FIG. 3 is a side view thereof, the other side view being a mirror image thereof;

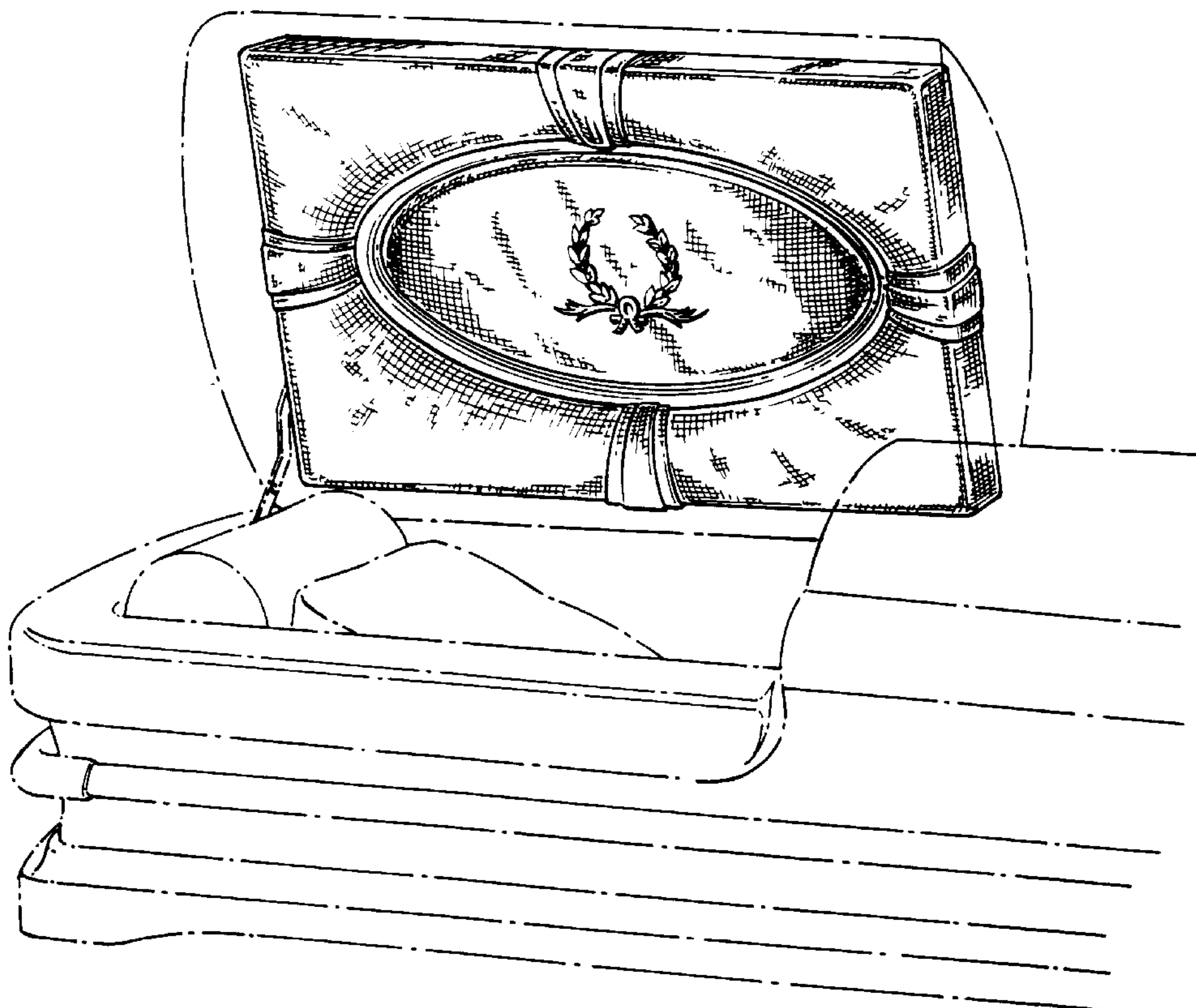
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof, the bottom being a mirror image thereof;

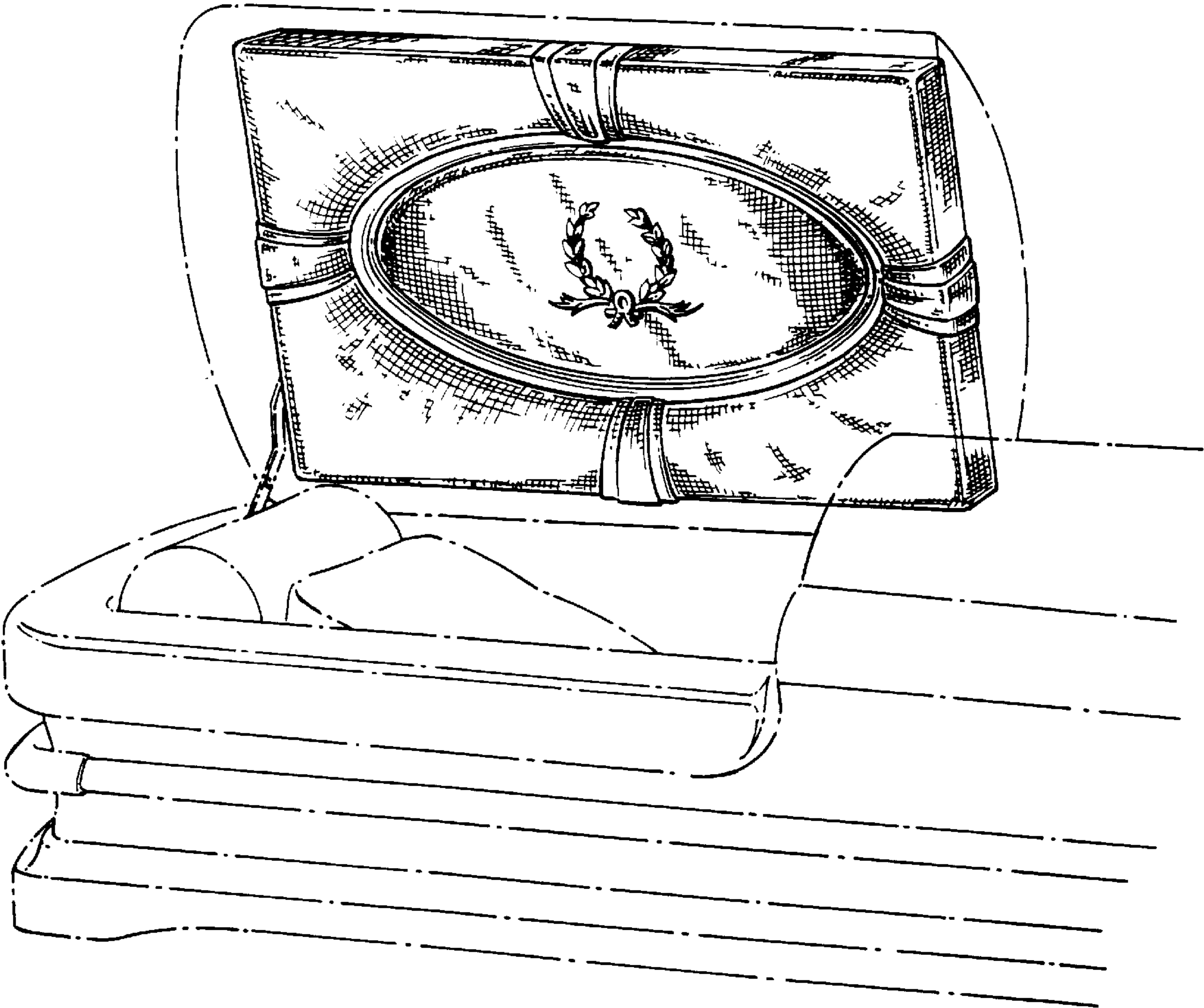

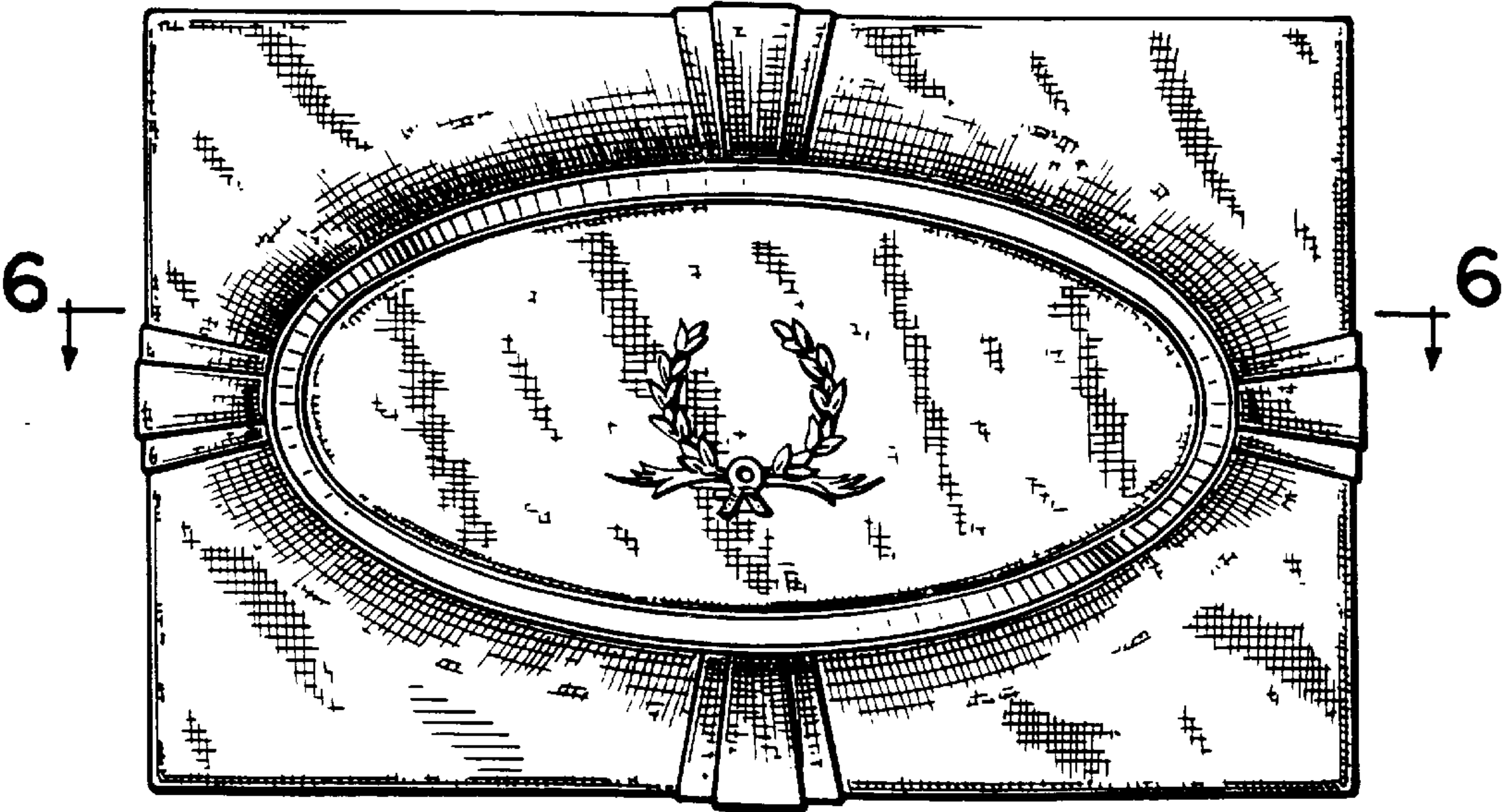

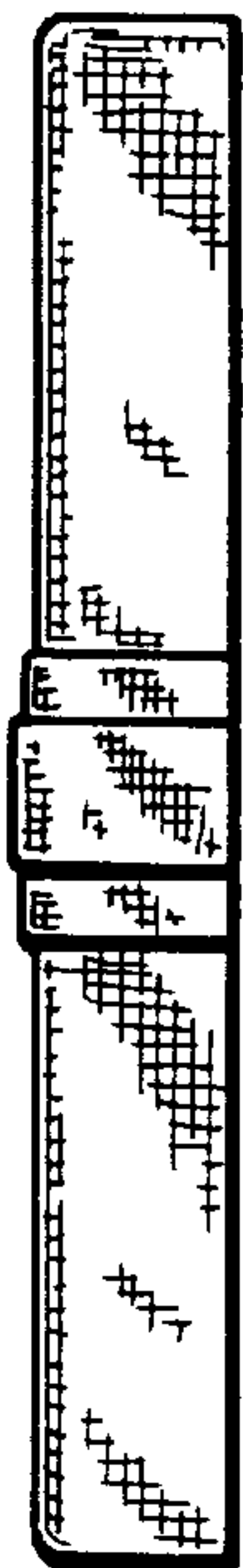

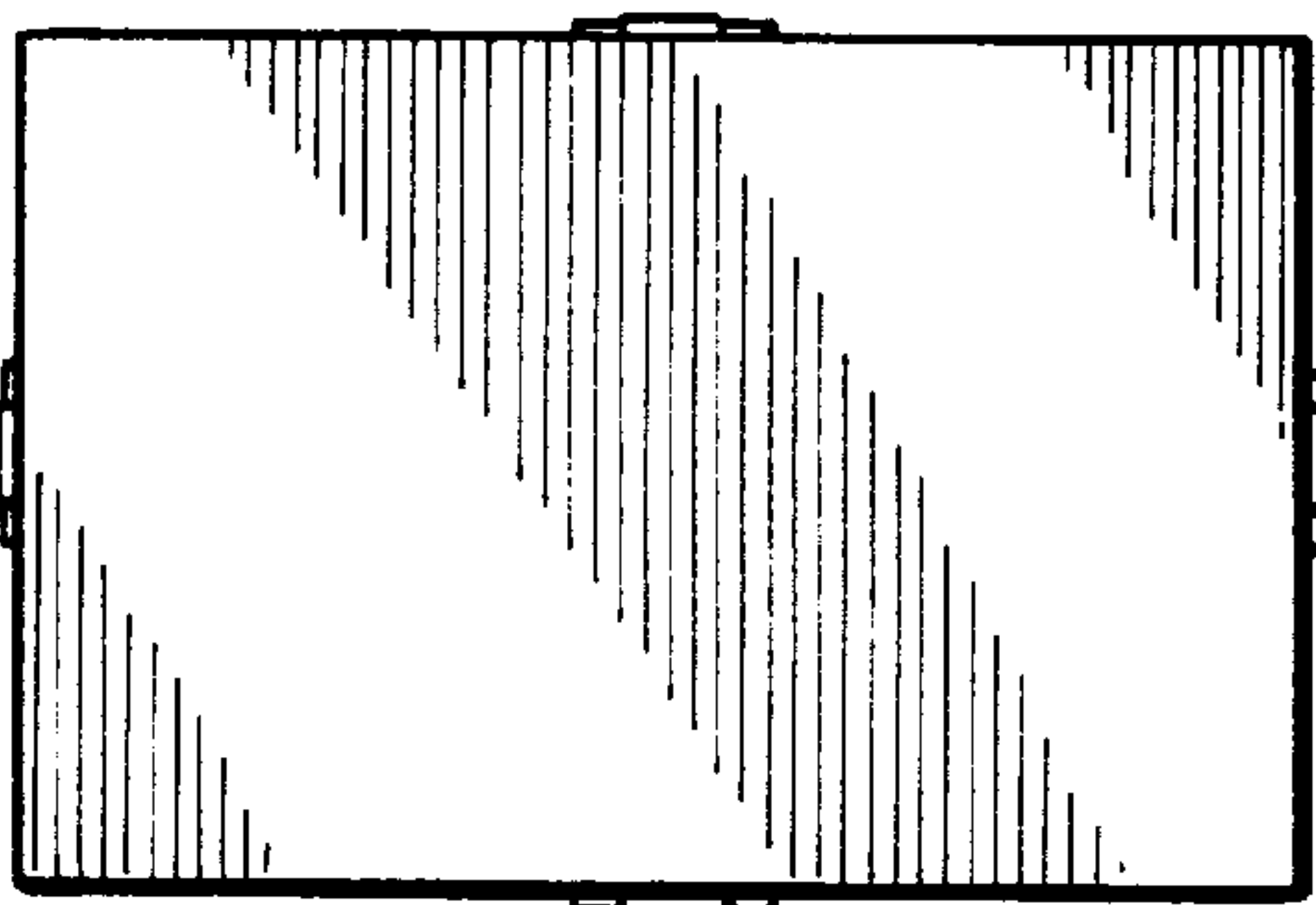

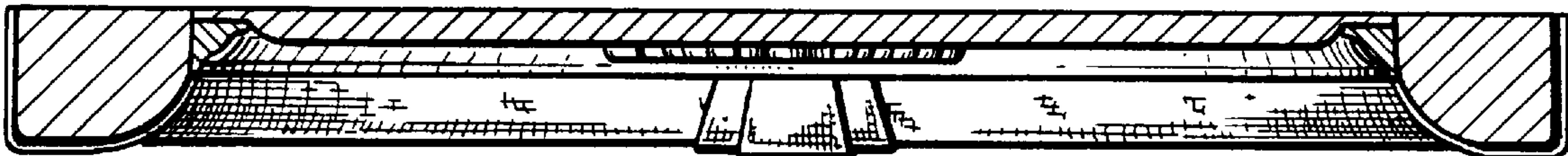
