FIG. 4 is a left side view of the claimed design;

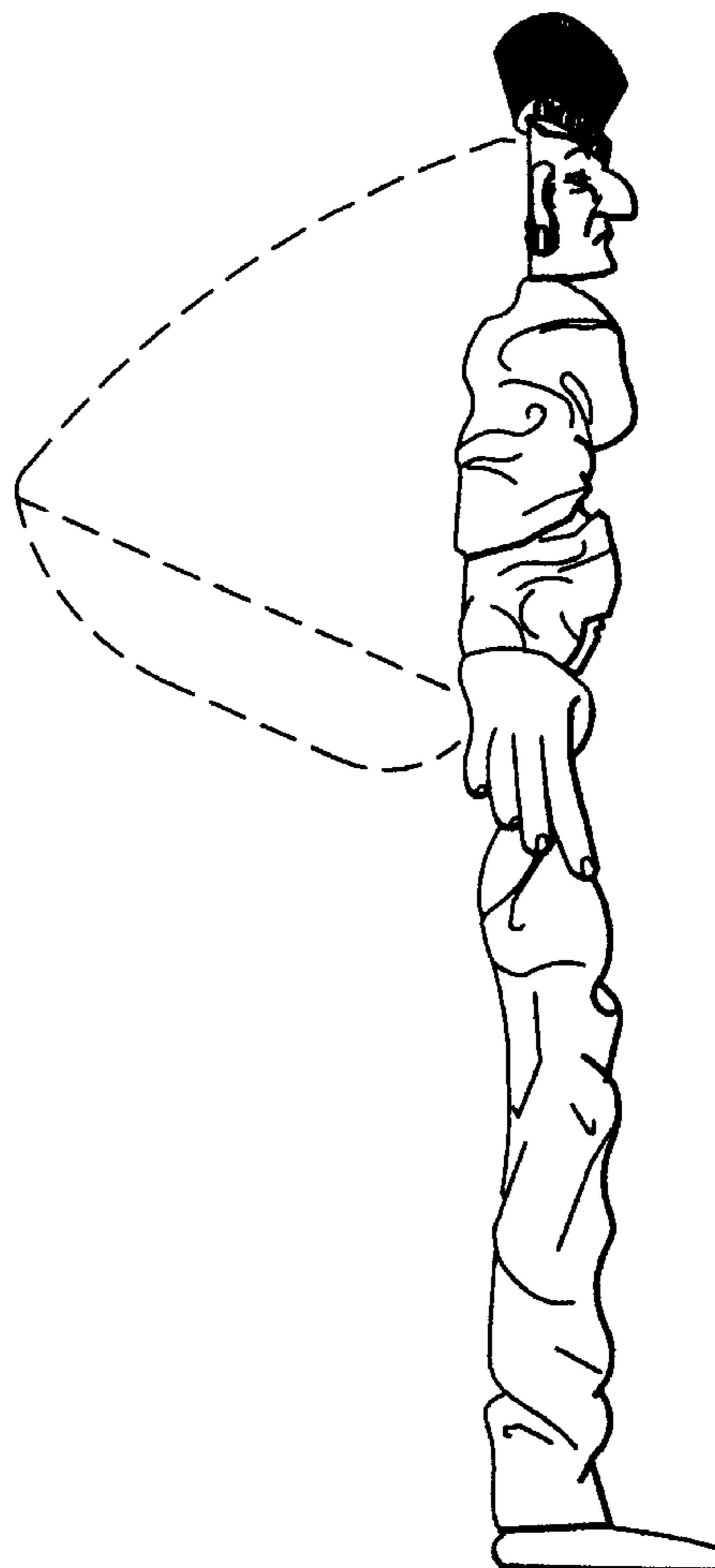
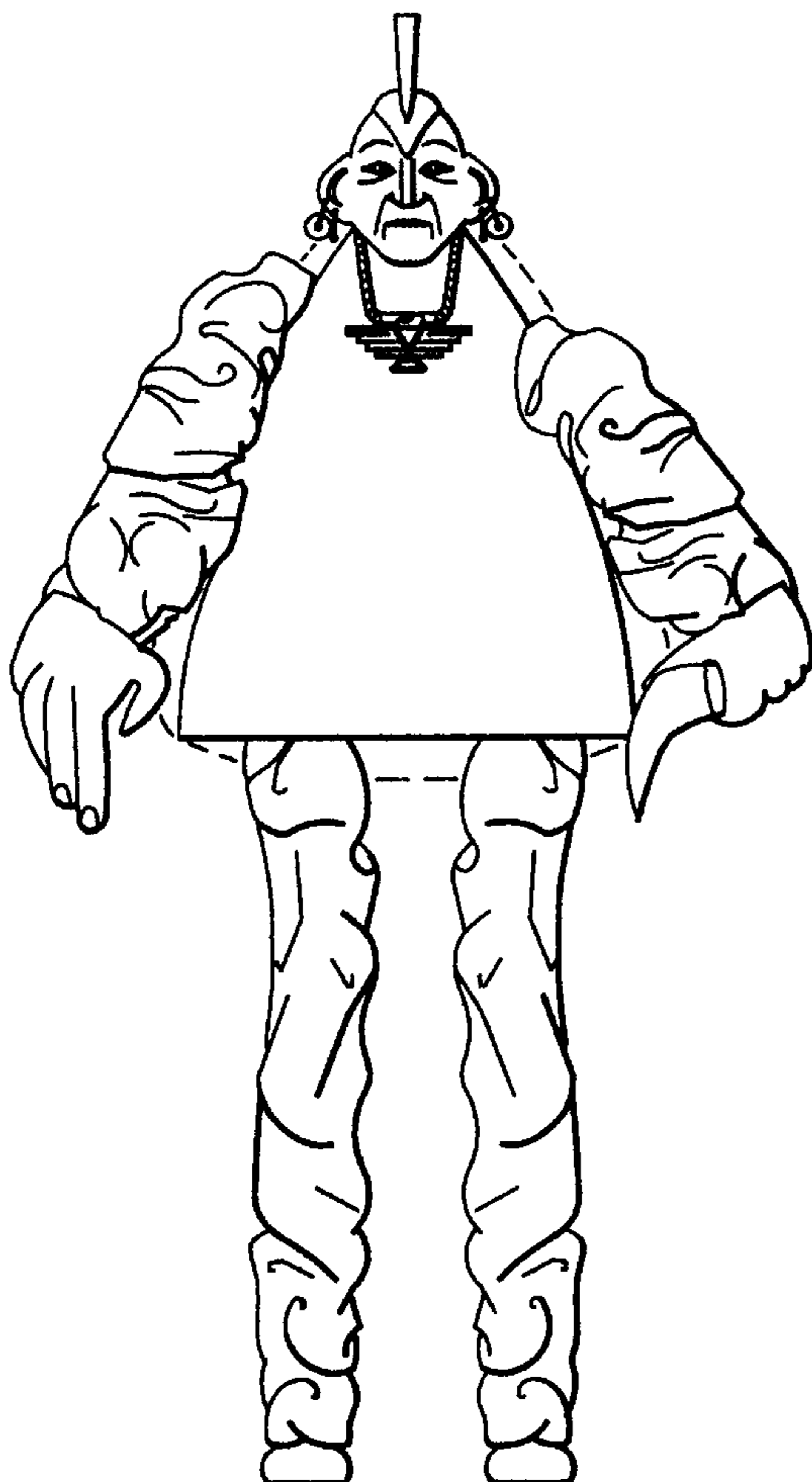
FIG. 5 is a back view of the indian doll of the present invention; and,

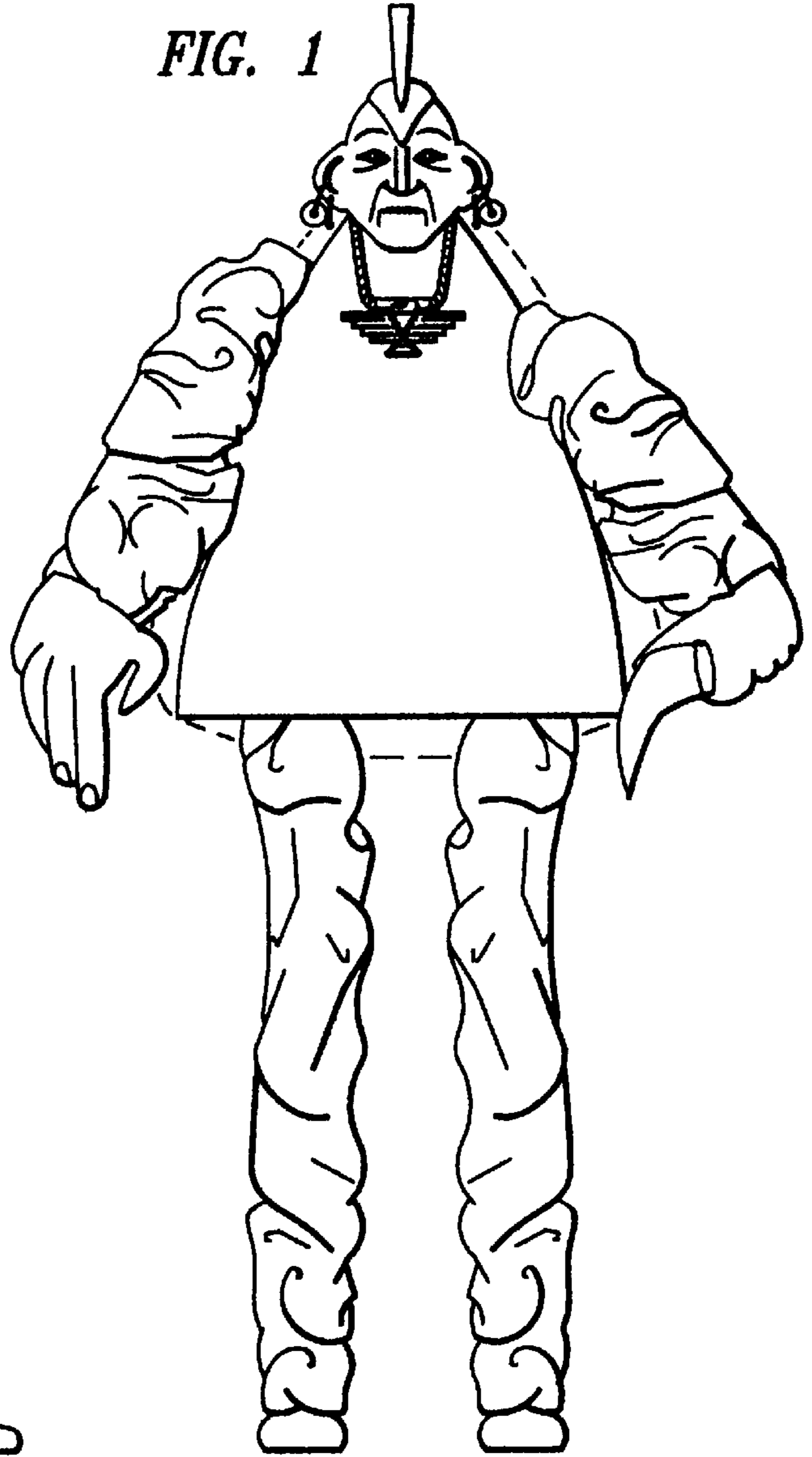
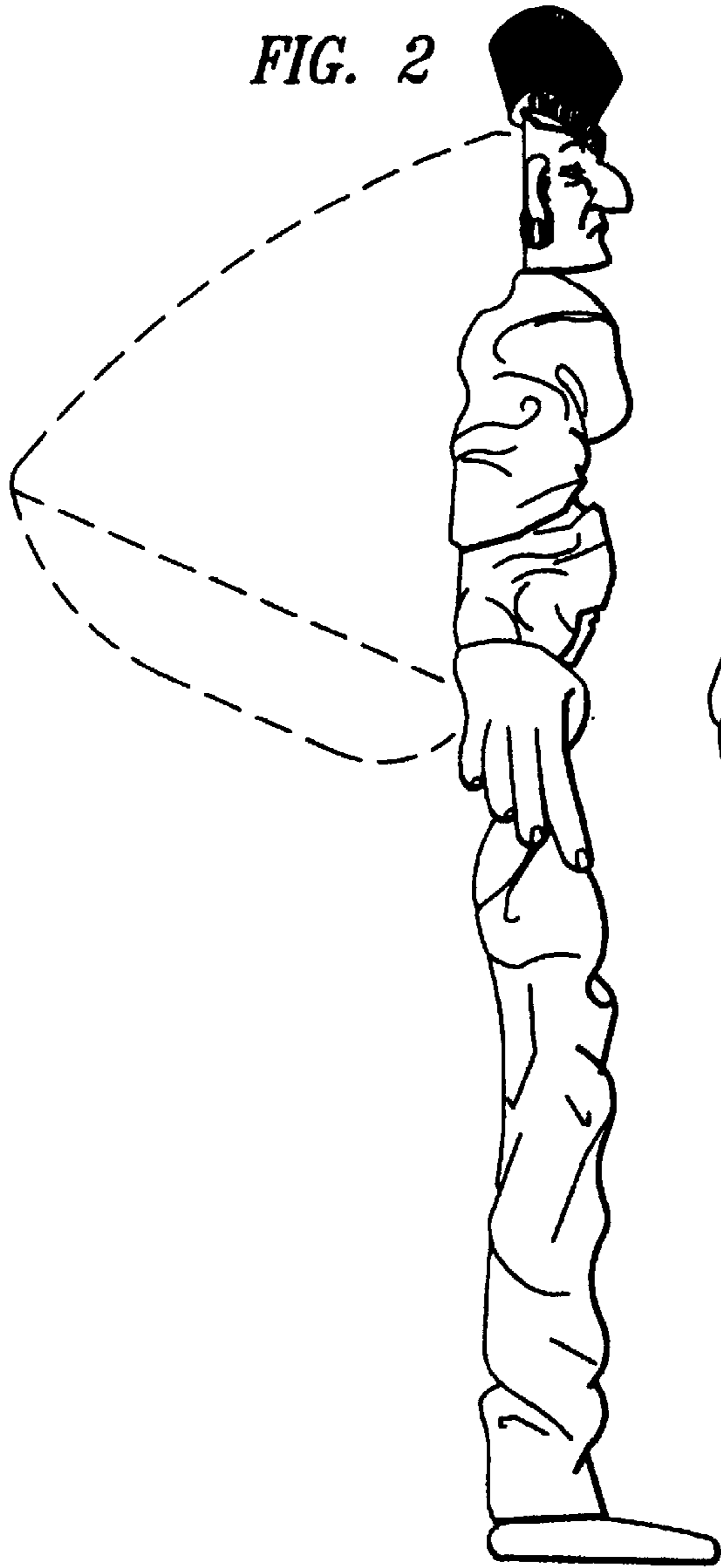

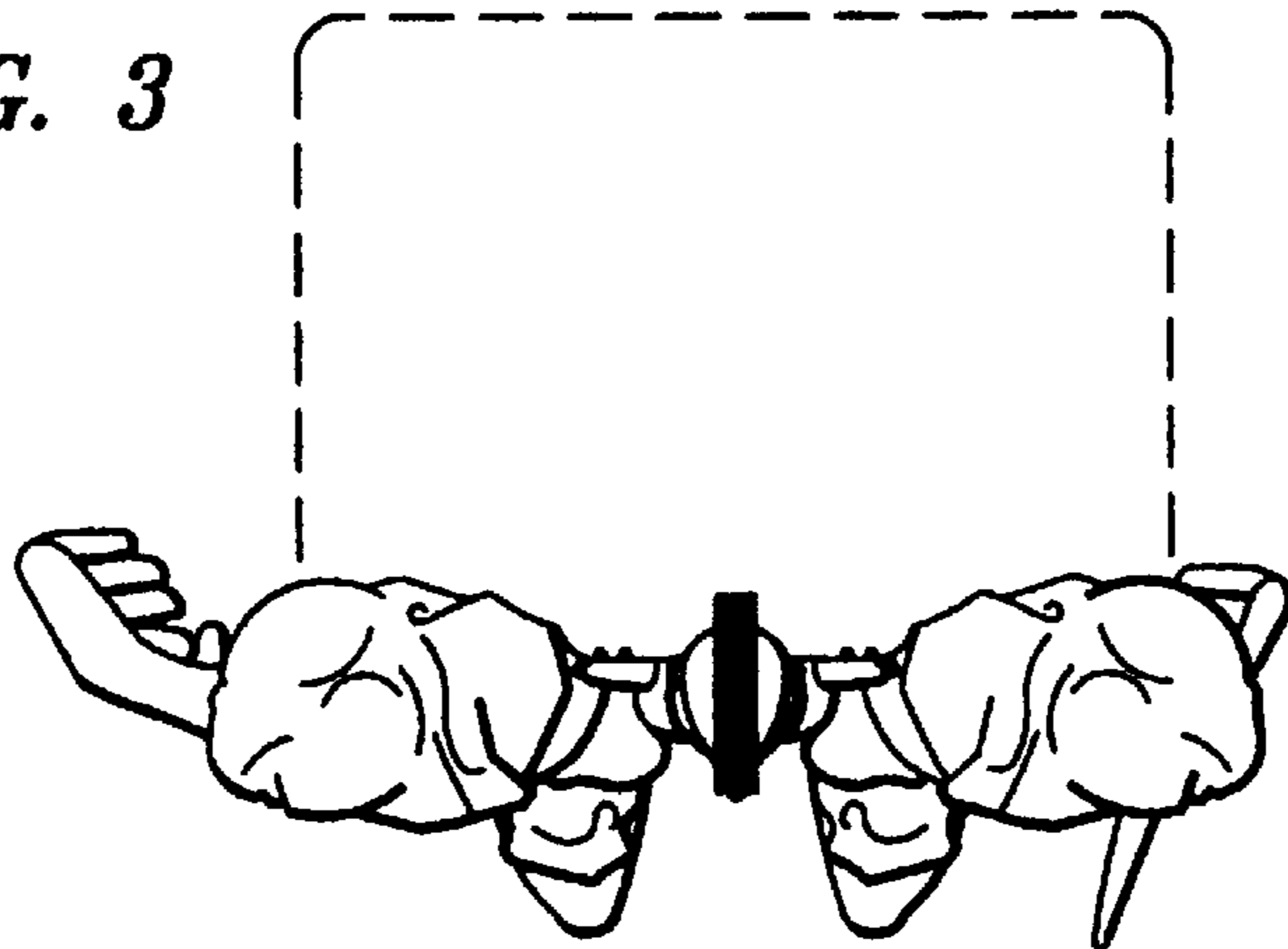

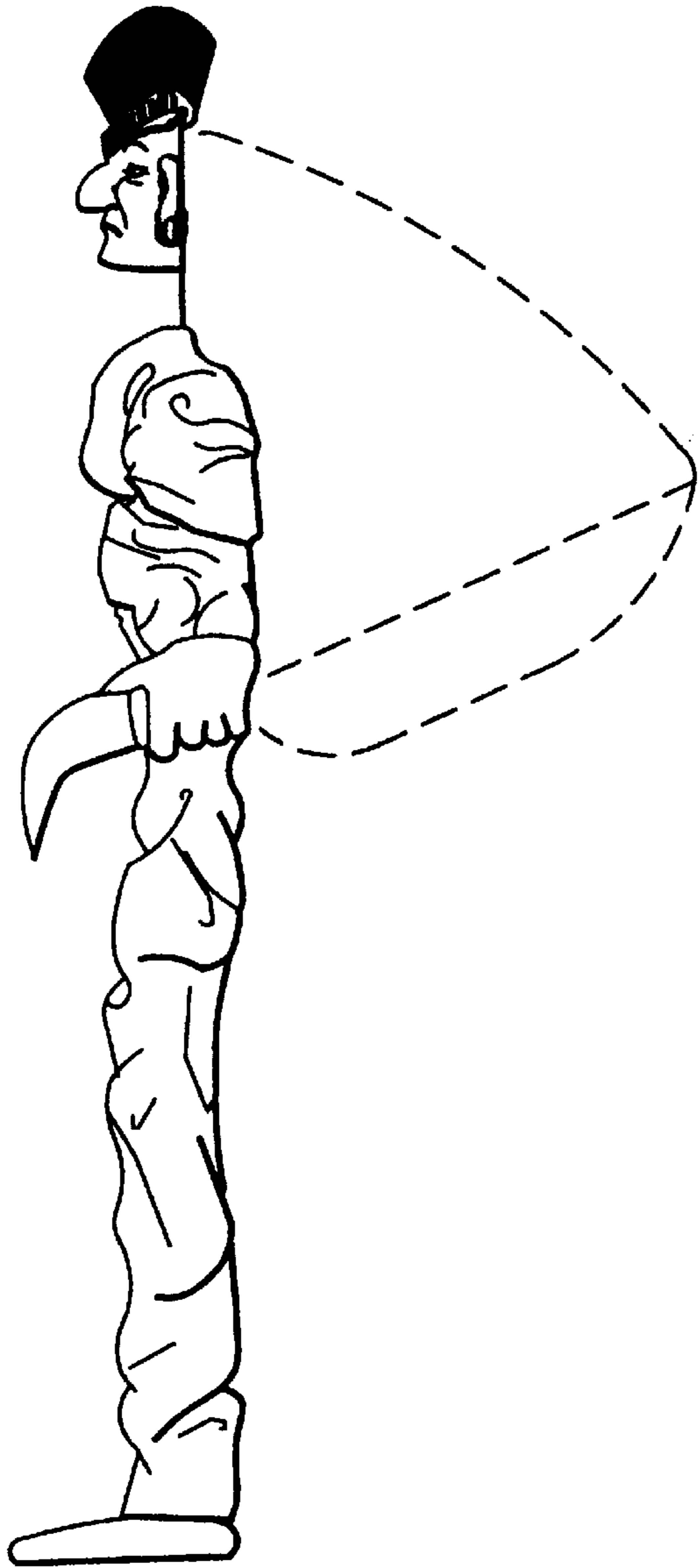

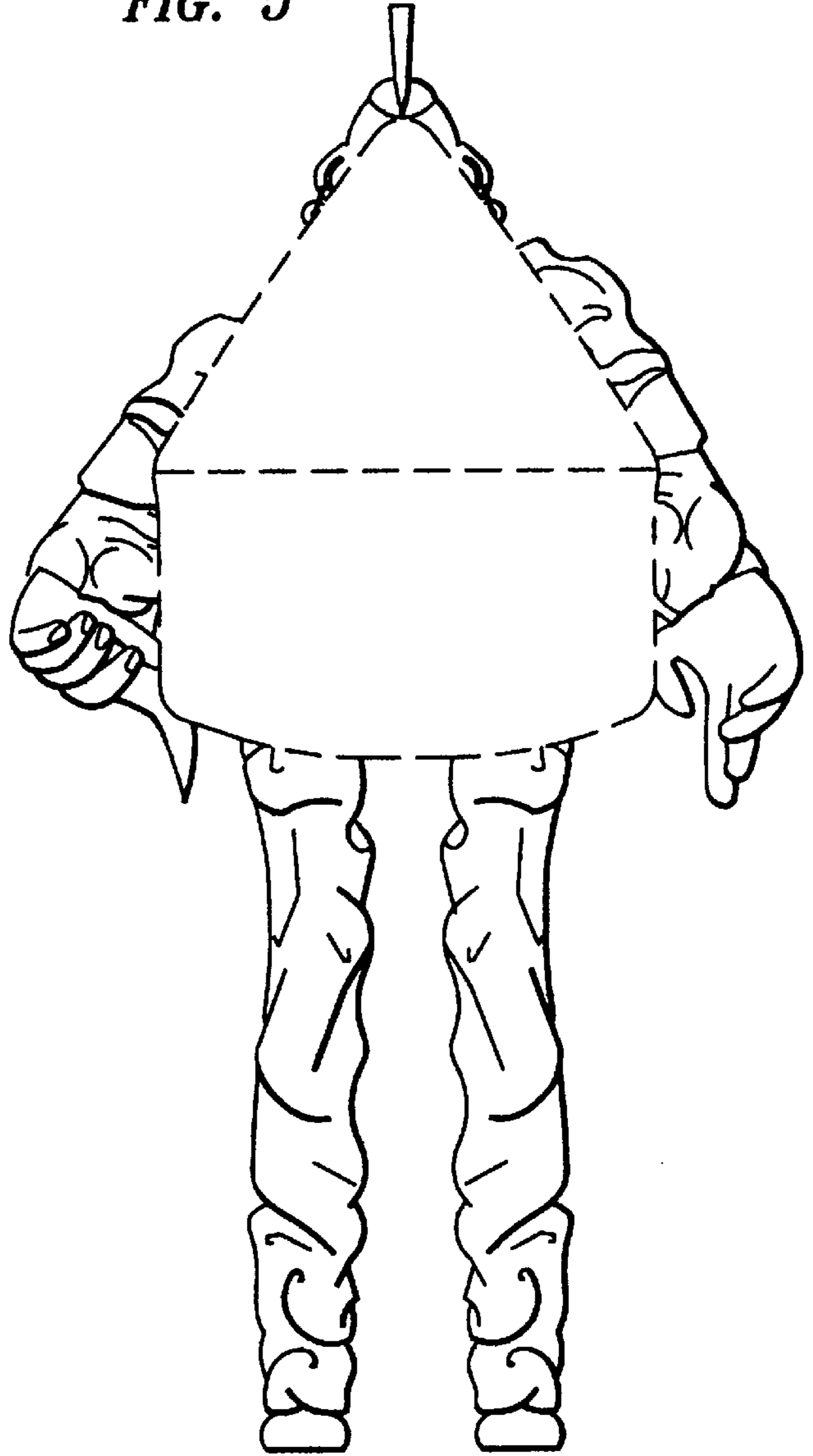
