DESCRIPTION

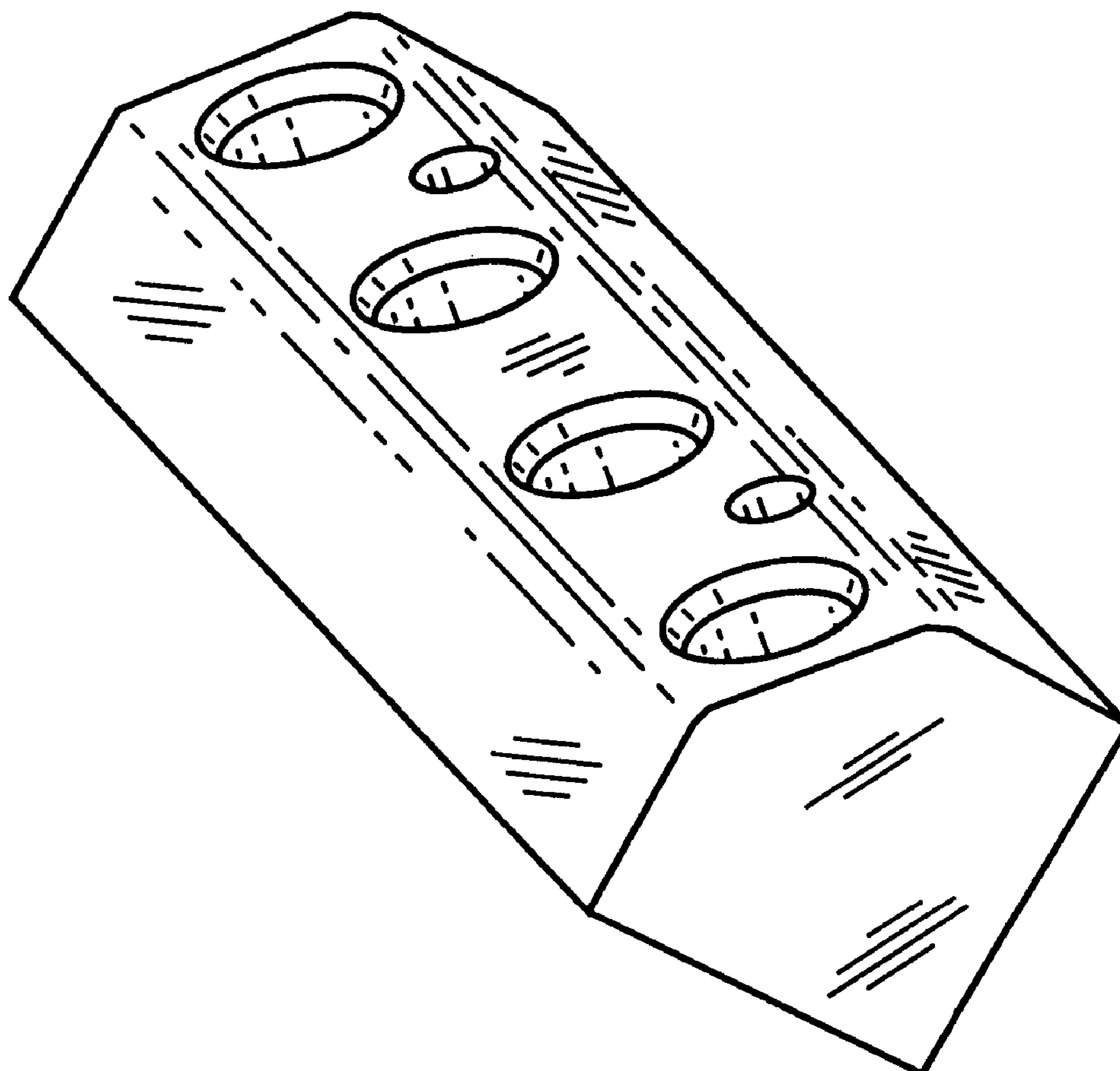

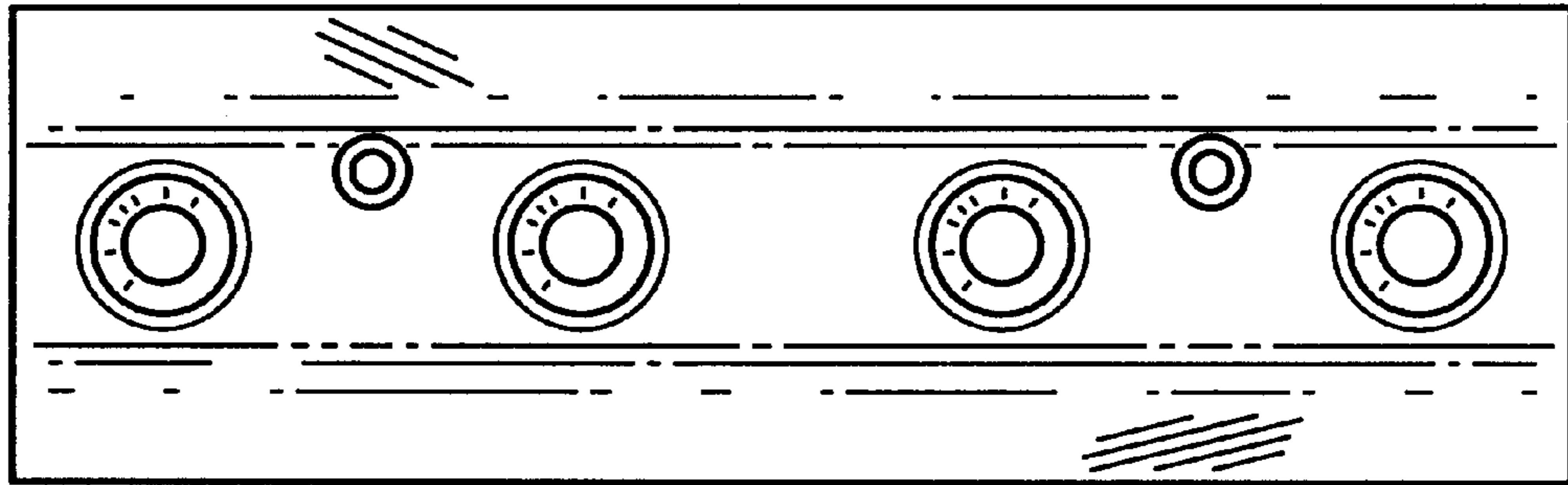

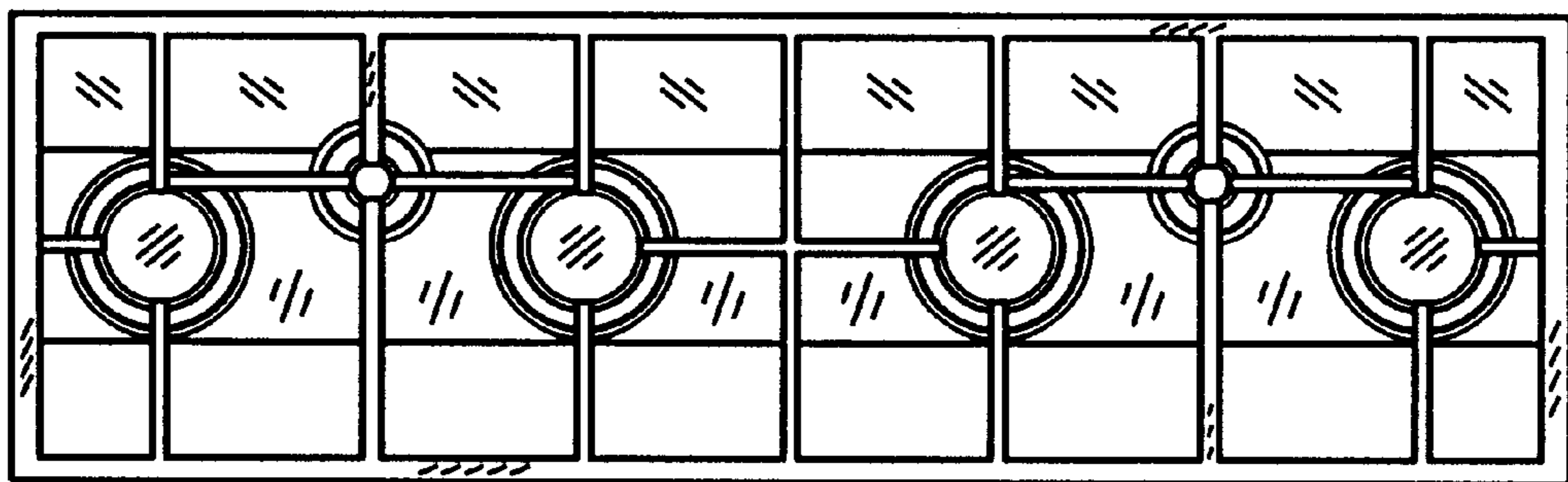

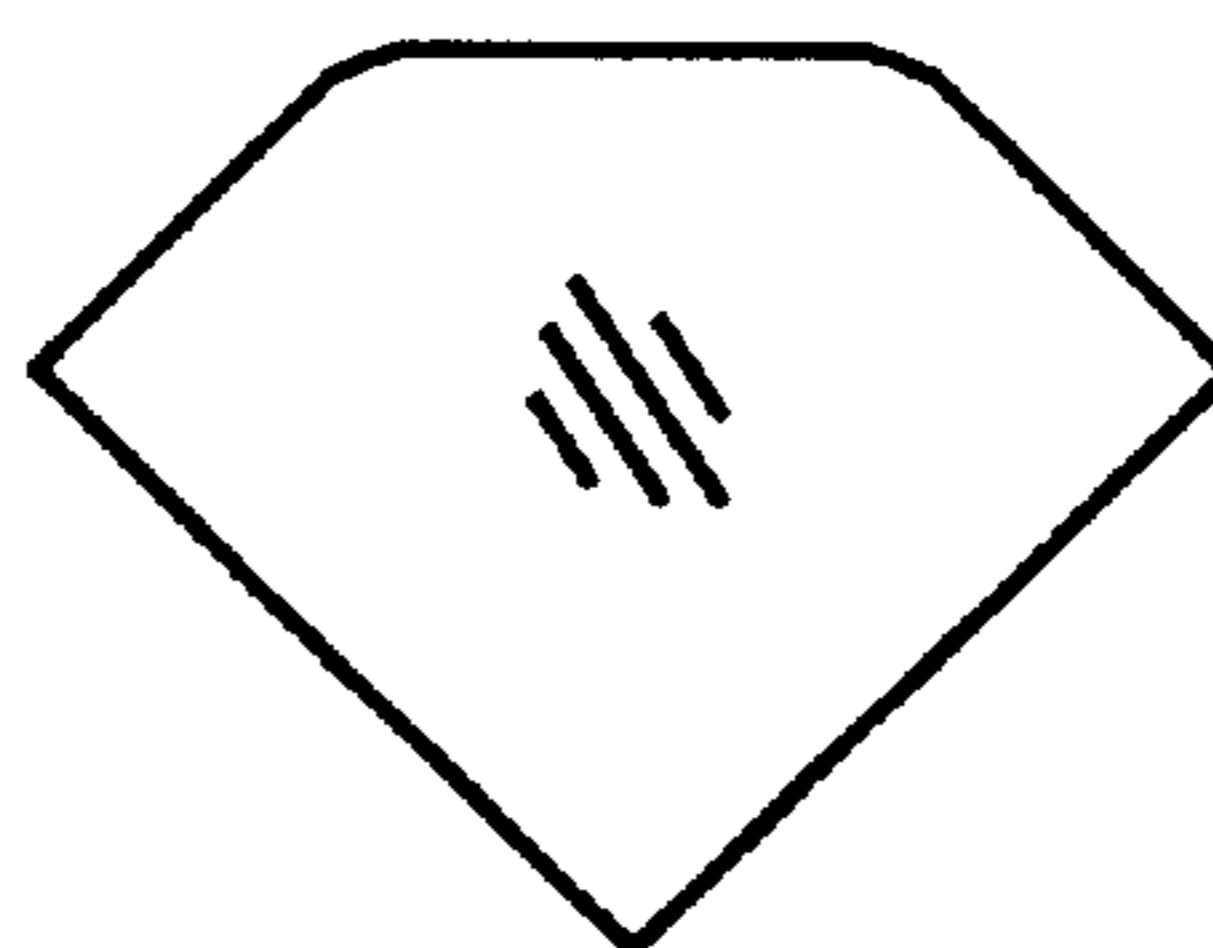

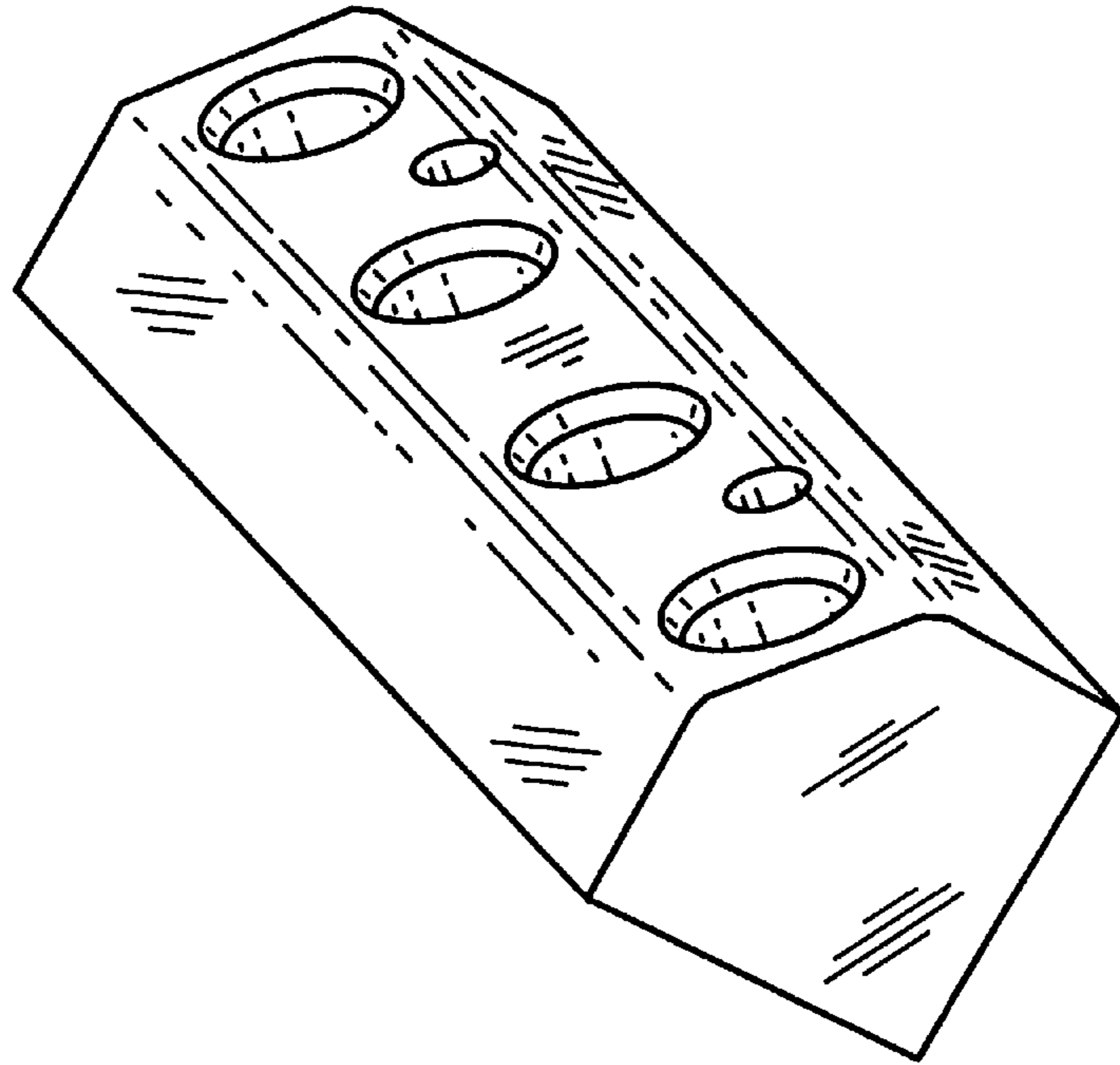

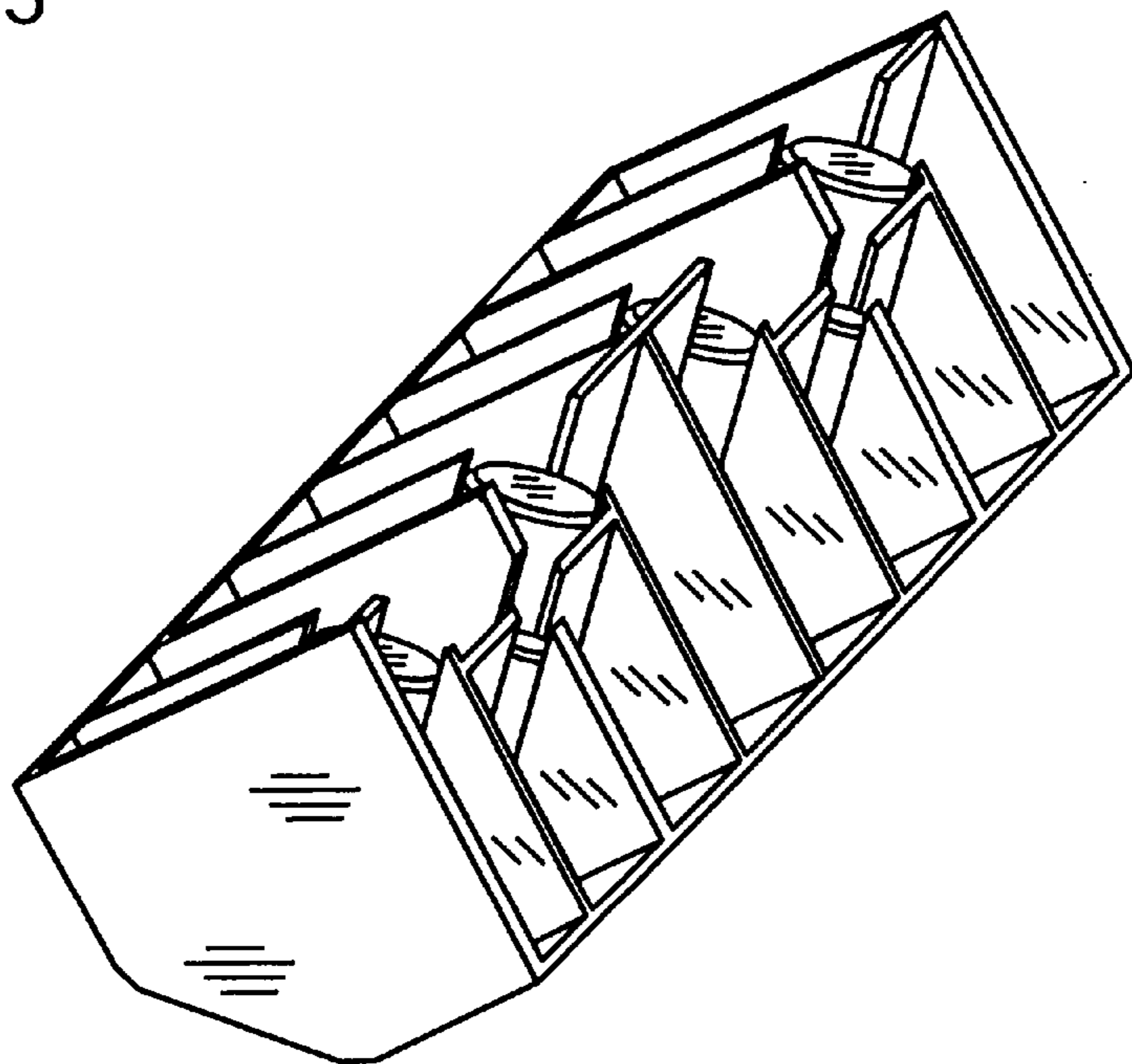
