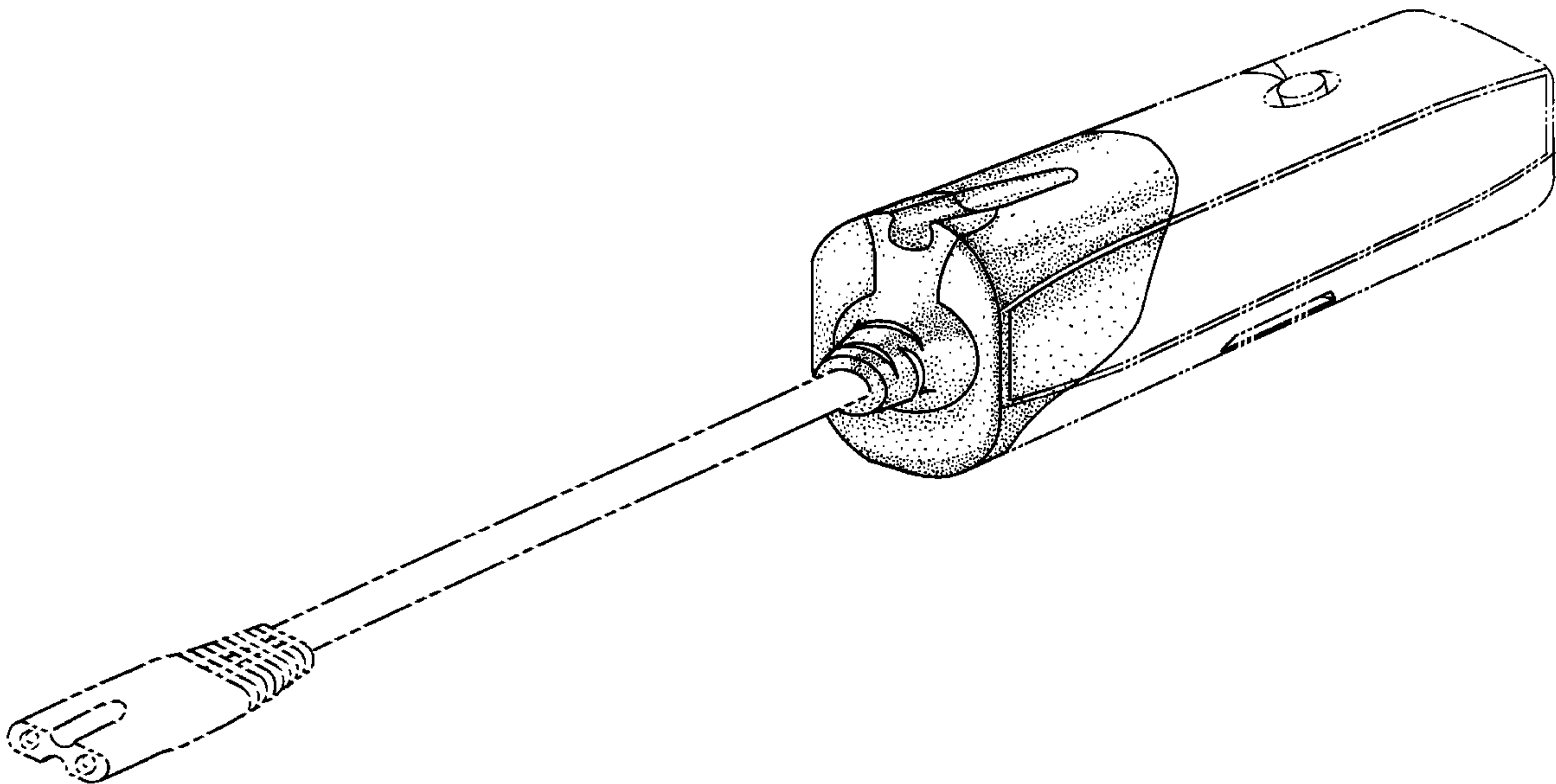
The ornamental design for a portion of an electrical surge protector, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an electrical surge protector showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a front elevation view thereof.

The broken line showing of the remainder of the electrical surge protector and of the circular element with two lines extending from the perimeter in FIG. 2 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

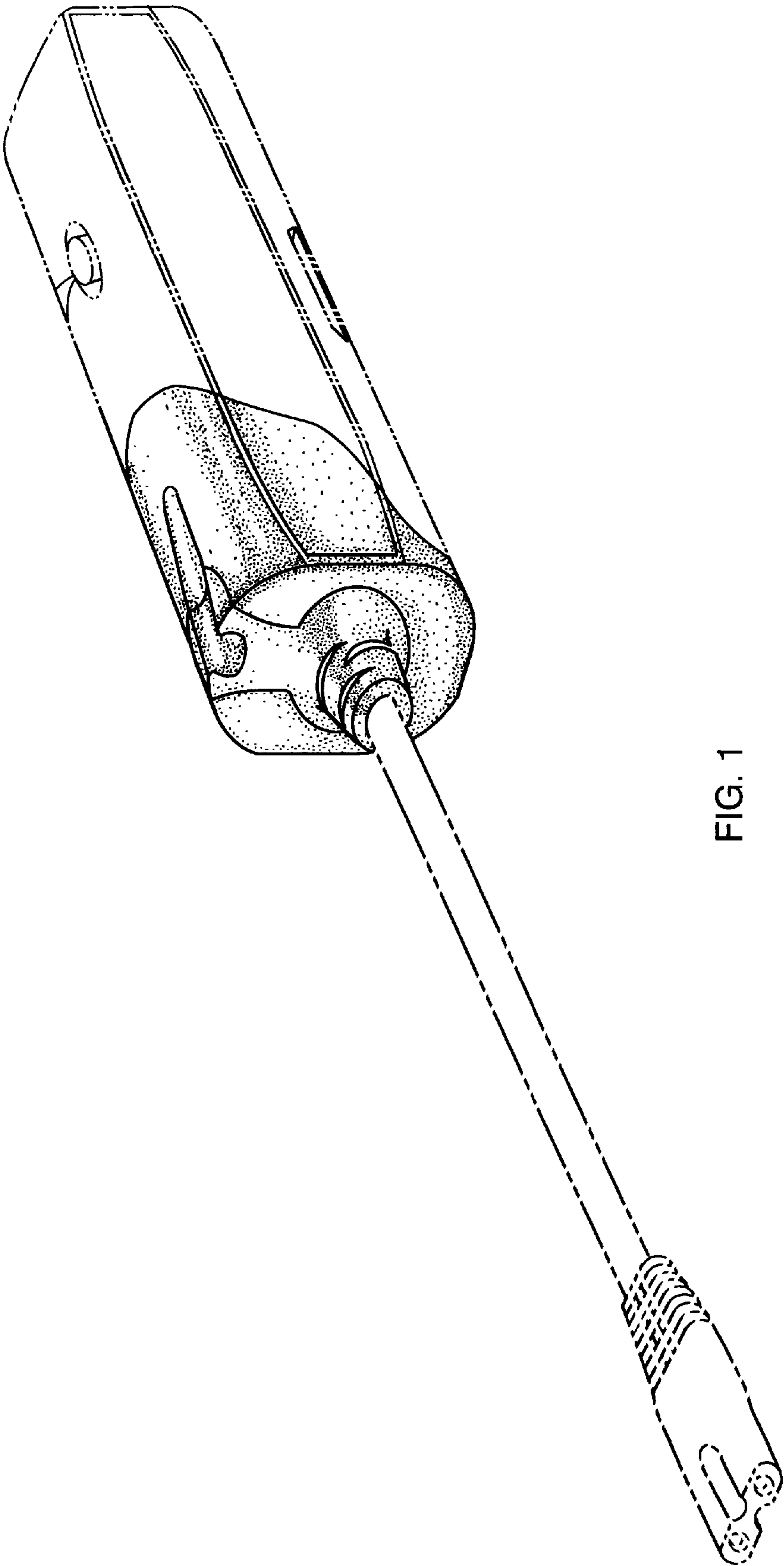

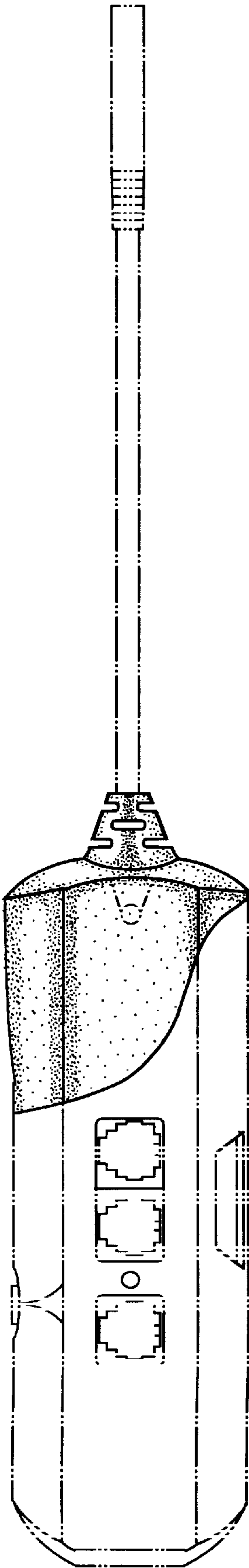

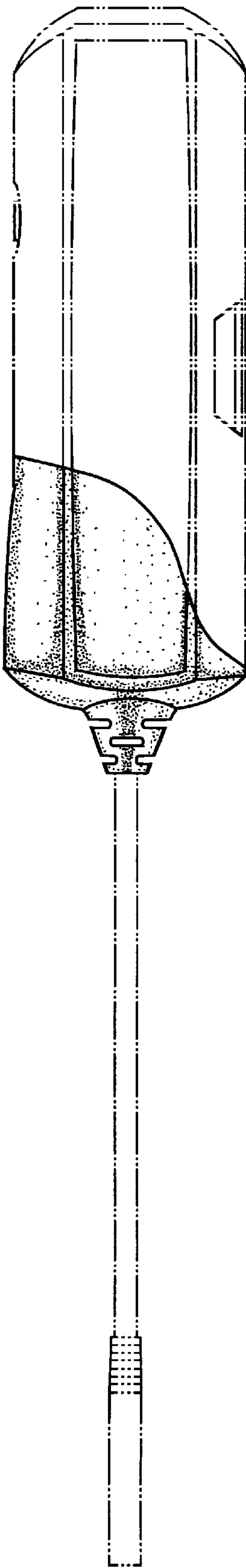

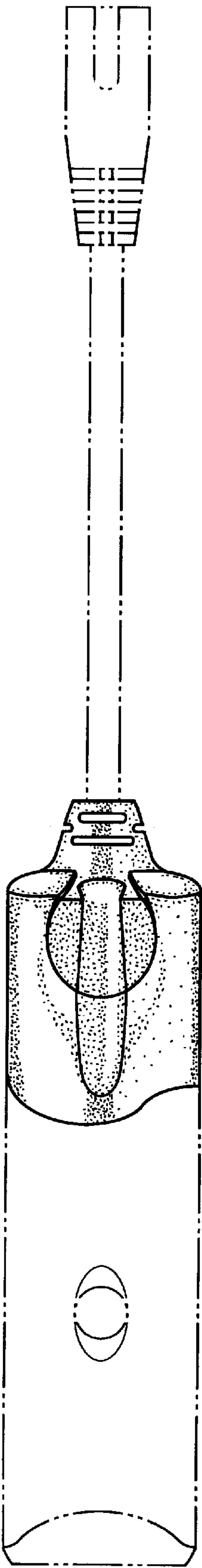

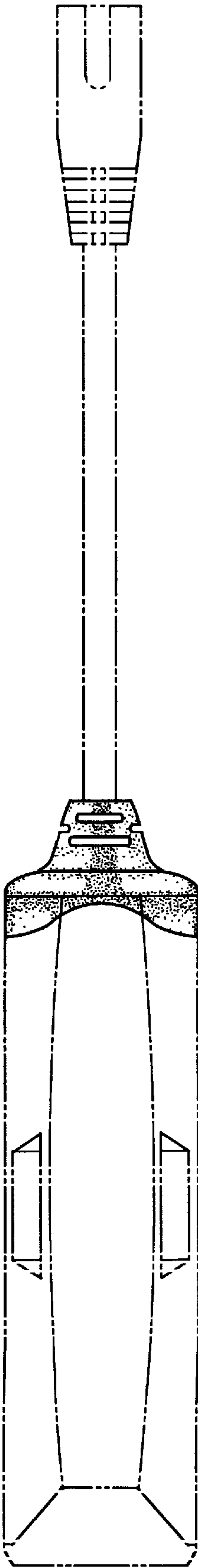

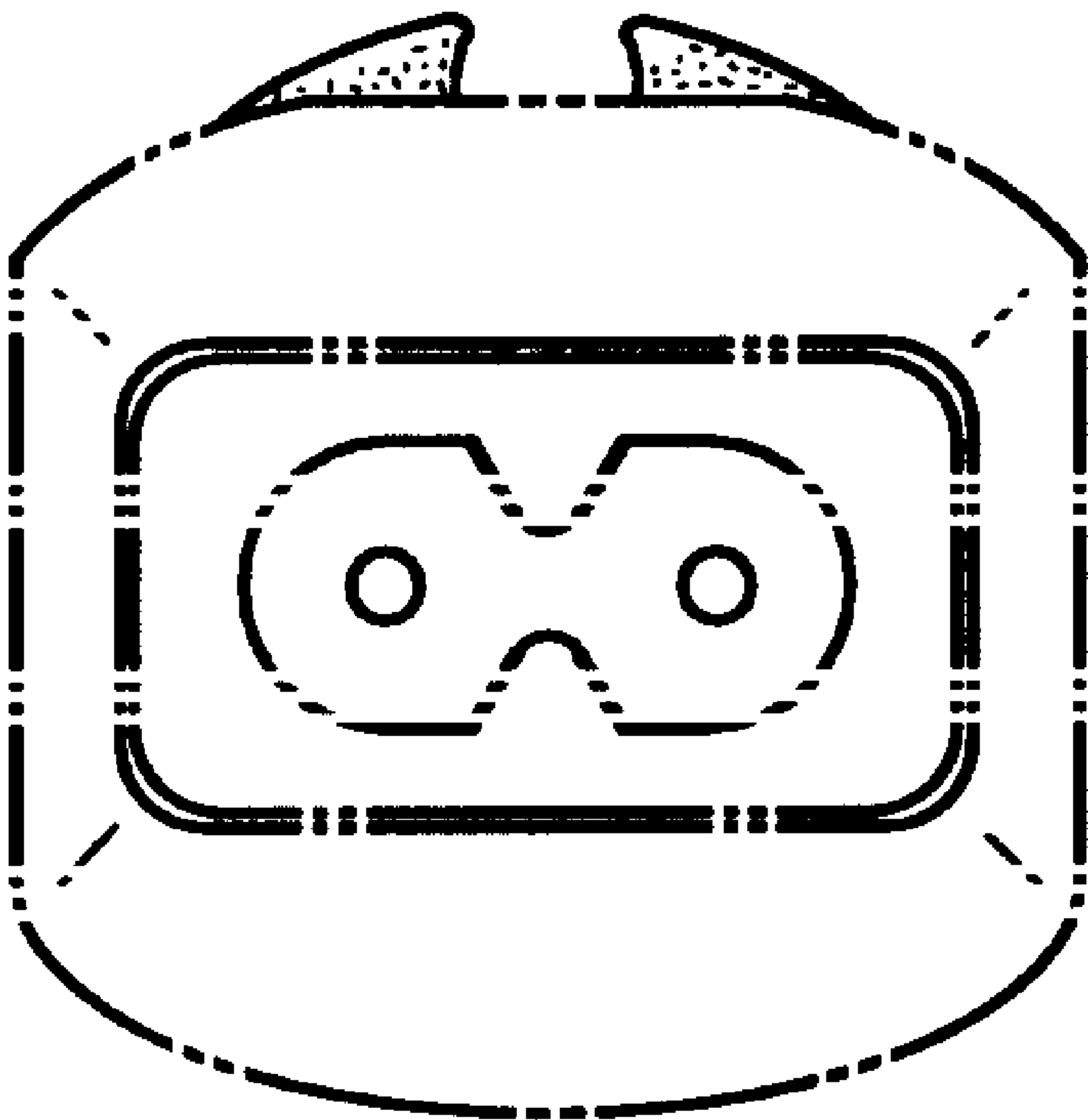

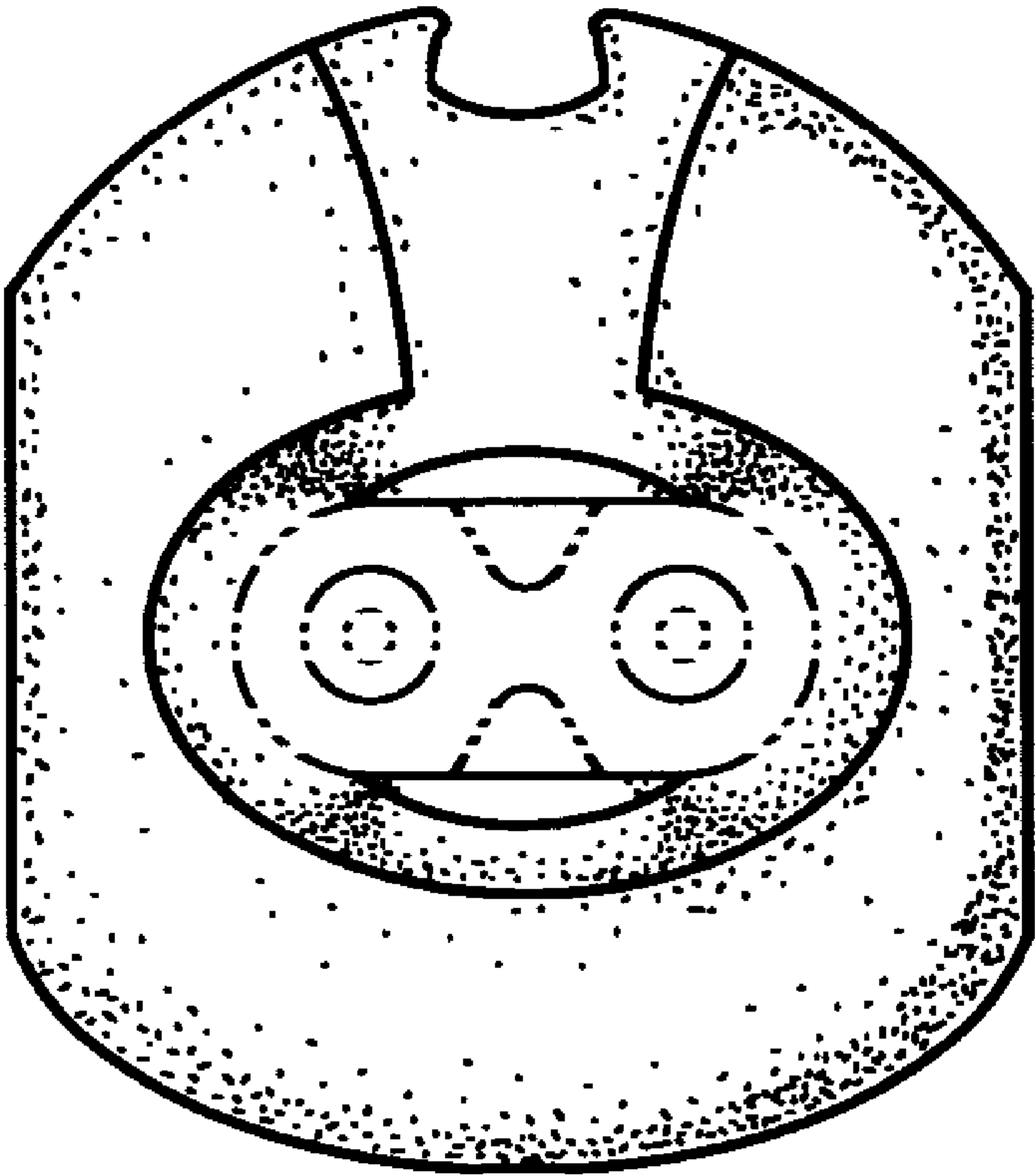
