DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tool holder showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of the tool holder;
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of FIG. 7;
FIG. 10 is a side elevational view of FIG. 7, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 7; and,
FIG. 12 is a top plan view of FIG. 7.

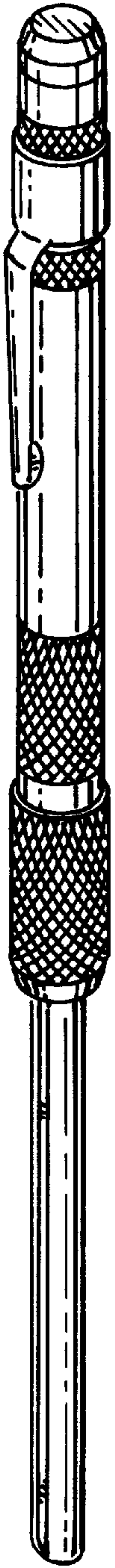

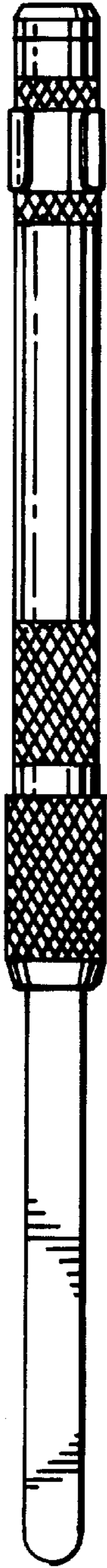

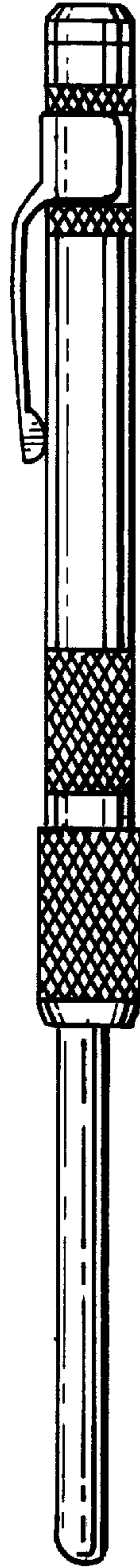
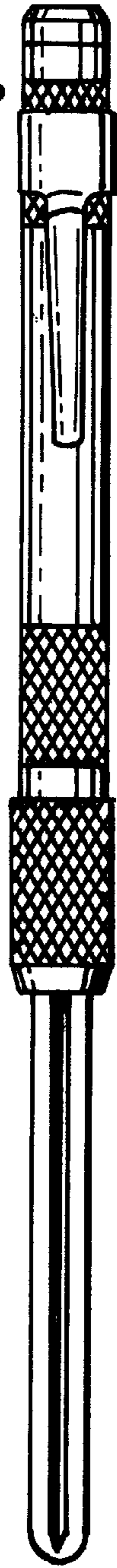

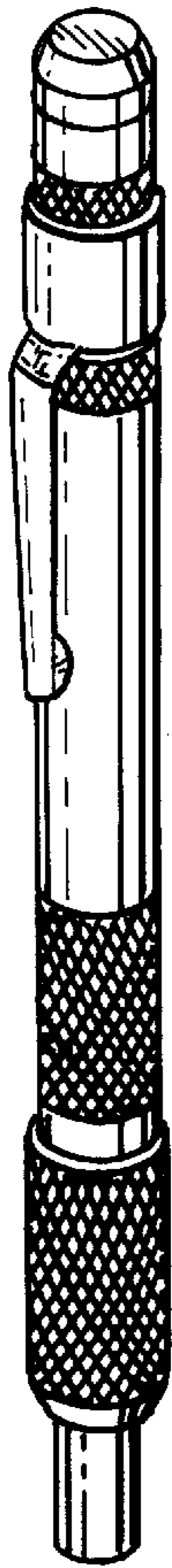

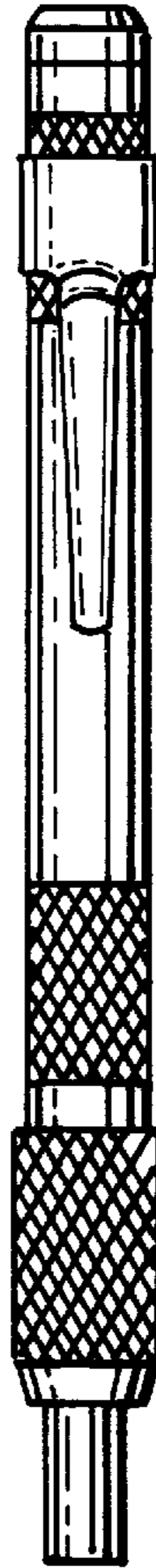

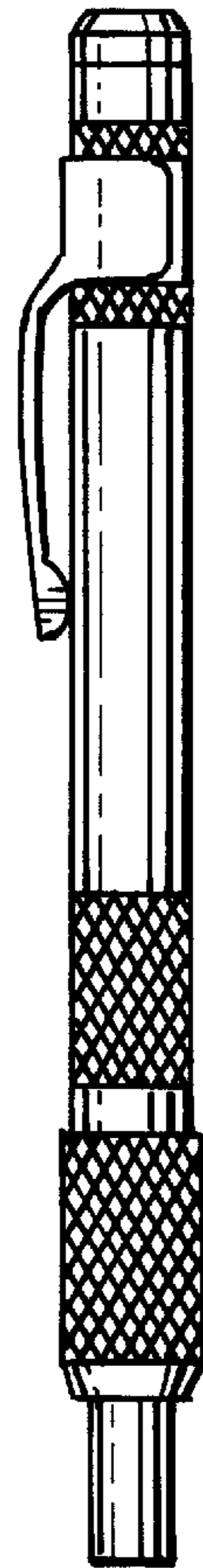
