The ornamental design for a guitar head and neck assembly, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a guitar head and neck assembly shown attached to a guitar body illustrating my design.

FIG. 2 is a top perspective view of the guitar head and neck assembly.

FIG. 3 is an inverted perspective view of the guitar head and neck assembly shown in FIG. 2.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the invention.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the invention.

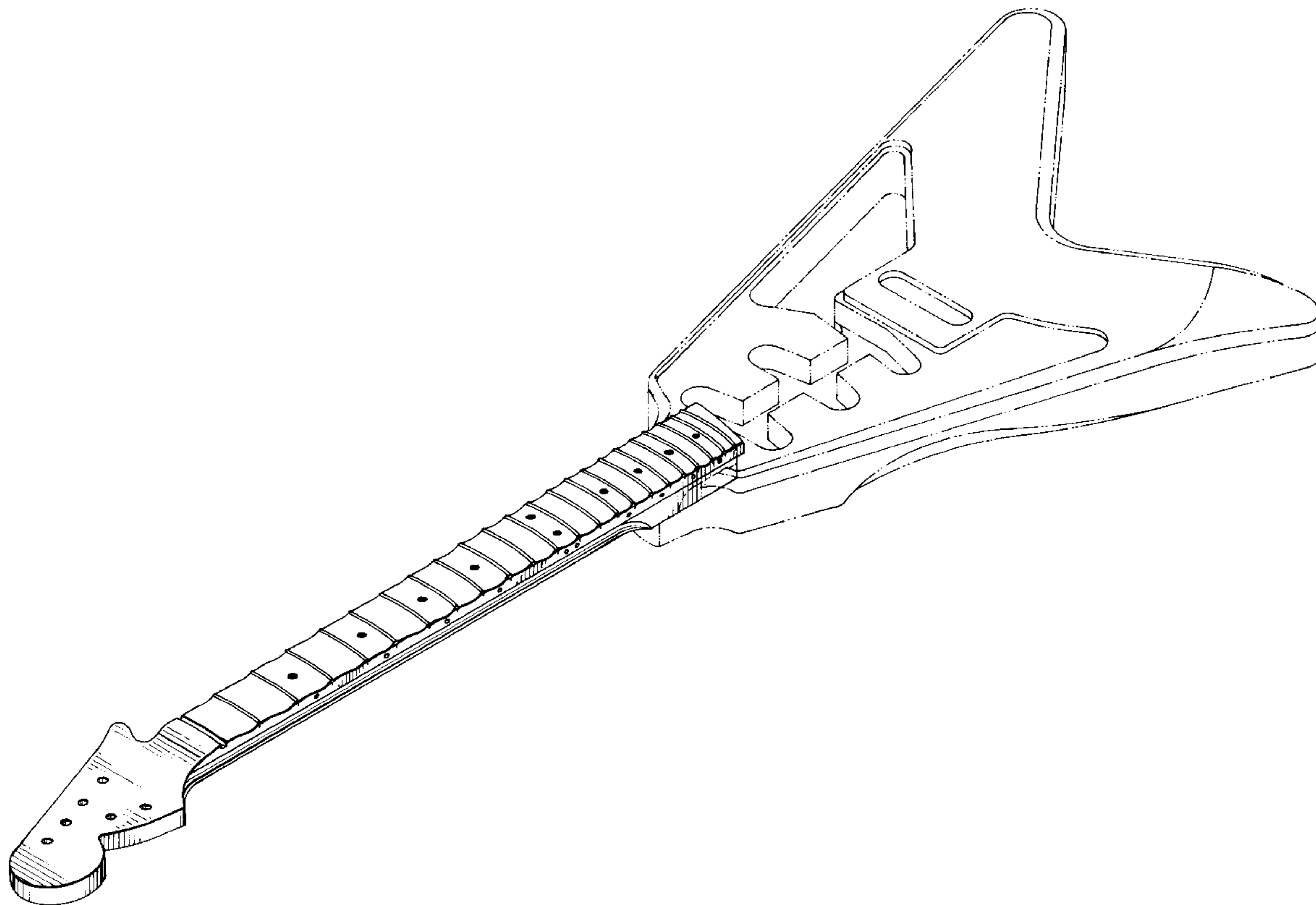
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of the invention.

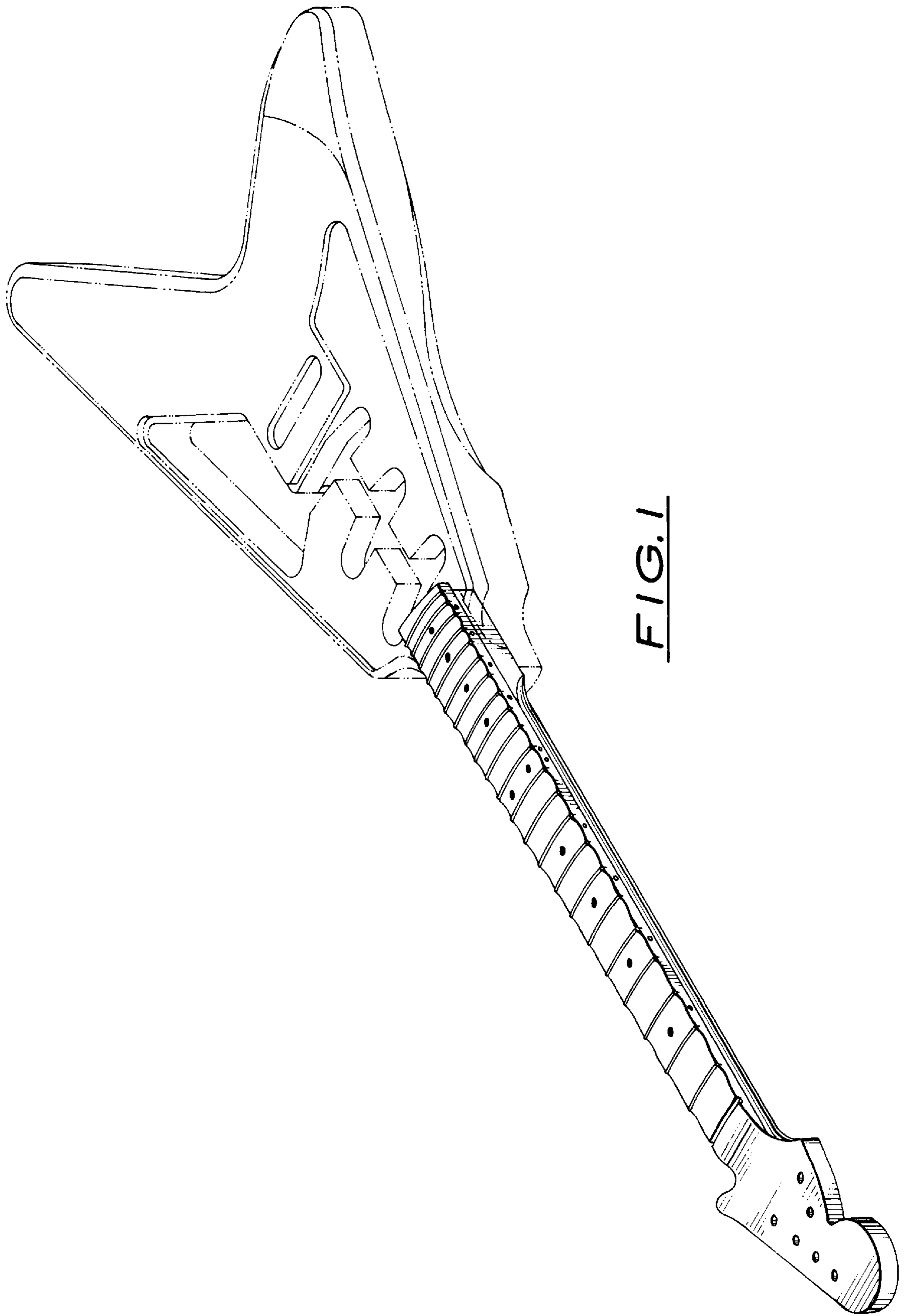
