[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pharmaceutical tablet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a pharmaceutical tablet showing the new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a bottom perspective view of the pharmaceutical tablet showing the new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof, opposite of FIG. 3; and,

FIG. 8 is an end elevational view thereof, opposite of FIG. 4.

The characteristic feature of the design resides in the color blue. The horizontal line shading in the upper right corner of the article of FIG. 1 is understood to represent the color blue and extend to cover all surfaces of the claimed design. The "Pfizer" logo forming part of the claimed design is a registered trademark of Pfizer Inc.

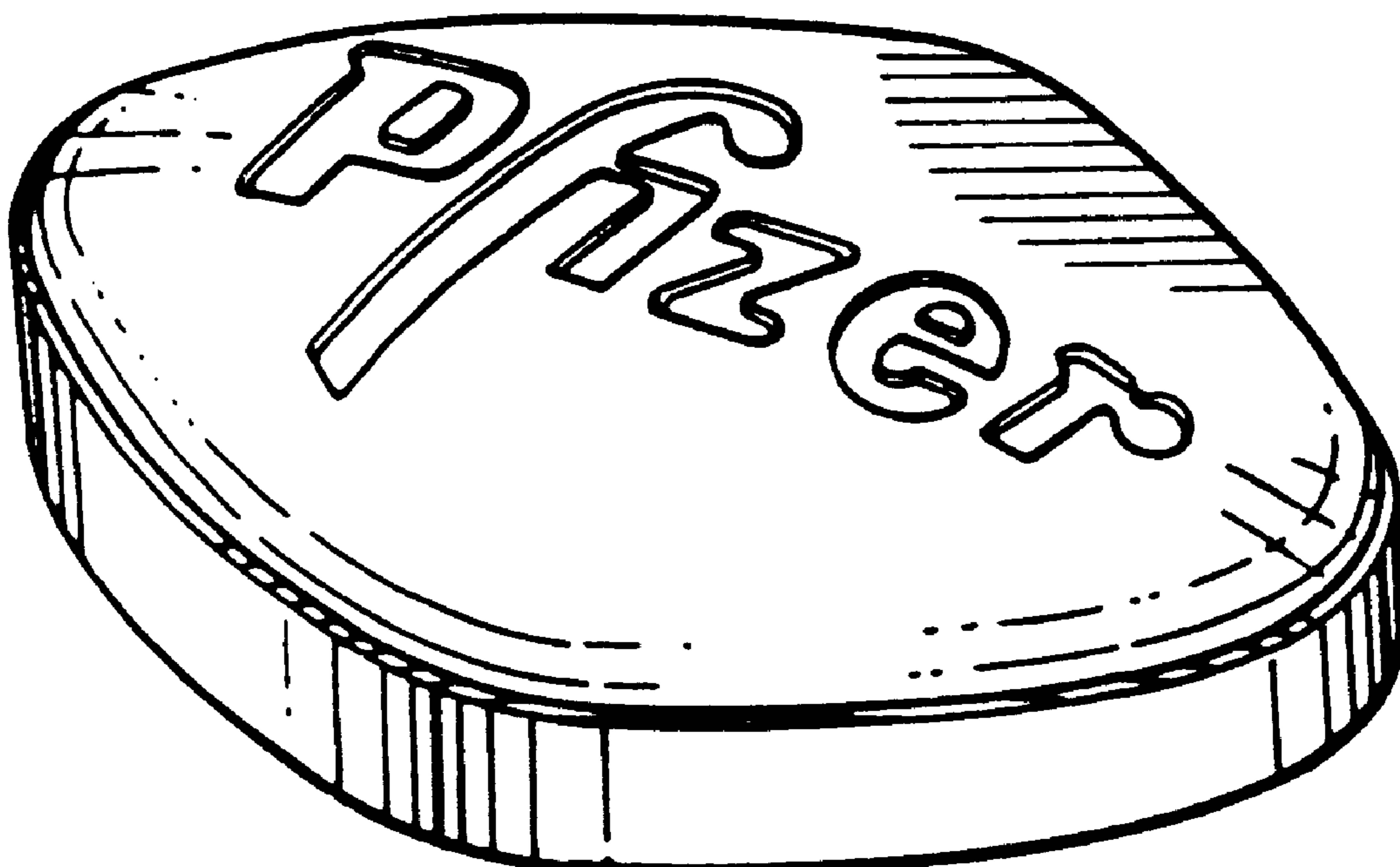

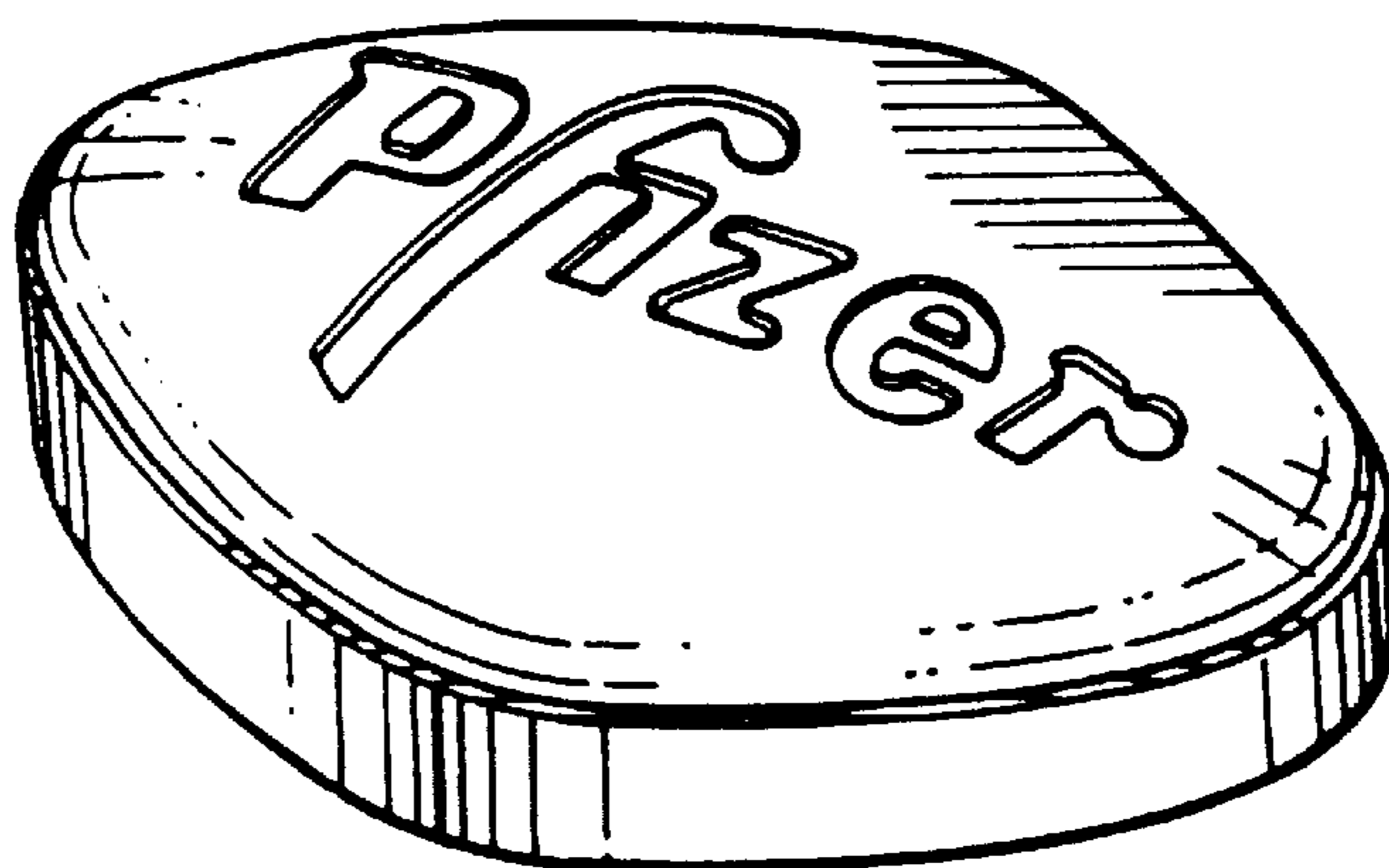

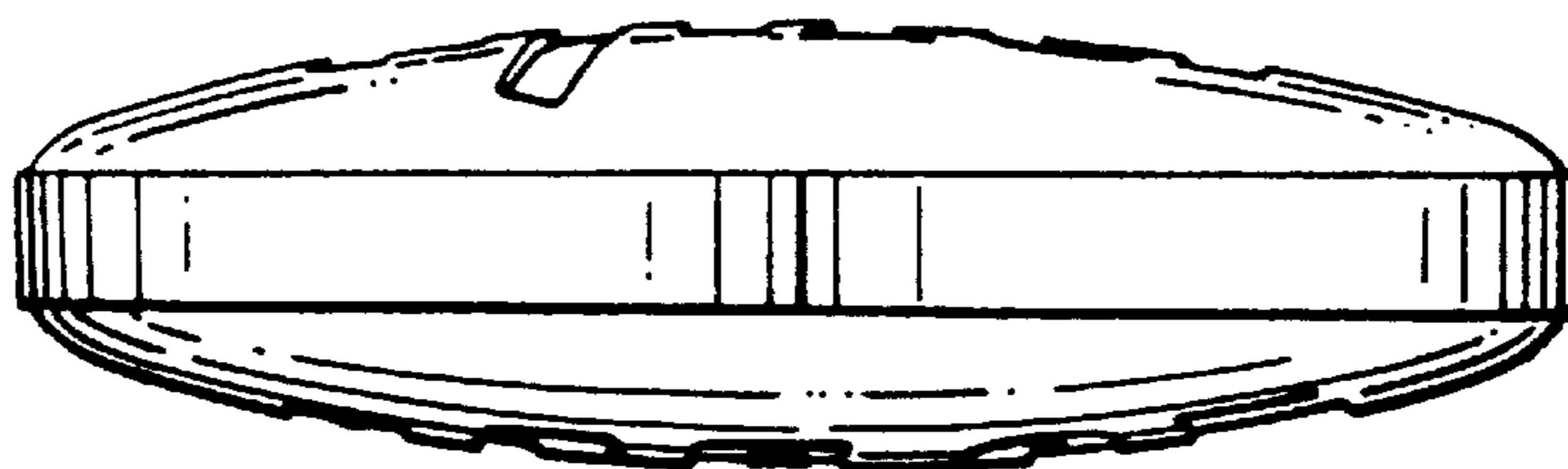

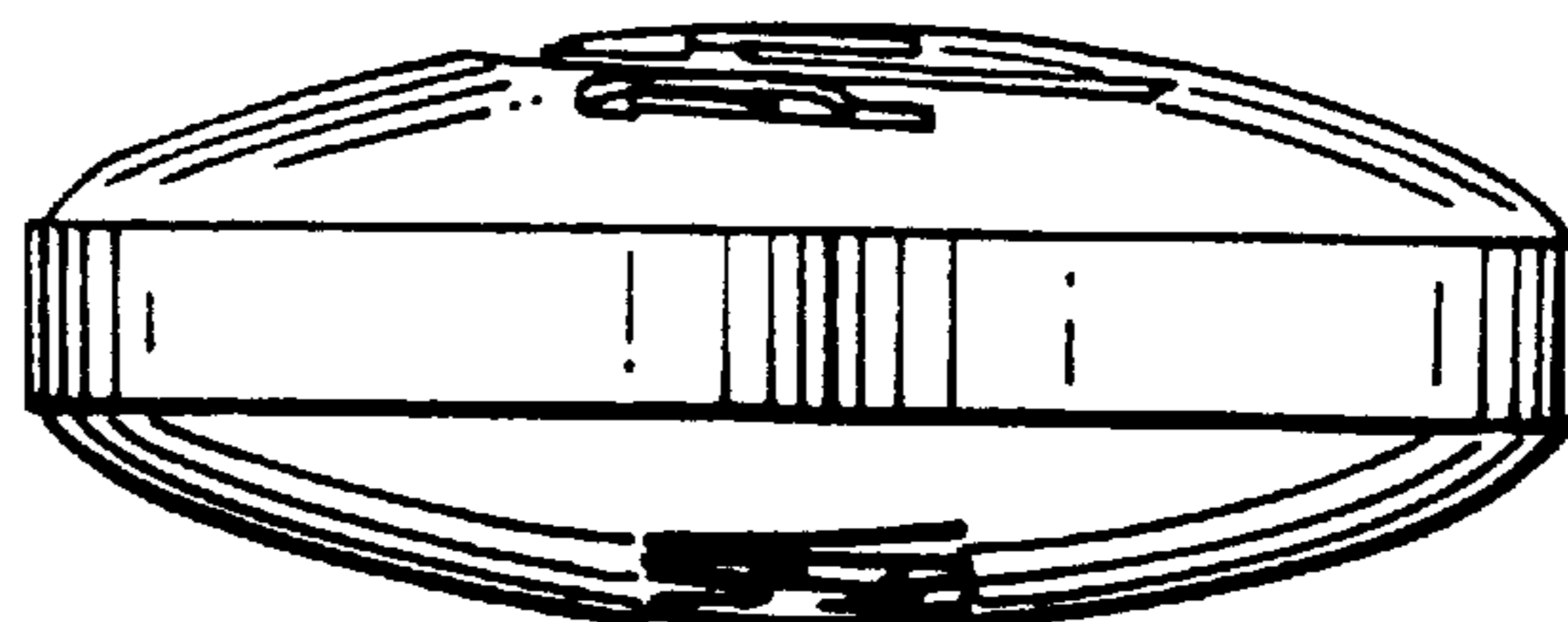

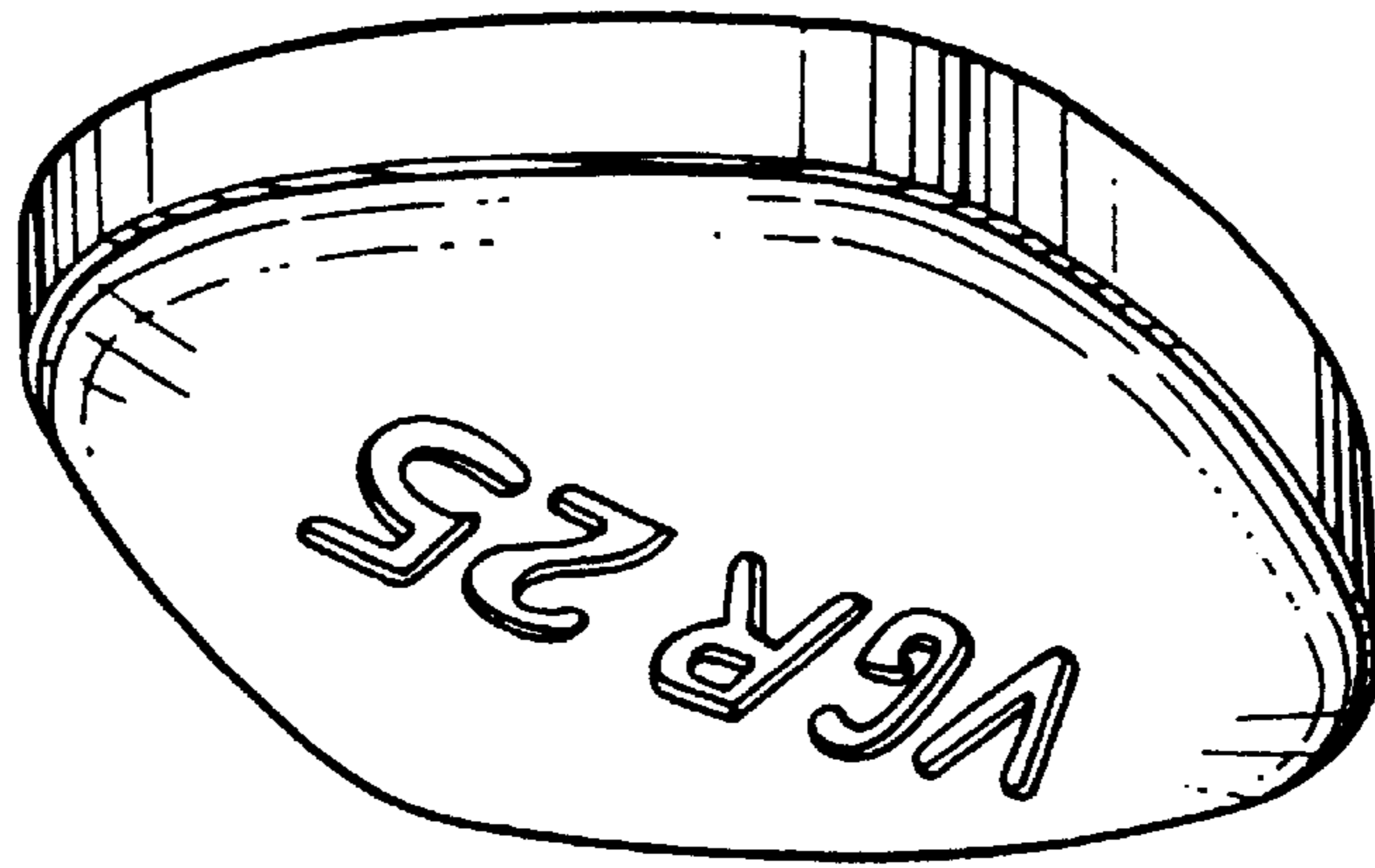

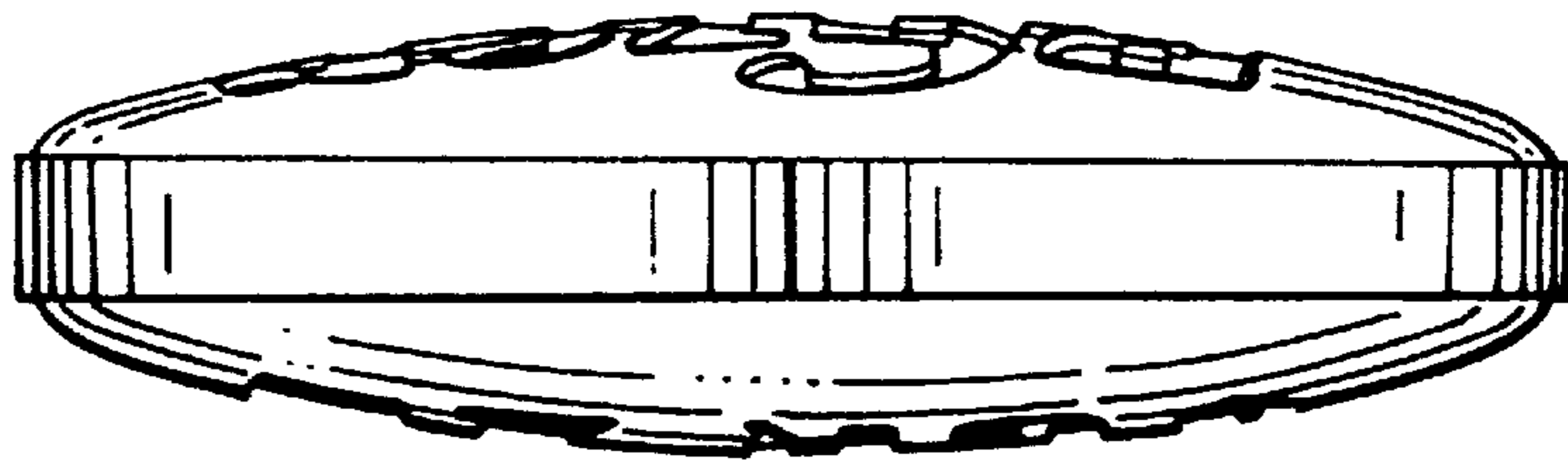
