design, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

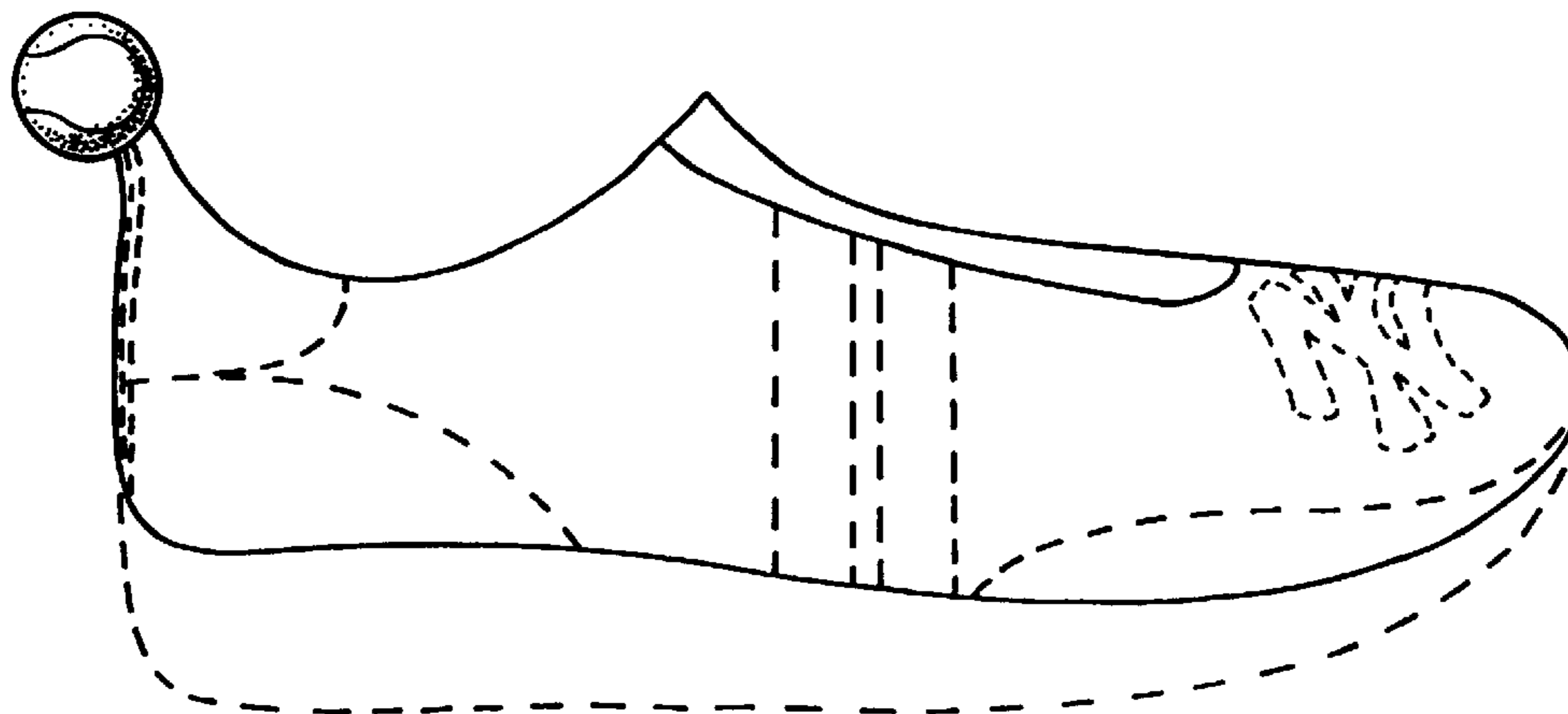
FIG. 10 is a top plan view thereof;

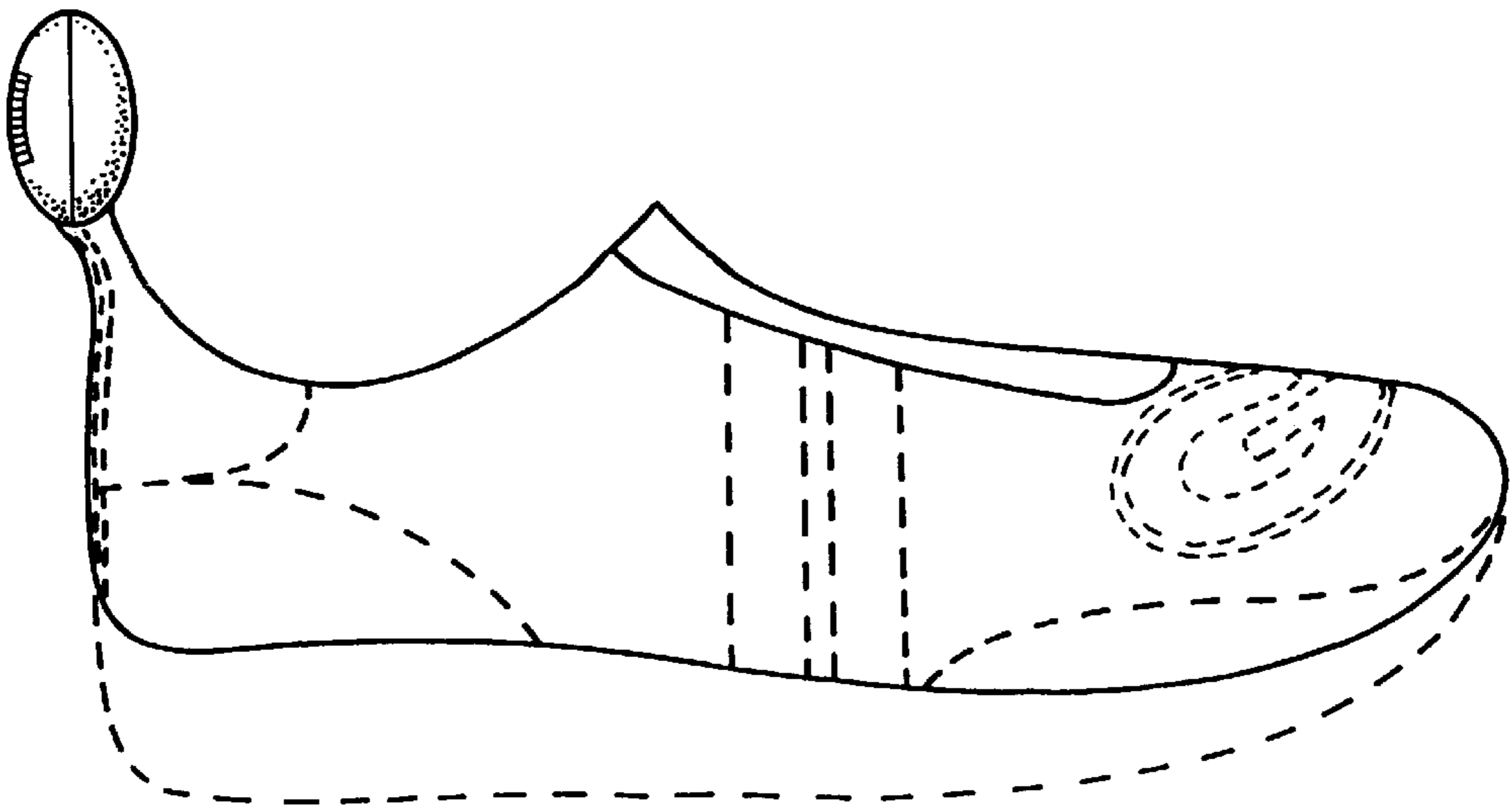

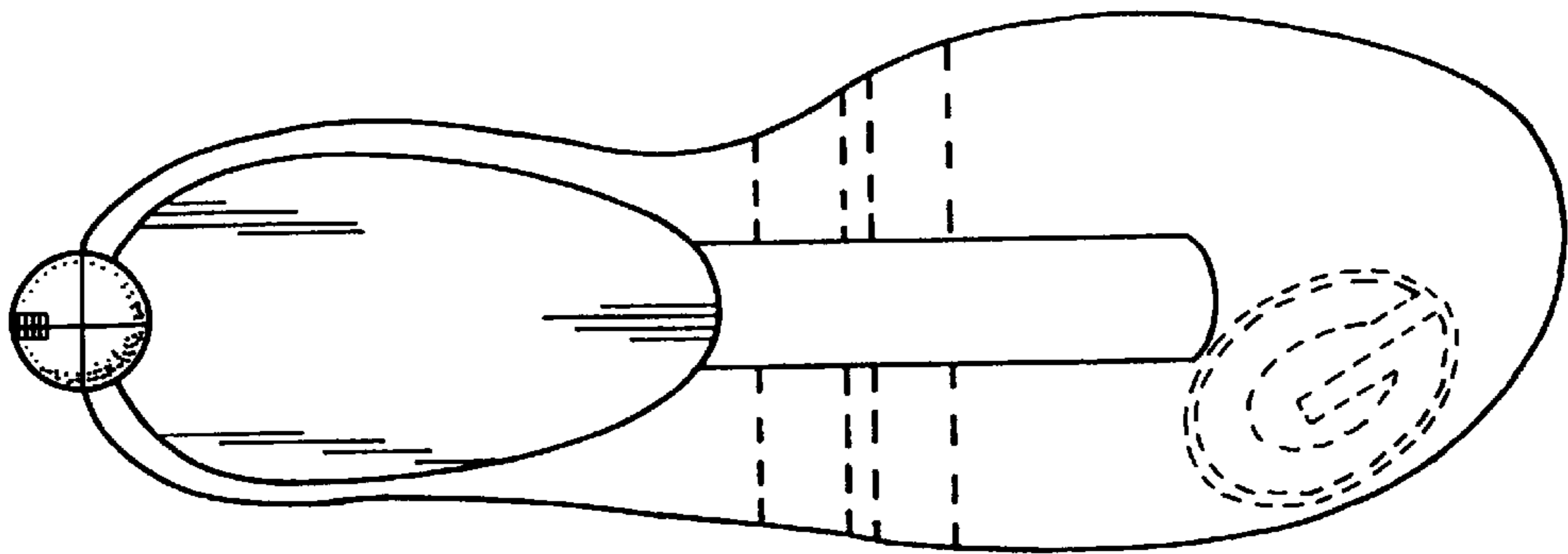

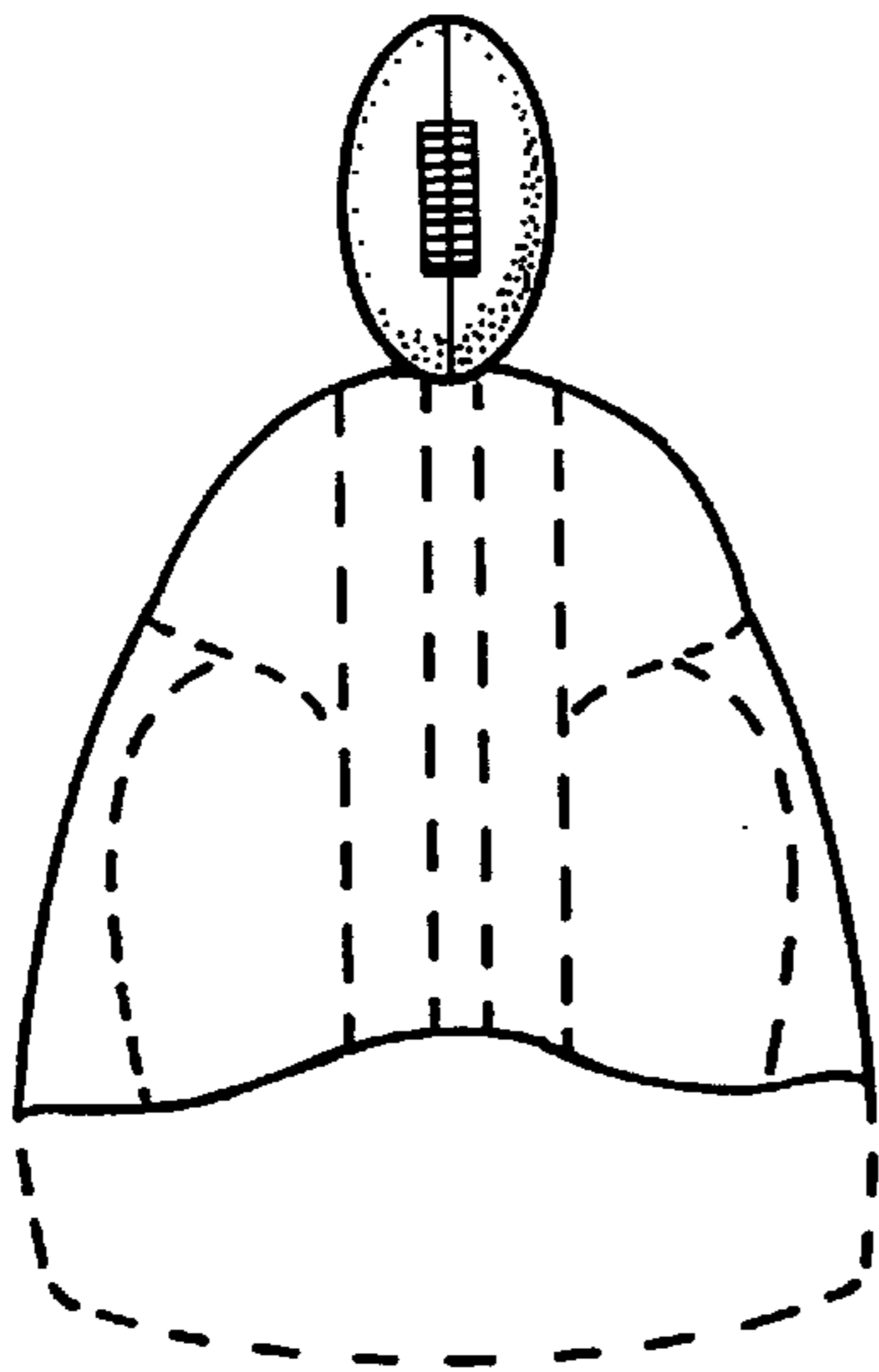

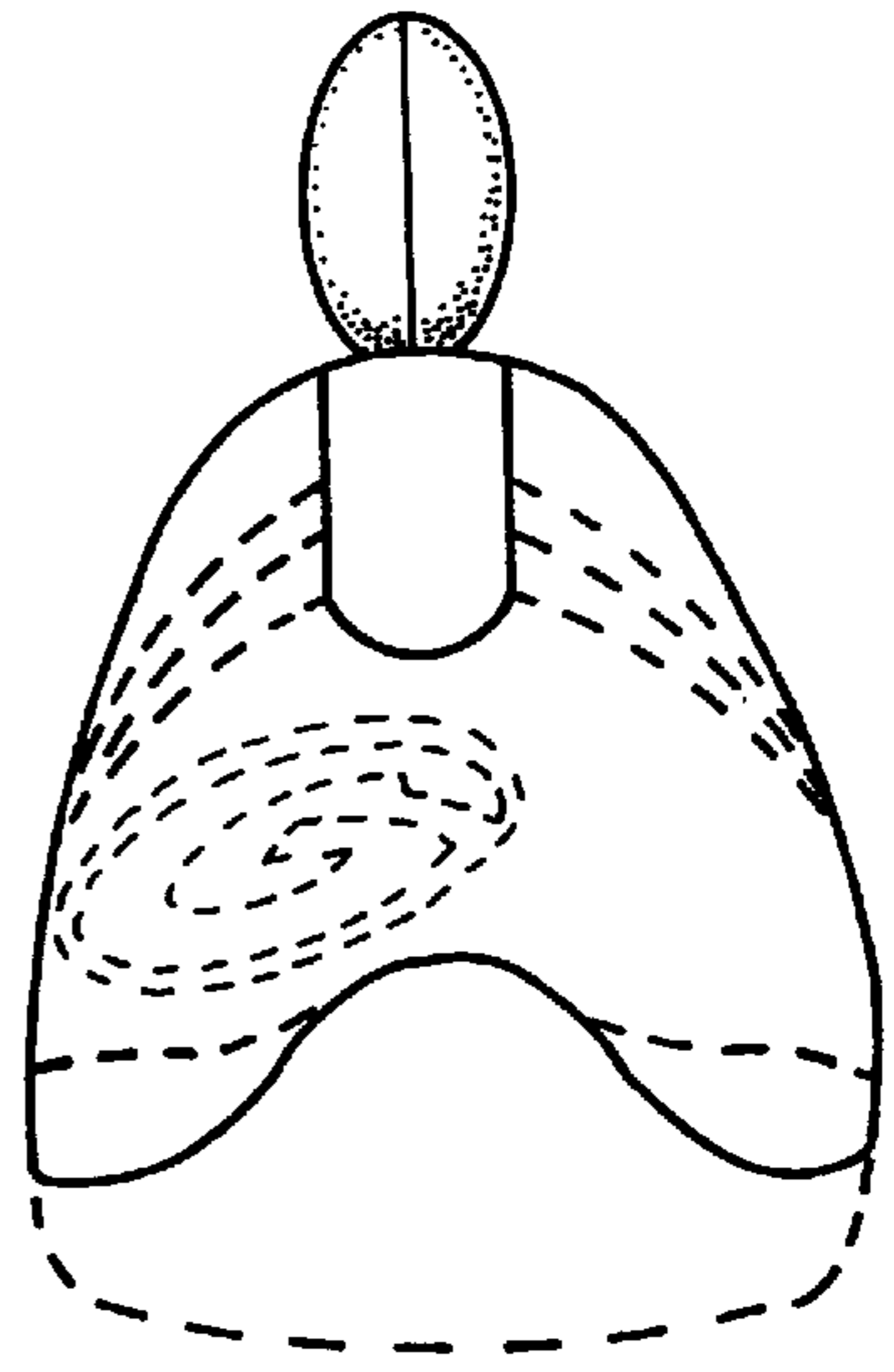

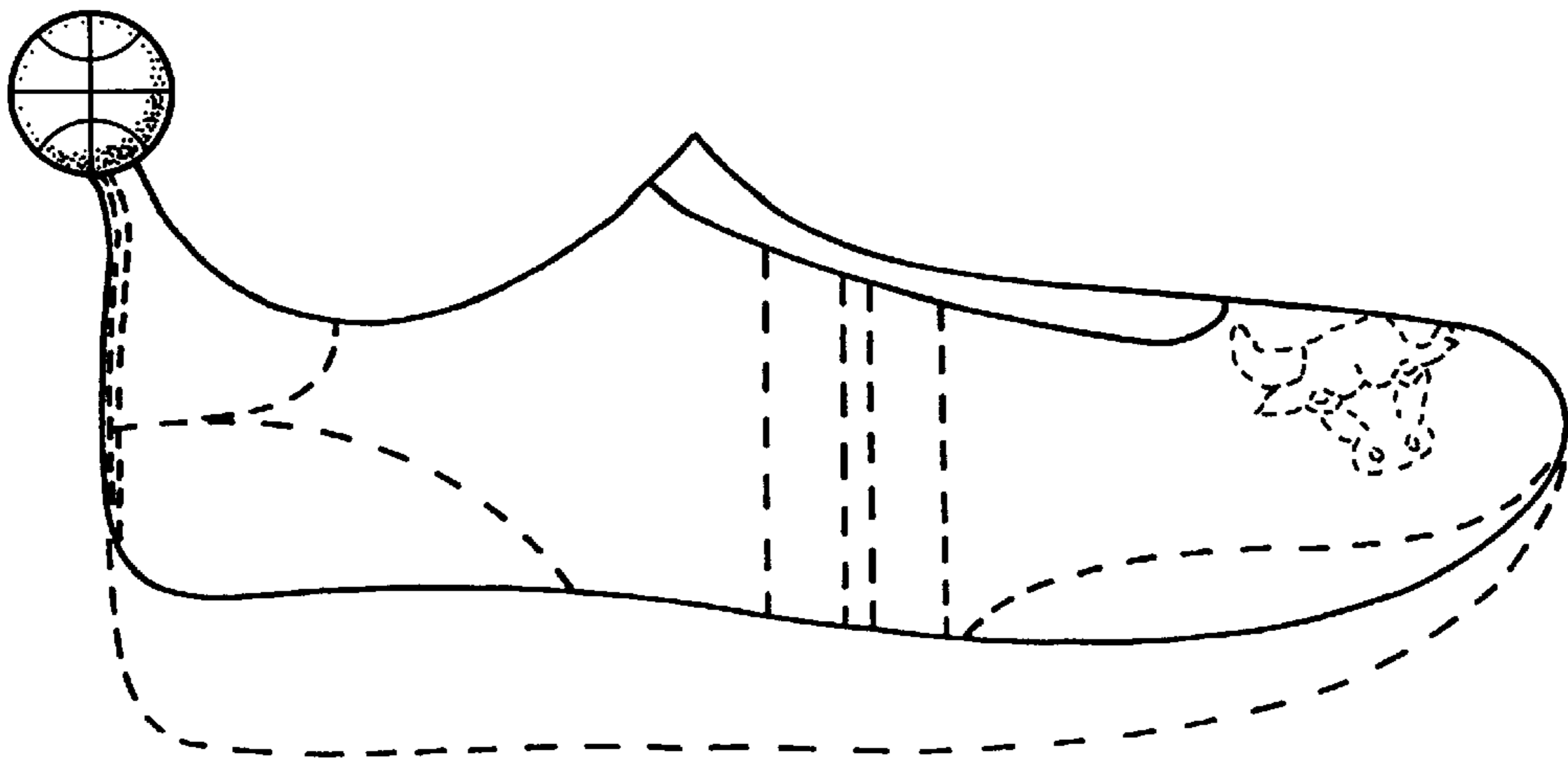

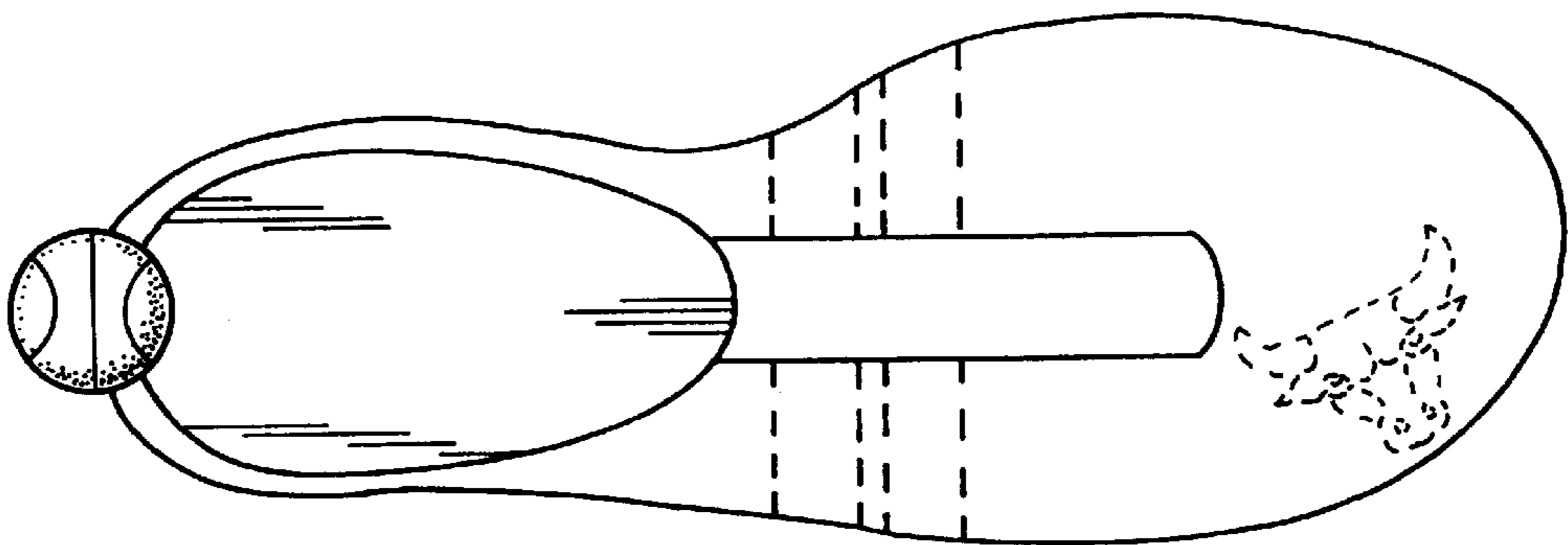

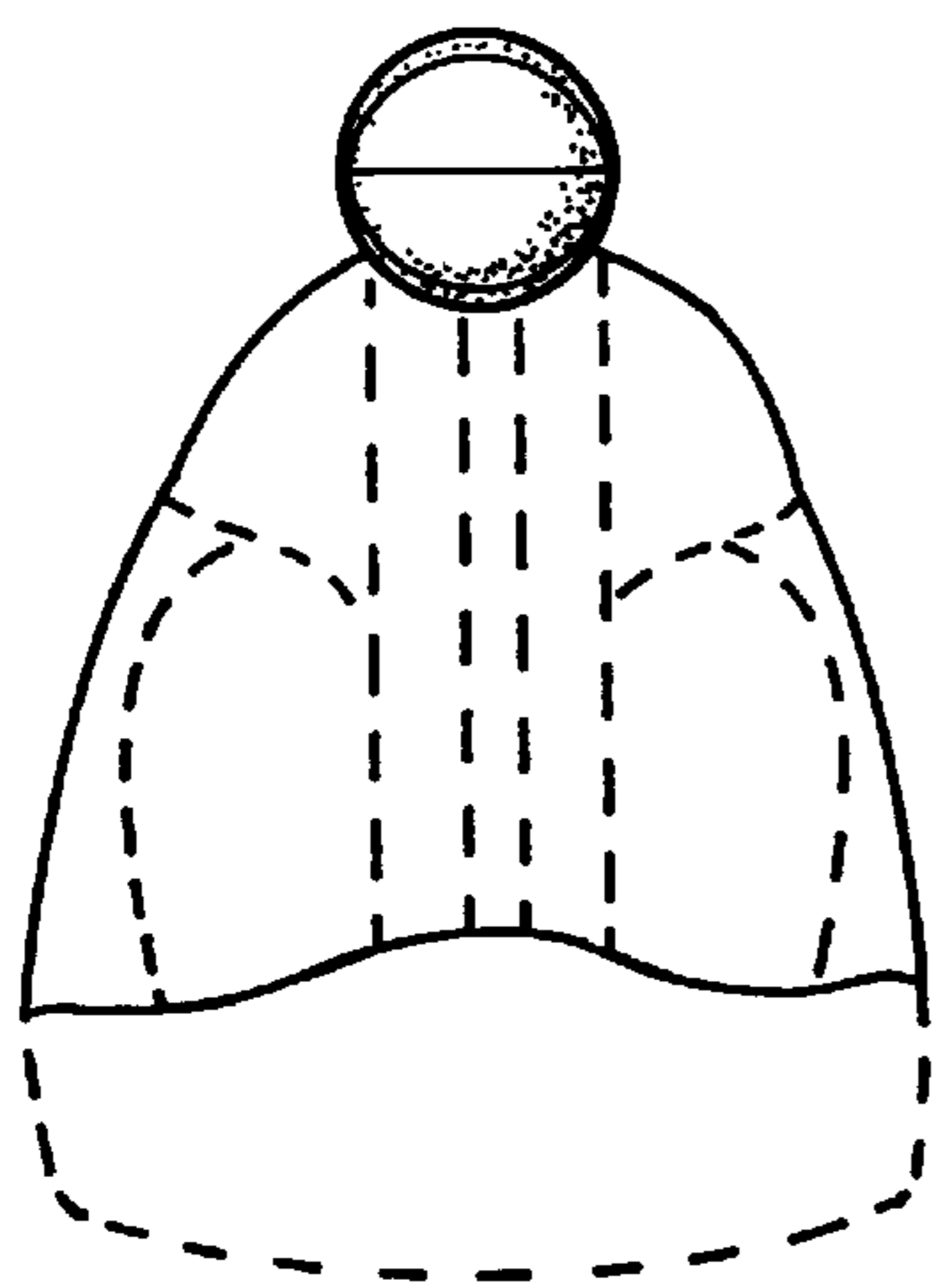

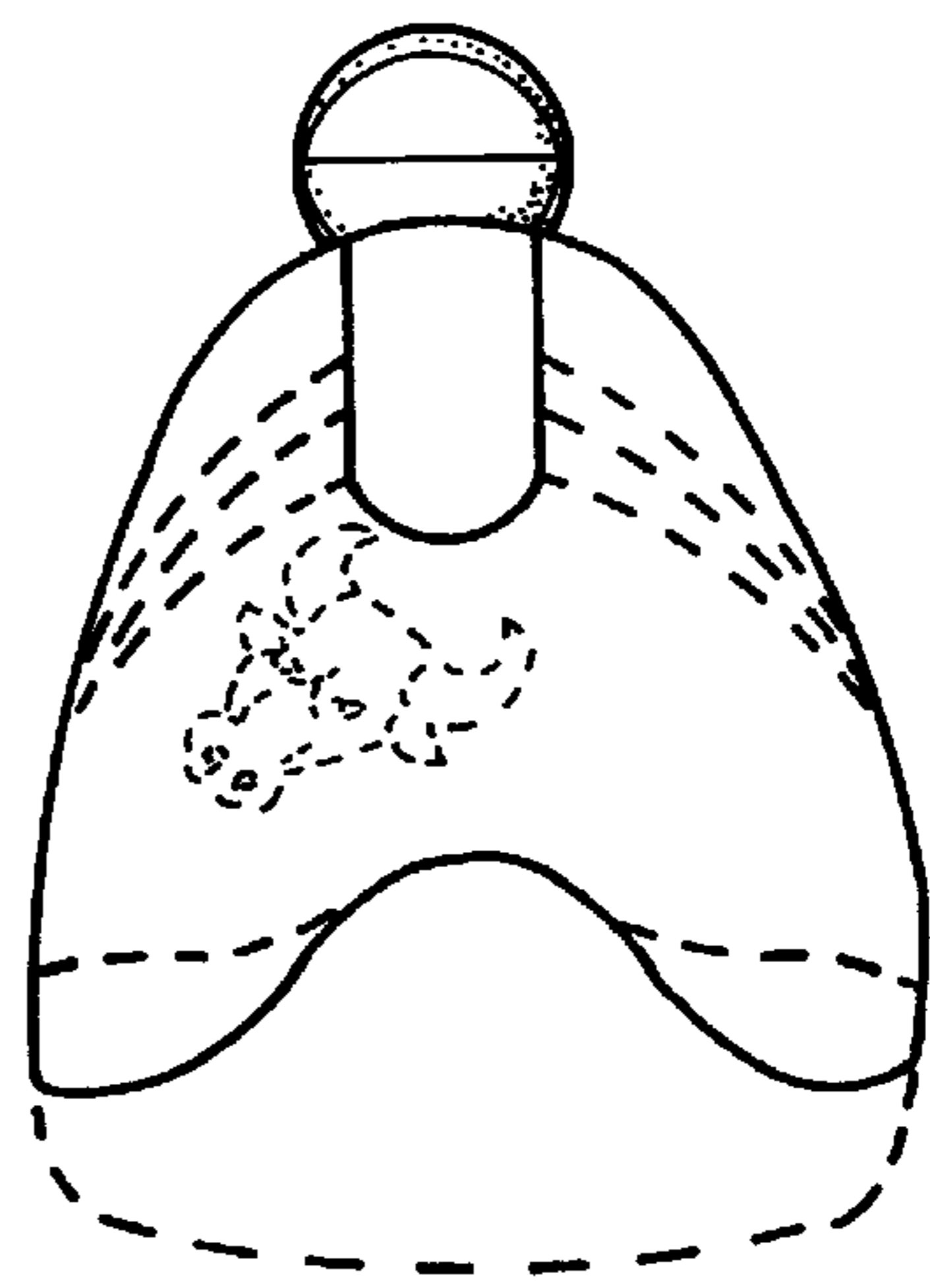

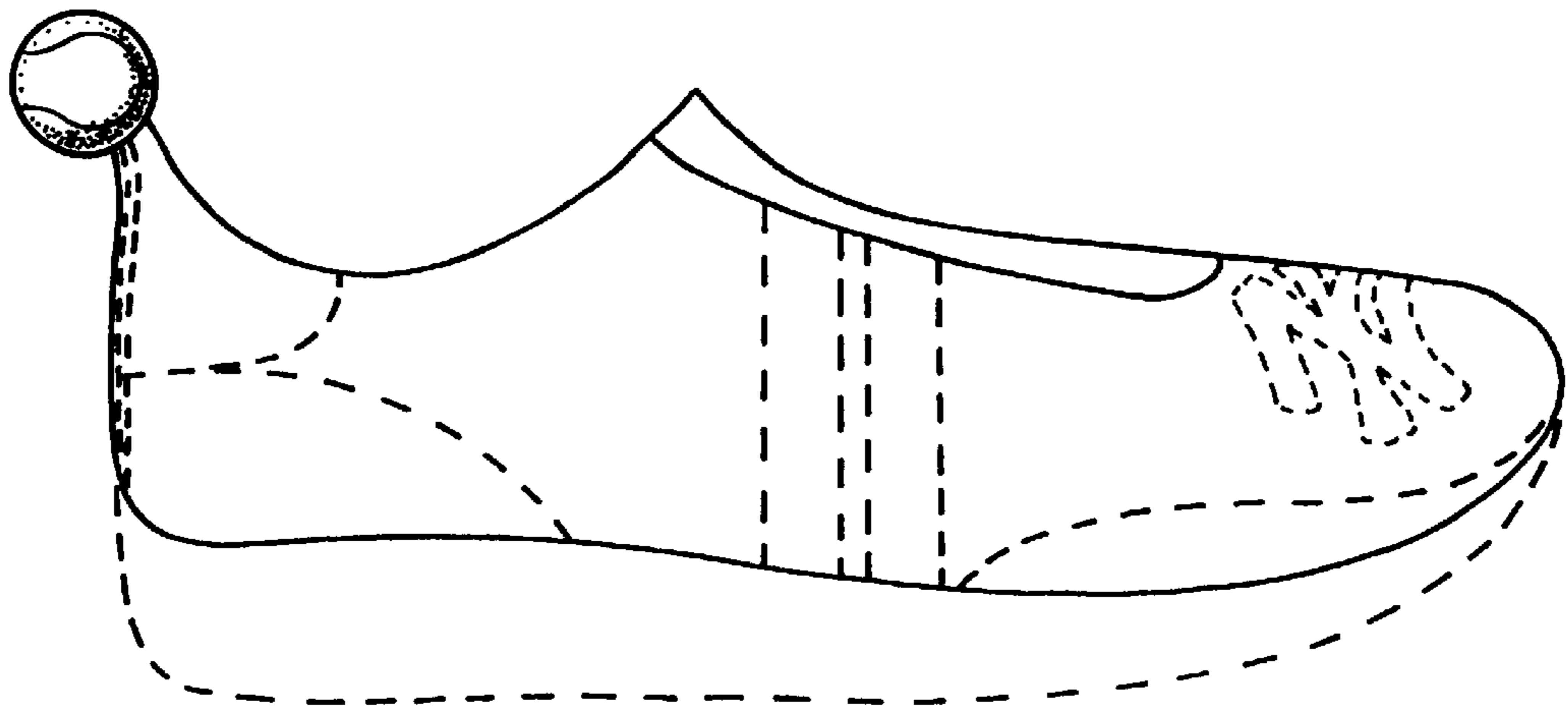

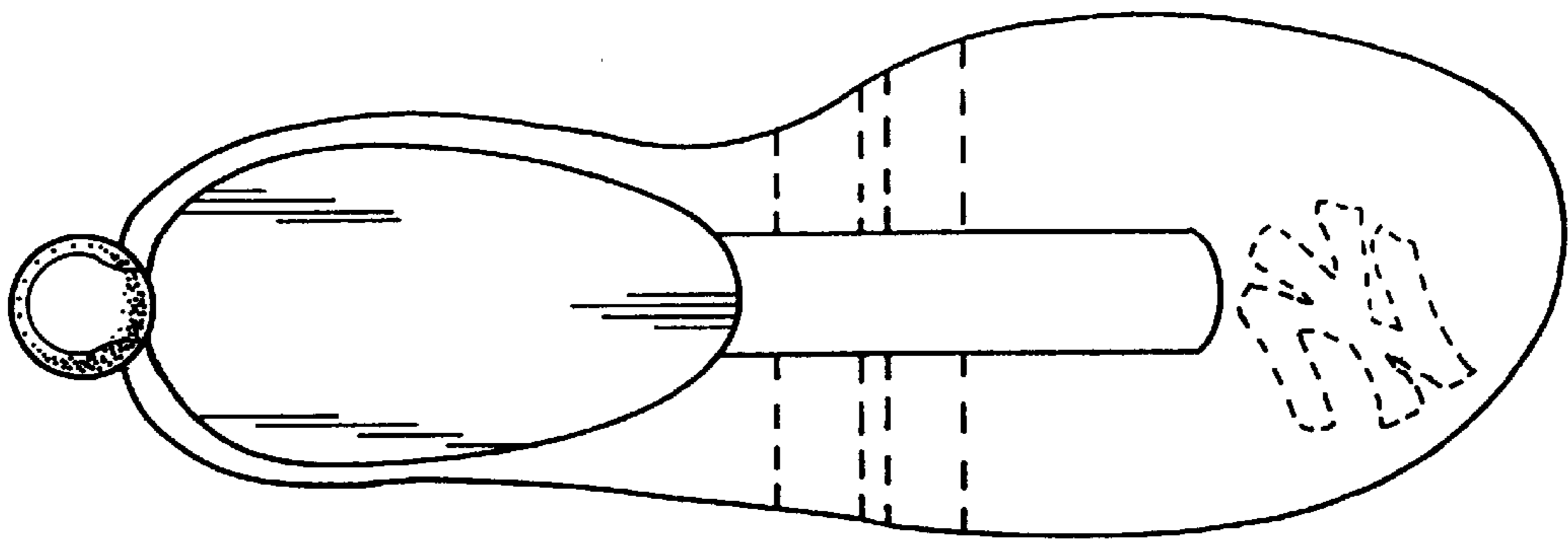

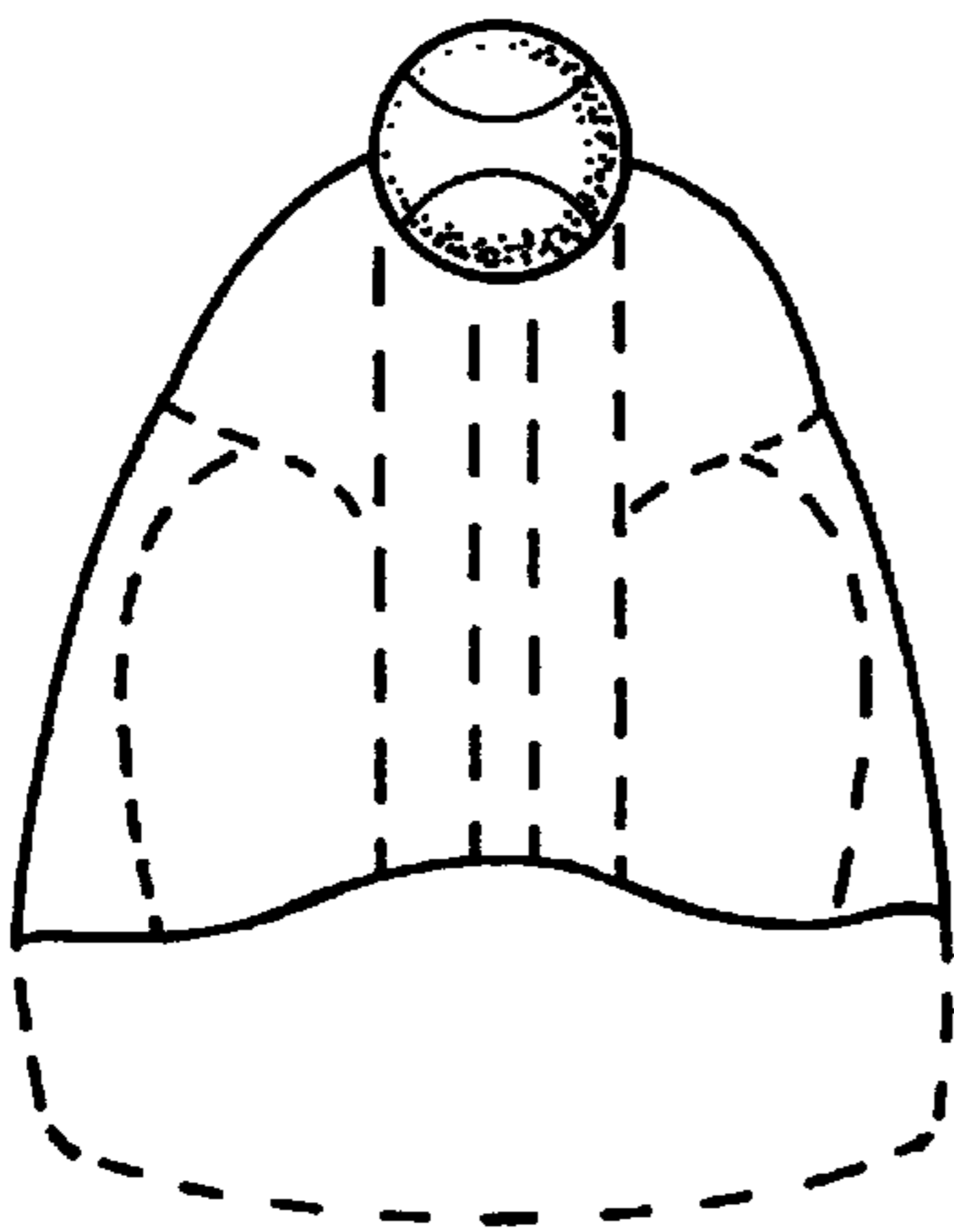

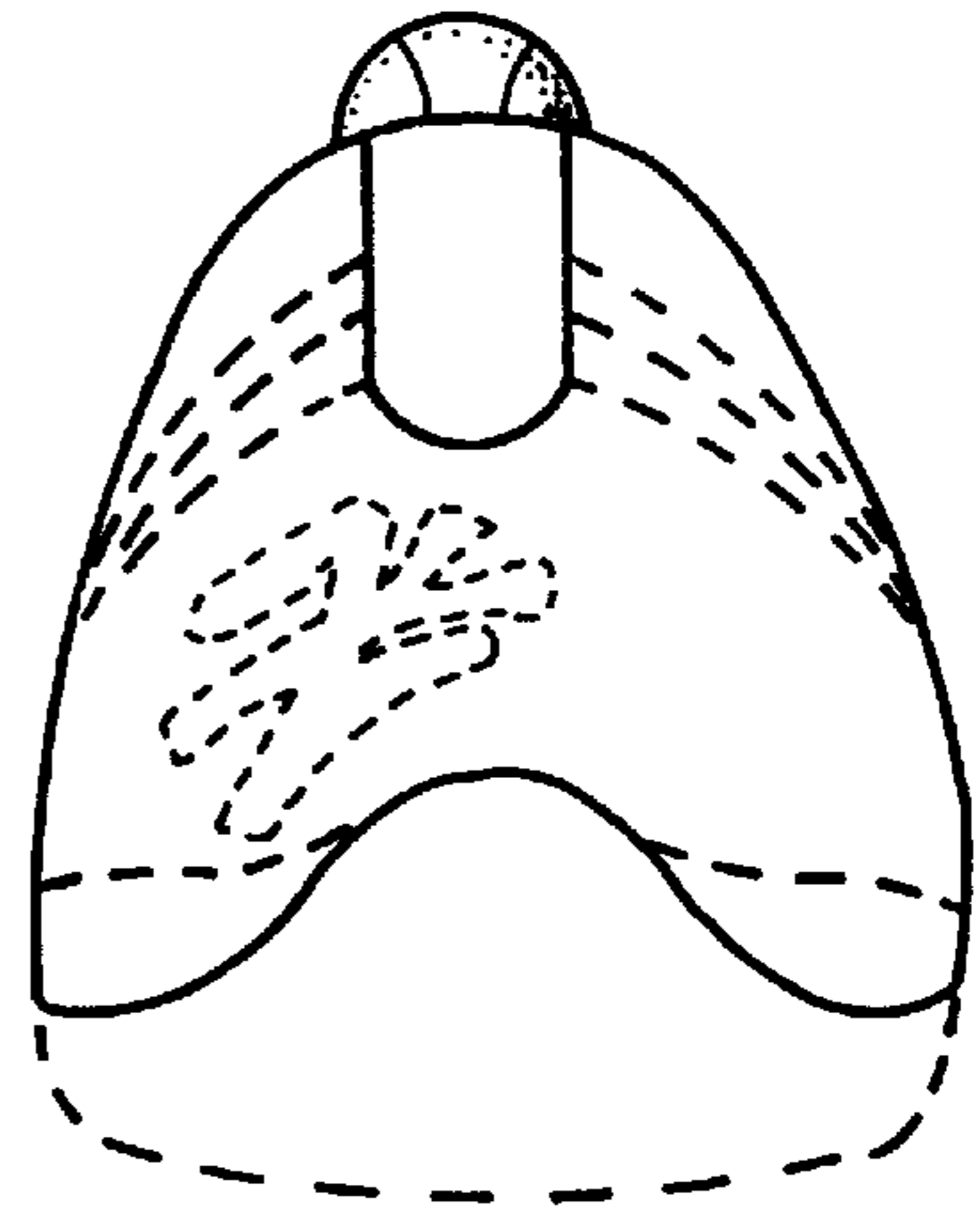
