[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an A-frame mobile cabin, showing my new design. showing a side view of a fold-out deck;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of an A-frame mobile cabin as illustrated in FIG. 4 having a hinged tongue structure with cup and a deck in fold-up position; and,

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view of an A-frame mobile cabin.

The sides shown in the drawings as well as the wood on the subject deck are shown in randomly-drawn jagged lines and are for illustrative purposes only having no regular or set pattern.

The broken lines are shown for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
