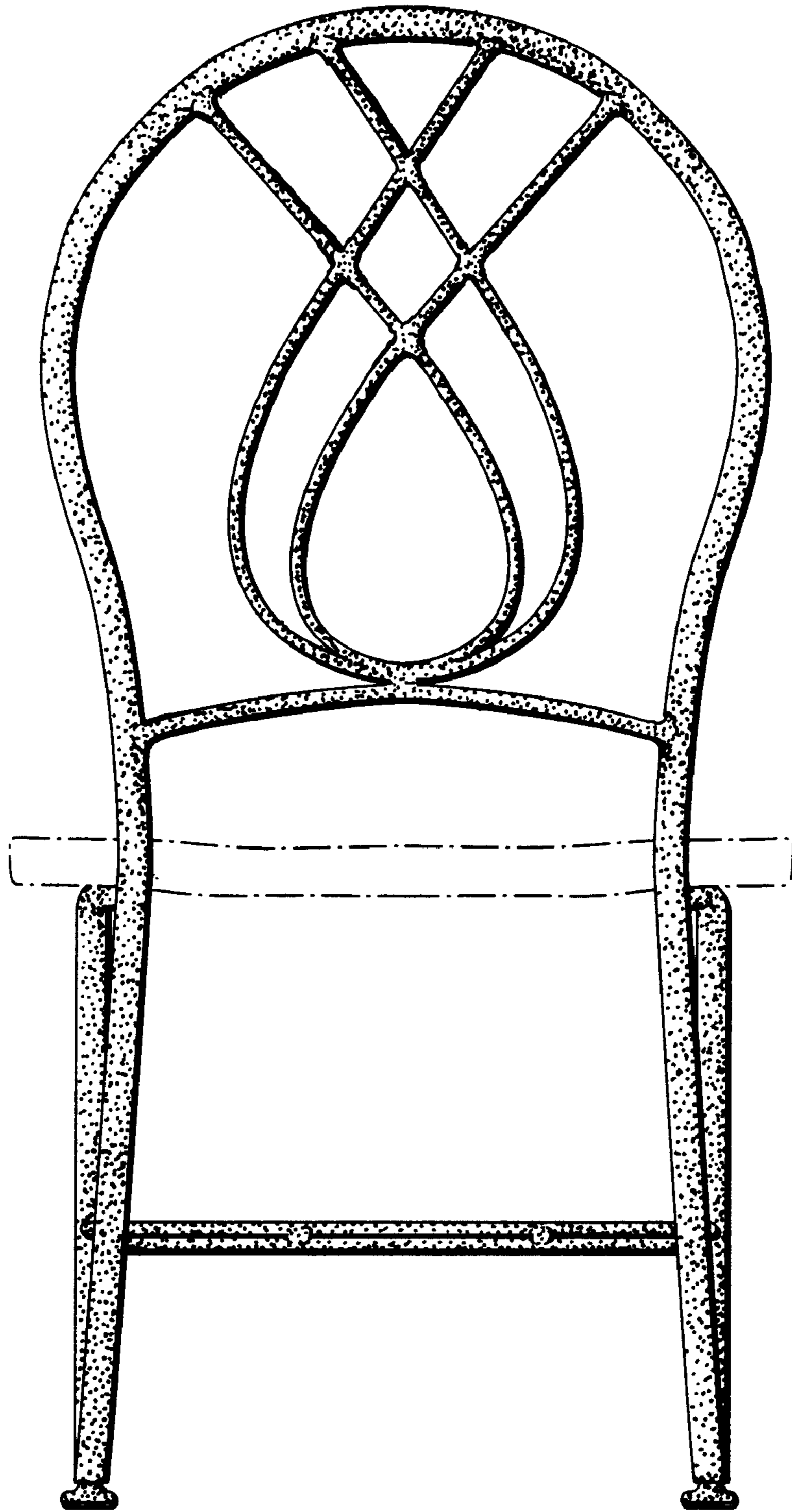

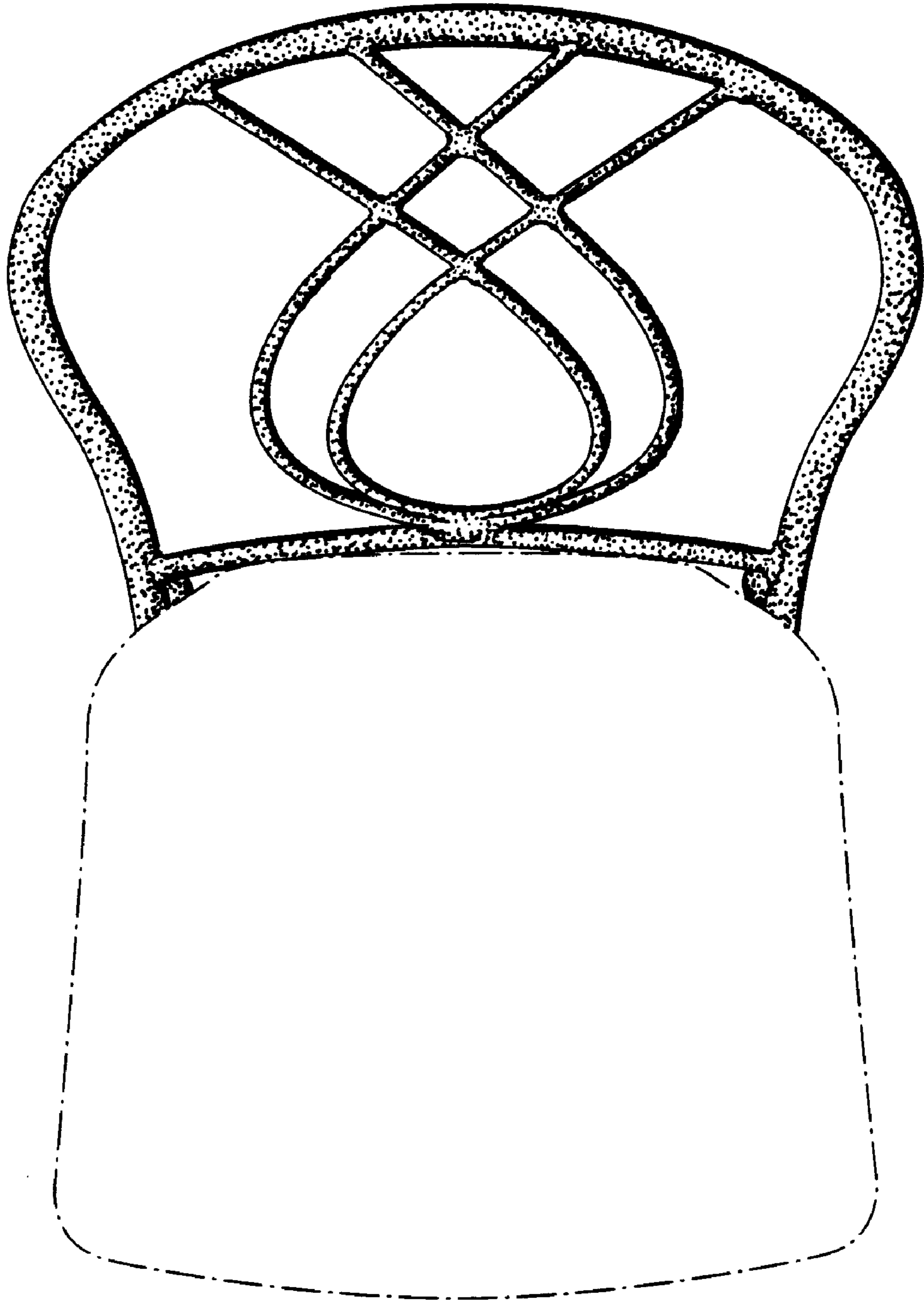
