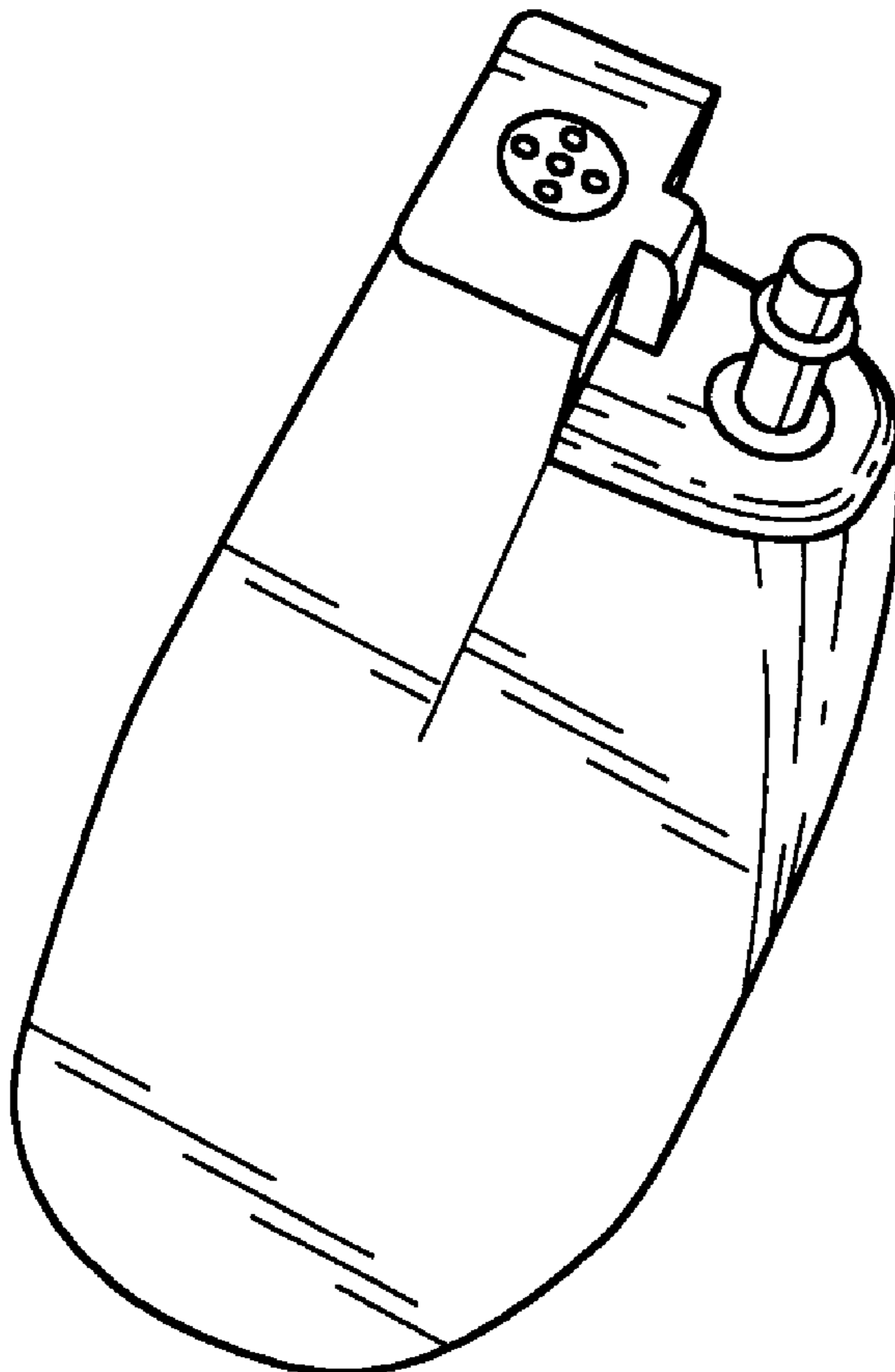
### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a behind the ear hearing aid device, as shown and described.

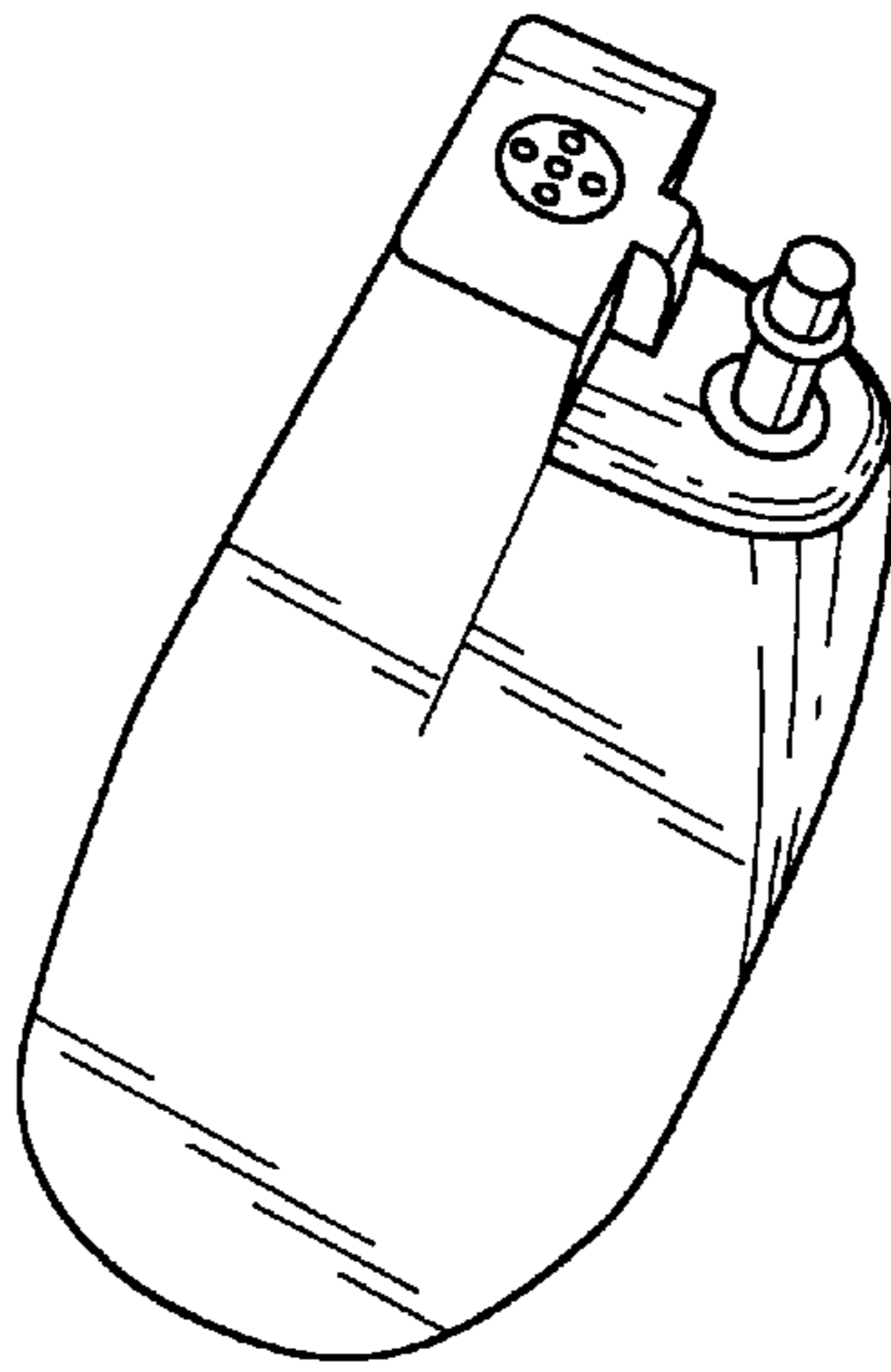
#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

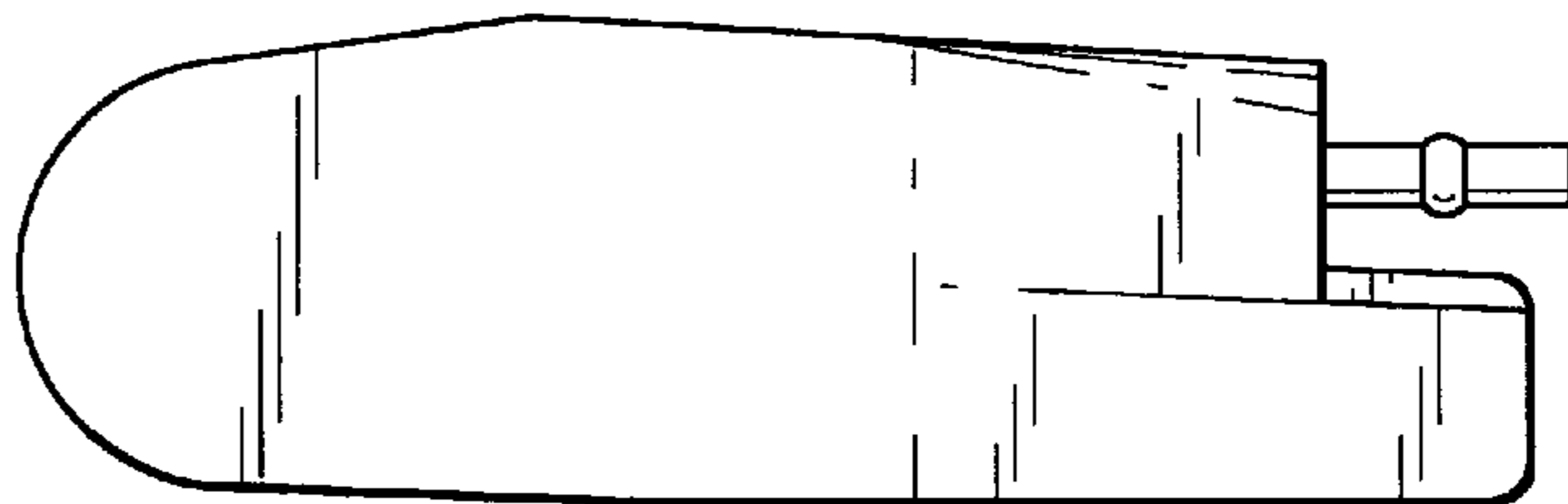

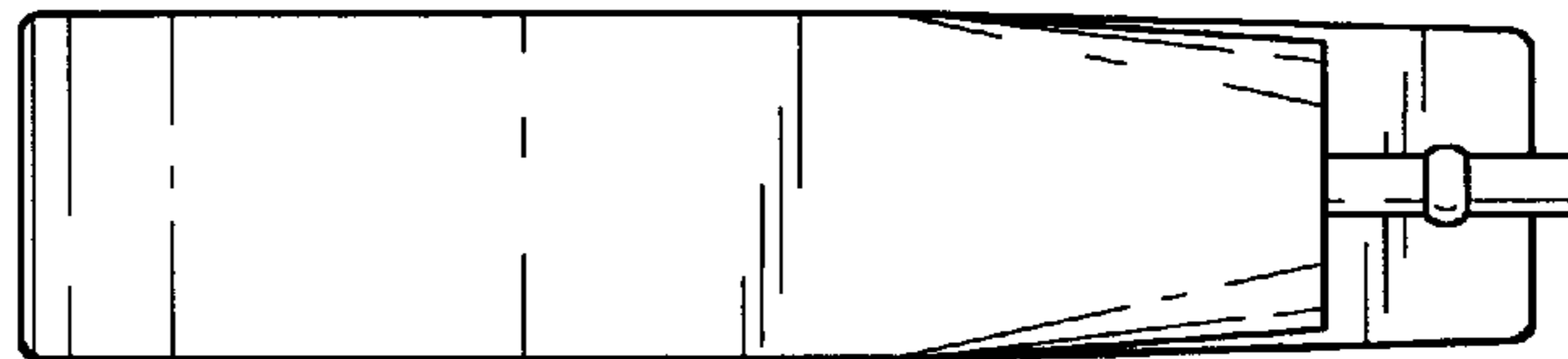

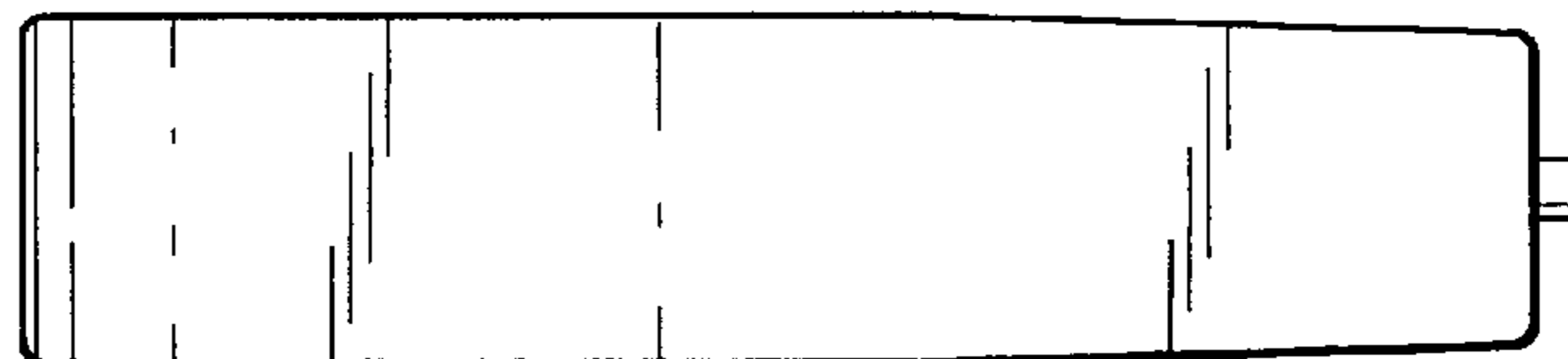

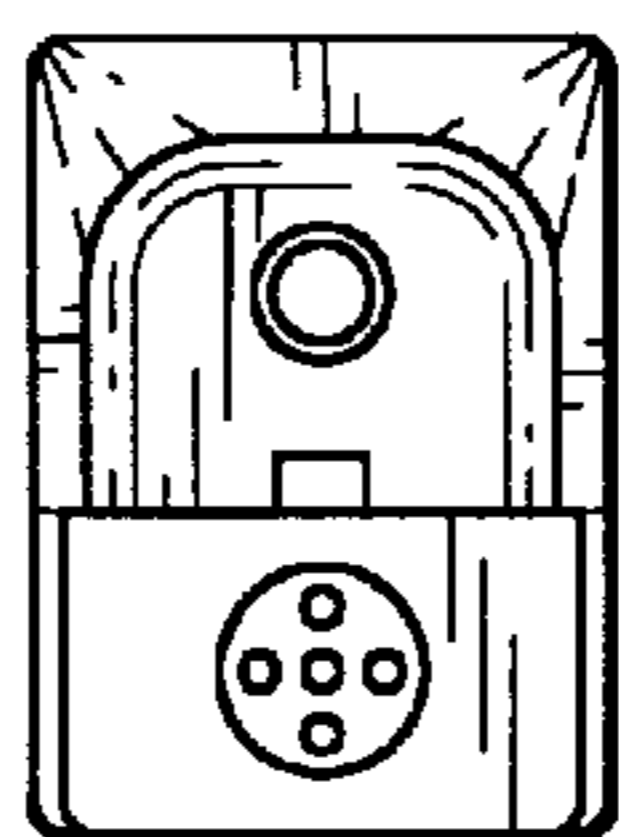
