The ornamental design for a utensil handle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment thereof; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a first embodiment thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of a first embodiment thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of a first embodiment thereof; FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a second embodiment thereof;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a second embodiment thereof, the bottom plan view is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment thereof;

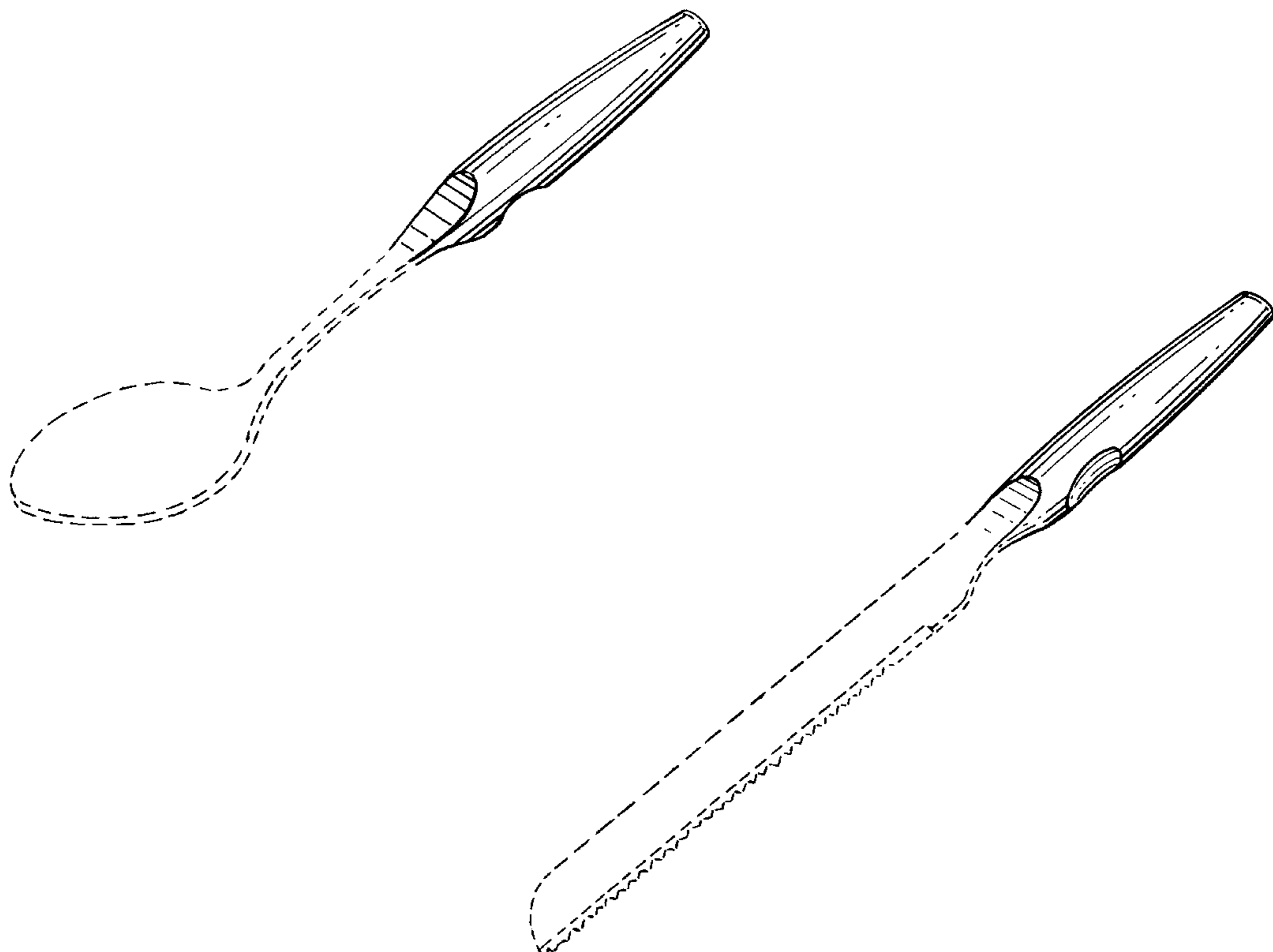
FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment thereof;

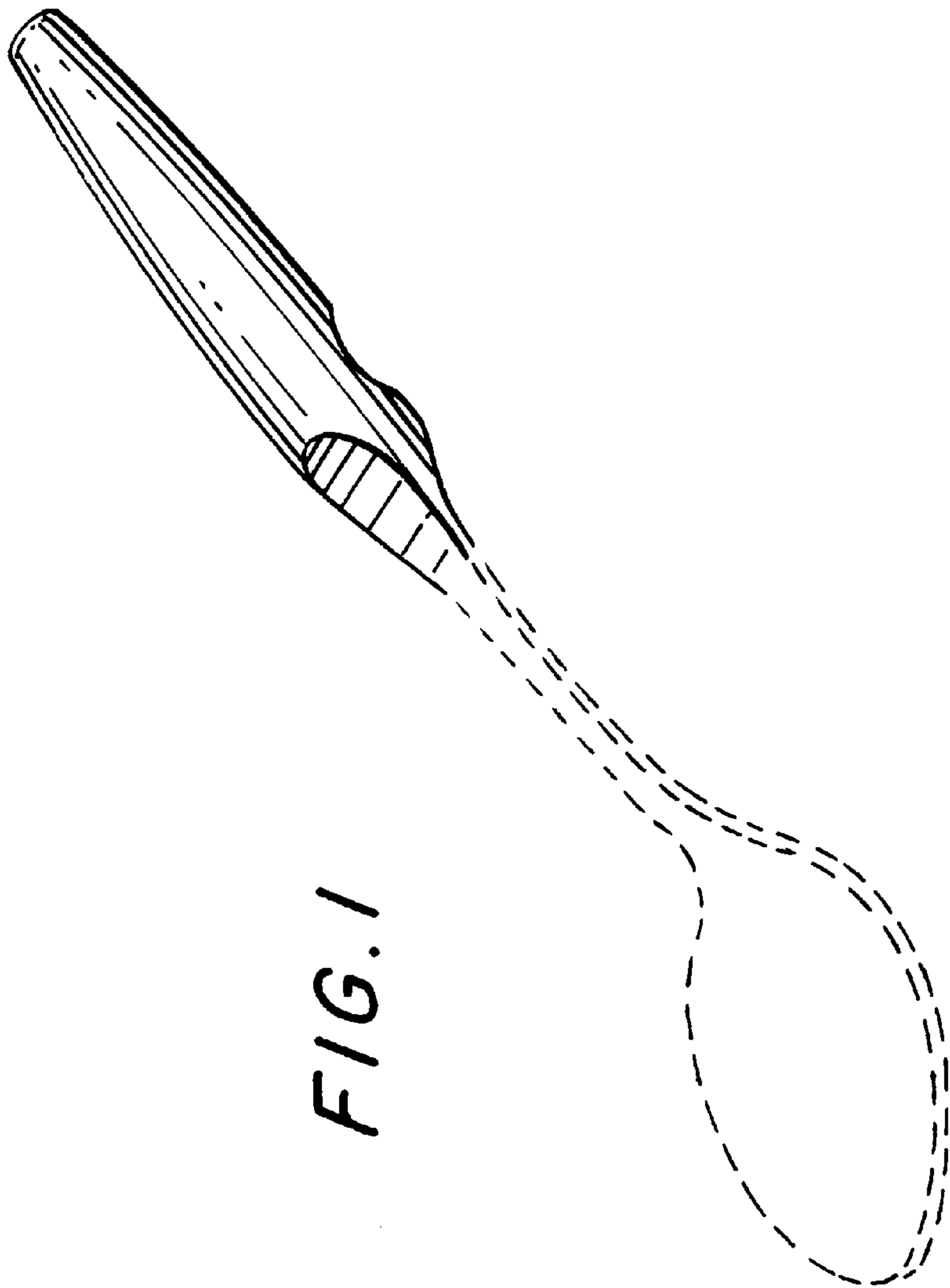
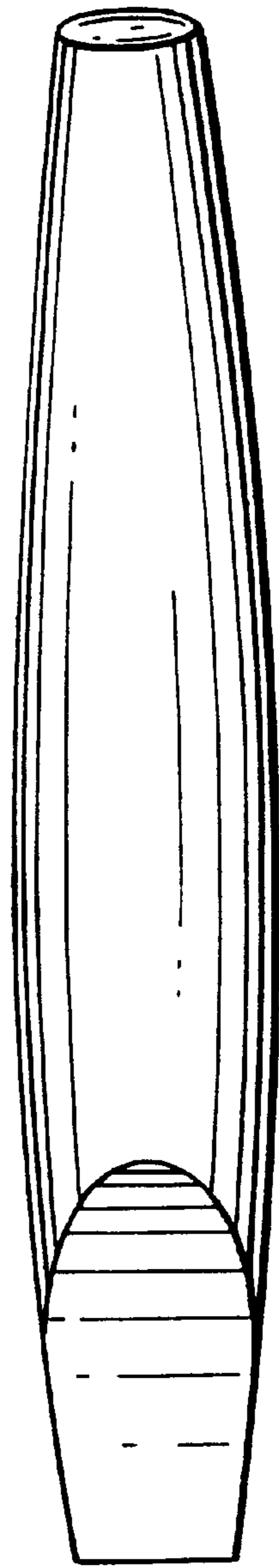
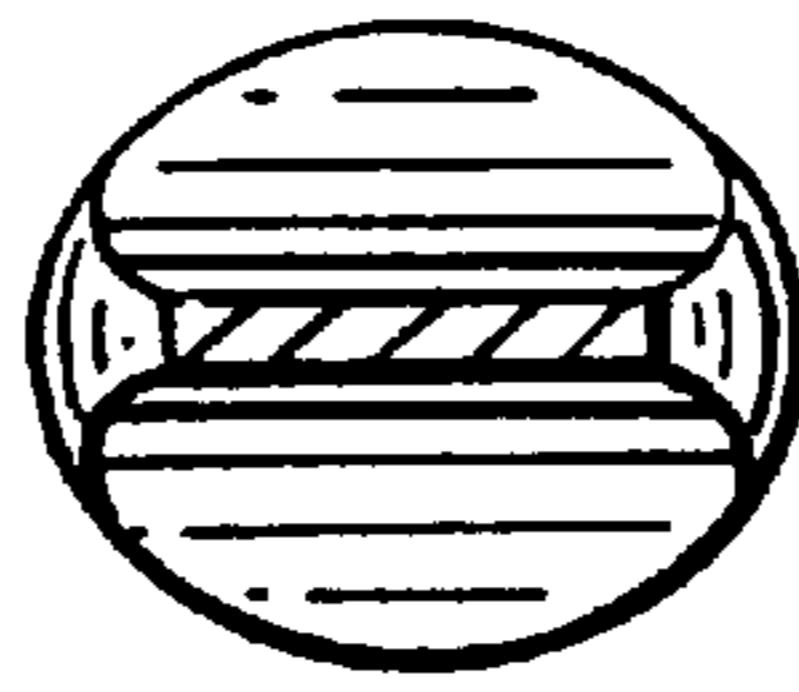


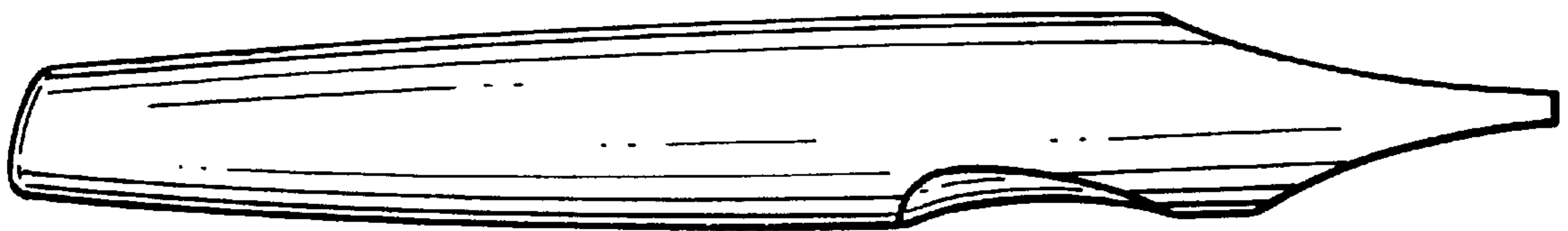

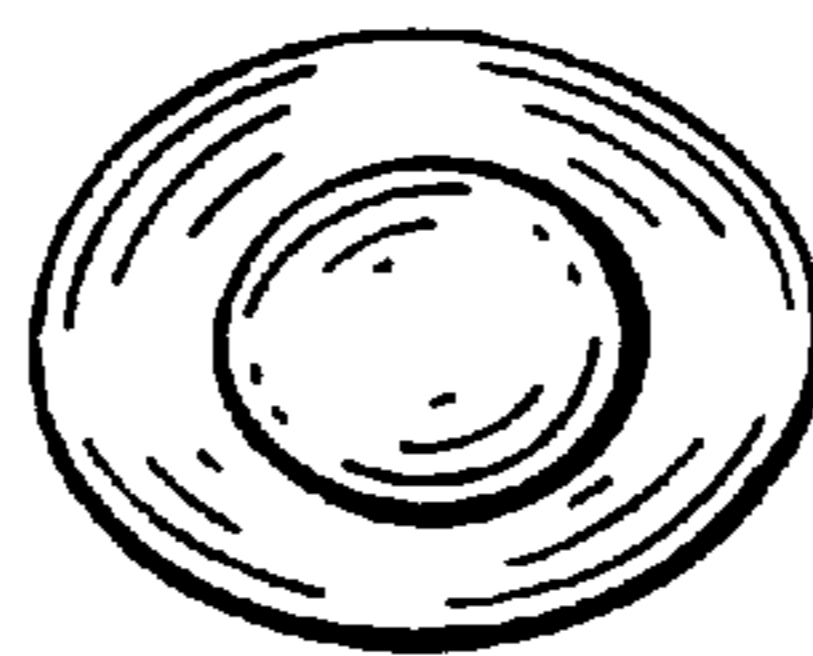

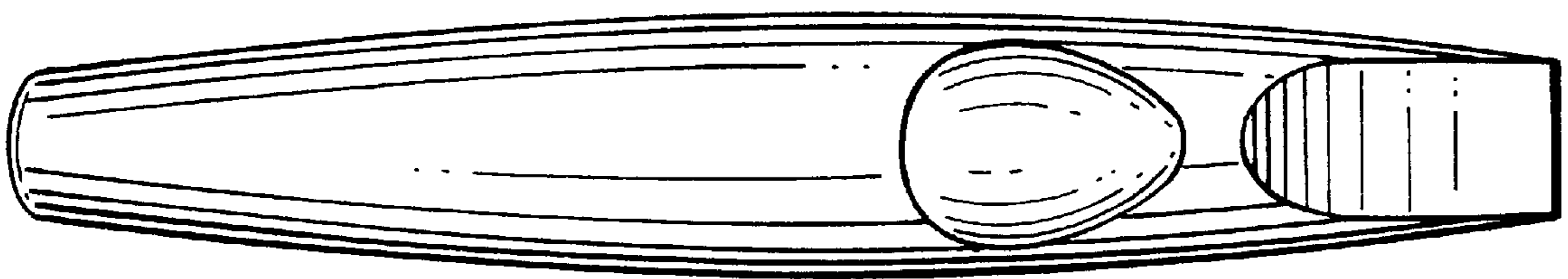

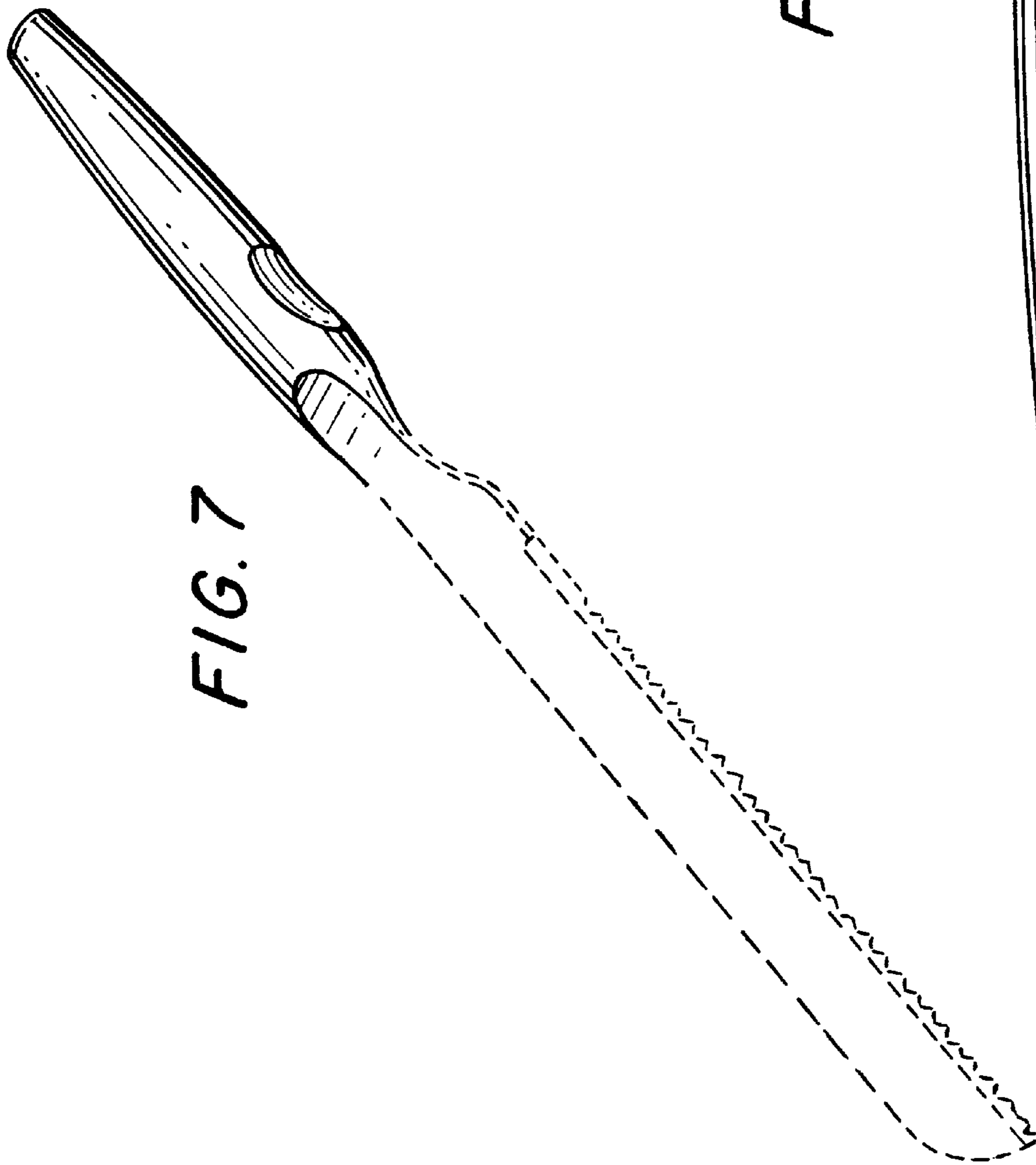
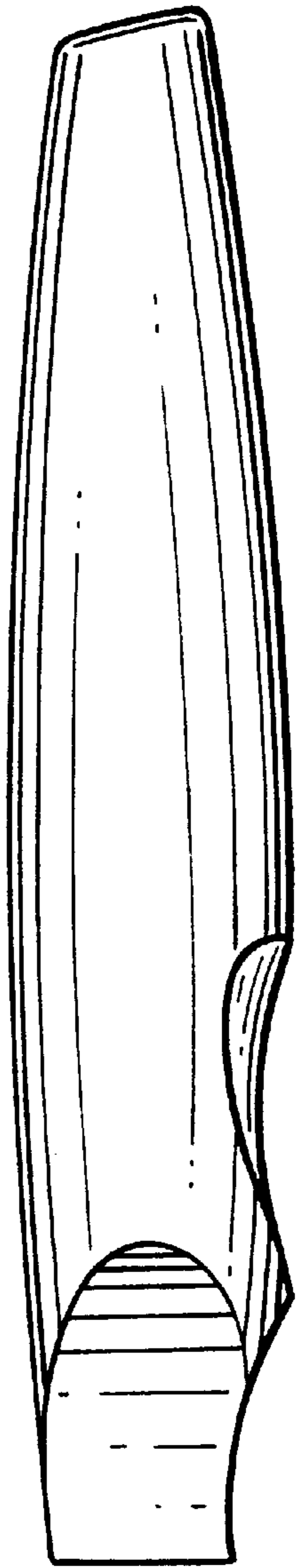
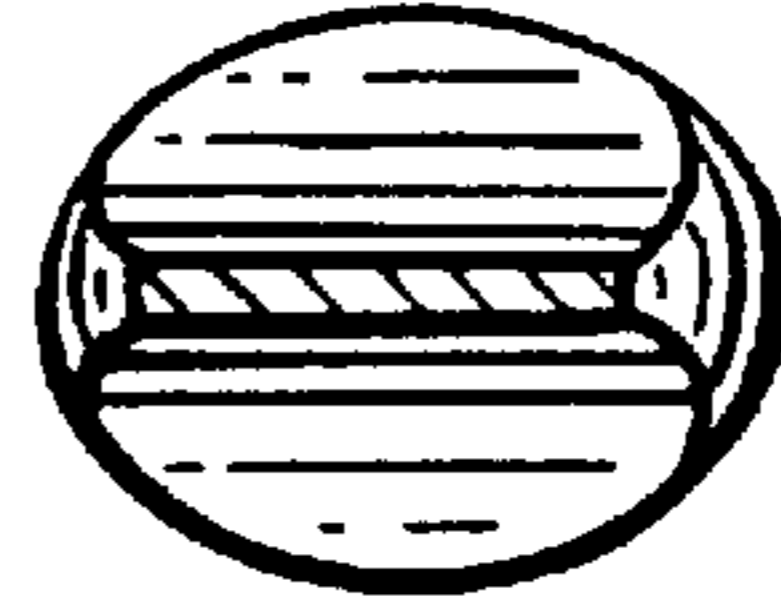

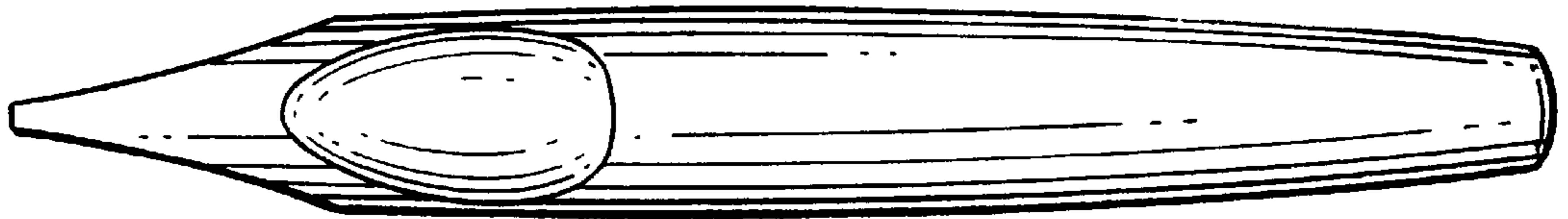

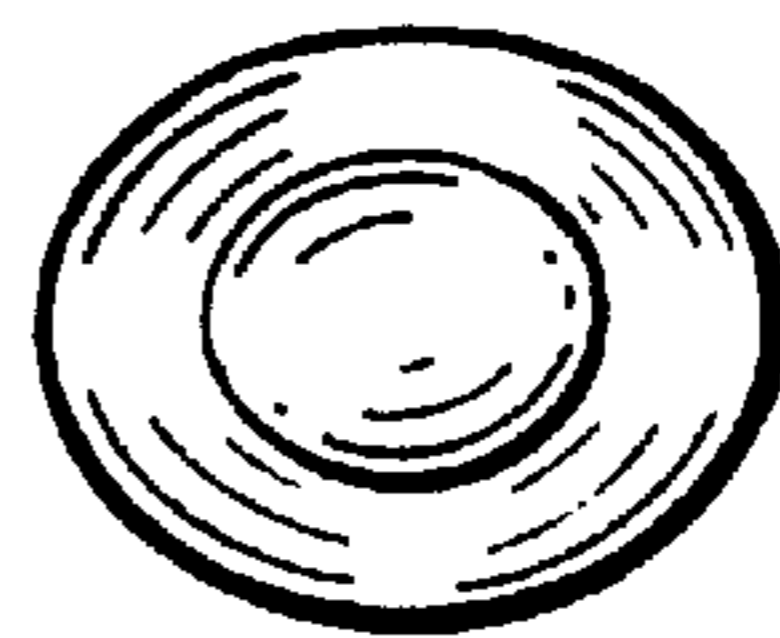
