DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of chair showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;

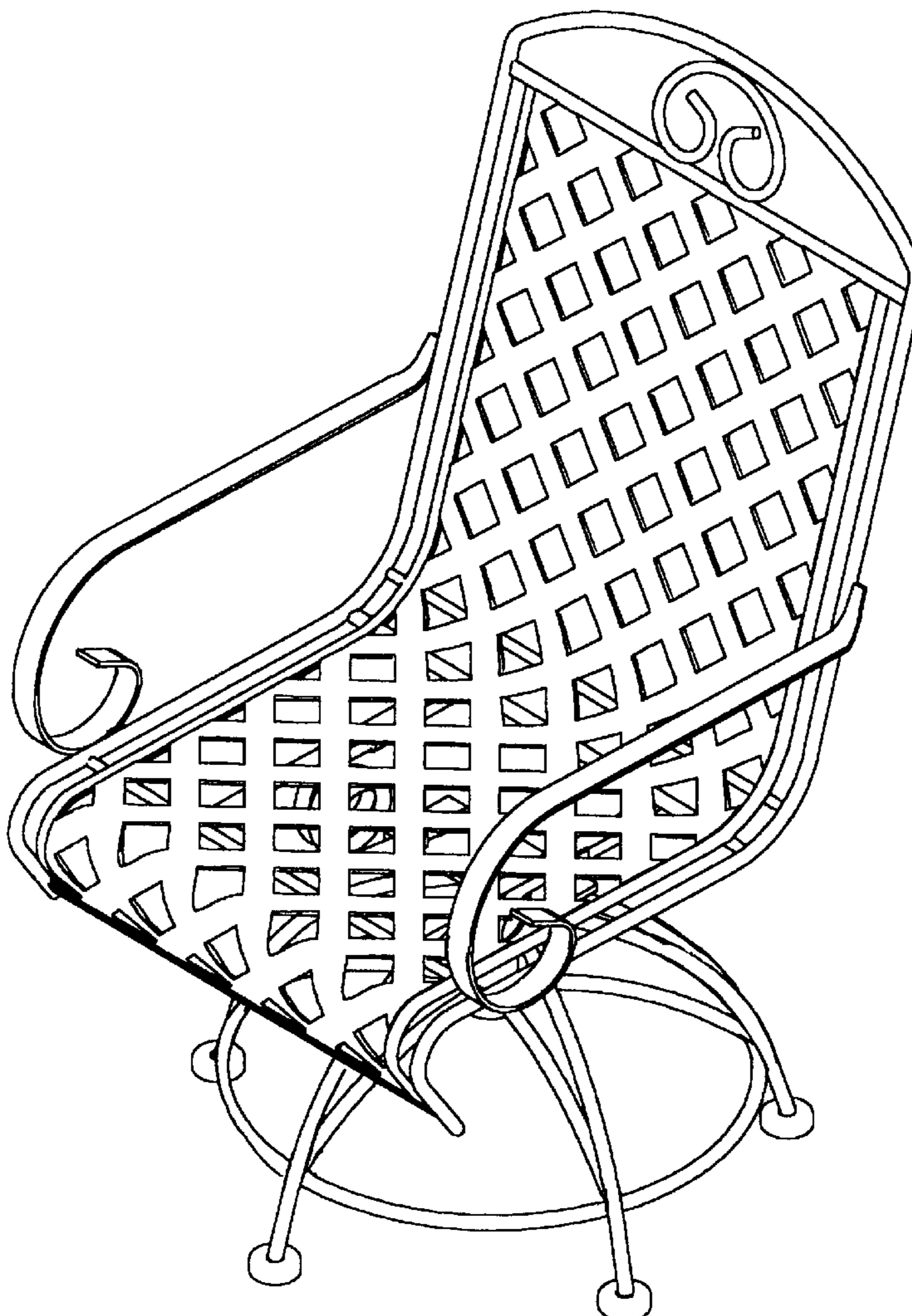
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof; and,

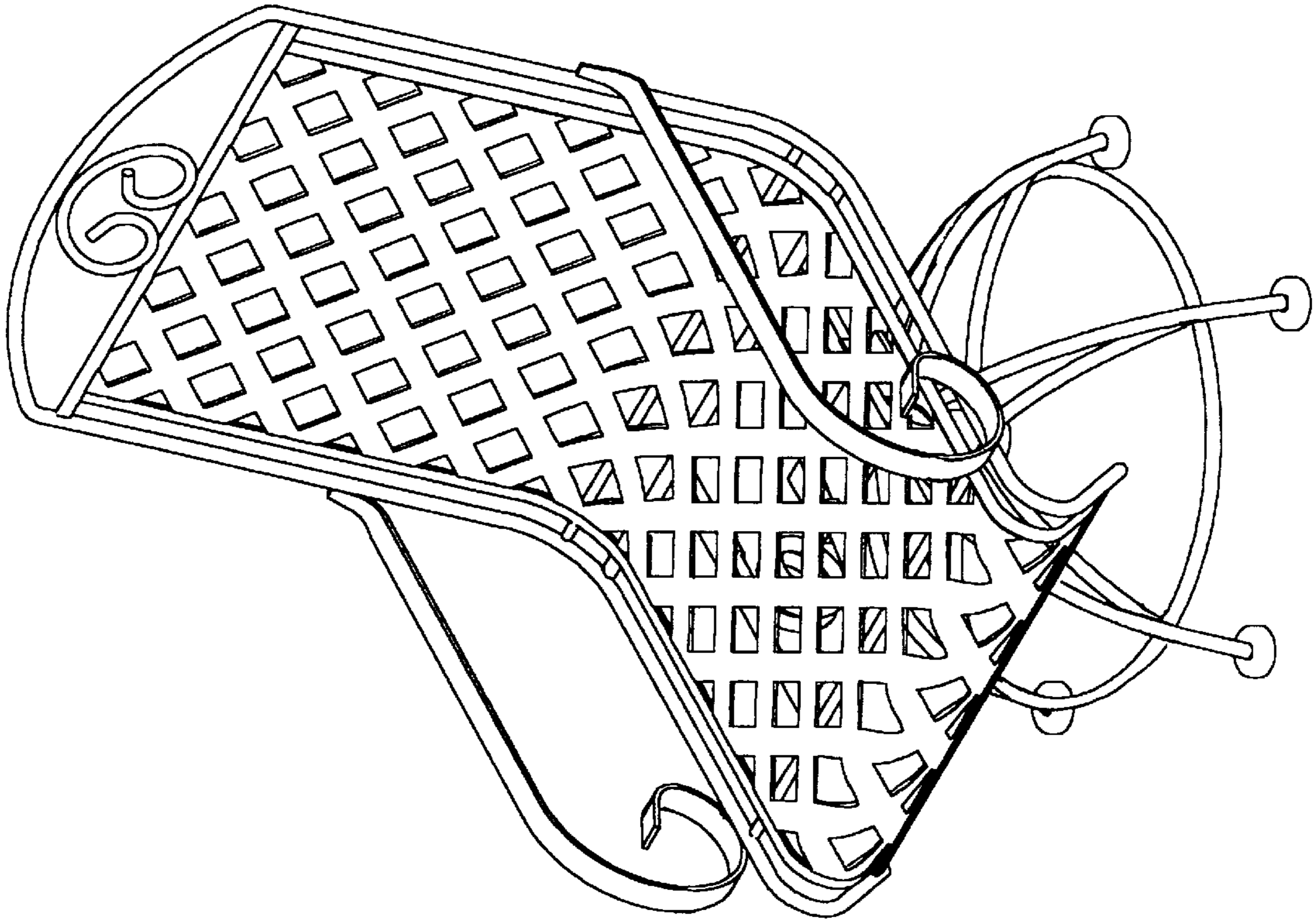

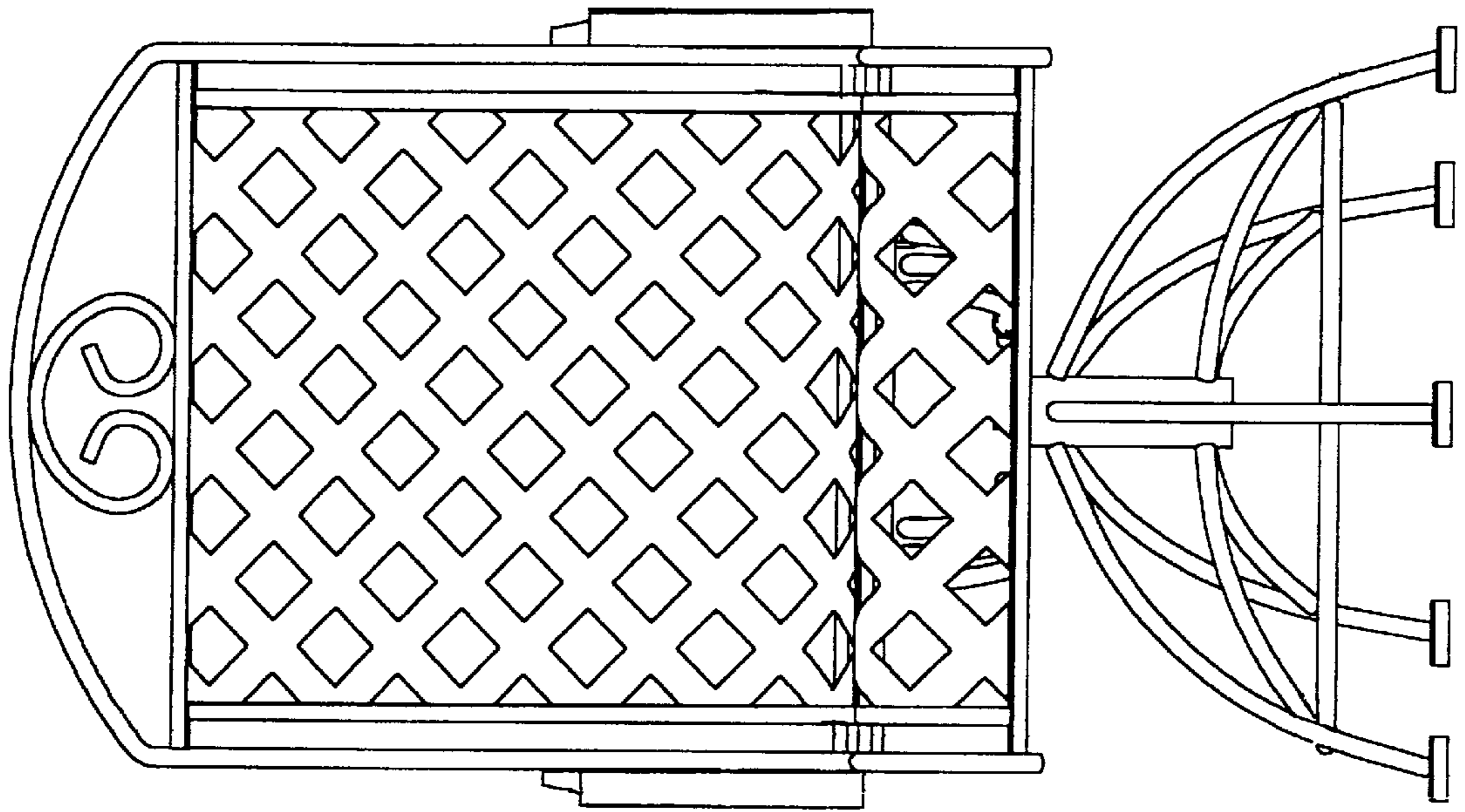

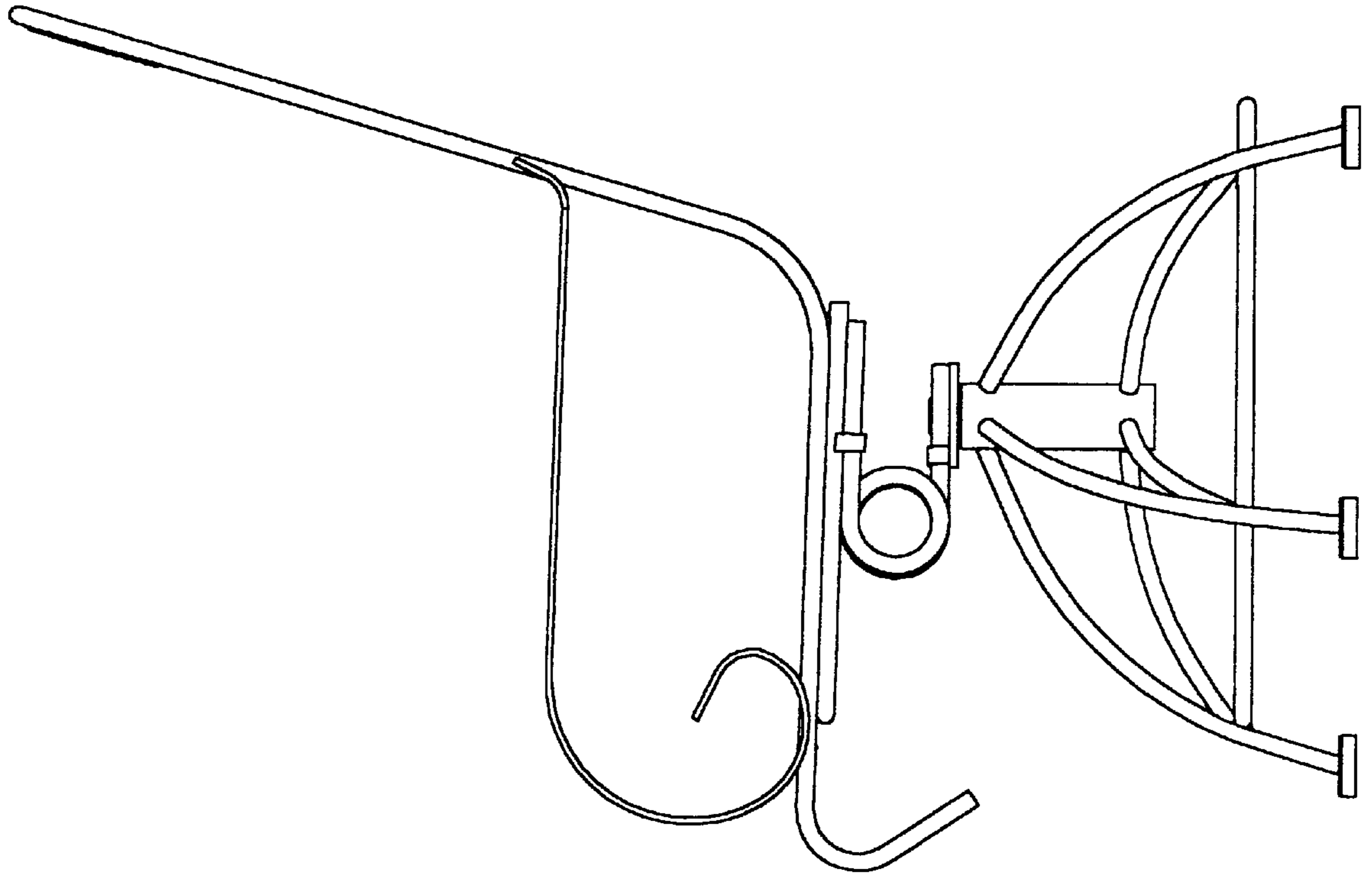

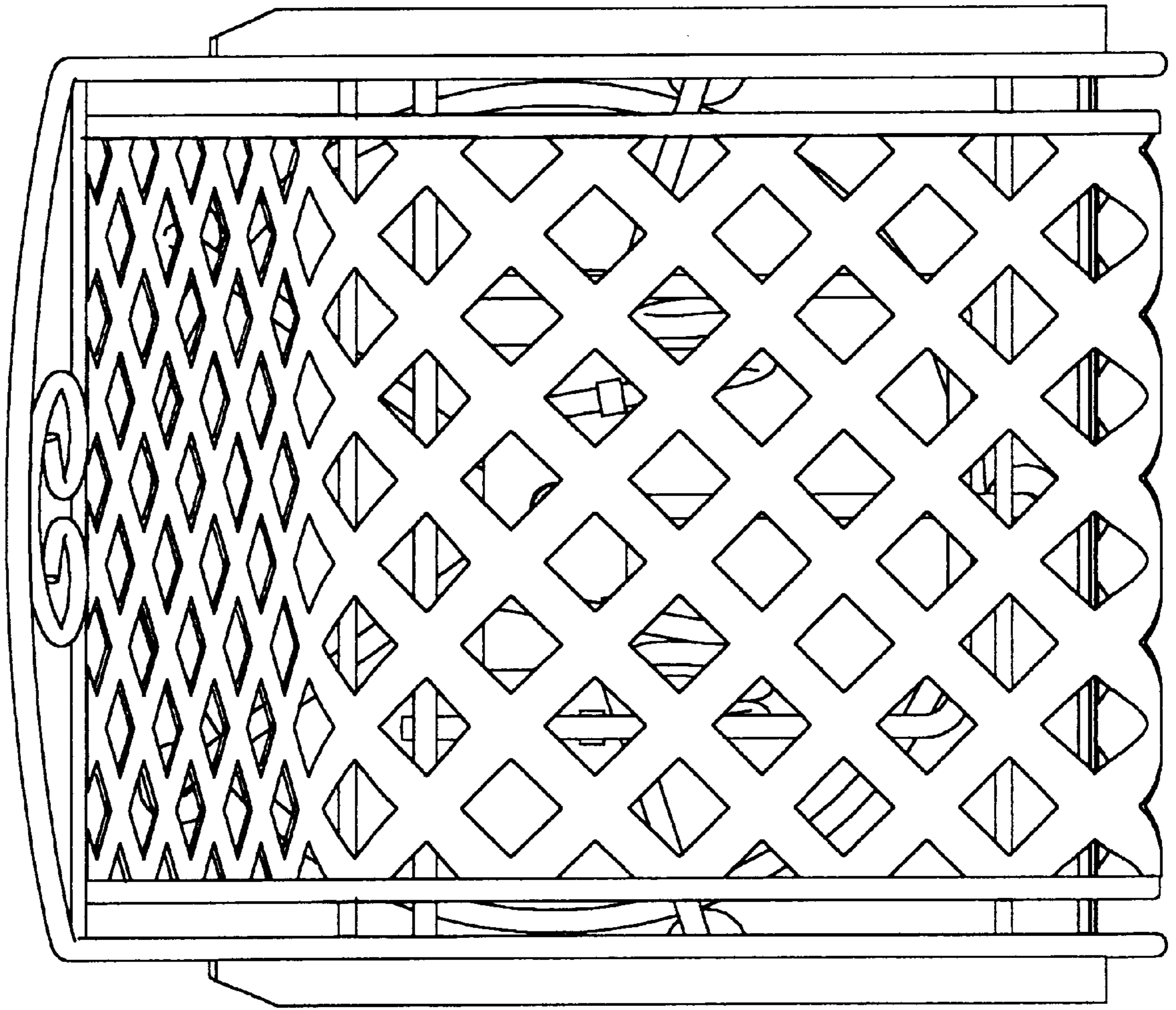
