DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a vehicle showing our new design;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

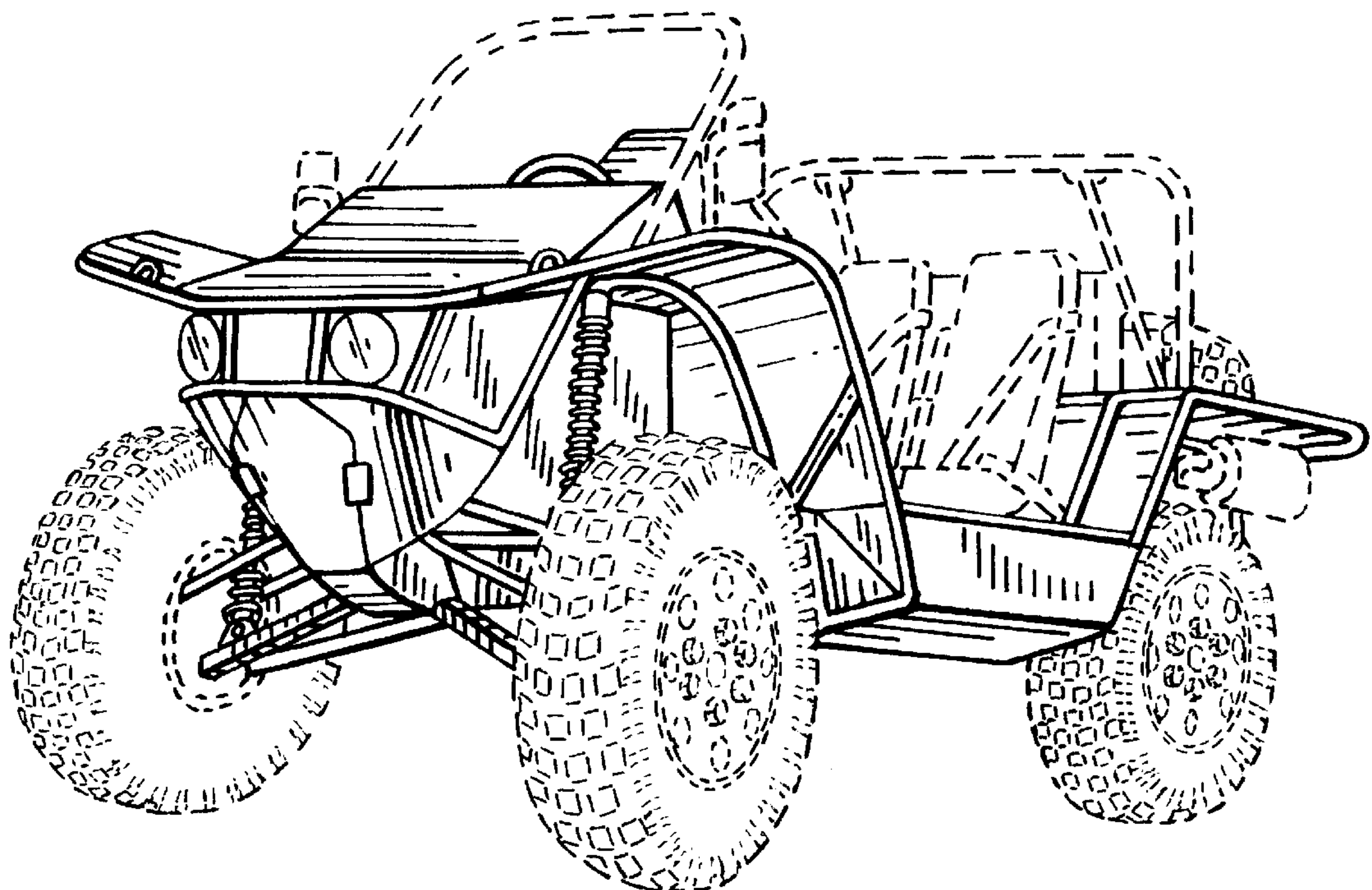
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view thereof;

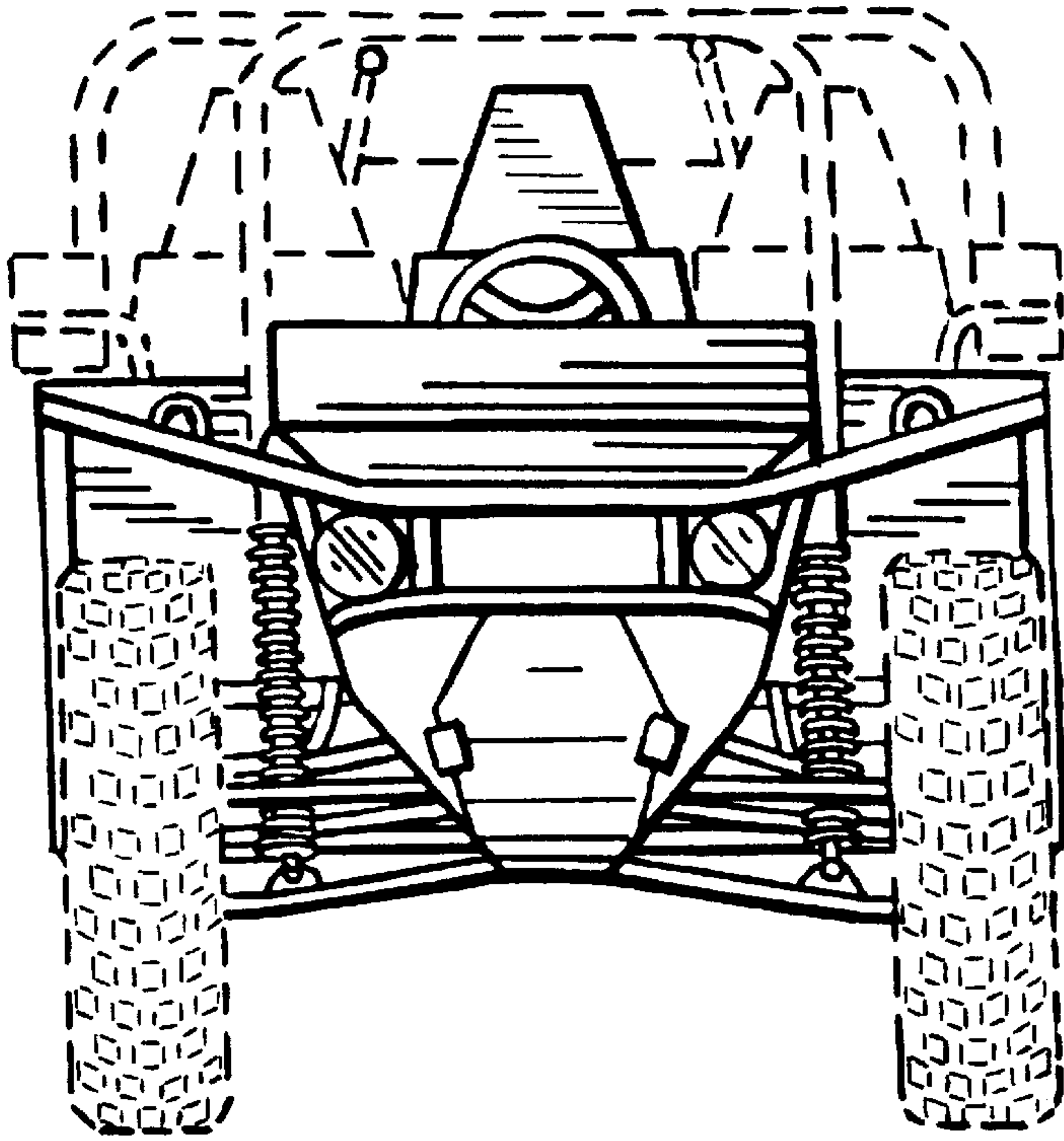

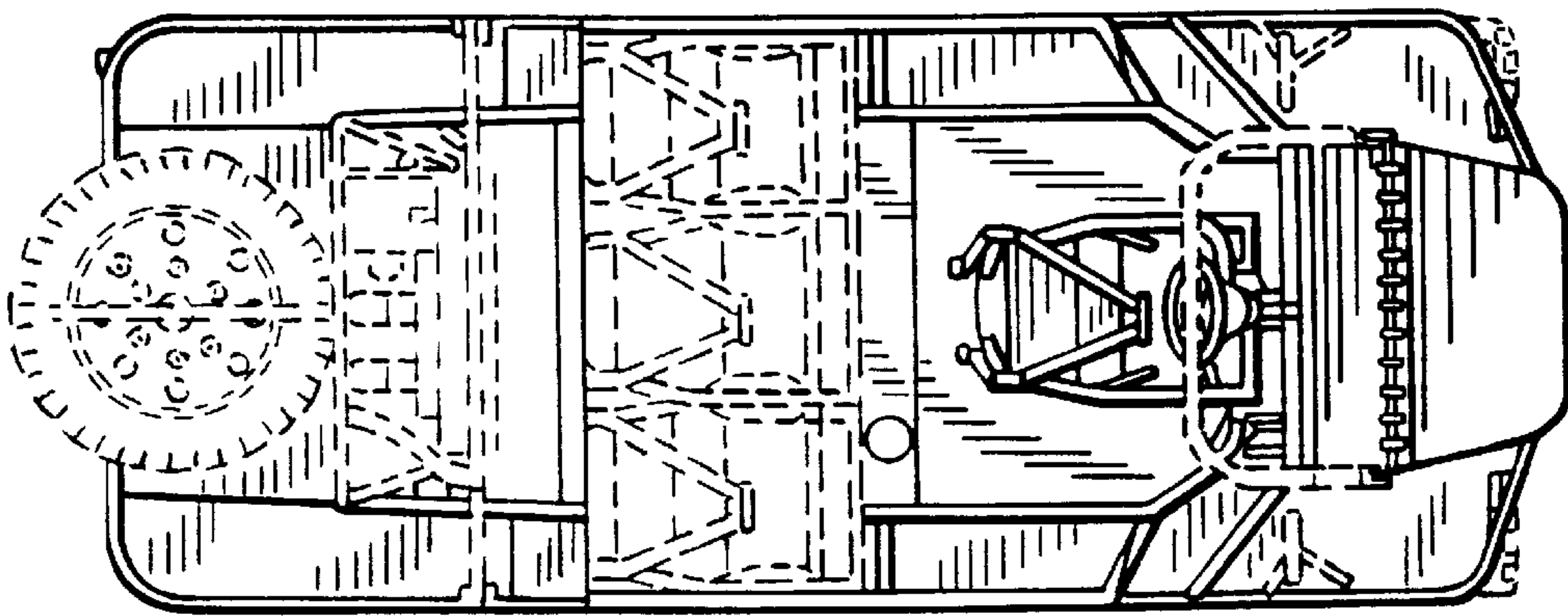
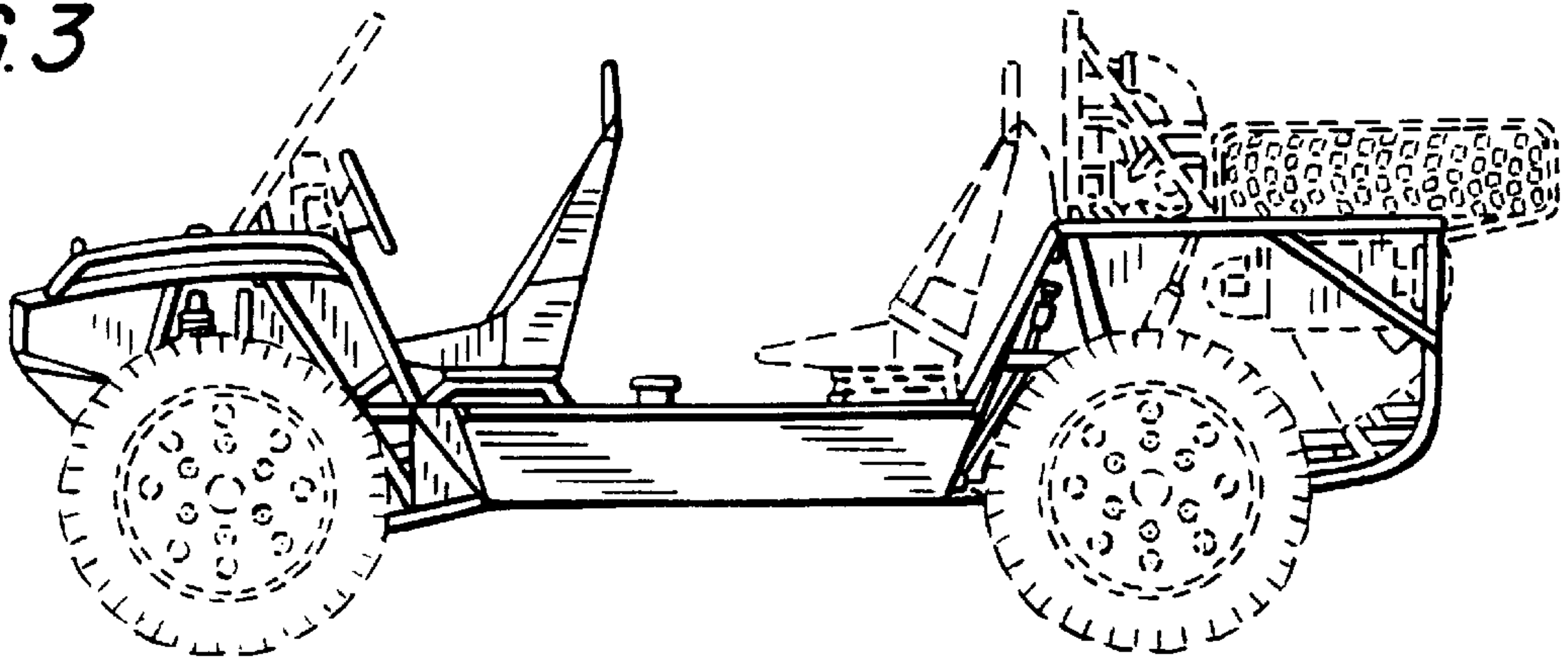

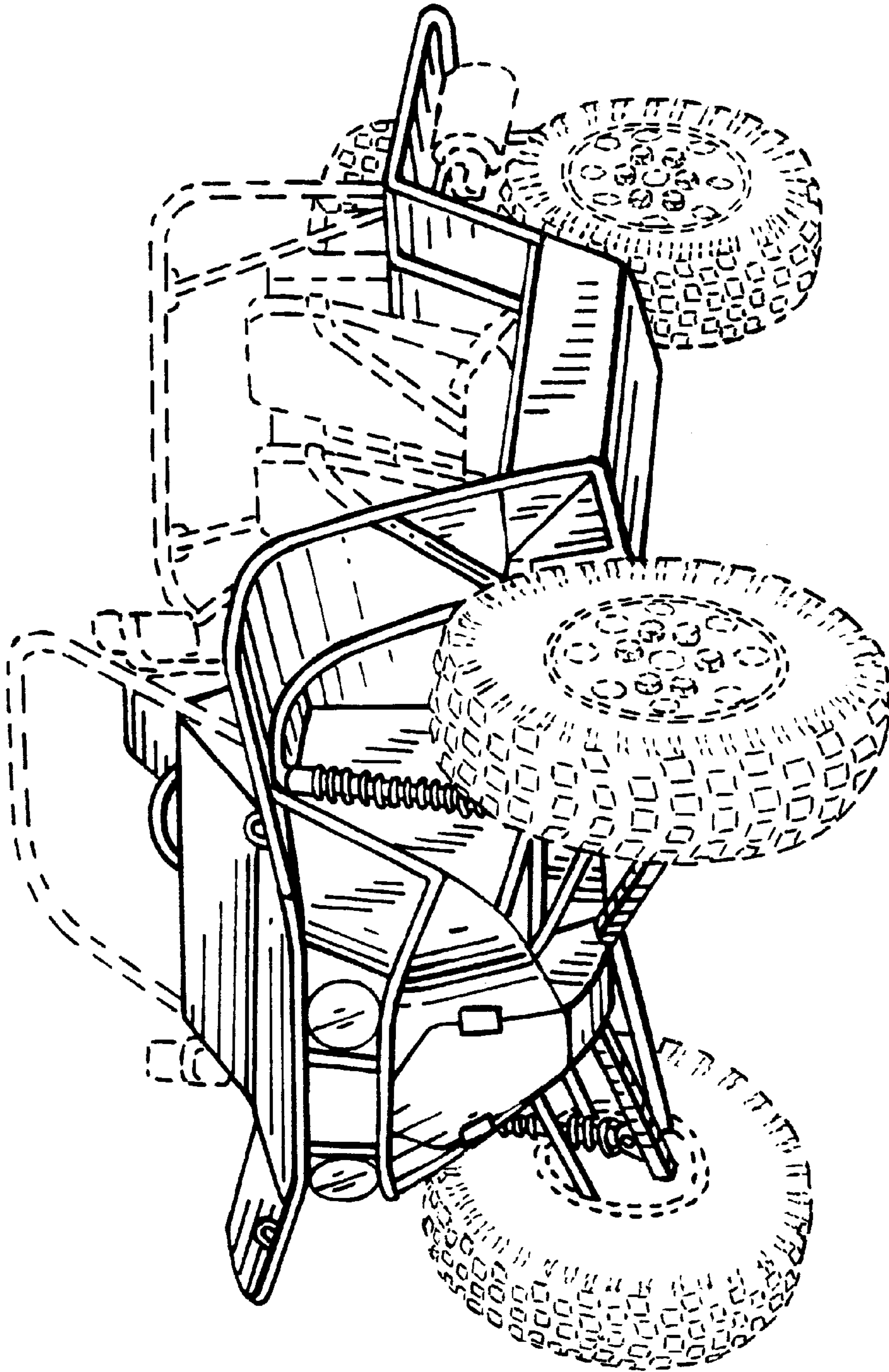

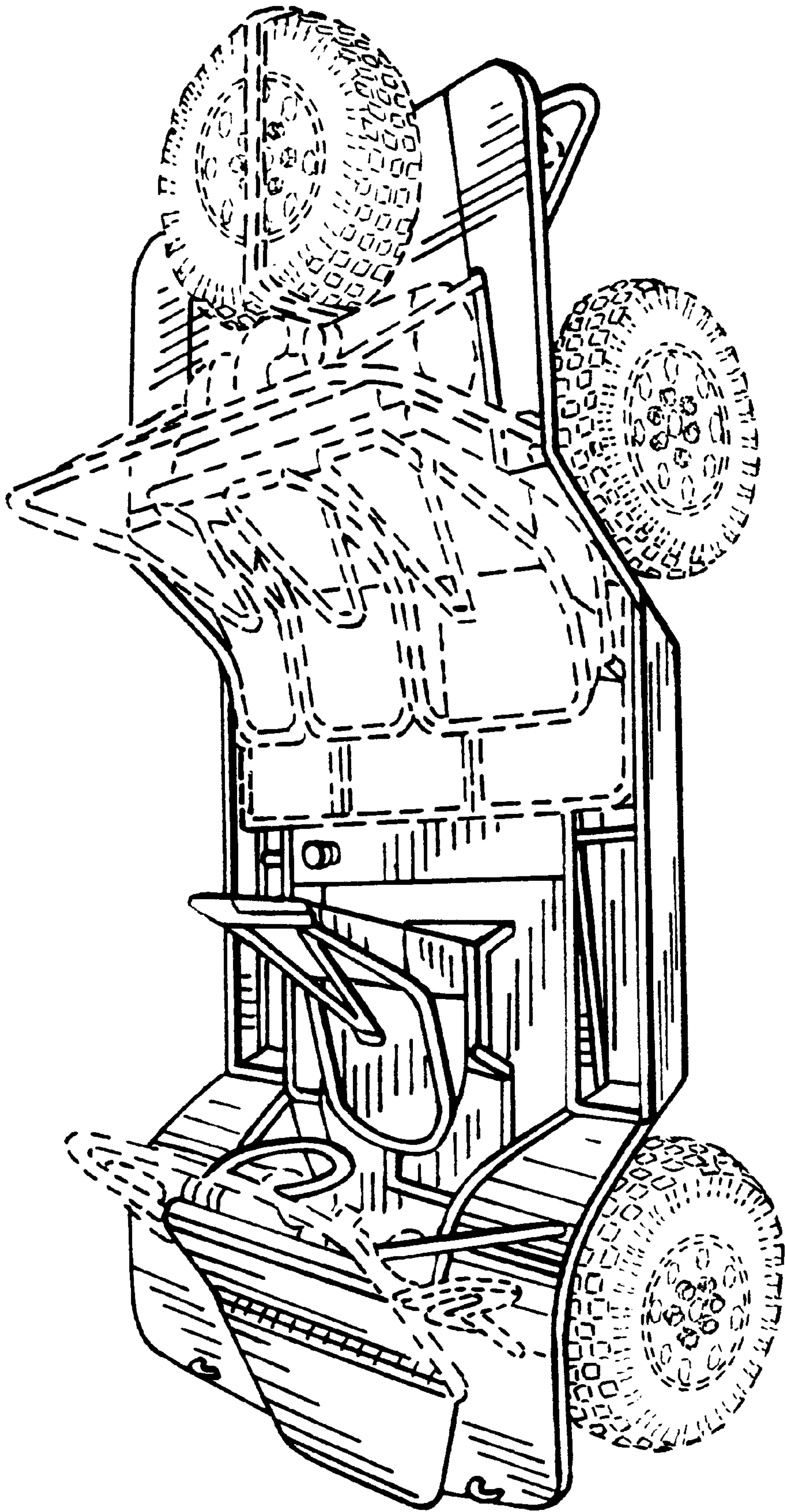

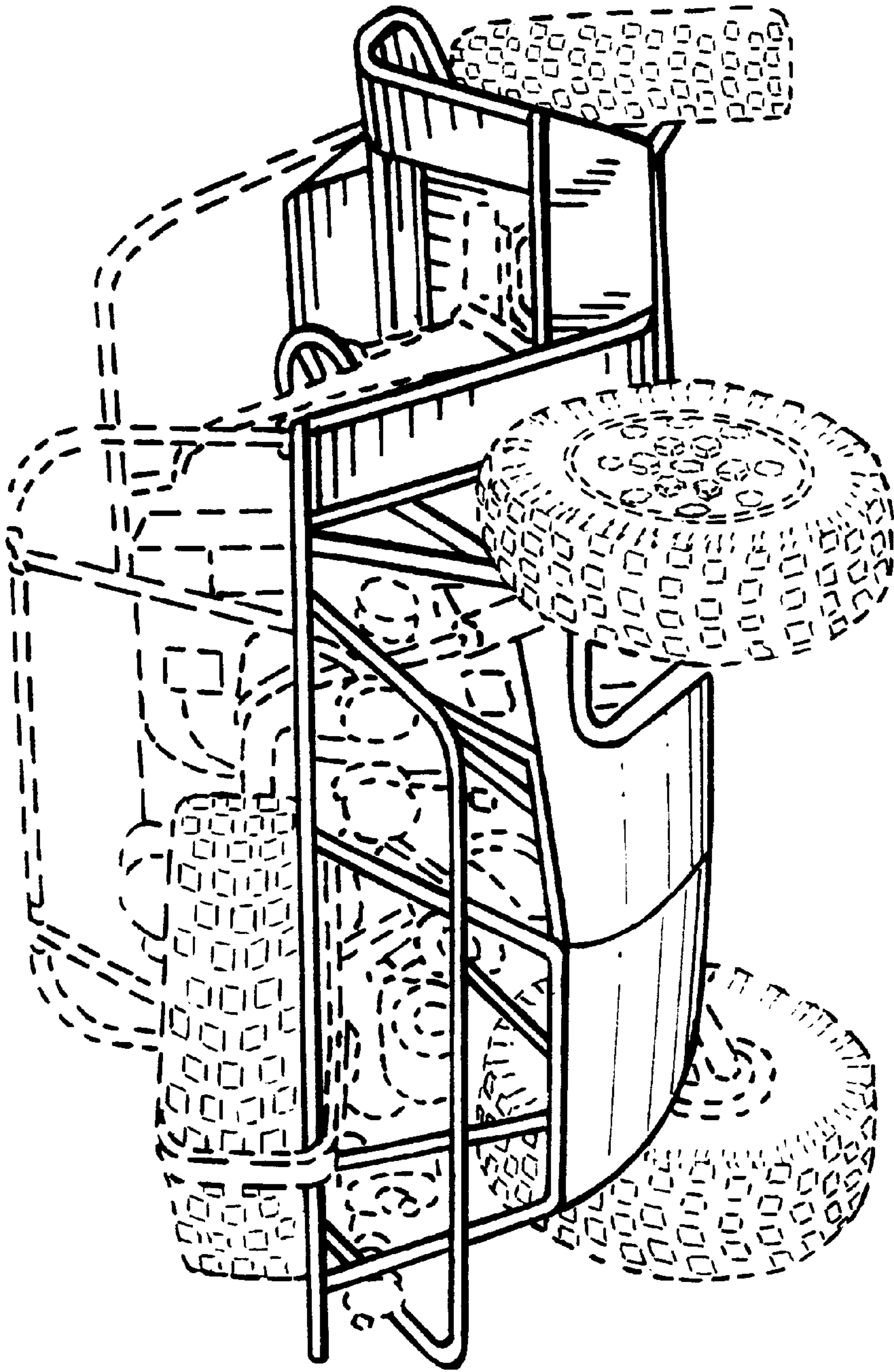
