[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a reflective portrait mirror, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an enlarged fragmentary view of a reflective portrait mirror, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 2-2 in FIG. 1; and, FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof. The broken lines are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

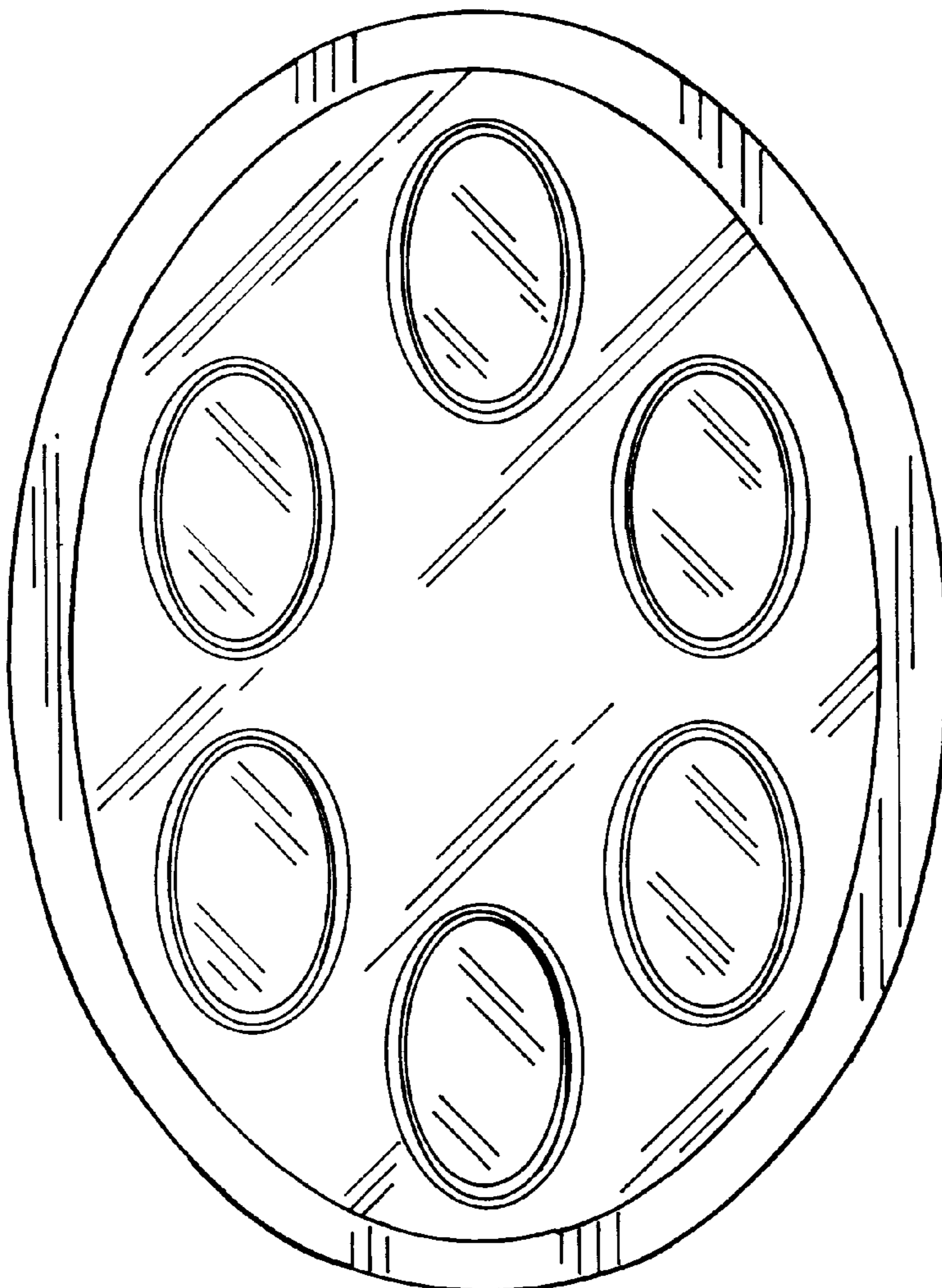

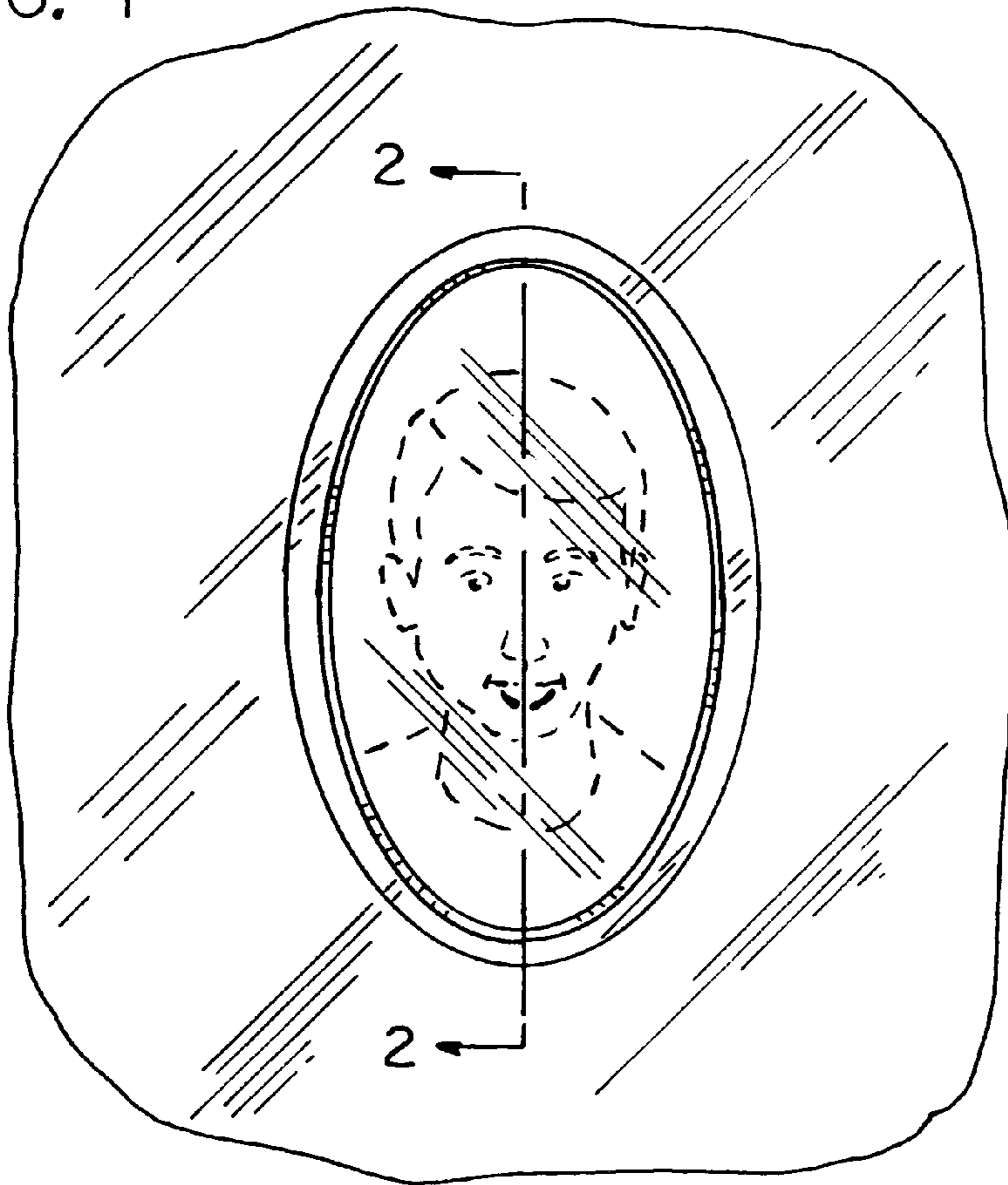

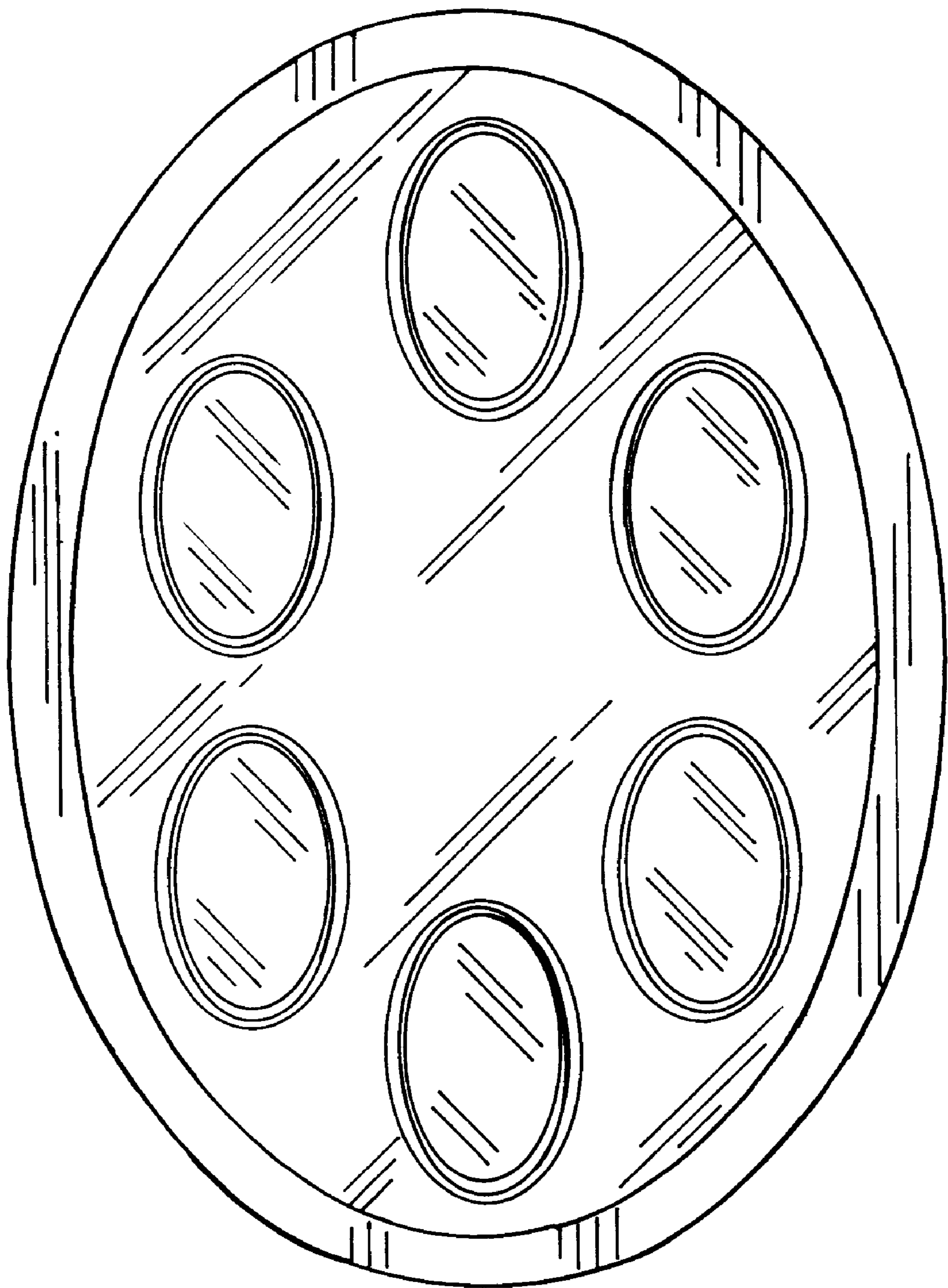
