[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wrist watch, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the wrist watch in accordance with the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the wrist watch;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the wrist watch;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view of the wrist watch taken along line 4—4 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the wrist watch;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the wrist watch;

FIG. 7 is a left side view of the wrist watch; and,

FIG. 8 is a right side view of the wrist watch.
















