

**CLAIM** [57]

The ornamental design for a combined cabinet with glove box and container for housing medical waste, as shown and described.

#### **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a combined cabinet with glove box and container for housing medical waste, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side view of the combined cabinet with glove box and container for housing medical waste;

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the combined cabinet with glove box and container for housing medical waste;


FIG. 4 is a rear view of the combined cabinet with glove box and container for housing medical waste;

FIG. 5 is a top view of the combined cabinet with glove box and container for housing medical waste;











