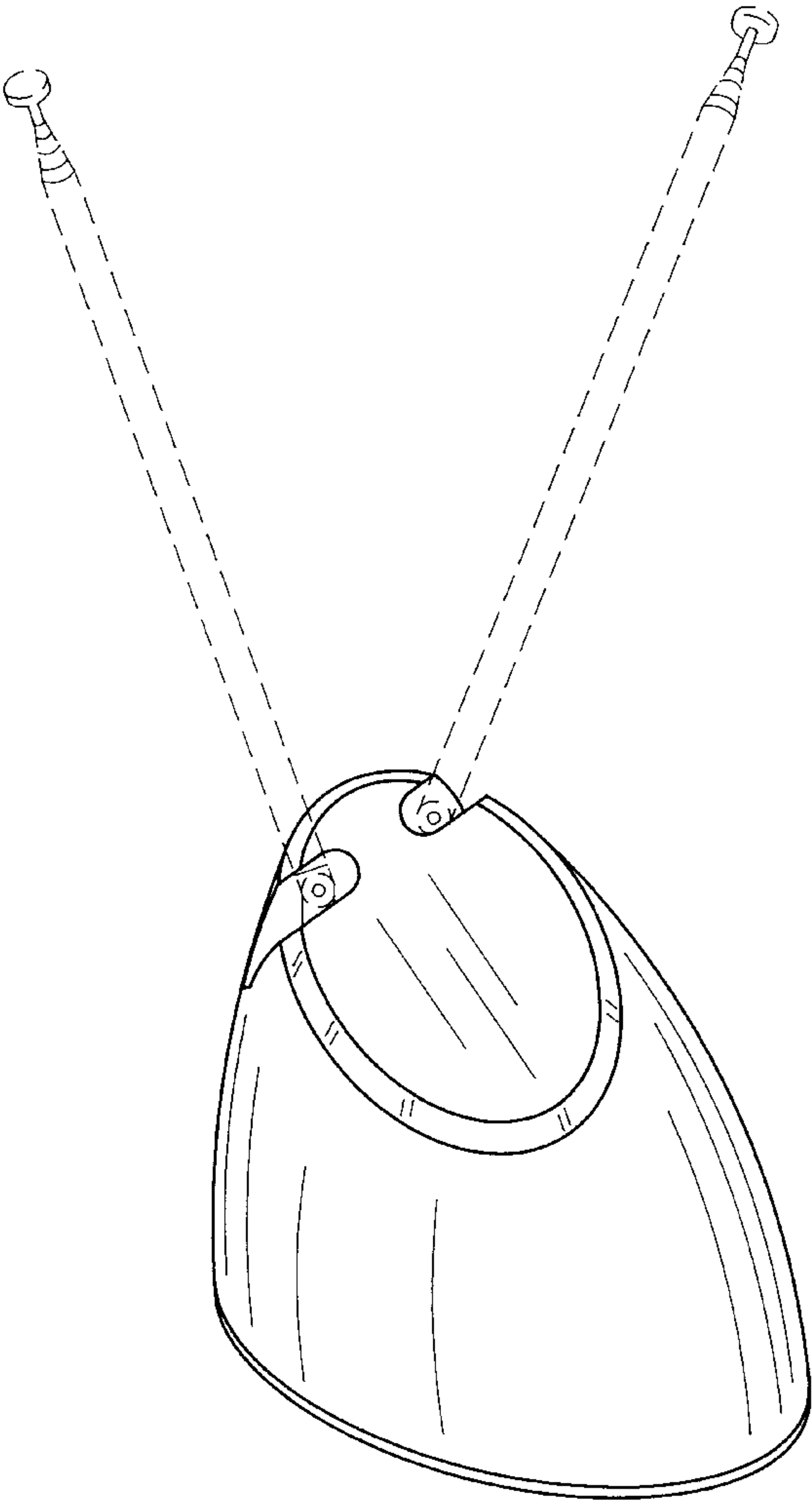
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

tive view of a antenna base, showing our new design with
the broken line structure being for illustrative purposes only

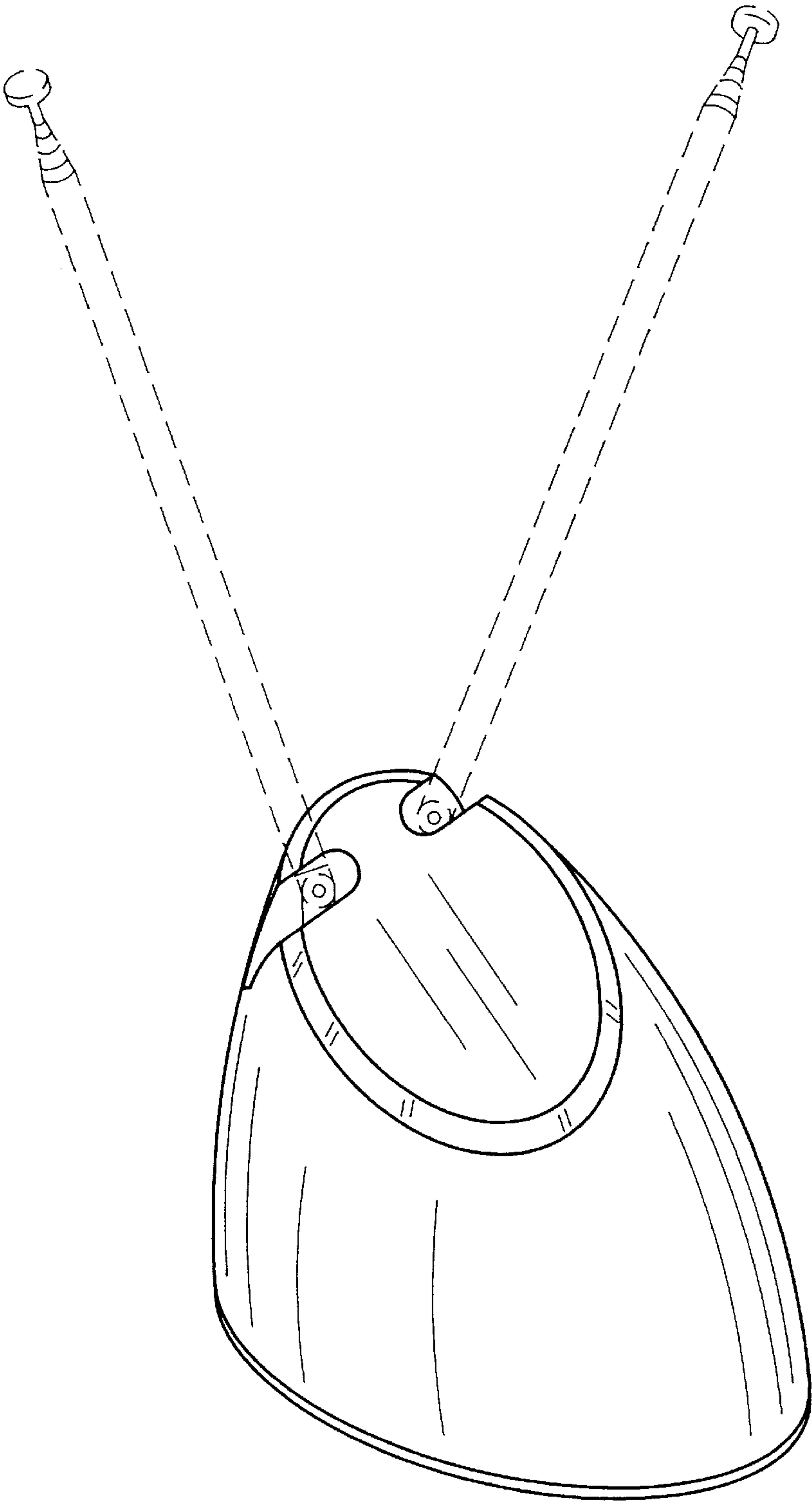

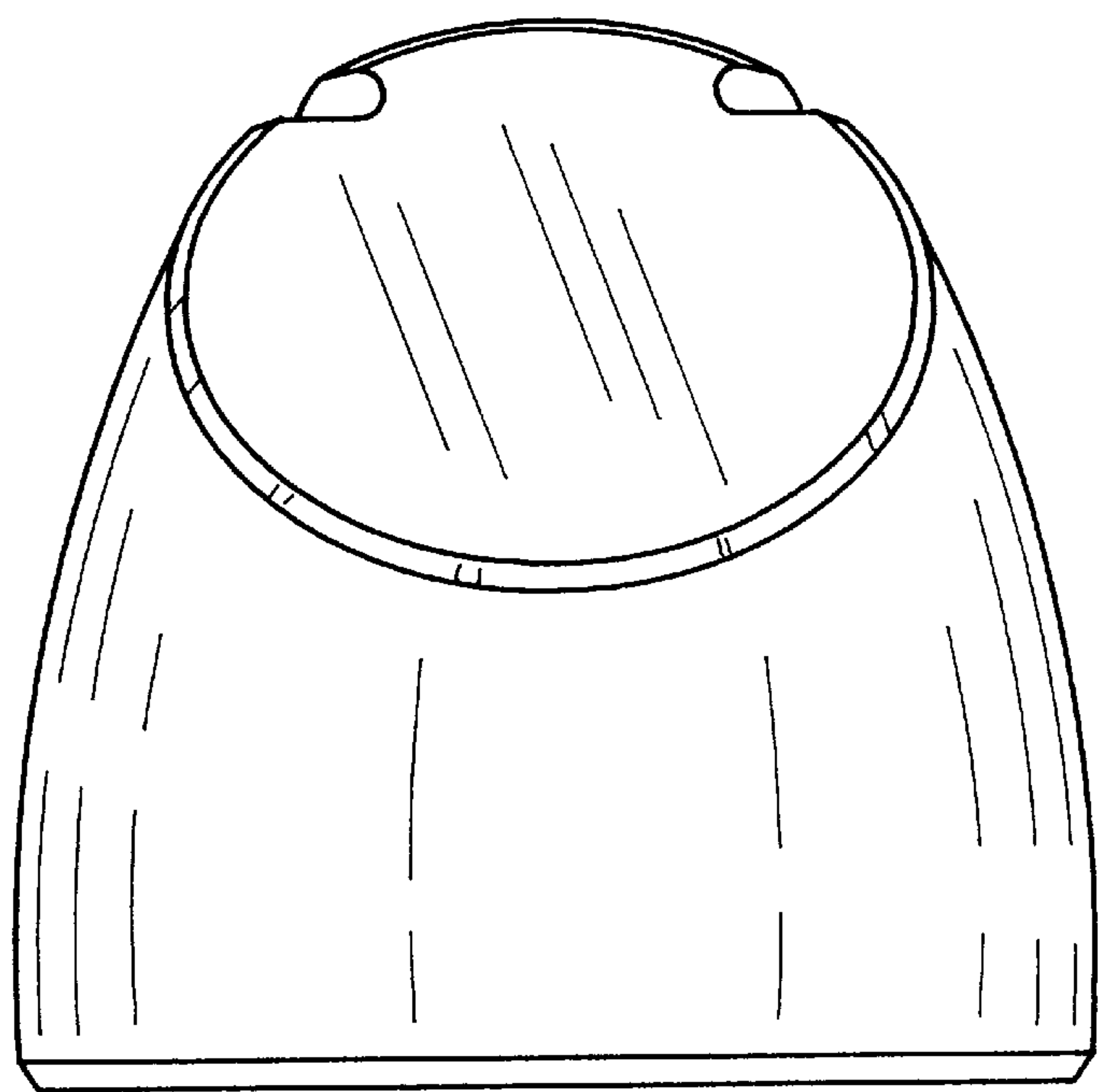

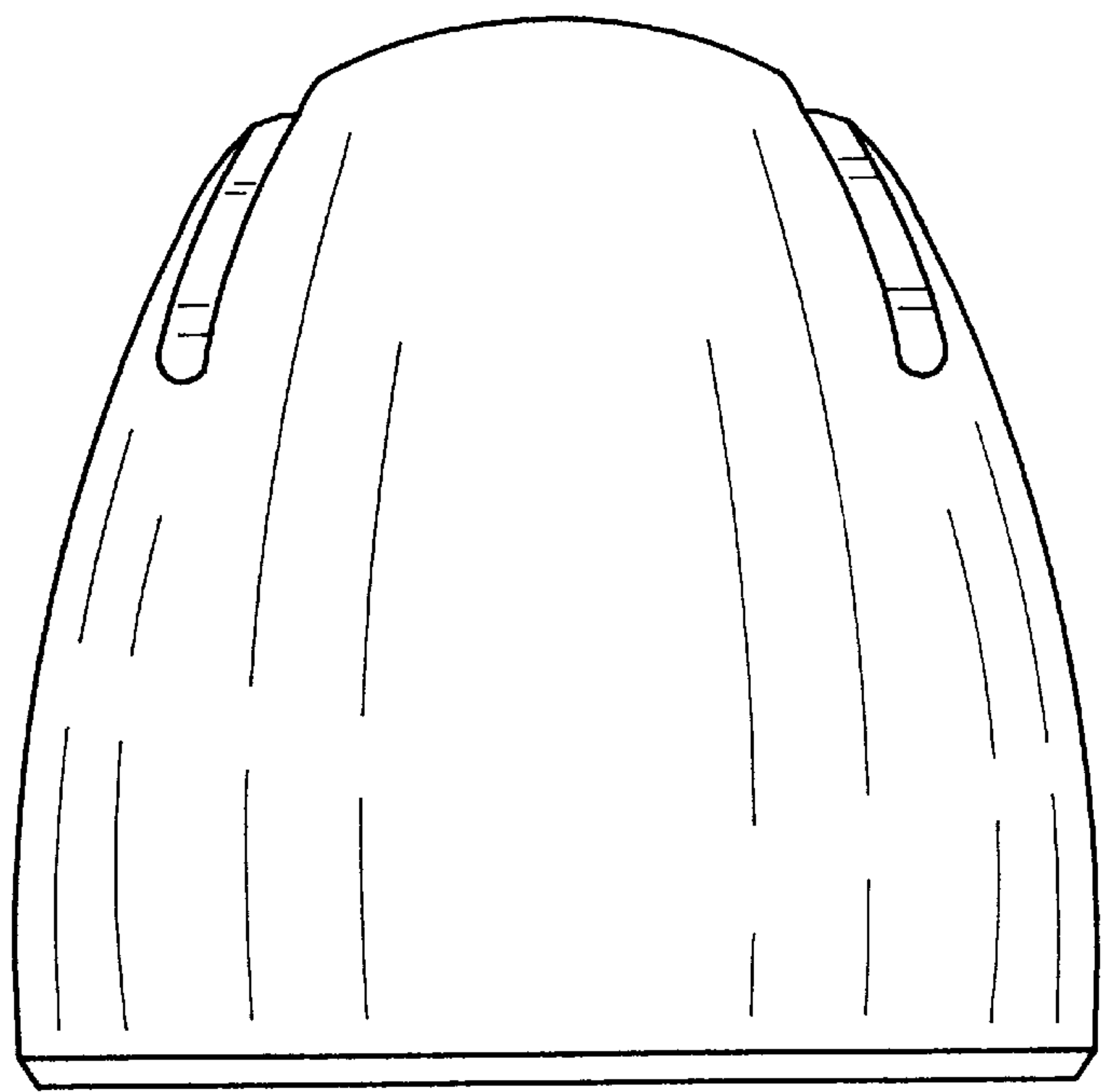

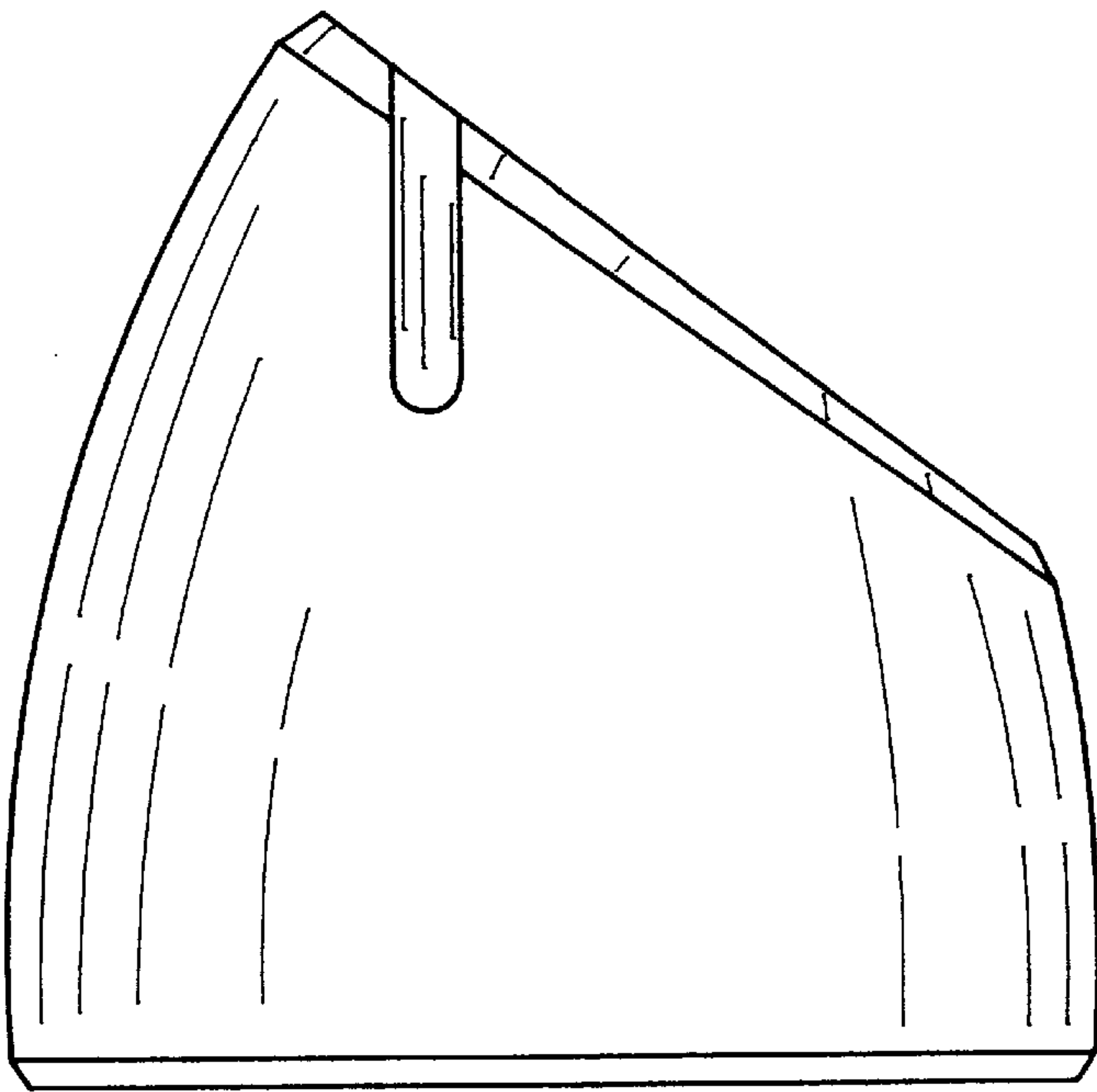

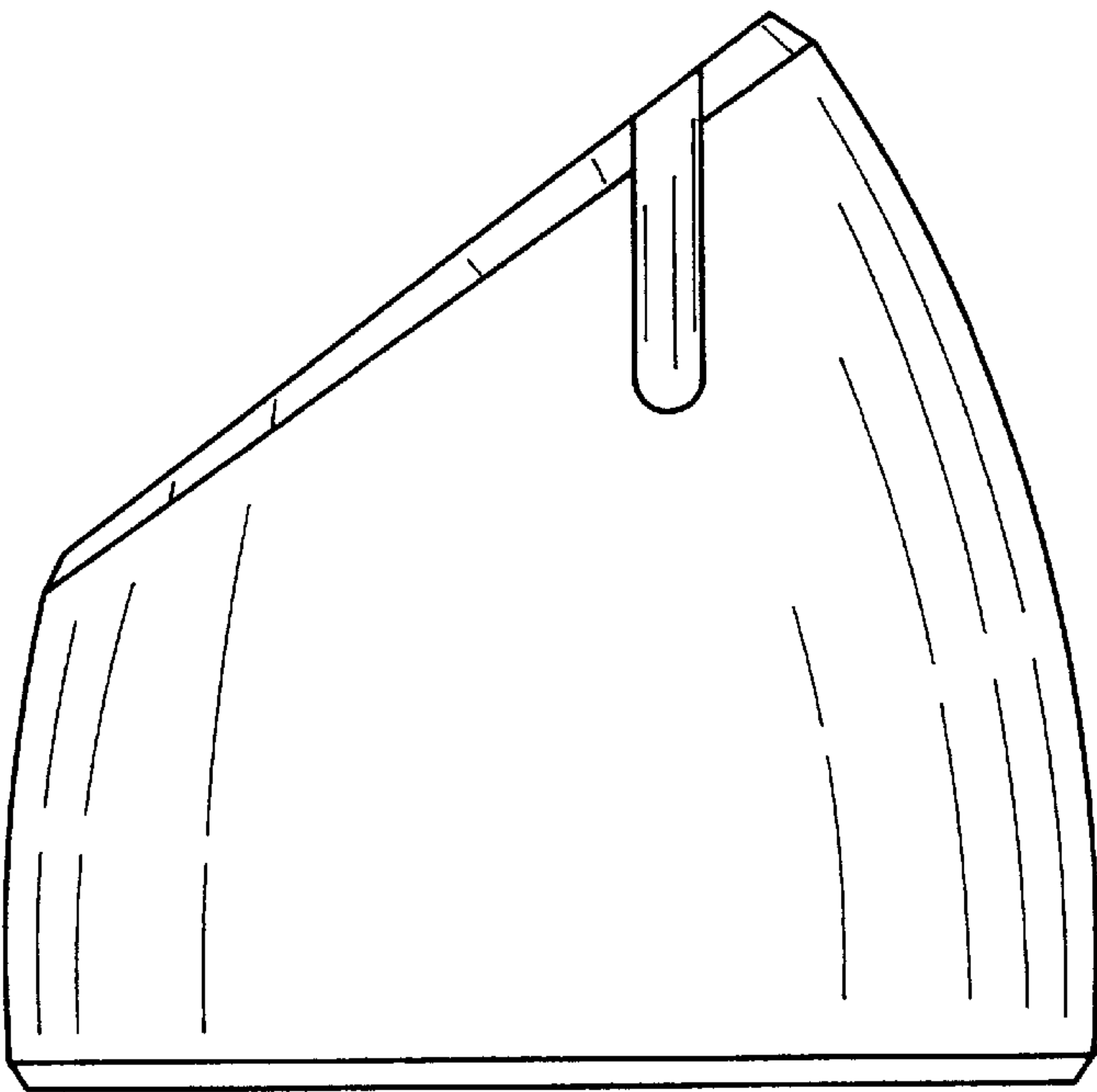

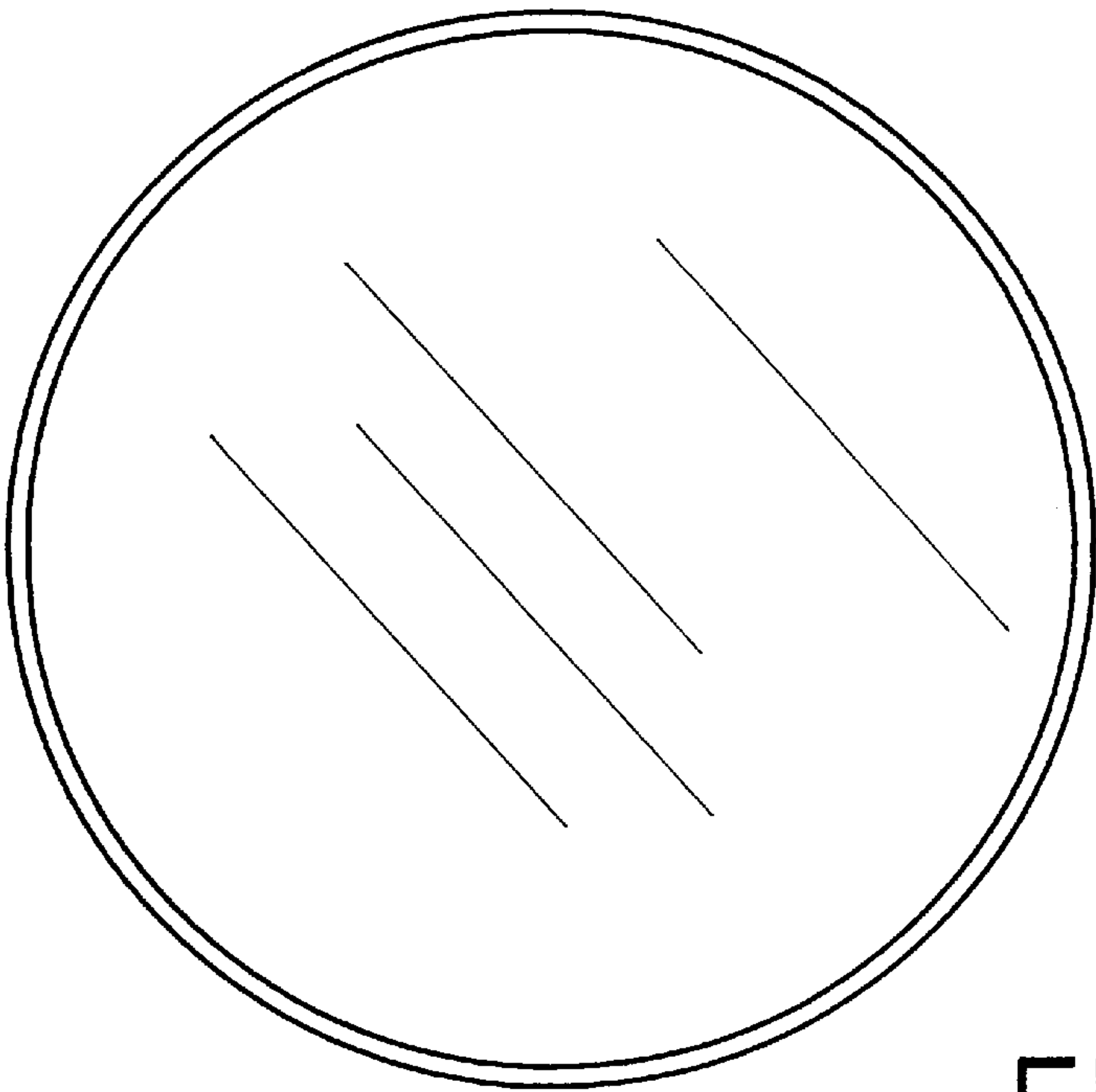

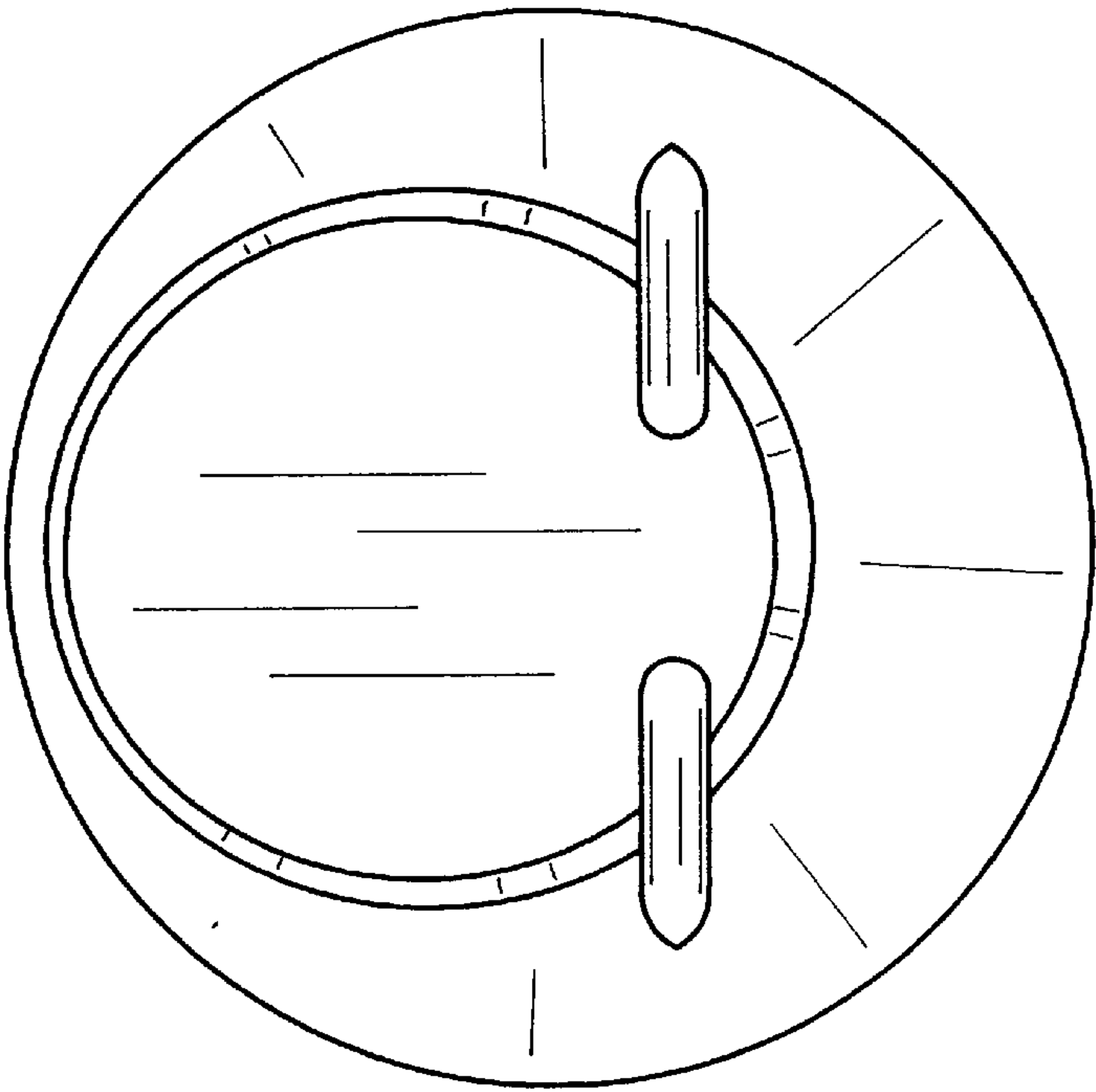
