DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view taken from the left side of
the chair shown in FIG. 1, the opposite side of the chair
being a mirror image of the view illustrated in FIG. 3;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view; and,
FIG. 5 is a top view.

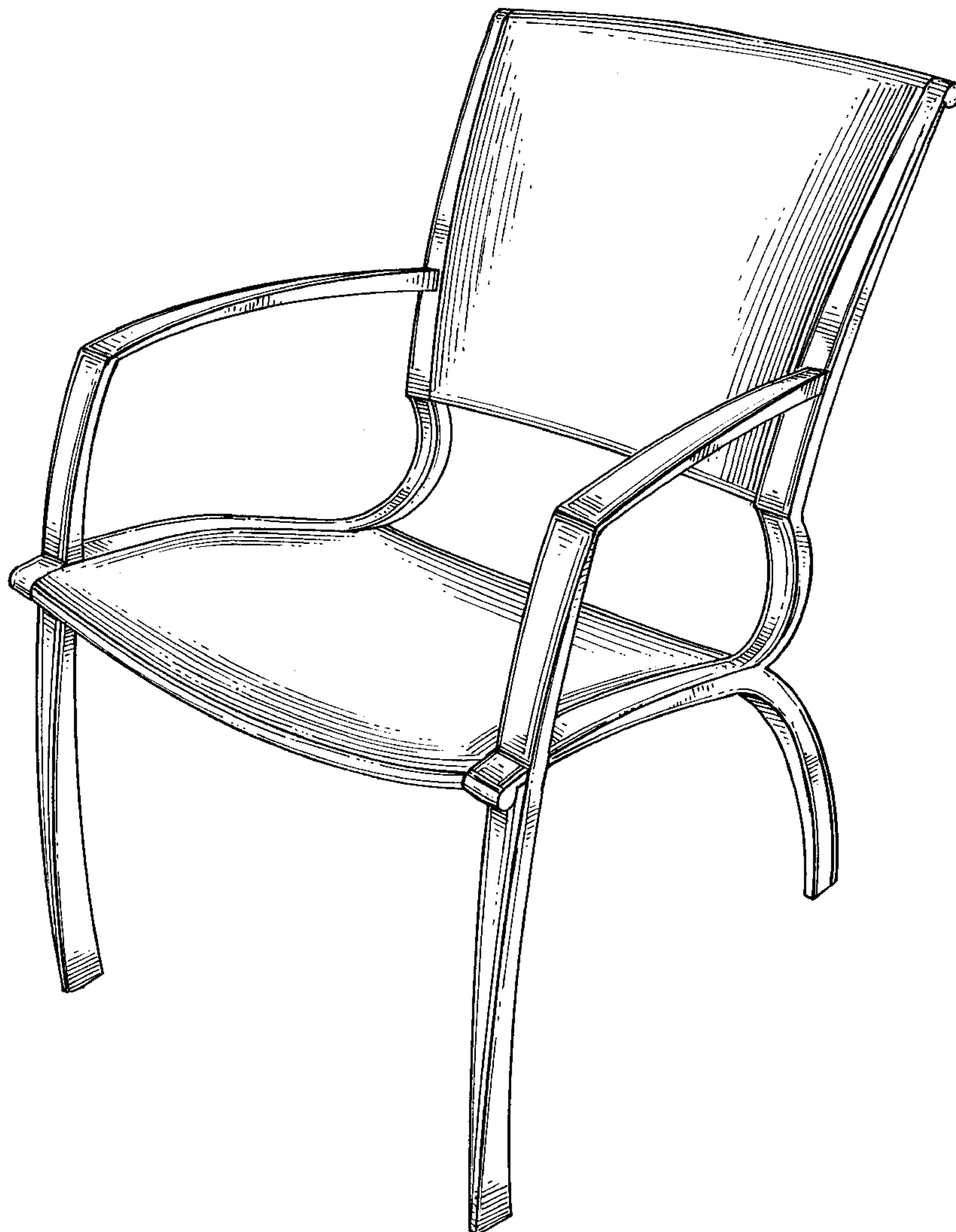

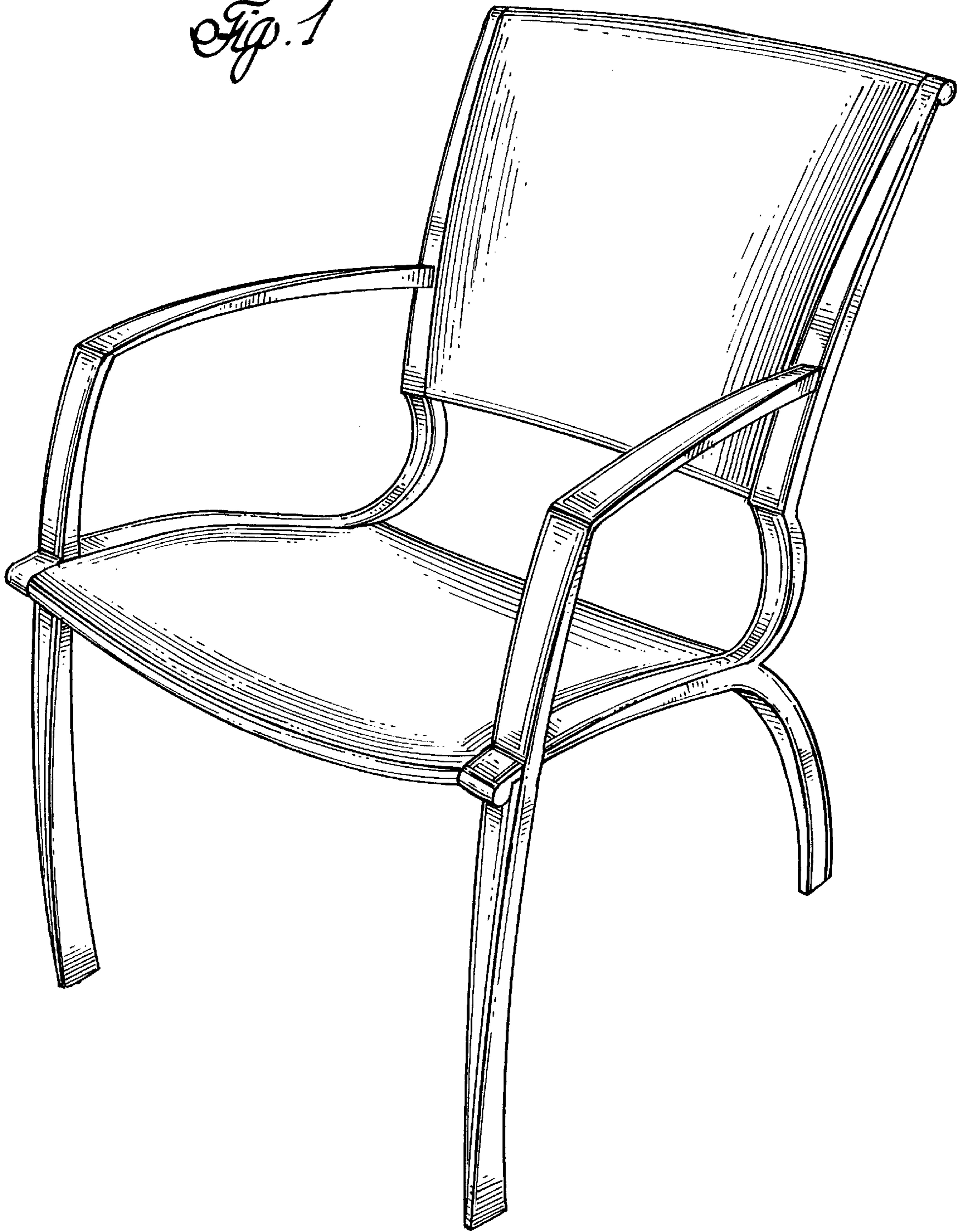

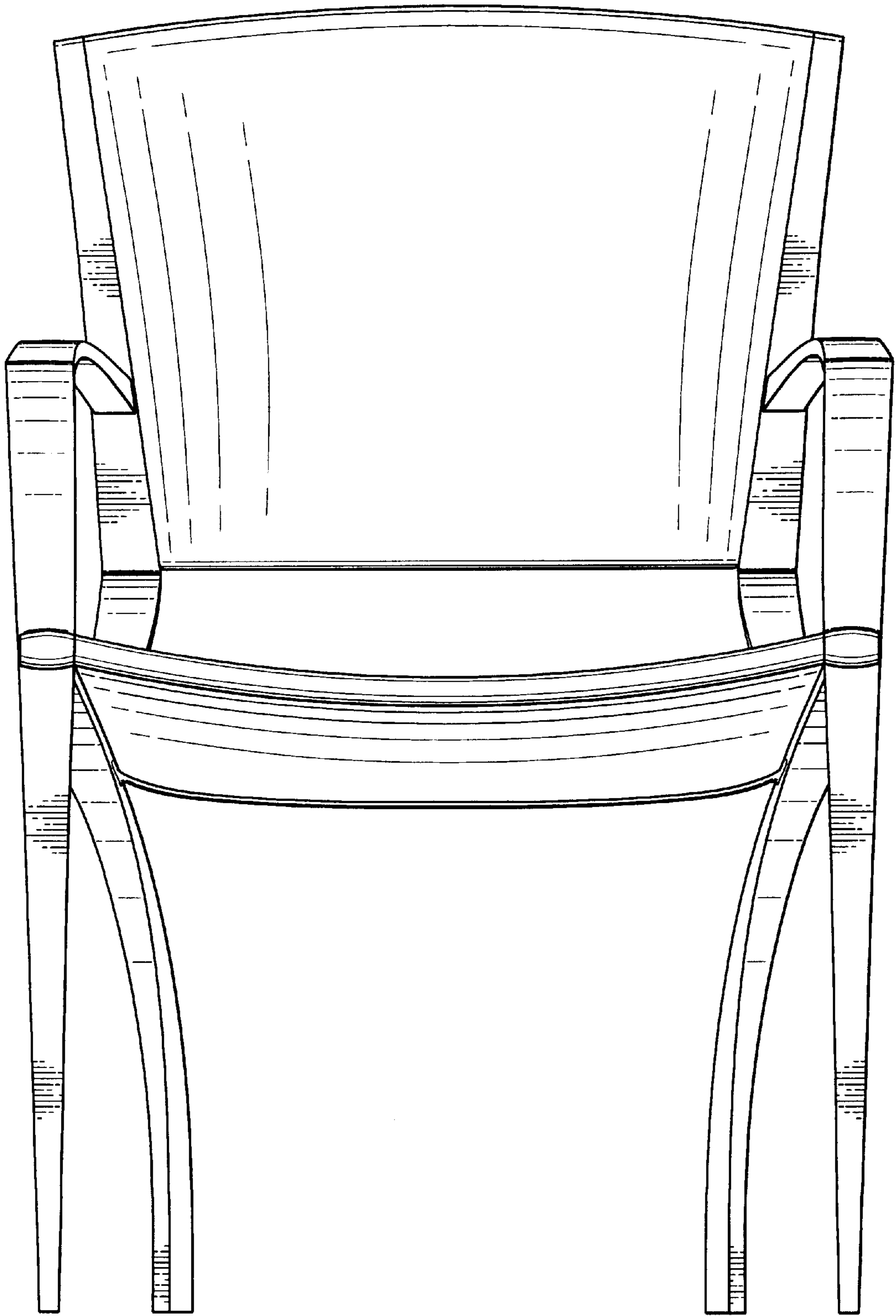

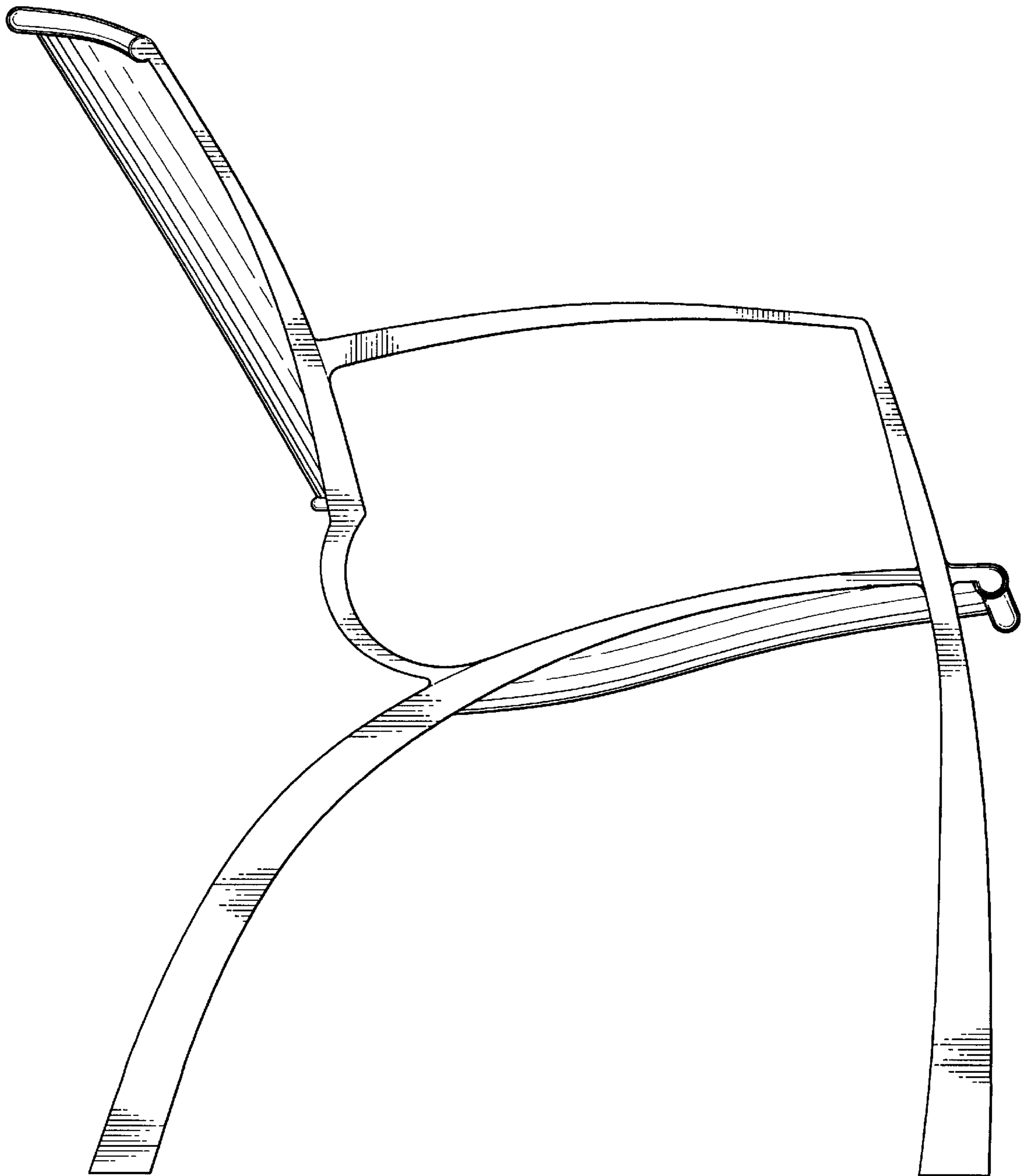

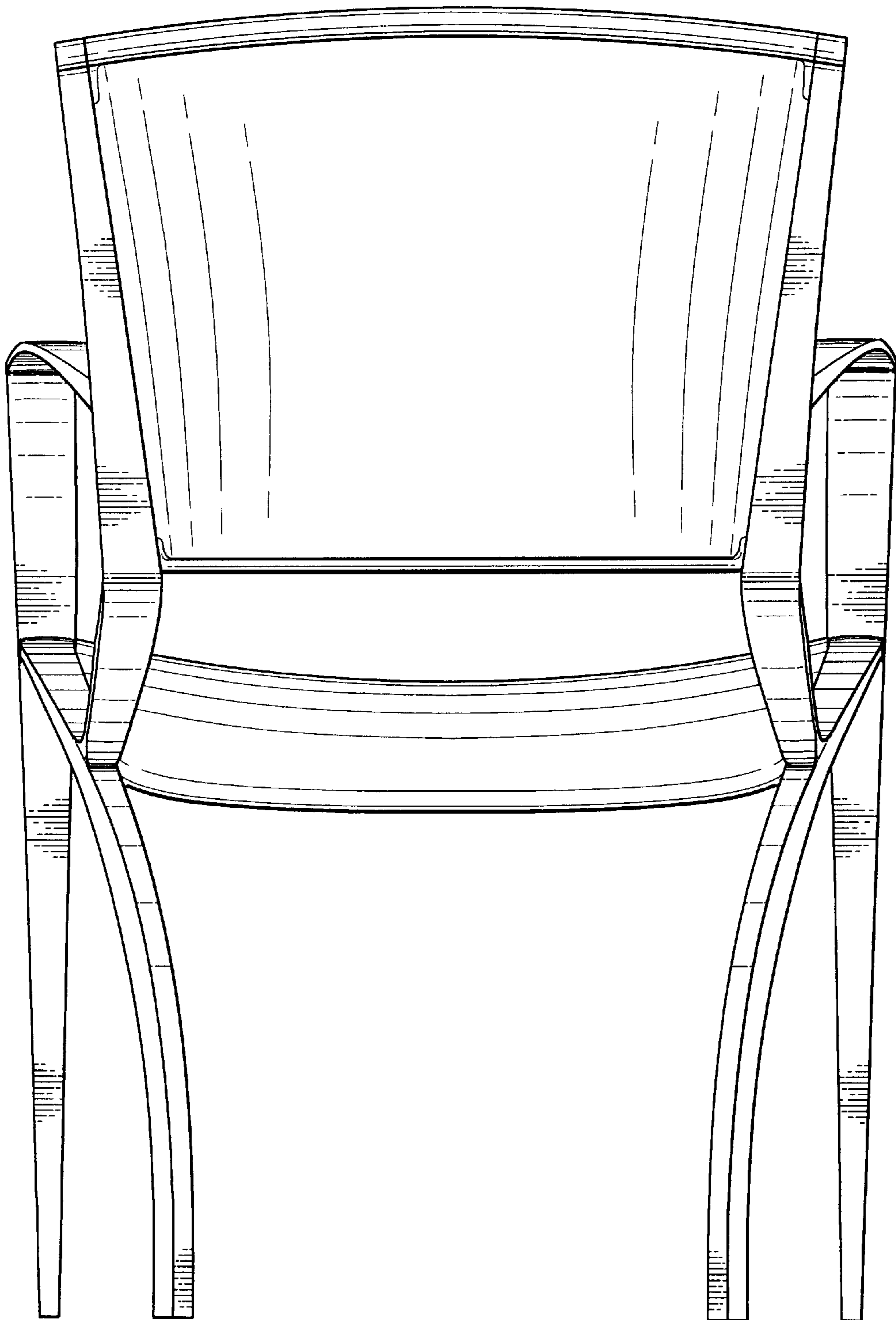
