[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a sole for a golf shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the sole for a golf shoe showing my new design, the broken lines showing the shoe upper in FIGS. 1 and 2 being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 2, the broken lines of the shoe upper being removed for ease of illustration, and the broken lines showing a midsole being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of FIG. 3;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of FIG. 8;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of FIG. 1; the broken lines of the shoe upper being removed for ease of illustration, and the broken lines showing a pattern on the upper surface of the shoe sole being for illustrative purposes only forming no part of the claimed design;

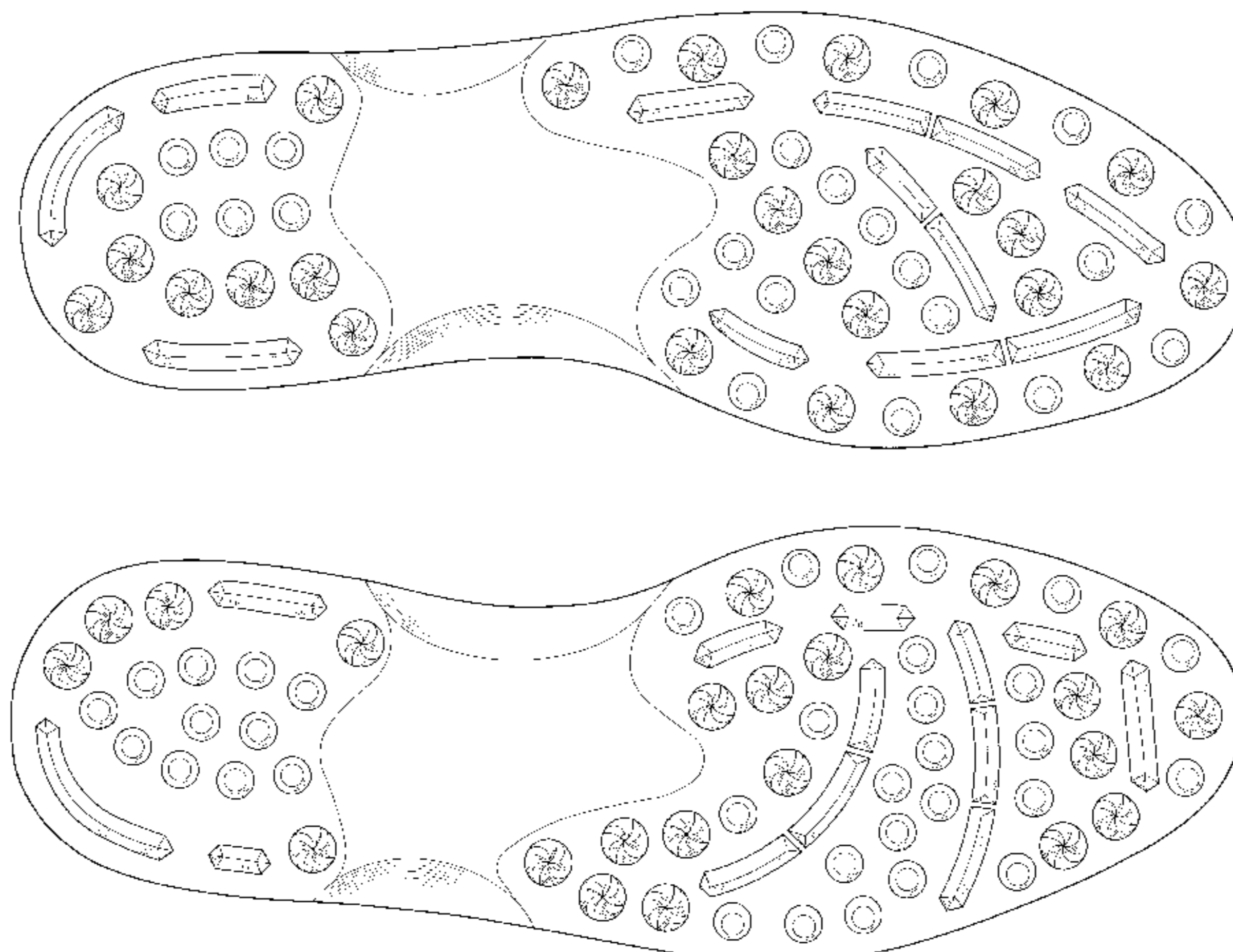

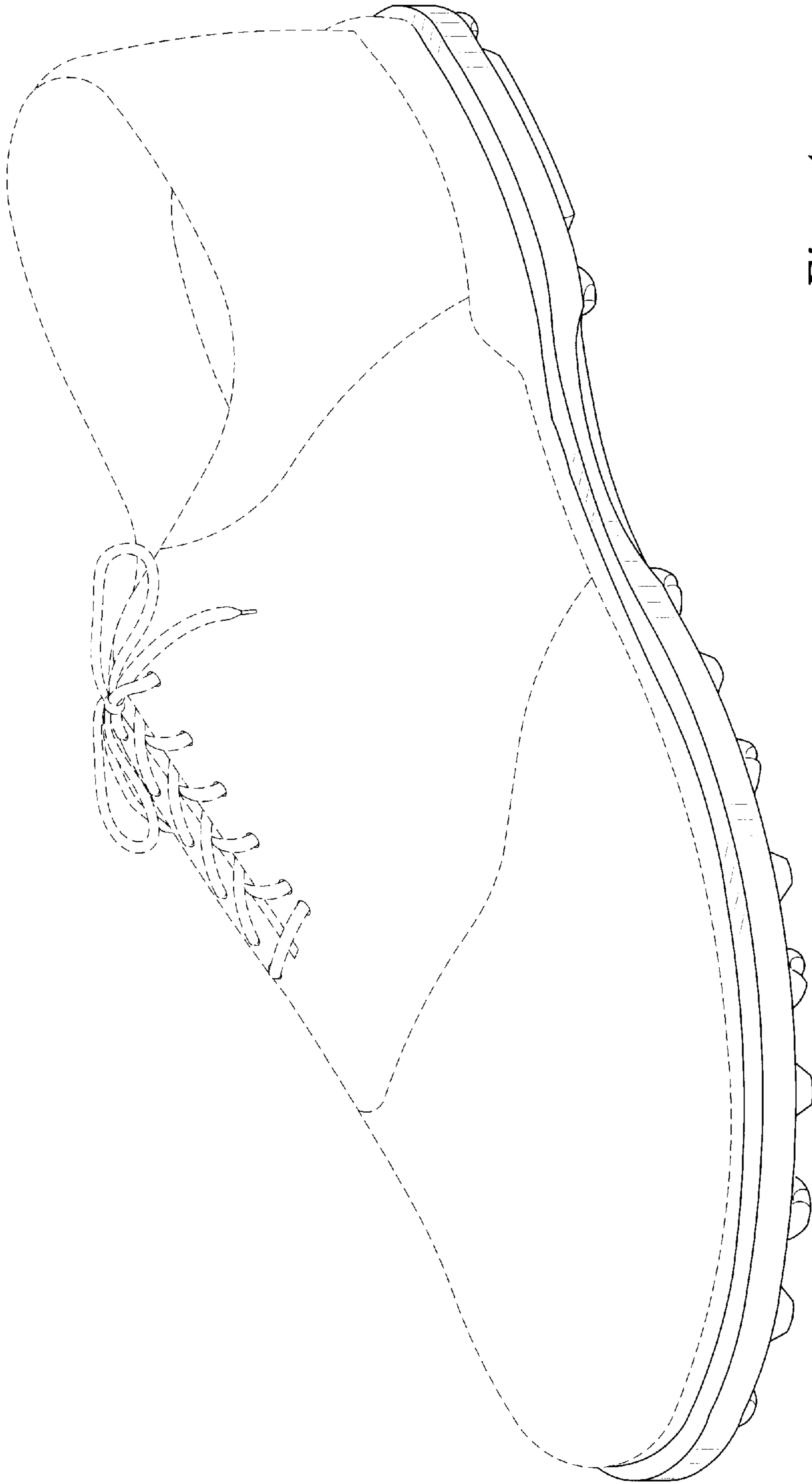

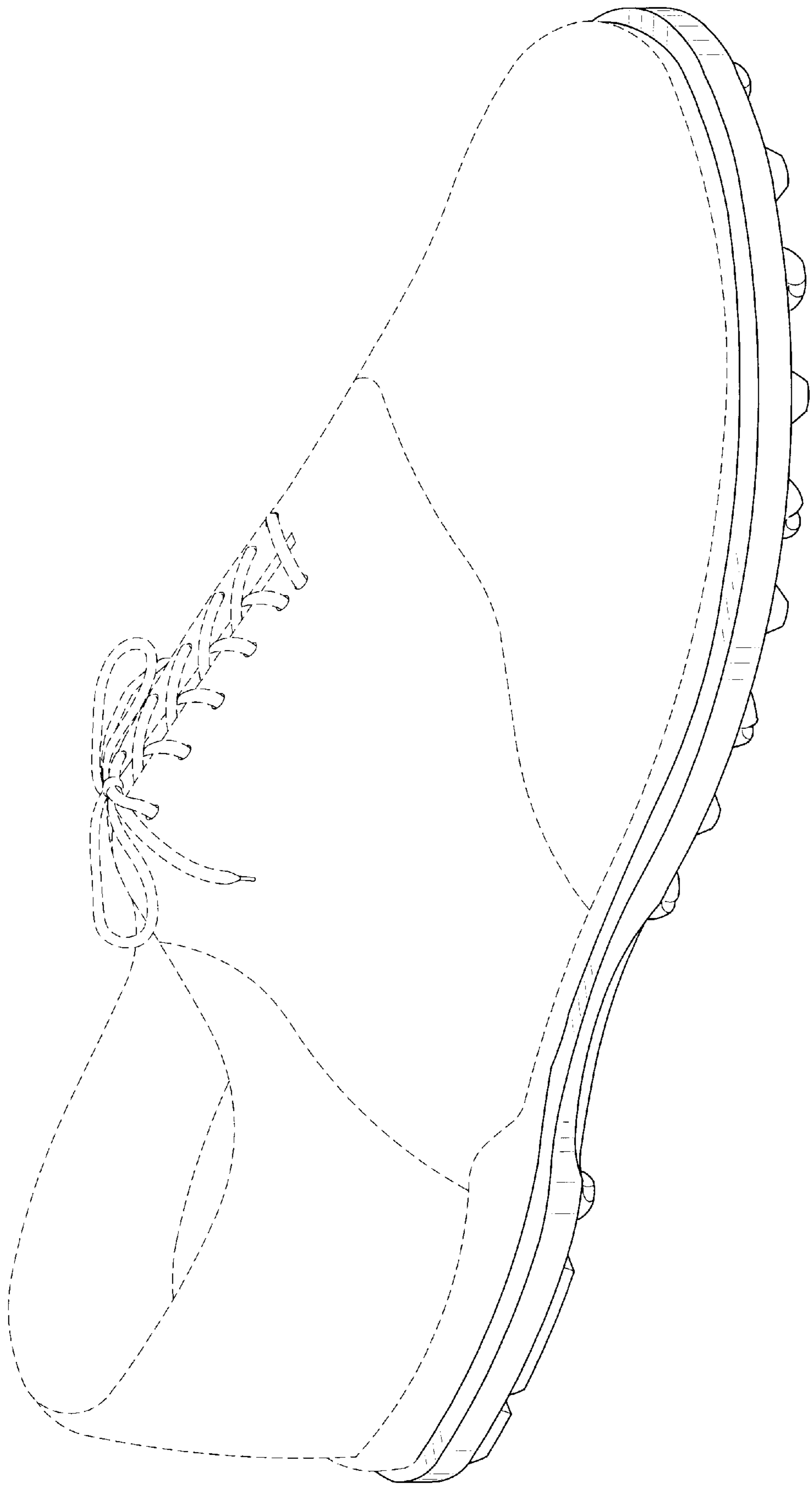

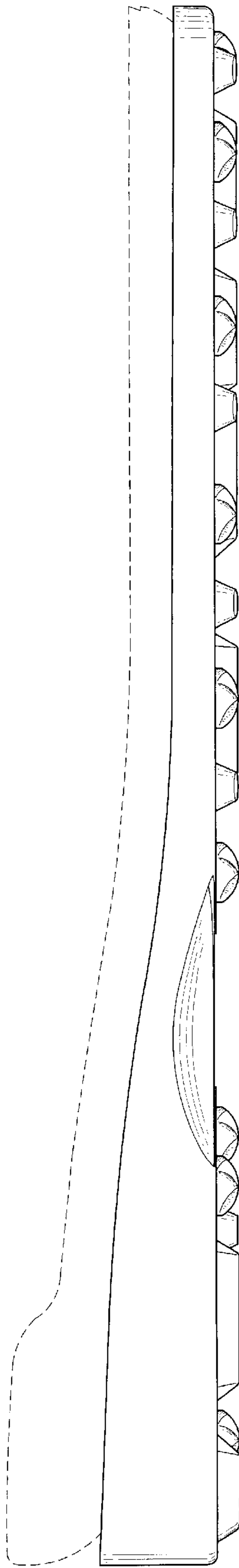

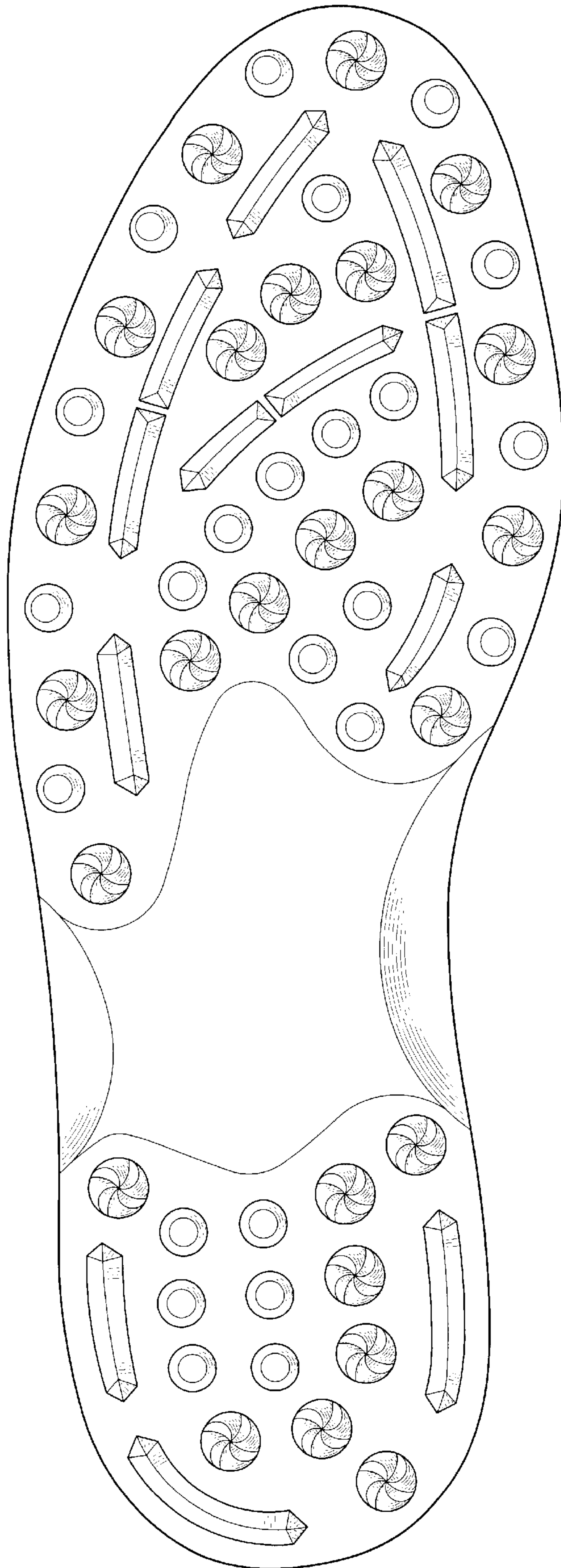

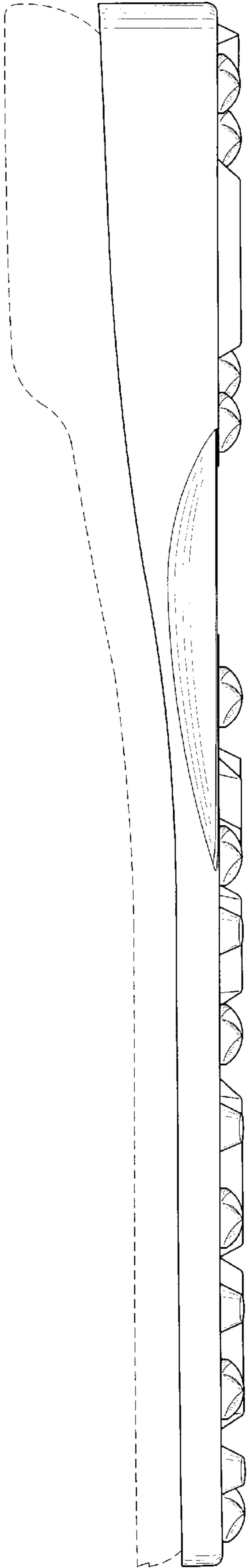

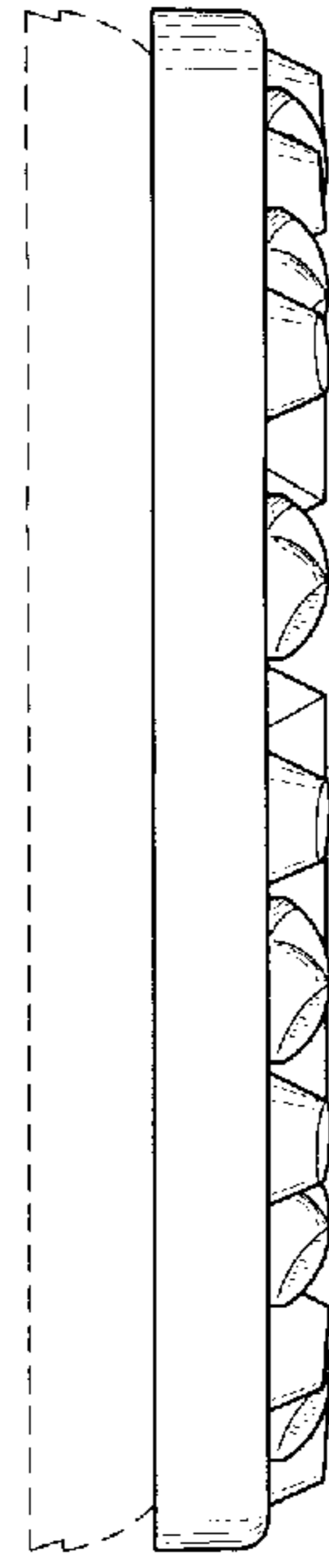

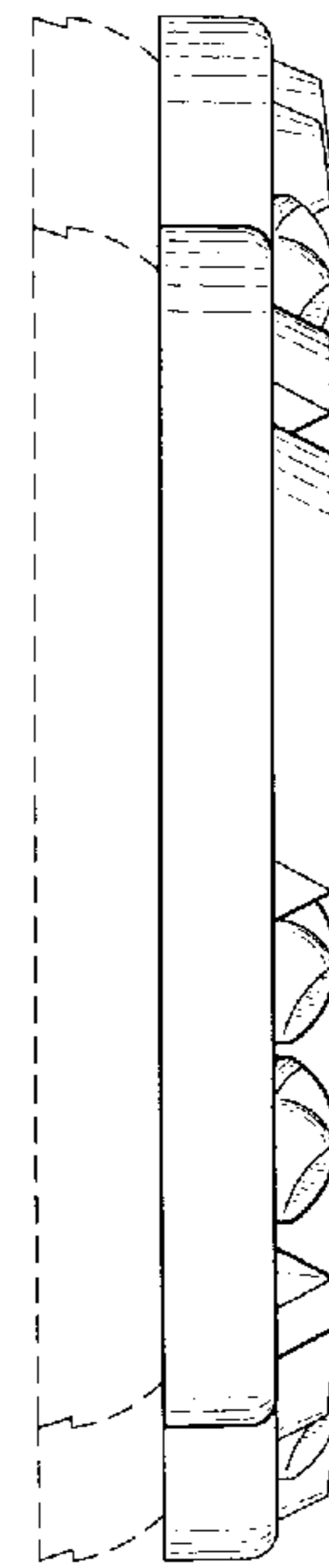

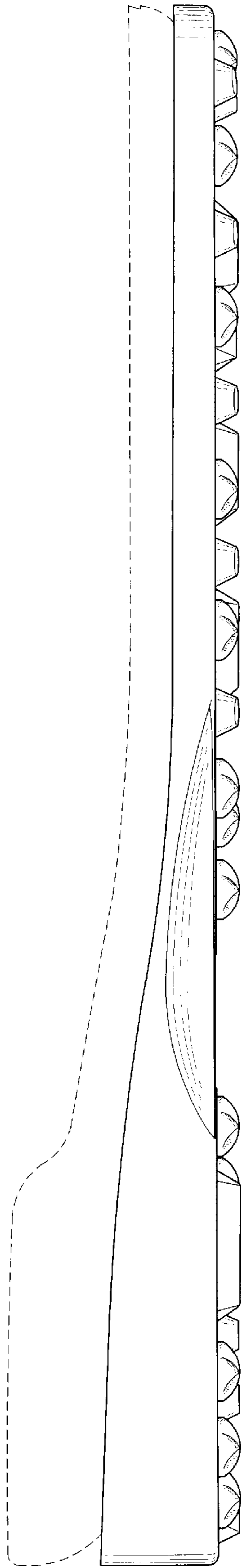

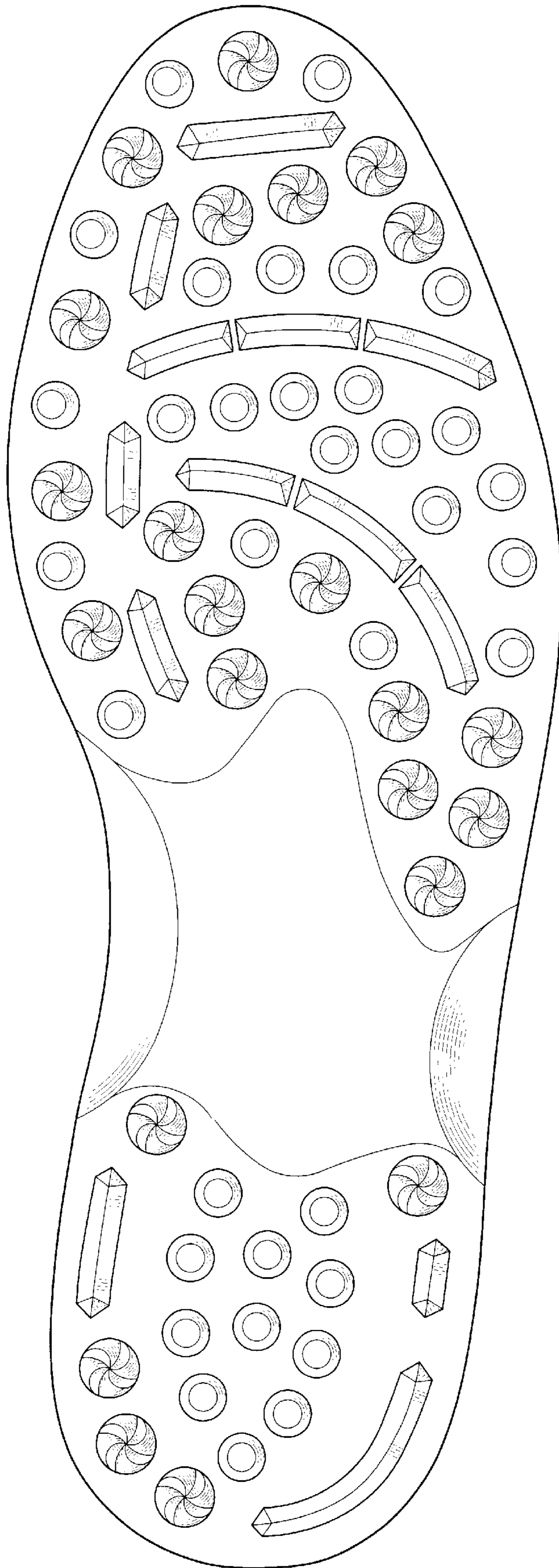

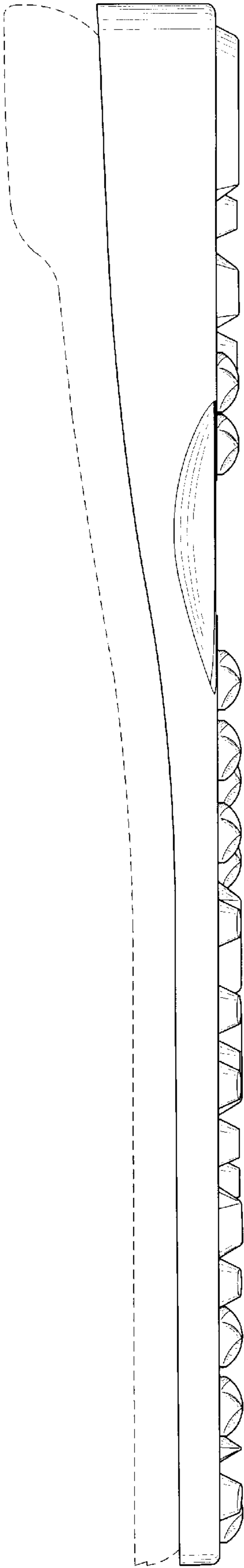

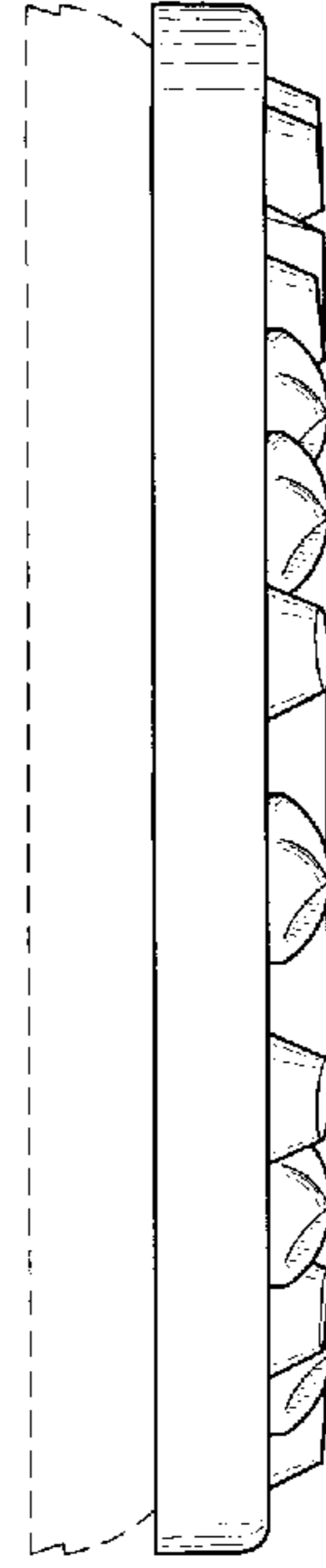

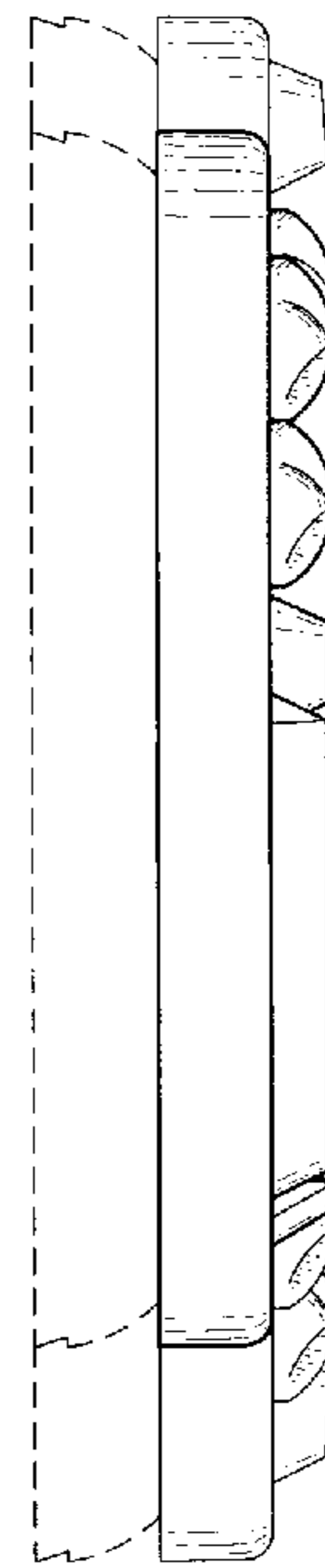

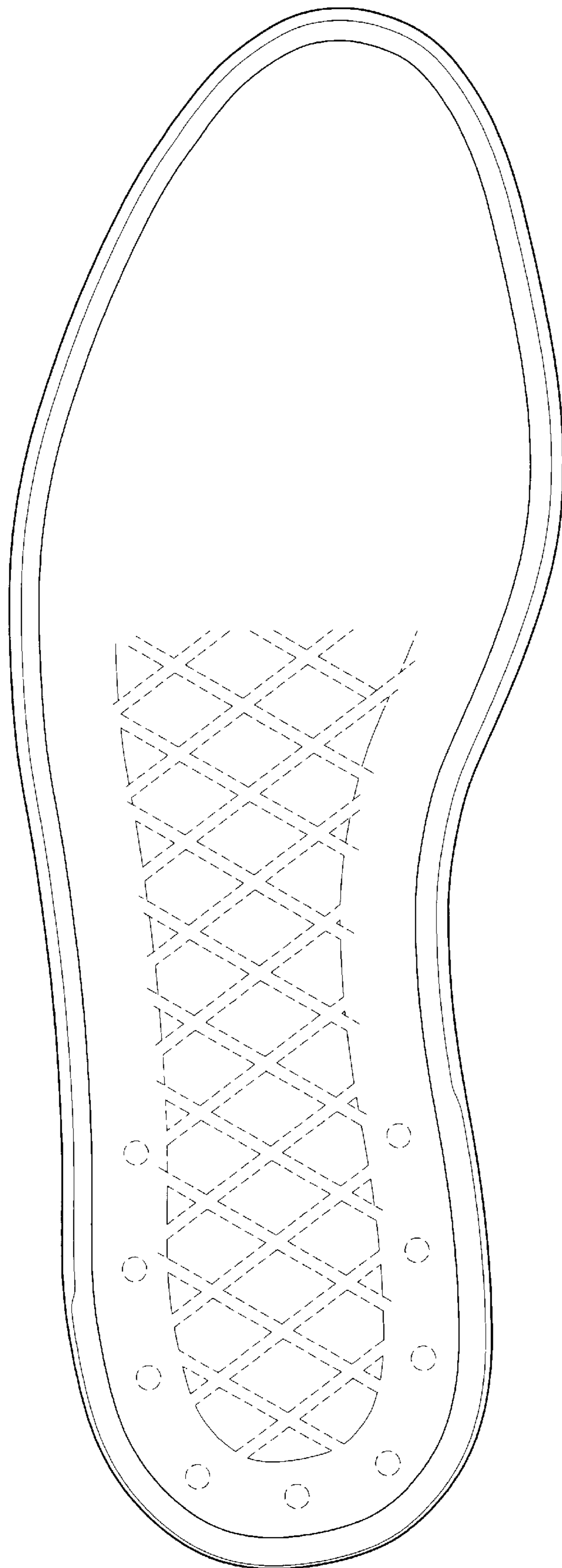

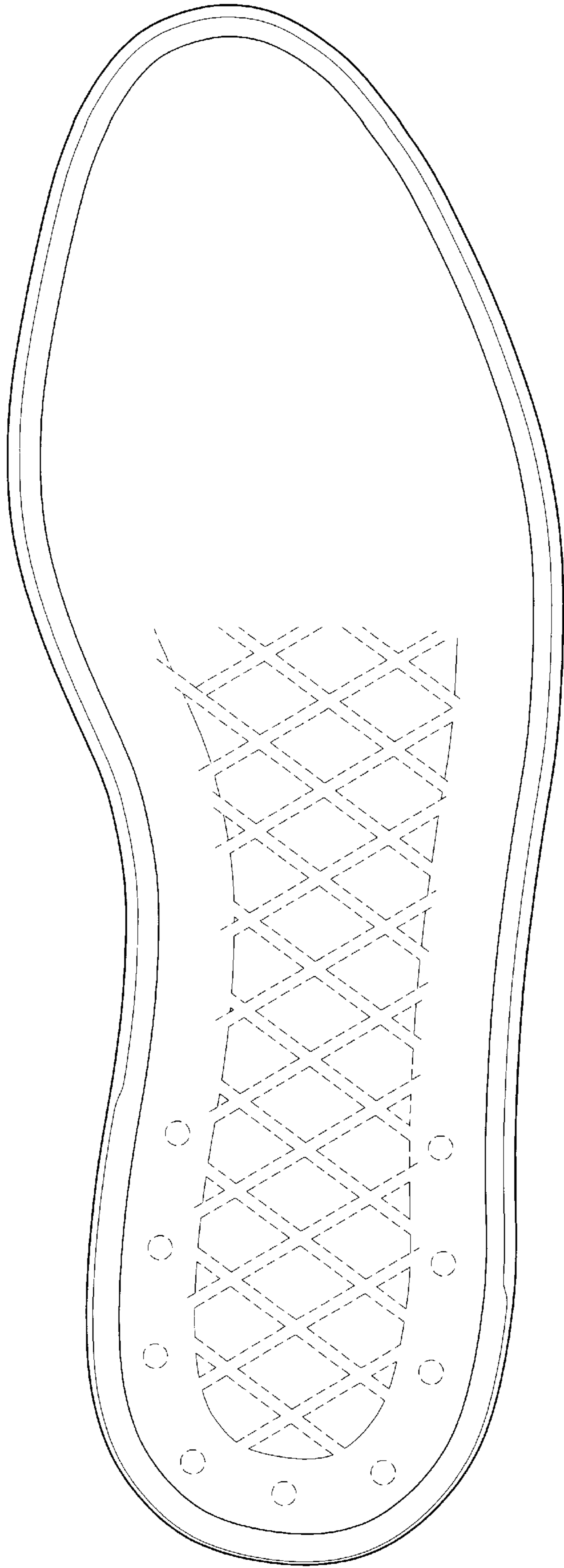

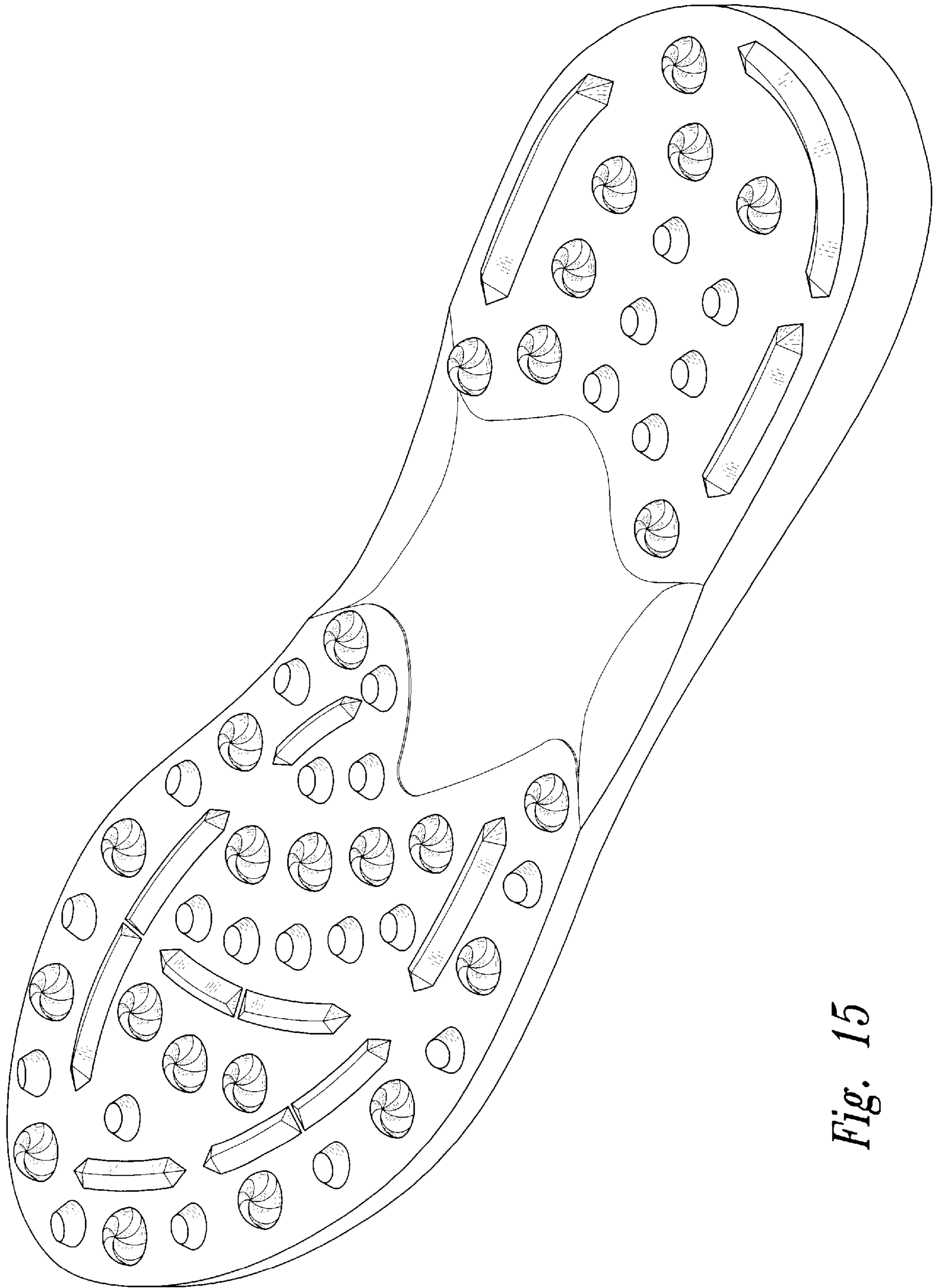

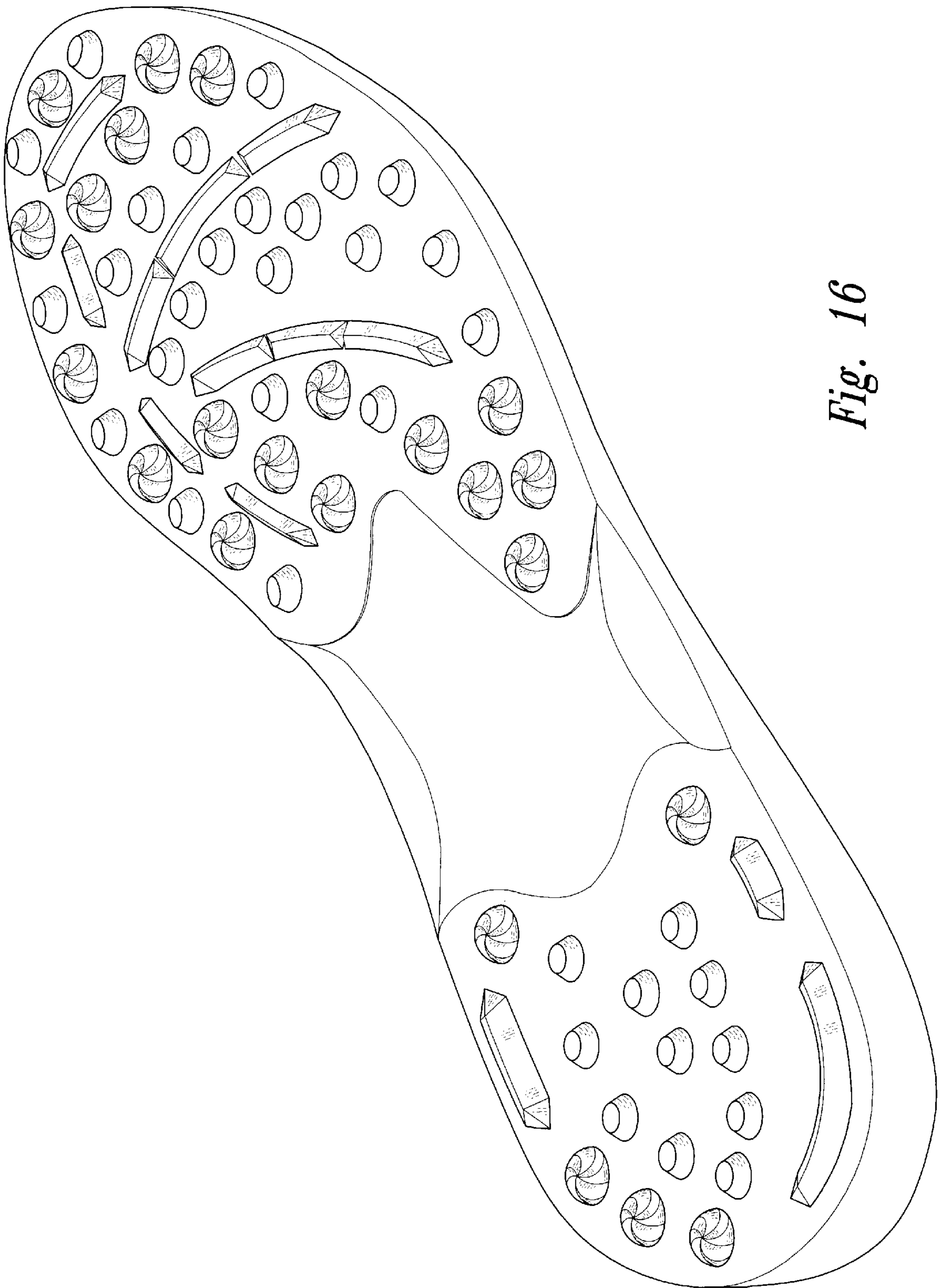
