DESCRIPTION

FIG. 11 is a rear prospective view of a chair cover showing the third embodiment of my new design;

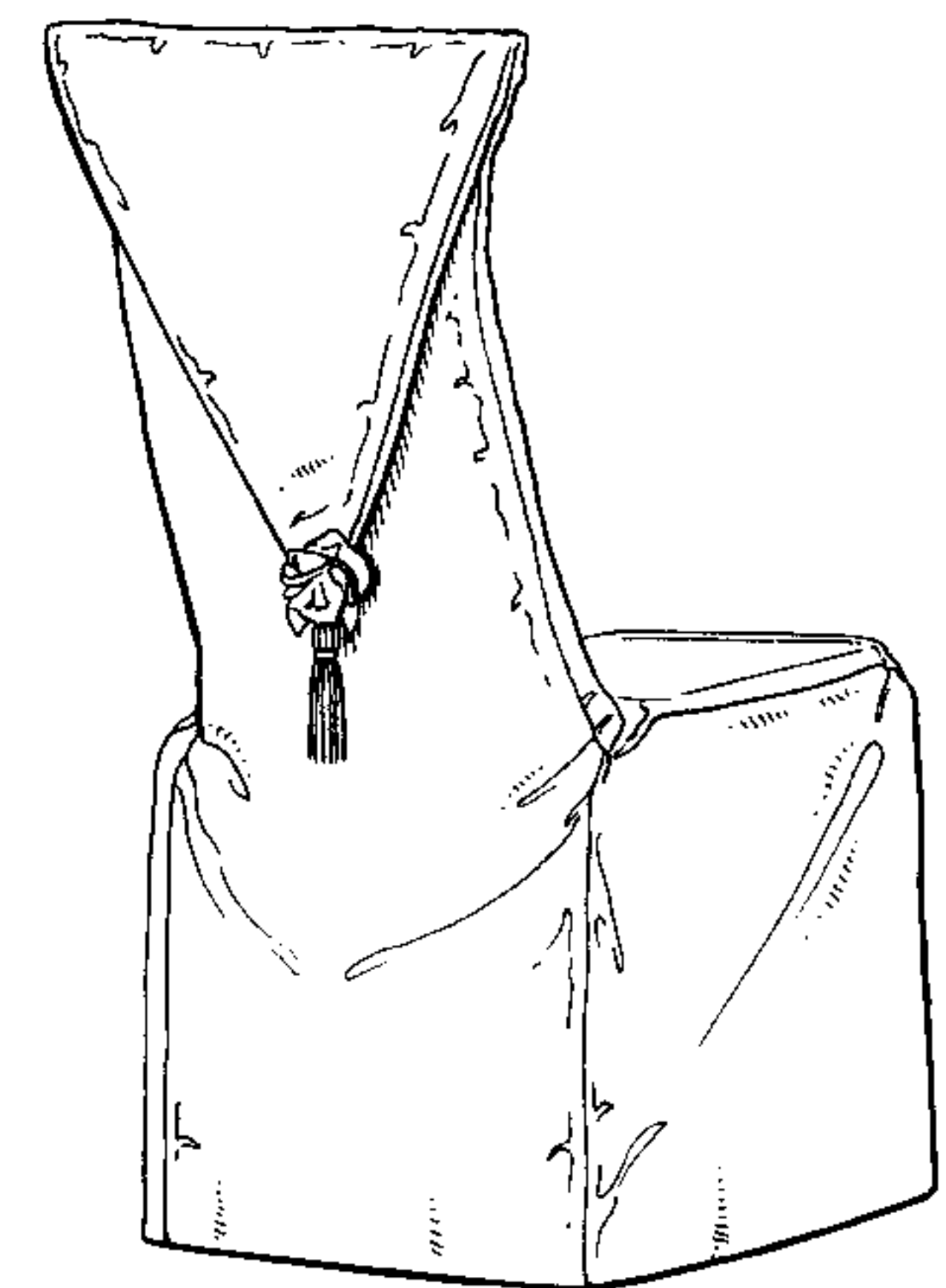
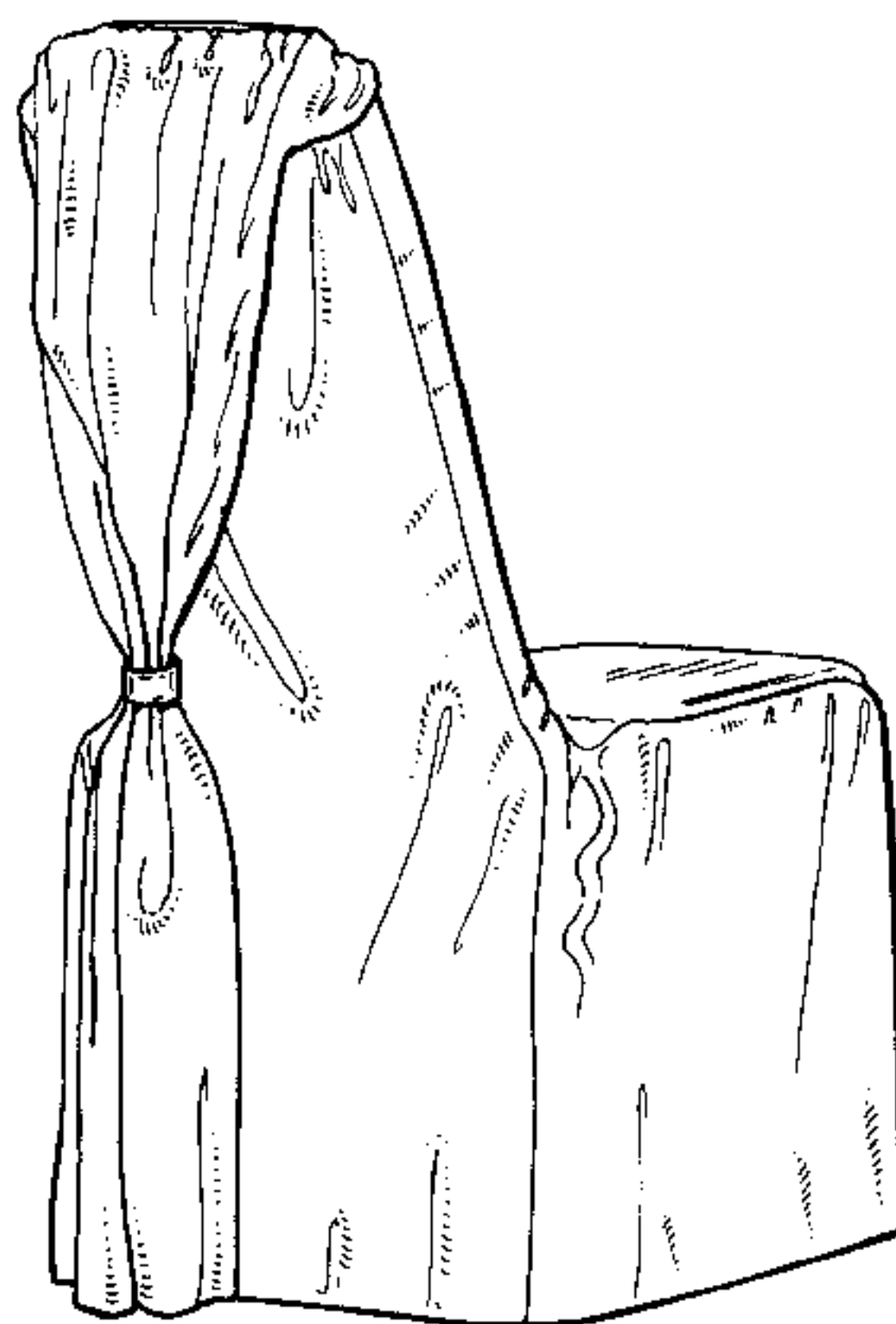
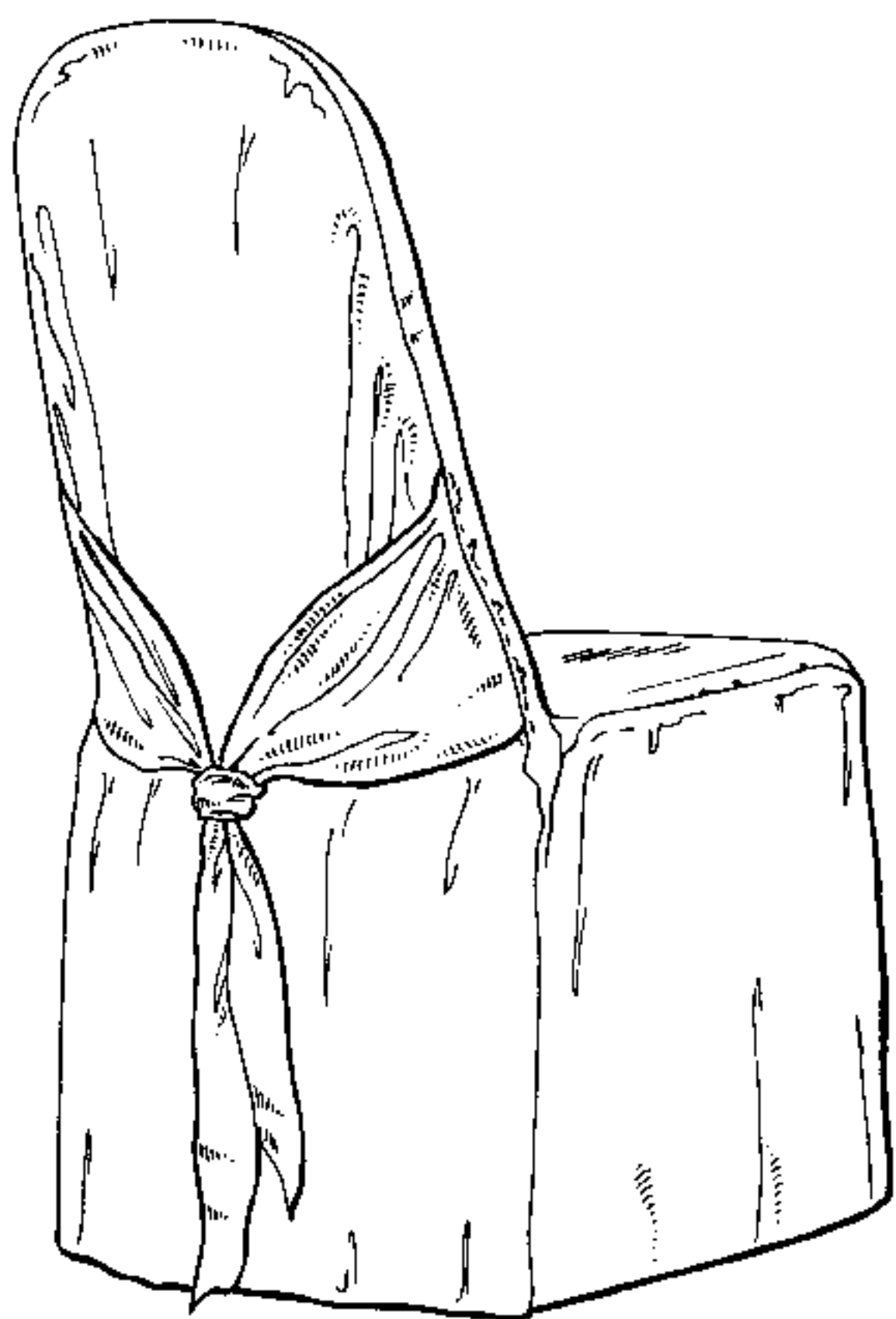
FIG. 12 is a front elevational view of the third embodiment;

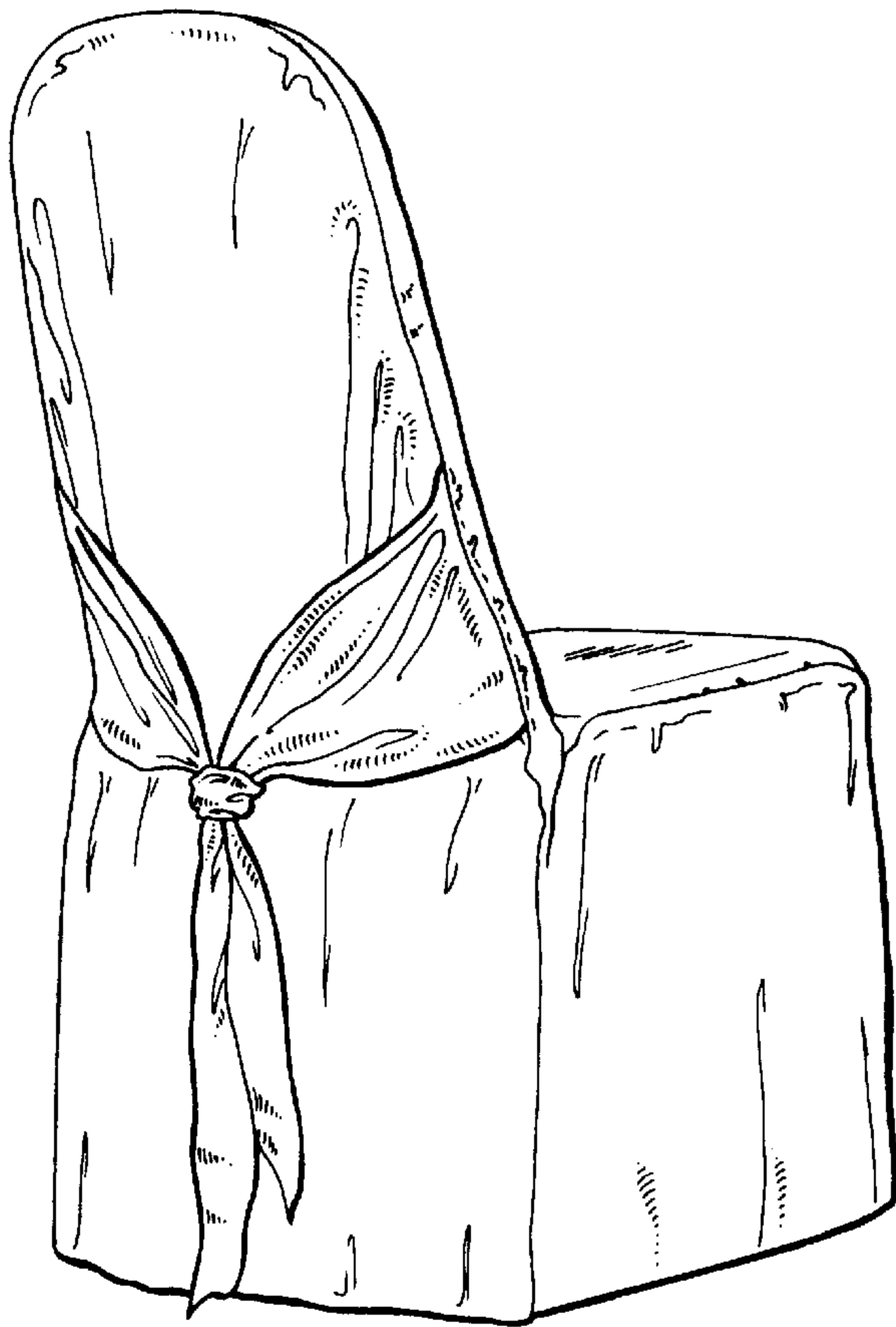

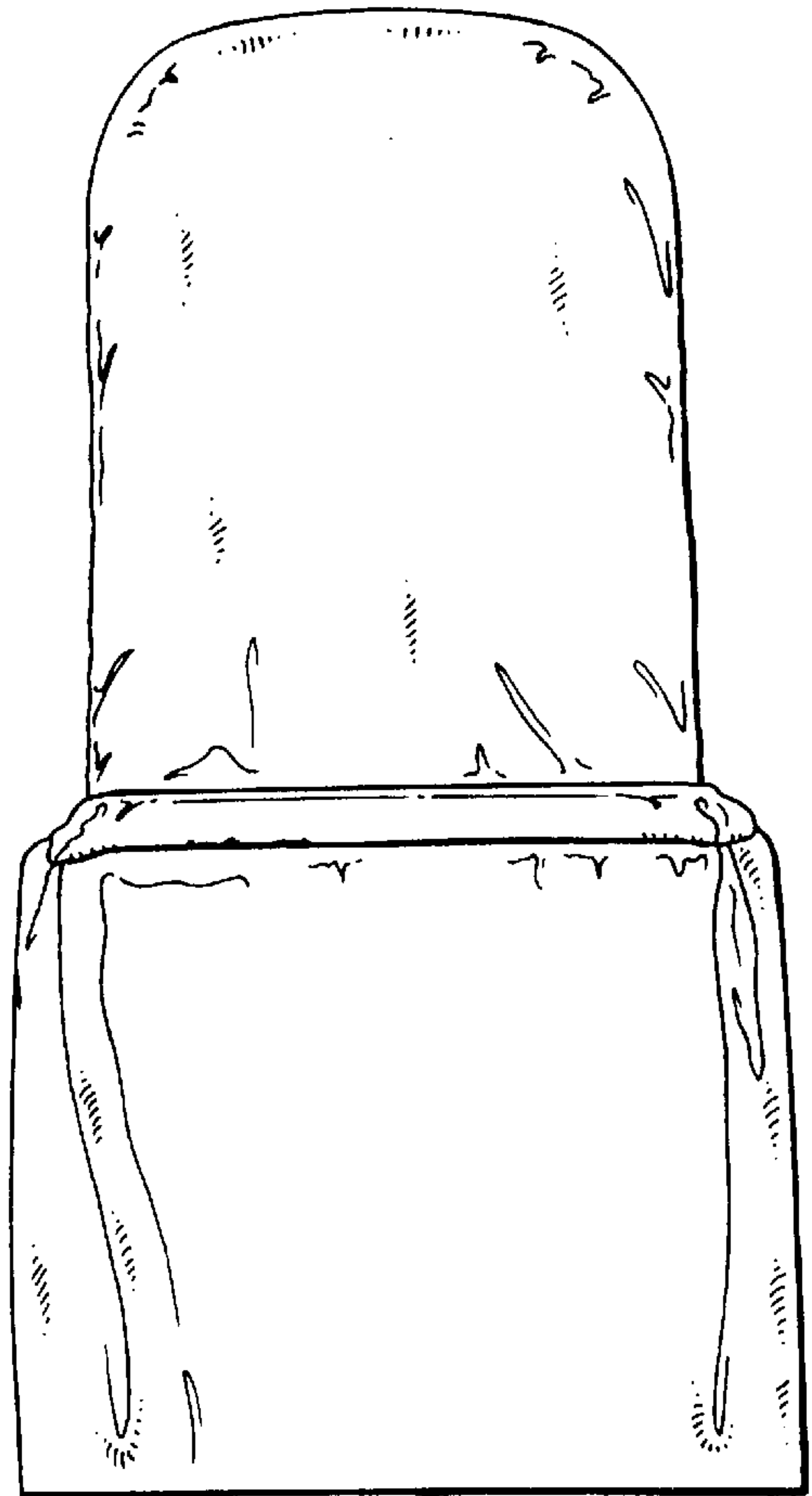

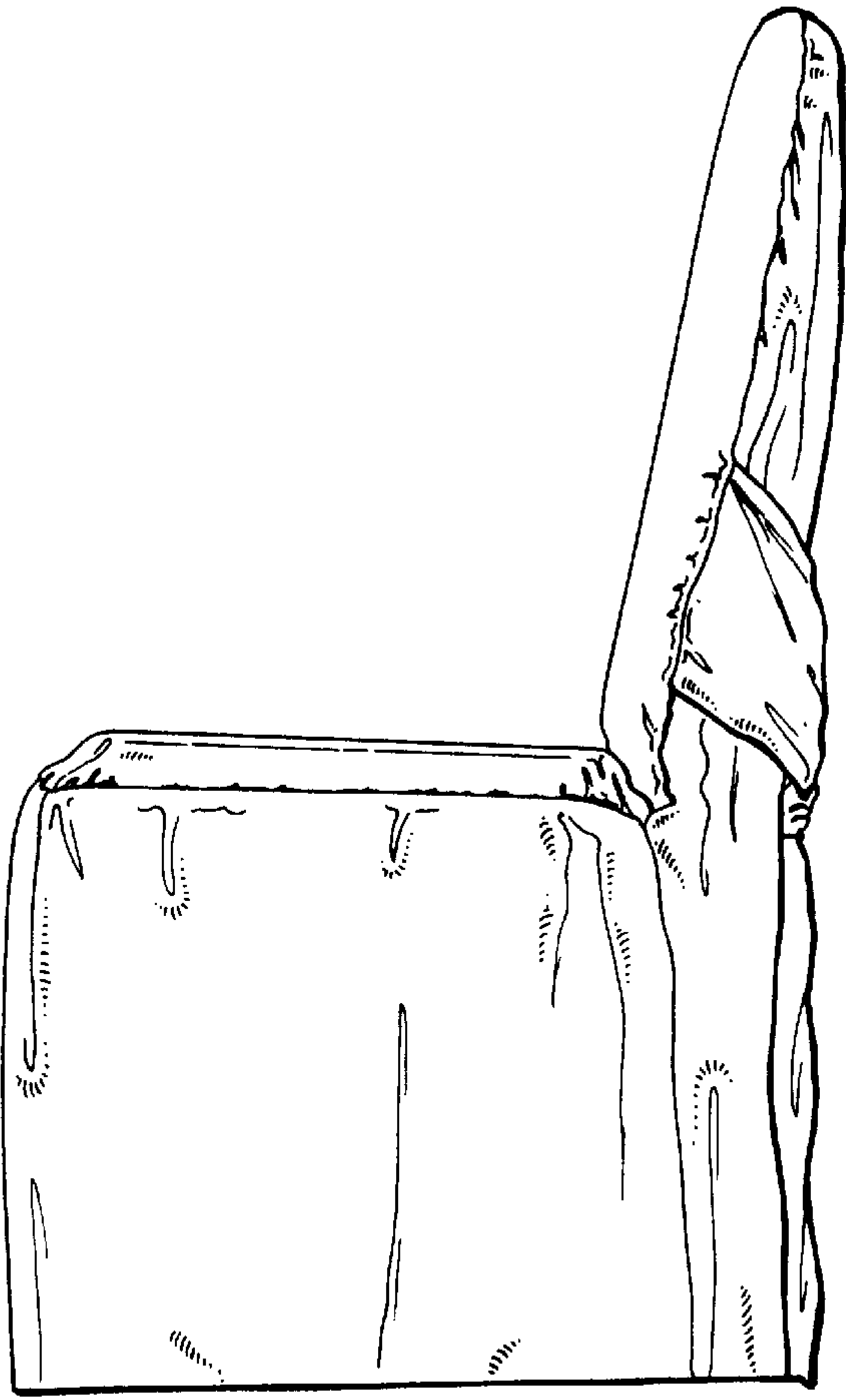

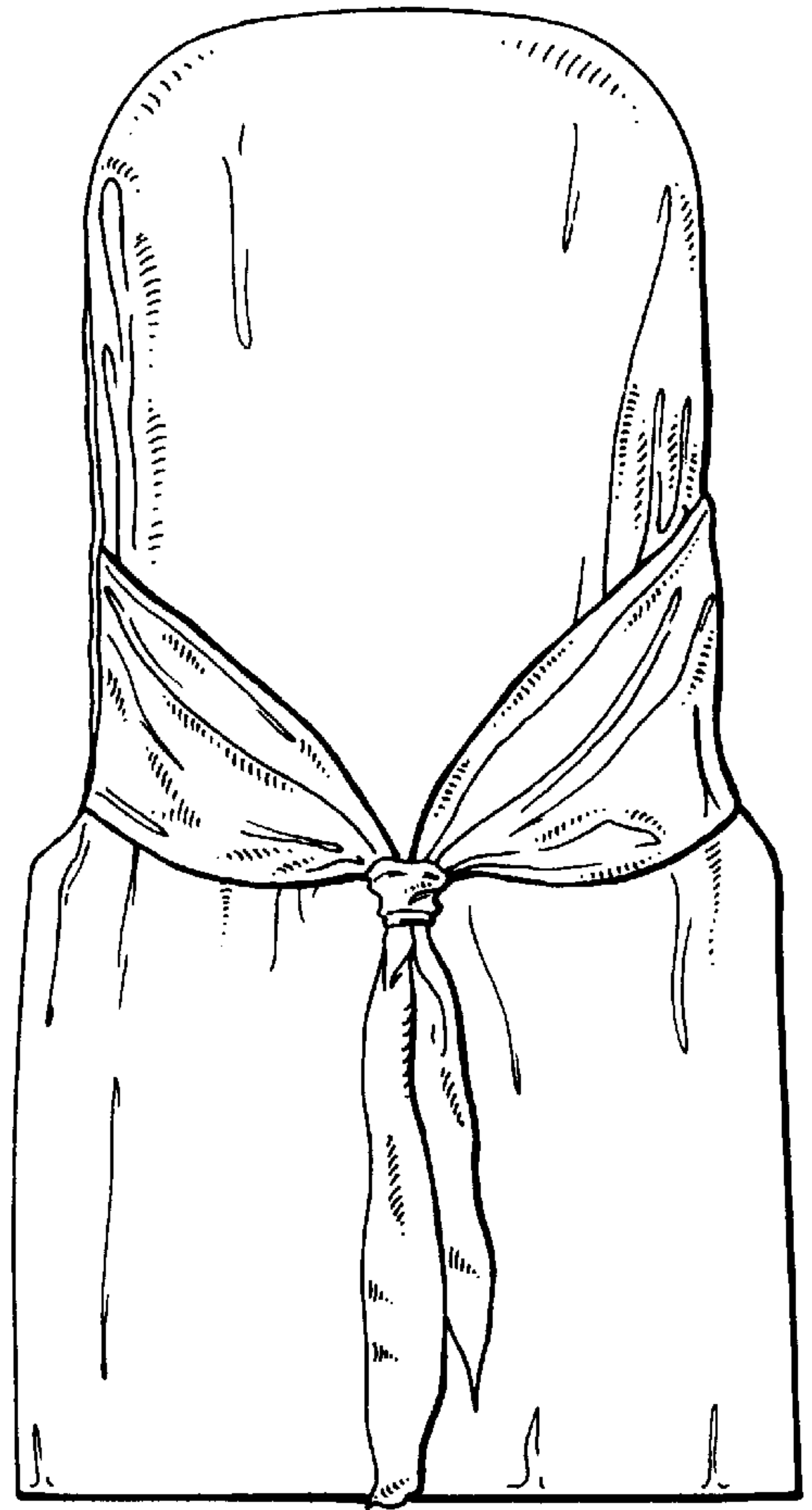

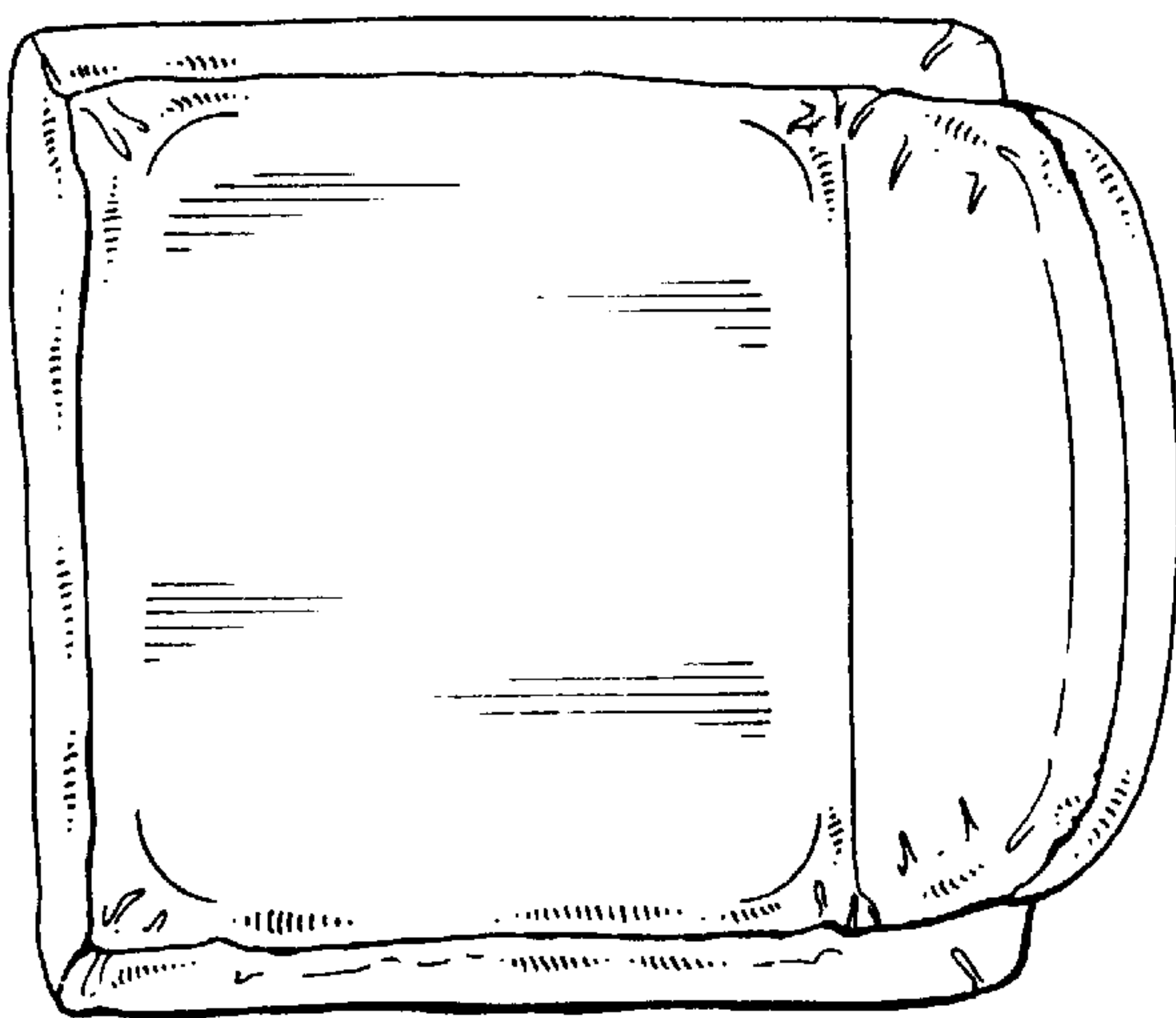

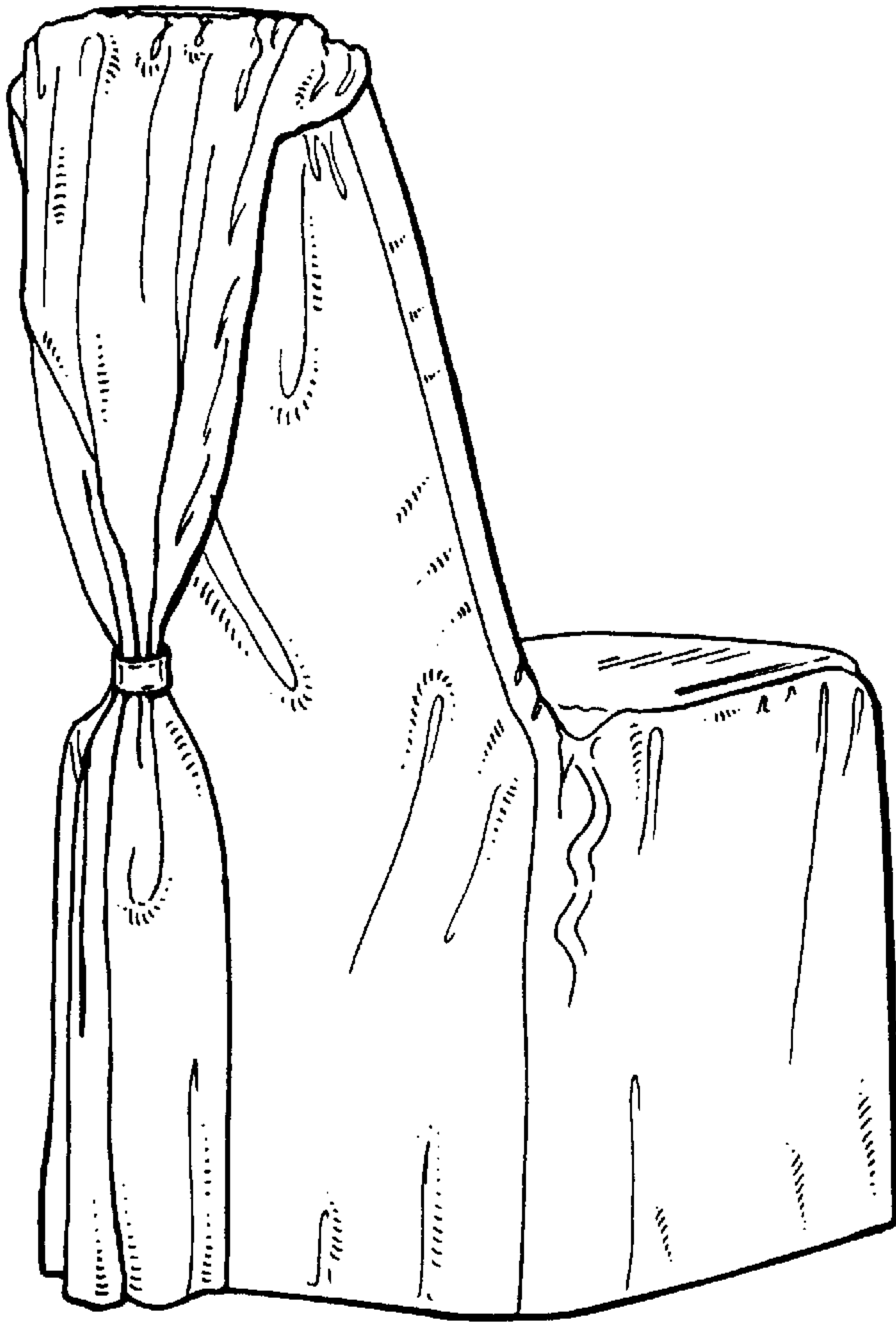

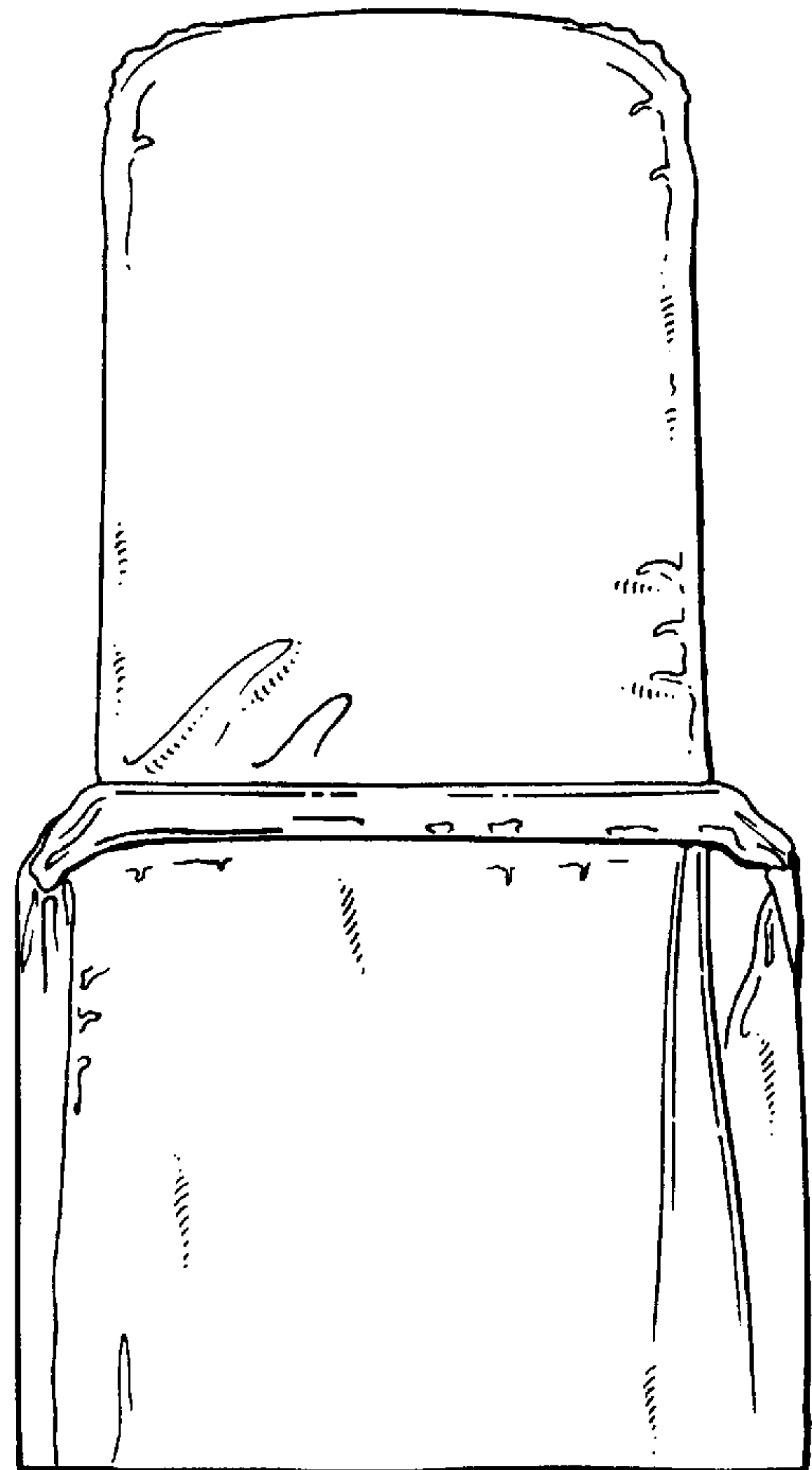

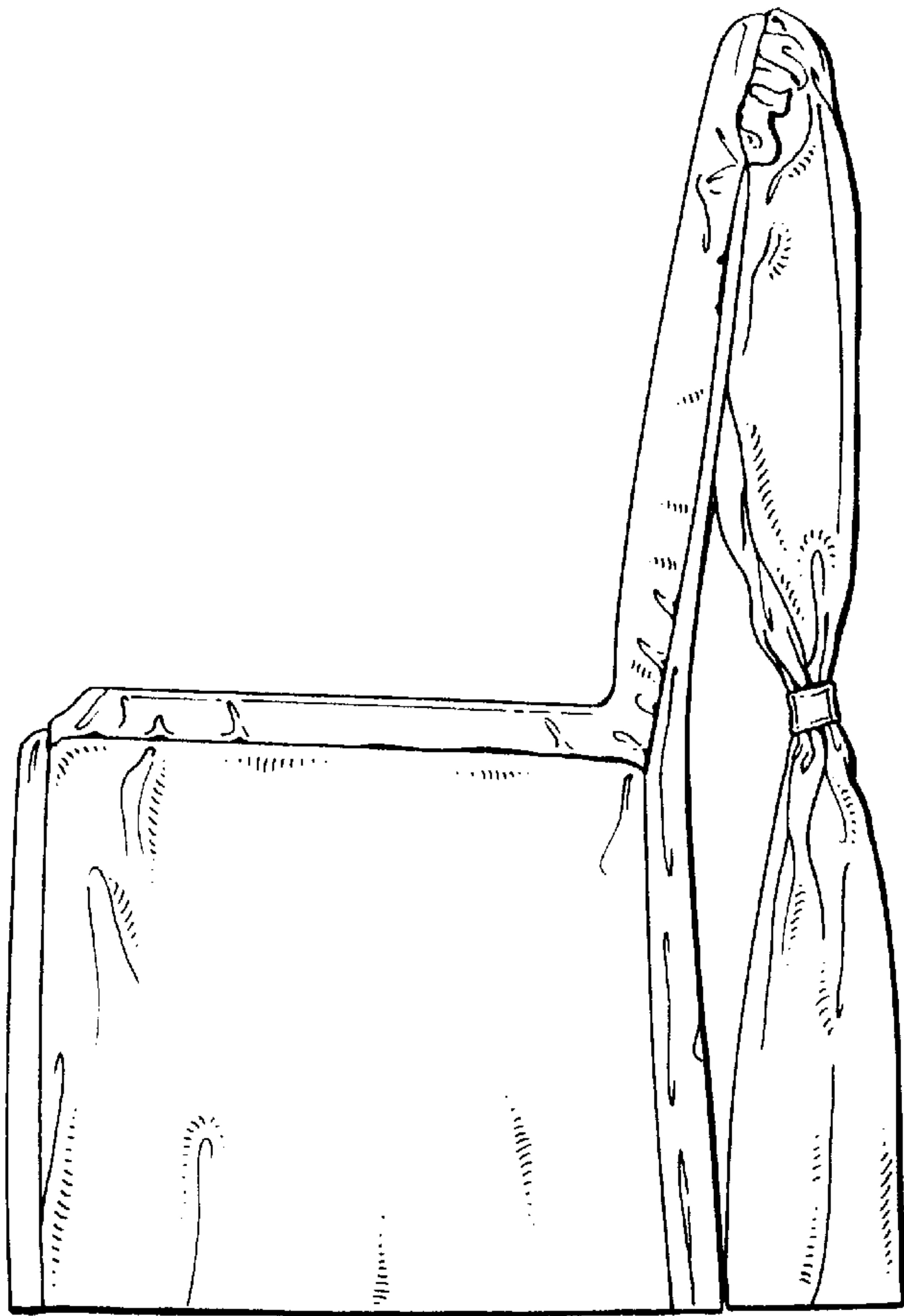

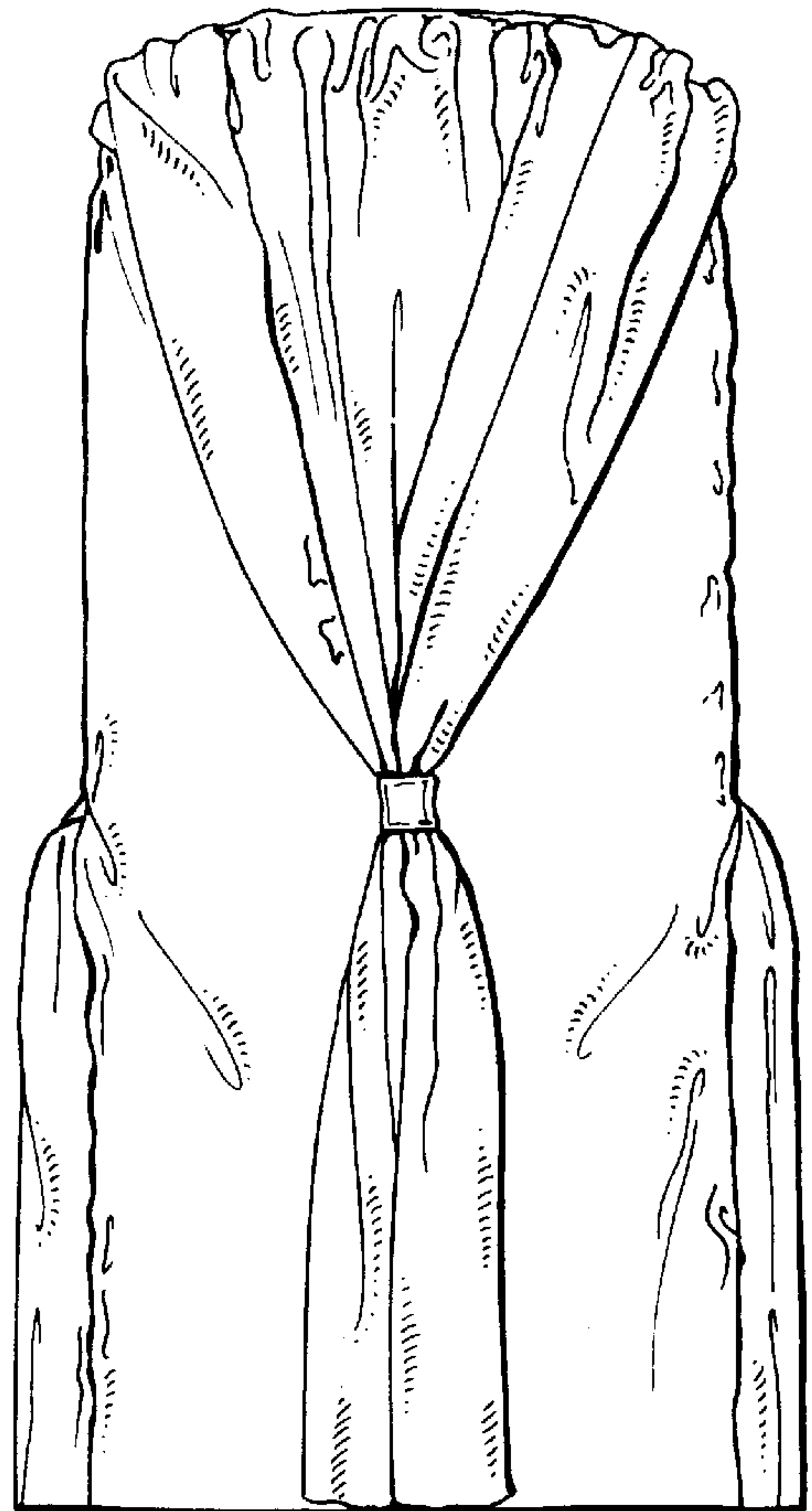

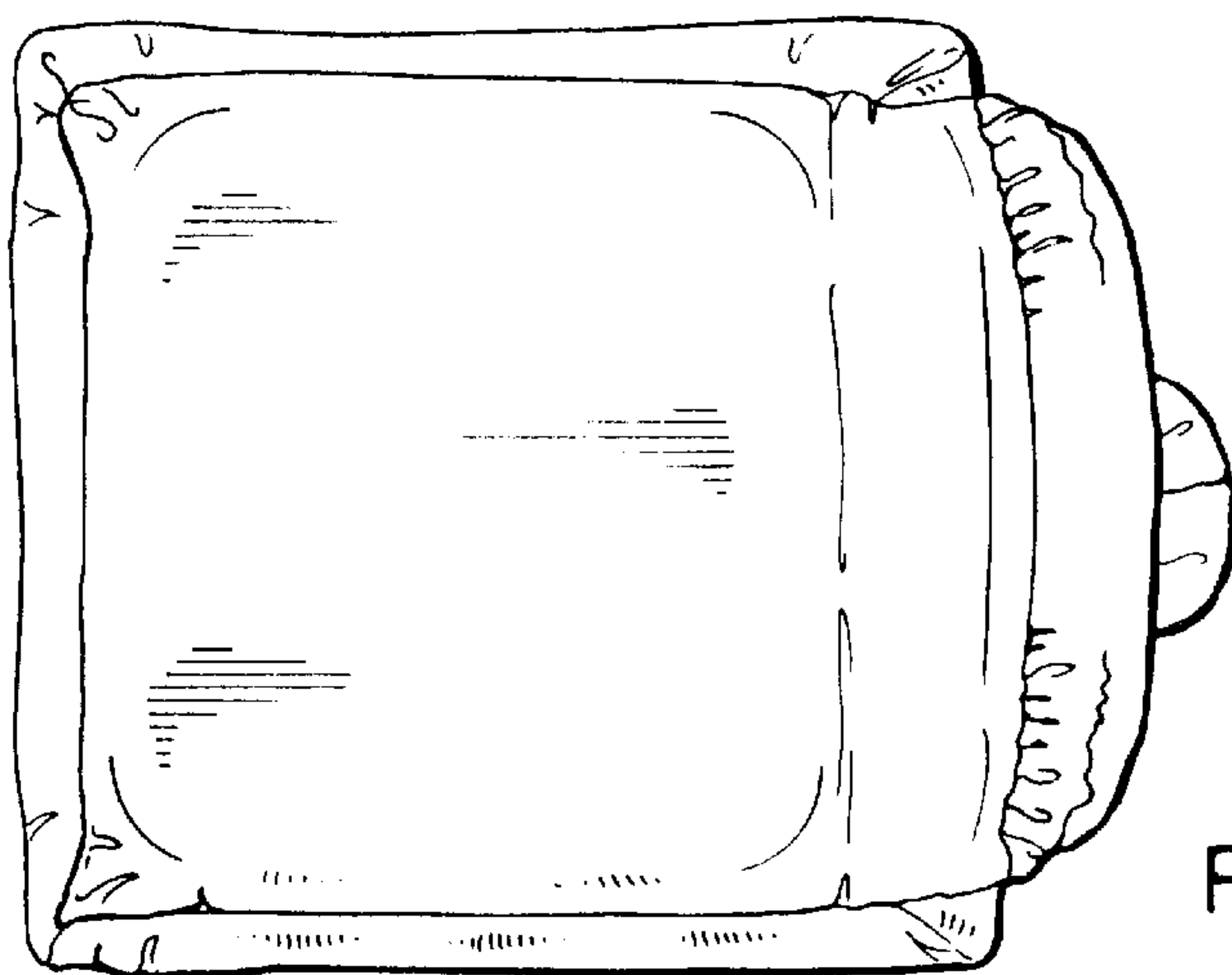

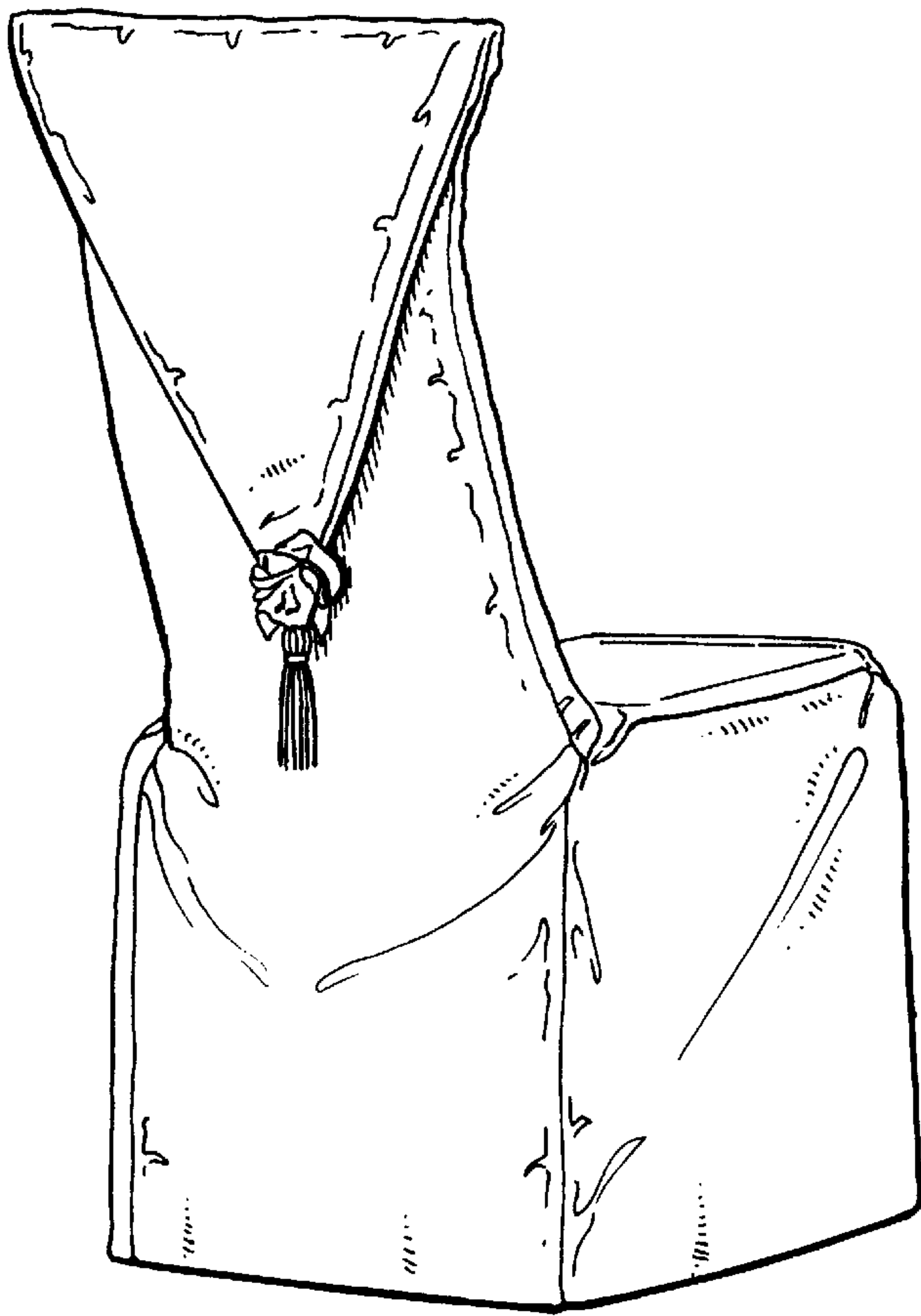

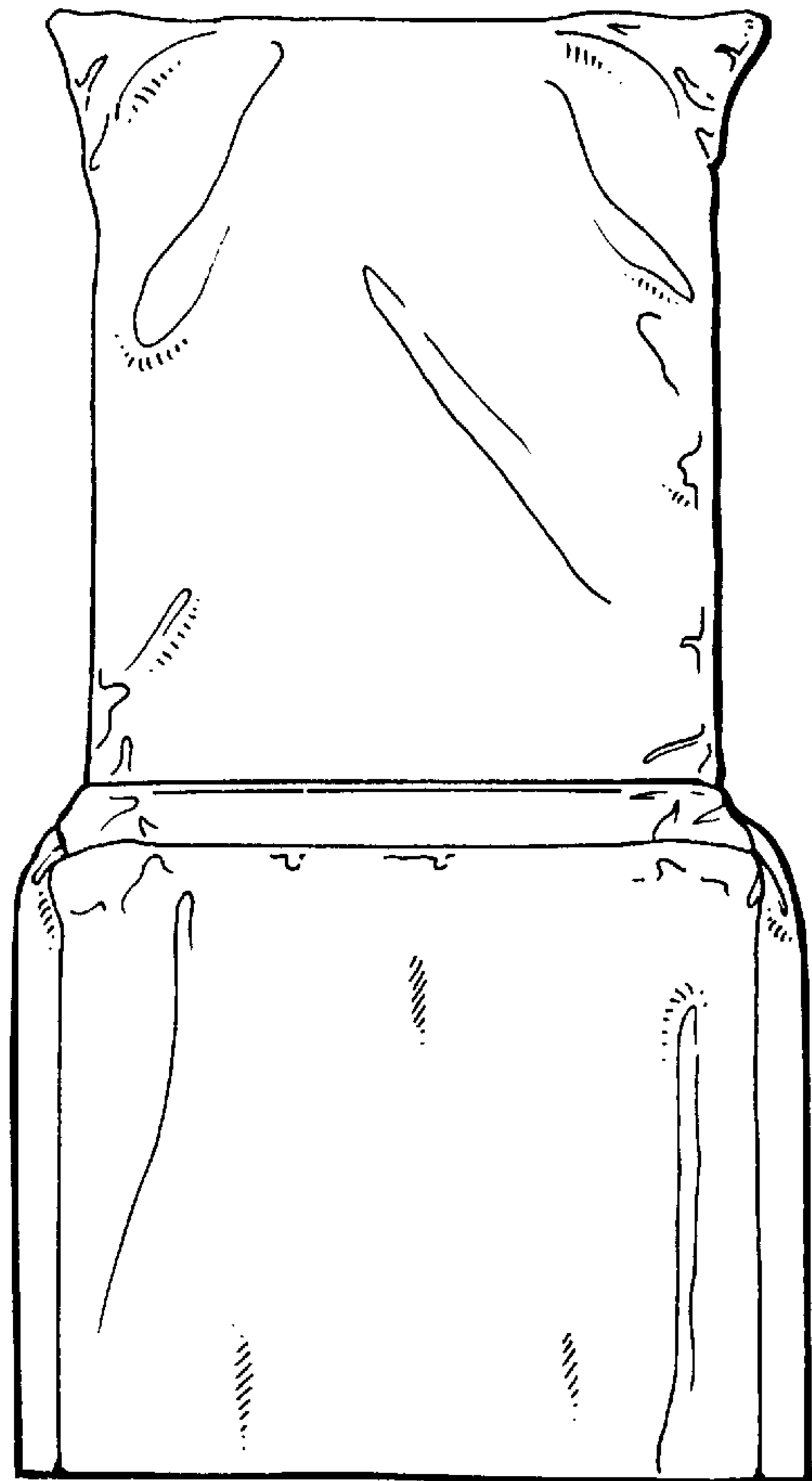

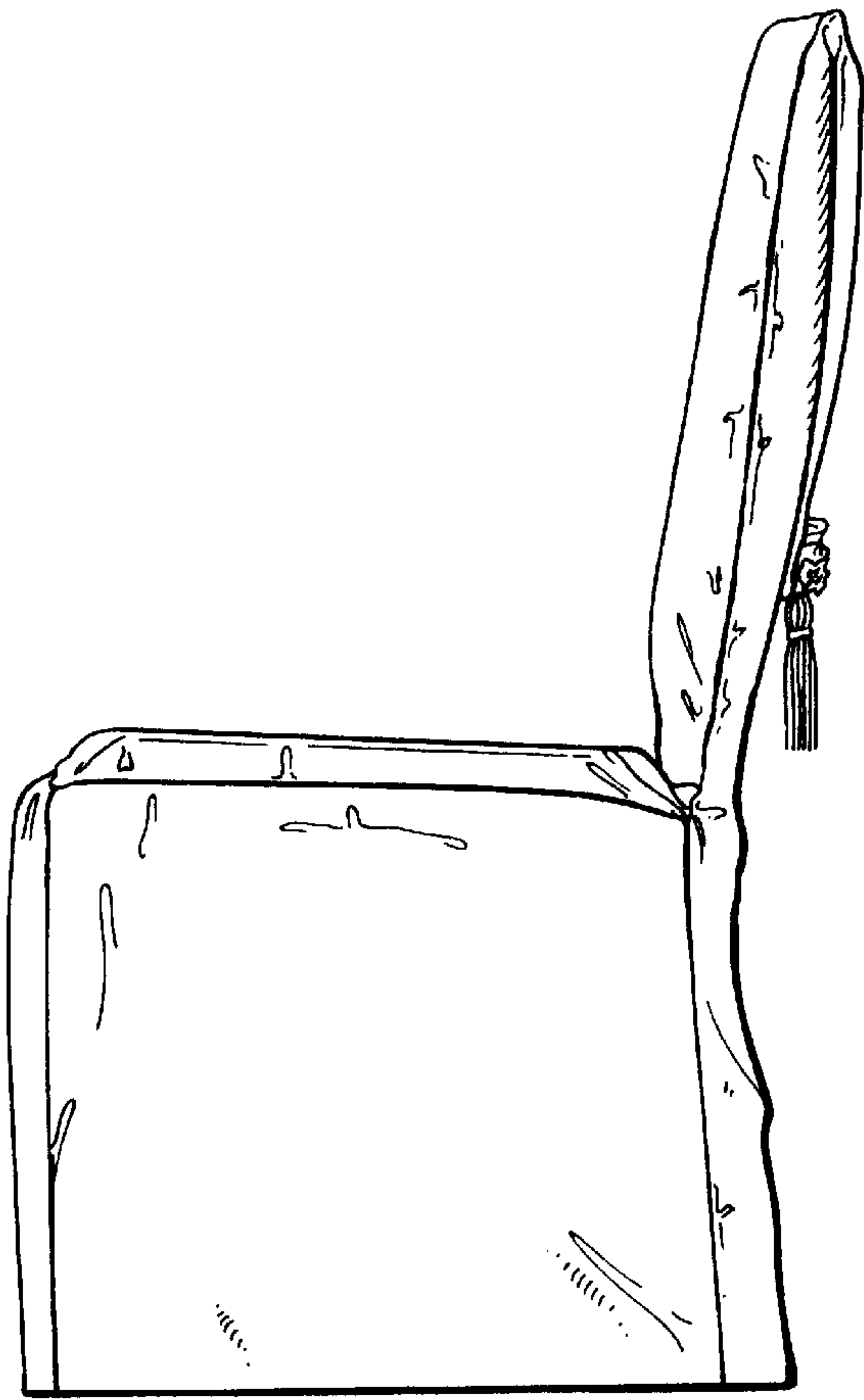

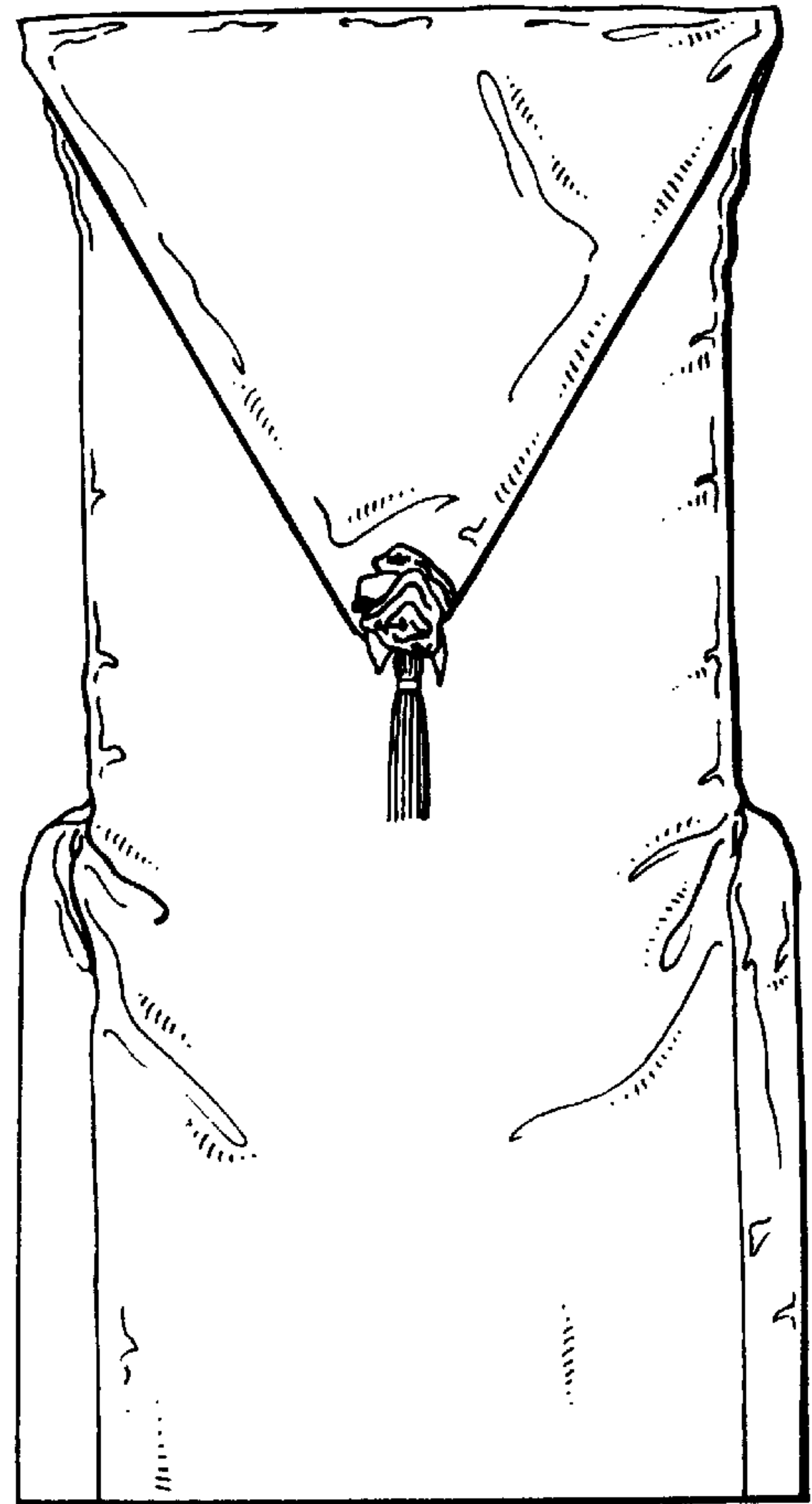

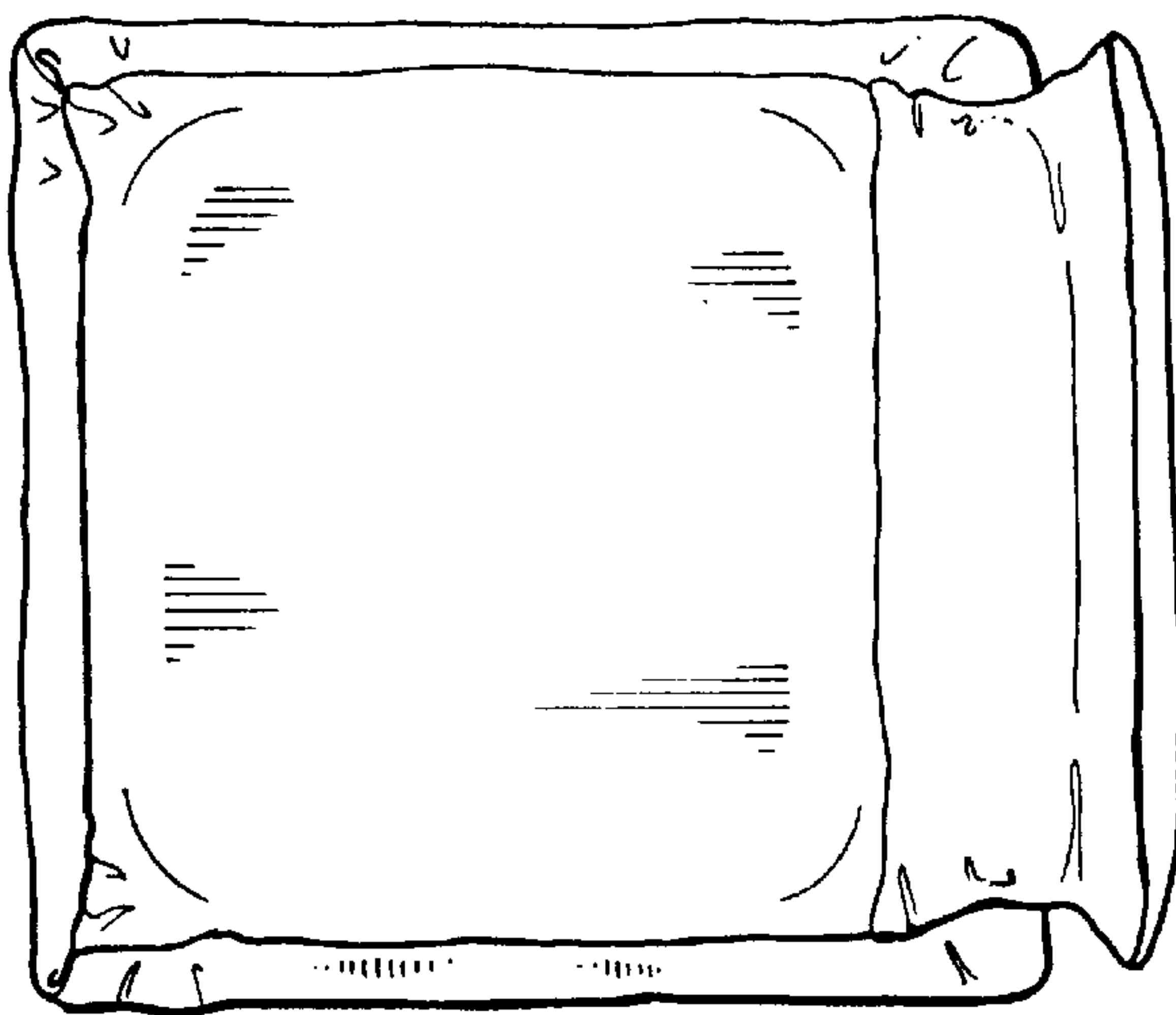
