DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the mini marker of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a right hand, left hand, side view of the mini marker of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is a top, end view of the mini marker of the present invention.

FIG. 4 is a bottom, end view of the mini marker of the present invention.

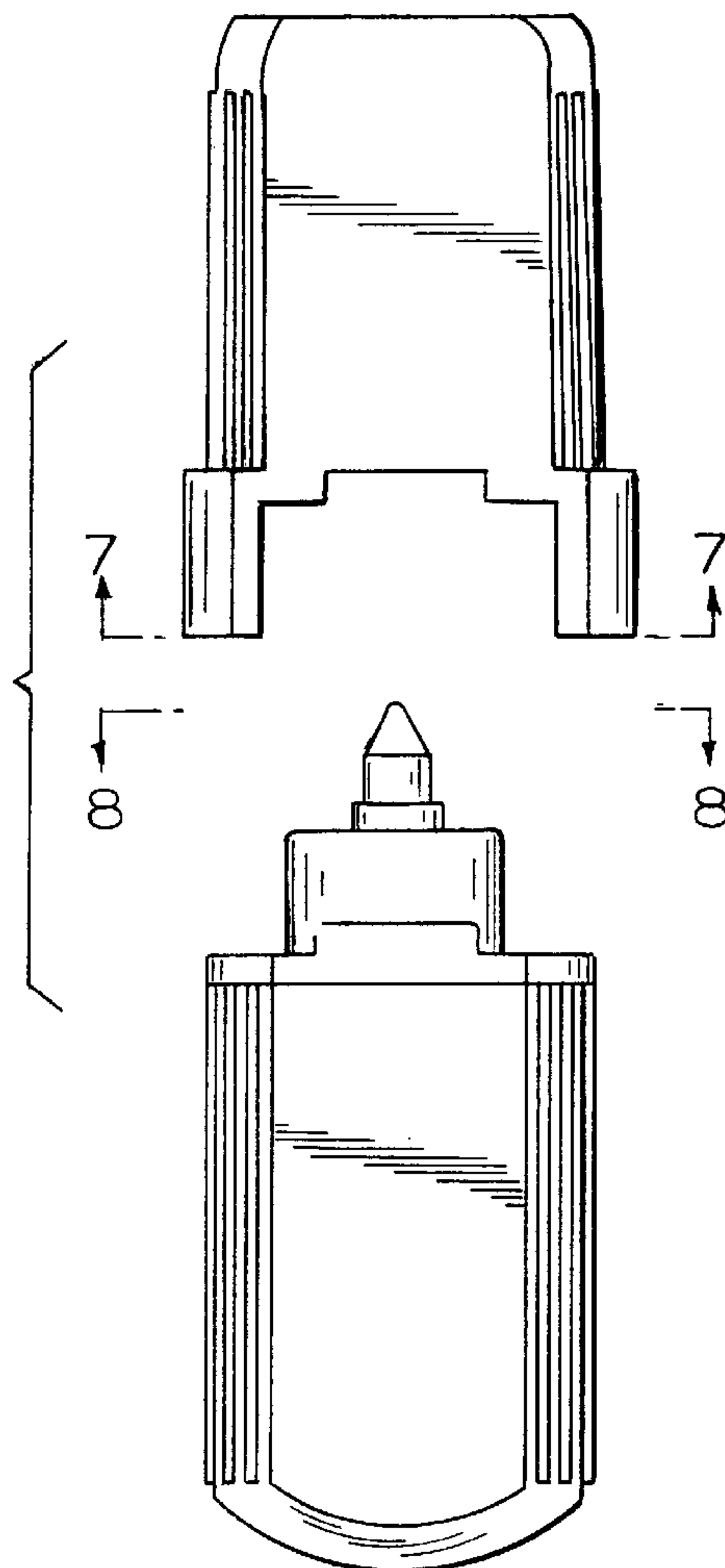
FIG. 5 shows the mini marker of FIG. 1 in an exploded view.

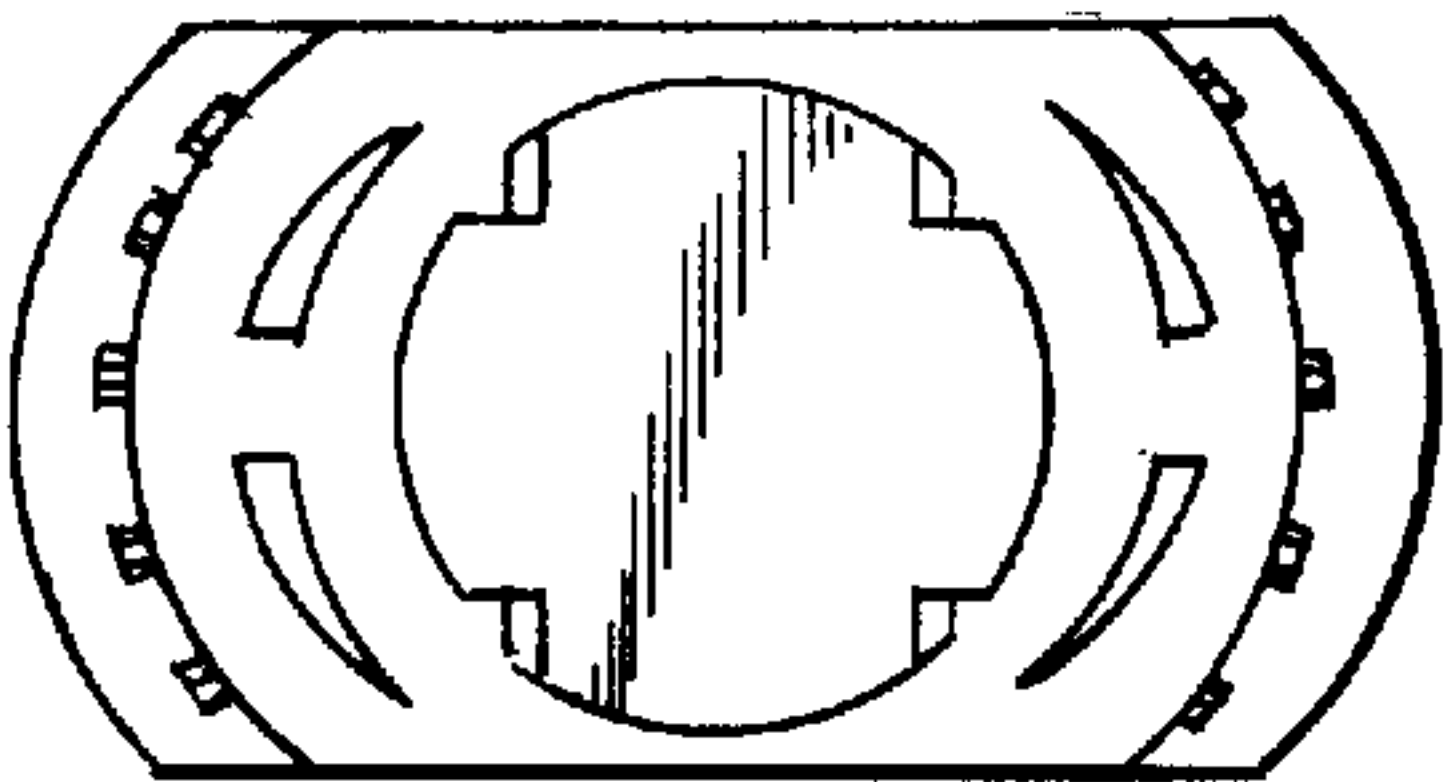

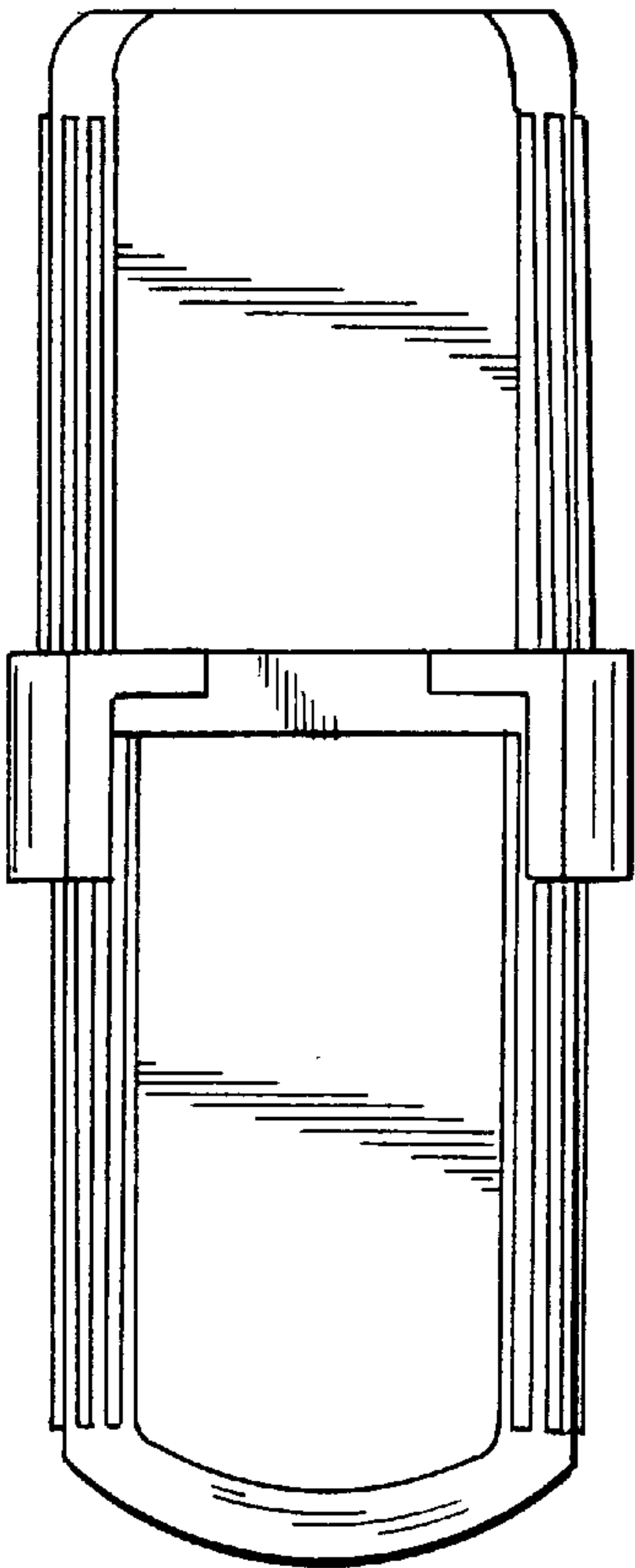

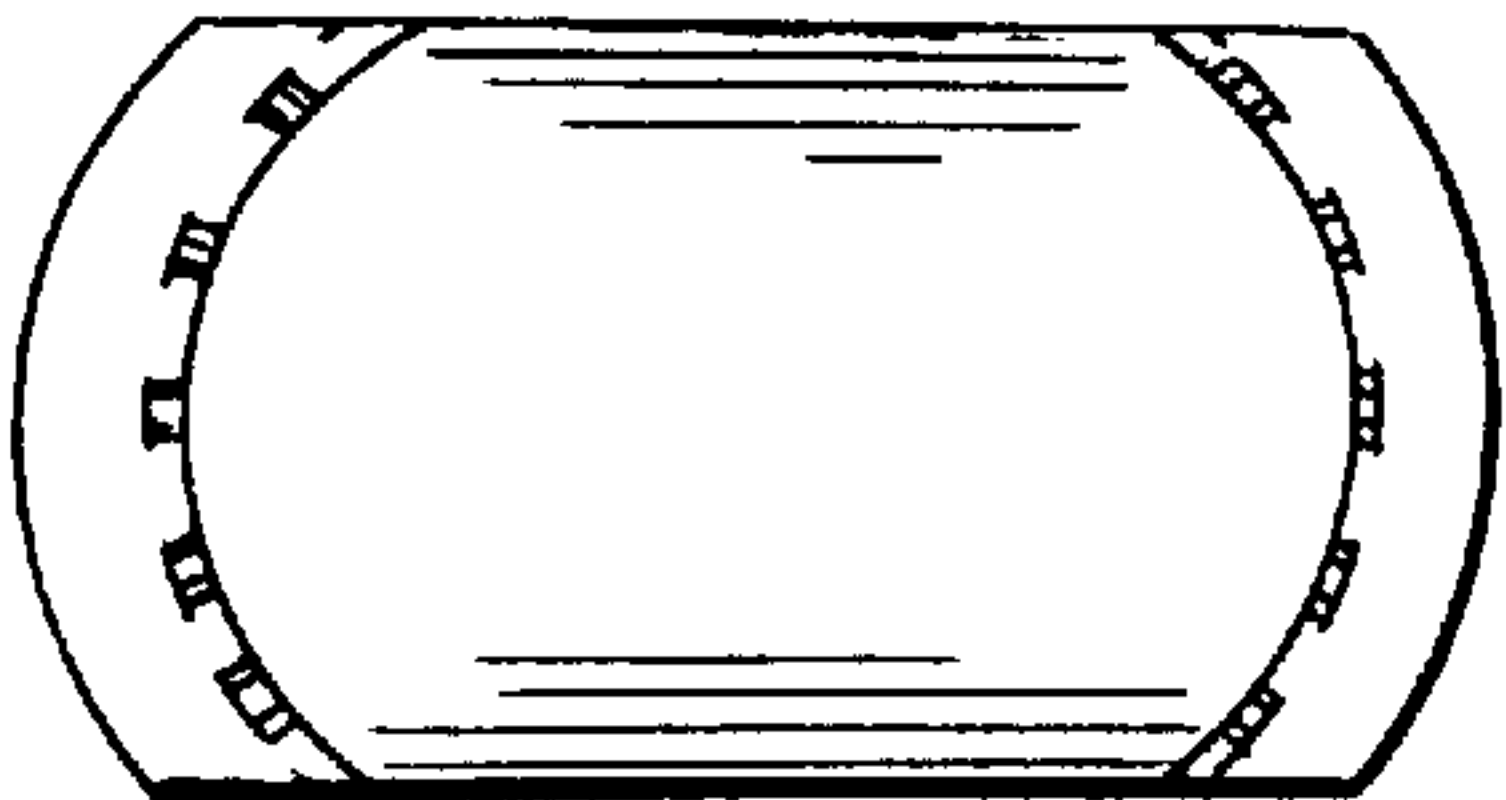
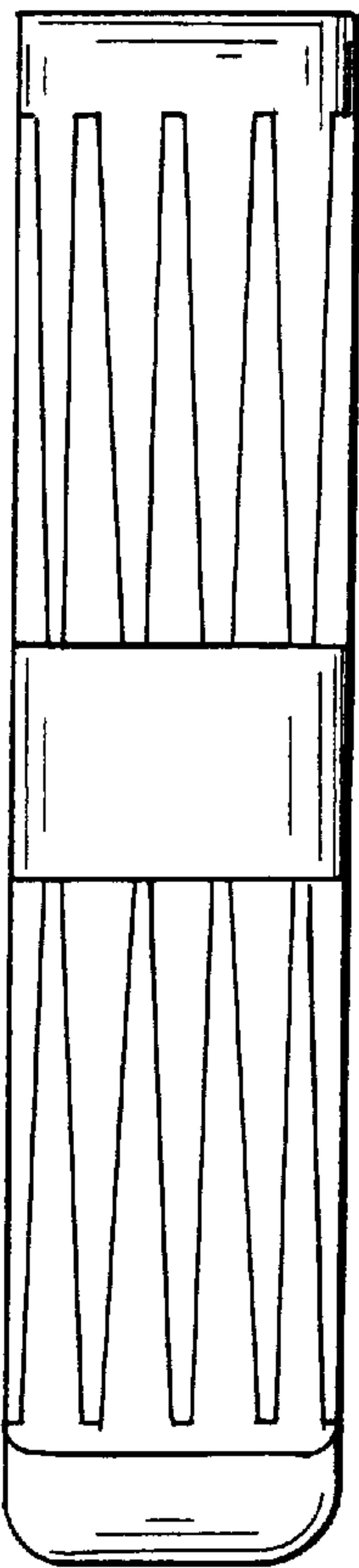

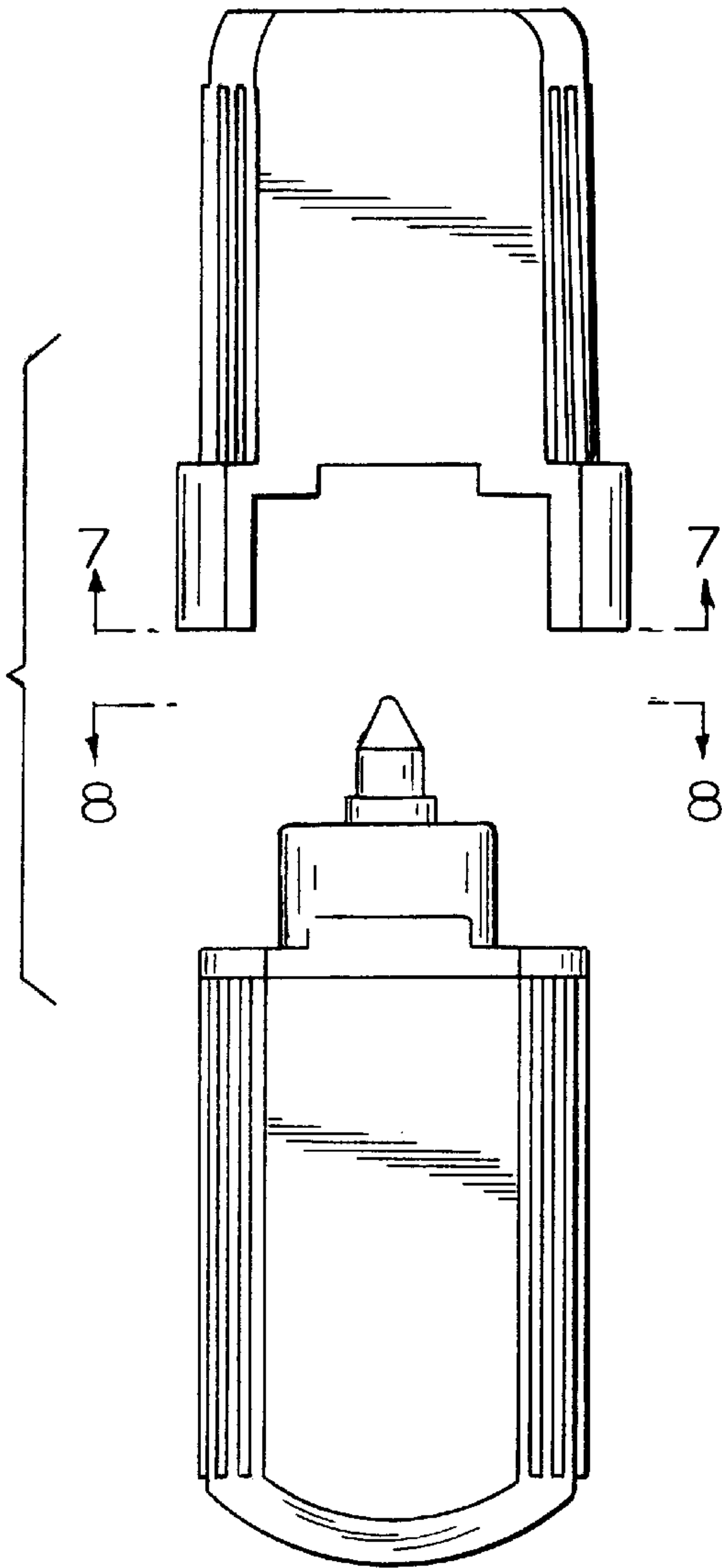

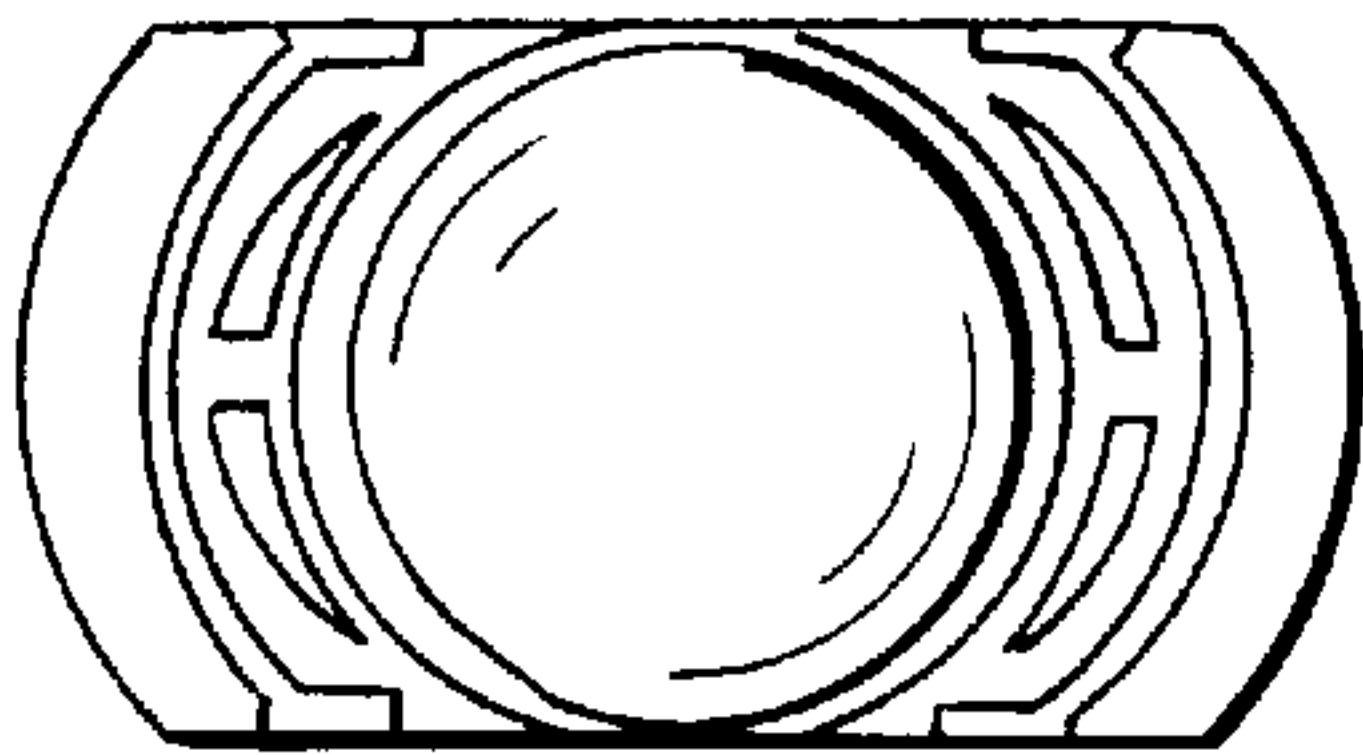
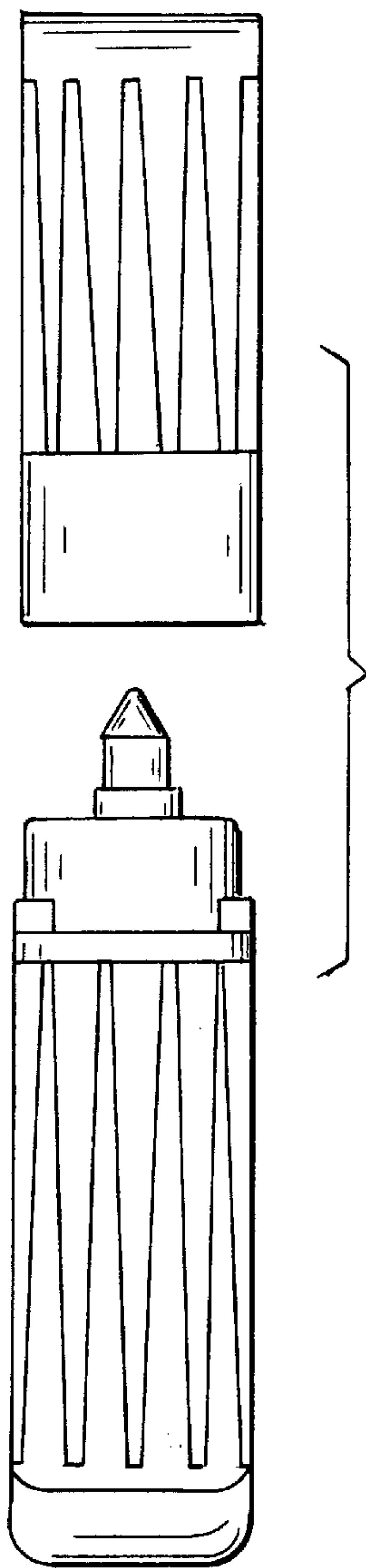

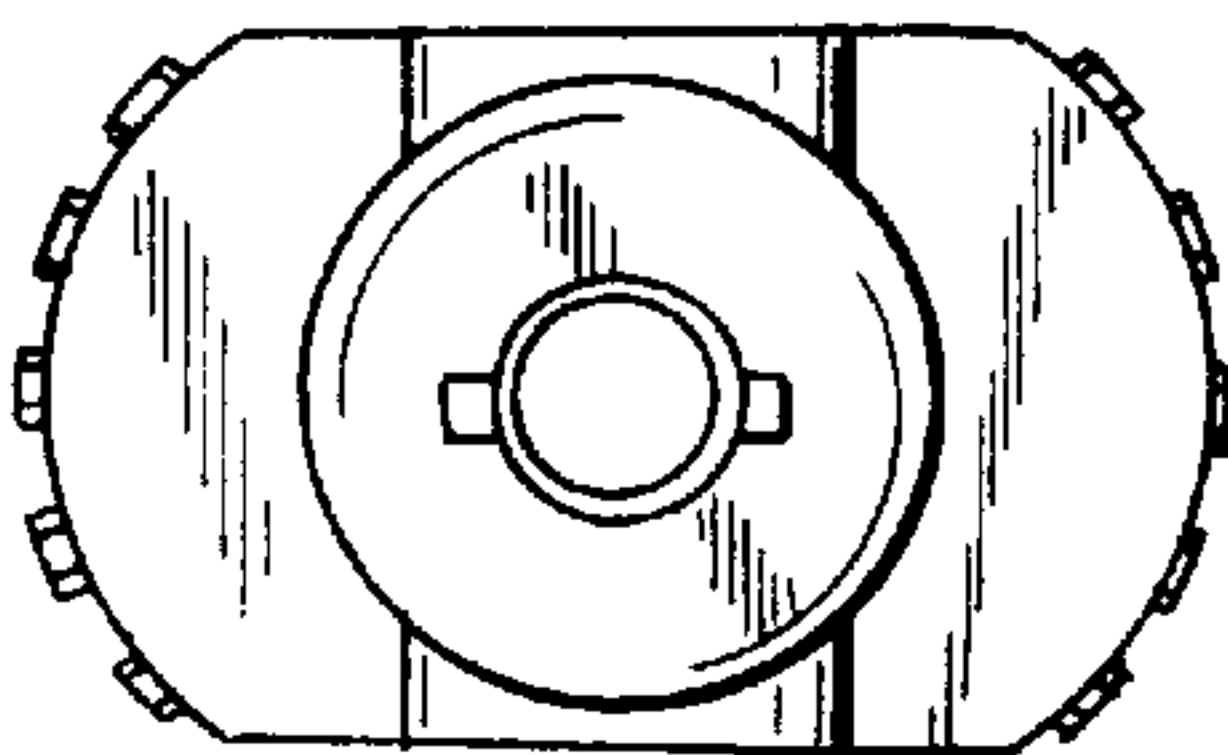
