The ornamental design for a “sled-base chair,” as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sled-base chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side view thereof, the opposite side view being the mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

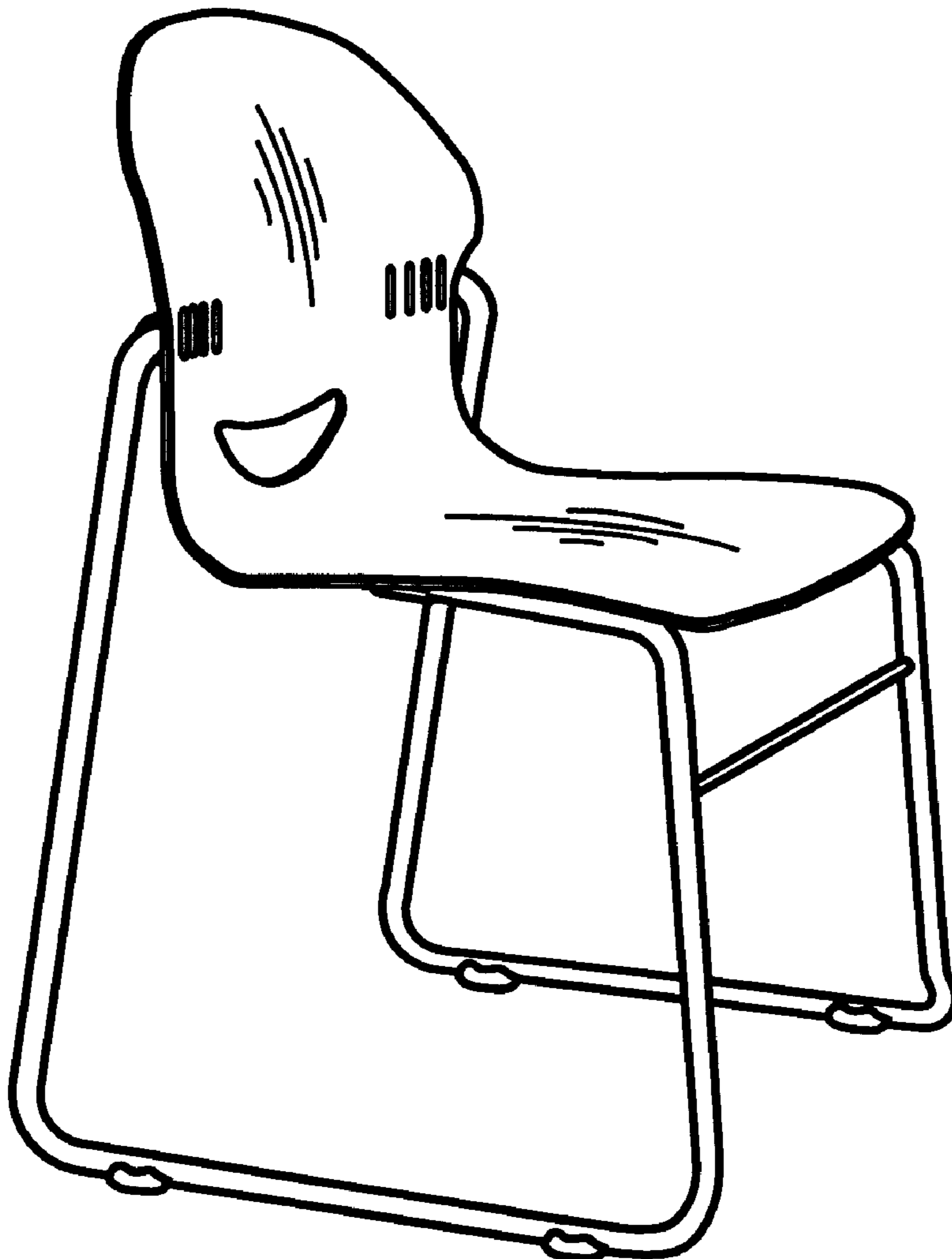

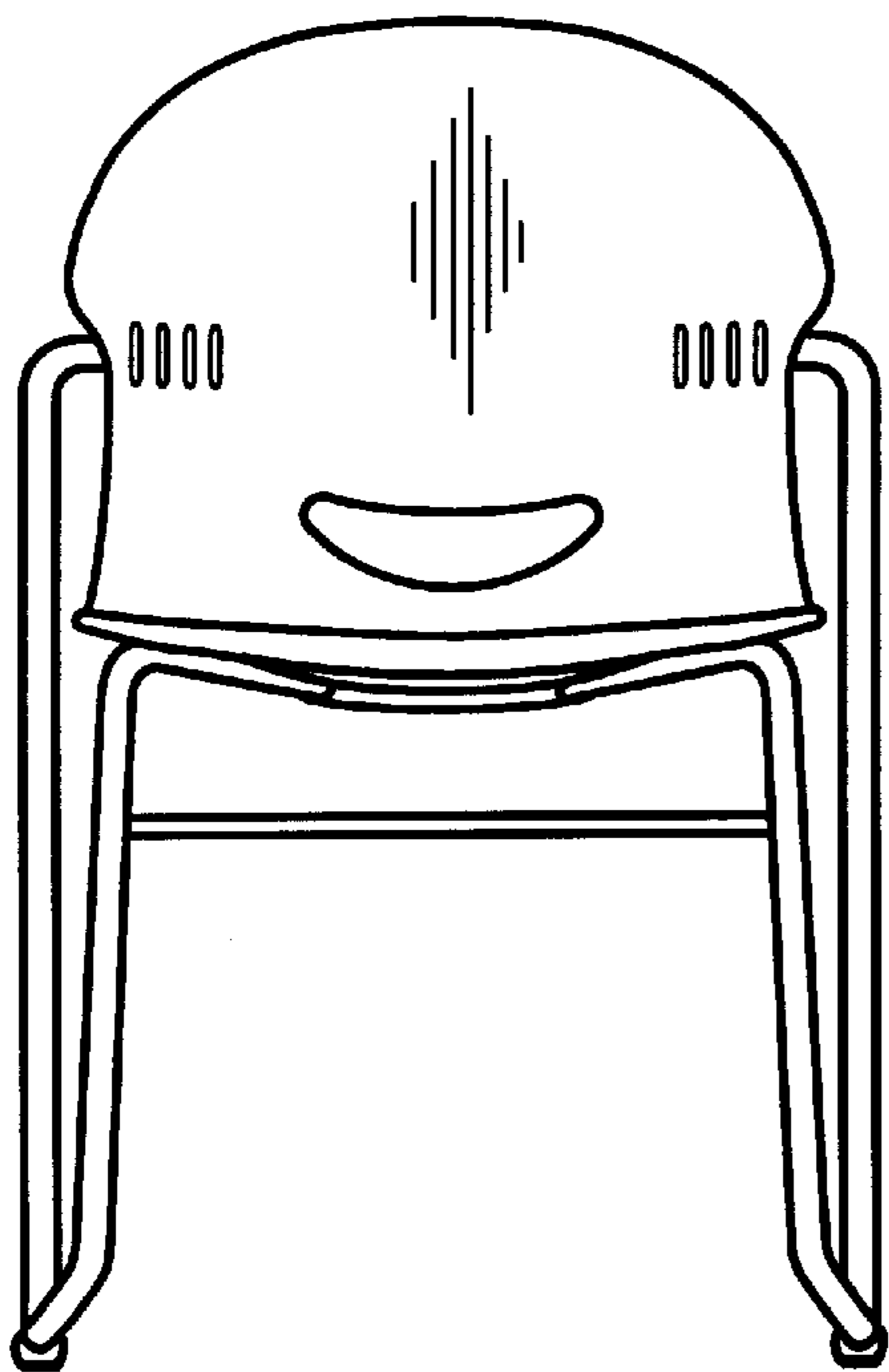
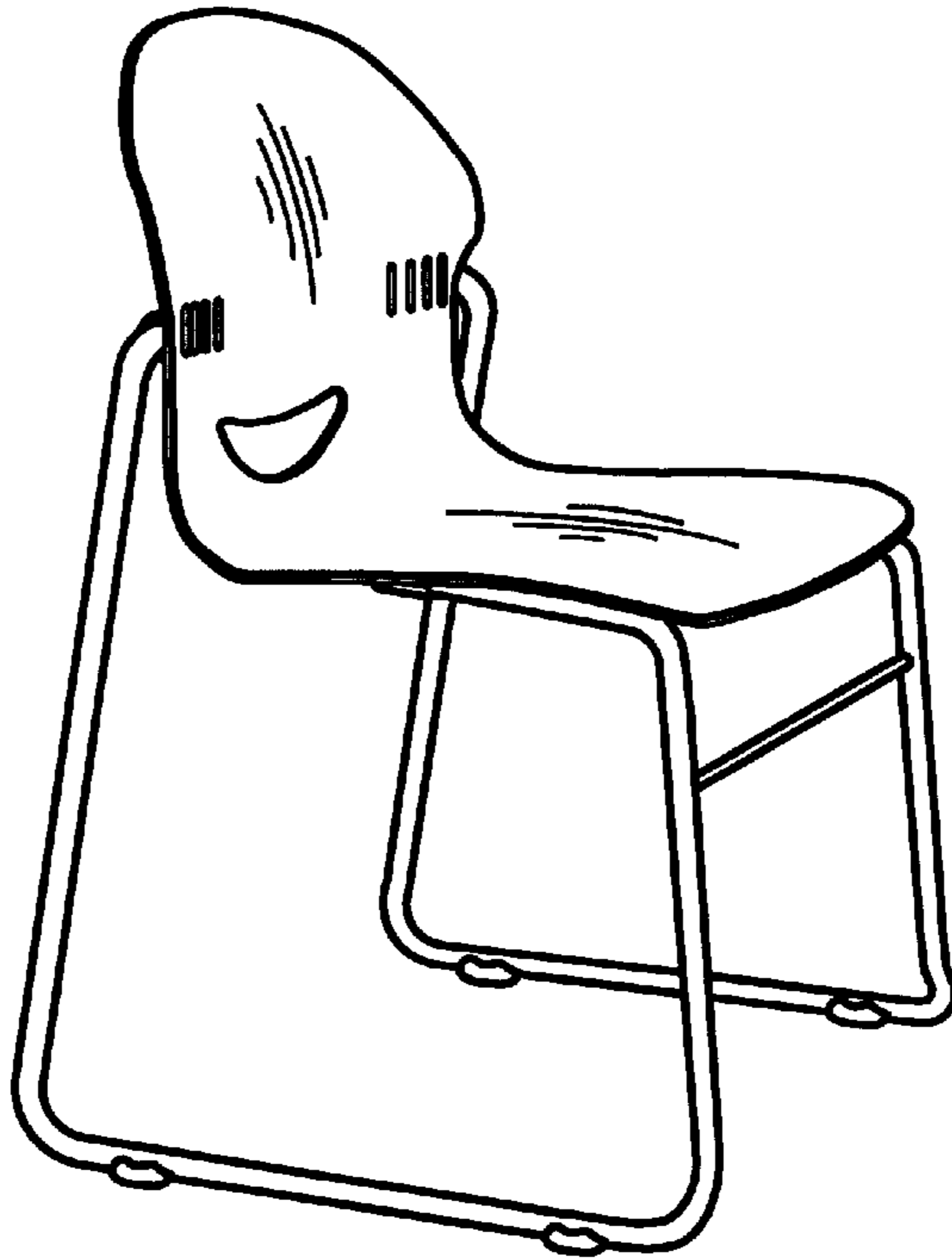

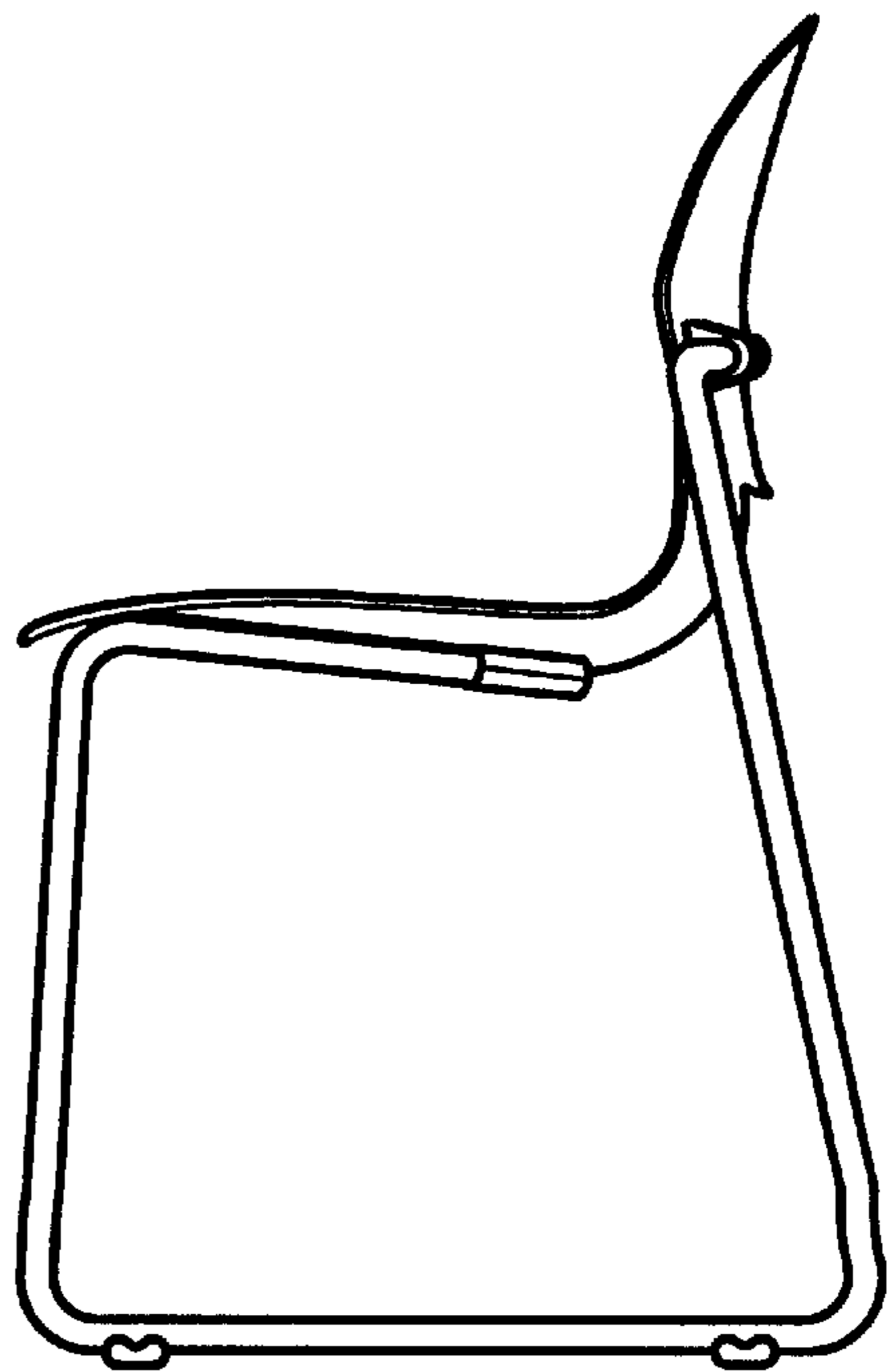

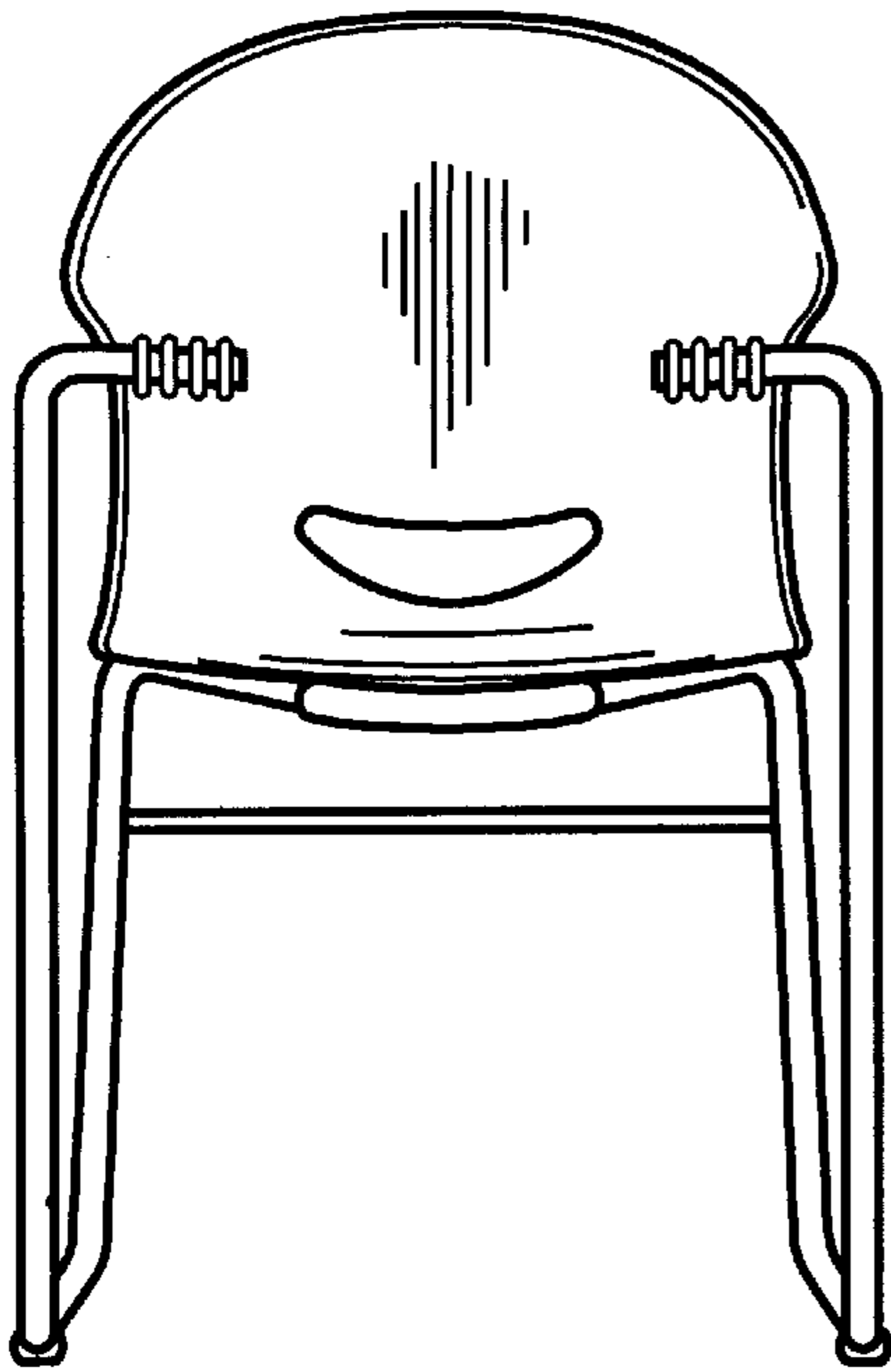

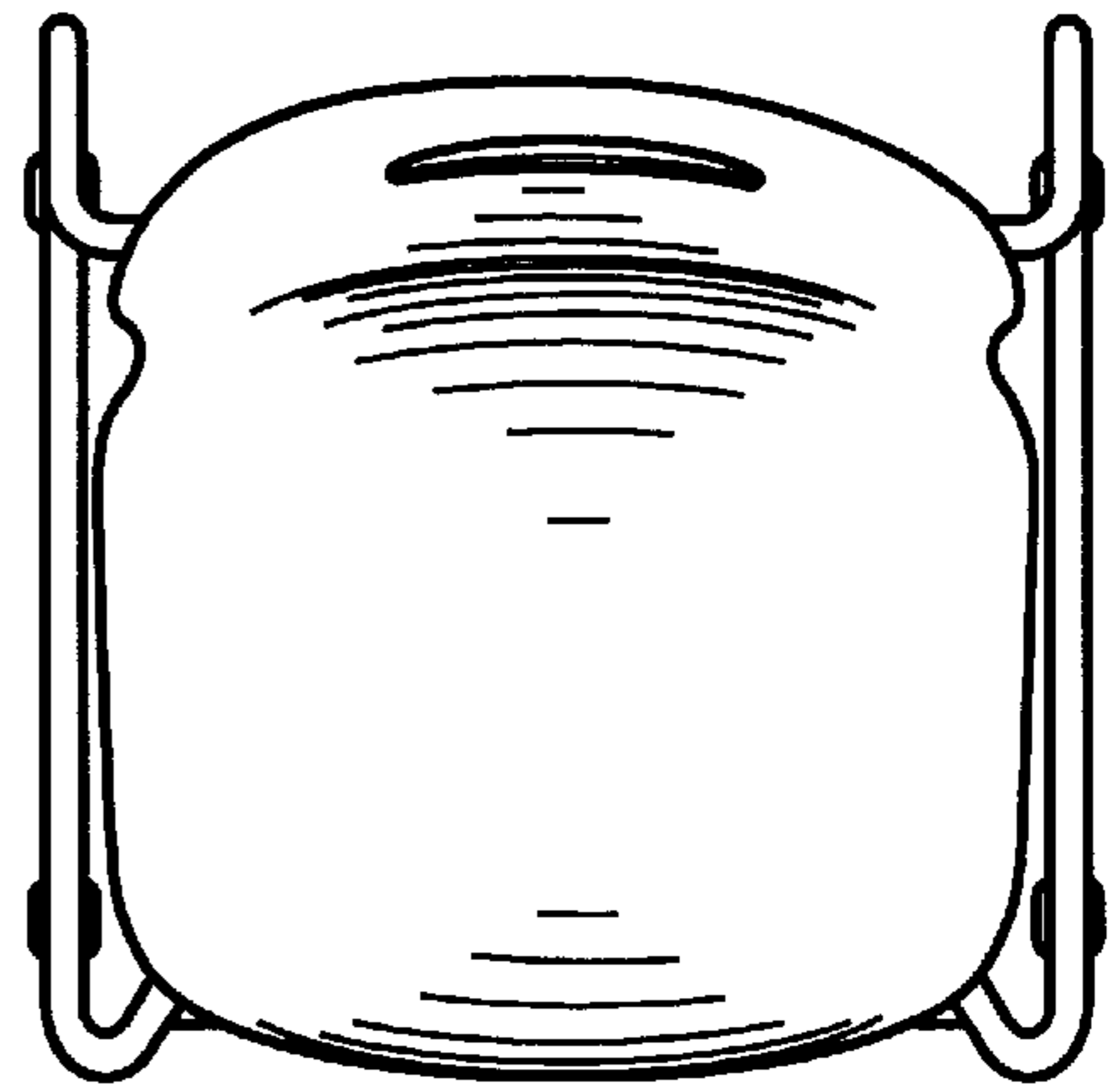

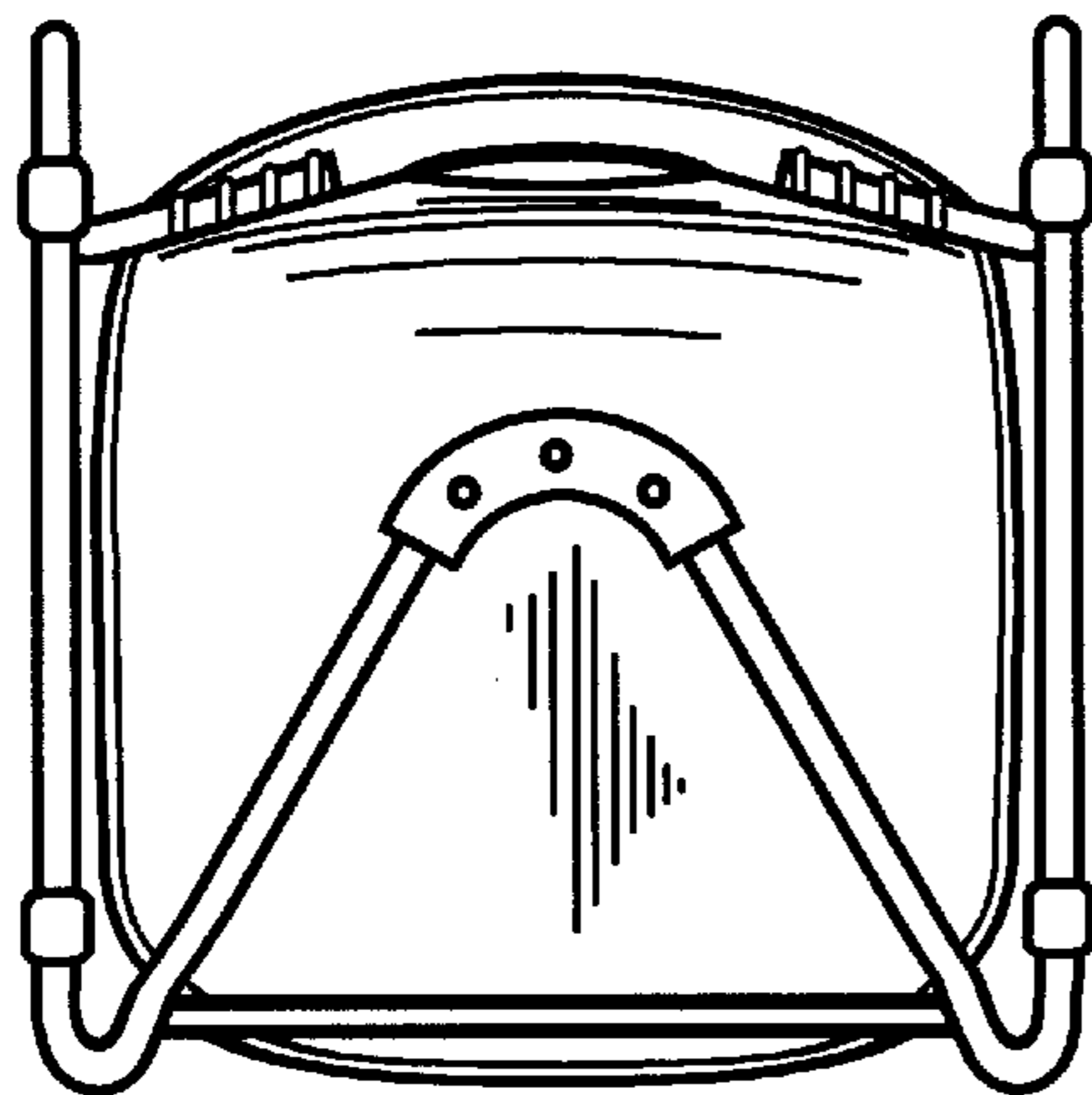
