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[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a portable emergency radio signal transmitter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a portable emergency radio signal transmitter showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof, the bottom being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a back view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a sectional view taken along lines VI—VI in FIG. 1, the internal mechanism of the transmitter being omitted;
FIG. 7 is a sectional view taken along lines VII—VII in FIG. 2, the internal mechanism of the transmitter being omitted;
FIG. 8 is a sectional view taken along lines VIII—VIII in FIG. 1, the internal mechanism of the transmitter being omitted; and,
FIG. 9 is a perspective view thereof.

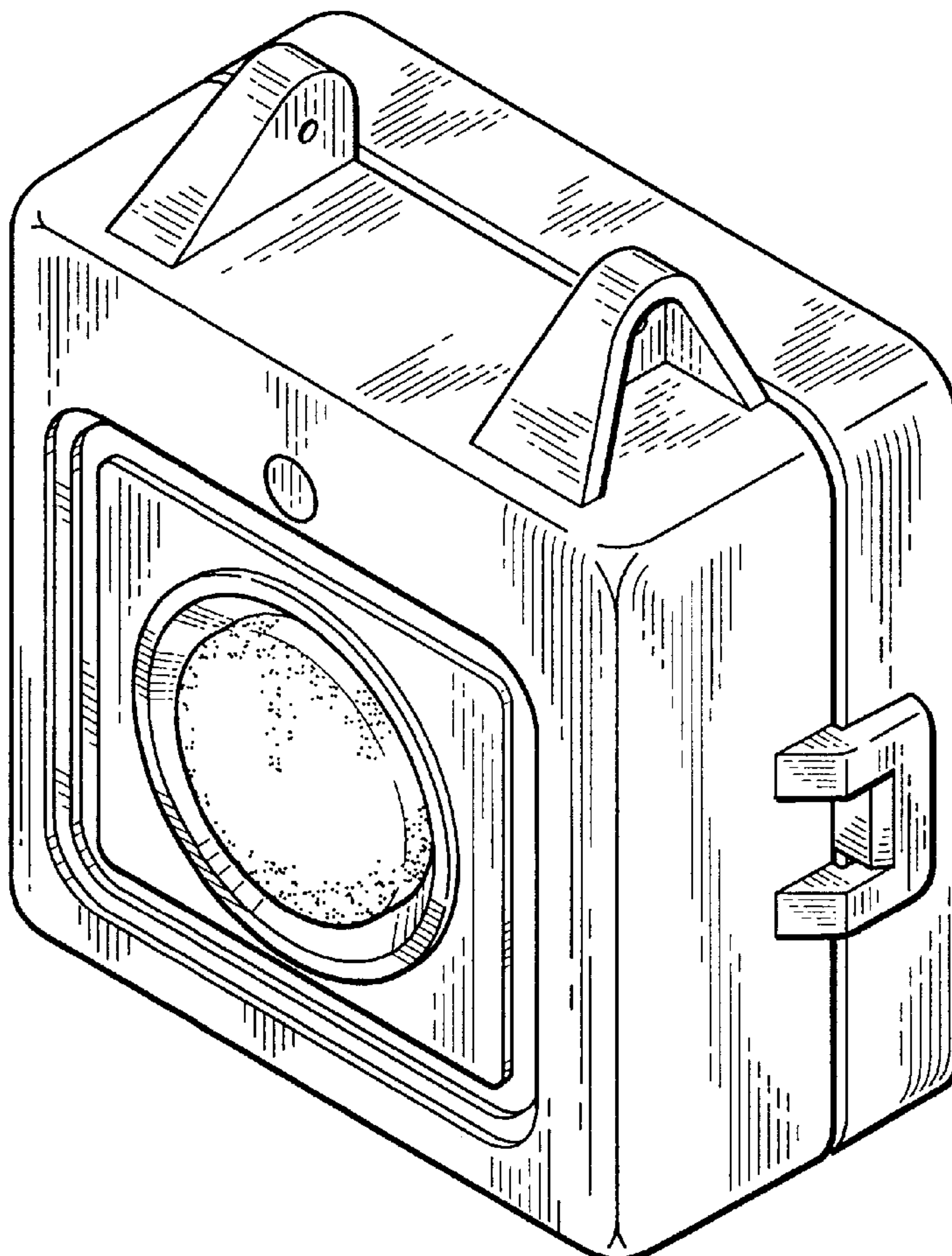

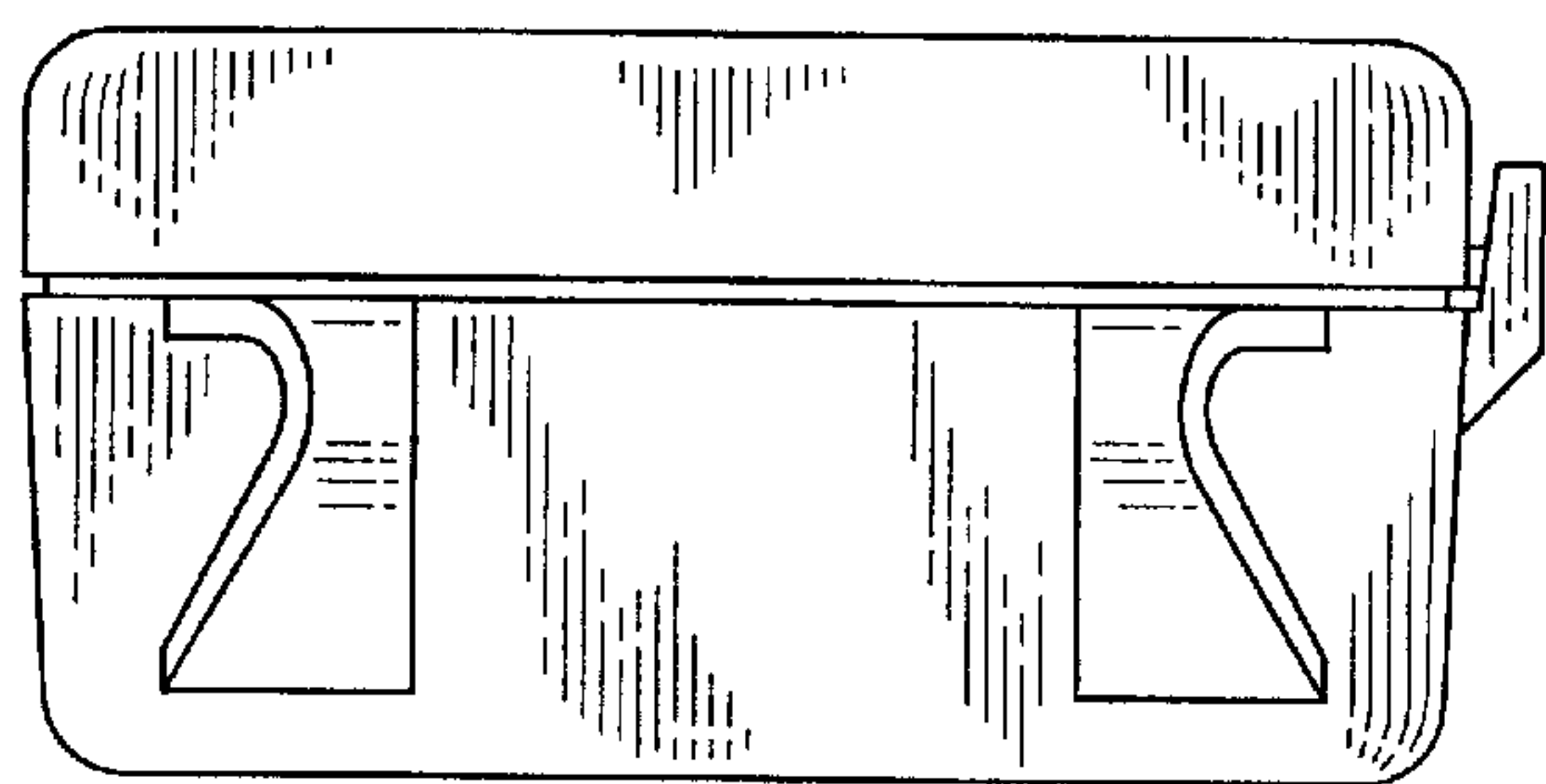

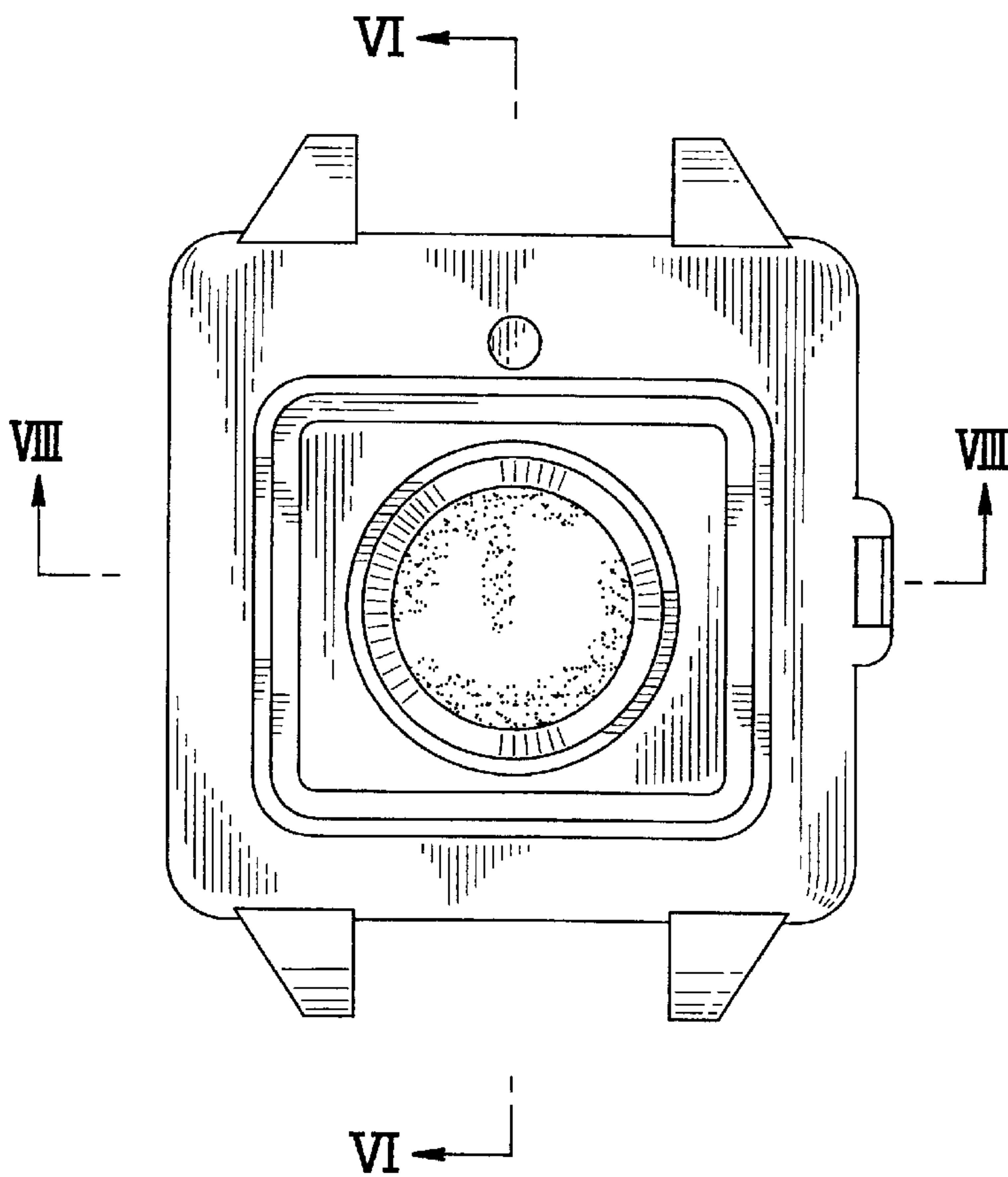

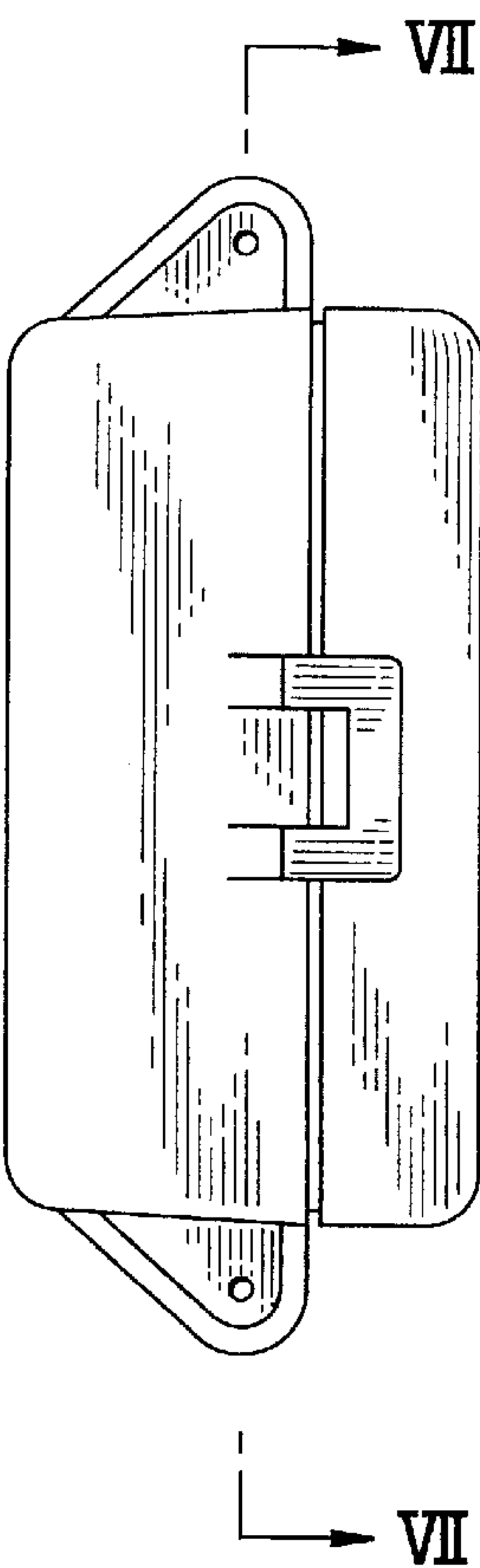

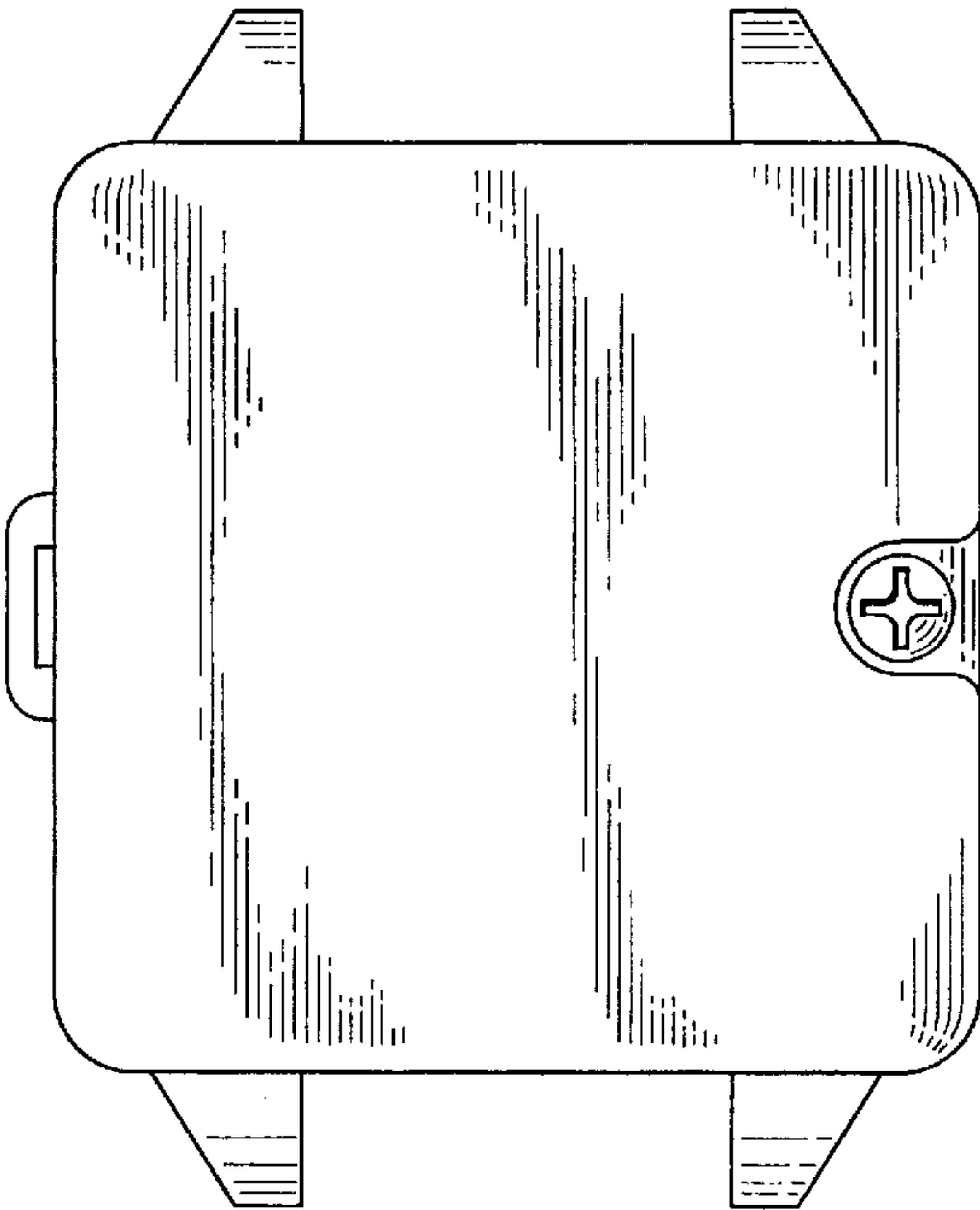

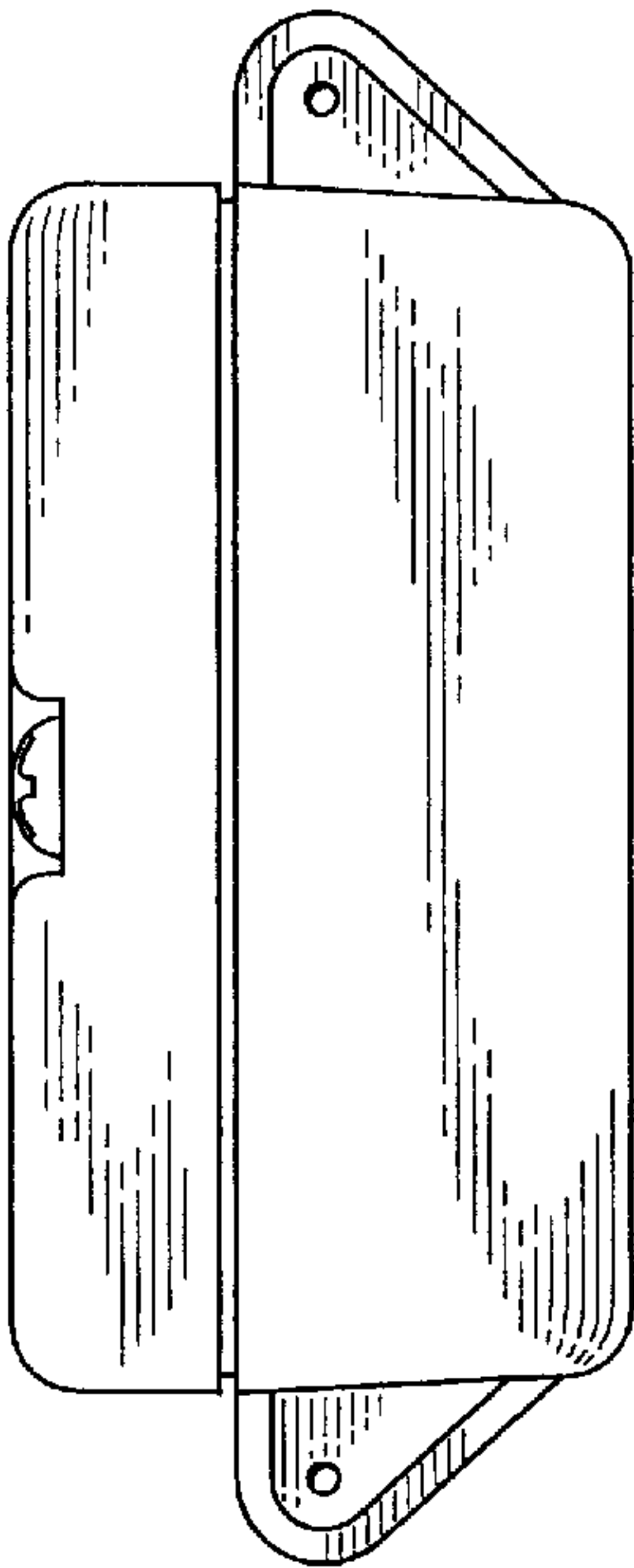

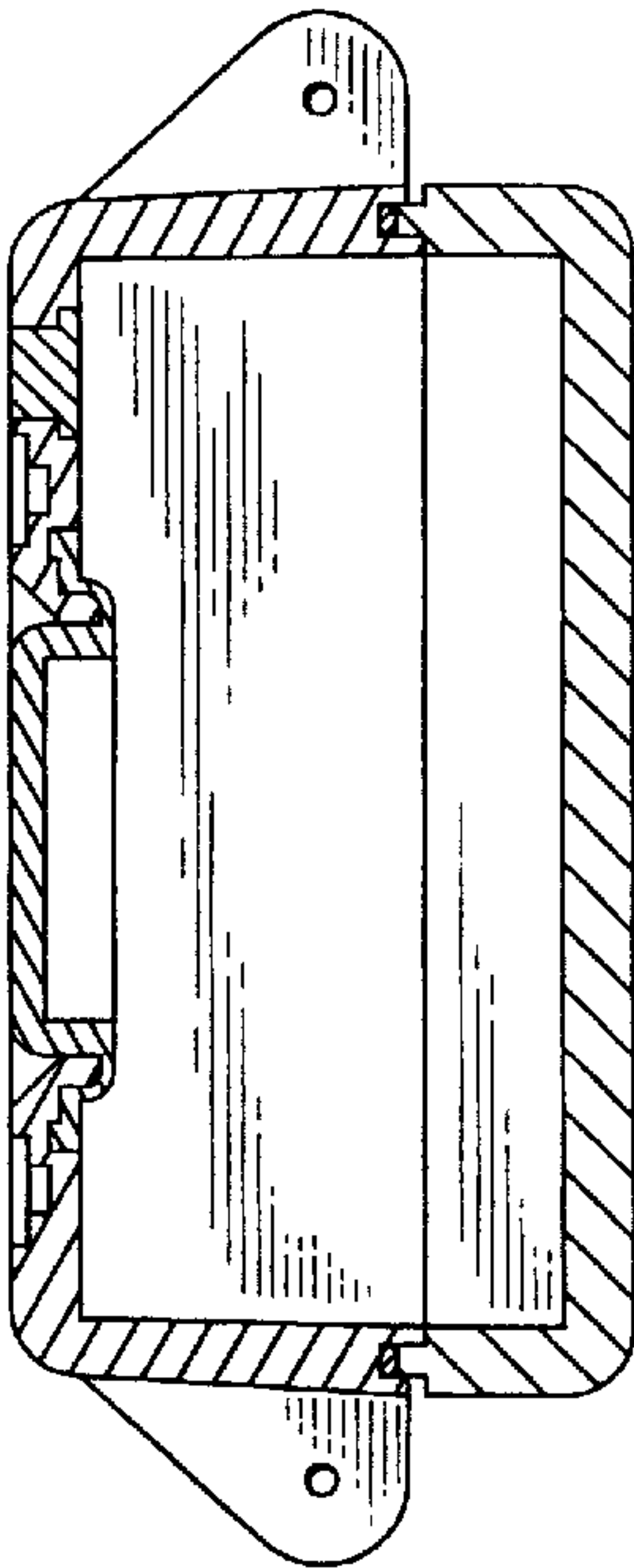

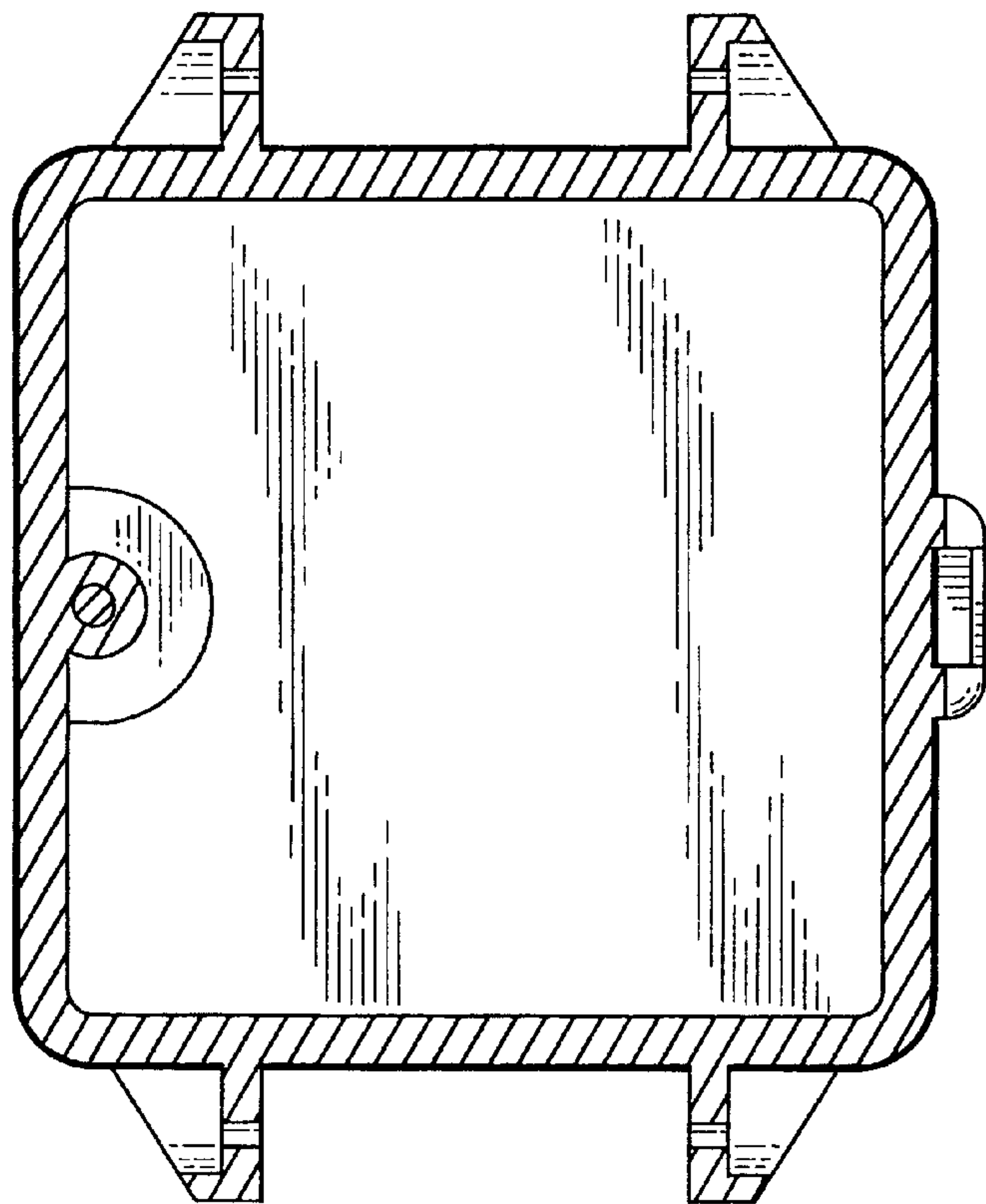

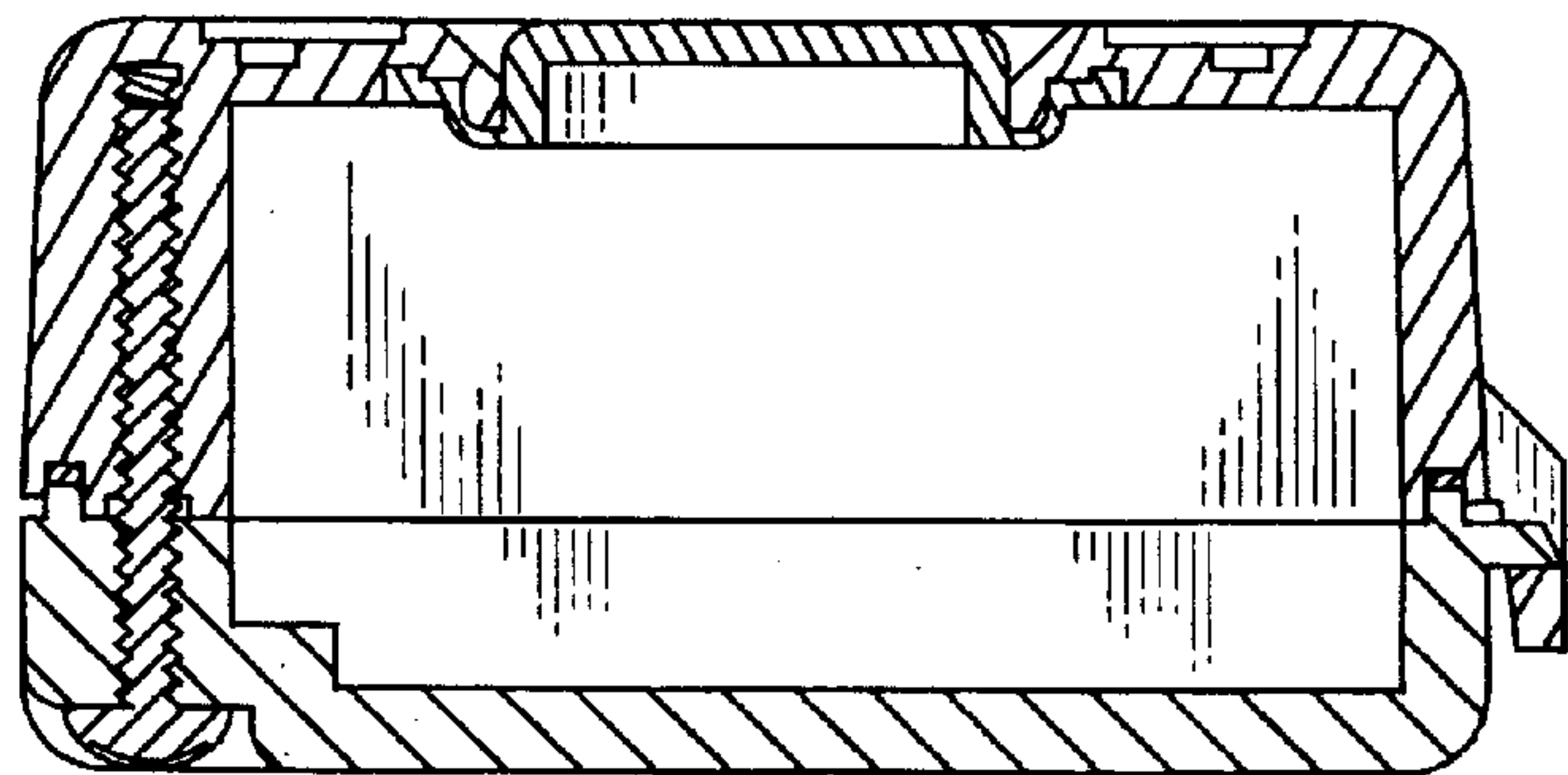
