DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a backpack showing our new design;

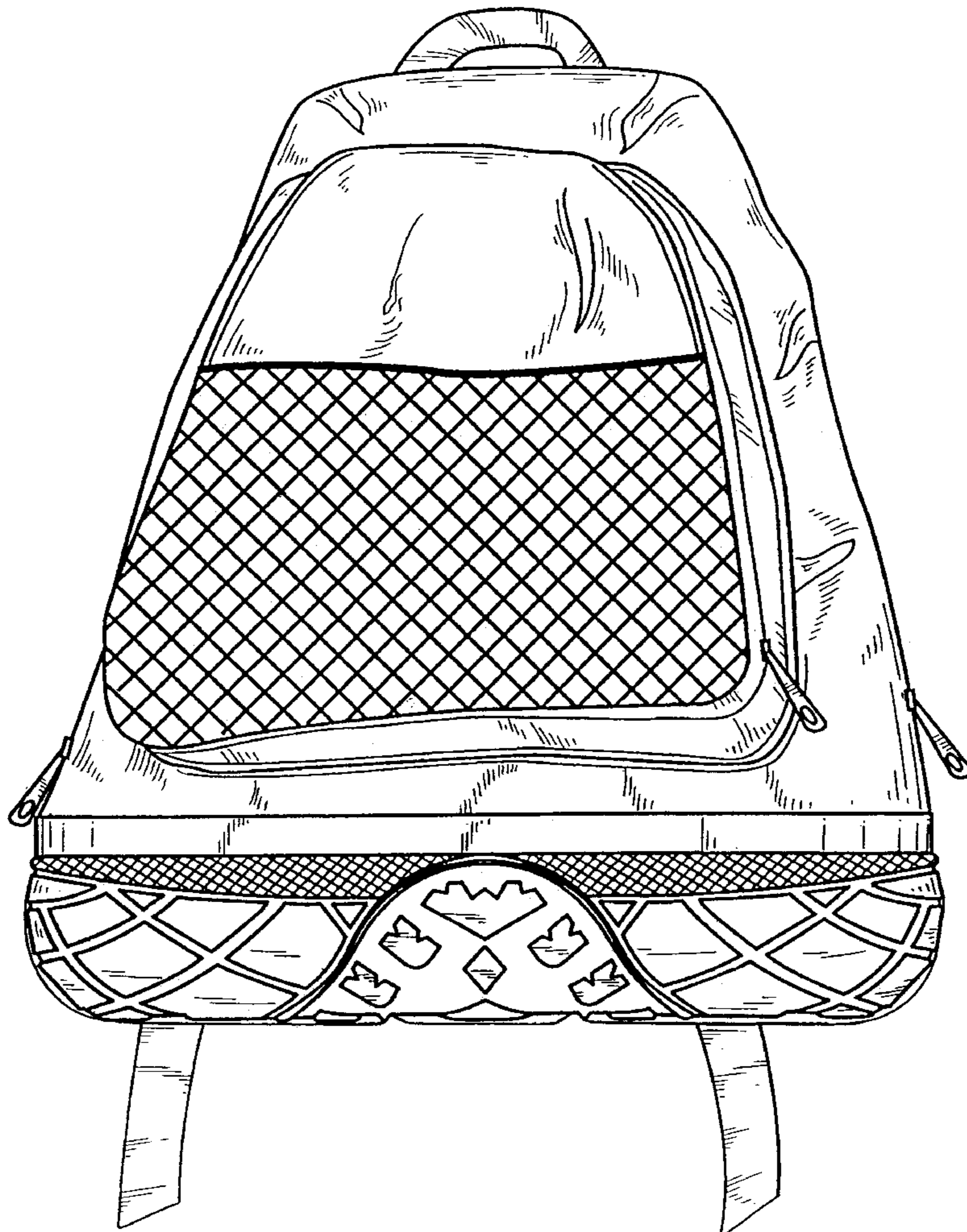

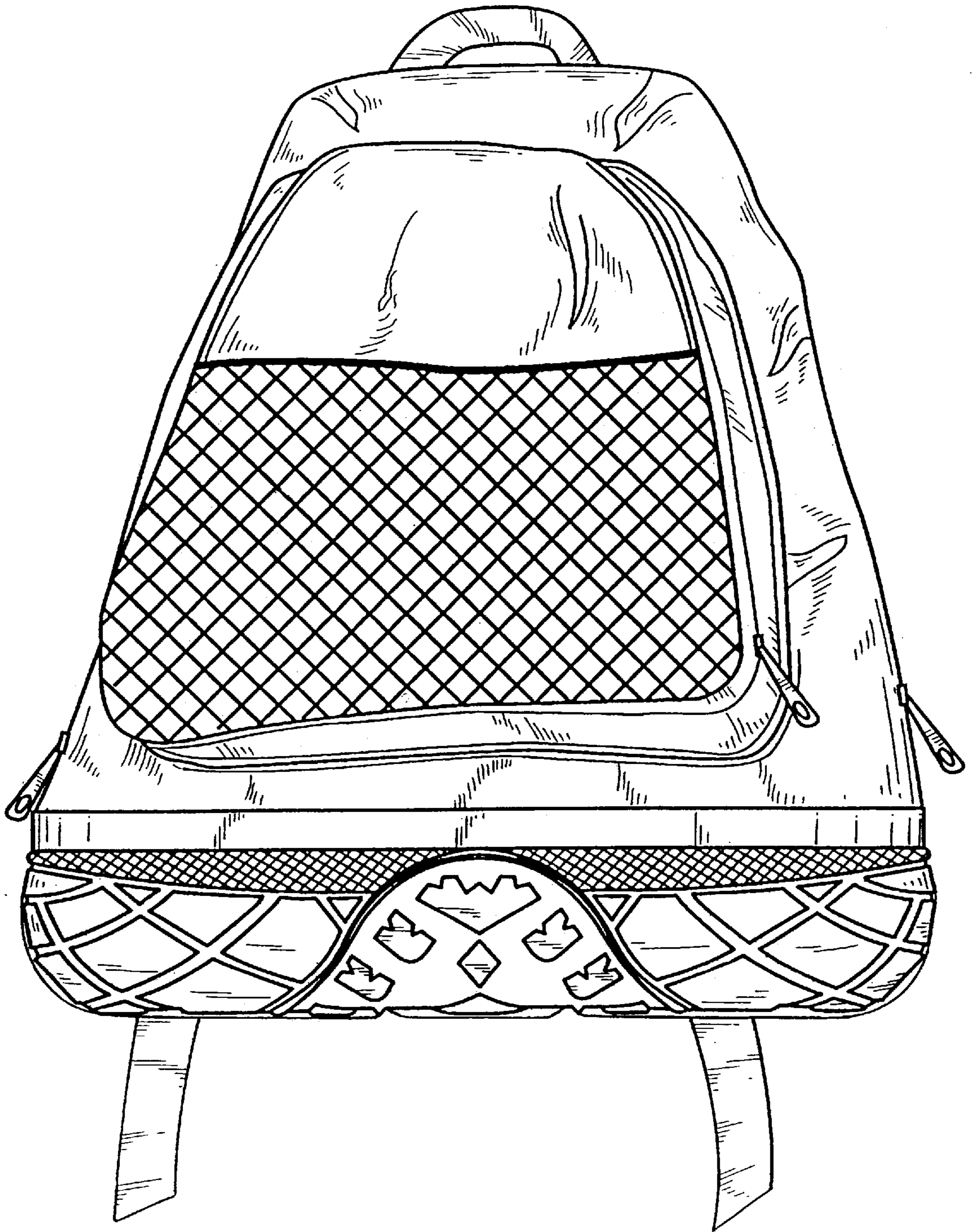
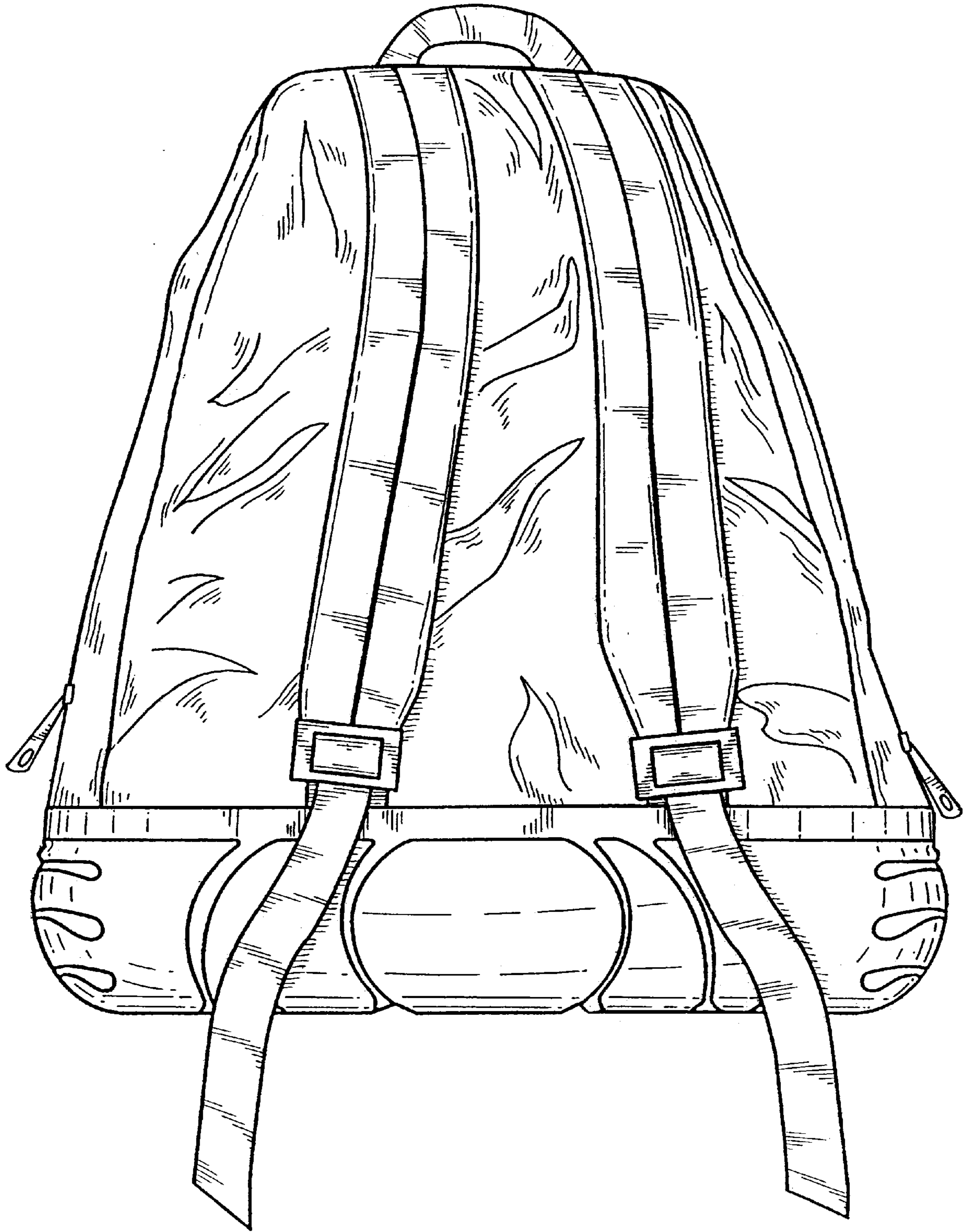

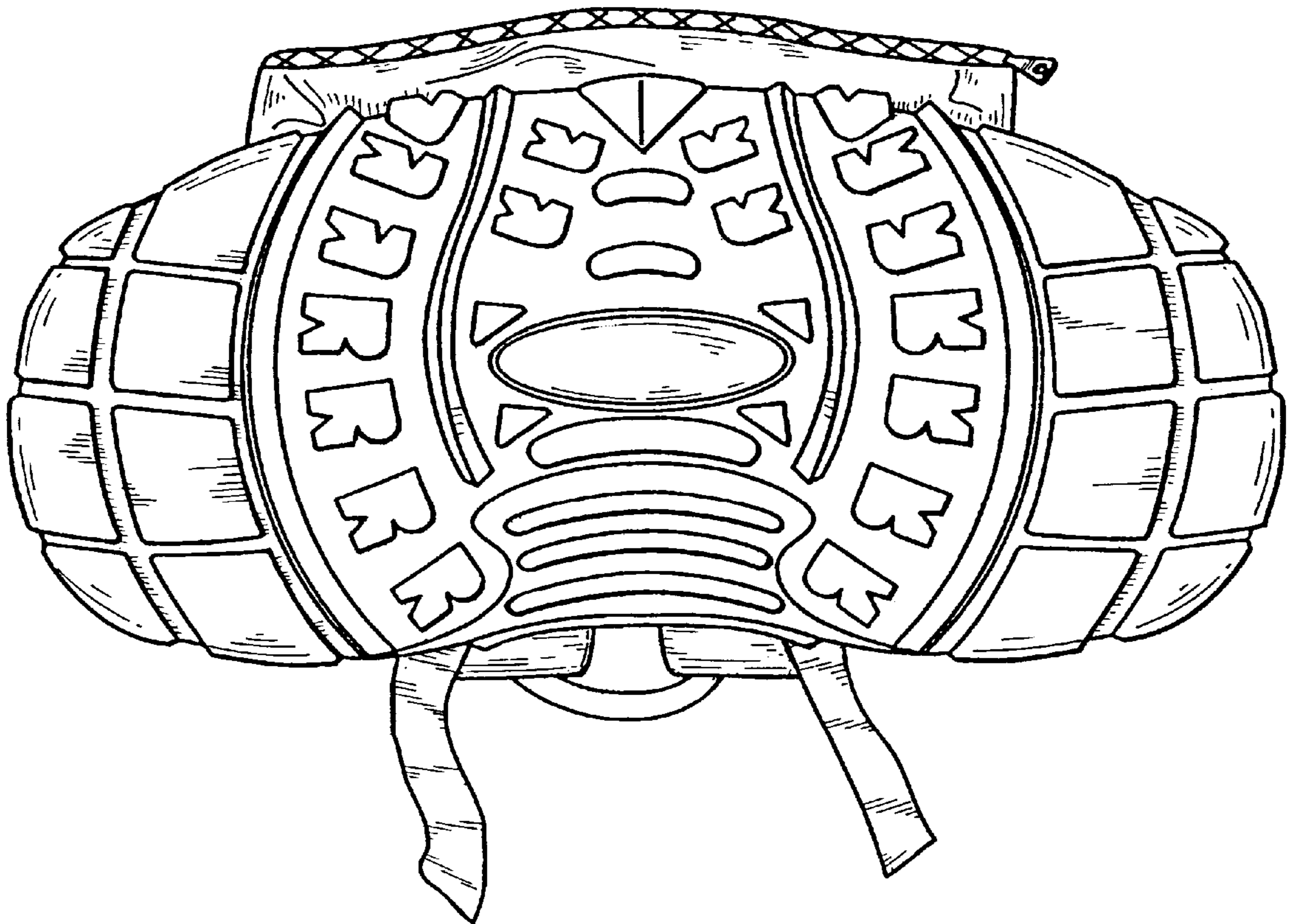
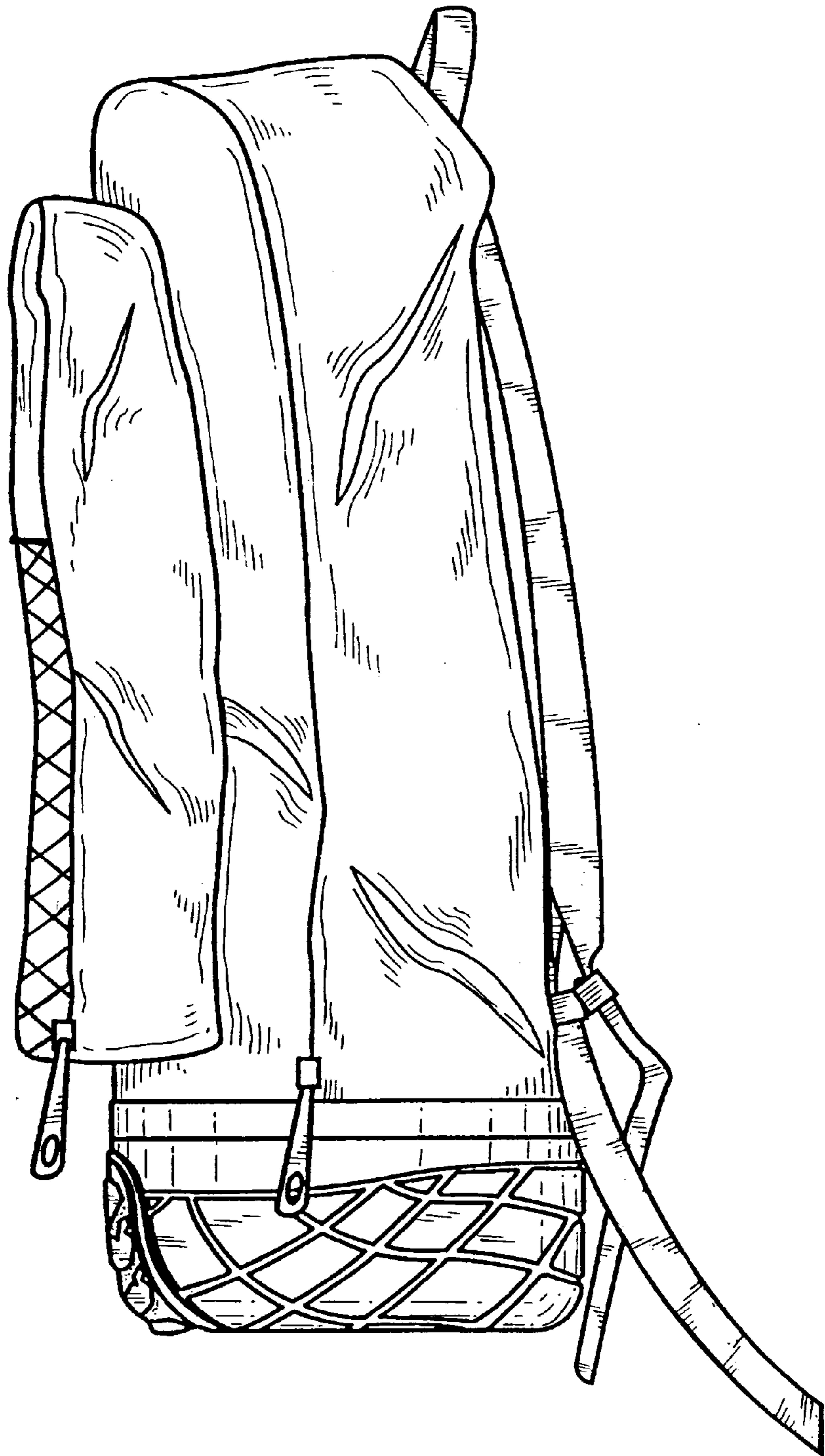

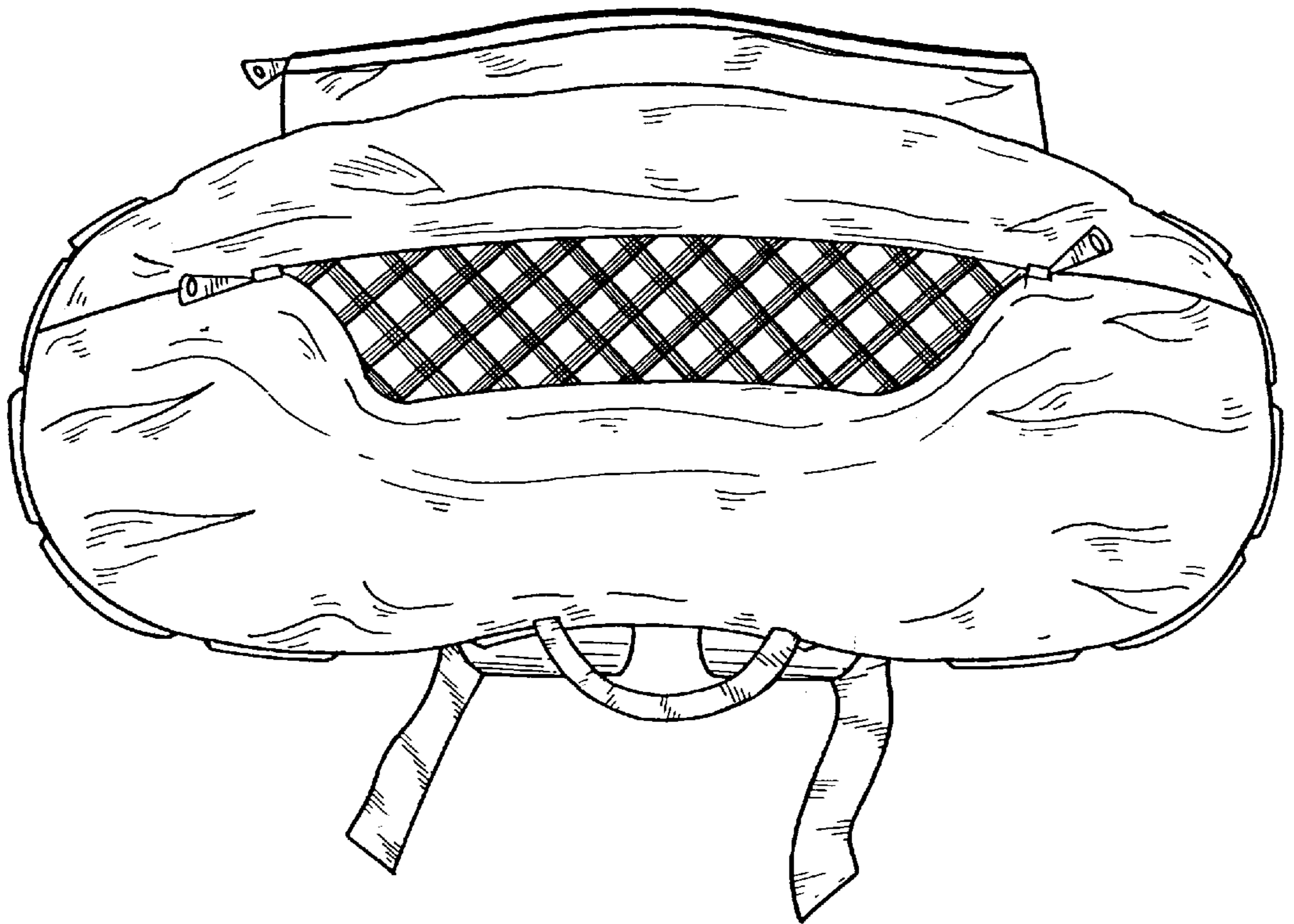
