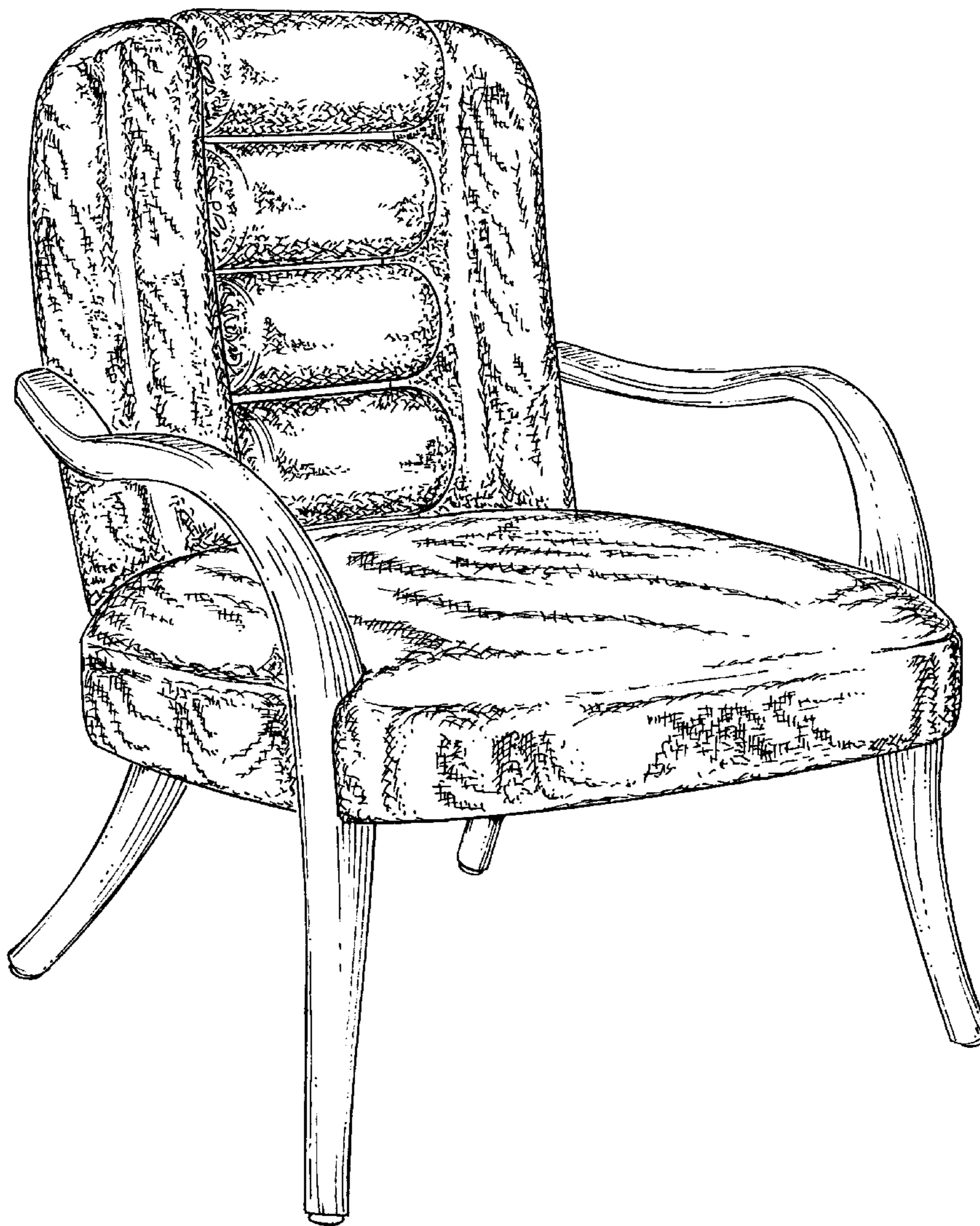
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the chair showing my new design; and, FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof. The fragmented cross-hatching shown on the seat and backrest is understood to represent upholstery and would be continuous throughout the implied areas.

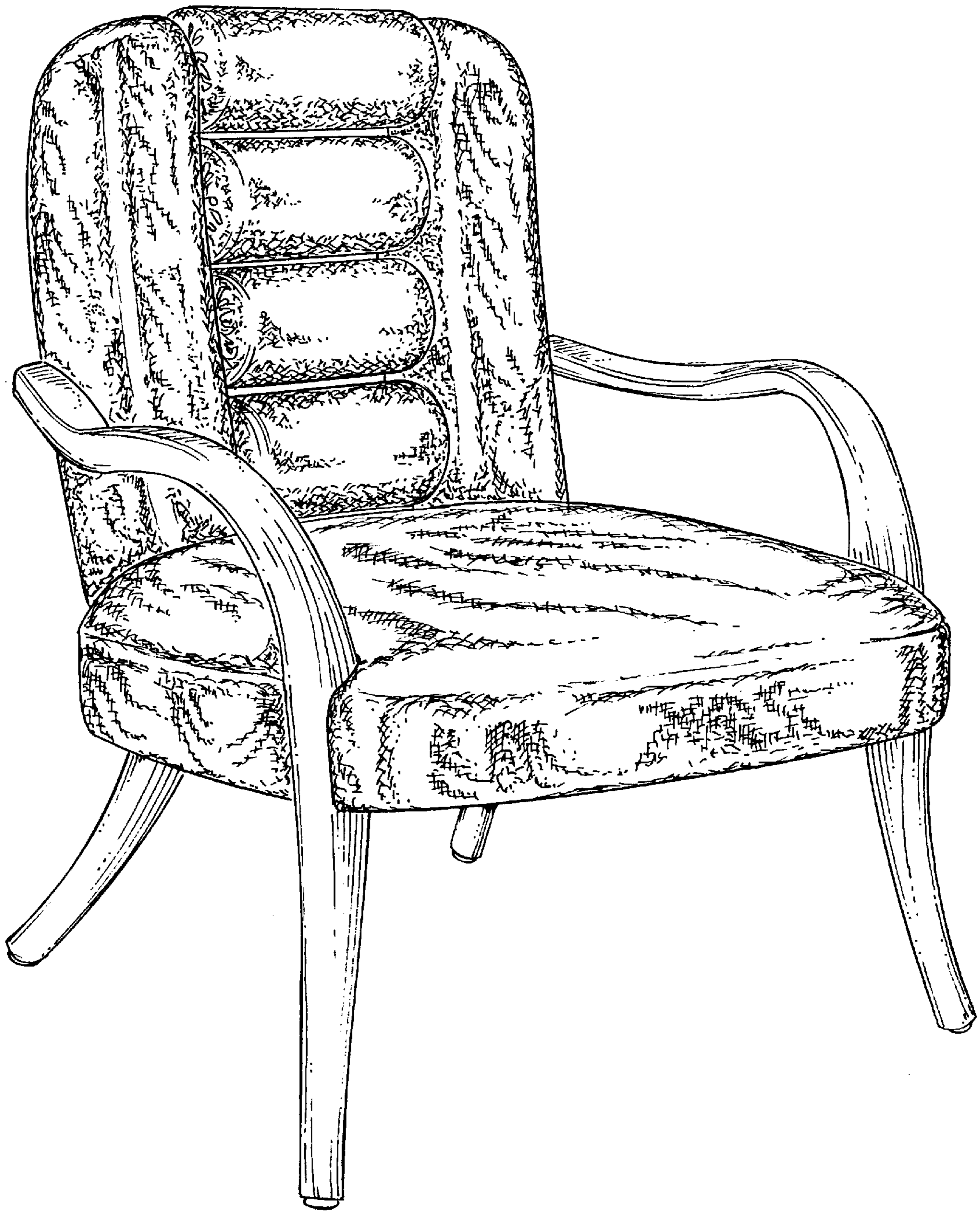

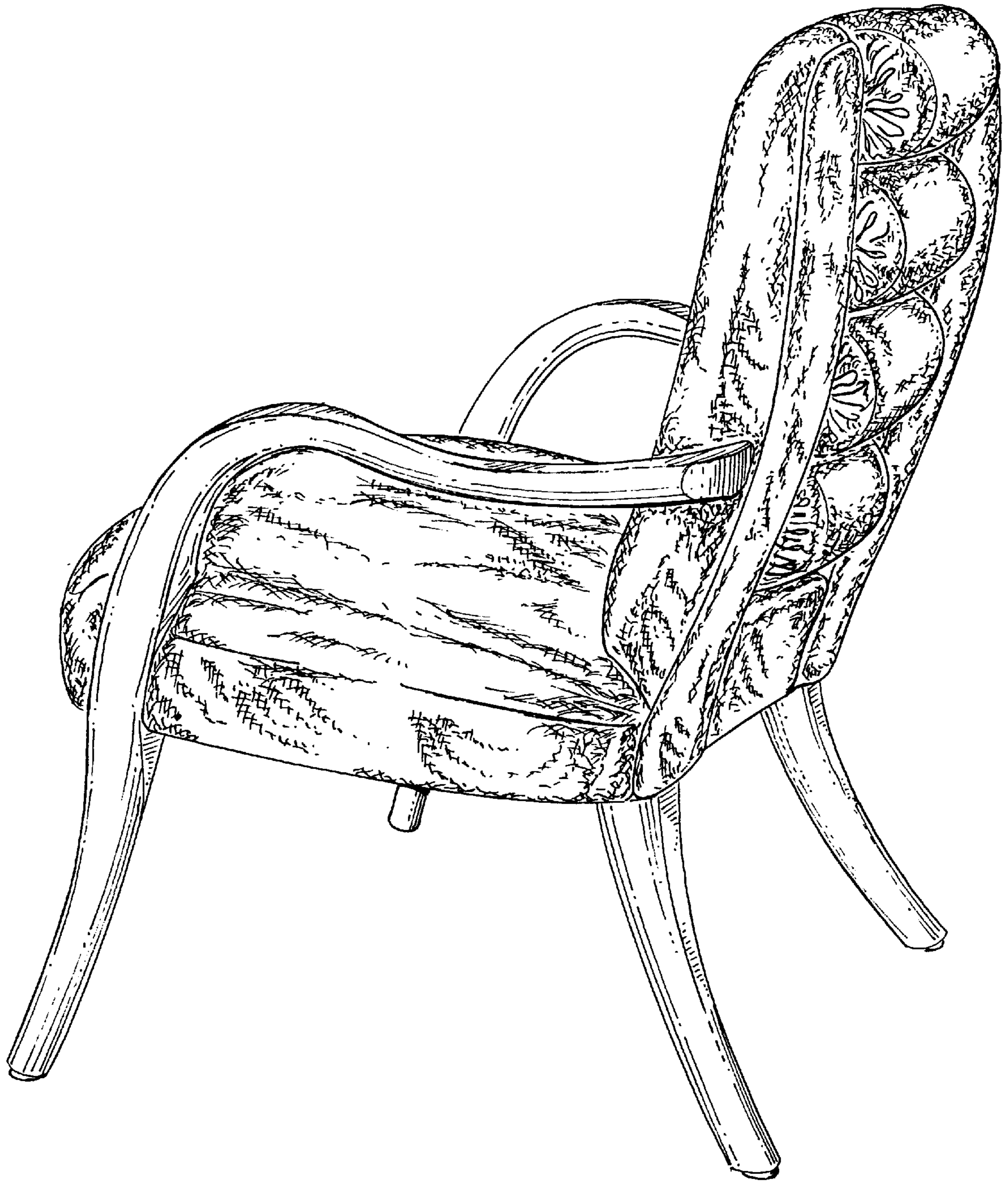
