DESCRIPTION

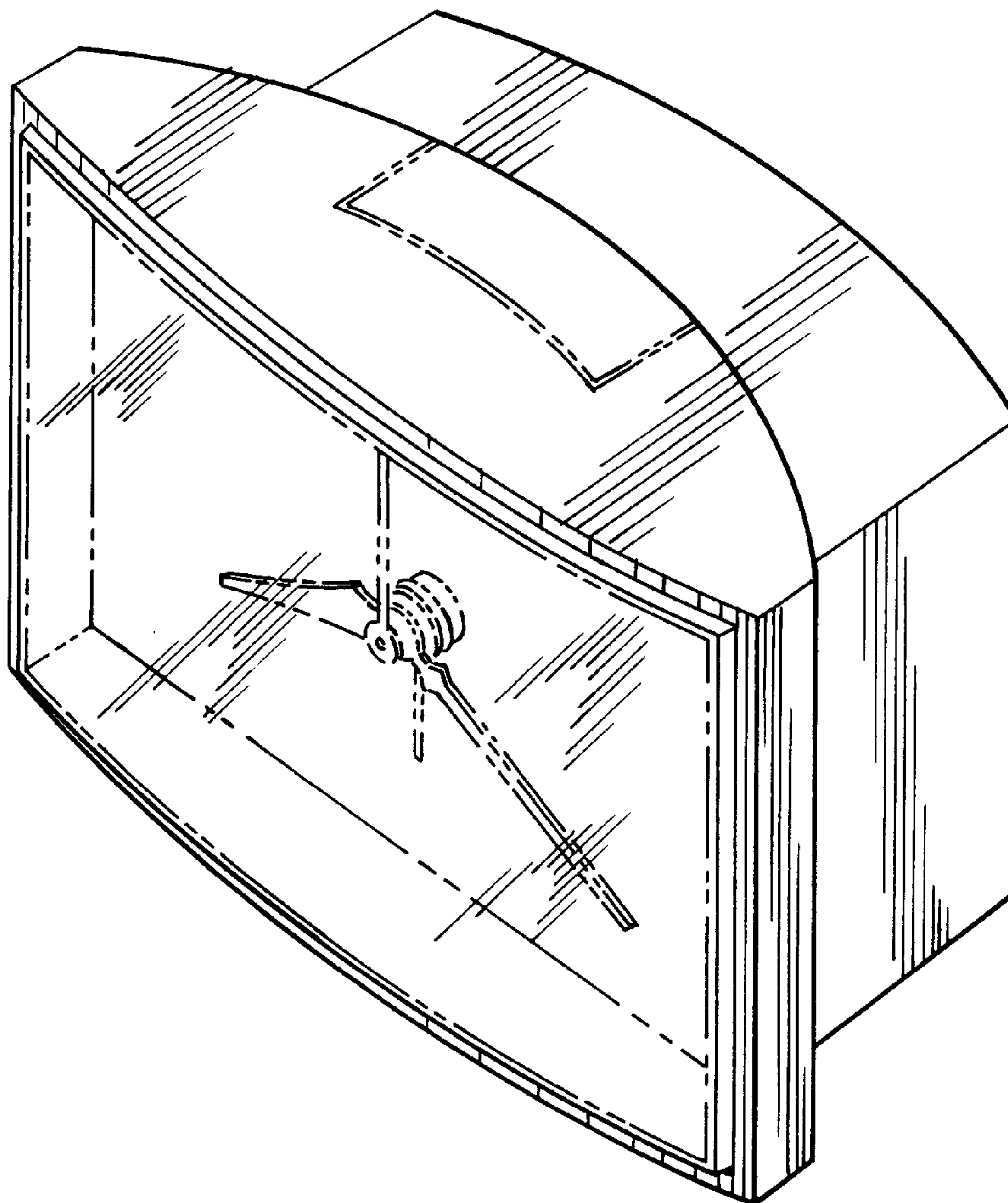

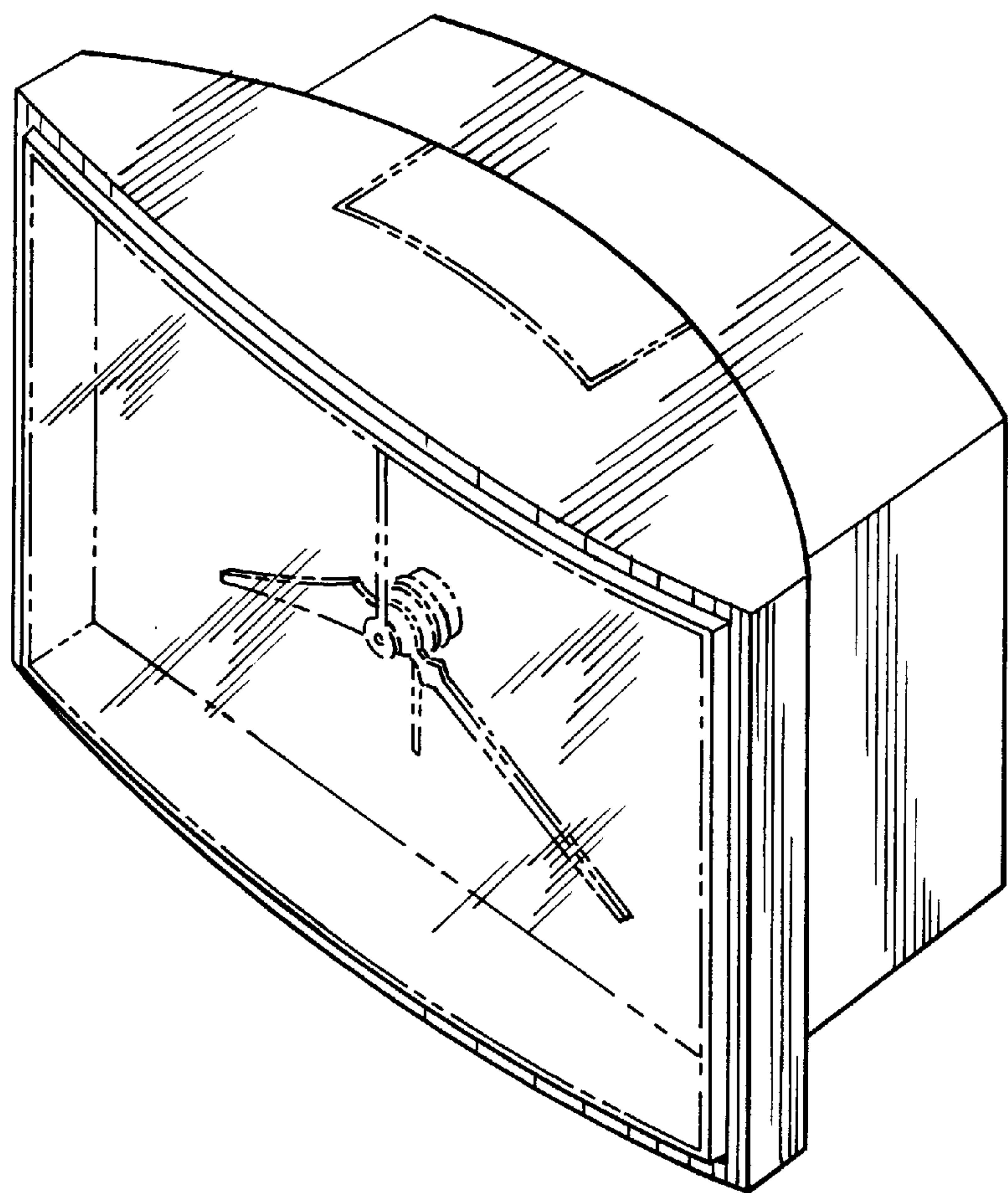

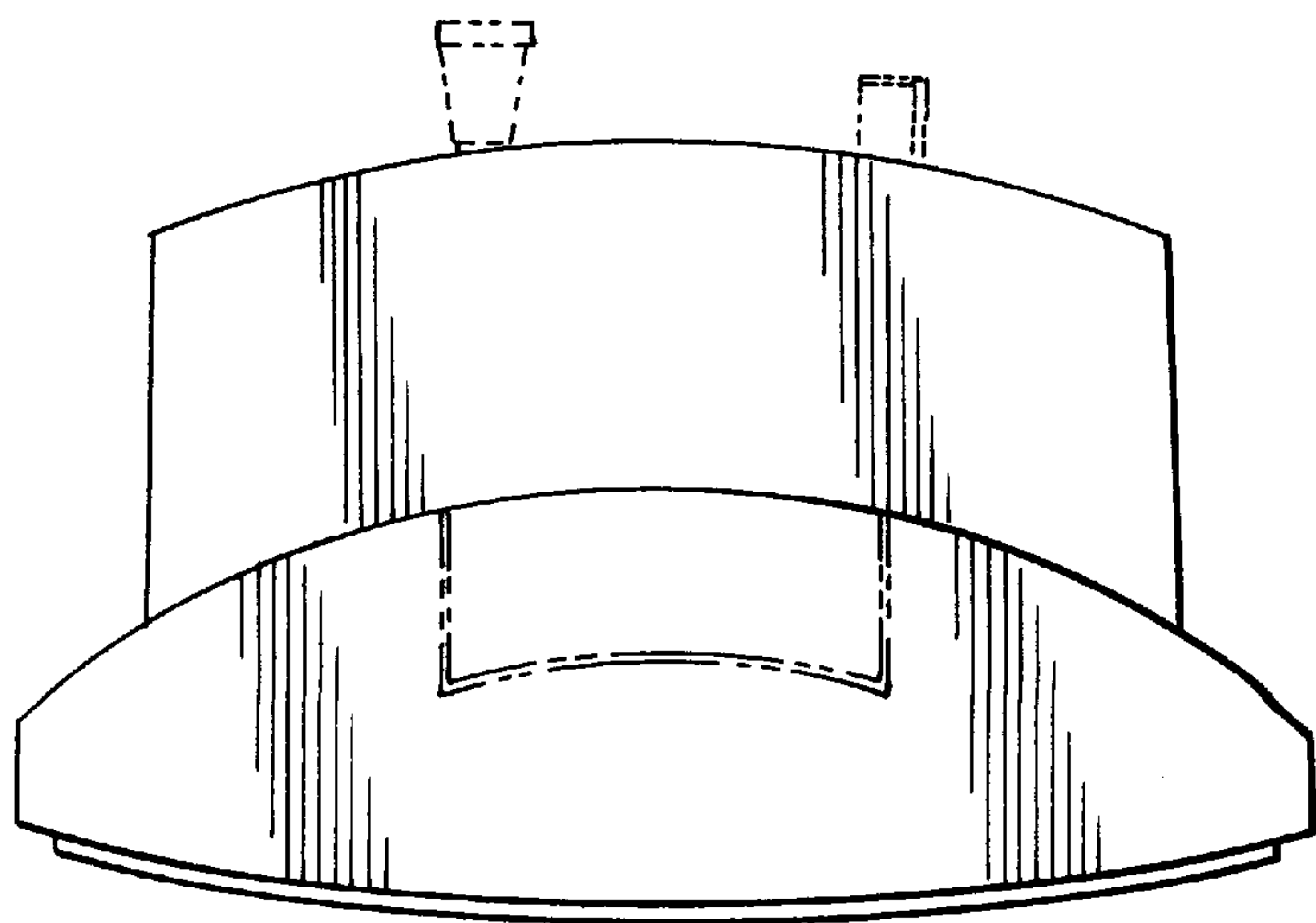

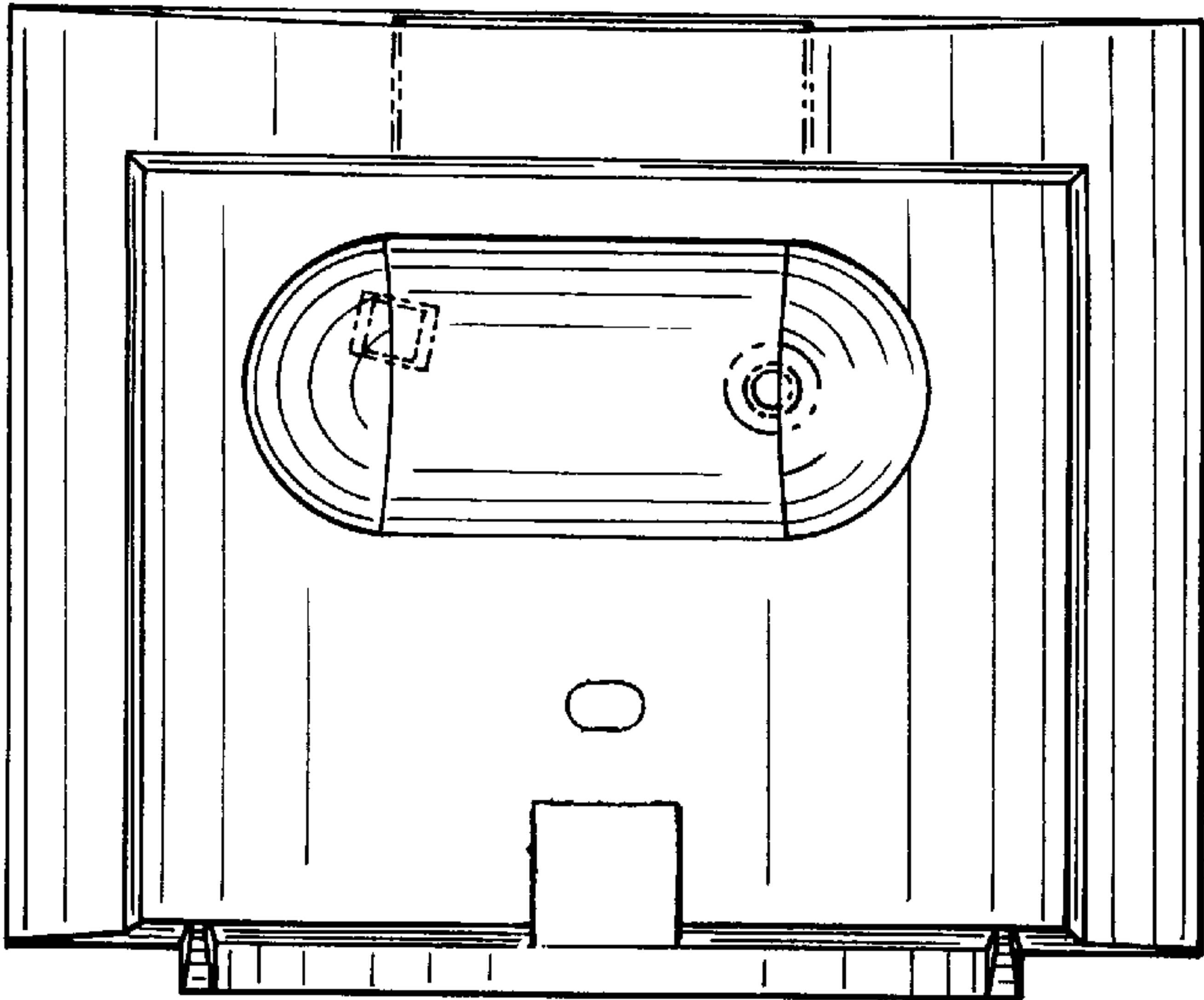

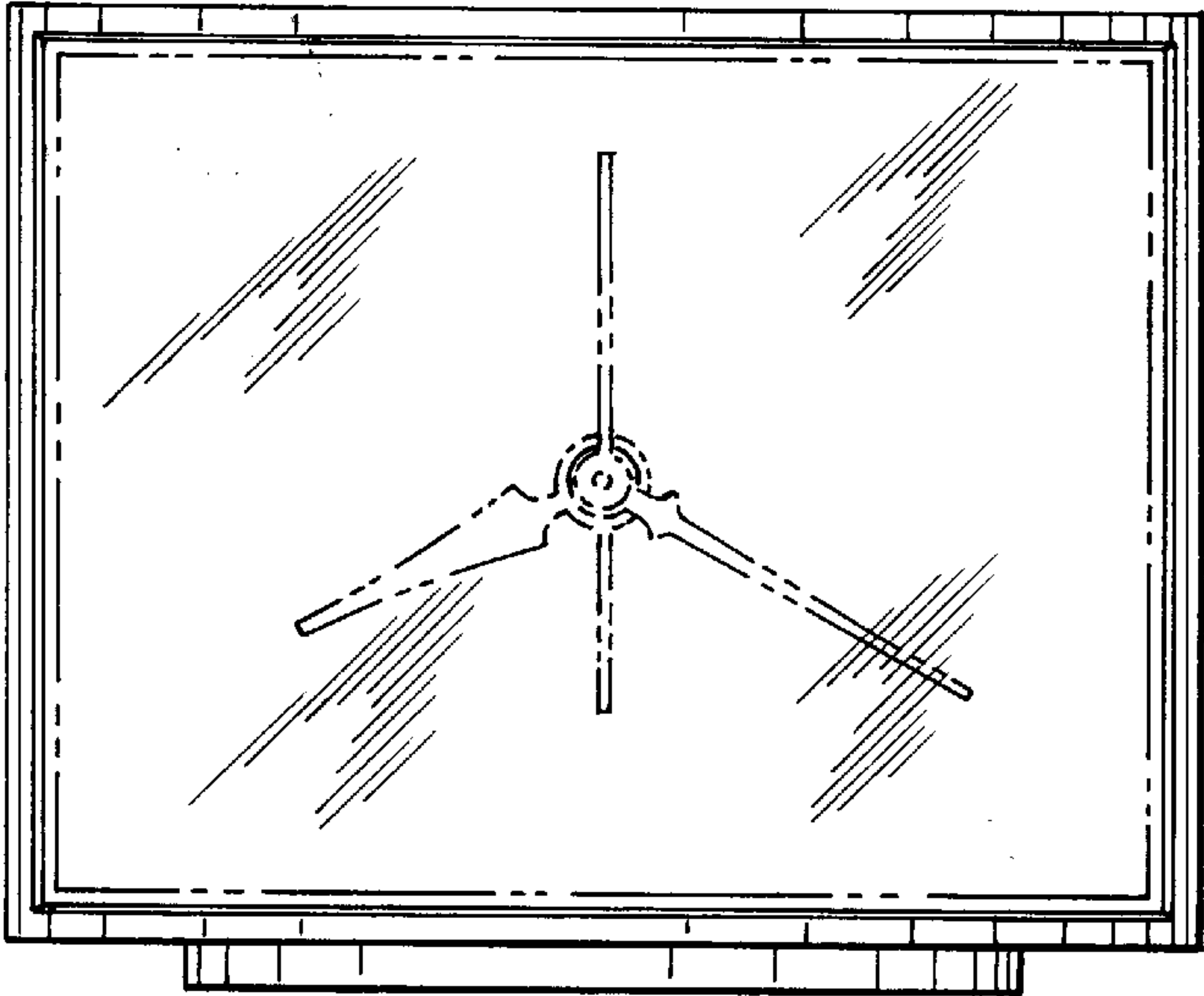
