[57] **CLAIM**

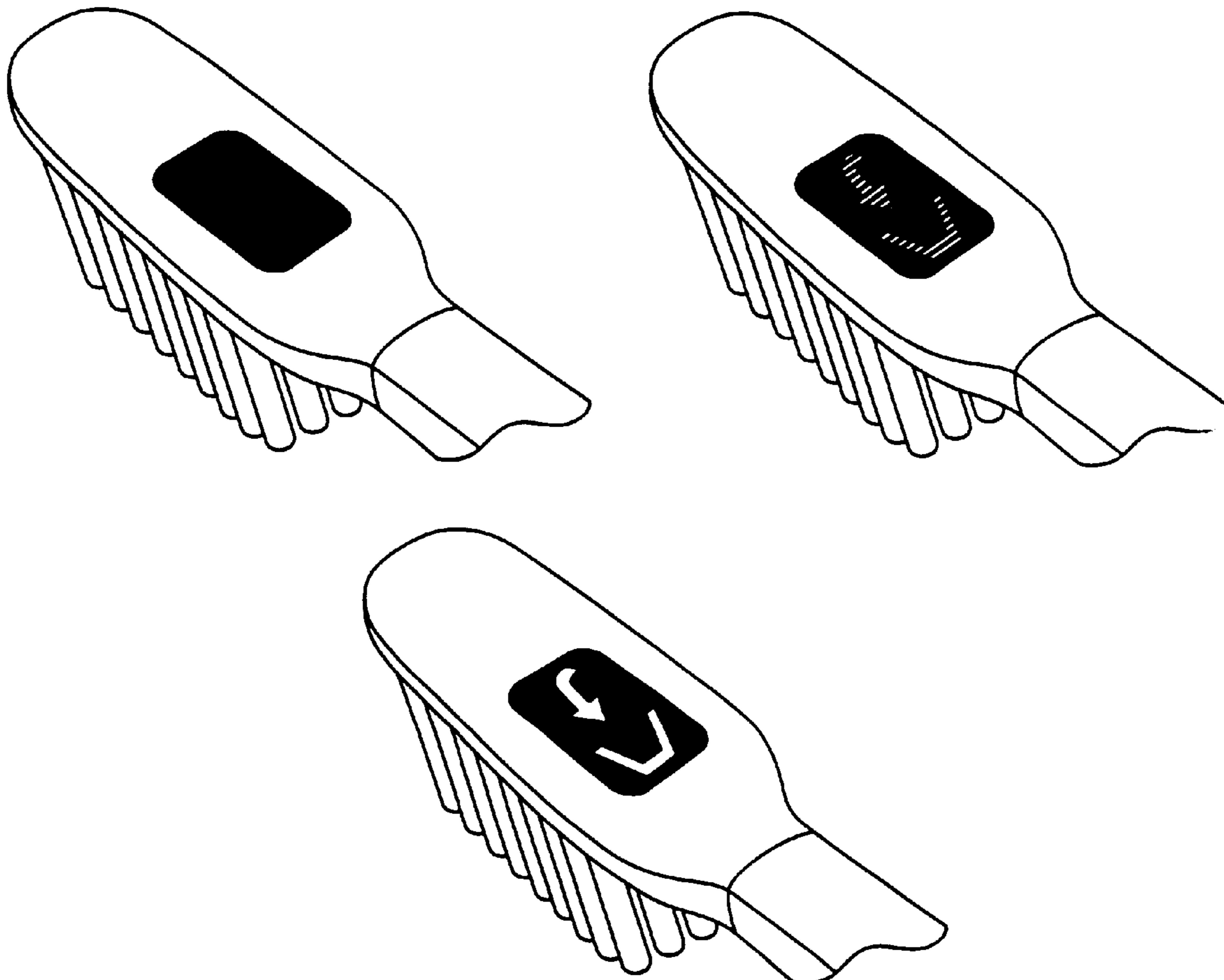
The ornamental design for a toothbrush having an indicator, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

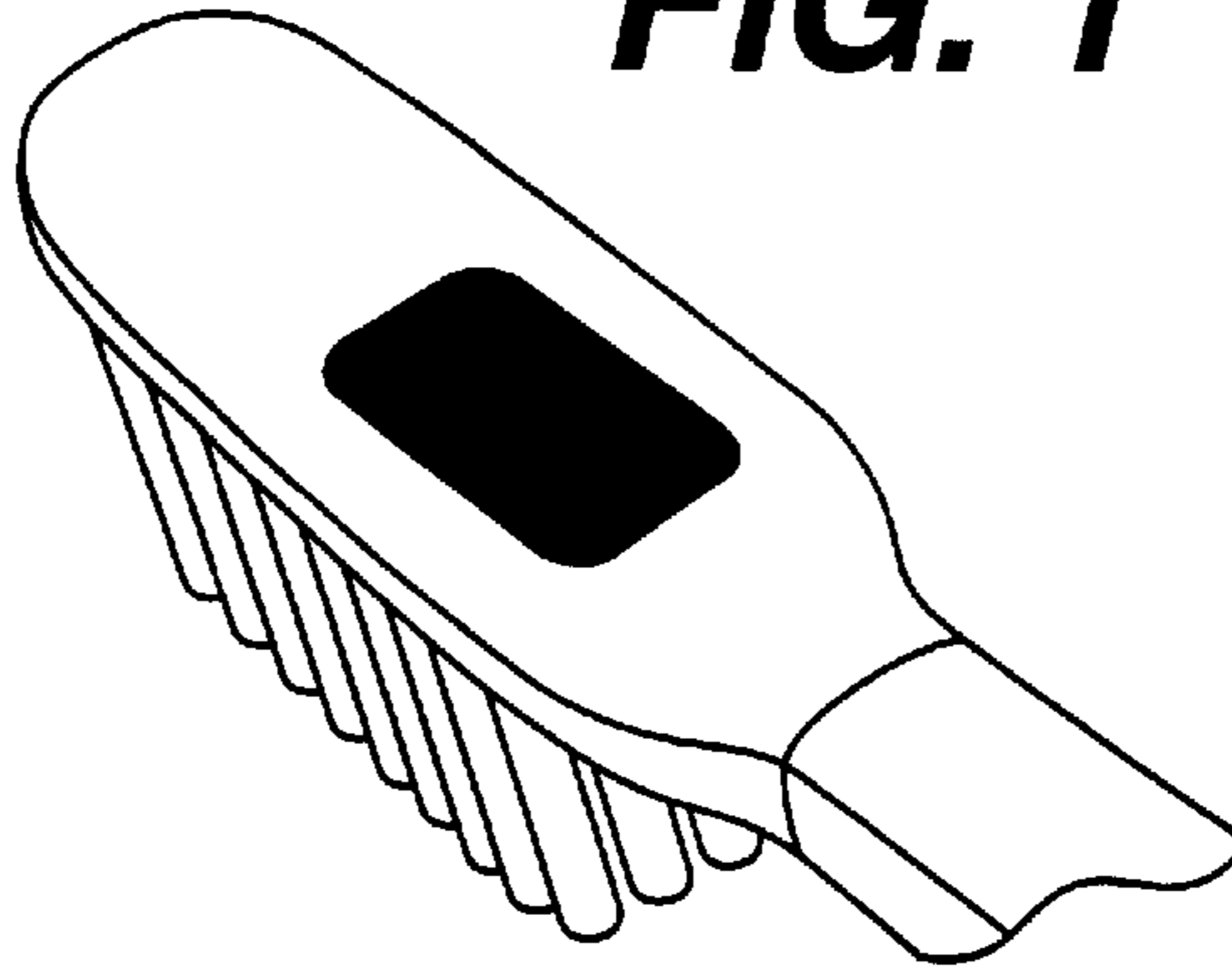
FIG. 1 is a bottom perspective view of a toothbrush having an indicator showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof showing the indicator in an alternate configuration; and,

The top, front end and right side of the toothbrush form no part of the claimed design.

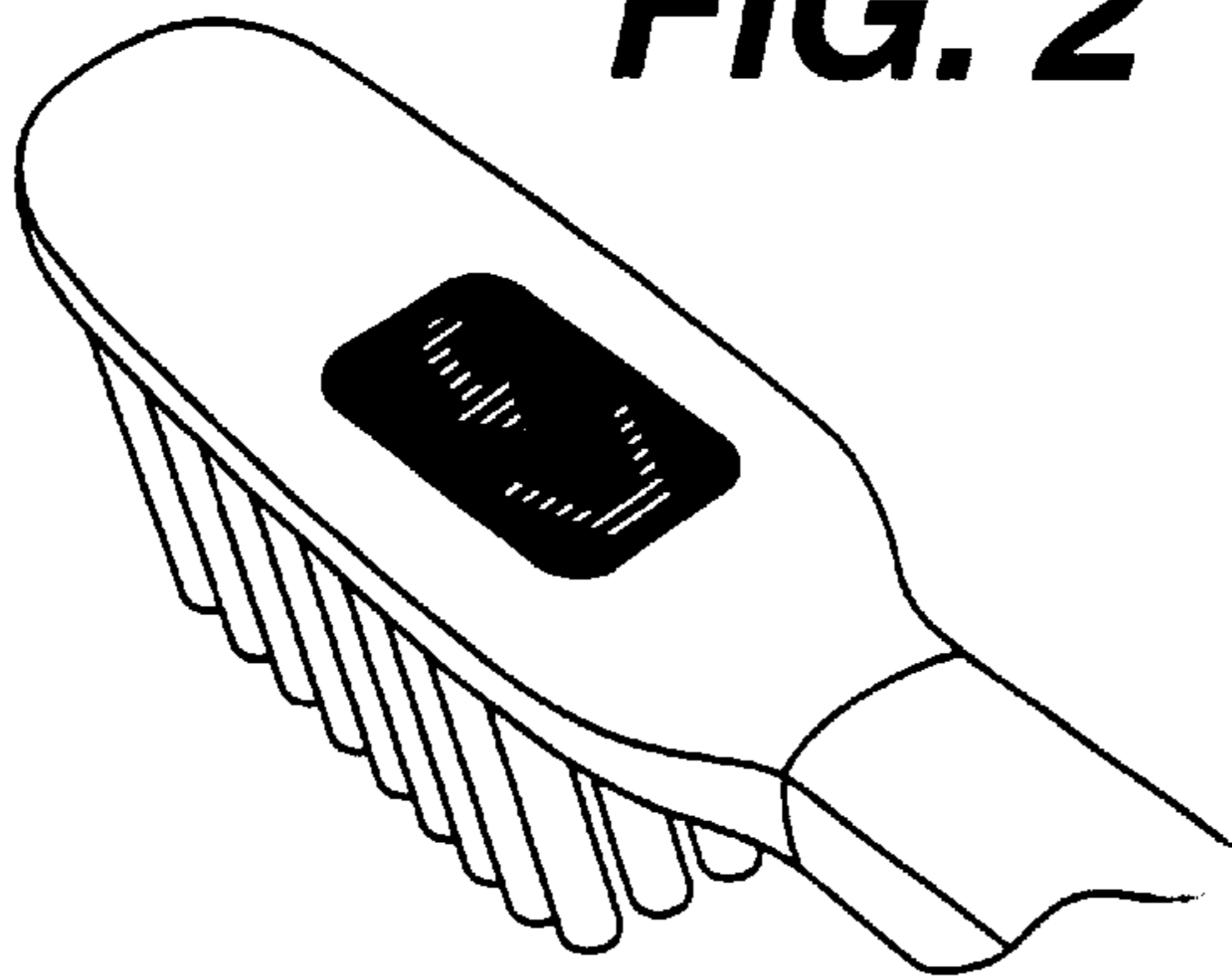
