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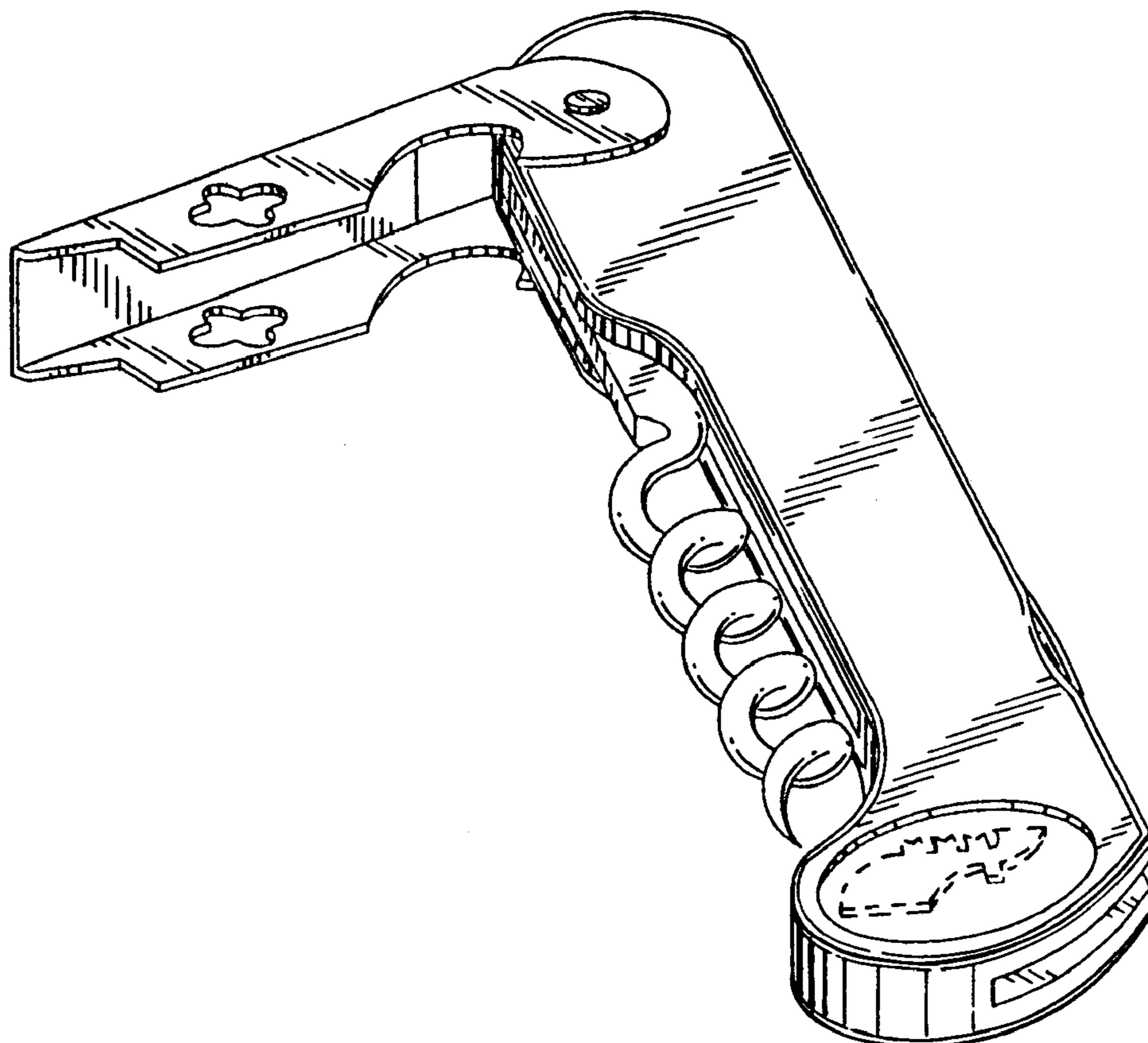
### [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a corkscrew, as shown and described.

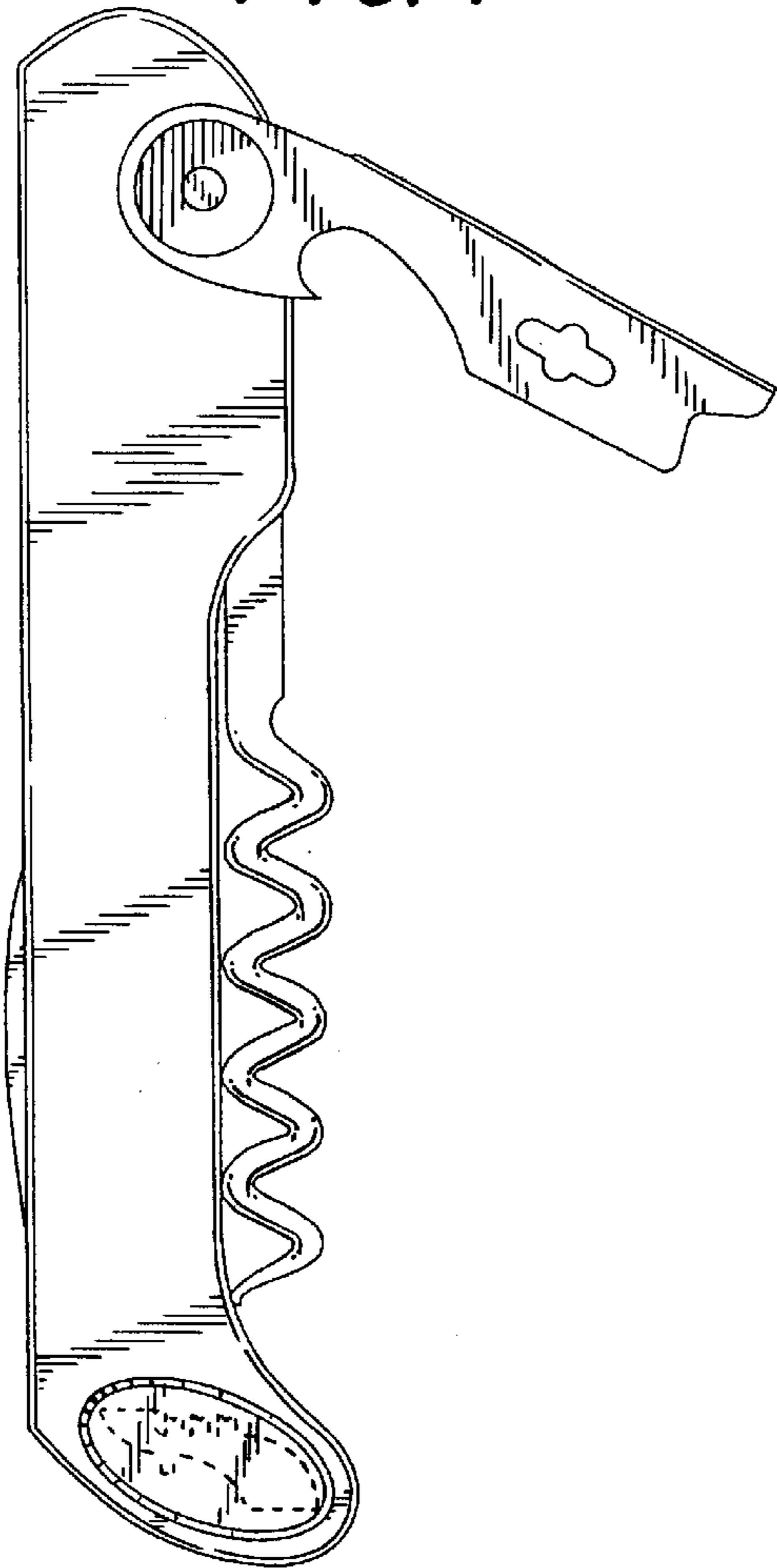
### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a one side view of the corkscrew;  
 FIG. 2 is the other side view of the corkscrew;  
 FIG. 3 is a top view of the corkscrew;  
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the corkscrew;  
 FIG. 5 is a rear view of the corkscrew;  
 FIG. 6 is a front view of the corkscrew;  
 FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the corkscrew;  
 FIG. 8 is a side view of the corkscrew with the worm, lever and cutting element in the closed position; and,  
 FIG. 9 is a side view of the corkscrew with the worm, lever, and cutting element in the open position.  
 The ornamentation shown in dashed lines at the end of the handle opposite to the end of the hinge of the worm and the lever is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

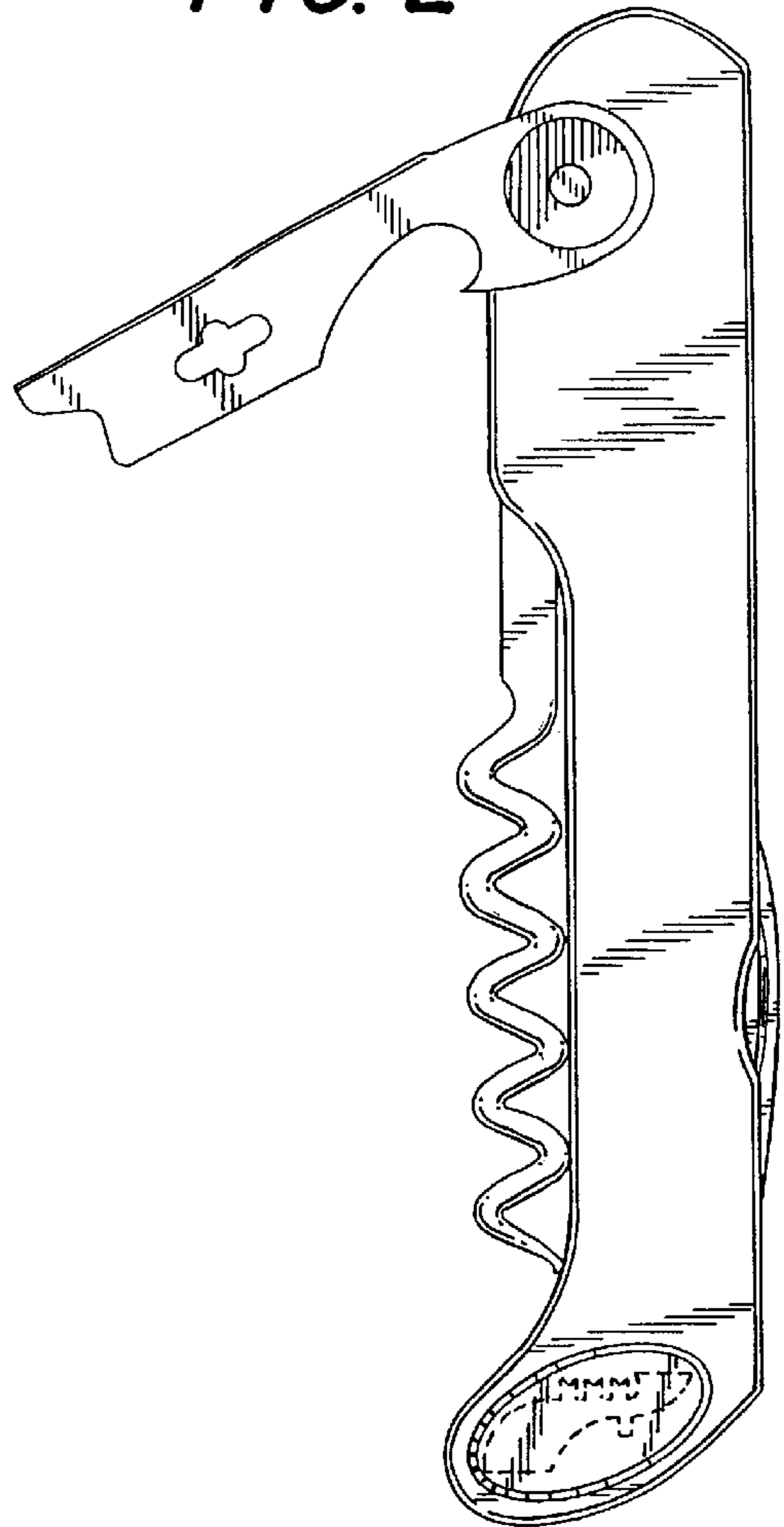

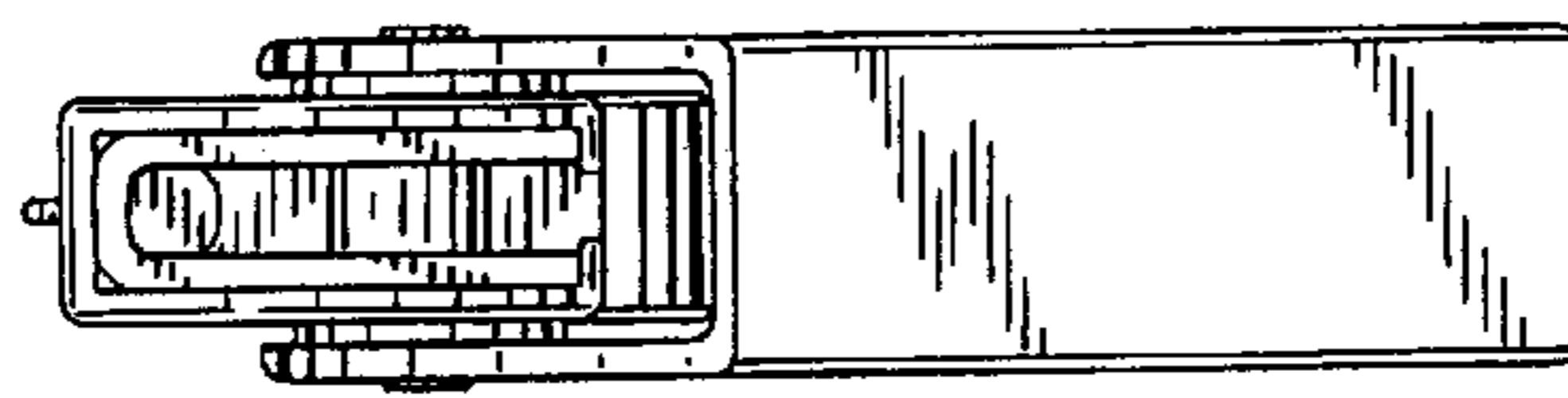

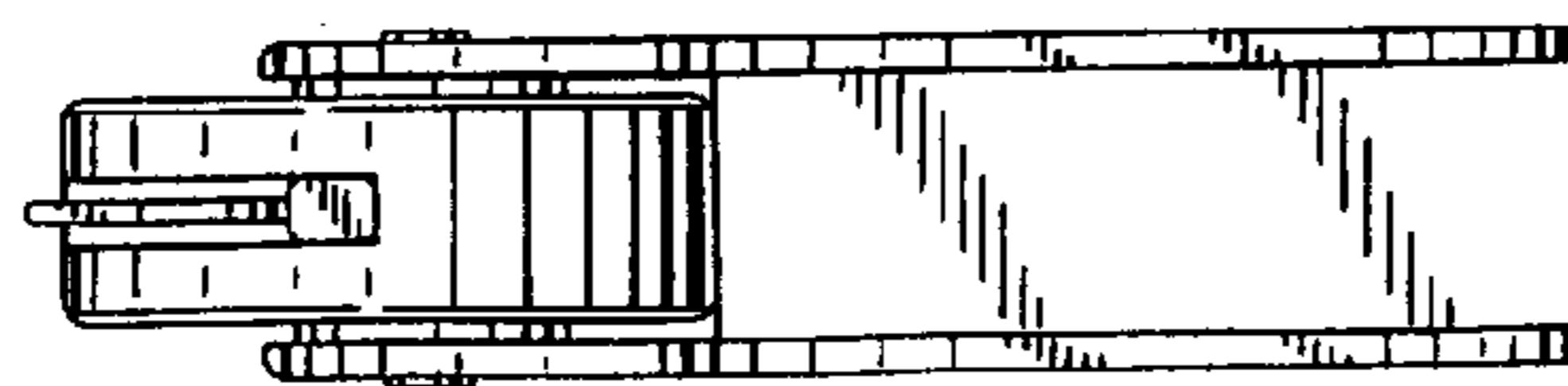

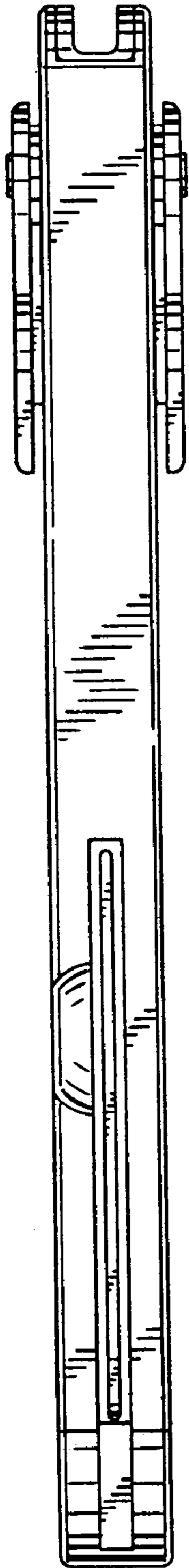

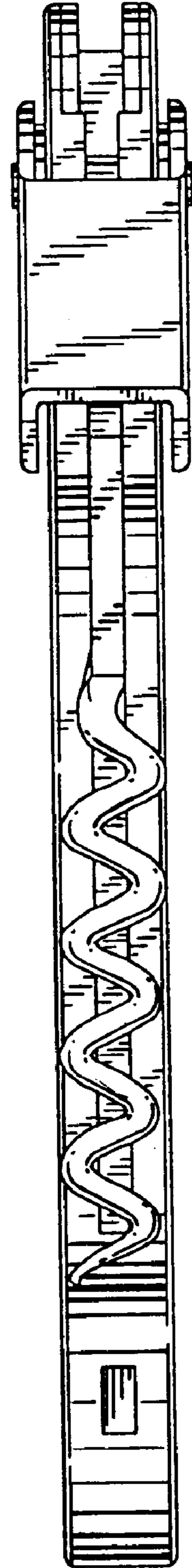

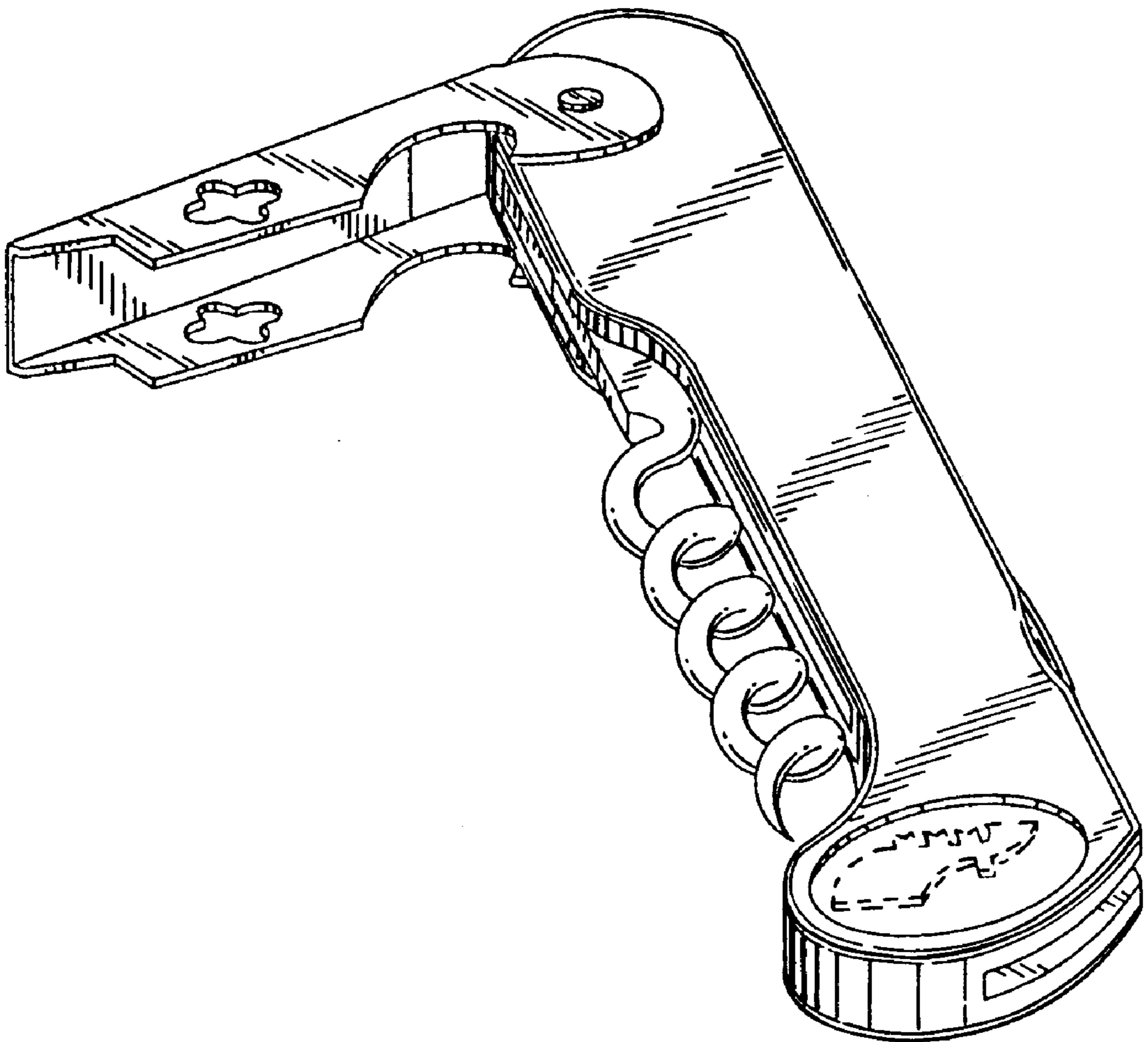

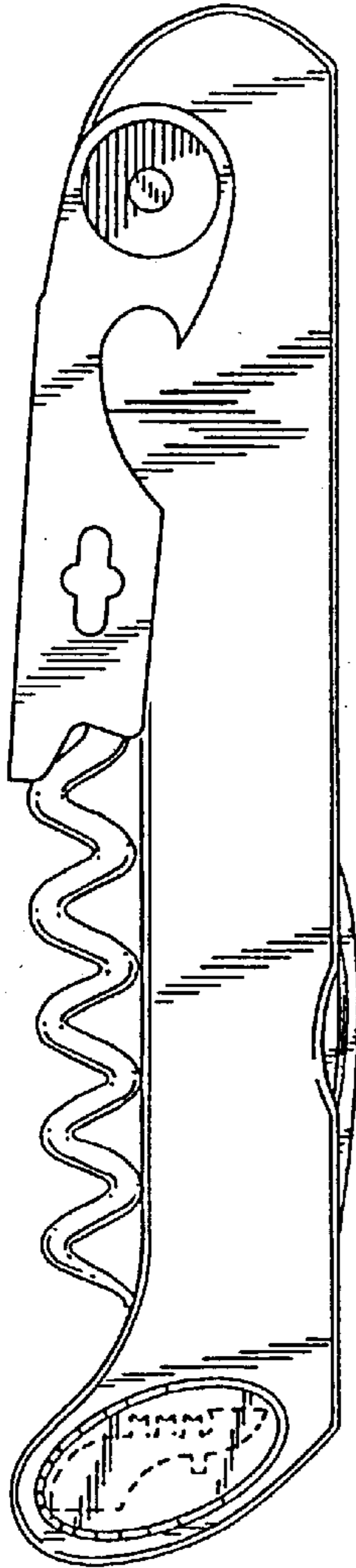
