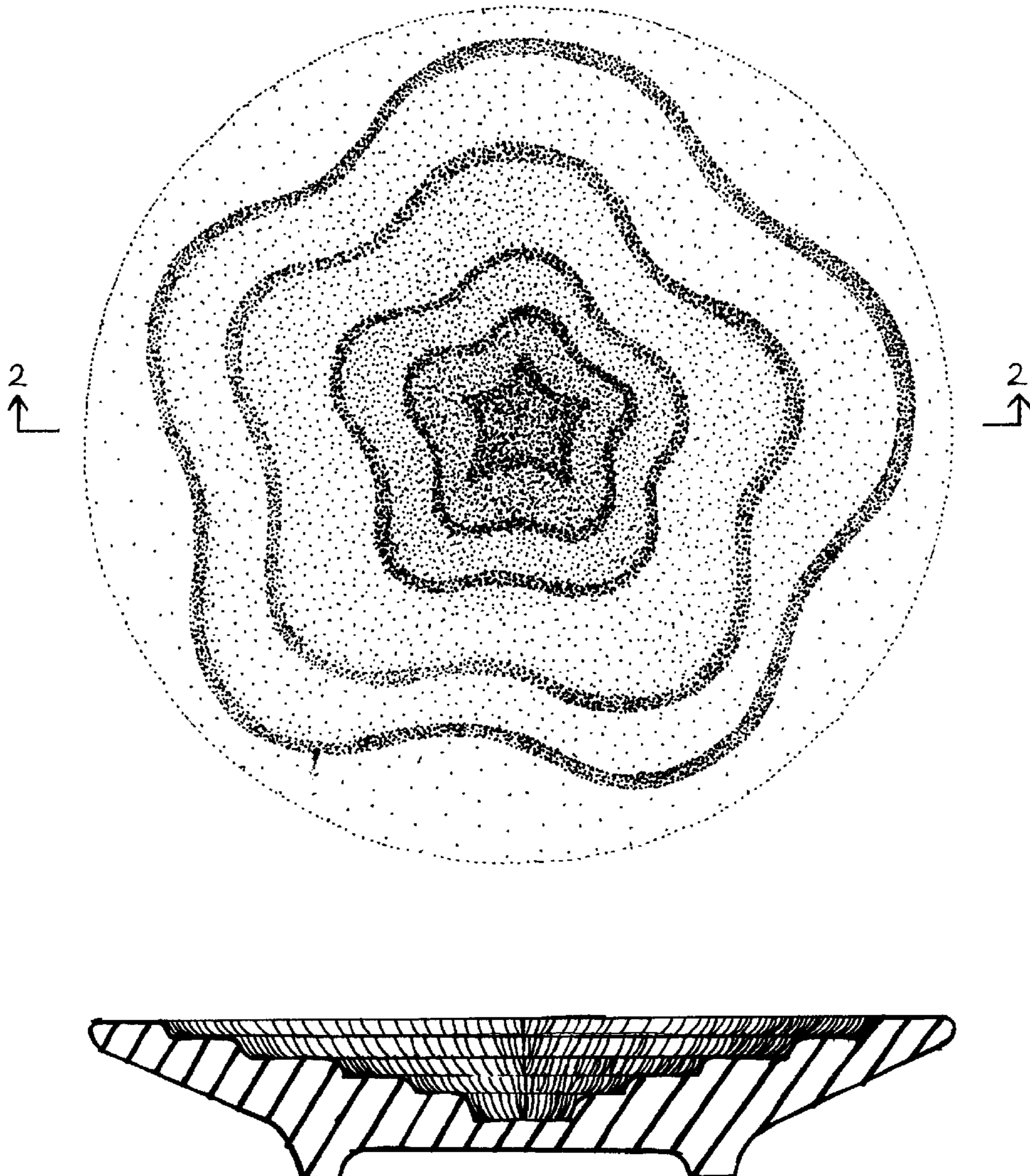
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a terraced oil dish, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a terraced oil dish showing my new design; and,

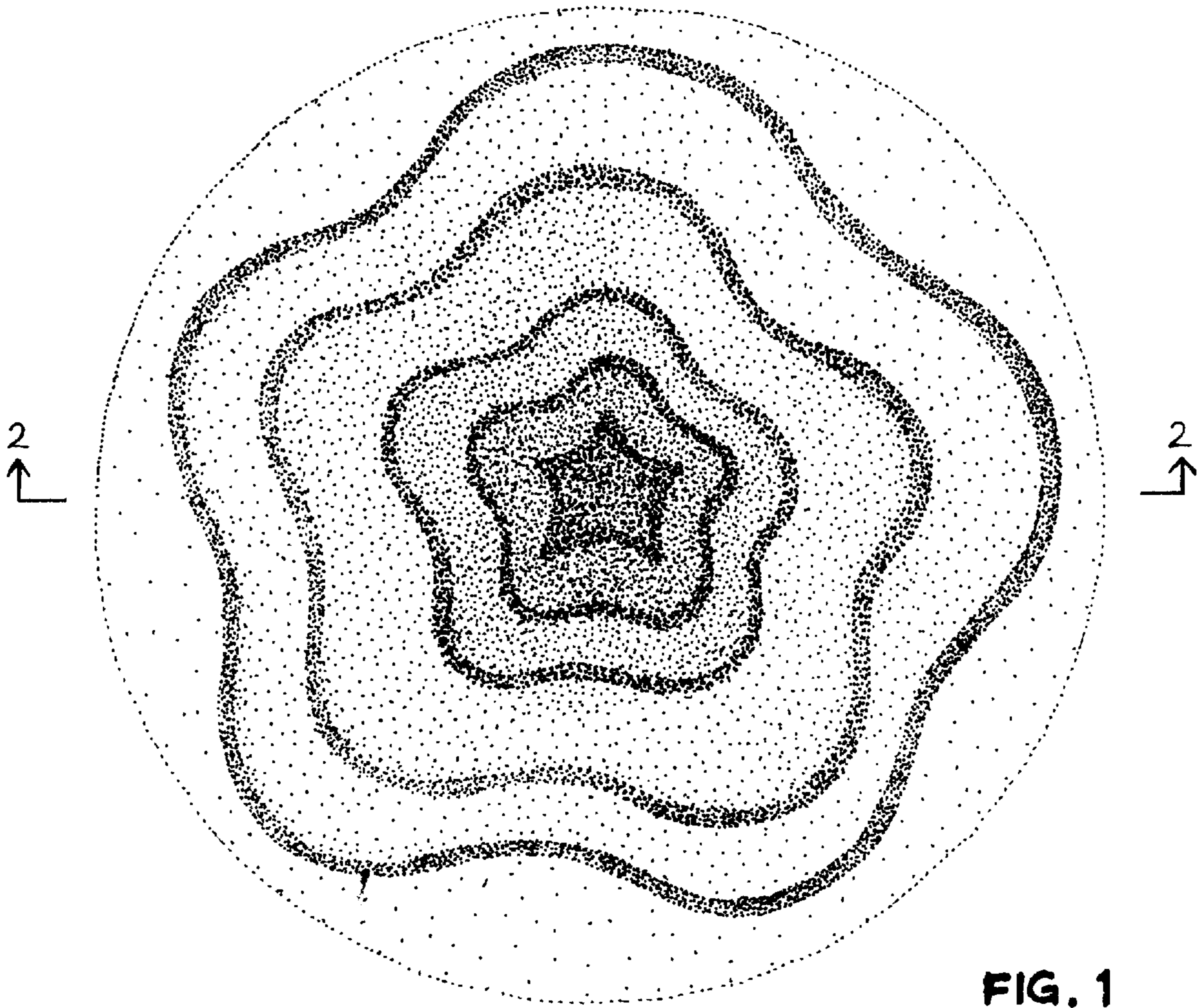

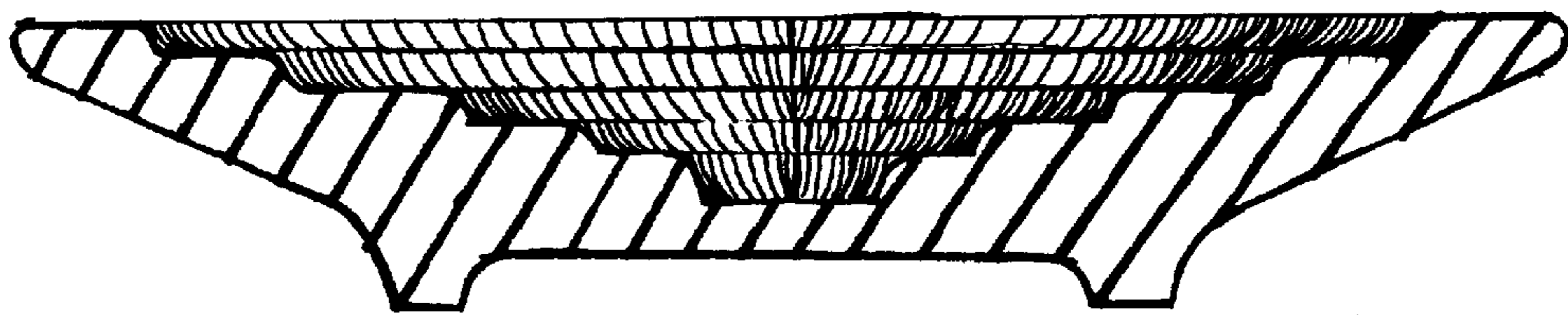
