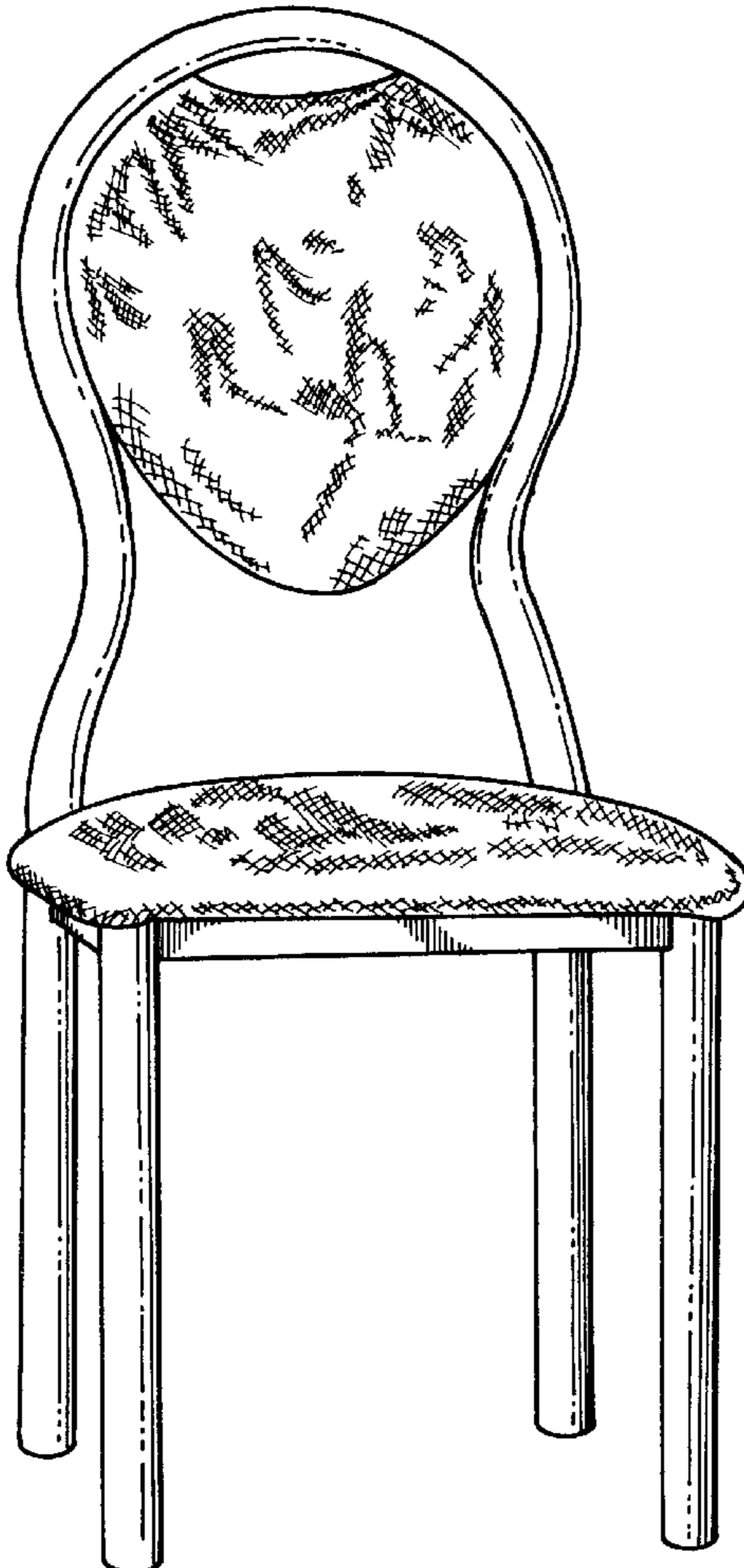
The fragmented cross-hatching shown on the seat and backrest is understood to represent fabric and would be continuous throughout the implied areas.

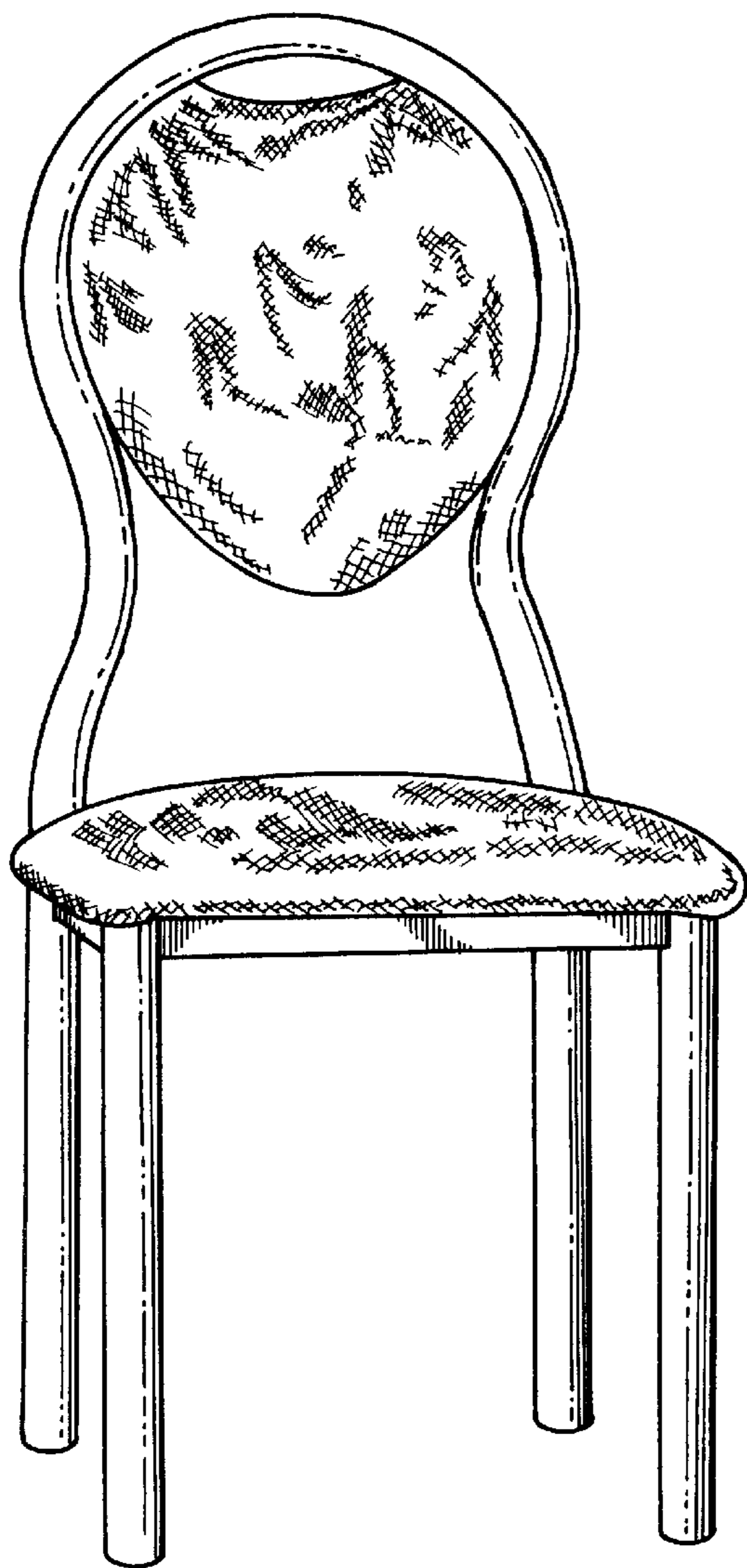

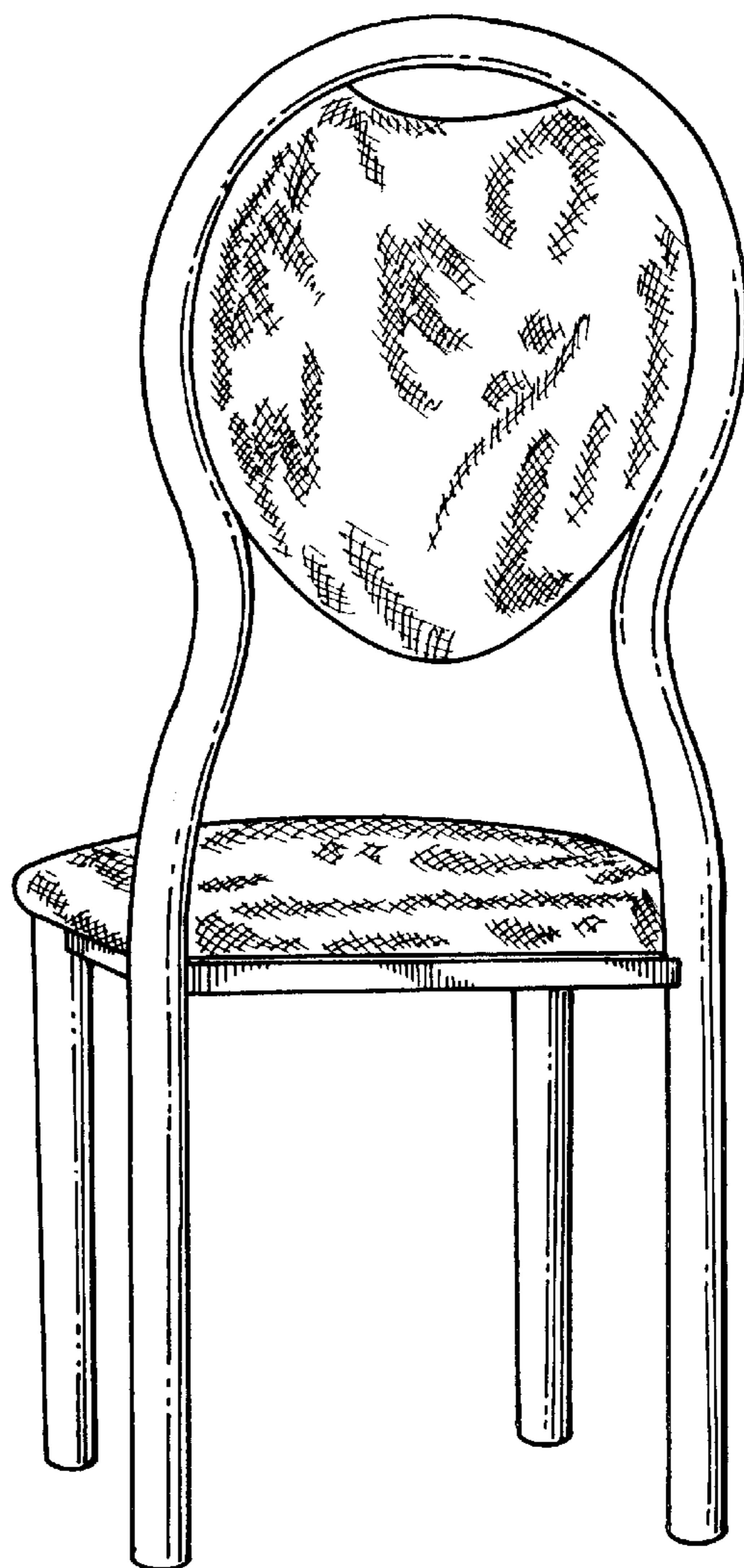
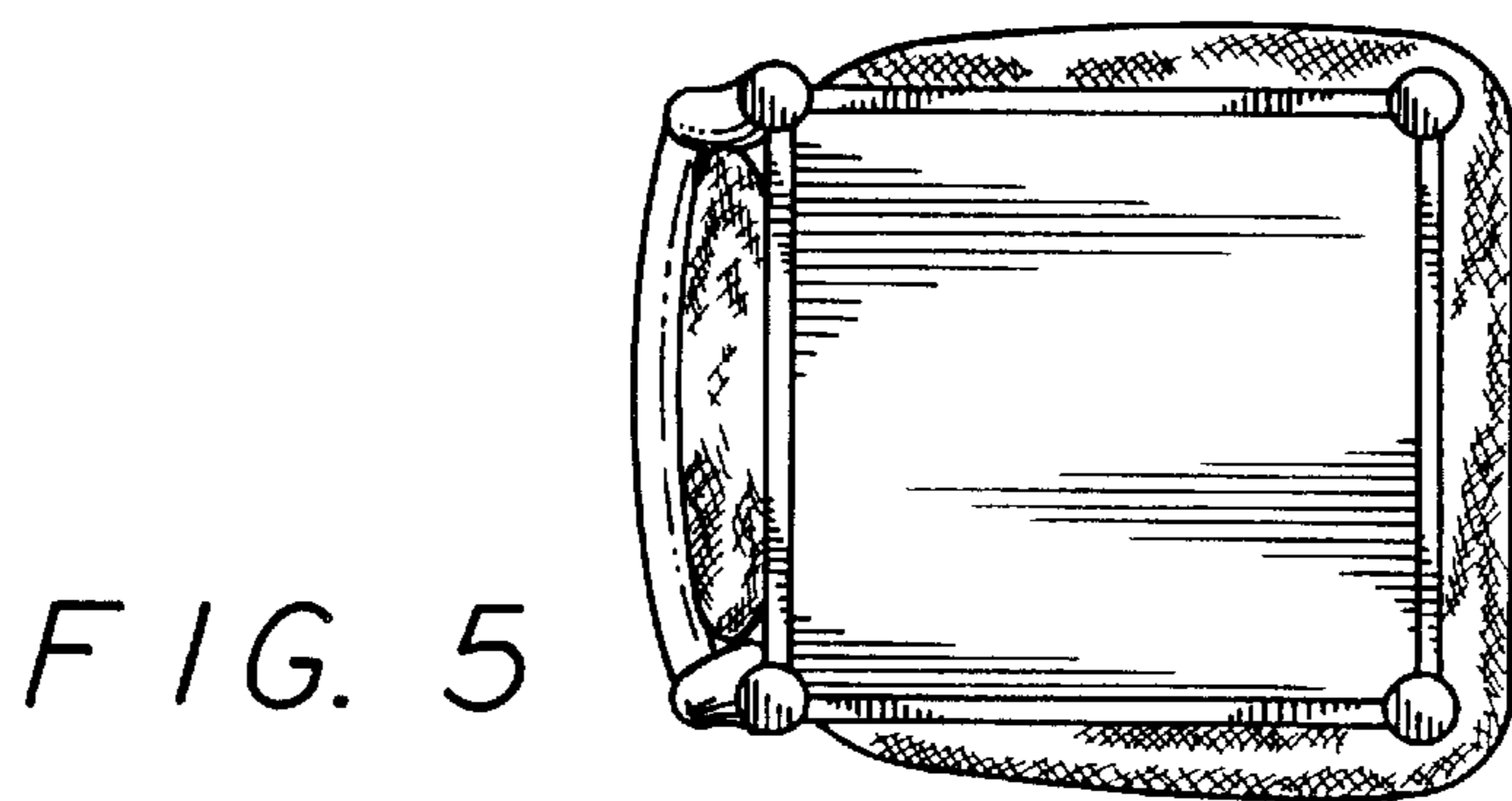
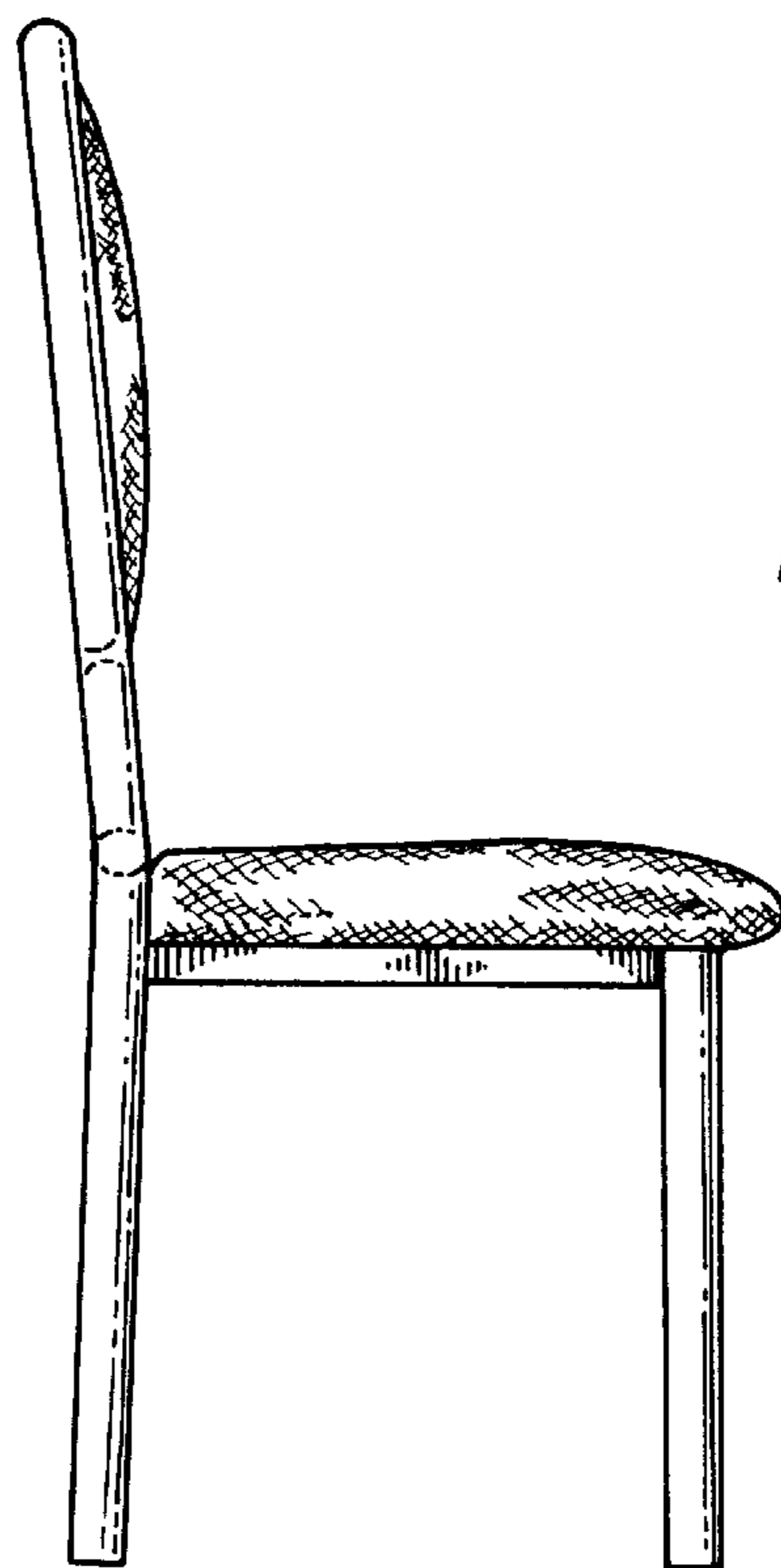
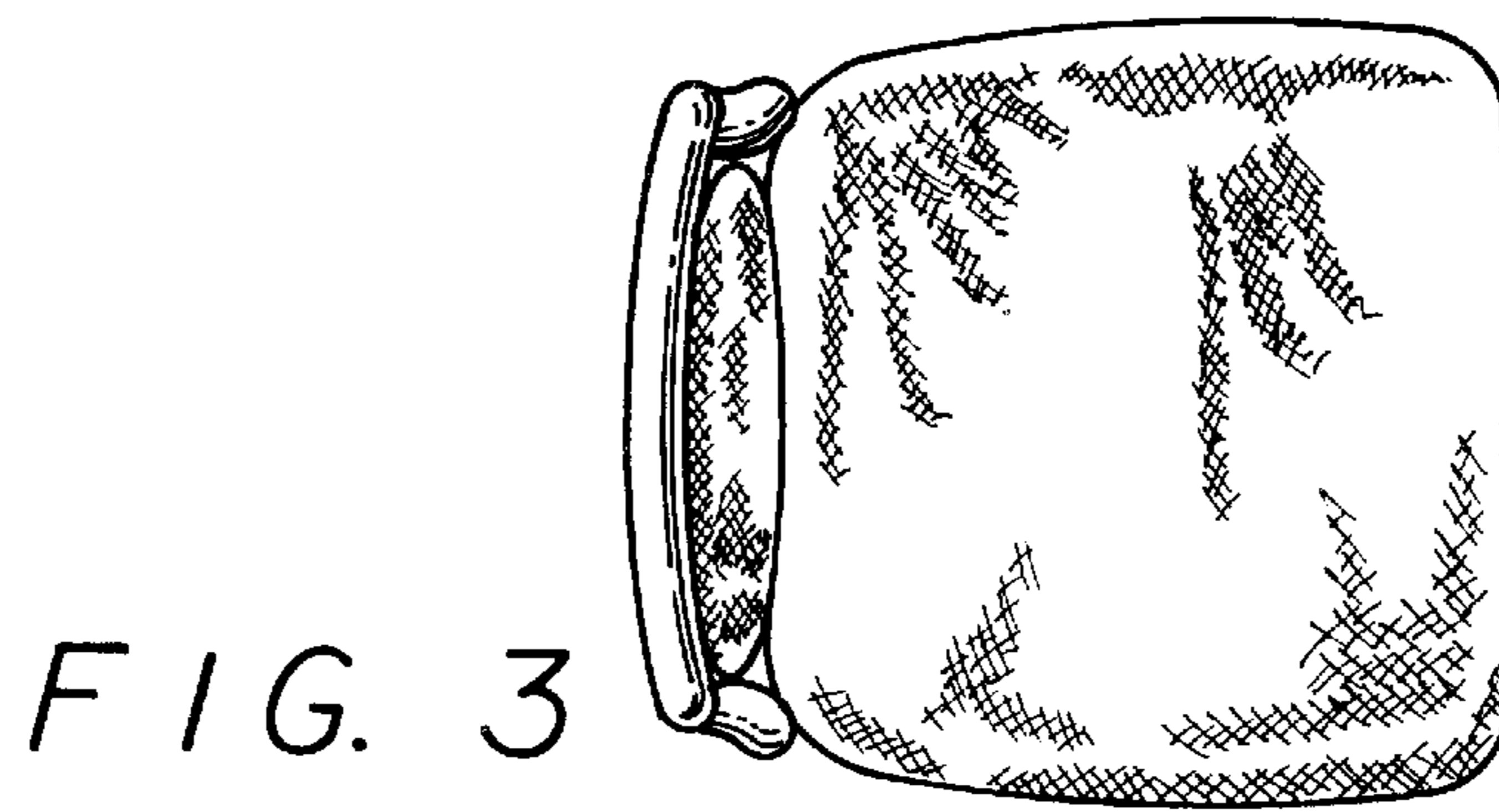
