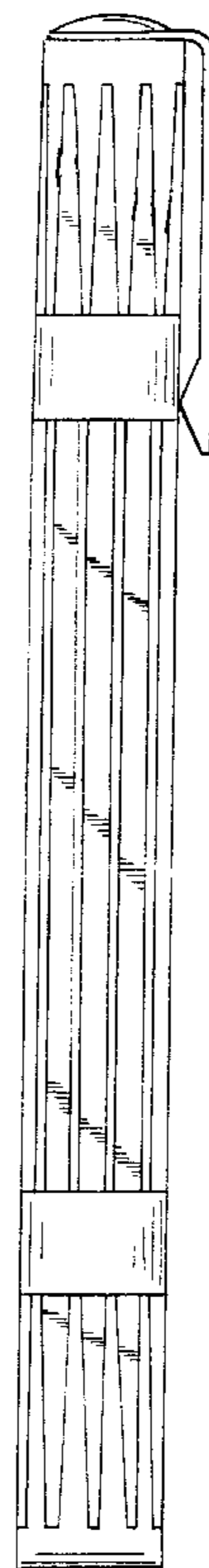
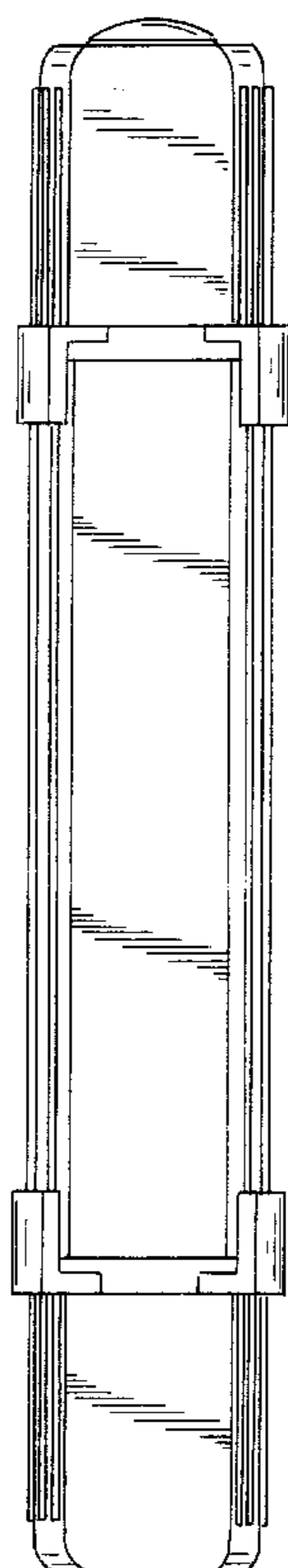
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a double-headed pen/marker, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the double-headed pen/marker of the present invention.
 FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the double-headed pen/marker of the present invention.
 FIG. 3 is a rear side, elevational view of the double-headed pen/marker of the present invention.
 FIG. 4 is an upper side, end view of the top and of the double-headed pen/marker of the present invention.
 FIG. 5 is a bottom side, end view of the bottom end of the double-headed pen/marker of the present invention.
 FIG. 6 is an exploded view of FIG. 1 with the two caps removed.
 FIG. 7 is an exploded view of FIG. 2 showing the double-headed pen/marker with the two caps removed.
 FIG. 8 is an end view of the double-headed pen/marker as seen along lines 8—8 in FIG. 6; and,
 FIG. 9 is an end view of the cross-section view as seen along lines 9—9 in FIG. 6.

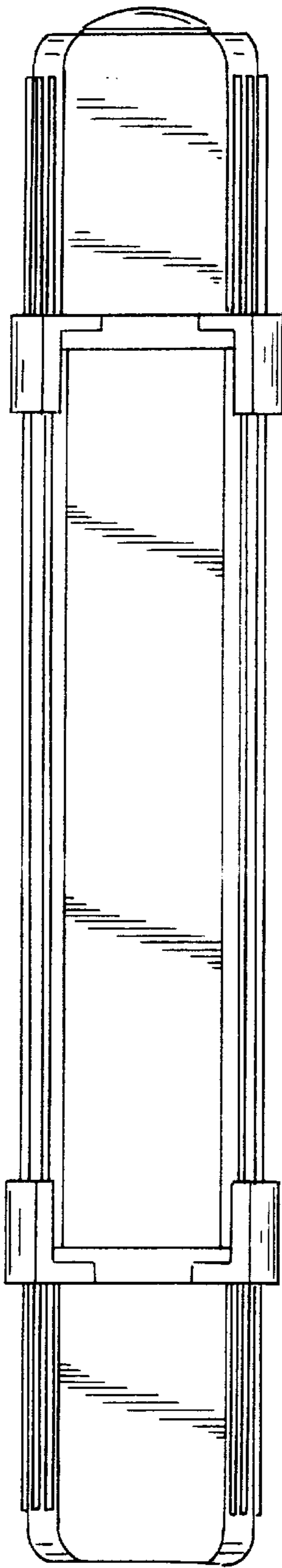

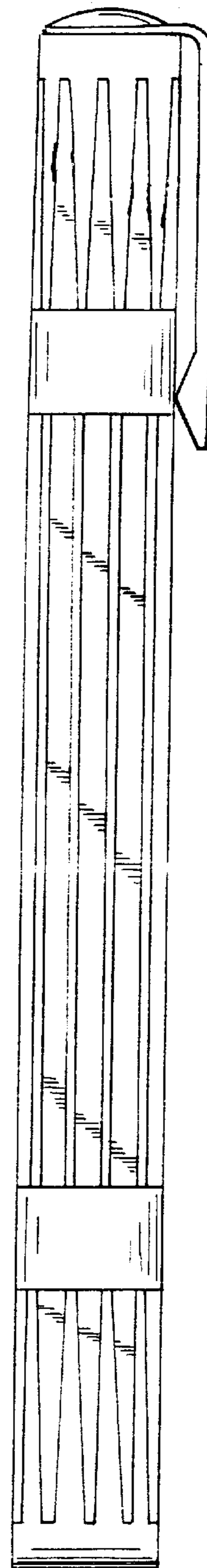

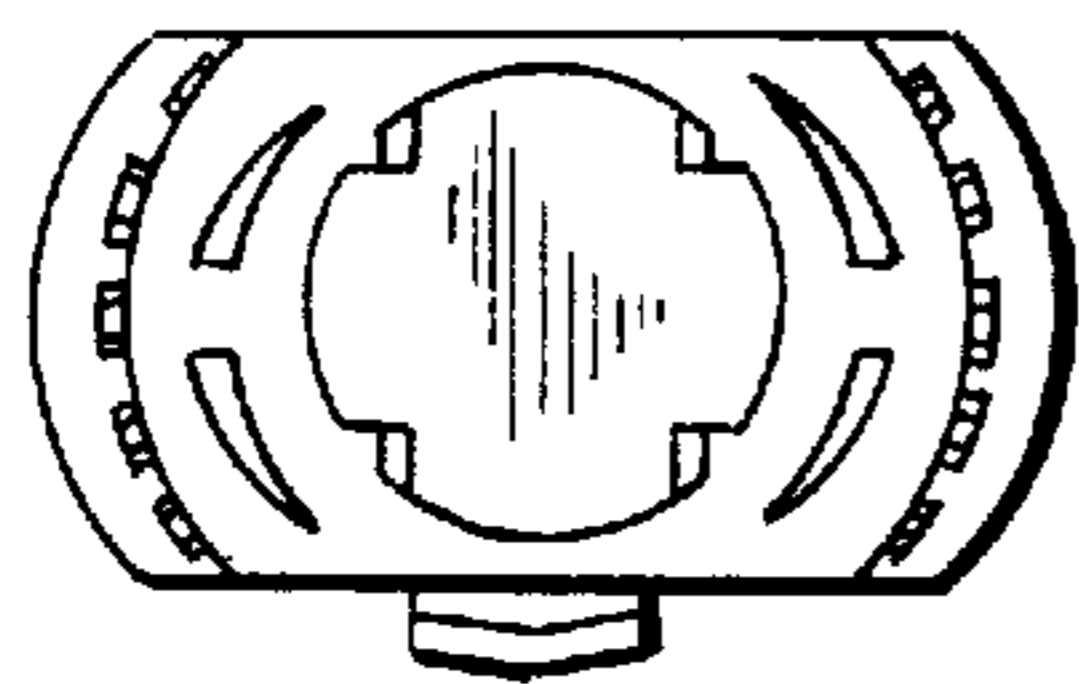

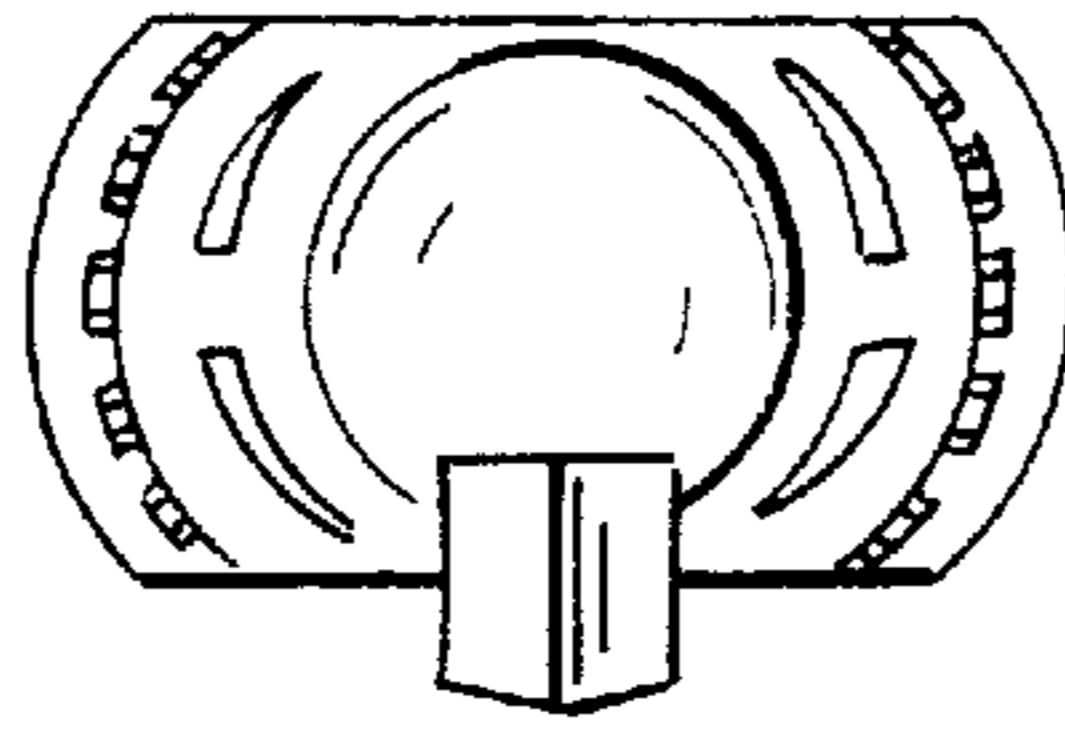

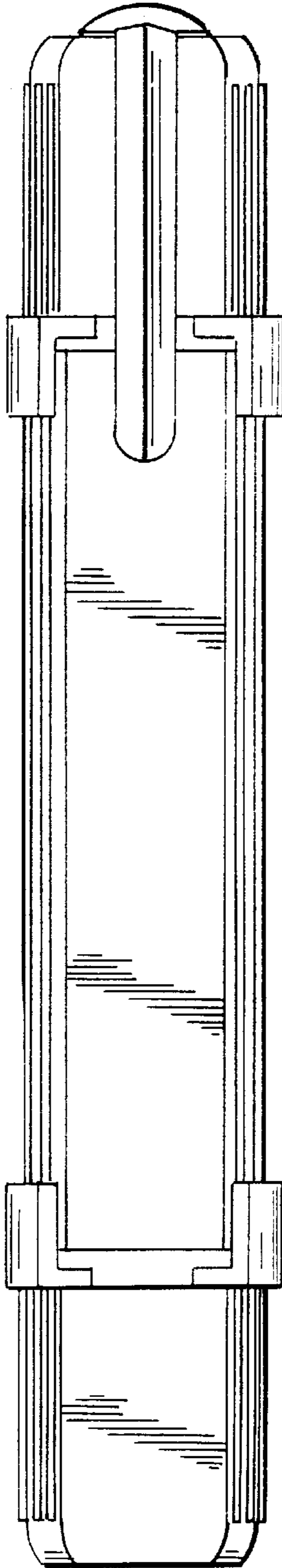

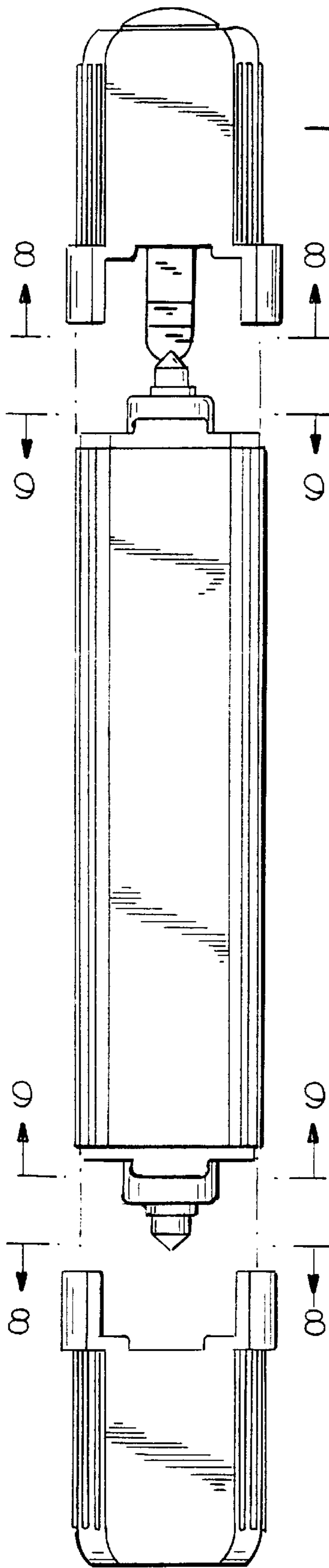

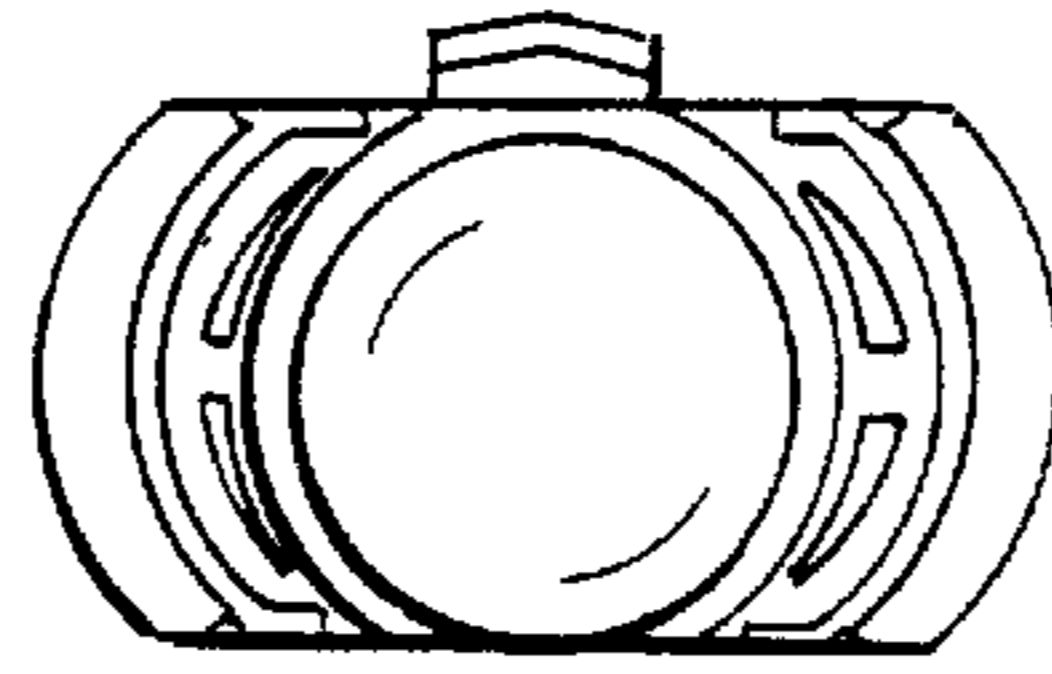

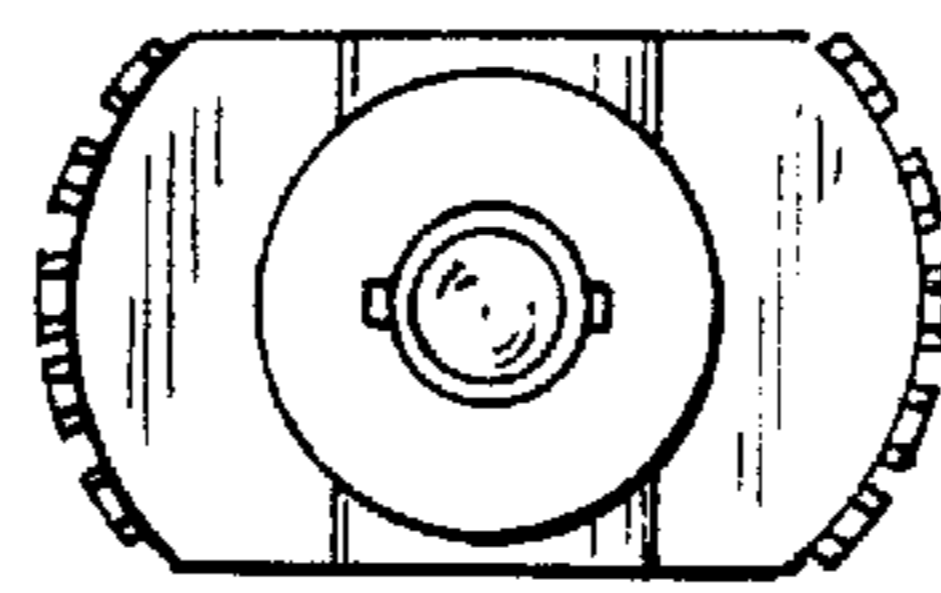
